Fire displaces several residents

ROCHELLE — A Christmas day fire in Rochelle left nearly 10 people displaced by the time firefighters cleared the scene.

No one suffered any injuries in the fire located at 128 North Main Street — a building known as the De Los and Ogle Hotel and Apartments.

Flames were noticed at approximately 2 p.m. when firefighters were called to the scene. Upon arrival, heavy smoke was evident from the second floor and attic area on the south side of the building.

The fire was located between the walls and in the ceiling area. Crews worked to remove siding to extinguish the flames before the fire was able to spread to the attic area of the building.

The exact cause is yet to be determined; however, it could be electrical or an overheated heating system.

Two apartments located in the building suffered fire and water damage.



Departments responding to the scene included Rochelle, Steward, Flag Center, Hillcrest, Creston, DeKalb, Stillman Valley, Lynn-Scott-Rock, Malta and Ashton.

The Red Cross was called to assist residents displaced by the fire.

Thiravong places fourth in essay contest

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Township High School senior Megan Thiravong was recognized Wednesday for her Voice of Democracy Scholarship Essay which won fourth place in the District 6 VFW's annual contest.

Rochelle VFW 3878 Post Commander Bill Bumgarner presented Thiravong with two checks — one from the local VFW post and the other from the District post — along with a certificate recognizing her accomplishment in the contest.

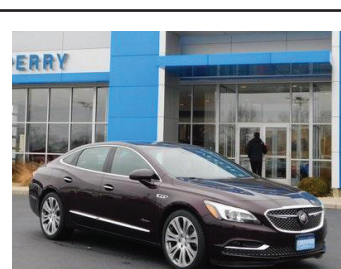

Truck goes into river

On Dec. 22 at 11:40 a.m., the Ogle County Sheriff's Police responded to a truck in the Rock River with one occupant. This was in the 10,900 block of North Illinois Route 2. The driver was helped from his truck and later taken to Swedish American Hospital for treatment. The driver was identified as Roger Durham, 65, of Rockford. The Byron Fire Department and Maggios assisted at the scene while

Winnebago County Sheriff's Police and Byron Police Assisted with traffic control. The investigation is pending.

On Dec. 20 at approximately 1:24 a.m., Ogle County Sheriff's deputies conducted a traffic stop in the 9500 block of E. Illinois Route 64. Upon further investigation, deputies arrested Christopher N. Rollin, 44, of Rochelle, for driving while license suspended. Rollins was released on an Individual

Bond and set a return court date. Rollin was also cited for speeding in excess of 35 m.p.h. over the speed limit.

On Dec. 22 at 8:20 p.m., deputies stopped a 2006 Jeep on Interstate 39 at milemarker 109 northbound for speeding. After a short investigation, deputies arrested Donald Johnson, 24, of DeKalb, for driving while license suspended. Johnson was released on scene and will appear in court on Feb. 3.

Congress passes \$900 billion relief bill

Legislation extends unemployment benefits

WASHINGTON, D.C. — The U.S. Congress reached an agreement on a roughly \$900 billion coronavirus relief package that extends unemployment benefits, provides stimulus checks to Americans within a certain income bracket and funding to small businesses, but it fell short of providing direct funding to state and local governments.

The relief package approved by both chambers of Congress Monday evening comes as the federal assistance provided in the last aid package, the federal

Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security, or CARES Act passed in March, are set to expire Dec. 26.

The bill still needs to be signed into law by President Donald Trump.

The new coronavirus relief bill provides 11-week extensions to the Pandemic Unemployment Assistance program, which is available for gig workers, independent contractors and other self-employed individuals who don't normally qualify for traditional unemployment insurance, and to the Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation, which is available to individuals who have exhausted their

regular jobless benefits. Those programs will provide \$300 per week in supplemental unemployment benefits.

The \$900 billion package also will provide \$600 in direct stimulus payments to individuals making \$75,000 or less annually, and families making \$150,000 or less.

The Paycheck Protection Program, which provides forgivable loans to small businesses impacted by the pandemic, will receive about \$284 billion under the new relief package.

After the initial aid package passed, Illinois received roughly \$3.5 billion in CARES Act money to pay for expenses related to its COVID-19 response, and it has a little over \$1.8 billion remaining.

Most of that funding, roughly \$557 million, was spent by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, for things like medical supplies and testing equipment.

U.S. Sen. Dick Durbin, D-IL, said the bill doesn't provide the \$160 billion funding for state and local governments that

he hoped it would, but suggested that funding could be included when President-elect Joe Biden takes office.

"It's going to be a priority for him, and we're ready for that fight," Durbin said during a Zoom news conference Tuesday. "The difficulty if we don't is that these units of government will have to lay off firefighters, policemen, health care workers, teachers. That's exactly the wrong thing at this moment

in history. We need to protect those jobs, give those people a chance to go back to work."

Although the state of Illinois currently has a roughly \$4 billion budget deficit, Durbin said he would advise state leaders not to count on the federal government for additional aid to fill budget holes.

"I wouldn't make any assumption that money is coming from Washington for the help of the state. They have to prepare

their budget on the possibility there'll be no assistance," Durbin said.

Durbin, who described the new COVID-19 relief package as having "strong bipartisan support," said it is meant as an emergency measure.

"This is supposedly written as an emergency piece of legislation for the first three months of next year, just so Joe Biden can get his feet on the ground, and get this administration moving," Durbin said.

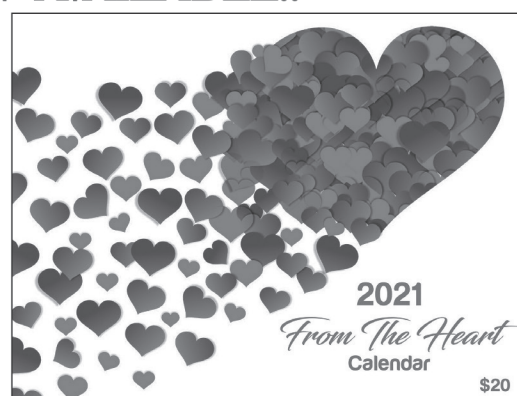

Discover how God sees you

IN today’s society, insecurity and self-rejection have reached an all-time high. More than ever before, so many people simply don’t like themselves.

Over the years, I have met countless people who believe God is angry with them because they haven’t “arrived” at the place of perfection. As a result, they live in a state of perpetual frustration—continually rejecting themselves and feeling bad every time they make a mistake.

But Jesus didn’t give His life for us to walk around feeling guilty and condemned. He wants us to feel good about ourselves and our relationship with Him. And it all starts with discovering our true identity in Christ.

For many years, I tried to please God with my works. It seemed as if I was living on a performance treadmill—always trying to do something to feel good about myself and feel like I was in right standing with Him. In the process, I became weary, worn-out, and unhappy. I would think, “Something is just not working. I was right. No matter how much we love God and choose to do what’s right, we will always be frustrated until we understand this life-changing truth:

“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God” (Ephesians 2:8 NIV).

There is nothing we can do to earn our salvation or right standing with God; we have been made right with Him

through our faith in Jesus Christ. A believer that is lacking this understanding is like a jumbo jet on the runway with no gasoline—he has all the equipment but is going nowhere!

In His mercy, God allowed me to see that there was absolutely nothing I could do to make Him love me any more or less than He already did. All He wanted was for me to believe in Jesus, “the one he has sent” (John 6:29 NIV) and receive the righteousness He has provided.

In order for us to experience true freedom and grow in our relationship with God, we must learn to accept ourselves right where we are and see ourselves the way God sees us. As we do, we will begin to understand that becoming like Christ is a process that takes time... and God will be faithful to finish the good work He has started in us (see Philippians 1:6).

This does not mean that we don’t sin anymore or that we can dismiss it like it’s no big deal. For example, when she was two years old, one of our granddaughters would throw fits when she didn’t get her way. She’d throw herself on the ground and scream uncontrollably. Now, even though I disliked her behavior, I

still loved her tremendously. I don’t stop loving my grandchildren or kick them out of the family because they do wrong things. I love them and work with them to develop the good character I know they need to succeed in life.

The same is true with God, our heavenly Father. He doesn’t love our wrong behavior, but He certainly loves us. Romans 5:8 says that He proved His love for us by sending His Son “while we were still sinners.” In other words, He didn’t wait until we were righteous to send Jesus—He sent Jesus because we would never be righteous without Him.

Isaiah 61:10 (NIV) says, “I delight greatly in the Lord; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of his righteousness...”

What does this mean for us? It means when we make mistakes, God literally has us covered with His robe of righteousness. So when the enemy comes against us with thoughts of guilt or condemnation, we can stand firm against his accusations. We can stand on God’s Word and say...

“I am the righteousness of God in Christ. I am clothed in His righteousness—not mine. The Bible says that if I confess my sin, God is faithful to forgive me and cleanse me from all unrighteousness. I am loved!” (See 1 John 1:9)

God is on your side, and He wants you to feel good about yourself and the progress you are making. So don’t spend your time frustrated because you haven’t “arrived.” God is not mad at you because you aren’t perfect—He is only disappointed if you quit running the race.

Statewide COVID stats surprising

Dear Editor,

Some friends of mine were talking about why restaurants, bars and stores are being ticketed or forced to stay closed in some places.

That got me wondering, so I looked up the Illinois Department of Public Health's website and the statistics. They were surprising.

Did you know that statewide, restaurants are not the leading cause of COVID transmission?

In fact, they are way down the list. You have to get through 56 percent of the cases before you even see restaurants on the list.

Here are the statewide numbers/COVID transmission "Leader Board":

Coming in first: Schools—15.6 percent statewide, or 19.8 percent in Region 1. That's one in five people infected by COVID coming from schools in Region 1.

Second: Business or Retail at 9.09 percent

Third: Hospitals at 9.07 percent

Fourth: Other at 8.93 percent

Factory at 7.19 percent

Office Setting at 6.44 percent

Statewide, Restaurants are at 5.5 percent, but in Region 1 where we live, they are at only 3.87 percent.

To put that in perspective:

Out of 100 people infected, that means four people in Region 1 were infected in Restaurants and Bars, while 20 were infected in schools. So how is closing the restaurants going to flatten the curve? Quite frankly, it isn't.

So, why is Governor Pritzker closing restaurants, bars and some retail and expecting to "flatten the curve?" There are more than 56 percent of other COVID sources with most notably the biggest contributor being schools, but no major action was done there. If action was directed at schools as it should have been, that could drop one in five COVID cases which would flatten the curve.

Maybe a better approach is needed, one where contact tracing to a business is conducted, and if a pattern of infections emerges, the IDPH is dispatched for a visit and offers feedback on what the biggest COVID spreaders need to do to fix their problems.

Closing restaurants in light of this information obtained from the State of Illinois is both inappropriate and unlikely to make the necessary change in infection rate—it's like expecting the tail to wag the dog. 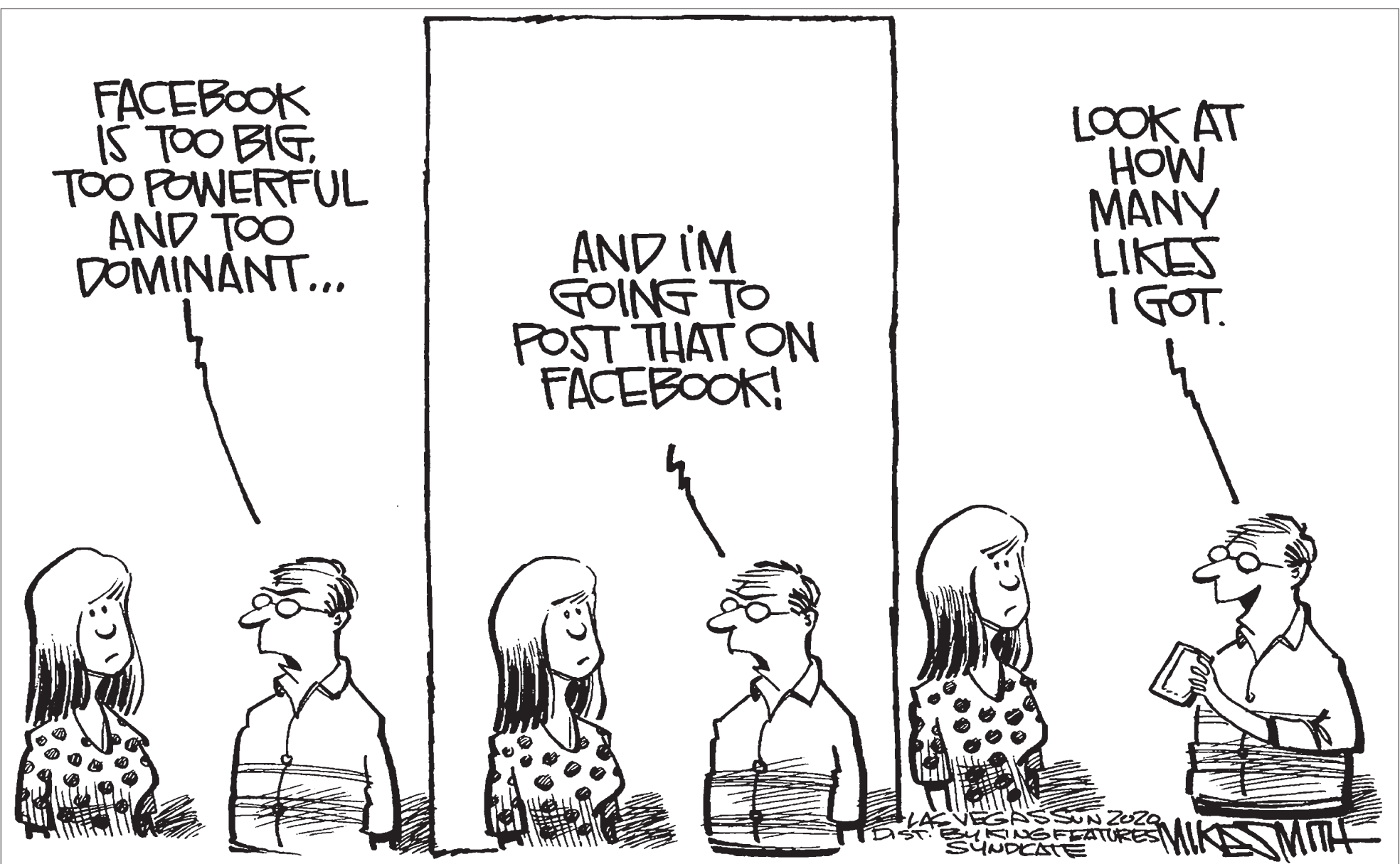
Worse yet, the governor's order is an illegal order, which violates state law 20 ILCS 2305(c). Law enforcement people who are being forced to enforce this illegal order are in effect, being instructed to operate outside the law.

Let's work to get some sanity into this process. Yes, COVID is dangerous to some groups of people. Yes, wearing masks is something everyone should do. On the other hand, maybe our government should focus on the schools in Region 1 to flatten the curve, and not penalizing restaurants by closing them because they happen to be located in the same region as those schools.

Think of it this way: If Byron Station could have an outage with greater than 2,000 visiting workers and not have an outbreak, why can't schools?

I'm grateful that local law enforcement in Ogle County has decided to work with businesses instead of against them. I can only hope this letter to the editor gets some other counties thinking and looking at their statistics and asking "Why" instead of just following the wrong leader and killing their local businesses when we have a governor who is blindly issuing orders.

Huskie linebacker Pugh named semifinalist for Comeback POTY Award

DEKALB — Northern Illinois University football's Kyle Pugh was named a semifinalist for the Mayo Clinic Comeback Player of the Year Award announced by the College Sports Information Directors of America in association with The Associated Press and the Fiesta Bowl Organization on Monday.

Pugh, who saw action in five games in 2020, starting four, has battled injuries throughout his career but has fought through them to return to the field each time.

After seeing action in the final 10 games as a redshirt-freshman, Pugh earned a spot as the Huskies' starting middle linebacker in 2017. He made an immediate impact, making a career-high 17 stops and an interception

in the season opener against Boston College. Unfortunately for Pugh and the Huskies, he ruptured a bicep in the fourth game of the season, ending his season.

The Chicago Heights native was dealt another blow in the 2018 season opener when he dislocated his shoulder. One injury away from ending his season, Pugh was able stay healthy the rest of the year, helping NIU to its seventh MAC championship with a 30-29 come-from-behind victory over Buffalo.

Pugh, a product of Bloom Township High School, had surgery to repair the dislocated shoulder in the offseason and was ready to go for the 2019 campaign. However,

Pugh was hit with another setback when he sustained another shoulder in the second game of the season.

Cleared for spring ball in 2020, Pugh has not looked back. The Huskie senior earned third-team All-MAC honors, finishing the campaign with 36 tackles, tied for second on the team, and three-and-a-half tackles for loss with a sack-and-a-half to his credit.

One of 14 semifinalists, Pugh is one of two players from the Mid-American Conference named a semifinalist. He is joined by Buffalo punter Evan Finegan. The three winners for the award will be selected by a vote of the Associated Press college football writers announced Sat., Jan. 2, 2021.
