COVID-19 case confirmed at RTHS

ROCHELLE — Rochelle School District 212 and the Ogle County Health Department released a joint statement Friday evening after it was discovered that an individual at Rochelle Township High School has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

The individual was last in school on Wednesday,

Oct. 7, according to the joint statement released by Superintendent Jason Harper and Ogle County Health Department Administrator Kyle Auman. Students in the classroom with the infected individual will be temporarily moved to remote learning for a required 14-day quarantine. The school district and health department

have begun contacting parents regarding the situation.

“The district has been closely monitoring the health and safety of our students and staff,” the statement read. “Today we became aware that an individual in Mrs. Berge-son’s in-person classroom at Rochelle Township High School has been diagnosed

with COVID-19. Out of an abundance of caution, all students in this classroom will be temporarily moved to remote learning due to a required 14-day quarantine. Quarantined students will return on Thursday, Oct. 22... All areas of the building and/or classrooms potentially impacted are being cleaned and disinfected in accordance with

recommendations from the CDC and IDPH. For all other students attending Rochelle Township High School or other Rochelle schools, there is no indication of a larger spread of COVID-19. The district continues to work with the Ogle County Health Department to determine the best course of action for all students.”

More REC bids approved

ROCHELLE — During a special virtual session Wednesday evening, Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District commissioners approved bids for construction work on the playground and south parking lot of the REC Center while also approving a bid for sports equipment.

Park board commissioners approved a bid amounting \$33,055.56 from Kompan for a playground that will be placed slightly east of the main entrance of the REC Center. The playground will be purchased with funds donated from the Hayden family.

Two additional bids approved Wednesday evening included a bid not to exceed \$15,000 for sports equipment from BSN Sports and a bid amounting \$53,440 from Norwest Construction for work on the south parking lot of the REC Center.

Executive Director Jackee Ohlinger said the south parking lot is expected to be completed before the REC Center’s soft opening on Nov. 1.

Mail-in voting, early voting underway

OREGON — Ogle County Clerk, Laura J. Cook, announced that her office complies with the Federal Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act.

The Ogle County Courthouse is accessible to disabled citizens for voter registration. If you are unable to go to a Deputy Registrar, we will send a deputy registrar to the residence of any person who wishes to

register to vote. For information on this service, please call the County Clerk’s Office at 815-732-1110.

Any Ogle County resident who has never registered in Ogle County, has moved within the county, or has had a change of name since the last election must be registered with the correct name and address if they wish to vote in this election.

First time registrants shall (by

Nov. 3 General Election) have resided in their precinct for 30 days and must be 18 years of age on or before the Nov. 3 General Election. The last day to register to vote or change your address for the Nov. 3, 2020 General Election is Oct. 6, 2020, (with the exception of grace period voter registration beginning Oct. 7, 2020 and ending Nov. 2, 2020, in the office of the Ogle

County Clerk.)

All properly registered voters are eligible to Vote by Mail. An Application to “Vote by Mail” can be downloaded by visiting the Ogle County Official website at www.oglecounty.org by going to the “I Want To” tab, select “Application for Vote by Mail.”

Nominating petitions for Flagg-Rochelle Public Library now available

ROCHELLE — Nominating petitions for open board positions at the Flagg-Rochelle Public Library are now available. Current Board members include Jaqueline Dickow, Teresa Haggstad, Michael Scanlan, Lanning Nicoloff, Sheri Klindera, Susan Sevedge and Darci Waltrip.

“There will be four openings for library trustee in the April 6, 2021 election,” library director Sarah Flanagan said. “These are four-year terms.”

To be considered for election, candidates must file a petition of 50 signatures by qualified voters residing within the library district. Additionally, prospective candidates must complete, sign and have notarized a loyalty oath, statement of candidacy and statement of economic interest.

All necessary forms will be included in the candidate’s election packet, which will be made available at the Flagg-Rochelle Public Library Monday through Thursday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Friday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Candidates may begin filing completed petitions at the library on Monday, Dec. 14. Filing will conclude Monday, Dec. 21.

Packets returned after that date may not be considered for candidacy.

AARP, senior groups stump for graduated tax, address retirement income claims

Opposition group led by Illinois Chamber announces new alliances

SPRINGFIELD – A group of retirees organized through the senior advocacy group AARP held a virtual news conference Wednesday to express support for a graduated tax constitutional amendment and opposition to a tax on retirement income – two things that they note are mutually exclusive.

Many of the speakers, which included a former state director of the Department on Aging, took direct aim at recent claims by opponents of the tax amendment. Illinois is one of 12 states that do not tax retirement income. Of those 12, nine do not levy income taxes at all.

“The fair tax amendment would also protect our retirement income,” Chicagoan Carmen Betances, a member of the Jane Addams Seniors in Action, said at the news conference. “Illinois is one of the few states that does not tax retirement income. The fair tax will not change that. In order to protect retirement income in Illinois, we need more revenue to keep us afloat.”

The “fair tax” is a name proponents, including Gov. JB Pritzker, have given to the graduated tax constitutional amendment proposal. That measure, which will appear on the Nov. 3 ballot, would amend the state’s constitution to remove the requirement that any income tax be levied at a flat rate equally across all levels of income. If approved by voters, the amendment would allow lawmakers to impose different tax rates on varying levels of income.

Should the amendment pass, a rate structure that has already been approved by lawmakers would take effect in January. It would scrap the current 4.95 percent flat tax, creating six tax brackets for varying levels of income ranging from 4.75 percent under \$10,000 to 7.99 percent above \$750,000 for single filers.

Those earning more than \$250,000 annually would see rates increased under the structure, while those earning less than that amount would pay slightly less or the same under the new tax system compared to the current flat tax structure.

In estimates released prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, Pritzker’s office said it expects the approved graduated tax

rate structure to bring in about \$3.4 billion in state revenue once it is in place for a full fiscal year.

Speakers at the news conference Wednesday said state government has ongoing budget deficits in the billions of dollars, especially as revenues plummet amid the COVID-19 pandemic, and the graduated tax rates approved by lawmakers are one way to raise revenues without taxing middle income earners or retirement incomes.

Pritzker has estimated the budget shortfall for the current fiscal year at \$6.2 billion dollars. Without the graduated tax, which would only be in effect for half of the fiscal year, the shortfall could reach \$7.4 billion, he said in April.

“If Illinois doesn’t find a way to fix this budget crisis with steps in the right direction, such as passing the graduated income tax, that’s when state lawmakers may be forced to consider adding a retirement income tax or more drastic spending cuts,” Charles Johnson, AARP Illinois volunteer and former Director of the Illinois Department on Aging, said at the news conference.

Opponents of the amendment have seized on a June comment by Treasurer Michael Frerichs, a Democrat, who said at a local chamber of commerce event, “One thing a progressive tax would do is make clear you can have graduated rates when you are taxing retirement income... And, I think that’s something that’s worth discussion.”

Frerichs called a news conference this week to address the statement, but abruptly canceled it, instead issuing a release saying he is against taxing retirement income.

While opponents have argued that allowing different tax rates on different levels of income would open the door for a future tax on high-dollar amount retirement incomes, the actual wording of the amendment does not create a retirement tax and does not make it any easier for the state to levy one.

Pritzker said in a separate news conference Wednesday he was opposed to taxing retirement income.

“I want to preserve the ban on retirement taxes, and I stand with all democrats opposed to raising retirement taxes,” he said. “But the people who are opposed to the fair tax want to put the burden on people who can’t afford it.

“If Illinois doesn’t find a way to fix this budget crisis with steps in the right direction, such as passing the graduated income tax, that’s when state lawmakers may be forced to consider adding a retirement income tax or more drastic spending cuts.”

I want to put the burden on the people who can most afford it. And that’s our millionaires and billionaires in Illinois.”

Opponents, however, have argued that even the \$3.4 billion from the graduated tax would not fill the state’s budget holes, meaning further increases would be needed in the future and rates could be adjusted. Opponents argue more structural spending and pension reforms are needed before taxpayers are tapped for more revenue.

The amendment does not change the simple majority vote threshold needed from lawmakers to raise taxes in Illinois, but opponents argue by allowing lawmakers to set tax rates for smaller sectors of the population at any one time, it makes it a politically easier move for future General Assemblies.

On Sept. 24, Lt. Gov. Juliana Stratton said lawmakers “will be forced to consider raising income taxes on all Illinois residents by at least 20 percent, regardless of their level of income” if the graduated income tax fails. That would push the

current tax rate to about 6 percent.

The Illinois Republican party quickly issued a statement following those remarks, calling them a “scare tactic” that will not sway Illinois voters.

A coalition led by the Illinois Chamber of Commerce, the Illinois Farm Bureau and National Federation of Independent Business has been growing in opposition to the amendment since the beginning of the

year, and on Wednesday they announced 40 new members opposing the tax, including 27 local chambers of commerce.

The approved rates also raise the corporate tax rate from 7 to 7.99 percent, and the Vote No on the Progressive Tax Constitutional Amendment coalition argues that, amid the COVID-19 pandemic and associated economic restrictions, now is not the time to raise corporate taxes.

“Like the rest of small businesses, our auto dealers are struggling to recover from major losses due to the COVID-19 pandemic,” Illinois Automobile Dealers Association Director of Government Affairs Joe McMahon said in a news release. “Now is the worst possible time to increase taxes on our businesses that are fighting to keep their doors open and their teams employed.”

Proponents, however, point out that small businesses earning less than \$250,000 per year will see taxes lowered if they are pass-through entities such as S-corporations or sole proprietorships.

The graduated income tax will need support from 60 percent of those voting on the ballot question or a majority vote of the total votes casts in the election

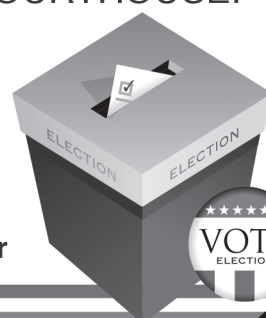

Liesch to present Wild Ones program

ROCKFORD — The monthly meeting of the Rock River Valley Chapter Wild Ones will feature PJ Liesch.

Liesch will present a program via Zoom about common spiders of the midwest on Thursday, Oct. 15. Information on connecting to the Zoom presentation will be posted on the chapter website (www.wildonesrrvc.org) beginning on Oct. 15, and will also be distributed via Constant Contact.

Spiders are amazing creatures that receive little praise for the role they play in the ecosystem. Whether indoors or out, the overwhelming majority of spiders are harmless, beneficial predators that consume an astonishing mass of insects around the globe each year. In this presentation participants will take a closer look at our eight-legged neighbors, with an emphasis

on common myths, spider biology, and the diversity of the Midwest's spider fauna.

Liesch is a University of Wisconsin Extension entomologist and has been the director of the University of Wisconsin Insect Diagnostic Lab since March 2014. He has been involved with insect-related research, outreach, and Extension since 2005. He is a regular speaker for the Master Gardener program, the Wisconsin First Detector Network, the Pesticide Applicator Training program, and UW Farm and Industry Short Course programs. Liesch is an avid insect collector and has an inordinate fondness for beetles. He can be found Tweeting about life as an entomologist: @WiBugGuy.

3, 2020, General Election. The first day to mail a Vote by Mail ballot is Sept. 24, 2020 with the last day for mailing a ballot from the County Clerk's Office being Oct. 29, 2020.

Early voting in person at the County Clerk's Office may be done through Nov. 2, 2020, until 4:30 p.m. Voting will be conducted at the Ogle County Clerk's Office located at the Ogle County Courthouse, 105 S. 5th St., Oregon, Sept. 24 through

Nov. 2, 2020, for all Ogle County Precincts.

Voting hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, Oct. 31, 2020 from 9 a.m. to noon.

Early Voting will be conducted at the Flagg Township Building located at 303 W. Illinois Route 38 in Rochelle Oct. 28 through Oct. 30 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Oct. 31 from 9 a.m. to noon, for Flagg and Dement Precincts, only.

If there are any voters in Ogle County who cannot get into the polling place, we can send two Judges of Election within 50 feet of the polling place with the ballot.

A request should be made prior to the Election on a form provided by the County Clerk's Office.

Get free of the fear that's holding you back

GOD has a wonderful plan for each of our lives (see Jeremiah 29:11). And when we put our faith in Jesus as our Savior, we put ourselves in a position to walk out our God-given destiny.

Sadly, many believers in Christ aren't living out their destiny because of fear. The fear of man is a common problem that causes us to worry about things like, "What will they think of me? What are they going to say about me? What will they do if I don't do what they want? What if they reject me? What if they don't like me?"

Everyone struggles with insecurity and the fear of rejection to some degree. And there's nothing wrong with wanting people to like you. But when we're so focused on being people pleasers that our fear of being rejected, judged or criticized controls our choices, we're being controlled by the fear of man.

If we're going to get free of fear and really pursue everything God has for our lives, we have to make a decision that we will not live with fear. Instead, we can learn how to live courageously by the grace and

strength we have in Christ.

It's important to understand what it means to live courageously. It doesn't mean we will never feel fearful, because the truth is, we will never completely get rid of the feeling of fear. But it does mean that when we feel afraid, we can do whatever we need to do through Christ who gives us strength. (See Philippians 4:13.) We can follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and do what God puts in our hearts to do, rather than settle for an okay or average life. And God wants to do amazing things in our lives that will likely pull us out of our comfort zones and require us to walk by faith to do them.

Now, I'm not talking about making foolish choices or doing things that are dangerous because you don't want fear of those things to hold you back. Living courageously means we can be bold and take risks instead of just doing what seems "safe" and keeps us from becoming everything God has created us to be.

I remember when I had to make some bold, scary choices so I could move forward in God's plan for my ministry. I had friends who didn't think I had the right personality to be a Bible teacher. There were people in my church who didn't think women should teach the Word. And there were family members who didn't understand the call of God on my life and they rejected me because of it.

It was a very hard time, but I'm so glad God gave me the courage I needed to do it afraid. And now, it's scary to think about where I would be if I hadn't trusted God and followed His plans for me because I was afraid I'd lose my friends and not be well thought of by others.

The only way you can conquer fear is to confront it...to keep going forward with God while the enemy of fear is trying to drive you backward. Remember that "God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind" (2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV).

When you're struggling to do what you

know God wants you to do, go to the Word for encouragement. Here are a few powerful scriptures you can use to conquer fear:

Isaiah 41:10 says, "Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand" (NIV).

Psalms 118:6 says, "The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?" (NIV)

Psalms 27:1 declares, "The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?" (NIV)

Romans 8:31-32 says, "...If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave Him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" (NIV)

The Word of God has power to set you free from fear. Take time to study these verses and pray for God to help you live courageously in His will for your life. You'll discover there's nothing more exciting than being the person God has created you to be.

Bigger than the Great Chicago Fire

FIRE Prevention Week is a good time to change batteries in smoke detectors and make sure they work.

Last week I asked about the big fire that started Oct. 8, 1871. Most people know about the Great Chicago

Fire, which burned from Oct. 8 to Oct. 10 but that fire paled in comparison to the Peshtigo Fire, which started the same day as Chicago's.

Peshtigo is a small, quiet town in the woods of northern Wisconsin. Following a long hot and dry summer, the woods around town were tinder waiting to burn.

And burn they did. What was described by survivors as a "tornado of fire" ravaged the area. More than 1,500, and as many as 3,000 people died in the flames. In comparison, the Great Chicago Fire resulted in an estimated 300 deaths.

In the Peshtigo fire, 12 towns and villages were destroyed by the flames, which may have started from a railroad construction crew, lightning, or some other cause.

Coincidentally, the Port Huron Fire and the Great Michigan Fire, which affected half state from Holland to Manistee, also started the same day.

Then, like now, conspiracy theories and rumors abounded. While Mrs. O'Leary and her cow were blamed for the Chicago fire, I have also read that it was more likely a drunk who fell asleep with a cigar, a young boy smoking behind a barn, and other theories. The cow story seems more folklore than true.

One other theory floating around is that a comet breaking up was the cause of all the fires, although astronomers say that is unlikely.

Four major fires

starting Oct. 8, 1871 — coincidence, comet, or conspiracy? I don't think we will ever know.

I have heard a couple of people say candidate signs have been damaged or stolen from their yards.

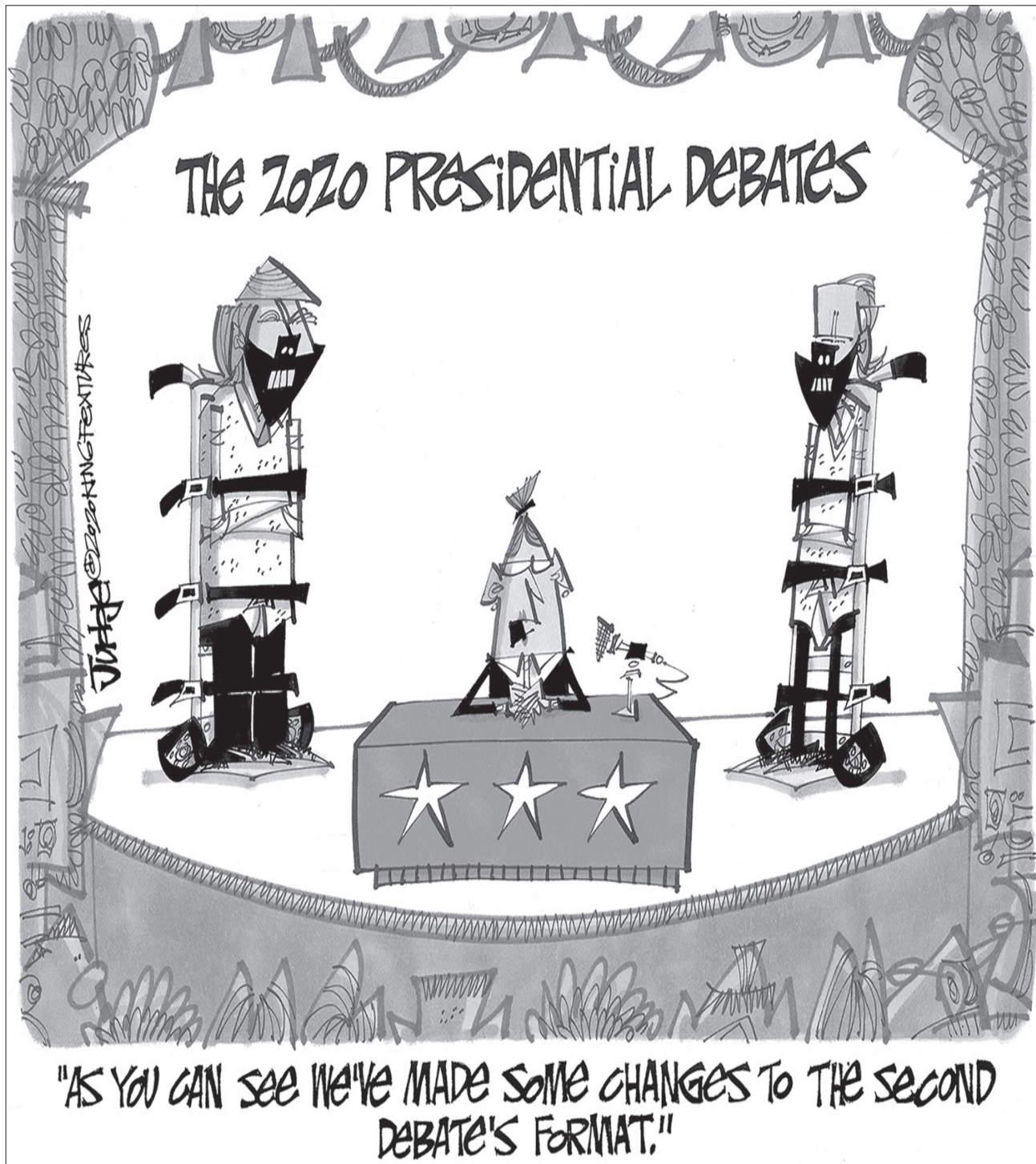
One of the great things about the United States is our ability to speak our minds and support our candidates in peaceful ways.

Electronic recycling events set for October

OREGON—The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will be holding two residential electronic recycling events in October.

Electronics will be accepted on Saturday, Oct. 17, from 8 a.m. to noon and on Friday, Oct. 23, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., do not arrive early. The electronics recycling events require permits in advance, and will be held at the Ogle County Annex Building at 909 Pines Road in Oregon.

To obtain a free permit, call the OCSWMD at 815-732-4020, or e-mail the department at solidwaste@oglecounty.org. There are a limited number of permits for each event and the deadline for acquiring a permit is noon on the Wednesday prior to each event. These electronics recycling events are for Ogle County residents only and each permit is valid for a specific date.

The advance permitting system was implemented, beginning in August, in response to extremely long lines and safety issues at the June and July electronics collection events.

Users of the program have expressed gratitude to the OCSWMD for the permit

system, which has resulted in reduced wait times and a more efficient drop-off experience.

Acceptable items

Items accepted at this event include all televisions, computers, computer monitors, computer hardware and cables, printers, FAX machines, copiers, scanners, video game consoles and equipment, DVD/VCR's, satellite and cable boxes, tablets, cell phones, laptops, radios, stereo equipment, digital clocks, phone systems, holiday lights, rechargeable batteries, CFL bulbs, and printer cartridges. Limit five large items per permit.

Please remove all batteries from devices, discard the alkaline batteries, and recycle the rechargeable ones at the event.

Huskie players return to the practice field

Mid-American Conference football programs begin games in November

DEKALB — The Northern Illinois University football was back on the football field prepping for the upcoming 2020 Mid-American Conference season Monday morning.

The Huskies, who are practicing for the fourth season since it was announced the season was back on, worked out for an hour and a half in the crisp DeKalb air at Huskie Stadium. Head coach Thomas Hammock was pleased with the way the team responded.

"It felt really good," Hammock said about being out on the practice field. "For us, it's been a long time coming and a lot of uncertainty, but it was good to have a focus, a narrow focus, on knowing the start date and knowing

the things we need to get done to get ready for the season. Our players had great energy and it's been outstanding."

All Mid-American Conference schools will start their seasons on Wednesday, Nov. 4. Having that start date to point to, Hammock can see the difference in his squad early in practice.

"You went from trying to keep the players engaged during the fall semester to now we're preparing for a game," Hammock said. "I think the urgency has certainly picked up amongst the coaches. It has certainly picked up amongst the players and guys know that we need to get ourselves mentally and physically prepared to play a MAC

season."

Without a traditional fall camp and classes already in session, Hammock and his staff had to adjust their practice schedule accordingly.

"We looked at a normal camp schedule, and what we wanted to do was take the things from camp that we thought were productive and we could be efficient with our time and try to get that into a school day," he said. "You can't have the players here more than four hours a day. The things that you would normally space out take more time during training camp, you have to be able to condense in a timely fashion to make sure we're not going over our time, but with the understanding that these guys are in class,

have study tables, tutoring, etc. We want to make sure we can be as efficient and effective with our time. I think the way we have our schedule mapped out is really good. We get our physical work in the morning with practice."

In the spirit of efficiency and with an eye on safety, Hammock and his staff are also taking advantage of the technology they relied on during the pandemic to continue to coach their players up outside the

practice field or meeting rooms.

"I think Zoom helps a lot now too," he said. "You can have an opportunity to grab a guy on a meeting and he doesn't have to physically come back into the building. We still want to be cautious in everything we're doing because of COVID and making sure we're being smart and safe to prevent the spread of this virus that is still in play."

Hammock has a very simple goal for his squad

leading up to their first game of the season.

"The goal is to progressively build this team up, to get them ready and peaking by Nov. 4," he said. "You have to build them up to be able to sustain a two-hour practice, which helps prepare you for a three-hour game. You don't just jump right into it day one. What we tried to do is progressively work ourselves back into practice shape, into game shape and we want to peak at the right moment."

Seldal leads Hubs to victory over Oregon

Johnson finishes fourth for Lady Hubs

OREGON — Hub senior Aiden Seldal had one runner to beat during the final stretch of Rochelle's cross country race against the Oregon Hawks on Thursday. Competing stride-for-stride with Oregon harrier Ryan Hussung, Seldal maintained a slight edge before making a strong turn around the last turn of the course at Oregon Park West. With nothing remaining but a sprint to the finish, Seldal pushed toward the line, extending his lead and ultimately winning his first race of the 2020 season with a time of 19:08.1.

"I knew that if I stuck with whoever I was running with, I could beat him out at the end," Seldal said. "It felt really good to win the race. I think my season has gone pretty well, but I think my next few races are going to be even better. I want to finish in the 17-minute range during my next race at the conference meet and I want to be a sectional qualifier this year."

Seldal's first-place performance propelled Rochelle's boys past Oregon on Thursday, with the Hubs winning 25-30 for their first victory since Sept. 3. Sophomore David Wanner placed third for Rochelle (5-7, 1-6 Interstate 8) with a time of 20:00, while junior Josue Huerta took sixth in 20:33.8. Freshmen Parker Lenkaitis and Alex Burke rounded out the top eight runners in the race, with Lenkaitis (20:34.0) finishing seventh and Burke (21:20.1) placing eighth.

"We're racing really well right now," Seldal said. "We have a well-rounded team and everybody placed well today. I think we can race well at the conference and regional meets. These next few races may be the last few for some of the guys, so we want to show what we can do."

The Lady Hubs also went head-to-head with Oregon on Thursday, with the Hawks defeating Rochelle 17-46. Junior Sara Johnson finished fourth for the Lady Hubs (3-8, 1-6 Interstate 8) with a time of 24:01.1 and sophomore Karina Lopez took 13th with a time of 28:12.9.

2020 schedule released

Huskies face Buffalo on Nov. 4

DEKALB — The Northern Illinois University Huskies will open the 2020 football season on Wednesday, Nov. 4 when they play host to the Buffalo Bulls at Huskie Stadium in the first of three 2020 home games as the Mid-American Conference released its complete 2020 football schedule Wednesday.

NIU will start the season with #MACtion games on three consecutive Wednesday nights in November before the schedule moves to Saturdays beginning on Nov. 28, the Saturday after Thanksgiving. The MAC Championship game will be played on Friday, Dec. 18 at Ford Field in Detroit.

In addition to the season opener versus Buffalo, the only MAC East opponent on the 2020 schedule, NIU will take on Central Michigan at home on Wednesday, November 11 and faces Toledo at Huskie Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 5. NIU will travel to Muncie, Indiana to face Ball State on Wednesday, Nov. 18 and plays Western Michigan in Kalamazoo on Nov. 28. The Huskies conclude the regular season Dec. 12 at Eastern Michigan. (see schedule below)

Second-year head coach Thomas Hammock said announcing the schedule was another step forward in this unusual 2020 season.

"As coaches, we like to plan months ahead, so it feels great to know who you're preparing for," Hammock said. "We know the outline, the layout and when we'll have a longer week as opposed to a shorter week. We're



excited about the schedule. It's very fair, very challenging and very competitive. We know that we have to be ready to play each and every week if we are going to be successful. We open with Buffalo, one of the best teams in the MAC with a great running back and they're going to have our undivided attention and our focus as we prepare."

With fans inside Huskie Stadium limited to immediate family of student-athletes for the three home games, NIU will not sell tickets or be able to accommodate season ticket members at Huskie Stadium in 2020. Individuals who purchased season tickets earlier this year and who have not yet contacted the NIU Athletic Ticket Office to provide direction for those funds have until Nov. 1 to do so.

With Huskies Invest: The Campaign underway to raise funds to support NIU student-athletes and help fill the budgetary shortfalls created by the coronavirus

pandemic, season ticket members are invited to donate the money already paid for season tickets to Huskies Invest at this critical time.

While most fans will not be allowed to cheer on the Huskies in person this year, there will be a chance for NIU fans to be represented in Huskie Stadium in 2020 by purchasing a life-sized cardboard cutout of themselves, a family member or fellow Huskie fan that will be positioned in the stands. Virtual historic tour of homes launches on Oct. 24

A favorite Pumpkin Fest tradition is the DeKalb County History Center's Historic Tour of Homes. This year, while our community might not be celebrating together, people can still enjoy learning more about architecture and local history during this year's virtual House Walk.

In the past, a theme was announced, volunteers were recruited, and about seven homes were open for the public to explore on the Saturday of Pumpkin Fest. This year, due to COVID, the History Center came up with a creative option to host this important fundraiser – a virtual House Walk. While homes will not be open to the public, there are going to be a variety of opportunities to discover the rich history of Somonauk Street along with two bonus homes.

“By offering a virtual House Walk we can present our research and stories in a variety of new formats. First, we are offering a magazine-style color brochure that highlights 15 homes, compared to the traditional black and white booklet with seven homes. We are also including two interviews with home owners who have never had their home on the Walk. Using Google Earth, people can access material with a mobile device. Finally, there is also the option to print out the text from a computer. All of these choices provide people several ways to discover and engage with Sycamore's historic homes,” explained Michelle Donahoe, Executive Director of the DeKalb County History Center. She continued, “Another benefit is that more people will have the time to enjoy the House Walk. Hundreds of people are volunteering during Pumpkin Fest and are not free to participate in the House Walk. This year, with the virtual option, there is more flexibility in when you want to participate.”



The homes included in the tour are: 230 Somonauk, 305 Somonauk, 319 Somonauk, 320 Somonauk, 413 Somonauk, 420 Somonauk, 421 Somonauk, 432 Somonauk, 450 Somonauk, 608 Somonauk, 614 Somonauk, 708 Somonauk, 813 Somonauk, 827 Somonauk, and 925 Somonauk. There are also two interviews with the homeowners of 314 S. Main Street and 740 W. State Street.

The History Center will launch their Virtual Tour on Saturday, October 24. Simply visit their website

dekalbcountyhistory.org, pay the \$20 fee. Then, you can download the information to a computer, access the mobile tour, listen to the interviews, and print out the historical information. The House Walk will be available for purchase until January 10.
