Truck takes down utility pole

ROCHELLE — No one suffered serious injuries Friday afternoon after a truck struck a utility pole on Illinois Route 251 in Hillcrest.

According to reports, the accident occurred around 2:45 p.m. when a pickup truck traveling northbound left Illinois Route 251 near Hemstock Road, struck culvert and then crashed into a utility pole. The

pole then fell into the roadway.

Sparks then caught brush in the ditch on fire, burning approximately 50 yards of grass before firefighters from Rochelle and Hillcrest arrived on scene.

RMU was called to the scene to cut power to the downed pole and restore power to the area of Hillcrest affected by the accident.

ROCHELLE — The Foundation for Focus House and Community Programming of Rochelle was forced to cancel its annual car show and parade this year, but it is moving forward with its plan to host the car show virtually.

The car show this year is free to enter and is open to any type of classic old vehicle, whether it be a car, pickup truck or motorcycle. Participants are asked to send in one photo of their vehicle to jhardin@oglecounty.org.

Contact information such as an address and phone number, as well as the make and model of the vehicle, should also be included in the



email. The deadline to send in a vehicle photo is Sept. 10 and there is no limit to the amount of people who can participate.

"We had to cancel the outdoor car show and parade out of concern for the community, but

we are very excited to try this out," Foundation for Focus House President Dave Tess said. "I have been dealing with old cars since my brother got me my first one when I was 16 years old and I have never seen anything like this done."

Once all photos have been received, they will be compiled into one photo album and uploaded onto Facebook. Voting will begin on Sept. 14 and run through Sept. 27, with individuals either clicking the like or heart icon on their favorite vehicle in the album. The one that receives the most attention will be chosen as the winner.

Plant loss would hurt economy

700 jobs, tax money, donations would be lost locally

BYRON — If the Byron Generating Station does close in September 2021, it will mean more than a loss of about 700 jobs.

It will also mean the loss of millions of dollars in taxes locally.

Exelon Generation announced on Aug. 27 that it intends to retire its Byron Generating Station and Dresden Generating Station in fall 2021. Byron will close in September 2021.

Paul Dempsey, communications manager of the Byron station, said that the station's 2017 tax bill was more than \$38 million. The taxes went to a variety of taxing bodies, including the Byron School District, Ogle County and the Byron Museum and Library District.

There are also the charitable donations giving by the station, which Dempsey said amount to about \$250,000. Donations have gone to Rock River Center in Oregon, Pinecrest Community in Mount Morris, Hub City Senior Center and many others.

In July, the station donated \$9,000 to libraries in Ogle County. And in June it donated \$35,000 to local food banks.

"We need Byron Station in our community. It provides 700 good-paying jobs, over \$38 million in taxes, and supports our local schools, fire departments, forest preserves, and park districts... It also provides clean, carbon-free energy to 2.3 million homes and businesses in our area."

Sarah Downs, executive director of the Byron Chamber of Commerce, said that the community has been well aware that Exelon has been sounding the alarm for years that its zero-carbon Byron and Dresden plants are uneconomic to operate and would likely shut down early to prevent further financial losses.

"We need Byron Station in our community," she said. "It provides 700 good-paying jobs, over \$38 million in taxes, and

supports our local schools, fire departments, forest preserves, and park districts. It's a key source of business for our local retailers and restaurants. It also provides clean, carbon-free energy to 2.3 million homes and businesses in our area. We

implore state leaders to take action to save Byron Station from early retirement next year."

The Byron Forest Preserve District received \$2.3 million in tax money from the Byron Station last year.

"The Exelon Generation Byron Station is obviously an important part of the greater Byron/Oregon community," said Todd Tucker, executive director of the Forest Preserve District. "The Byron Forest Preserve District alone receives nearly 75 cents of every property tax operating dollar from the Byron Nuclear Plant."

Tucker pointed out that the money the district has received over the past 35 years has made it possible for it to preserve more than 2,300 acres of natural land for nine preserves, develop the PrairieView Golf Club, Jarrett Prairie Center, Keller Education Center and our the PrairieFire Golf facility.

"Their support has made it possible each year to offer education programs and recreation opportunities for thousands of school aged children, individuals and families in the Rockford Region and beyond," Tucker said. "We currently employ 22 full time staff who operate top-notch facilities thanks to this tax support."

And while the news of the proposed closure is clearly causing concern in the region, Tucker said now is not the time to panic.

"We are hopeful that there is still time for our legislators in Springfield to work out some sort of agreement with Exelon to lessen the impact both for our organization and

the entire Northern Illinois Region," he said.

The Oregon Park District received \$2.7 million in taxes in 2019, with 78 percent of that coming from taxes paid by Exelon. Park District Executive Director Erin Folk said the plant closure will significantly impact the people employed by the Oregon Park District, the residents it serves and the services it provides.

"The District has made many decisions over the past 10 years in preparation for a potential reduction in taxes, but the plant closure will be devastating to our District, the other taxing bodies and Ogle County," she said. "We are hopeful the State of Illinois will address potential legislative needs to aid in keeping the plant open. Many decisions will need to be made over the course of the coming months and

we will continue to act in the best interest of the District as we navigate through this difficult time."

And many of the 700 employees at the plant live in and pay taxes in the county. Dempsey said as of February 2019, 130 employees lived in Byron, 55 in Oregon, 36 in Stillman and at least 10 each in Davis Junction, Mount Morris and Rochelle. The others live in cities including Rockford and Dixon.

"No words can describe the loss that would be deeply felt if the decision to shut down the Byron Nuclear plant can't be changed," said Oregon Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Liz Vos. "Exelon consistently gives back to our communities. So many communities are literally and figuratively powered by this company."

I also notice there are some that might benefit from a little TLC.

Wouldn't it be great if there was a program to provide interest free loans to people who want to make improvements to homes over 100 years old? I don't see the city or state initiating a program like that because I don't think the dollars are there to make the loans.

I do think it would benefit current residents and potential residents who are attracted to older homes in smaller towns.

Sinissippi Centers received support for staffing and basic needs for clients in assisted living situations. The Village of Progress utilized support to stay connected with those they serve while quarantine and social distancing made it impossible to gather.

Not crying not an option at daughter's wedding

Itold myself I wasn't going to cry. Not only that, I wasn't going to even tear up.

I have been known to cry from time to time. I will admit I was a bit of a crybaby when I was a kid, but I have always been pretty emotional. I get it honestly, as I come from a family of emotional people, i.e. criers.

But this was my daughter's wedding, held recently in Du-luth, Minn., and the last thing I wanted to do was cry. There is this tradition I had never heard of called "first look," where she comes into the room as I have my back turned, taps me on the shoulder and I turn around. The photographer captures the mo-

ment I see her in her dress for the first time.

I told my wife I was not going to cry, and I actually believed it until the moment my little girl tapped me on the shoulder, I turned around and saw her in her beautiful wedding dress.

OK, I didn't totally lose it, but it was pretty close. And I am sure this was not some masculine moment with a few tears of joy. I didn't blubber exactly, but I am not looking forward to seeing the pictures.

But how could I not get a little weepy? Here was my little girl, my only girl — the only girl in my family — in a wedding dress on the day of her wedding. Here is the little angel that I held in my arms the day she came home from the hospital. Here was the little girl who walked and talked way early, who loved Halloween candy probably too much and who got anything she wanted when she called me daddy.

Her mother and I divorced long ago, but my daughter and I have remained close. We still talk probably three or four times a week and always have, no matter what is happening in our lives. We talked through high school, through college, when she was getting her first teaching job. We also talked the day she was going to meet some kid she was talking to online who lived in Du-luth. I was, of course, not thrilled about her going up there, but she was an adult and I trusted her.

Well, that young man is now my son-in-law. And he is a great guy. He is in the Air Force, like I was, so how could I not like him?

We talked a lot about the wedding, and as COVID-19 hit, she was always unsure whether it would go on or not. Ultimately it did. We all had to wear masks except when we were eating or drinking, and it didn't hurt the

ceremony or the reception one bit. In fact, it probably made it a little more special.

Walking my daughter down the aisle was a thrill for me. I am so proud of the woman she has become. She is a funny, warm, open and accepting person. As we walked slowly down the aisle, I looked at her husband-to-be. All he saw was her. It was such a look of love than any father would feel comforted about giving this man the hand of his daughter.

My brother flew in from Arizona to perform the ceremony. My other brother flew in from California, so we had a little reunion. It was a night to remember for many reasons.

So now my daughter has a different last name. Yes, it is a little weird, but I am getting used to it.

In fact, when I think about it, I can't help but shed a little tear of joy. I am a crier after all.

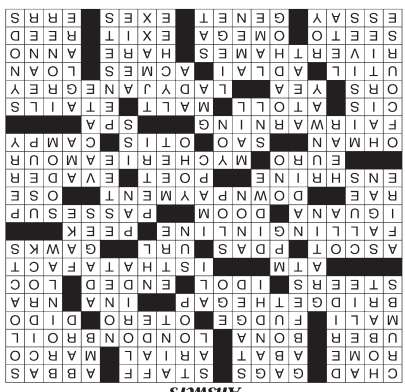

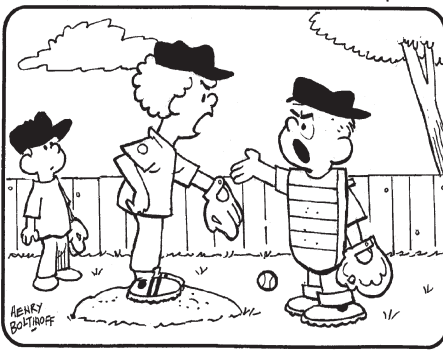

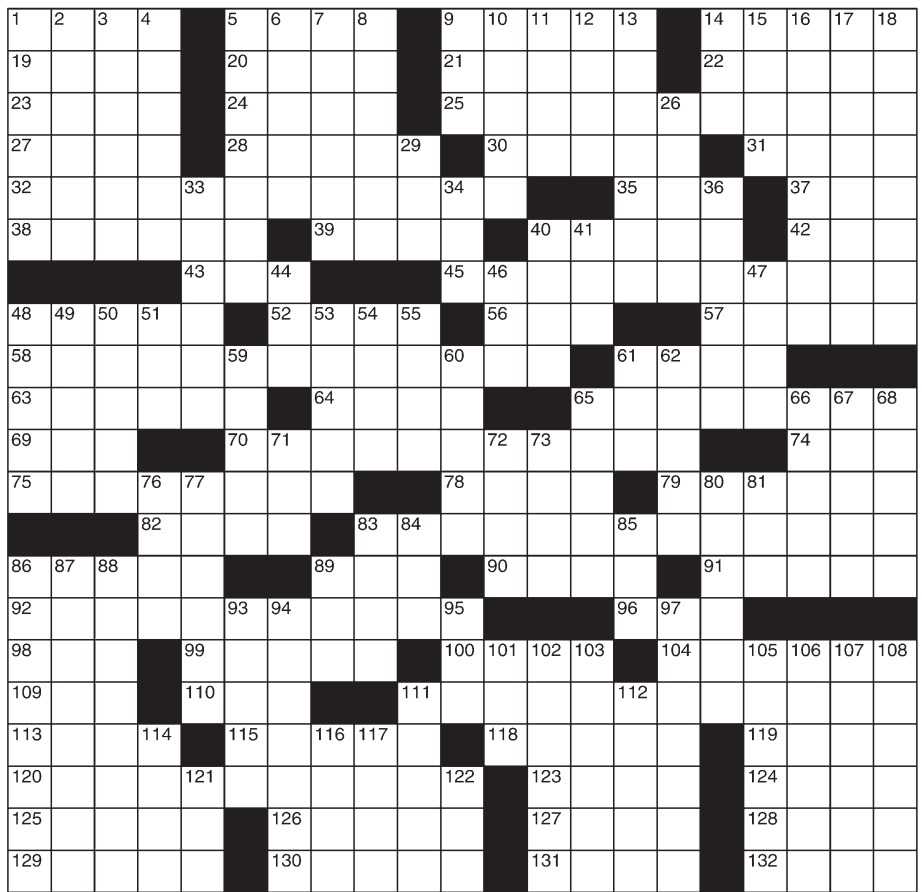

Celebrate Labor Day

Exploring the origins of Labor Day

LABOR Day marks the unofficial end of summertime fun and a day when thousands of people gather across the country for their final big barbecue blowouts. Labor Day has evolved into a holiday about relaxing with friends and family, and that has led to its origins getting somewhat lost in the celebratory shuffle.

Created by the labor movement in the late 19th century, Labor Day was established to highlight the achievements of American workers, both from a social and an economic perspective. Labor Day highlights one of the main benefits of being a citizen of the United States, the ability to have professional freedom and contribute to the prosperity and strength of the country through gainful employment. Labor Day became a federal holiday in 1894.

Celebrated annually on the first Monday of September, it is believed that Labor Day was first promoted by the Central Labor Union and the Knights of Labor, which also organized the first labor-related parade in New York City.

Although the true fathers of Labor Day remain a topic of debate, some historians maintain that Peter J. McGuire of the American Federation of Labor put forward the first Labor Day proposal in May 1882 after witnessing a labor festival in Toronto, Canada.


Labor Day was largely celebrated in the past with parades, speeches and a day off of work for the country's workers. Similar festivities occur to this day, with the gradual introduction of other events that mark the unofficial end of summer.

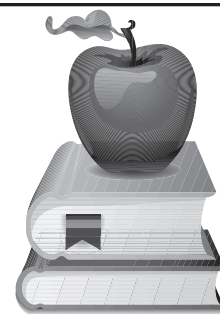

Johnson wins, Hubs take first in four-team meet at Walcamp

KINGSTON — Sara Johnson could feel the fatigue building in her legs as she pushed through the trails at Walcamp Park on Thursday. The Rochelle Township High School cross country standout didn't lose her focus, however, and her perseverance resulted in a first-place finish when the Hubs and Lady Hubs faced Genoa-Kingston, North Boone and West Carroll.

It was the first individual victory in a high school meet for Johnson, who finished with a time of 22:27 despite racing for the second time in two days. The Lady Hub junior was one of three Rochelle girls who recorded top-6 finishes on Thursday, with sophomores Yuelma Ortiz and Ahtziri Zepeda placing third (23:10) and sixth (24:22), respectively.

"I felt really strong today and it was incredible to win my first

race," Johnson said. "The course was pretty tough. There was an incline during the second mile that was pretty tough, but it was a nice course overall. My legs and arms were definitely sore, but once the gun went off at the start of the race, I was in running mode and I forgot about everything else."

Johnson and the Lady Hubs (2-2) finished second out of three teams competing Thursday, scoring 40 points. Genoa-Kingston won the meet with 27 points, while West Carroll took third with 66 points and North Boone did not field a varsity team. Rochelle's boys remained perfect on the season, winning a tiebreaker with North Boone thanks to a strong performance from freshman Luis Pizano, whose time of 21:41 put the Hubs (4-0) over the top.

"The kids ran really well today and I'm really proud of our team," head coach Mark Zilis said.

Brennan named head golf coach at Kishwaukee College

PLAYING for Kishwaukee College wasn't an option for local golfer Thomas Brennan when he was closing out his accomplished high school career just over a decade ago. That will change this coming school year, however, and Brennan will be tasked with leading the Kougar and Lady Kougar golfers in the program's first season back since prior to 2010.

Brennan has been hired as the head coach of the Kishwaukee College men's and women's golf teams, which will compete during the 2020-21 school year in Region IV of the NJCAA. Brennan, who competed collegiately at the College of Lake County and Hannibal-LaGrange University, an NAIA program, has been coaching for the last several years, spending five seasons at Hannibal-LaGrange and one season at Johnson & Wales University's Denver campus.

"My wife and I were looking to move back to the area and I had been talking with Mitch [Hamilton] at Fairways since I had been planning to help run some tournaments and junior golf camps," Brennan said. "He let me know that the coach Kishwaukee College had initially hired resigned in June, so I reached out to the athletic director and we had a couple of good interviews. It's a good fit for me, and Kishwaukee will be using Fairways as its home course."

A Rochelle native, Brennan led the Hubs to two straight IHSA 2A Sectional appearances during the 2007 and 2008 seasons. He began his collegiate career at Nicholls State University in 2009 before transferring to the College of Lake County and finishing at Hannibal-LaGrange. Brennan immediately made the leap to coaching in 2014, when HLGU hired him to lead the program.

"It will be a different type of experience with the Kishwaukee College program," Brennan said. "We're going to have a much greater emphasis on recruiting local athletes... What I'm going to enjoy most about coaching at Kishwaukee College is giving local players an opportunity to compete that I didn't have in high school. We had a lot of good players on our team when I was in high school, but we had to spread out because Kishwaukee didn't have a program."

Brennan guided the HLGU golf program to nine tournament victories throughout his five years as the university's head coach. He was also responsible for doubling the program's men's roster size and for bringing in the No. 1 ranked NAIA freshman class for the 2017-18 season, according to GolfStat. Brennan earned a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in 2014.

A local champion, Brennan has won multiple Fairways club titles, and he continues to compete in tournaments outside of coaching. His experience and vast knowledge of the Rochelle course will be very useful to the Kougar and Lady Kougar players this coming season.

"Coaching gives me time to continue competing while also helping kids improve and become successful golfers," Brennan said. "I know what kids are looking for in a program and I want our program to be as player-friendly as possible while maintaining high standards for work ethic and academics. I want our kids to have fun on the golf course. It doesn't matter what they shoot when they arrive. What I look for is how much they're improving."

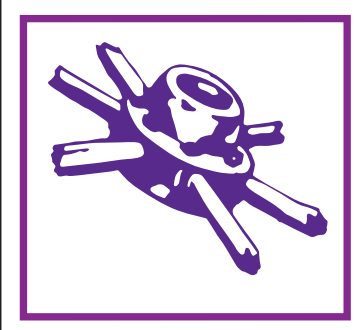

Varsity team records season-low 169 to beat Oregon, North Boone

OREGON — The Rochelle Hubs are playing their best golf of the season, and their efforts resulted in a dominant sweep of their three-team matchup with the Oregon Hawks and the North Boone Vikings at Silver Ridge Golf Course on Wednesday.

“Dominic’s a great ball striker,” Mehrings said. “He has a really strong release through the ball and he can drive the ball over 300 yards. He only had one wayward drive today, and driving the ball long and straight really put him in a

position to succeed, especially on a shorter course. . . Griffin’s all-around skills have improved so much. His mishits are tighter and he’s working through his putting, but he’s taking his time before shots and his ball striking has been solid.

He’s giving himself a lot more chances for birdies and pars as opposed to big numbers.”

Wednesday’s round continued a strong trend in the right direction for the Hubs, who recently recorded 171 in a home

victory against Plano this past week. Rochelle will look to keep posting quality scores this weekend, when the Hubs compete in the Rocket Invitational at Rock Falls.

“After shooting in the 170s last week, I knew

we could get into the 160s this week,” Mehrings said. “We had a few hiccups out there, but our kids were really solid and our top four players have really carried us so far. It’s nice to see our kids collectively improve as a group.”
