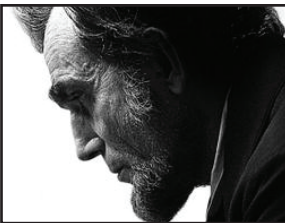

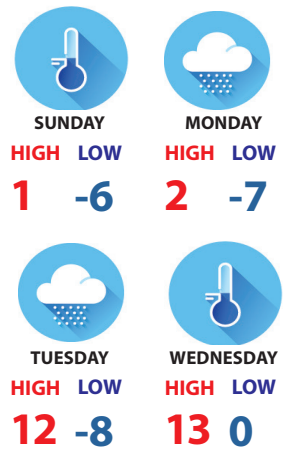

VanVickle sworn in as Illinois Sheriffs' Association president

SPRINGFIELD — Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle was sworn in as a liaison with Illinois legislators, both to serve as President of the Illinois Sheriffs' Association on Feb. 11 at the Virtual Winter Training Conference in Springfield. The Association also serves support teams. The Association also serves as a liaison with Illinois legislators, both introducing and tracking bills that will impact the criminal justice system in Illinois and the communities we serve.

VanVickle has served on the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Executive Board for six years, having been nominated by DeKalb County Sheriff Roger Scott, and served the Northern Region while on the board.

"I've served on the executive board for six years and have been helping the past president," VanVickle said. "I'm looking forward to continuing with the law enforcement coalition and moving forward to work with legislators going forward."

Water generator bid approved

HILLCREST — Village trustees approved a bid from Engel Electric Company in Sterling amounting \$128,670 for the water generator replacement project. The village received seven bids for the generator project, which was originally estimated to cost around \$180,000.

The new water generator will cover both the

village water supply and the village hall in case of an emergency. Baxter & Woodman's Carl Fischer said work on the project is scheduled to begin in early March. Fischer also said the project is expected to be completed by late September.

Seal coat work

Hillcrest will be conducting seal coat work on the north end of the village this year. The

cost for the seal coat work will be \$44,000 and motor fuel tax revenue will be used for the project.

A meeting regarding the annexation of land for the solar farm project was postponed until next month due to a miscommunication. The annexation meeting will be scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 10 with the monthly board meeting beginning 30 minutes afterward.

Elementary district hosts parent meeting about school plan

ROCHELLE — Families in Rochelle School District 231 had an opportunity to listen and voice concerns at a public meeting Thursday evening regarding Superintendent Jason Harper's recent proposal to shift the district from a neighborhood school model to an attendance center model.

The transition to an attendance center model would result in May School closing and District 231 moving forward with three schools (Lincoln, Central and Tilton) for the 2021-22 school year and beyond. Preschoolers, kindergartners and first-graders would attend Lincoln School, while second and third-graders would attend Central School and fourth and fifth-graders would attend Tilton School. Rochelle Middle School would see no change with the transition.

"We have a problem the district is facing and that challenge is that May School is projecting to be only half full next year," Harper said. "That means there would only be six full classrooms... Our enrollments across the district have continued to sharply decline over the last two decades. We've seen about a 12 percent decline over the last 10 years and a 21 percent decline over the last 20-to-25 years... We averaged about 190 kids at each grade level over the last 25 years until about 2013. We have 140 kindergartners this year and we're projecting 120 next year."

Harper said lower district enrollment and more

families choosing to enter students into the district's Dual Language program, which is run through Central and Lincoln Schools, are the two biggest contributors to May School's lower enrollment projections. According to Harper, 65.3 percent of district kindergartners participated in the Dual Language program this year as opposed to 34.3 percent last year, while 67 percent are projected to participate in the program next year.

As a result of increased Dual Language program participation, 29 percent of second-graders, 41 percent of first-graders and 53 percent of kindergartners are not attending their neighborhood school, which is determined by district boundaries in proximity to the school. Harper said a transition to an attendance center model would not change the Dual Language program.

SPRINGFIELD — State Sen. Brian Stewart (R-Freeport) has been asked to serve as a Spokesperson for the Senate Pensions Committee for the 102nd General Assembly.

Change to visitor restrictions, departments reopening at hospital

ROCHELLE — In response to the decrease in the COVID-19 positivity rate, effective Monday, Feb. 15, Rochelle Community Hospital has announced a change in visitor restrictions. Also, the cafeteria will reopen to the public, an increase Fitness Center capacity and support groups will resume meeting onsite.

In all areas of the hospital, patients and visitors are reminded they are required to social distance and masking is required at all times. Screening is required.

Rochelle Community Hospital inpatient visitor restrictions will allow one dedicated visitor per patient in the facility for inpatients who are not being treated for COVID-19. RCH is easing, not eliminating, visitor restrictions. We know that when patients have a loved one with them they have less anxiety and often have better outcomes. Therefore, one dedicated visitor per patient will be allowed on the Medical/Surgical floor.

Cafeteria

The cafeteria is open to the public with limited seating Monday through Friday from 7 to 9 a.m., 12-1:15 p.m. and a made-to-order menu from 5 to 6:15 p.m. Weekend hours offer items from the made-to-order menu available from 12 to 1:15 p.m. and 5 to 6 p.m. Catering orders are also resuming. The Fitness Center will be increasing its current capacity to 50 percent or 10 members in the department exercising at a time. Members who are working out will need to wear face coverings at all times, including while engaged in individual exercise regardless of the member or the machine spacing. Appointments are required to exercise and members are asked to call 815-562-2181, ext. 2730 to reserve a time.

"I think there are educational outcomes that will be improved," Harper said. "It would also allow our district to allocate our resources and our specialists based on grade level and need as opposed to a standard approach in each building. There's also a financial impact including savings in the first year and beyond... There are two impending factors that will impact our financial state. Those include the minimum wage increasing to \$15 an hour and the state mandating that teachers have a \$40,000 base pay minimum. This is a way for us to proactively save and avoid any potential for more cuts and increased class sizes in the future."

Harper initially proposed the transition during the monthly District 231 Board of Education meeting on Tuesday. Harper said the district would save around \$200,000 next year and around \$300,000 the following year onward if the board decides to close May School and transition to the attendance center model. Harper said he plans to update the board with feedback from teachers, parents and community members during next month's meeting on Tuesday, March 9.

"What we're looking to do is improve this recommendation for the board," Harper said. "We know it isn't perfect and we know there are downsides. We've heard great ideas from parents, teachers and people who are familiar with how the model works in other

communities."

Harper said a transition to the attendance center model would allow the district to assign one teacher per grade level for remote learners if the district remains under COVID-19 mitigations, which would then allow for full-day, in-person learning next year. District 231 has operated under a hybrid learning model this year, with students who opted in attending school during the day and learning remotely during the afternoon. Harper said roughly 25 percent of students opted out for full remote learning, while between 1-2 percent of students have left the district.

In addition to the Spanish public meeting that followed the English public meeting Thursday evening, Harper said teacher and staff meetings at all four elementary schools have taken place this week. Harper said a vote on the transition to an attendance center model will take place during the board meeting on Tuesday, April 12 at 7 p.m. at Lincoln School. If approved, Harper said the district will begin implementing the transition from May through August.

Emmett was mayor of the village in the late 60s/early 70s and one of his proudest accomplishments was starting the event, "Farmers Market Days" (along with other community members) to raise money to develop the village park and purchase playground equipment, some of which is still there today being enjoyed by many. During all of those years, he played piano and organ with different musician friends and sometimes solo all over the DeKalb area at special events, supper clubs, and the DeKalb Elks Club. He enjoyed taking his woodcrafts to craft fairs all over the area and was one of the longest running vendors at Oregon's "AutumnFest" attending for 30 years. Again, he was surrounded by family and friends at these events as they either came to work the booth with him, or stopped to chat awhile.

He and Marilyn enjoyed taking trips together to Shipshewana in Indiana and to the Amana Colonies in Iowa (both which carried his wood products) where one shop owner would bring out her accordion, call in friends, Emmett would sit down at the organ and they'd all enjoy a jam session. He also enjoyed going

to his stepdaughter and husband's condo up north, visiting and fishing.

Emmett loved spending time with his children and grandchildren, joking around and playing music together. He was known for his clever wit and humor. He also had a sweet, sensitive side that was cherished by his family. He brought smiles and laughter to most everyone he met. People loved being around him. He had an attitude that he was going to live his life the way he wanted and he did just that, enjoying everything he did.

Practical ways to live in God's kingdom

DURING His ministry on Earth, Jesus' message was, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near" (Matthew 4:17 NIV). And throughout the New Testament, there are scriptures about the Kingdom of God or the Kingdom of Heaven.

When difficult times come in my life, I often say, "This is going to end well." I believe I will know something I didn't know before and I'll be a better person than I was before.

We can encourage ourselves to stay in faith by realizing there is a lot going on in our lives that we can't see. I like to remind myself that just because I may not see anything happening in my circumstances, it doesn't mean nothing is happening. God is always working as I put my faith in Him, and He does a lot before I actually see the results.

In order to stay in faith and live in the

Kingdom of God, we need to keep it in mind more consistently. Colossians 3:2-3 says to "set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God."

Real life is found in Christ, by having a personal relationship with Him, receiving Him as Savior and trusting that as you confess your sin and give Him your heart, you are born again (2 Corinthians 5:17, 21).

In Christ, you are a new creation and you have right standing with God. He is not mad at you, and He not only forgives your sins, but He forgets them; He removes them from you "as far as the east is from the west" (Psalm 103:12).

When you really know this in your heart, you can live by faith and experience Kingdom living here on Earth! You can have God's peace that surpasses your understanding and be anxious for nothing in every situation (Philippians 4:6-7). You can be "filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy" (1 Peter 1:8).

You can know that "the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world" (1 John 4:4) and you can do everything He is calling you to do through Christ who strengthens you (Philippians 4:13).

Hebrews 11:1 says faith "is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." Having faith is easy until you're tempted to give in to doubt and unbelief. A lot of doubt and unbelief comes by paying too much attention to what we see and feel, rather than believing what God says about who He is and what He wants to do in our lives.

I want to encourage you to stir up your faith! Spend time with God in prayer. Study the scriptures in this article and look up others that help you get a better perspective of the life God has planned for you.

Choose to believe that something good is going to happen to you and through you as God works in your life. This is the key to actually living in His Kingdom more than the world around you—by faith.

Attendance center model makes sense

I see there is some consideration for creating attendance centers for Rochelle elementary school children. Lincoln would house pre-k, kindergarten and first grade, Central would house second and third and Tilton would house fourth and fifth grade students.

This was brought up long ago when I was still teaching. I felt it would “even out” education in our schools. When I taught way back when it was not unusual for my fifth grade class to have 16 or 17 students while another had 24 and vice versa. Having all grade levels in one building would help eliminate that problem plus allow curriculum to be presented in a more unified manner. And there will be some cost savings in only operating three buildings while “mothballing” a fourth.

The issue of neighborhood schools will be brought up, but there are a lot of current students not in their neighborhood school. In fact, some neighborhoods don’t even have a school. It may take some coordinating for parents when it comes to school events, especially if they have children in three different elementary buildings.

A decision won’t be made until April with implementation possible at the start of the school year next fall.

I am sure you have an opin-

ion. Issues like this could anger a community. People get upset because their children can’t attend the school they attended or the school right across the street from their house.

I ask that when you talk about this you remain open minded and most of all, considerate. You don’t like the idea? Give your reasons why, but please don’t call people names or be rude.

I don’t like shots. At one point in life, fainting was a possibility when I saw the needle.

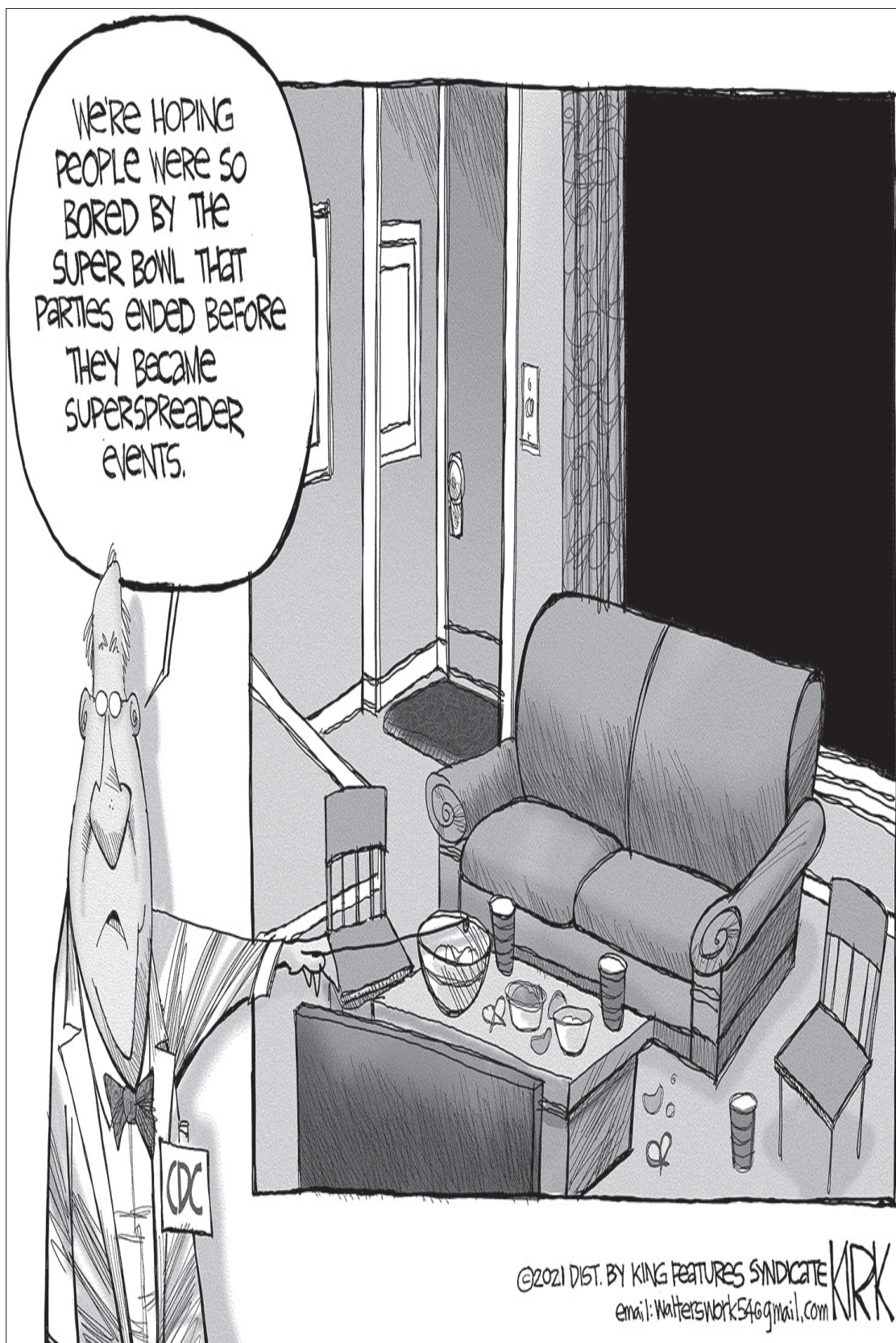
But last Friday my wife and I and a few hundred other folks got our shots. It was painless, with the only discomfort a sore arm the next day.

This is the kind of weather that makes no one happy. It is not like it is 32 degrees and snowing that lovely

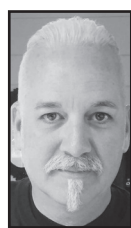

Protect plants from winter salt damage

URBANA – Deicing salts are essential to winter travel in Illinois and provide necessary safety in a landscape setting by melting dangerous ice on precarious steps, sidewalks, entryways and other areas of frequent foot traffic. However, damage from salt can be a major problem in some landscapes by negatively impacting plant health or sometimes outright killing plants from overexposure.

There are some drawbacks; it's highly corrosive to vehicles and concrete and it's mobile in the environment, which

can ultimately end up impacting plant life in several ways.

Salts typically move in the environment, either as runoff in meltwater or as aerosol sprays dispersed by fast moving vehicles and wind. The greatest plant damage from salt usually occurs around major roadways as sprays accumulate on plant parts.

Plants showing damage from salt spray are easily identified since damage is concentrated on the road side of plants. In addition, the suspended spray often only reaches a specific height on affected plants,

creating a distinct line where damaged foliage ends.

A less common, but often more serious, plant ailment can occur if salt-laden meltwater infiltrates the soil profile. In these cases, soil very near a source of salt, such as a heavily treated sidewalk or similar surface, accumulates sodium. The impact is often very concentrated in well defined drainage paths, Pankau says.

At times, it can create soil conditions unsuitable for root growth, but can also be detrimental to beneficial soil biota, such as

mycorrhizae. In addition, salts in soils actually absorb soil water that would otherwise be available to the plants.

Since salt application is often essential for safety in the built environment, what are some ways we can limit the impact to plants? Pankau suggests moderate use of salt, when possible.

Pre-application with a liquid form of deicer is considerably more efficient. Many states are reporting dramatic decreases in road salt use as highway departments turn to liquid application

and pre-treatment. At the homeowner scale, some hot water and a small pressurized sprayer can be used to dissolve the salt and very efficiently apply it. The direction and rate of application can sometimes help to limit plant exposure, if strategically applied, Pankau says.

Be aware that salt is very corrosive to sprayer parts, so careful cleaning and rinsing after use can help prolong the sprayer life.

Alternatives to the traditional rock salt include calcium chloride which can melt ice at tem-

peratures down to about -60°F. At high levels it can damage plants, but it is significantly less harmful to soils, Pankau says. Calcium magnesium acetate is another alternative that is biodegradable and causes no harm to plants and soil.

Phase 1B expanded, Senate committees address COVID concerns

ILLINOISANS with underlying health conditions will be authorized to receive a COVID-19 vaccine beginning Feb. 25, according to a Pritzker Administration announcement this week, which State Sen. Brian Stewart (R-Freeport) says comes after several weeks of Senate Republicans calling on the Governor to prioritize those most vulnerable to COVID-19.

In other action, subject-matter hearings took place remotely for the Senate's Labor, Commerce, and Health committees. Topics of discussion included unemployment insurance, Business Interruption Grants, and the COVID-19 vaccination rollout.

Also during the week, Senate Republicans continue to voice their concerns regarding the pending State Board of Education rule that is expected to come before the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules on Feb. 16.

Phase 1B expanded to include those with underlying conditions

The Governor announced Feb. 10 the expansion of Phase 1B vaccine eligibility to include those with underlying health conditions.

For weeks, Senate Republicans critical of Illinois' vaccination rollout have been urging the Governor to prioritize these individuals, saying those most at risk of dying from the virus should be first in line.

Beginning Feb. 25, those with comorbidities, underlying conditions, and disabilities will be able to receive the vaccine. Prior to this announce-

ment, Phase 1B included those ages 65 and older, essential workers, prisoners, and legislators.

The list of qualifying underlying conditions includes:

- Cancer
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease)
- Diabetes
- Heart Condition
- Immunocompromised State
- from a Solid Organ Transplant
- Obesity
- Pregnancy
- Pulmonary Disease
- Sickle Cell Disease

Sen. Stewart says the prioritization of Illinoisans with underlying medical conditions is long past due. He also questioned why these individuals have to wait another two weeks for COVID-19 vaccines, when prisoners and legislators have already begun receiving shots.

Senate committees address COVID-19 concerns

The Senate's regularly scheduled legislative session was canceled this week, but Senators continued their work remotely. The Senate's Labor, Commerce, and Health committees met via Zoom to discuss a variety of issues brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Senate Labor Committee heard testimony about ongoing issues with the state's unemployment insurance system. Senate Republicans expressed concern over the continued fraudulent claims, the long call-back times, and

Illinois Department of Employment Security offices remaining closed.

The Senate Commerce Committee also heard testimony regarding Business Interruption Grants, which seek to assist businesses forced to close under the Governor's mitigation restrictions. Republican members of the Committee expressed concerns about the lack of transparency in the process of awarding grants, and were frustrated with the fact that only 20 percent of applicants have received grants.

What garnered the most attention this week was the Senate Health Committee, which dove into the issues surrounding the Administration's handling of the COVID-19 vaccine rollout. Illinois continues to lag behind others states in the percentage of people who have received at least one dose. Additionally, Senate Republicans continue to hear from constituents regarding the struggles they face in accessing a vaccine.

Sen. Stewart says he is frustrated by the lack of accountability by the Pritzker Administration. Just this week, the Governor signed his 13th consecutive emergency declaration, marking one full year of ruling under Executive Order. Despite having total control over every aspect of COVID-19, the Governor continues to blame everyone but his own Administration for the failures of the vaccine rollout.

ISBE rules continue to cause concerns

Lawmakers continue to voice their concerns about a pending rule that is expected to come before members of the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules on Feb. 16.

The controversial new rule gives the Illinois State Board of Education broad power to implement guidelines that impact teacher preparation standards. However, due to the nature of the demands the new rules place on teachers, Sen. Stewart is questioning the real intent behind the proposal.

Sen. Stewart notes the proposed new rule is setting a highly progressive narrative in the classroom, arguing that the proposal creates a burdensome, confusing, and vague set of progressive requirements that threaten a healthy learning environment in Illinois classrooms.

Residents of the 45th District are encouraged to voice their thoughts about the proposal by reaching out to members of JCAR or by signing Sen. Stewart's petition opposing the new standards.

Hypothermia a risk when temperatures drop

COLD winter temperatures begin to appear as early as November. While some people retreat into their homes to escape the chill, plenty of others embrace winter because of the opportunities for recreational activities such as snowboarding, skiing, snowtubing, and much more. Many do not mind the brisk temperatures, preferring the cold when walking the neighborhood or hiking nearby trails.

However, just as activities enjoyed in hot climates put individuals at risk for heat-related health emergencies, when the mercury drops, hypothermia can compromise outdoor enthusiasts' health. The Mayo Clinic says hypothermia is a medical emergency that occurs when the body loses heat faster than it can produce heat. While body temperature normally hovers around 98.6 F, hypothermia sets in when body temperature falls below 95 F.

Hypothermia occurs as a result of prolonged exposure to cold temperatures. It also can happen after capsizing into cold water or even sweating and then getting chills when the temperature drops.

WebMD says that, during exposure to cold temperatures, around 90 percent of heat loss escapes through the skin, and the rest is exhaled from the lungs. Heat loss speeds up when the skin is exposed to moisture or wind. In response, the body will shiver to produce heat through muscle activity. Furthermore, the body also will temporarily narrow blood vessels, called vasoconstriction. Activity of the liver and heart normally produces most of the

body's heat. But as core temperature drops through hypothermia, these organs will engage in a protective shutdown to preserve heat and protect the brain.

Anyone spending time outdoors in the cold weather should be aware of the most common symptoms of hypothermia so that prompt action can be taken. Such symptoms include:

- excessive shivering
- slowed speech
- clumsiness
- slowed breathing
- stumbling
- confusion
- weak pulse
- excessive fatigue

Infants and older adults have a higher risk of developing hypothermia due to a decreased ability to regulate body temperature.

Hypothermia is an emergency situation, so it is necessary to call 911 immediately if you or a companion suspects its presence. Treatment goals include increasing body temperature to a normal range. While waiting for trained medical professionals, these steps can be taken.

Remove wet clothing.

Cover the person with warm blankets, including the face but not the mouth. If no blankets are available, use body heat to warm one another.

Try to administer warm soup or beverages if the person is conscious.

Apply warm compresses to the chest, neck or groin.

Do not move the person around or attempt to massage their body to help restore heat, as it could put the individual at risk for cardiac arrest.

Hypothermia is a serious condition that requires prompt attention when temperatures begin to drop.

Shovel snow safely this winter

The beauty of freshly fallen snow is undeniable. Such beauty compels millions of people across the globe to ski and snowboard each winter, while millions more enjoy simply looking out their windows at snow-covered landscapes.

If it was as convenient as it is beautiful, snow would likely be welcomed with open arms whenever the local weatherperson includes it in his or her forecast. But heavy snowfall can be inconvenient, making it difficult to travel and even creating more work for individuals responsible for shoveling their driveways and walkways.

Shoveling snow can increase a person's risk for injury, and some may be surprised to learn just how frequently such injuries happen. The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission notes that, in 2018, more than 137,000 people needed medical assistance for injuries that happened while shoveling snow or using snowblowers.

Sprains and strains in the back and shoulders are the most common injuries when shoveling snow. But people also can suffer lacerations and injuries related to below-freezing temperatures when shoveling snow. The American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons recommends people keep these safety precautions in mind when shoveling snow this winter.

Stretch before shoveling. Just like you would do before exercising in a gym, stretch



prior to picking up your snow shovel. Warm up your muscles with some light exercise for 10 minutes to reduce your risk of sprains, strains and muscle tears.

Stay hydrated and take frequent breaks. The AAOS notes that snow shoveling and snow blowing are aerobic activities. Such activities require participants to be hydrated. In addition, taking frequent breaks can help

prevent injuries.

Avoid shoveling snow if you're at risk for heart attack. Some people should avoid shoveling snow entirely. According to the Harvard Medical School, researchers correlated hospital admissions and deaths due to heart attack the day after it snowed in Canada between 1981 and 2014. Researchers found that the deeper the snow, the more men died of heart attacks. In fact, researchers found that there was a 34 percent increase in heart attack deaths the day after an eight-inch snowfall, and those rates increased when snowfall increased. Most deaths were men, but both men and women who are at risk of heart attack should avoid shoveling snow, particularly after heavy snowfall. Adults who are unsure of their heart health should consult with their physicians prior to shoveling snow.

Use the right equipment. Ergonomic snow shovels can make shoveling less taxing, reducing your risk for sprains

and strains. Spacing hands on the tool grip can increase leverage, making shoveling easier and less likely to lead to injury.

Pushing snow instead of lifting it. The AAOS recommends pushing rather than lifting snow when possible. If snow must be lifted, squat with your legs, knees bent and back straight. When lifting, lift with your legs and do not bend at the waist. Scoop small amounts of snow at a time and walk to where you want to dump. The AAOS warns against holding shovels full of snow with arms outstretched, as doing so puts too much weight on the spine. Snow should not be thrown over the shoulder, as such a technique requires a twisting motion that puts stress on the back. In addition, the AAOS notes that heavy wet snow should be removed in pieces and not all at once.

Anyone can get injured while shoveling snow. Such injuries are preventable when certain safety measures are taken.

How to make driving in inclement weather more safe

IMPAIRED visibility can be a safety hazard while driving. Everything from sun glare to hail can affect a driver's ability to see the road and navigate it effectively. Before drivers get behind the wheel, they should make note of their local forecast and make a plan for what to do if rain, snow or other conditions make it challenging to drive.

The International Association of Traffic and Safety Sciences indicates that, based on an examination of crash test data conducted by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the "likelihood of a crash increases during periods of low visibility, despite the tendency for less traffic and for lower speeds to prevail during these times."

Drivers can take several steps to improve their visibility when driving in poor weather conditions. Inspect and change

windshield wiper blades. Wipers are instrumental in clearing precipitation away from the windshield. If they're not functioning properly, wipers cannot do their jobs. Drivers should replace their wipers at the first indication that they are no longer effective. In some conditions, wipers can freeze or stick. Drivers should then pull over and clean the wipers manually.

Clear obstructions. Always make sure the windshield is clear before driving. This can include removing ice and snow in the winter and cleaning off mud or bug splatter in the spring and summer. Use the front and rear defrost if condensation fogs up windshields and windows.

Slow down. Foul weather can reduce drivers' ability to see far into the distance. Drivers should always drive slower in inclement weather in order to improve reaction time.

Top off fluids. Always keep the windshield washer reservoir full and keep extra fluid in the trunk. In addition, look for a fluid that does not freeze in very cold temperatures.

Learn how to drive in fog. Each year, more than 38,700 vehicle crashes occur in fog, states the Federal Highway Administration. Travelers Insurance recommends slowing down, staying focused and using regular headlights and not high beams when driving in fog.

Go out only if necessary. In snowy or icy conditions, drive only if it's absolutely necessary, as snow and ice can impair visibility and make roads slick, says AAA.

Avoid driving at dusk and dawn. The human eye can have trouble adjusting to rapidly changing light and darkness conditions, which are common at dusk and dawn. If possible, drivers should make trips

during the heart of the day, especially if poor lighting conditions typically make

it difficult for them to drive. Drivers can take steps

to improve visibility when inclement weather makes roadways hard to navigate.

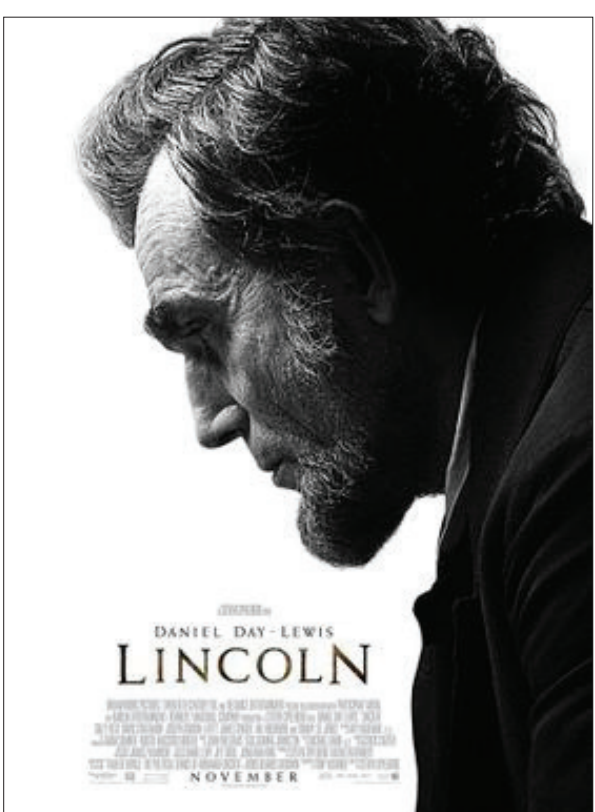

Cavs cruise over Hubs

Troubling third quarter dooms Rochelle in 83-64 loss to LaSalle-Peru

ROCHELLE — A disastrous third quarter ruined any chances of victory for the Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team during Interstate 8 Conference play against LaSalle-Peru on Friday. Rochelle held a slim 45-42 lead over LaSalle-Peru early in the third quarter before Cavalier senior Drake Weber ignited from beyond the arc, sinking four 3-pointers and scoring 18 of his game-high 34 points in the period. LaSalle-Peru throttled the Hubs 37-19 in the third quarter, sealing an 83-64 win over Rochelle that dropped the purple and white to 1-2 overall. “I felt that not only Weber, but everybody on their team was making shots,” head coach Tim Thompson said. “Our defensive rotations were so slow tonight and I felt that we didn’t do any of the things we prided ourselves on against Sycamore on Tuesday. They were getting their first dribble into the lane and kicking the ball for wide open looks. When teams get wide

open looks, they’re going to make open shots... I felt that they wanted to win this game more than we did.” Weber was one of three Cavaliers in double figures Friday evening. LaSalle-Peru held a slight 23-20 advantage after the first quarter behind nine points on four made field goals from John Riva, who finished with 17 in the game. Senior Garrett Burdin was Rochelle’s first-half spark plug, nailing four of his game-high seven triples in the opening half to keep the Hubs within striking distance. A sloppy second quarter from both sides resulted in a 34-34 game at half. “The first half was a little ugly,” Thompson said. “There were a lot of points scored because neither team was really guarding that well. I wouldn’t say we shot the ball that well but we made some plays to stay in the game. Our offense was super stagnant in the second half. We couldn’t make reversals and we weren’t getting enough inside touches for easy baskets.” Burdin finished with 25 points on a team-leading

nine made shots for the Hubs, who will host Sandwich on Wednesday, Feb. 17 at 7 p.m. after facing Kaneland on the road this weekend. Juniors Adam Kemp and Zach Sanford

combined for 23 points, with Kemp totaling 12 and converting three 3-pointers while Sanford added 11. Junior Tanner Lager had eight points. “I think Garrett can

score 20-to-25 for us every night,” Thompson said. “We need to be crisper offensively and it seems that every team we’re playing right now is preventing us from getting ball reversals,

which shouldn’t be that big of a deal. We’re lazy on our passes and we have to be better there... Our ball rotations have to be quicker and Zach has to touch the ball inside.”

Schwanert carries Lady Hubs against LaSalle-Peru

Junior bowler rolls 204 high game in loss to Cavaliers

ROCHELLE — Junior bowler Alyssa Schwanert battled back from a tough second game to roll Rochelle’s high game and high individual series when the Lady Hub varsity team hosted LaSalle-Peru at T-Byrd Lanes for an Interstate 8 Conference match Wednesday evening. Schwanert led all bowlers in the first game, shooting 204 after opening the game with four strikes over her first five frames. Although she was unable to break triple digits in her second game, Schwanert recovered nicely with 176 in her third game to shoot a 473 series. Senior Kiya Porter added a 424 series for the Lady Hubs, who fell 2,492-2,138 to move to 0-2 overall. “Alyssa was really locked in during the first game,” head coach Eric Widick said. “I thought she concentrated too much on keeping her arm in and she was slowing her ball down about 2 miles per hour during the

second game, so when the ball went down the lane, it went through the nose and left splits. We talked about getting her speed back up and she bounced back.” LaSalle-Peru edged Rochelle 824-794 in the first game despite Schwanert’s 204 and 152 from Lady Hub freshman Faith Adams. The Cavaliers claimed the second game 759-626, with Porter firing a series-best 170 for Rochelle. Schwanert’s 176 was Rochelle’s high score in the third game, which LaSalle-Peru won 909-718 behind 210 from Olivia Weber, who rolled a match-best 600 series for the Cavaliers. The Lady Hubs are at Ottawa on Tuesday, Feb. 16 at 4 p.m. “I thought we weren’t as focused today as we were Monday,” Widick said. “Our series scores were a little lower... We need to work on our spares. We were well under 50 percent on spares, which we worked on during practice Tuesday. The girls are definitely trying their best.”

Hubs bounce back with road win at Sycamore

Burdin scores team-high 22 points in 67-49 victory over Spartans

SYCAMORE — Losing three times against the Sycamore Spartans during the 2019-20 season was more than enough to motivate Hub senior Garrett Burdin when the Rochelle varsity basketball team faced the black and gold in its conference opener Tuesday evening.

Burdin led all scorers with 22 points on 9-of-18 shooting and the Hubs used their defensive length to shut down Sycamore forward Xavier Gagnepain, who finished with only eight points. Rochelle totaled nine steals and eight deflections Tuesday, limiting Sycamore to only 17 second-half points as the Hubs defeated the Spartans 67-49 to move to 1-1 on the season.

“Losing our first game really motivated us,” Burdin said. “We came back to practice and worked on things we struggled with on Friday and it really showed Tuesday night. It was big for us to get a conference win because our No. 1 goal is to win a conference title.”

Junior Noah Brown added 14 points on 3-of-7 shooting from 3-point range off the bench for the Hubs, who outscored Sycamore 23-13 in the first quarter. The Spartans battled back in the second quarter, rallying behind Tyler York and Sam Stoner, who combined for 21 points in the game. Leading 38-32, Rochelle

put Sycamore away with a 19-9 third-quarter performance.

“My teammates spaced the floor really well and we were rebounding well on both ends,” Burdin said. “Our depth and everybody stepping up and playing their roles will be the biggest key for us to win the conference championship this season. We have a lot of length on our team, so guarding with our length and rebounding will be huge for us. We may not be the biggest team, but we can use our length to

space the floor and grab rebounds.”

Junior Zach Sanford finished with 10 points and six rebounds for the Hubs, who will host LaSalle-Peru on Friday at 7 p.m. Burdin led all players with four steals in the win, while junior Ryan Simmons totaled a team-high five assists along with five points and three rebounds. Senior Spencer Warborg scored eight points on 3-of-5 shooting with three assists Tuesday.

“We learned a lot from losing against them last

season,” Burdin said. “Our seniors and juniors have wanted to beat Sycamore for a long time. It felt like when we beat Sterling last season because it felt like we had a weight lifted off our shoulders. We can build on this win.”
