



Officials work to save nuclear plant

Demmer tells county board talks on the issue have started in Springfield

OREGON – State Rep. Tom Demmer told the Ogle County Board that people are mobilizing to try to save the Byron Generating Station, which Exelon Generation said it would be closing in September 2021.

At its Oct. 21 meeting, Demmer told board members that he and other legislators on both sides of the aisle are looking for ways to change state policies that could save the Byron and Dresden plants. Dresden, in Morris, is scheduled to close in November 2021.

Demmer said that making changes to save the plant is “not an impossibility.”

He said Exelon has been active in Springfield over the last couple of years and has talked about the importance of it nuclear plants and the carbon free electricity they produce, and how they should factor into the state’s overall electric power policy.

The company has also said that plants like the Byron Station could close if changes weren’t made.

“It’s been talked about for several years, but recently became a lot more real,” Demmer said.

But even after the talk, he said the announcement to close the plants released on

Aug. 27, “...was a shock to a lot of us.”

Demmer said Gov. JB Pritzker has set up a power policy group, and Demmer said some people from Byron will be testifying in front of that group on the importance of the plant to the local economy and the region.

“There’s a discussion happening in the governor’s office,” Demmer said, adding that this discussion will be happening for “several

months.”

Local officials have also come together to try to save the plant. The group put together an economic impact report on the plant, which is available at savebyron.com.

The loss of the Byron plant would mean the loss of more than 700 jobs. The plant also spreads plenty of tax money around the county. Paul Dempsey, communications manager of the Byron station, said that the station’s 2017 tax bill was more than \$38 million. The taxes went to a variety of taxing bodies, including the Byron School District, Ogle County and the Byron Museum and Library District.

Terry McGoldrick, president of Local IBEW 15, told the board that they are looking for a long-term agreement so they don’t have to do this again in a couple of years.

“This is very serious, and it will close if we don’t get something done,” said McGoldrick, who lives in Stillman Valley.

For its part, the county board did approve a resolution in support of the Byron plant.

It read, in part: “...be it resolved, by the County of Ogle, that we urge the State of Illinois to support policies to preserved Illinois’ nuclear energy plants, because of their support for our local economy by creating thousands of jobs, strengthening the commitment to a pollution and carbon-free environment, and ensuring a more reliable electric grid for consumers and businesses; while creating a sustainable energy future for generations...”

Mail-in ballots showing high returns

ROCHELLE — With the 2020 election less than two weeks away, residents across Ogle County and Illinois are taking advantage of early voting and mail-in voting opportunities as a way to remain involved in the political process safely due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

The U.S. Elections Project reported Friday that at least 52.4 million people in the United States have cast their ballots early for the 2020 election. That’s over 38 percent of the total votes counted in the 2016 election. Over 36 million people have cast their ballots through the mail this year, and over 85 million mail-in ballots have been requested by voters across America.

Illinois has seen roughly 2.3 million mail-in ballot requests and nearly 1.1 million mail-in ballots returned, according to the U.S. Elections Project. In Ogle County, over 21 percent of registered voters have requested mail-in ballots, and of the roughly 7,000 voters who have

requested mail-in ballots, almost 63 percent (or 4,429) have returned ballots successfully.

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Rotary Daily Cash Calendars are now available for purchase. For those unfamiliar with the club’s annual fundraiser, the Daily Cash Calendar is a way to give back to eight local non-profit organizations that benefit from the club’s From the Heart fundraiser as well as a chance to win a cash prize every day for a year.

Every calendar purchase gives a chance at winning daily cash prizes — a total of \$18,250 for the year. Prizes range from \$25 daily, \$50 each Sunday to \$250 and higher on holidays. Those whose names are drawn for New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day and

Christmas are awarded \$1,000.

The eight area non-profit organizations who receive large contributions from the sales of the calendars — and the From the Heart event held in February — are the Hub City Senior Center, Focus House, CASA, Shining Star, YMCA Child Care Center, Rochelle Christian Food Pantry, Rochelle Area Community Foundation, and HOPE of Ogle County.

“This is a very challenging year and we really need support from the community through the purchase of the cash calendars,” Rotarian Dave Eckhardt said.

RCH extends COVID-19 triage line hours

Appointments required for testing

ROCHELLE—Due to increased demand, Rochelle Community Hospital has announced that effective Monday, Oct. 26, COVID-19 Triage Line hours will be increased to 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. five days a week, Monday through Friday.

Non-emergent COVID-19 questions will be addressed by calling 815-561-8829 and an RCH nurse will be available for assistance. Callers will have the ability to leave a message and the call will be returned during the triage line hours of operation.

Patients who meet the criteria for COVID-19 testing through the COVID-19 Triage Line are scheduled with an appointment time. Testing volumes are increasing and RCH wants to emphasize that patients need to go through the triage line to schedule a COVID-19 testing appointment by calling 815-561-8829 instead of coming straight to the hospital.

To alleviate any confusion RCH wants to emphasize that patients should drive up to Entrance E (shown on the map). This is the Emergency Room entrance on Third Street. Follow the instructions provided and Lab personnel will meet scheduled patients.

Due to the onset of colder weather, COVID-19 testing will be moving

indoors in a safe environment at Entrance E.

The Mutual Aid Box Alarm System (MABAS) tent has returned and was recently erected on the South side of the hospital. With the increased positivity rate in the region which Rochelle is located, the tent was brought back


while the resources are still available and to provide an alternate testing site in the event that RCH needs to expand services.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended for 2019 were \$11,086,825. The proposed corporate and special purposes property taxes to be levied for 2020 are \$11,934,648. This represents a 7.6% increase from the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2019 were \$4,420,406. The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public commission leases for 2020 are \$4,503,586. This represents a 1.9% increase from the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended for 2019 were \$15,507,231. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2020 are \$16,438,234. This represents a 6.0% increase from the previous year.

"We're starting to see more ballots come through," Rochelle Postmaster Paul Charboneau said. "I've never seen an issue with mail-in voting. We treat every ballot as First Class mail and there isn't anything left in our office at the end of the day... I've been working with the postal service for 32 years and we've processed mail-in votes for every election throughout those 32 years."

Voting by mail first became prominent during the Civil War period. With many union soldiers on the frontlines, 19 states changed their laws to allow soldiers to vote absentee in the 1864 election between Abraham Lincoln and George McClellan. Voting by mail was highlighted once again during World War II, when the Soldier Voting Act of 1942 allowed troops to send ballots over to the United States from abroad. 3.2 million absentee votes were cast in the war.

The State of Illinois has presented clear guidelines voters must fol-

low in order to ensure their main-in ballots are completed and counted successfully. For Ogle County voters, the process begins with filling out a form designating where the voter's mail-in ballot application will be sent. Within a single business day, voters will receive their mail-in ballot application form, which must be completed correctly and mailed back to the Ogle County Clerk by Thursday, Oct. 29.

Within two business days, voters will receive their mail-in ballots, which must be completed and placed inside the certification envelope, which must be sealed, signed and mailed back to the Ogle County Clerk. Envelopes containing mail-in ballots must be postmarked by Election Day, Nov. 3, and they must be received within 14 days after the election (Nov. 17) to be counted.

Lastly, the voter's signature is confirmed with the signature on the voter's registration record.

"We take the ballot envelopes and place them in collection boxes with all the collection mail,"

Charboneau said. "The envelopes are then processed at our distribution centers in Palatine and Carol Stream. There are intelligent mail barcodes on the envelopes that provide timestamps and show when the ballots are processed. The election committee gets informa-

tion from the intelligent mail barcode that's on the envelope. Once the ballot envelopes are processed, they're sent back out to Oregon, which is where all of the mail-in ballots from Ogle County end up."

While mail-in voting has enabled millions of Americans to cast their ballots ahead of Election Day, some skeptics claim that excessive mail-in voting can lead to voter fraud or other forms of cheating. However, a recent op-ed published by The Hill revealed that over the last 20 years, over 250 million mail-in ballots have been cast and only 143 criminal convictions have been made for election fraud related to mail-in ballots. That's

a fraud rate of 0.00006 percent.

Charboneau said he hasn't witnessed any voter fraud or cheating throughout his time with the postal service. Additionally, while Charboneau said he plans to vote in person, he said the current pandemic could encourage more early and mail-in voting for future elections.

"We've had absentee and mail-in voting for quite a while and I've yet to see an issue with it," Charboneau said. "I'm personally going to vote in person, but I don't see an issue with mail-in voting and I don't see anything at the post office that could cause any issues with mail-in voting."

"There are intelligent mail barcodes on the envelopes that provide timestamps and show when the ballots are processed. 

Medical incident leads to accident

On Oct. 21 at 11:48 a.m., the Ogle County Sheriff's Office, the Leaf River Fire Department and the Leaf River Ambulance responded to a one vehicle accident with injuries in the 2,000 block of Illinois Route 72. Effective Sunday, Region 1 to see Tier 2 restrictions

ROCHELLE — Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker and state health officials announced Thursday that Region 1 of the IDPH healthcare map, which includes Winnebago, DeKalb, Carroll, Jo Daviess, Whiteside, Boone, Ogle, Stephenson and Lee counties, will see Tier 2 COVID-19 restrictions beginning Sunday, Oct. 25.

Region 1 has been under Tier 1 of the state's resurgence mitigation plan since Oct. 3 after seeing a seven-day rolling average test positivity rate of 8 percent or above for three consecutive days. Beginning Oct. 25, Region 1 will face additional mitigations, such as a tighter gathering cap of 10 individuals rather than 25 and new table caps of six rather than 10 when eating out.

"We've said all along that if things don't start to turn around after two weeks in Tier 1, we can add more stringent measures to help usher in the progress we need to see to get things more open again," Pritzker said. "That is now the case in Region 1, which has seen its positivity rise by nearly two points since Oct. 14 alone. Region 1, bordering Wisconsin and Iowa, carries the additional responsibility of navigating a situation where the massive surge of cases in our neighboring states will continue to have a spillover effect. There is no easy fix. So as colder weather comes upon us - and brings flu season along with it - it's imperative that we take extra caution and extra care. Because at the end of the day, this is bigger than you. This is about all of us, and the communities we call home. We have to take care of each other."

Region 1's positivity rate will be tracked by the IDPH to determine if and when restrictions can be relaxed or if additional restrictions are required. Region 1 can return to Phase 4 guidelines under the Restore Illinois Plan if the positivity rate averages less than or equal to 6.5 percent for three consecutive days. If the positivity rate averages between 6.5 and 8 percent, the new restrictions will remain unchanged. More restrictions can be applied if the positivity rate averages more than or equal to 8 percent after 14 days.

Restrictions

The COVID-19 restrictions taking effect on Sunday, Oct. 25 state that all bars and restaurants must close by 11 p.m. and remain closed until 6 a.m. the following day. No indoor bar or dining service will be allowed and all bar patrons should be seated at tables outside. No ordering, seating or congregating at the bars is allowed and bar stools should be removed. Tables must be 6 feet apart and no standing or congregating indoors or outdoors while waiting for a table or exiting.

No dancing or standing indoors and no seating of multiple parties at one table. No tables can exceed six people. Reservations are required for each party.

The COVID-19 restrictions taking effect on Sunday, Oct. 25 for meetings, social events and gatherings include limiting to 10 guests in both indoor and outdoor settings. These are applicable to professional, religious and cultural and social group gatherings. These are not applicable to students participating in-person classroom learning, sports or polling places. This does not reduce the overall facility capacity dictated by general business guidance. No party buses are allowed. Gaming and casinos must close at 11 p.m., be limited to 25 percent capacity and follow restrictions for bars and restaurants, if applicable.

The COVID-19 restrictions taking effect on Sunday, Oct. 25 for organized group recreational activities including sports, but excluding fitness centers, include limiting to lesser of 25 guests or 25 percent of overall room capacity both indoors and outdoors. No groups of more than 10 people are allowed and the All Sports Policy remains in effect. Outdoor activities continue to follow the current Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity guidance.

KEC has been busy adding offerings for high school students. The barbering class is now the eighth program added to the KEC catalog since 2012 along with emergency medical technician, esthetics, business leadership, sports medicine, basic firefighter operator, new

teacher academy and web development. KEC has over 20 programs total, with most offering college credit.

"We have been fortunate to have great post secondary partners like Northern Illinois University, Kishwaukee College, Waubesa Community College, Rock Valley College and Elgin Community College that all share the same passion with providing college credit and opportunities for high school students in our region through KEC," Crouch added. "The local businesses like the Legacy Academy, Hair Professionals and Debutantes that offer certificates and training for our future workforce is also a blessing."

Trusting God with every injustice

ARE you going through something difficult right now, experiencing pain or disappointment from a situation that just doesn't seem fair? In this world, so many things are not right, and you don't have to look far to find some kind of injustice.

But one of the things I love most about God is that He's a God of justice—He makes wrong things right.

I really love 1 Peter 2:23, which says that when Jesus was "reviled and insulted, He did not revile or insult in return; while suffering, He made no threats [of vengeance], but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges fairly" (AMP).

When we're being mistreated or enduring something difficult, it's easy to want to take matters into our own hands. However, the best thing we can do is say, "God, I'm going to trust You to be my vindicator."

Many people are used to trusting God for things—for a raise, for better health, or for the next great thing they would like to happen in their lives. But God also wants us to trust Him through things—when we're experiencing difficulties or when life isn't working out the way we hoped it would. Trusting God allows us to enjoy our lives

even when everything is not the way we want it to be.

For instance, maybe you've worked harder than ever at your job but still haven't received a promotion or a pay raise. Maybe a coworker who doesn't seem to work as hard as you gets the promotion you wanted. I know what this is like. Years ago when this happened to me, I immediately thought, It's not fair.

And I had a choice to make: I could choose to be angry and bitter toward the people involved and try to vindicate myself, or I could choose to trust God to make wrong things right, knowing that He could pay me back for any injustice done to me.

I want you to know I understand what it's like to have to make this choice, and that it's never easy. For the first 23 years of my life, I endured a lot of painful experiences that left me bitter, resentful, and constantly blaming other people.

As a child, I was sexually abused by my father. My mother eventually found out, but fear prevented her from confronting the issue, so the abuse went on for years. When I turned eighteen, I married

the first man who came along because I was convinced no other man would ever want me. But this only led to more pain. We ended up divorced after I discovered he was cheating on me with other women and was involved in criminal activities.

When we're hurt or mistreated, it's easy to have an attitude that says, Someone owes me. I sure did. For years, I tried to "collect" from people who had no way of paying me back. Because a man (my father) hurt me, I found myself trying to make other men pay. And it affected every area of my life in a destructive way.

Thankfully, as I began to read and study God's Word, I discovered that God wants to be our vindicator, and He can restore everything we've lost through injustices we've experienced.

Isaiah 61:7-8 (NIV) says, "Instead of your shame you will receive a double portion, and instead of disgrace you will rejoice in your inheritance. And so you will inherit a double portion in your land, and everlasting joy will be yours. For I, the Lord, love justice...." This is basically saying if we will trust God, He will give

us double for our trouble.

Through Scriptures like this, God helped me understand that no person can ever pay me back for what I went through—but He can. When I finally began trusting God to be my vindicator—when I got my eyes off of everyone else and focused on Him—it was truly amazing what He began to do in my life.

God wants to do the same thing for you. If someone mistreats you, refuse to stay mad at them and trust God to bring justice into your life. I can promise you this: If you'll stop trying so hard to get justice for yourself—to manipulate people and situations to get "what you deserve"—you'll be amazed at what God will do for you as you place all of your trust in Him.

So, whatever's going on in your life today—whatever you've endured and whatever doesn't seem fair—I want you to know that you're not invisible to God. He sees you, He knows exactly how much you can take, and He will deliver you at just the right time. He won't be a moment too late.

Remember, God is the only One Who can truly vindicate you. He is the God of justice, and He can take your wrong thing and make it right.



Ignoring this routine maintenance can put engines in jeopardy of breaking down and adversely affect vehicle performance, diminishing fuel economy and leading to a sluggish ride.

Identifies safety issues: Routine inspections and work performed by reputable service stations help drivers stay abreast of recalls or issues that can affect the safety of the vehicle.



Maintains a maintenance record: When the time comes to sell the vehicle, having a log of routine maintenance indicates to potential buyers that the vehicle was well cared for.

Keeps compliance: Vehicles covered under manufacturer's warranties typically need to be maintained in adherence to factory-recommended maintenance

schedules. This ensures that the vehicle is in compliance and will be covered in the event of a warranty claim.

Routine vehicle maintenance is important for a variety of reasons. Drivers can work with a trusted and reliable mechanic to develop a schedule that keeps their cars and trucks on the road.

How to effectively and safely sanitize a car

THE COVID-19 pandemic changed the way people live. One readily felt effect was spending more time at home. Vehicles sat idle in driveways and even some automotive insurance providers reduced rates because people were driving much less.

Wash hands. First and foremost, it is crucial to wash your hands before and after using the car. This can reduce the likelihood of growing ill because of transferred viruses or bacteria.

Use rubbing alcohol. Solutions that

contain 70 percent alcohol are effective against many viruses and bacteria, including coronaviruses, says the CDC. Furthermore, Jeff Stout, Executive Director of Global Innovation at Yanfeng Automotive Interiors, says that, for the most part, nearly every interior surface of a vehicle can be cleaned with isopropyl alcohol. Plastic to painted chrome to imitation leather have been tested to ensure they don't degrade when exposed to pure isopropyl alcohol.

Avoid bleach or hydrogen peroxide. While bleach and peroxide are very effective cleaners and sanitizers, they are likely to damage a car's upholstery, according to Consumer Reports.

Use soap and water: Experts say that vigorous washing with a soap-and-water solution can be effective against many contaminants because it breaks down the protective envelope that surrounds coronaviruses and other germs to disarm them. Friction also can help to break down germ cells during cleaning.

"You want to do the best with what you have, so even soap and water can chip away at the risk," says Stephen Thomas, M.D., Chief of Infectious Diseases and Director of Global Health at Upstate Medical University in Syracuse, NY.

Address frequently touched surfaces. Pay attention to the steering wheel, door handles, buttons, touchscreen displays, shift lever, and more when sanitizing. Each of these items can harbor germs.

Deep-cleaning a vehicle has become a necessity since COVID-19 emerged. Frequently cleaning and sanitizing can help make vehicles safer to operate.


Tire maintenance keeps drivers safe

Maintaining tires is an important component of safe driving. Tires are some of the hardest working parts on a car or truck and are subjected to wear and tear every time rubber meets the road.

Tires affect many components of driving, including handling, braking and the comfort of the ride. Maintaining tires makes driving safe not only for drivers and their passengers, but also for fellow motorists.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration says that, in 2017, 738 fatalities occurred because of tire-related crashes. Many of those crashes were no doubt preventable, and that only highlights the importance of maintaining tires and monitoring their performance.

Poor tire maintenance can lead to premature wear and potentially result in a blowout. The automotive group AAA notes it is important to visually inspect tires as often as possible. Drivers should look for overall tread wear. Pay special attention to tread wear on one edge of the tires, which could indicate poor



alignment. Erratic tread wear may mean tires are out of balance.

Drivers also should pay attention to how their cars drive and sounds. Unusual vibration or thumping noises suggest issues with the tires. A car that pulls in one direction also may be experiencing tire problems.

Vehicle owners should be aware of the routine maintenance steps that can keep them safe and improve the life expectancy of tires.

Tire pressure: The NHTSA says only 19 percent of consumers properly check and inflate their tires. Keeping tires properly inflated is one of the most important steps to maintaining them. Tires lose around 1 psi per month, and under-inflated or over-inflated tires can contribute to unusual wear, blowouts and even excessive fuel consumption.

Rotation: Check the owner's manual or recommendations from the tire manufacturer, but know

that most mechanics advise having tires rotated every 5,000 to 8,000 miles. Rotation helps distribute wear more evenly on tires.

Balancing: AAA says balancing also helps minimize uneven wear and tear. Balanced tires are achieved by using small weights attached to the wheels to limit vibration of the tire and wheels as they turn. New tires should be balanced, and tires also should be balanced after one or more is removed to repair a puncture.

Alignment: Vehicles have wheel alignment measurements that pertain to manufacturers' specifications. Alignment that falls outside of the range can impact handling, fuel economy and tread wear. A drift or pull suggests alignment problems and should be addressed.

Vehicle owners should keep tire inspection and maintenance in mind as part of their overall car care plan.

Staying prepared

Hub and Lady Hub programs taking advantage of fall contact days

ROCHELLE — Although the fate of the 2020-21 winter sports season remains in the balance, Rochelle Township High School's Hub and Lady Hub basketball programs are taking advantage of their fall contact days and preparing as if they'll be taking the courts this winter.

Lady Hubs looking to build on historic finish

Rochelle program trending upward after six-win season

ROCHELLE — The Lady Hub tennis team entered the 2020 season having won only four matches over the previous four years. After a historic finish at the IHSA 1A Rochelle Sectional this past weekend, the future of the Lady Hub tennis program is looking brighter than ever.

Rochelle finished third at the sectional tournament and medaled two doubles teams for the first time in school history. The postseason achievement highlighted a 6-12 campaign that saw the Lady Hubs secure nearly twice as many victories as they recorded between 2016-19. Rochelle also went 5-4 over its last nine matches, a sign that the best is yet to come for the Lady Hubs.

"I hope the girls continue to keep training, whether that means conditioning over the offseason or playing other sports," head coach Lizzie Cartwright said.

Jones reflects on first semester with Kish golf

ROCHELLE graduate Hayden Jones received his first taste of collegiate golf this fall, competing with the Kishwaukee College team under new head coach Thomas Brennan. Both Brennan and Jones are RTHS alums and former Hub golfers. Additionally, Brennan and Jones are both left-handers, and the two have already formed a strong bond over the first half of the golf season.

"It's been a blessing having the chance to be taught by coach Brennan," Jones said. "It really helps that we're both left-handed because he can show me things with his swing that I can apply to mine. It's also great that we can talk about our past experiences playing for RTHS."

Jones was one of five men to hit the tees for the Kishwaukee College golf program this fall. The Kougars competed in five events throughout September and October, with the season scheduled to resume in the spring with six more matches as well as the NJCAA Nationals. Jones opened the season with 197 over 36 holes in the Skyhawk Classic at Byron's PrairieView Golf Club before carding 172 in the IVCC Fall Classic at Seneca's Oak Ridge Golf Course.

"I think the first semester went great," Jones said. "I learned a lot from coach Brennan that I think will definitely help me moving forward. I enjoyed playing with my new teammates and they were really easy to get along with. I thought my course management improved the most. Depending on where I was on the course, I was able to hit certain shots as opposed to just walking up and hitting the ball. I want to improve my ball striking so I can shape my shots."

Jones concluded the fall season with 277 across two days and 54 holes at the NJCAA Region IV Championships at PrairieView Golf Club. A former multi-

sport student-athlete at RTHS, Jones plans to play golf and baseball for the Kougars during the spring semester. The Kishwaukee baseball team will begin its season against Frontier Community College on Feb. 26, 2021.

"It's been a while since I played baseball because of COVID-19, so I'm excited to get back out there," said Jones, who recently spent one year with the TCS Post-Grad Academy in McKinney, Texas. "I plan to make baseball a priority but I will still play golf whenever I can."





Basketball has been deemed a medium-risk sport by the Illinois Department of Public Health, meaning student-athletes can conduct intra-squad scrimmages but no competitive play. All medium-risk sports are currently at Level 2 of the IDPH All Sports Policy, with Level 3 allowing for conference and COVID-regional contests only. Low-risk sports such as golf, tennis and cross country are currently competing at Level 3 because they are deemed low-risk by the state.

Players who scrimmage indoors are also required to wear masks under the IHSA Fall Contact Day Guidelines. Masks haven't been an issue for student-athletes at RTHS, though, and both coaches said players have adjusted to wearing masks while working out on the basketball court.

"I think masks will be here to stay for a while," Rowan said. "They're something we can whine about but it won't change anything. COVID-19 is a serious issue and we're enforcing the mask policy. I think wearing masks will

prepare the girls for whatever comes our way, but it will be important for us to continue having a positive attitude as we move forward."

"The kids have been great with the masks," Thompson said. "Wearing masks during the summer and getting the feel for wearing masks helped us. There were some complaints about the masks being uncomfortable during the summer, but the kids have adjusted well and I rarely hear anything from them. We want the kids to be safe, but we're not going to change the way we play, and so if kids need to come out of the game a bit earlier, then we'll sub them out."

The IHSA Board of Directors has scheduled a special meeting on Oct. 28, when administrators are expected to make an announcement regarding winter sports for the 2020-21 season. Regardless of what happens over the next few weeks, Thompson and Rowan have stressed being positive and staying prepared as they remain optimistic for the season to start on time.



Times for Nov. 4, Nov. 11 games vs. Buffalo, Central Michigan set

DEKALB — The Northern Illinois University Huskies will kick off the 2020 football season versus the University at Buffalo at Huskie Stadium on Wednesday, Nov. 4 at 6 p.m. (CT) in a game that will air on ESPN2, as the Mid-American Conference announced the game times and television schedule for the first

two weeks of midweek #MAAction contests on Monday.

One week later, on Wednesday, Nov. 11, NIU will play host to Central Michigan at 7 p.m. (CT) on ESPN2. For the rest of the regular season, game times and broadcast networks will be announced 12-13 days in advance with nearly all of the

Tuesday and Wednesday #MAAction games slated for broadcast on ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or CBS Sports Network.

Once league teams transition to Saturday games beginning on Nov. 28, games will be on one of the ESPN platforms or on CBS Sports Network.

NIU is no stranger to the television cameras

with seven games on an over-the-air network a year ago and 10 in 2018. The Huskies are 24-11 all-time on ESPN2, including a 1-1 mark last season, and have a 12-9 record on ESPNU.



McGee and teammate Sylvia Hasz shined at the sectional tournament, medaling in third place

and helping Rochelle to its best team performance since 2010.
