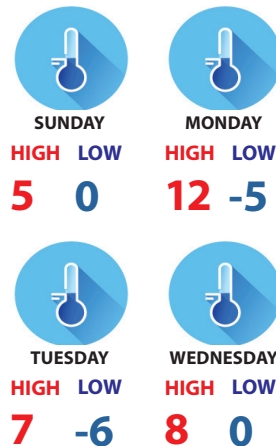

You do have the ability to leave a message with any of these organizations and your call will be returned.

When you register, please know this is not an immediate appointment but the list will be used to schedule vaccination appointments based on the supply of vaccine received. Please note that

it is only necessary to call one of the organizations to be added to the list. Multiple registrations will not move a person's name up on the list and actually creates additional work. Be assured, you will receive a call back to schedule your appointment. When you receive your call, appointments will be scheduled for both your first and second doses of the vaccine.

The online pre-registration is also available by logging into health.oglecounty.org. Also note that when typing the address into your browser, do not use "www" as you will receive an error; simply type in the web address as listed to complete the pre-registration process. Select your language of choice to complete the registration.

If you need transportation to your scheduled COVID-19 vaccination appointment, both the Hub Senior Center and Rock River Center can help with scheduling a ride.

In addition, the Lee-Ogle Transportation Systems is available by calling 815-288-2117.

At this time, the demand is higher than the supply of vaccine so we continue to ask for patience as appointments are scheduled in the upcoming weeks and months.

CHICAGO — While Illinois and the world adjusted to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, Exelon Generation's Illinois nuclear fleet produced a record-breaking amount of reliable, carbon-free electricity to ensure hospitals, nursing homes, businesses and vital infrastructure had the power needed to help Americans combat the virus.

"The reliable generation of electricity is important in any year, but in 2020 that job became even more vital as every facet of our lives was challenged by the pandemic," said Dave Rhoades, Chief Nuclear Officer of Exelon Generation. "Our frontline, essential workers battled weather extremes of heat and cold and multiple storms in 2020, all while adjusting to new procedures and safety measures brought on by COVID-19. Our mission is to safely deliver carbon-free, reliable

energy for customers and we're grateful to our employees for accomplishing that goal."

Nuclear produces clean energy 24/7 and is the most reliable form of power generation.

In Illinois last year, Exelon Generation's Byron and Dresden stations each set world records for shortest refueling outage duration for pressurized water reactors and boiling water reactors, the respective reactor type of each facility. The Braidwood, Clinton, LaSalle and Quad Cities stations also set annual records for the amount of electricity produced at each station. The company's six Illinois nuclear plants generate more than half of the state's electricity and nearly 90 percent of its carbon-free energy.

Exelon Generation's nuclear plants, which are located in Illinois, Maryland, New York and Pennsylvania, produced nearly 150

million megawatt-hours of zero-emissions energy in 2020, the equivalent of taking 32 million cars off the road. The units' capacity factor, a metric used to measure the percentage of time units operate, was an incredible 95.4 percent, significantly higher than other energy sources. Planned refueling and maintenance outages account for much of the offline time.

This is the third consecutive year Exelon's planned refueling outages averaged 22 days or fewer—solidifying its world-class expertise at performing important upgrades and maintenance projects while keeping the time the reactors are offline to a minimum. Electricians, pipe fitters, welders, carpenters, laborers and other workers from union halls play a critical role in completing the tasks, inspections and other maintenance activities during outages to get the reactors back online producing

electricity.

"Exelon provides thousands of jobs for highly-skilled union workers across Northern Illinois," said Terry McGoldrick, President of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 15. "The highly skilled, hard work of these employees ensures Illinois' nuclear power plants operate safely and provide the region with reliable, carbon-free power."

Despite the ongoing safe and reliable performance, Exelon Generation has announced the planned retirement of both its Byron and Dresden plants in Northern Illinois due to flawed market policies that fail to compensate nuclear for the carbon-free characteristic of the energy produced by the stations. Byron and Dresden, which are scheduled to be shut down this fall, together employ 1,500 employees and produce 30 percent of Illinois' carbon-free power.

In other news, Republican lawmakers are voicing their concerns over a controversial new rule pending before the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules (JCAR) that will have a lasting impact on Illinois teachers and students.

Senate Republicans are also reviewing the input and notes provided by local law enforcement in recent Zoom meetings about House Bill 3653, the dangerous criminal justice reform proposal awaiting action by the Governor.

Controversial teaching rule

pending before JCAR

Republican lawmakers are raising concerns about a new rule pending before JCAR that would create additional, unnecessary demands on teachers, would step away from knowledge-based learning, and would promote progressive political viewpoints in the classroom.

In December 2020, the Illinois State Board of Education approved a new rule for Illinois teachers called the "Culturally Responsive Teaching and Leading Standards" (CRTL). This new rule creates a burdensome, confusing, and vague set of progressive requirements and standards that teachers will use to guide their teaching narrative.

Main concerns contained within the new proposal include:

The standards throughout the rule are extremely vague, overlooking substantive knowledge and performance indicators.

While being perpetuated as standards to promote inclusivity, the new rule could actually threaten alternative viewpoints and silence the voices of many students and educators.

This new rule requires teachers to take on a new role: activist nurturer. Unfortunately, there is no clear definition as to what that role will entail.

This rule clearly seems designed to shift classrooms away from knowledge-based learning and move them toward promoting left-leaning political viewpoints.

The standards are redundant in many ways, repealing and replacing existing rules that already require that teachers create an inclusive environment.

While Republican lawmakers support a positive learning environment where students can develop the ability to understand and interpret events and issues for themselves, and are respected for their differences, the CRTL standards are ambiguous and create demands on teachers that opponents say are not conducive to a healthy learning environment.

Sen. Stewart is encouraging constituents to voice their thoughts on the proposal by reaching out to members of JCAR or by signing his petition in opposition to the new standards. CREMATED REMAINS

As cremation gains in popularity, some odd dilemmas crop up. Some years ago, for instance, funeral directors in Florida realized they had a delicate problem on their hands. Their storage rooms were filling up with containers of unclaimed cremated remains, some of which had been there more than half a century.

In some cases the deceased had no immediate survivors and had left no directions beyond a request for cremation. Sometimes the widows or widowers had planned to claim the remains within a few weeks, but died themselves before doing so.

Then, too, there were plenty of instances in which survivors



apparently didn't understand that while cremation satisfies the law's demand for the "final disposition" of a body, the ashes that emerge from the fire are the tangible remains of a human life and call for something more dignified than being dumped into the trash bin.

Develop your vision beyond what you can see

BEING a Christian and following God is a great adventure. It's also challenging because, to people who don't believe in Christ, we seem a bit odd in our way of thinking and doing things, like we're upside down compared to how the world generally operates. But the truth is, we're part of "the upside-down kingdom that is right-side up."

During His ministry on Earth, Jesus' message was, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near" (Matthew 4:17 NIV). His disciples believed Jesus had come to set up an earthly kingdom and rule the world, but that isn't what He was talking about at all.

The disciples didn't get it. They were thinking in physical terms, not spiritual ones.

As believers in Jesus who are born again, we are new creations in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17); we belong to God and are part of His kingdom (Colossians 1:12-14). The kingdom of God is unseen to the natural eye, and it is eternal.

The apostle Paul talked about seeing the unseen. In 2 Corinthians 4:16-18, he said, "Therefore we do not lose heart.

Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal" (NIV).

Paul had been beaten, shipwrecked, imprisoned, and gone hungry many times, yet he considered these experiences to be "light and momentary troubles." He believed this because the kingdom of God—what is eternal—was more real to him than this earthly realm—what is temporary.

This is hard for us because we are so accustomed to only believing what we can see with our natural eyes, and if we don't see God doing something, we assume He isn't doing anything. But instead of just looking at the world around us and our problems, we can learn to think about and see with spiritual eyes what God is in the process of doing in the midst of it all.

I've discovered that when I'm feeling discouraged because I've been praying

for something a long time and I'm weary of waiting for breakthrough, instead of getting down in the dumps, I can stir up my faith and say, "God is working!"

If you want to have a steady flow of joy in your life and "the peace of God, which transcends all understanding" (Philippians 4:7 NIV), learn how to believe what you can't see more than what you can see.

In Ephesians 1:18, Paul prayed "that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you" (NIV). The eyes of your heart can see the unseen realm of the spirit and give you hope—a confident expectation of God's goodness in your life—in every situation.

With this kind of hope, when hard times come, we can look beyond what we see in the world around us and realize that there are good things going on. God has done, and He's doing, so many things in our lives!

He loves us and has good plans for us to give us hope and a future. (Jeremiah 29:11)

He's always with us and will never

leave us or forsake us. (Deuteronomy 31:6; Hebrews 13:5)

Jesus paid the price to heal and restore every kind of brokenness in our lives. (Isaiah 53 and 61)

And He's preparing a place for us so we can be with Him throughout eternity! (John 14:2-3)

THIS is the truth we need to live by.

I wonder what God is up to in your life. I know it's easy to get discouraged and fearful when hard times come and it seems things will never change. But if you're a believer in Christ and you're praying according to the truth in God's Word, then you can be assured He is working. So don't stop believing because you're not getting an answer as quickly as you'd like.

Keep believing no matter how long it takes. And remember that just because you haven't seen the final outcome yet, it doesn't mean God isn't doing something. Make a determined decision to trust Him and believe what He says no matter what you think or feel or how things look. And pray for God to enlighten the eyes of your heart so you "know the hope to which he has called you" in His kingdom.

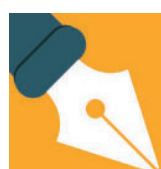
- Built the world's most prosperous economy prior to the China Virus

time I let it grow was probably 1990, in college at Northern Arizona University. I am not sure I got a haircut that year at all.

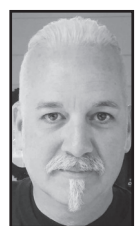
By 2000, I had short, spiky hair and I kept it like that for a long time – probably too long.

RTHS Varsity Boys Basketball

One basket short

Stillman Valley edges Rochelle 71-69 in competitive season opener

STILLMAN VALLEY — There may have been only 30 spectators in attendance, but Friday evening’s varsity basketball game between the Rochelle Hubs and the Stillman Valley Cardinals was about as competitive, energetic and evenly-matched as a season-opening contest could be.

For roughly two hours Friday evening, COVID-19 was cast aside and the focus was on the basketball court, with Rochelle and Stillman Valley battling in the first game for both teams in nearly 12 months. The back-and-forth affair saw neither team take a lead larger than 10 points, but the Cardinals managed to hold the Hubs off in the end, winning 71-69 behind seniors Chad Gerig and Micah Johnson, who combined for 55 points with Gerig leading all players with 31.

“It was nice to see the kids play again,” head coach Tim Thompson said. “We were in the game with a chance to win the whole time... Stillman Valley

runs such great ball-screen offense and they’re really good at getting those players moving to their strengths. Johnson was excellent going to his left and Gerig was really strong and used his athleticism to finish well at the rim.”

Stillman Valley opened with a strong surge, taking a 19-9 lead in the first quarter with Johnson and Gerig teaming up for 15 of those points. Junior Adam Kemp used the 3-point shot to keep Rochelle within range, sinking two of his team-leading three triples in the opening quarter to help the Hubs bring the Cardinals within four points entering the second quarter.

Despite a solid second-quarter performance from junior Ryan Simmons, who made three close-range baskets for six of his eight points, Stillman Valley answered on nearly every possession, utilizing fast transition offense and taking advantage of slow defensive rotations from the Hubs. The Cardinals led 35-33 at halftime, with Gerig and Johnson scoring 25 of those points.

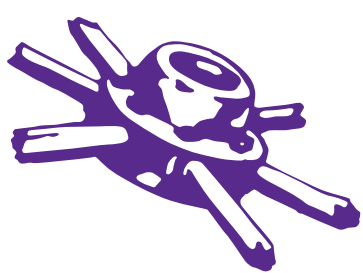

ROCHELLE — With the cold weather limiting space to operate and less than a month to prepare for the upcoming spring season, Rochelle Township High School's Hub soccer team is getting creative with its out-of-season contact days and beginning conditioning workouts indoors.

It's definitely going to be a challenging season in terms of the conditions we'll be playing under, but we'll make the best of it. We have a good, positive group of guys who work hard."

"It wasn't that they beat us behind the arc, they beat us at the rim," Thompson said. "They scored so many layups and we weren't stepping up and taking charges. We weren't in good weak-side positions and I thought that was because we struggled a bit offensively. Half-court defense was our bugaboo tonight. We could guard the ball screen on one side, but once they got a reversal or two, our defense broke down. We have to stay disciplined in those sets."

Junior Tanner Lager took his turn leading the Hub offense in the third quarter, scoring six of his 14 points on two layups and a pair of free throws. Five Rochelle players made shots in the third quarter, allowing the Hubs to slice Stillman Valley's lead down to 55-54 entering the fourth. Two of those shots were from senior Garrett Burdin, one of three Hubs to score 14 in the loss.

"We need to run our offense through the post," Thompson said. "I felt

Garrett put a little too much pressure on himself to initiate the offense, but that's natural with a senior captain. Everybody's learning their roles and there isn't a tremendous amount of continuity yet. With only four weeks to find that continuity, we're going to be learning on the run."

Johnson, who led all players with 12 field goals Friday evening, made three in the final quarter to push Stillman Valley ahead by as many as five points. Junior forward Zach Sanford did his best to help the Hubs stay in the game, taking the ball into the post for six of his 14 points in the fourth quarter. An offensive rebound and put-back layup from Burdin made it a one-possession game with 7.1 seconds to spare, but the Cardinals successfully inbounded and ran the clock.

Kemp finished with nine points for the Hubs, while senior Spencer Warborg totaled eight points. Rochelle's next game will be played at Sycamore on Tuesday, Feb. 9 at 7 p.m.

Coaches, student-athletes read children's books by black authors and illustrators

Frazier. "What a great opportunity to highlight books written by Black authors for children in our community. Although we couldn't read to the kids in person this year, I had a lot of fun recording the book as a guest reader, and I know our coaches and student-athletes felt the same."

Hammock adds 12 players to 2021 recruiting class

Walk-ons added to NIU football program Wednesday

DEKALB—Northern Illinois University head football coach Thomas Hammock continues to bolster the Huskies' 2021 roster, adding 12 walk-ons to the program on Wednesday.

"We're really excited about adding this group of talented student athletes to our incoming class," Hammock said. "The walk-on tradition here at NIU has been strong for as long as I can remember. When I was playing, we had some great walk-ons like Travis Moore, now our defensive ends coach, Larry Williams, Brian Atkinson and

Randy Drew to name a few who became all-conference players and were nationally recognized. As an assistant coach here, I helped recruit Chad Spann who would become MAC Player of the Year.

"Since becoming head coach, we've got a large core of this team who have earned their scholarships, getting it done on the practice field, on game day, and in the classroom. I have great respect and admiration for guys that do it the Hard Way. This group we're signing today fits that mold, and we're excited to see what they

can do."

The newest Huskies, representing four different states, join a 2021 signing class of 22 players, announced on Dec. 16, 2020, and graduate transfers Rocky Lombardi and Clint Ratkovich who came to NIU at the start of the semester. The February group consists of six defensive players, four on offense and two special teams players.

Among the additions are DeKalb wide receiver Tyler Brueckner, who played at Aurora Christian alongside quarterback Ethan Hampton, a Decem-

ber signee who enrolled at NIU for the spring semester. The Huskies also added Macomb, Michigan wide receiver Alex Crawford, the younger brother of former Huskie tight end Daniel Crawford, who finished his NIU career in 2020 with a pair of degrees and 65 career catches over the past six seasons.

The list includes seven Illinois products, two each from Michigan and Indiana and one from Missouri. (See the complete list — attached.)

NIU football has traditionally had a strong walk-on program with

players like Spann, the 2010 Vern Smith Award winner, eight-year NFL veteran Rashaan Melvin and current Huskie Nick Rattin, who started all six games for NIU at middle linebacker last year.

Multiple walk-ons from Hammock's 2020 signing class — including freshman All-American kick returner Trayvon Rudolph and defensive end Devonte O'Malley — have been awarded scholarships.

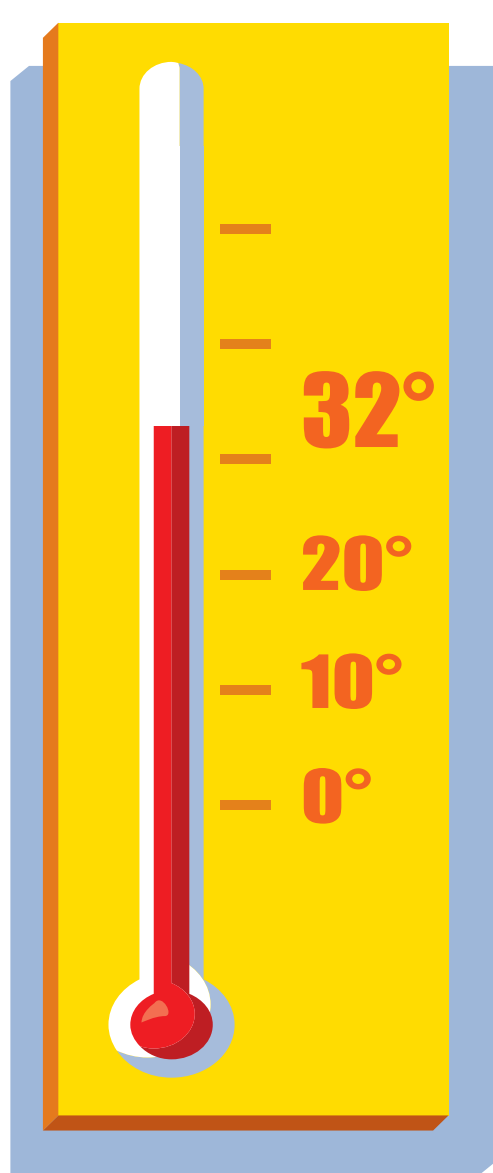
"We are really excited about the walk-on program we have going here, and I really believe we knocked this class out of the park,"
