Students returning to in-person learning

ROCHELLE — Rochelle School Districts have received confirmation from the Ogle County Health Department that all Rochelle schools are able to return to the original hybrid learning model and in-person learning on Tuesday, Jan. 19.

Below are details from a letter written by Superintendent Jason Harper.

Friday, Jan. 15 will be a Remote Planning Day for pre-kindergarten through eighth-grade teachers with no instruction for pre-kindergarten through eighth-grade students. Remember that all Rochelle schools will not have school on Monday, Jan. 18 for Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

We are excited to welcome your students back to school.

Here are some general reminders about what school will look like when we return on Tuesday, Jan. 19:

Your child(ren) will return to in-person learning only if that is the choice you made in October/November for the second trimester (Grades PreK-8) or second semester (Grades 9-12). We will follow all the same start and end times for

each school. Bus times and meal offerings will all be the same.

All remote learners will transition back to their schedules before the adaptive pause. In the days to come, teachers and building principals will provide more information about returning to in-person learning.

Riots at US Capitol bring State Capitol security concerns into focus

Governor calls for heightened security as lawmakers return to Springfield

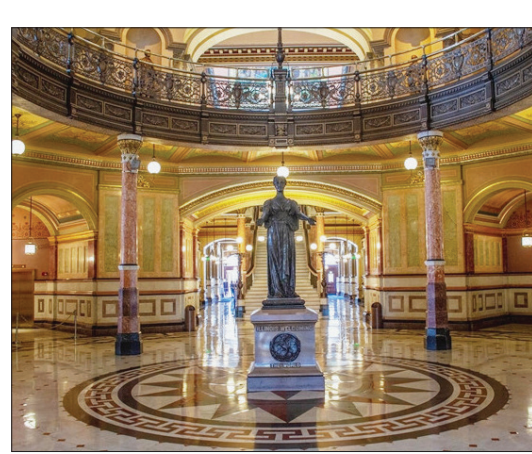
SPRINGFIELD — Just two days after hundreds of rioters broke through police barricades and vandalized the halls of Congress, Illinois lawmakers will return to the seat of government for a lame duck session.

The security presence at the Capitol, where the state Senate will convene, and the Bank of Springfield Center, where the House of Representatives will meet, has come under renewed focus.

The Illinois State Police has increased security around the state Capitol and the Bank of Springfield Center, at Gov. JB Pritzker's request, and will be coordinating efforts with the Secretary of State police and the Springfield Police Department, an ISP spokesperson wrote in an emailed statement Thursday.

"The ISP will have all resources at its disposal to assure the safety of the participants and protect the integrity of the session. To ensure security, we cannot discuss protocols or manpower associated with this effort," the ISP spokesperson wrote.

In a statement Wednesday evening calling for President Donald Trump's impeachment, Pritzker said he asked for the Illinois State Police and other law

enforcement Wednesday to "redeploy to heighten their presence at government buildings and the Capitol in Springfield."

Pritzker's spokesperson did not respond to a question Thursday about whether the governor plans to deploy the Illinois National Guard at the Statehouse or other government offices for the legislative session.

The governor's statement Wednesday came as a much smaller group of demonstrators gathered outside the Illinois Capitol to protest the election certification of President-elect Joe Biden.

There were no arrests or incidents re-

ported at the Illinois protest, according to Henry Haupt, a spokesperson for the Illinois Secretary of State, who estimated it was attended by 40 to 50 people.

The Secretary of State Capitol Police force is assigned to the nine buildings comprising the State Capitol Complex. Security at the Bank of Springfield Center falls under the purview of the Illinois State Police, said Haupt.

Steve Brown, spokesperson for House Speaker Michael Madigan, declined to comment on security procedures at the Bank of Springfield or discussions among House leadership for additional security.

"I think there is adequate security, as there was in May (during the last legislative session)," Brown said on Thursday. "If you remember, visualizing the scene, (security) was pretty comprehensive from what could be seen, and there were additional layers, not necessarily visible to the general public."

John Patterson, spokesperson for Senate President Don Harmon, said in an email that there are ongoing conversations with the Secretary of State's Office to address any questions or concerns and reassure every one of the building's security in advance of the Senate session.

Creston library construction set for summer

CRESTON — Creston trustees received an update from Creston-Dement Library Board President Doug Kroupa on the \$2.5 million construction project for a new library Tuesday evening.

Kroupa said construction on the new library, which will be located at the corner of Main Street and Cederholm Street, is scheduled to begin in either July or August 2021.

The need for a new library stems from an increased number of patrons on a monthly basis. Kroupa said the number of library users has grown from between 60-to-80 people per month to well over 700 people per month. Despite COVID-19 mitigations,

Kroupa said roughly 200 people per month on average are still using the current library, located at 107 S. Main St. in Creston.

The new library will be a 7,500-square-foot facility and it will include many new features including study rooms and a presentation area that could seat 100 people. The \$2.5 million project includes the construction of sidewalks around the building and a retention pond.

The library district received \$750,000 in grant funding from the state to help fund the project, which will require Creston trustees to annex 2 acres of land for the library into the village as well as rezoning the property. Kroupa said residents have continued donating money for the project.

The Creston village meeting concluded with the annual auditor's report as well as an update on bids for the Safe Routes to School project. Bids for the project will open on Jan. 15. Trustees also considered purchasing a new pickup truck the village can use to plow snow.

Keep in mind we will follow all the same COVID19 mitigation strategies and guidance mandates as we did before the adaptive pause along with any updated policies. Here are some reminders:

Everyone must wear a mask at all times while in school. We will continue to take temperatures prior to entrance.

Parents must keep all children at home if any household member shows any COVID19 symptoms, any household member has exposure to someone with

COVID19, any household member is waiting on a COVID19 test, any household member is directed to quarantine by the OCHD or other health department and/or any household member is COVID19 positive.

We will temporarily move students or entire classes to remote learning if they display symptoms or otherwise have COVID19-related concerns. We will continue to follow OCHD and IDPH guidance on these situations. Please continue to have plans in place in the event your child temporarily moves to remote learning.

Keep in mind that we need your help in limiting the exposure of COVID19 in our schools. We again ask parents and students to adhere to all the mitigation strategies to ensure our schools can stay open as long as possible.

We appreciate your support and look forward to students returning to our buildings. If you have any questions about the return to in-person learning, please contact me directly. If you have any questions about the logistics that will impact your specific student, please direct those questions to your building principal.

Haupt said he couldn't comment on staffing levels or security protocols at the Capitol Complex but said the Secretary of State Capitol Police are working with the Illinois State Police and other law enforcement entities to ensure the Complex and surrounding area remains safe.

"Although the Capitol building is closed due to

the pandemic, I think it's important to highlight that the entry points are nonetheless manned by the Capitol Police," he said.

Every entry point at the Capitol Complex is staffed with at least one armed Capitol Police officer, Haupt said.

"But the point the Capitol Police has made to me numerous times is, we're going to be vigilant even in quiet times

because you can't anticipate something. So you have to be vigilant and on alert," he said.

The Secretary of State Capitol Police was established by the Illinois General Assembly after a gunman fatally shot state Capitol security guard Bill Wozniak in September 2004.

When the shooting took place, the General Assembly was not in session.

Police investigate missing person

BYRON — On Wednesday, Jan. 6 at approximately 1:18 p.m. a white passenger car was reported to have been found in the 9000 block of Illinois Route 2 in rural Byron.

The vehicle was located by Ogle County deputies a short time later and it was determined the unoccupied vehicle belonged to Brandon Cuddy who was previously reported as a missing person to the Byron Police Department.

The area was searched by deputies, the Winnebago County bloodhound, Ogle County Sheriff's Office

drone and a boat in the Rock River from the Byron Fire Department. All attempts to locate Cuddy were unsuccessful.

On Thursday, Jan. 7, members of the Ogle County Sheriff's Office, Winnebago County Sheriff's K-9 and Byron Fire Department expanded the area of search; again efforts yielded no additional evidence.

Kishwaukee College announces Summer and Fall 2020 graduates

MALTA — Kishwaukee College is proud to announce the graduates for Summer and Fall 2020. Graduation Honors are divided into three categories based on final cumulative grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale: summa cum laude indicates a cumulative GPA between 3.75-4.0; magna cum laude indicates a cumulative GPA between 3.5-3.749; and cum laude indicates a cumulative GPA between 3.25-3.499. Students who fulfill requirements for a Certificate and have a final cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher are awarded a Certificate with Distinction.

The most important key to a healthy life

DO you know that God is interested in every area of your life? The truth is He cares about every single thing that concerns you, and He wants every bit of you to be whole and healthy.

First Thessalonians 5:23 (AMPC) says, "May the God of peace Himself sanctify you from profane things, make you pure and wholly consecrated to God; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved sound and complete [and found] blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah)." This verse shows us that we can be "wholly consecrated to God," and He wants our spirit, soul and body to "be preserved sound and complete."

Jesus came to heal you and make you whole. He died so your sins could be forgiven and you could be made whole in your spirit, soul and body (Isaiah 61:1-3; Luke 19:10; John 10:10).

God created us as tri-part beings: we are a spirit, we have a soul and we live in a body. One function of our spirit is the conscience; it's the part of us that receives revelation from God. The soul is made up

of our mind, will and emotions, and our body is the "house" we live in. It's easy to think that God is only interested in spiritual things, but all three parts of our being are important to Him.

We can be sound spiritually—born again and on our way to Heaven—but God wants more for us than that. Jesus didn't come so we could just make it through this life and get to Heaven. He wants us to enjoy the journey, too.

I remember years ago when I was going to church regularly and had received Christ as my Savior, but so much of my life was a mess! I really loved God, but I didn't love my life. I looked like I had it all together on the outside, but there was a lot of pain and dysfunction on the inside of me that people didn't know about.

It was an amazing revelation when I saw in God's Word that He cares about how we think, talk, our finances, our relationships, and that He has a plan and purpose for every single one of us. God wants our lives to be good! It took time and a determined decision on my part to study the Word and believe God's promises were for me, but

I'm no longer a miserable Christian and can honestly say today that I am much healthier and enjoy the life God has given me.

The best way to begin pursuing better health is by pursuing a deeper relationship with Jesus, because if your spirit is not healthy and right with God, then the other areas of your life can't become completely whole either.

Psalms 63:5 (AMPC) says, "My whole being shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips." I love that this says "my whole being shall be satisfied."

And Psalm 63:8 gives us the key to complete satisfaction: "My whole being follows hard after You and clings closely to You; Your right hand upholds me." So if we want to be fully satisfied, we have to follow hard after Jesus.

In any area of life, you'll get out of it what you put into it. It's foolish to think you can have a close walk with God if you don't spend time with Him on a regular basis, or the only time you talk to Him is when you're in trouble. Being a victorious

Christian is not just a Sunday morning event. And God wants to have a personal, intimate, ongoing relationship with you.

Romans 12:1 says to "make a decisive dedication of your bodies [presenting all your members and faculties] as a living sacrifice, holy (devoted, consecrated) and well pleasing to God, which is your reasonable (rational, intelligent) service and spiritual worship." In other words, we need to dedicate our entire being to God...to be passionate for Him and see Him with ALL of our heart.

As you pursue greater health, I want to encourage you to start by dedicating (or rededicating) your entire life to Jesus. Spend time in prayer each day, study the Bible and discover for yourself what it means to have an intimate relationship with Jesus and be full of the life of God.

Remember that your walk with Christ is a lifelong journey, and learning to be completely dedicated to Him is a process. As you make progress little by little each day, your life will get more exciting because following the plan God has for you is the way to become satisfied in your whole being — spirit, soul and body.

Feels COVID funding for big businesses unfair

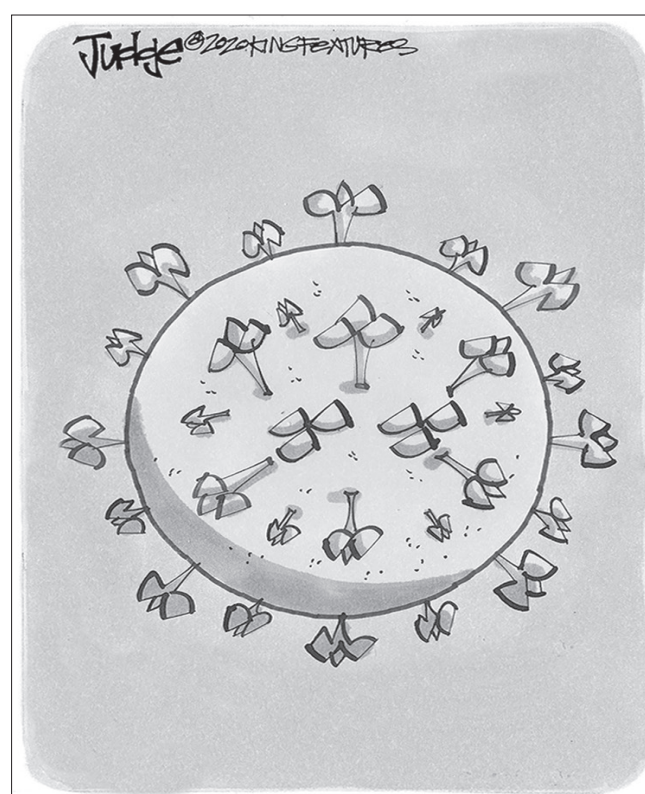
Dear Editor,

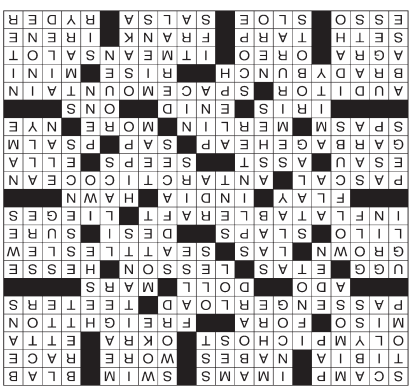

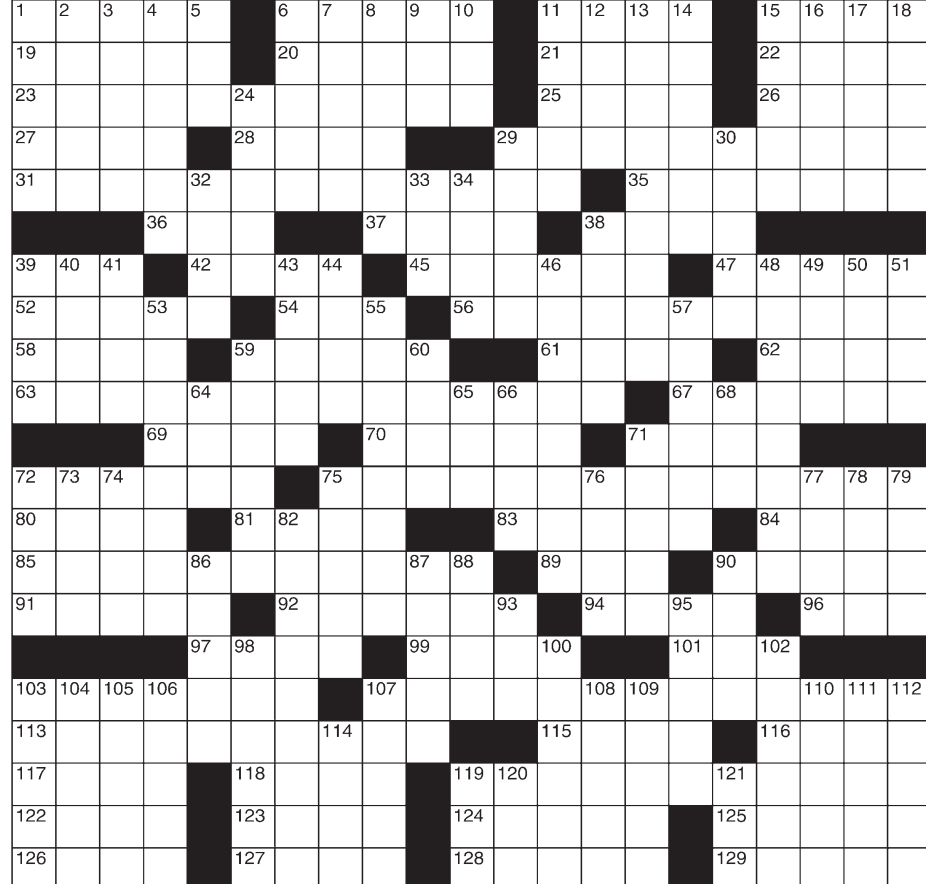

IDES responds to GOP criticisms

Department adding staff, balancing need for prompt payment, checks on fraud

SPRINGFIELD — House Republicans continued to criticize the Pritzker administration Wednesday as the Illinois Department of Employment Support works through ongoing staffing and fraud issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Since handling a historic number of unemployment assistance claims at the outset of the pandemic in March, IDES has added staff, changed processes and implemented additional measures to prevent fraudulent claims.

On Wednesday, some House Republicans continued calls for additional measures to be implemented, such as moving staff from other state departments to assist with the overload of unemployment assistance claims, implementing more anti-fraud measures and holding public hearings to discuss issues at the department.

"It is unacceptable how the governor and the department have responded to this crisis that they themselves have caused," Rep. Mike Marron, R-Fithian, said Wednesday. "It is my hope that someone at the administration cares enough to listen to our ideas and to start a di-

ologue."

IDES officials pushed back on criticisms offered by the Republicans Wednesday, stating that it is not possible to move employees from other state agencies without substantial training, and that many of the anti-fraud measures being proposed by the Republicans are already in use by the department.

"We are working hard to respond to an economic crisis and stand up five new, complex federal programs while battling fraudsters who have used stolen identities to file for benefits nationwide," said IDES Acting Director Kristin Richards in a statement.

Richards said the department was already short-staffed as a result of years of budget cuts which left IDES ill-equipped to handle the unprecedented number of claims last spring. The current employee headcount is roughly half of what it was 10 years ago, she said.

Since the pandemic began, the department has contracted over 1,000 employees to assist in handling unemployment claims, and has been approved for an increase in staffing and resources for the current fiscal year, which is fiscal year 2021. It continues to hire more employees, she said.

It has also implemented a callback only

system which allows an applicant with a question to be placed in a queue to be called back, rather than having to experience extensive waits.

"IDES was given an increased headcount for FY21, but adding full-time employees, as all state hiring does, takes time," Richards said. "This is especially true for IDES, whose employees possess a unique and complicated skillset to work on issues and deliver services to claimants."

Richards said a proposal to move employees from other state agencies would be ineffective in fixing delays.

"The legislators' call for moving state employees from one hollowed out agency to another ignores the nuance of what is involved in these jobs and positions and would create productivity deficits in the agencies from which state employees would be pulled," Richards said.

Richards said the department has worked to stabilize its operations in order to meet the needs of unemployment support applicants in a timely manner.

"The idea that IDES has disproportionate trouble processing new claims or paying out claims is misleading," Richards said. "A claimant who provides all the necessary data and

submits their claim will be processed in a timely and efficient manner and will receive benefits if they are deemed eligible and continue to certify."

She said the state has also begun paying out Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation, which adds an extra \$300 per month to claims from certain individuals collecting unemployment assistance.

But the federal rush to expand unemployment assistance amid the pandemic and associated government shutdowns has led to widespread exploitation of unemployment systems across the nation, including in Illinois. In particular, a federal Pandemic Unemployment Assistance program which allows certain independent contractors to collect benefits has been ripe for fraud.

Richards and the administration have said the fraud is due to a nationwide scheme enabled by data breaches of private companies that have made individuals' information, such as social security numbers, available to scammers. It is not the result of a breach to state unemployment systems.

Rep. Mike Murphy, R-Springfield, called for the department to implement additional anti-fraud measures, such as a flagging system for out-of-state applicants and multiple failed claims, measures which IDES said it already has in place.

"The above-mentioned anti-fraud measures, and many others that are already in place, have the effect of slowing down the process of distributing (unemployment insurance) benefits — and that is an unavoidable and necessary thing," Richards said. "But it demonstrates the cruel irony that IDES is being simultaneously besieged by historic unemployment claims and besieged by a globally orchestrated fraud scheme, and that solutions to these problems work against each other. Legislators are telling us to hurry up and make payments but slow down and put more barriers in place to stop fraud."

Richards said that IDES has been in routine communication with legislators and has done its best to provide timely answers to questions from lawmakers and constituents. But she said additional training and information will be necessary moving forward, citing a "misunderstanding some legislators have of IDES and unemployment insurance."

The lawmakers, however, continue to call for public hearings to discuss the department's pandemic response, rather than being reduced to input only through personal conversations with the administration.

"IDES will work with these legislators to create the first cohort of targeted training for elected state officials," Richards said.

Meyers would've had the chance to earn a larger varsity role with the Hubs this past spring, but he and many student-athletes across the state lost their seasons to COVID-19 cancellations. Meyers said he has been staying prepared for the upcoming season through playing summer baseball, lifting weights, practicing in-field drills and working on hitting in the batting cages.

think team unity is going to play a huge role in our success as a team and in our personal growth.”



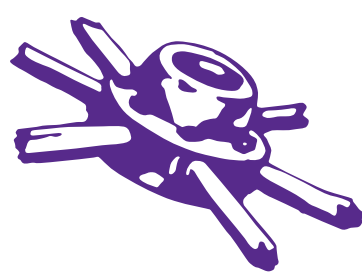

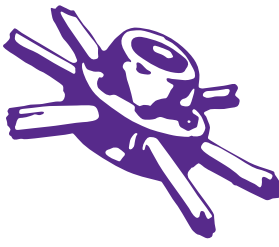

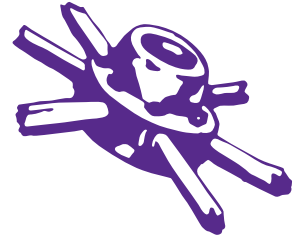

Rudolph earns Freshman All-American honor

DEKALB—Northern Illinois University football's Trayvon Rudolph was recognized for his outstanding first season of collegiate football as the Huskie freshman was named to The Athletic's 2020 College Football Freshman All-America Team.

A native of Crete, Rudolph earned first team honors as a kick returner. Rudolph led the Mid-American Conference and was second in the nation in combined kick returns with a nation-leading 717 yards on 30 kickoff returns, while adding eight punt return yards. His 23.9-yard kickoff return average ranked 30th in the nation and sixth in the league and is the sixth most

by a Huskie in a single season.

The former walk-on, who earned a scholarship by October, is the first Huskie named to a freshman all-America team since left tackle Max Scharping was named to the Football Writers Association of America's Freshman All-America Team in 2015. In addition to his prowess as a returner, Rudolph is one of NIU's top receivers ranking second on the team in receiving (232) and yards per game (38.7).

Rudolph, a second-team All-MAC selection, is one of two conference players named to the team. He is joined by Central Michigan kicker Marshall Meeder who was a second-team selection.

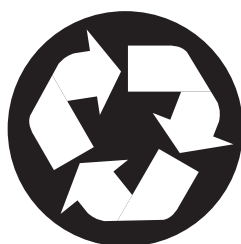

Huskies named to Phil Steele All-MAC Team

Richie receives First-Team recognition; 11 honorees eligible for 2021 season

DEKALB — Twelve members of the 2020 Northern Illinois University football team, led by first-team selection Tyrice Richie, have been named All-Mid-American Conference by Phil Steele's Magazine. Richie, who was also named first team All-MAC by league coaches following a break-out 2020 season, is among the 11 Huskies on the list who will return for NIU next fall.



game. He also was named to The Athletic's Freshman All-America team. Lafayette tallied 36 stops, including a sack, and an interception to earn his place on the All-MAC squad while Rattin made 33 stops from his starting middle linebacker spot. Patton and Cox helped pave the way for Huskie offense that saw Harrison Waylee reach the 100-

yard mark in each of the final two games of 2020 and Richie's four 100-yard receiving contests. A two-year starter, Richardson made seven-of-nine field goals and was perfect on PATs to lead NIU with 35 points on the season and is 21-of-27 on field goals in his NIU career. Ference averaged 42.2 yards on 31 punts and has already broken every NIU career and single season punting record in his four seasons.

Five Huskie student-athletes — senior tight end Daniel Crawford (Macomb, Michigan/Dakota HS), senior defensive tackle Weston Kramer (Naperville/Marmion Academy), senior linebacker Kyle Pugh (Chicago Heights/Bloom Township HS), sophomore cornerback Jordan Gandy (DeKalb/DeKalb HS) and kick returner Trayvon Rudolph (Crete/Crete-Monee HS) — garnered second-team accolades from Phil Steele.

Senior center Brayden Patton (Ellettsville, Indiana/Edgewood HS), freshman safety Devin Lafayette (Brunswick, Georgia/Brunswick HS) and sophomore kicker John Richardson (Orland Park/Brother Rice HS) were named third team All-MAC, while sophomore linebacker Nick Rattin (Palatine/Fremd HS), senior punter Matt Ference (St. Louis, Missouri/Lafayette HS) and sophomore offensive tackle Marques Cox (Peoria/Peoria HS) earned fourth team recognition from the magazine.

In six games, Richie topped his totals from a year ago, amassing 597 yards, which ranked fourth in the MAC, on 53 receptions. His 8.8 receptions per game led the conference and ranked third in the country. The senior from Chicago recorded four 100-yard receiving games in 2020, becoming just the eighth player in Huskie history to have four or more 100-yard games in a season and the first since Kenny Golladay in 2016.

Second on the team in receptions with 21 for 187 yards and a touchdown, Crawford averaged 30.5 yards per game receiving this year. Kramer tallied 17 tackles, including three for loss, in six starts at defensive tackle for the Huskies. A second-team All-MAC selection in 2018 before missing nearly all of the 2019 season, Pugh was solid in five games totaling 36 tackles, three-and-a-half tackles for loss and one-and-a-half sacks.

Gandy, who transferred to NIU via South Dakota State, led NIU with 41 tackles, seven pass break ups and an interception.

Rudolph finished the year with 717 kickoff return yards and eight punt return yards and ranked second in the nation in combined kick return yards (725) while ranking ninth in the country in all-purpose yards per

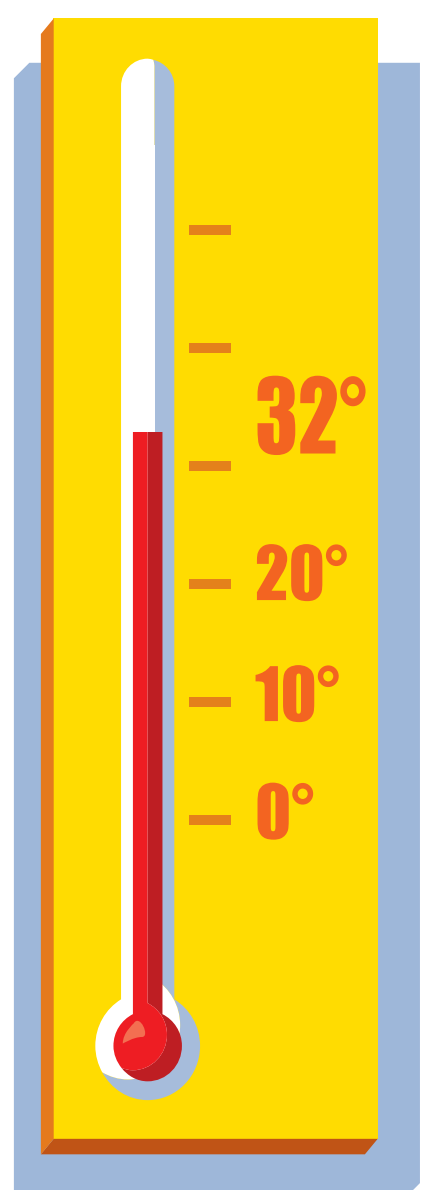
