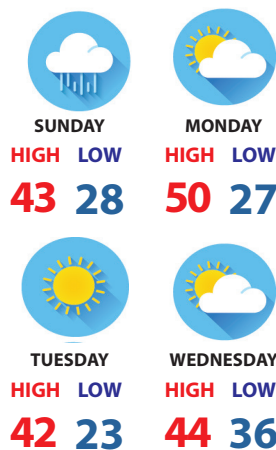

Sponsor soldiers through annual wreath program



DAR heading Wreaths Across America project

ROCHELLE – Last year the Rochelle community came together to sponsor wreaths on all 156 known veterans' graves at St. Patrick's Cemetery.

This year the Rochelle Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution is again coordinating the placement of wreaths as part of the national Wreaths Across America program.

"In addition to placing wreaths at St. Patrick's Cemetery, we are also accepting grave specific wreath sponsorships at Lawnridge, Trinity and other local cemeteries," Lydia Roberts of the DAR said. "Wreaths may be sponsored to decorate graves at St. Patrick's Cemetery in honor of an active duty service member, a living veteran or a deceased veteran, even if they are interred elsewhere."

Last year's ceremony included the Pledge of Allegiance lead by Girl Scout Troop 1168, the National Anthem performed by Daughters of the American Revolution member Debbie Katzman and a presentation of opening remarks followed by the presentation of the wreaths for each of the branches of the military.

Order forms can be picked up at St. Patrick's Catholic Church or submitted online at wreath-sacrossamerica.org/IL0136P. Wreath sponsorships vary from \$15 to \$150.

The deadline for the DAR to receive wreath sponsorship orders is Monday, Nov. 30.

The ceremony will be held on Dec. 20 at 2 p.m. An abbreviated ceremony will take place at Lawnridge Cemetery after the conclusion of the wreath laying at St. Patrick's.

In-person learning still the plan

Elementary board keeping eye on numbers and partial closures

ROCHELLE — Rochelle School District 231 will continue conducting in-person learning despite recent recommendations from the Ogle County Health Department that all schools transition to remote learning from Thanksgiving break to mid-January due to rising COVID-19 cases.

The District 231 Board of Education met Tuesday evening to hold discussions and hear audience comments regarding a potential move to remote learning. Rochelle Superintendent Jason Harper said that nearly 80 percent of students in the district will be attending school in person for the second trimester after around 65 percent were in person for the first trimester.

"We looked at the decision as an overall decision," Board President Dave Casey said. "We looked at the education of our kids and the safety of our students and staff. We looked at the impact the kids are seeing at home as opposed to learning in person and the impact on the kids and their families. We're watching our numbers daily and we're ready for any partial closures. But right now, we feel the benefits of in-person learning outweigh

the potential negatives."

Central School teacher Cosme Becerra and Rochelle Middle School teacher Jason Deutsch presented board members with results of a survey conducted by the Rochelle Elementary Education Association during Tuesday's meeting. Roughly 70 percent of the 117 teachers in the REEA responded to the survey, which revealed that, although the classroom is the best place to learn, teachers supported following the Ogle County Health Department recommendations.

"We have a really good relationship with our teachers and we want them to feel safe," Casey said. "It wasn't going to be an easy decision either way and the concerns of our teachers made up a large portion of our discussions. We respect and care for all of our teachers and staff."

District 231 has seen a few partial transi-

tions to remote learning since the start of the school year. Central School's first and fourth-graders were temporarily moved to 14-day remote learning recently, while Tilton School and Rochelle Middle School have seen at least one confirmed COVID-19 case as well. Casey said the district will continue to monitor local data as well as any potential COVID-19 cases or outbreaks within its schools moving forward.

Levy

Board members discussed the upcoming tax levy, which will be approved at the December meeting next month. Business manager Kevin Dale said the EAV of the district totaled about \$320 million, which is roughly \$10 million greater than last year. Dale said the district will be asking for \$9,388,250, an increase of 3.99 percent from last year's levy.

Generator project moving forward

HILLCREST — During Wednesday evening's village board meeting, village trustees received an update from Baxter & Woodman on the engineering project to replace the current generator.

Engineer Amanda Streicher said designs for the new generator project will be completed at the end of the month before begin-

ning the bidding process for work orders. Streicher said the project will be completed during the late summer or early fall months next year.

The new generator will cost around \$180,000 and the village has \$75,000 in grant funding it could use to help cover the cost of the project. The generator will provide power for the village water system as well as village hall in the event of an emergency outage.

Streicher said Baxter & Woodman has

begun the application process for an Illinois EPA Grant that could provide up to \$5 million in funding for the future infrastructural improvements within the village. Trustees concluded the meeting with a brief discussion regarding Trinity Memory Gardens Cemetery and a potential transfer of ownership.

The topic will be discussed further at the village board meeting next month, which will be held on Wednesday, Dec. 9.

Communities to receive Rebuild Illinois investment funds

Lee-Ogle Transportation on list of statewide recipients

SPRINGFIELD — The Illinois Department of Transportation announced Friday that \$112 million is being awarded to 31 downstate transit providers as part of Gov. JB Pritzker's historic and bipartisan Rebuild Illinois capital program. The grants will help to expand and improve service, providing more transportation options and promoting an enhanced quality of life in communities throughout the state.

Locally, money will be going to Lee County which includes service in Ogle County through the Lee-Ogle Transportation System.

The appropriation of \$2,794,783 will provide for purchase of real estate property to design, construct and equip a new satellite maintenance and administration location in Ogle County, which shares Lee County's transportation system. Overall, the facility will provide the Lee Ogle Transportation System with a greater presence; purchase of three Ford transit vehicles, one of which will be expansion and two of which will be replacements; and the purchase of video cameras for each transit vehicle in the LOTS system.

Overall, this proposed capital project of Lee County/LOTS will improve access for ridership, improve safety

for both riders and drivers, and reduce the volume of "dead-head" rides between counties.

"Due to decades of underinvestment by previous administrations, roads, bridges, and transit systems across the state, especially in downstate Illinois, are in desperate need of repair. During my first year in office, I worked with state representatives and senators from both sides of the aisle to create the bipartisan Rebuild Illinois capital plan — the largest infrastructure investment in our state's history," said Governor JB Pritzker. "Over the next five years, downstate communities will receive \$121 million to improve and expand transit services — that's on top of the work that's already been done in Year One, which delivered \$2.7 billion in improvements to over 1,700 miles of highway and over 120 bridges statewide. These projects will improve the quality of life for downstate residents and provide good jobs to grow our economy in every region." "Transit in our downstate communities can be a lifeline for getting to work or school, a doctor's appointment or a trip to the grocery store," said Acting Transportation

Secretary Omer Osman said. "This funding through Rebuild Illinois means these providers finally will have the resources they need to improve service in communities that have not seen this type of investment for many years."

Rebuild Illinois identifies a total of \$4.5 billion — \$3 billion in bonding and \$1.5 billion in new pay-as-you-go funding — to invest in transit throughout the state. Today's announcement is the first installment of \$355 million being distributed via grants in three cycles to transit providers outside the Chicago area. The remaining funds will be distributed in two more distributions, with the next call for proposals in 2021 and 2023. Passed in 2019, Rebuild Illinois investing a total of \$33.2 billion over six years into the state's aging transportation system, creating jobs and promoting economic growth. Rebuild Illinois is not only the largest capital program in state history, but also the first one that touches all modes of transportation: roads and bridges, transit, waterways, freight and passenger rail, aviation, and bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.



Bond refinancing allows Kishwaukee College to lower rate for taxpayers

MALTA — Kishwaukee College district taxpayers will see a lower tax rate this year thanks to bond refinancing that will save the taxpayers money for the foreseeable future.

Kishwaukee College approved a reduced tax levy rate at this month's board of trustees meeting. The primary reason the Board was able to lower the rate was because the college refinanced \$48.5 million in general obligation bonds earlier this year.

"Because the college was able to take advantage of lower interest rates, the district taxpayers will save approximately \$14 million over the life of the bonds, which extend to 2037," said Kishwaukee College Chief Financial Officer Jill Hansen.

The voter-approved general obligation bonds that were refinanced were initially issued in 2010 as the college took on the addition of the Student Center and renovation of older parts of the building.

"The community invested in the students and Kishwaukee College committed to overseeing the responsible fiscal decisions of this monumental project," said Bob Johnson, Chairman of the Kishwaukee College Board of Trustees. "The district's tax levy rate is now at its lowest since 2011 as college leadership continues to find ways to reduce taxpayer costs and maintain a quality, affordable education for Kishwaukee students."

First grant cycle open

Community Foundation of Northern Illinois to award In Youth We Trust grants

ROCKFORD — The Community Foundation of Northern Illinois is now accepting applications for the first of two In Youth We Trust grant program cycles. For the 2020-2021 school year, in recognition that COVID-19 may impact the feasibility of youth-led projects and events, IYWT will have two grant cycles: one for proposals written by nonprofit organizations (adults) for the purpose of serving youth, and one for proposals written by youth for youth-led, youth-benefiting projects.

The first cycle, for proposals written by nonprofit organizations (adults), is open and closes at 5 p.m. on Jan. 5, 2021.

Applications

Applications in this cycle must be submitted by organizations providing COVID-19 related items, services, or programming to youth in Boone, Ogle, Stephenson, or Winnebago Counties; applicant must currently be providing before- or after-school

programming. Applications must be submitted via CFNIL's online grants application portal which may be accessed, along with full program details, at <https://cfnil.org/grants/iywtdadult>.

Applications will be reviewed by the In Youth We Trust Council, a group of local high school students who convene monthly with staff and advisors of the Community Foundation of Northern Illinois to learn about grantmaking, volunteerism, and community leadership.

Applicants can request a maximum of \$5,000. For this unique grant cycle, The IYWT Council will look for proposals that:

Request support for unforeseen COVID-19 related expenses, Provide support for youth served during before- or after-school programming, Have a clear, practical plan for implementation, and Have a realistic budget.

The IYWT Council is an opportunity for high school students from Boone, Ogle, Stephenson, and Winnebago

Counties to learn about and practice philanthropy. The students help establish grant criteria, evaluate proposals, and recommend grant awards for youth led projects. IYWT empowers youth to expand their moral imagination and "see the good." In Youth We Trust was established in 1994 and has surpassed \$500,000 in grantmaking for youth-benefiting projects in our region.

The Community Foundation of Northern Illinois (CFNIL) has been a regional leader in philanthropy since 1953 and serves as a catalyst for giving in order to attract, preserve, and grow an endowment for the needs of the people of Northern Illinois. Driver service facilities closed Nov. 17 through Dec. 7

SPRINGFIELD — Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White is announcing Driver Services facilities statewide will be closed to the public for in person transactions effective Tuesday, Nov. 17 and will reopen on Monday, Dec. 7, 2020, due to the worsening COVID-19 pandemic. White is encouraging the public to take advantage of online services.

In addition, White announced that expiration dates for driver's licenses and ID cards will be extended until June 1, 2021. This June 1, 2021 extension also includes those who have February, March, April and May 2021 expiration dates. As a result, expired driver's licenses and ID cards will remain valid until June 1, 2021. CDL (Commercial Driver License) holders and commercial permit holders are excluded from this extension due to federal requirements.

"After careful consideration, we have decided to close all Driver Services facilities until December 7, 2020, due to the worsening COVID-19 pandemic," said White. "The health and safety of employees and the public remains paramount and face-to-face transactions potentially increase the further spread of the virus. We have extended expiration dates to assist people during this difficult time. I am also encouraging customers to consider using online services which are available for many office transactions."

Online

As White noted, many transactions with the Secretary of State's office may be conducted online at www.cyberdriveillinois.com, some of which include:

- Renewing a license plate sticker;
- Renewing a valid driver's license for qualifying drivers;
- Renewing a valid ID card for those age 22-64 (seniors 65 and older have free, non-expiring IDs);
- Obtaining a driver record abstract;
- Filing Business Services documents, such as incorporations and annual reports; and

Customers with issues involving administrative hearings may contact adminhearings@ilsos.gov.

Those who are eligible for online driver's license renewal will receive a letter from the Secretary of State's office with a PIN necessary for online renewal. Those whose driver's licenses or ID cards expired between Feb. 1, 2020 and Jan. 31, 2021, who qualify for online renewal should receive their

PIN letter in December 2020 or January 2021. Those whose driver's licenses or ID cards expire after Feb. 1, 2021, will receive their PIN letter approximately 90 days before their expiration date.

White noted that 19 CDL (Commercial Driver License) facilities will remain open for CDL written and road exams. These CDL facilities are:

Belleville, 400 W. Main St.; Bradley, 1111 Blatt St.; Charleston, 1010 E. St.; Danville/Tilton, #5 Southgate; DeKalb, 1360 Oakwood St.; Elk Grove Village, 650 Roppolo Dr.; Marion, Mascoutah, 9221 Beller Dr.;

1905 Rendleman St.; Moline/Silvis, 2001 Fifth St., Ste. #10; Olney, 1302 S. West St.; Peoria, 3311 N. Sterling Ave., #12; Princeton, 225 Backbone Rd. East; Quincy, 2512 Locust St.; Rantoul, 421 S. Murray Rd.; Rockford, 4734 Baxter Rd.; Salem, 1375 W. Whittaker St.; South Holland, 41 W. 162nd St.; Springfield, 2701 S. Dirksen Pkwy.; and West Chicago, 1280 Powis Rd.

"Commercial truck drivers provide essential services by ensuring goods can be transported safely and efficiently throughout the state and country during this pandemic," White said.

CDL driving tests are by appointment only by calling 217-785-3013.

Drive-thru service

Lastly, White announced that seven facilities will be offering drive-through services for license plate sticker transactions ONLY. These facilities were selected due to the configuration of the buildings which allowed for drive-through transactions. The seven drive-through facilities are: Chicago North, 5401 N. Elston Ave.; Chicago West, 5301 W. Lexington St.; Rockford-Central, 3720 E. State St.; Macomb, 466 Deer Rd.; Springfield, Dirksen 2701 S. Dirksen Parkway; Tilton, #5 Southgate Dr. and Chicago South (opens Nov. 19), 9901 S. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.

"During the COVID-19 pandemic, we have been the only government agency open statewide offering in-person transactions," said White. "We have remained committed to serving the public. Protecting the health and safety of our residents is my top priority, and this is the guiding principle of our decision-making."

All other Secretary of State departments are open to serve the public. Check www.cyberdriveillinois.com for more information.

Secrets to sabotage the enemy's attacks

ISAIAH 54:17 gives us a wonderful promise from God. It says, "'No weapon that is formed against you will succeed; and every tongue that rises against you in judgment you will condemn. This [peace, righteousness, security, and triumph over opposition] is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from Me,' says the Lord" (AMP).

No one likes to be judged or criticized by others, and this verse clearly says "every tongue that rises against you in judgment you will condemn." The question is, how do we show those who judge and criticize us unjustly that they are wrong? Do we defend ourselves? Do we get mad at them and say equally bad things about them, trying to get back at them? No, none of that works and it's not what this scripture is talking about.

Jesus is our ultimate example of how we should live, and the Bible says in 1 Peter 2:23 (NLT), "He did not retaliate when he was insulted, nor threaten revenge when he suffered. He left his case in the hands of God, who always judges fairly." When someone comes against us, we're often tempted to defend ourselves and say something like, "You're not going to talk to me like that!" Or "If you think you're going to treat me that way,

then I'm going to do this to you!"

But the way we show those who judge and criticize us that they are wrong is by behaving in a godly way instead of letting what the enemy – the devil – did through them cause us to act the same way.

As believers in Jesus Christ, we are in a war, but it's not a war against human beings. Ephesians 6:12 (AMP) says, "We are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places."

I realize that talking about the devil is unpleasant, and many people don't want to do it. I attended church for years and, although I knew the devil was real, I didn't understand that he could be a real problem in my life.

The truth is that all of the evil in this world – all of the bad things that happen – the source of it all is our enemy, the devil. It's so important for us to really get this if we want to effectively fight and get victory in the spiritual warfare we face.

Sometimes we take a verse, like Isaiah 54:17, and focus on the part that we like

or want to do and expect to reap the benefits of the whole thing. For example, we like saying, "No weapon formed against me will prosper, and everyone who says wrong things about me will be proven wrong!" But we need to take the rest of the verse to heart to. It says, "This [peace, righteousness, security, triumph over opposition] is the heritage of the servants of the Lord [those in whom the ideal Servant of the Lord is reproduced]..." (AMPC).

The heritage we have in Christ – His peace, righteousness, security and triumph over opposition – is experienced by those who follow the example of "the ideal Servant of the Lord," which is Jesus Christ. This means that true faith in Christ produces a lifestyle that represents His heart...His character and His behavior.

When you have a real relationship with Jesus, His Spirit lives in you and He changes you little by little, from glory to glory (2 Corinthians 3:18). When you're born again, the Holy Spirit comes to live in your spirit and shows you how to live right. You won't be comfortable with an ungodly lifestyle as you grow closer to Him.

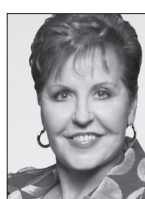
So, practically speaking, what does it

mean to act like Jesus in these situations? The first thing we need to do when someone comes against us is pray for them. They need to have an understanding of how dangerous it is to treat others this way. Matthew 7:2 (NLT) says, "You will be treated as you treat others. The standard you use in judging is the standard by which you will be judged."

We need to keep our eyes on Jesus and trust Him to give us the wisdom and strength to do what He would do. Remember the greatest commandment God gives us: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind.' And, 'Love your neighbor as yourself'" (Luke 10:27 NLT).

I want to encourage you to be a wholehearted believer in Christ who lives for Him in every area of your life! Commit yourself completely to Him and pray, "Lord, I give You every part of my life – there's nothing that is closed off to You. Do what You want to do in me and make me everything You've created me to be."

Loving God with all of your heart, soul, mind and strength is the secret to certain victory in spiritual warfare. In Christ, no weapon that's formed against you will prosper!

The city is installing a recreation path south of town past VFW Park, but there is no path connecting that to the north side path.

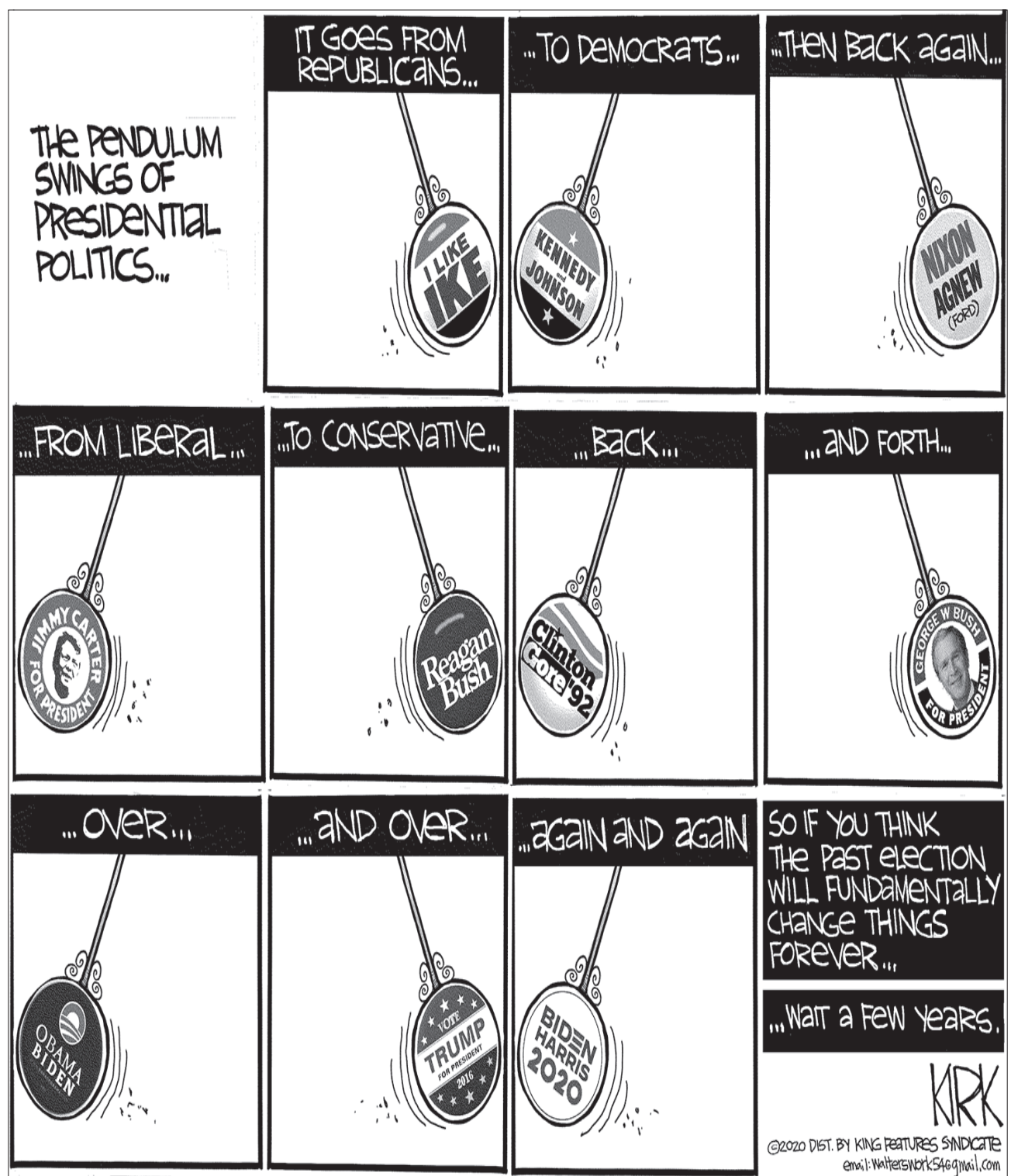
Someday someone will have a creative plan to expand the path south, maybe even looping the city or linking to Creston. That would indeed be sweet.

WITH limited opportunities to practice with the Rochelle Township High School basketball program, Adam Kemp and a few of his teammates competed over the summer through the Players Advantage AAU program. That experience and the chemistry formed between Kemp and his junior teammates will be beneficial when the Hubs take the court next season.

Kemp started in the backcourt for a sophomore team that went 24-5 and won an Interstate 8 Conference Championship this past season. 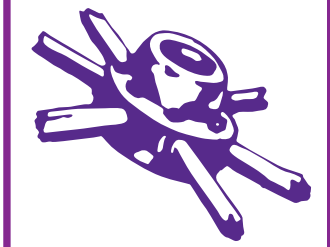

Huskies upended at home by Central Michigan

NIU falls to 0-2 on season with 40-10 loss to Chippewas

DEKALB—The NIU Huskies trailed by just nine at halftime, but two third quarter takeaways helped Central Michigan score 24 unanswered points to start the second half on its way to a 40-10 victory over NIU on Wednesday night (Nov. 11) at Huskie Stadium. “Obviously this falls squarely on my shoulders,” said NIU head coach Thomas Hammock. “I take full responsibility for the way we played, we have to play better. It’s unfortunate, the way our kids have practiced and got themselves prepared, at the moment we are just not reaping the rewards. We have to be better on offense, we have to be able to move the ball, we have to be able to stay on the field on third down. We have to be able to score in the red zone to give our defense a chance.”

Kyle Pugh (Chicago Heights/Bloom Township) made a game-high 14 tackles, including 1.5 sacks, his highest total in a game since 2017. Dav-
ereren Rayner (Indianapolis/Lawrence Central), making his first career start, and Jordan Hansen (Arlington Heights/John Hersey) each made seven tackles.

Central Michigan (2-0, 2-0 MAC) struck first with a 58-yard touchdown pass from Daniel Richardson to Dallas Dixon on the first drive of the contest. The Chippewas needed just two plays to go 76 yards to open the scoring.

Richardson was 13-of-19 passing in the contest for 196 yards and two

touchdowns.

Late in the first quarter, the Huskies moved to the Central Michigan 23-yard line but were unable to convert on fourth and three, turning the ball over on downs as the Chippewas took a 7-0 lead into the second quarter.

A mishandled snap on a punt deep in NIU (0-2, 0-2 MAC) territory was knocked out of the back of the end zone by the Huskies for a Central Michigan safety with just over two minutes left in

the opening half, giving CMU a 9-0 lead at the intermission.

Central Michigan added to its lead with a 12-play, 94-yard drive to start the second half. Kobe Lewis capped the drive with a 1-yard touchdown run as the Chippewas took a 16-0 lead.

A Huskie fumble on the ensuing kickoff gave the ball back to the Chippewas inside NIU territory and CMU converted with a 40-yard field goal to take a 19-point advantage.

Late in the third quarter, NIU turned the ball over on downs near midfield and, on the second play of the drive, Central Michigan added another score as Richardson connected with Lew Nichols on a screen pass that went 58 yards for the score.

Nichols added another touchdown early in the fourth quarter before John Richardson (Orland Park/Brother Rice) got the Huskies on the scoreboard with a 45-yard field goal. Nichols finished with a

game-high 91 yards on 12 carries.

Andrew Haidet (Plano, Texas/John Paul II/Houston Baptist) led NIU on an 8-play, 73-yard drive in the fourth quarter, finished with a 31-yard touchdown reception by Dennis Robinson (Hollywood, Florida/South Broward). Harrison Way-
lee (Johnston, Iowa/Urbandale) had four carries for 28 yards on the drive while Erin Collins (Plant City, Florida/Armwood/Hutchinson CC) added 9

yards on two carries on the scoring drive.

Ross Bowers (Bothell, Washington/Bothell/California) was 16-of-32 passing for 139 yards and Tyrice Richie (Chicago/Homewood-Flossmoor/Dodge City CC) recorded a game-high seven catches for 70 yards.

NIU will hit the road for the first time in the 2020 season on Wednesday, Nov. 18, as the Huskies travel to Ball State. Kick-off is set for 6 p.m. and will be televised on ESPNU.

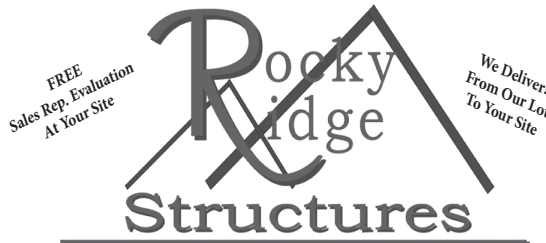

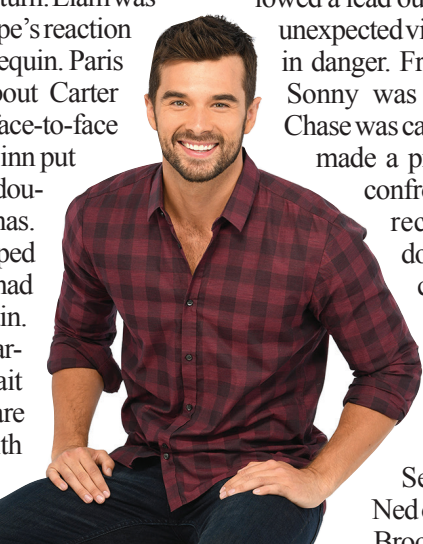

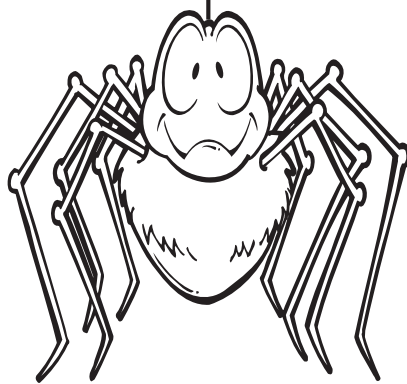

Illinois High School Association

Board of Directors take no action on basketball

State organizations including IDPH, ISBE invited to attend Nov. 19 meeting

BLOOMINGTON — The Illinois High School Association (IHSA) Board of Directors held a virtual update session on Nov. 11, 2020, to review recent developments related to the IHSA basketball season ahead of the board's regularly scheduled meeting on Nov. 19.

The board announced that they are formally inviting representatives from Governor Pritzker's Office and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) to attend the IHSA board meeting on Nov. 19. Additionally, the IHSA will also seek representation at the meeting from the Illinois Principals Association (IPA), the Illinois Association of School Administrators (IASA), the Illinois State Board

of Education (ISBE), and a coalition of nearly 200 school superintendents who recently contacted the Governor regarding school sports during the 2020-21 school year.

"The board hopes to create a dialogue and build a more collaborative relationship with all the entities involved with developing sports policy in our state as everyone tries to navigate the myriad issues caused by the pandemic," said IHSA Executive Director Craig Anderson. "The board's decision to move forward with the IHSA basketball season was not meant to be adversarial. It was rooted in a desire to receive more direct communication and data from our state partners. They hope all the groups will



see the mutual benefit of increased discourse and be represented at the meeting on Nov. 19."

The board also announced that schools who plan to begin basketball practice on Nov. 16 should adhere to the Level 1 mitigations from the IDPH All Sports Policy until at least Nov. 19. The board cited rising COVID-19 cases in the state and a recent membership survey for this recommendation. The board plans to provide more direction on basketball practice and games

following the meeting on Nov. 19.

The Board revealed that among the 546 schools who responded to the survey (IHSA has 813 member schools), nearly 300 IHSA schools do not plan to start basketball on Nov. 16, and another 212 schools remain unsure of their status.

"The board recognizes the difficult decisions they have placed on member schools regarding basketball," said Anderson. "With a limited number of schools set to begin their
