Former Hub student-athlete training to become submariner

AFTER graduating from Rochelle Township High School in 2018, Blake Albers attended Kishwaukee College to continue both his academics and his baseball career. A former three-sport athlete for the Hubs, Albers spent one year with the Kougars, and while he enjoyed his time with the team, he felt deep down that school wasn't the right place for him.

Albers spent this past fall working multiple jobs, but an opportunity to find his direction arose when his father Brian approached him about enlisting with the U.S. Navy. Albers, whose grandfather Sherel Dean Albers was in the U.S. Navy, decided to move forward with enlisting, and after completing boot camp during the summer, Albers recently graduated from Basic Enlisted Submarine School at the New London Naval Submarine Base in Groton, Connecticut.

"It feels good to be called a submariner," Albers said. "I left home in May and it's been a long, hard process for me... I loved playing baseball at Kishwaukee and I made a lot of great friends there. I liked the coaching staff a lot, but I didn't see college as my way forward. I worked two jobs during the fall, and then my dad asked me about visiting the U.S. Navy office and seeing what they have to offer, since my grandfather was a gunner's mate for four years."

Registering to vote in Illinois can be confusing: Here's a breakdown

THIS Election Day is significant in Illinois because voters will have the chance, for the first time in 50 years, to tell state leaders whether they want their taxes raised and whether they trust state lawmakers with greater power to set their tax rates.

But before anyone gets to cast that vote, they may need a guide to navigating the confusing voting process. The important first step in making anyone's voice heard is registering to vote.

Who can vote in Illinois?

You must:
Be a citizen of the United States
Be a resident of Illinois and of your precinct at least 30 days before the election
Be at least 18 years old on or before the next election
Cannot be serving a sentence in prison
Cannot be voting anywhere else
How can I tell if I'm registered to



vote?

Not sure if you're already registered? The easiest way to see if you've registered to vote is by checking online. The Illinois State Board of Elections has an online tool Illinoisans can use. To check, you simply add in your name, date of birth and address. If you are already registered, you are good to go.

How do I register to vote in Illinois?

There are a couple routes you can take to register to vote. Regardless, you must ensure you're registered in a timely manner. Regular registration is open year-round, but ends 27 days prior to the election, on Oct. 6.

What do I need to register to vote?

Federal law requires some form of identification for first-time registration. Valid identification could include a state-issued ID or a copy of a utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or another government document showing your name and address.

Illinois does not require a voter to declare a political party to vote in a General Election. Although the option exists to pick a party, it is not required.

You will be required to sign your voter registration card.

A person who is 17 may register to vote if they will turn 18 on or before Election Day.

How do I register

online to vote?

Online registration is available until 16 days before the election on the Illinois State Board of Elections website. In order to register online, a person must have completed their registration by 11:59 p.m. on Oct. 18. When filling out the registration form, the voter will need to input some personal information such as their driver's license, age, name and address.

How can I register by mail to vote?

To register by mail, you may print out this form from the U.S. Election Assistance Commission and mail it to the Illinois State Board of Election at this address:

You will be required to submit identification with your mail-in form. If you do not submit the necessary identification, you will be required to show it in person when you vote, and you will not be eligible to vote by mail.

Additionally, mail-in registration forms must be postmarked by Oct. 6.

How do I register in person to vote?

If you miss the online or mail-in voter registration windows, you may also register in person during the "grace period" starting Oct. 7 and extending through Election Day, Nov. 3.

Each county has designated locations where a person can register to vote. It is best to check out your local county clerk's website or call their office to find a place near you. Typically in addition to the county clerk's office, you can register in-person at city and village offices, public libraries, and locations that are set up as permanent and temporary voting locations.

Voting in Ogle County

OREGON — Ogle County Clerk, Laura J. Cook, announced that her office complies with the Federal Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act.

The Ogle County Courthouse is accessible to disabled citizens for voter registration. If you are unable to go to a Deputy Registrar, we will send a deputy registrar to the residence of any person who wishes to register to vote.

Voter registration

Any Ogle County resident who has never registered in Ogle County, has moved within the county, or has had a change of name since the last election must be registered with the correct name and address if they wish to vote in this election. First time registrants shall (by Nov. 3, 2020 General Election) have resided in their precinct for 30 days and must be 18 years of age on or before the Nov. 3, 2020 General Election. The last day to register to vote or change your

address for the November 3, 2020 General Election is Oct. 6 (with the exception of grace period voter registration beginning Oct. 7 and ending Nov. 2 in the office of the Ogle County Clerk.)

Vote by Mail

All properly registered voters are eligible to Vote by Mail. An Application to "Vote by Mail" can be downloaded by visiting the Ogle County official website at www.oglecounty.org by going to the "I Want To" tab, select "Application for Vote by Mail." This application must be filled out and mailed or hand delivered to the county clerk's office, who will then mail the Vote by Mail ballot to the voter. After voting the Vote by Mail ballot it must be mailed or hand delivered back to the county clerk's office so it can be counted on Election Day.

The first day to apply for a Vote by Mail ballot was Aug. 5 for the Nov. 3 General Election. The first day to mail a Vote by Mail ballot is Sept. 24 with the last day for mailing a ballot from the county clerk's office being Oct. 29. Early voting in person at the county clerk's office may be done through Nov. 2 until 4:30 p.m.

Early Voting

Early voting will be conducted at the Ogle County Clerk's Office located at the Ogle County Courthouse, 105 S. 5th St., Oregon, Sept. 24 thru Nov. 2 for all Ogle County precincts. Voting hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, Oct. 31 from 9 a.m. to noon.

Early voting will be conducted at the Flagg Township Building located at 303 W. Illinois Route 38 in Rochelle Oct. 28 thru Oct. 30 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Oct. 31 from 9 a.m. to noon, for Flagg and Dement precincts only.

If there are any voters in Ogle County who cannot get into the polling place, we can send two Judges of Election within 50 feet of the polling place with the ballot. A request should be made prior to the election on a form provided by the county clerk's office.

Regular office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Call 815-732-1110 for more information.

*The last date a requested Vote by Mail ballot can be mailed is Oct. 29 to a voter - This will NOT be enough time for the voter to receive their ballot and have it POSTMARKED by Nov. 3, 2020. We ask that they apply for the Vote by Mail ballot as soon as possible due to the mail time.



"We have accepted 6,013 Vote by Mail applications which is about 19.5 percent of registered voters in Ogle County. There will be a secure drop box for Vote by Mail ballots installed on the west side of the courthouse. Due to the security requirements needed for a drop box location, this will be the only one in Ogle County."

Albers began his journey with six weeks of boot camp in the summer before starting BESS, where enlisted

us back up. We were doing something new everyday during boot camp, but we spent a lot of time in the classroom during BESS."

With boot camp and

sailors are introduced to the basics of submarine operation. His training included three high-risk trainers: Damage control, where sailors learn to patch leaks and seal ruptured pipes, submarine escape, where sailors learn how to escape from a disabled submarine well under water, and fire-fighting, where sailors learn and practice containing ship and surface fires.

"We learn a little about everything because we always have to be prepared for any situation," Albers said. "If there's a break in the pressure hull or a fire, we have to know how to fix and deal with those problems. We learn about everything from the control room to the sanitary tanks... During boot camp, they tore us down and built

BESS completed, Albers is currently in a waiting period before he will begin three additional months of accession training, also known as A School. There, Albers will receive training specific to his MOS, or Military Occupational Specialty. After A School, Albers

and other sailors will receive their assignments and relocate to their designated stations.

"I've met a lot of great people during boot camp and BESS," Albers said. "We're with each other all of the time and we're always there for each other if one of us is having a bad day... Whether it was during boot camp or BESS, we were always together and we made sure every person was doing well. Our instructors and commanding officers do everything in their power to help us out."

Choosing words to improve your life

I remember when my grandson, who was three years old at the time, got ahold of a sheet of paper that had pictures of me on it, and he decorated it with all sorts of colorful stickers. When he came over to my house to surprise me with it, I couldn't help but notice that in just about every picture, there was a sticker over my mouth. I thought: Well, God, are you trying to tell me something?

It actually made me pay attention to the way I was talking. And that's something we all should do, because there is no part of us that's harder to control than the mouth. The Bible says that no man can tame the tongue (James 3:8). But that doesn't mean we can never improve the way we speak. We just need to partner with God to bring about the change we want to see.

The words we say are so important because they impact the anointing of the Holy Spirit that is, the power and presence of God—in our lives. The power of God is the most precious thing we have, and it's something we need to know how to protect. One of the ways we can hinder God's

anointing is by speaking with a mixture of faith and doubt. When we say a few positive, faith-filled words here, and a few negative, doubtful words there, it weakens God's anointing on our lives.

If we want to have God's power working in us and through us each day, then we have to be in agreement with God not just part of the time, but all of the time.

Without the anointing, everything is hard. And that's not what God wants for us. Jesus said, "My yoke is easy and my burden is light" (Matthew 11:30 NIV).

God will never ask us to do anything without giving us the ability to do it, and He has equipped us with everything we need to live a powerful, victorious life. Acts 1:8 (NIV) says, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses...to the ends of the earth."

Let's make this practical. Here are a few ways you can use words to protect God's anointing on your life:

Don't judge other people. For example,

if you want God's anointing to be on you for parenting, you need to be careful not to criticize other parents.

Don't complain. The Israelites wasted forty years murmuring and complaining in the wilderness, when they could have just obeyed God and entered into their Promised Land a lot sooner.

Don't ask God for someone else's anointing or to be like them. Embrace the abilities He has given to YOU.

Think for a moment how your words could be affecting your life right now. How do you talk about yourself, your present circumstances and your future? When you talk with your friends, what kinds of things are you talking about?

Ask God to help you form a habit of speaking positive words of faith every day. Words like, "I love my life and I have a great future. I can do whatever I need to do through Christ who strengthens me. And something good is going to happen to me today."

Even when you're struggling to believe it, say it anyway. Because your words have the power to change your mind and your attitude when they agree with the truth in God's Word.

You'll also find that you have the joy and peace that come through simply believing the promises of God.

In Luke 1, God sent the angel Gabriel to tell Zacharias that he and his wife, Elizabeth, would have a son who would be anointed to be the forerunner of the Messiah.

Zacharias should have been so excited. But rather than believe the good news, he questioned the promise. So God supernaturally shut his mouth until the day his son was born.

If you want to live in the fullness of God's anointing, fill your mouth with His Word. Don't just carelessly speak what you think or feel or what other people say. You can have the promises of God fulfilled in your life if you will learn to come into agreement with Him, do what He tells you to do, and say what He says.

Covid-19 has killed 8,508 Illinois residents as of Wednesday morning. That is almost the population of Rochelle. Many of these people were elderly; maybe your parents' age or your grandparents' age. Some of them were in their 20s and a few even in their teens and younger.

Many of them had pre-existing conditions: diabetes, heart issues, immune system problems, asthma. Many of them were healthy.

Nurses, doctors, store clerks, teachers, truck drivers, first responders, janitors and police officers all among the victims.

A group of doctors and scientists say the most effective ways of containing and slowing the disease include wearing a mask, maintaining social distancing, avoiding large gatherings, and washing hands often.

But there is also a group of people who just don't believe it's a problem, certainly no worse than the flu. They do not get their information from a large group of scientists and doctors.

It just confuses me that we have a population in our country that doesn't believe the scientists and experts. Also, that same population doesn't particularly care about the health of the rest of us.

It makes no sense.

I saw an article on the Fair Tax Amendment that fascinated me. Texas has about twice as many people as Illinois and almost five times the land mass. Texas also has 5,000 units of government.

Illinois has over 8,000 units of government. In those units of government are about 852 school districts. Of those, 211 are single school districts, much like our high school, and 31 are districts with less than 100 students.

There are also 1,400 townships, and approximately 300 park and library boards.

That's a lot of different taxing units.

I would not want to see park districts and library districts consolidated into a city government because if money is tight, parks and books might be looked at as nonessential needs and those budgets cut.

And, I know schools are the center in places such as Kings, Steward and Lindenwood.

Somehow, the cost of government has to be reduced without drastically affecting our safety and services.

It's time to vote no for Kilbride's retention to the Illinois Supreme Court

The next election on Nov. 3 has many important races, including one that you might not be aware of. Illinois Supreme Court Justice Thomas Kilbride is up for retention. If we vote to retain him, he will have 10 more years on the Illinois Supreme Court.

Meeting Mt. Morris near Mt. Rushmore

I was standing at a scenic stop on Iron Mountain Road in the Black Hills of South Dakota when a few motorcycle riders approached me and the friend I was traveling with.

"Where in Illinois are you from?" he asked, saying he saw the license plates on our bikes.

We said Rockford. He said he and his wife were from Mount Morris. Another rider was from Rockford and the final one from Rockford.

Talk about a small world.

This was day three of a 2,685-mile motorcycle ride a friend of mine, Doug, and I took through Iowa, Minnesota, South Dakota, Wyoming and Montana. Meeting Roger Miller, his wife and friends was a very surreal moment in a trip filled with beauty and memorable moments.

The day before we rode Iron Mountain Road, I was able to see Mount Rushmore for the first time. I must say, I was overwhelmed by this monument. It is truly majestic. I encourage anyone who hasn't seen it to make the trip.

The next day we rode all over the Black Hills. Besides the beautiful twist and turns of Iron Mountain Road, we rode

Needles Highway, with rocks shooting out of the ground skyward, hairpin turns and a narrow road cut through rock. Then on to the Wildlife Trail, where we saw buffalo – yes, they are huge – wild burros and big horn sheep.

As a history buff, day four was one I was really looking forward to. We rode from Spearfish, S.D., up to the Little Bighorn Battlefield in Montana. I have read multiple books on the battle at the Little Bighorn – from the perspective of the Army and the Native Americans.

This is a very sobering place. You can stand at the top of Last Stand Hill, where Lt. Col. (his regular Army rank) George Custer and members of the 7th Cavalry were killed during the battle. From the hill, you can look down to where a large Native American encampment was, and imagine the battle raging on the hills and plains.

For anyone interested in that moment in history, this national park is well worth the entrance fee. It stuck with me for days.

On a happier note, after we left the park, we rode over to a nearby trading post and I had the best Indian fry taco I have ever had. OK, it was my first, but it was fantastic!

The ride back to Spearfish seemed to take forever. We rode

through a big chunk of Wyoming, and I have to give credit to the souls who live there. To me, there was a whole lot of nothing ... everywhere.


The next day we hit motorcycle hot spot Sturgis, S.D., to check out the town. The huge annual rally is held there in August, so it was pretty much a ghost town when we visited. That was fine with me. With our current COVID-19 situation, I wouldn't want to be around large crowds.

We then hit up Deadwood, S.D., which is a real tourist town. We even saw the reenactment of Wild Bill Hickok getting shot in the saloon it happened in back in 1876 – just two months after Custer was killed in Montana.

The ride home took two days. The first was our longest of the trip in a single day – about 580 miles. That is tough enough on a motorcycle, but when fighting 40 mph wind gusts it was downright exhausting.

We made it home on Sunday, Sept. 20. I was tired, needed a shower and had a backpack full of dirty laundry. My motorcycle was filthy and bug covered.

But I wouldn't trade it for the world. There is nothing like riding a bike long distances. We are already planning the next ride out to Roswell, N.M., in 2021. I just hope we don't get abducted by aliens.

Region 1 close to warning level

Ogle, Lee, Boone, Carroll, DeKalb, Jo Daviess, Stephenson, Whiteside and Winnebago counties included

ROCKFORD — The Northern Illinois Rockford Region (Region 1) is close to being in warning level for coronavirus disease (COVID-19).

The positivity rate for Region 1 has been steadily increasing.

As of Sept. 20, Region 1 positivity rate is 7.5 percent

A positivity rate of 8 percent for three consecutive days results in a warning level for COVID-19

If Region 1 goes into warning level, the Governor's office will mandate additional prevention strategies in the region to protect the public health.

Examples include:

Early closures and limited hours for bars, restaurants, gaming facilities, and casinos

Further restrictions on indoor services and dining

Reducing the number of guests for social gatherings

The local health departments want communities to move for-

ward toward recovery and not have to return to stricter measures to prevent further rise in community spread of COVID-19 that is driving the increase in positivity rate.

The LHDs cannot do this on their own. Each has a role in limiting the spread of COVID-19 in its communities.

Today, the LHDs ask the community to take these three additional steps to prevent Region 1 from going into warning:

1. Get a COVID-19 test. Testing is available at no cost for anyone in the community. You may not have symptoms, but you may be spreading COVID-19. For testing locations, contact your local health department or go to: <https://www.dph.illinois.gov/testing>

2. Limit contacts. Identify a close group of contacts with whom you mingle and keep to that limited group. If your children

are in school, keep the playdates to those that are in their class.

3. Leave. Be intentional about your action and activities. Leave a place where guidelines are not being followed, people are not masking or social distancing, or the gathering is too large.

The LHDs continue to remind the community that following these steps is needed to prevent the spread of COVID-19:


Wear a face mask: Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth covering

Watch your distance: Keep at least 6 feet apart from others

Wash your hands: Wash your hands regularly with soap and water for 20 seconds

About the non-profit organizations

Hub City Senior Center: The Hub City Senior Center offers a variety of activities and programs to meet the diverse interests of local seniors age 60 and up. The center offers a variety of activities including pool, card games, Bingo and games. The center also offers a monthly birthday party, a monthly movie day and important services for seniors including regular visits from a local podiatrist, eyecare technicians and hearing specialists. Daily lunches are also provided. Several groups meet at the center as well.

Focus House: The mission of Focus House is to provide a safe, nurturing and structured environment for youth. Through the commitment of Focus House to children, youth will are given the opportunity to develop self worth, responsibility and respect — enabling them to successfully return to their families and communities. The primary goal of Focus House is to return each child to his/her family, avoiding further — and more severe — court-mandated actions.

CASA: The Ogle County CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) program recruits, screens and trains volunteers from the community to become a voice for an abused and/or neglected child involved in the local juvenile court system. After completion of our training class, volunteers are sworn in by the Judge as a Guardian ad Litem. As a direct party to the

case, the volunteer has court authority to look into the child’s situation, submit findings and recommendations in the form of a court report and ensure that the best interests of the child are served. Ogle County volunteers are appointed to one case at a time. Free from the burden of a heavy case load and bound only to protect the child’s best interest, volunteers often bring information to the judge that otherwise might not be heard. CASA seeks to shorten the time a child is in foster care and ensures that child’s prompt placement into a safe, nurturing, permanent home.

Shining Star Children’s Advocacy Center: Since 2002, Shining Star Children’s Advocacy Center has been providing services for child abuse victims and their families. The mission of Shining Star is to transform victims of child abuse into survivors. The vision is to reduce the trauma of child abuse through identification, offender accountability, advocacy, counseling, and education on the path to eliminating child abuse. The purpose of the program is to provide forensic interviewing, case management and follow-through, and coordinated services to child victims of sexual and physical abuse and their non-offending family members in Lee and Ogle Counties as well as minimizing the trauma experienced by child victims by providing a comfortable and child-friendly environment for the interview and investigations of child abuse crimes.

YMCA Child Care Center: The YMCA Child Care Center, formerly the Rochelle Child Care Center, has been dedicated to the enrichment of children since 1965. The YMCA Child Care Center offers accredited day care, pre-school, and school age programs in a safe, clean, and nurturing environment staffed with loving, caring, and qualified professionals.

Rochelle Christian Food Pantry: The Rochelle Christian Food Pantry serves families in the Rochelle Township High School district who are needing temporary help obtaining food. The pantry receives food and cash donations and is a volunteer driven ministry. Food is distributed on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Rochelle Area Community Foundation: The Rochelle Area Community Foundation offers an opportunity for individuals, families, and businesses to leave a legacy for future generations that will continue to grow in perpetuity and grant money each year to improve the Rochelle Area. The Community Foundation is a public, charitable organization designed to attract

gifts that will be shared with Rochelle area non-profit organizations for the benefit of the entire community.

HOPE of Ogle County: HOPE of Ogle County’s mission is to advocate on behalf of domestic violence victims and their children in a welcoming environment. Our caring professionals provide safety planning, support, shelter, and referrals while empowering survivors to build a safe and peaceful future. Those experiencing domestic abuse can contact HOPE of Ogle County 7 days a week/24 hours a day. This service is available in most languages. Domestic violence advocates are there to listen, offer support and provide information on ways to increase personal safety. HOPE provides temporary emergency shelter for adults and their minor children who are experiencing domestic abuse. Safety, shelter, support and goal related services are provided to help individuals make their own choices about the next steps to take. Transitional housing is also available by application to families who access our emergency shelter. Adult and child counseling services are provided by appointment. Weekly support groups are available for adults and their children. HOPE staff also provides public education to local schools, colleges, service organizations, and businesses. Court advocates are also available to assist those experiencing domestic violence, in obtaining court Orders of Protection in Ogle County.

CHS Rochelle donates to park district projects

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Park District Wednesday announced CHS Rochelle is donating \$20,000 that will be split between the park district’s Engage Program and security upgrades at The REC.

The CHS processing plant located at 1900 Steward Road buys corn from area farmers and processes it in to roughly 125 million gallons of ethanol and by-products including distillers dried grains with solubles used by animal feed manufacturers to boost protein content. The park district is thankful to CHS Rochelle for supporting The REC and the Engage Program. The goal of the park district’s Engage Program is to have no individual, from child to senior, be tuned




team’s six-match losing streak.

“I’m happy that we were able to take the win, especially on Senior Night,” McGee said. “There was a great atmosphere at the courts today and we played with such high energy the whole

time... It was exciting to be recognized with all of my friends, and it’s sad that we’re almost done, but this win boosts our confidence so much. We’ve struggled recently, but we’re playing much better than we have in the past and I think this

win will definitely carry us forward.”

Dixon took a 2-0 lead after winning both the No. 1 and No. 2 singles matches. Juniors Megan Thompson and Josie Lundquist put Rochelle on the board, however, defeating Maci Kelly

Scarce harrier team falls against Sandwich

Johnson places second for Lady Hubs, Seldal runs season-best time for Hubs

YORKVILLE — Despite missing a few of their top runners, Rochelle Township High School’s cross country teams performed valiantly against a strong Sandwich program at Silver Spring State Park on Tuesday. The Hubs (4-5, 1-4 Interstate 8) fell to the Indians 15-50, while the Lady Hubs (3-5, 1-4 Interstate 8) dropped their race by a score of 19-37.

“It was a great day to be out there running,” head coach Mark Zilis said. “We ran at a place we’ve never seen before and we knew going into the meet that Sandwich had both a tough boys team and a tough girls team... Unfortunately, we were missing two of our top five runners, and we’re hoping to have those runners back for our meet next week.” Junior Sara Johnson ran the strongest race for Rochelle, rallying late for

a second-place finish with a time of 21:55. Sophomores Ahtziri Zepeda and Karina Lopez clocked in at 24:21 and 24:50, respectively, to take eighth and ninth place in the varsity girls race. Senior Aiden Seldal bounced back from an ankle injury to lead the Rochelle boys on Tuesday, placing ninth overall with a time of 19:11 while sophomore David Wanner finished 10th with a time of 19:25.

“Sara came through for us,” Zilis said. “She was in third place for over half of the race, but she zoned in and wound up passing the second-place girl and beating her by 18 seconds... Aiden had a really good performance and he recorded his best time of the year. David wasn’t too far behind, and our stud freshman Parker [Lenkaitis] nearly broke the 20-minute mark.”

Rochelle will race against the Morris Redskins on the road next Tuesday at 4:30 p.m.

Short-game strides helping Ohlinger find the hole

CHIPPING and putting were two skills Griffin Ohlinger knew he needed to improve as he prepared for his sophomore season with the Rochelle Township High School golf team.

Ohlinger spent his summer playing at least nine holes almost every day. Ohlinger also worked with golf instructor Biv Wadden to refine his mechanics and improve his swing and putting stroke. His efforts have certainly paid off this fall, as Ohlinger has become one of Rochelle's best and most consistent players, scoring in the low-to-mid 40s in nearly every head-to-head meet.

"I realized my short game was my weakness," Ohlinger said. "I couldn't putt for much last season but I've put a lot of work into my putting and coach Wadden worked with me a lot over the summer. We had several lessons where we worked on chipping, and we eventually moved up to practicing with my longer clubs before we finished with a lot of putting lessons."

Ohlinger quickly rose to the varsity level as a freshman, carding scores in the upper 40s and lower 50s and shooting scores around 100 in 18-hole tournaments. His confidence has grown significantly since his first varsity match in 2019, and while he still had some goosebumps when the Hubs teed off the 2020 season, the game has started to come easier to him.

"I was still a little nervous during my first few shots this season," Ohlinger said. "After that, I told myself that I had to keep moving forward, and I've been playing better with more experience. I've found myself worrying less and focusing more on my fundamentals."

Ohlinger's game has come a long way from when he first took up golf over two years ago. While he initially didn't take the sport seriously, he gradually warmed up to it as time progressed, and as his passion for the sport has grown, so has his desire to improve and shoot lower scores.

"My parents introduced me to golf and I received my first set of clubs about two and a half years ago," Ohlinger said. "I was only messing around when I first

started playing and I didn't know much about the game, but I found myself having more fun the better I played. Hitting a good drive, putting the ball in the middle of the fairway and one-putting from a good distance are confidence boosters for me that keep me going as I move forward to the next hole."

Ohlinger has been an integral player for a Rochelle varsity team that has started the 2020 season 6-2 overall, matching its win total from the last two years combined. He said his goals this season are to continue improving his putting and his shots off the tee box.

"I hope to be shooting in the 70s through 18 holes by next season," Ohlinger said. "I haven't been able to do that in tournaments, but I've done that during practice rounds where I'm playing at my pace. I have to learn how to play with more people and handle the pressure."

Senior Megan Thiravong and sophomore Griffin Ohlinger recovered from tough rounds against LaSalle-Peru earlier this week, leading the Hubs with 39 and 41, respectively, when the Hubs teed off with the Redskins on Tuesday. "We've never played Nettle Creek before so the kids had to adjust on the fly," head coach Glen Mehrings said. It was an unseen site for our kids but I thought they adapted pretty well."

Junior Brett Ferguson carded 51 to round out Rochelle's top four varsity players Tuesday. Mehrings said both the large, fast greens and the links-style layout of Nettle Creek, which plays slightly longer than Morris Country Club, presented the biggest challenges for the Hubs.

"Nettle Creek had the biggest greens we've seen

"It's a links style course and there are a lot of hills and undulations as well as hidden bunkers, which can make it difficult for the players to know how far they need to hit the ball to carry a trap. greens because they don't get to see them very often."

Rochelle will close out the regular season this week before beginning the Interstate 8 Championships next Monday and Tuesday. The boys will play at Bliss Creek Golf Course on Monday at noon, while the girls will play at Sycamore Golf Course on Tuesday at 10 a.m.

BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE FLAGG-ROCHELLE PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, OGLE COUNTY ROCHELLE, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2020 TO JUNE 30, 2021

The following constitutes the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the FLAGG-ROCHELLE PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, Ogle County, Rochelle, Illinois for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021, presented to the Board of Trustees of the District and proposed to be adopted by said Board of Library Trustees after a public hearing:

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Budget Law, 50 ILCS 330/1, et seq. as amended requires all Illinois Municipal Corporations as broadly defined therein, to adopt a combined Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, specifying the objects and purposes of expenditures; and the Illinois Public Library District Act 75 ILCS 16/1-10 and 75 ILCS 16/30-85, provides procedures for the passage of a Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and a Tax Levy Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above and other appropriate statutes, a Budget and Appropriation Ordinance has been prepared in tentative form at the designation of this Board, and has been made available for the public inspection at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereon, and a public hearing on said Budget and Appropriation Ordinance has been held prior to final action hereon, and notice of said hearing was published on August 7, 2019, being more than thirty (30) days prior to said hearing, in a newspaper published within the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Library Trustees of the FLAGG-ROCHELLE PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, Rochelle Illinois, as follows:


