Keeping history while transitioning into the future

VCCT names building Lincoln Arts Center

ROCHELLE – While COVID-19 may have slowed the down the process, the Vince Carney Community Theater has decided on a new name for its future home and is making progress on the buildings renovations.

Construction to turn the former Lincoln School, located on South Main Street in Rochelle, into the future home of the VCCT has been underway since last September. Until now, the building has been known to most in the community as the “old” Lincoln School.

It is known by this name because many people in the community have memories of going to school there when they were growing up in Rochelle. With that in mind, when renaming the building, the VCCT wanted to keep the history of the original building while making the transition easier for the community by

creating a name that is inclusive to all types of events.

“There is a lot of sentimental attachment to not just the building itself, but to the memories created there,” VCCT President Amy Frank said. “So, we decided to honor those memories as well as make the transition easier by keeping Lincoln in the name. We also decided on ‘Lincoln Arts Center’ because that keeps the space open for any type of events and not just theater productions.”

The VCCT will be holding a meeting to decide on the font of

the lettering and when it will be put up, but the original lettering in the word Lincoln will remain untouched. The VCCT also plans to keep some of the building’s interior original such as some of the murals.

Until COVID-19 happened, construction was going smooth and was on track to host its first show in July of this year. Since the quarantine, construction on the building has slowed down but has continued to move forward.

Preventing limitations

ROCHELLE—Thanks to a gift from Rochelle VFW 3878, a local veteran will no longer be limited to where he can and cannot go in his home and around town.

Bill Justice, a Vietnam War Veteran and member of Rochelle VFW Post 3878 who also lives in town, recently had his leg amputated due to health conditions linked to Agent Orange exposure during his time in the war. After the operation, the Rochelle VFW built Justice a metal ramp to get in and out of his house since he now uses a wheelchair. Until now, he had been using a push wheelchair and he



was limited to how far and where he could go.

“We are giving Bill a Quantum electric wheel chair that gives him complete 360-degree motion and will allow him to go more places without need-

ing help from anybody else,” Rochelle VFW Commander Bill Bumgarner said.

The chair originally belonged to the widowed wife of a veteran in Oregon who donated the wheel-

Kish College, regional community colleges collaborate with Rockford University

County and schools look to openings

Health department head says this school year will be different

OREGON — The Ogle County's Health Department is working with area school administrators on plans to open schools to students this year, the head of the department told the Ogle County Board at its July 21 meeting.

Kyle Auman told board members that his department is working with administrators to make sure students, faculty and staff are as safe as possible during the continuing COVID-19 pandemic.

"The upcoming school year will not look like school years past," he said.

He said they have heard from many parents who do not want to send their kids back to school, adding that masks, social distancing and a lot of hand washing "are a must" to keep everyone safe.

Auman said the county is now averaging about three new cases of COVID-19 a day. He said areas of concern continue to be daycares and long-term care facilities.

"We've had several issues with daycare facilities," he said.

He said overall, his department has tested 13

percent of the county's population. There are currently 356 positive cases, but only one person is hospitalized with the virus.

Auman said 300 people have recovered, and a total of five people have died of COVID-19 in the county.

"We've been working diligently to respond to the various needs of Ogle County," he said.

In response to a question from the board, Auman did remind everyone that the county does have a mandatory mask rule, and that the county does investigate when it receives tips that worked at area businesses — like bars and restaurants — are not wearing masks and following safety protocols.

"I have nothing but respect for you and your staff for what you've done through this whole thing," said county board chairman John Finfrock.

Other action

The County Board approved special use conditions for solar farms in the county by a 20-4 vote.

The board basically approved the same ordinance that it had considered in January 2019, with some changes, including to the noise ordinance.

Offering personal expression

ONE local business is doing its part to help make wearing a face mask less of a nuisance and more of a manner of personal expression.

926 Custom Embroidery, located at 404 Lincoln Highway in downtown Rochelle, has begun making custom face masks in addition to its other custom decorated apparel. The masks are made of either two or three plies of cotton and can include many different pre-made designs or any design a customer would like.

The cotton plies of the mask are first put together, then a vinyl cutting program cuts out the design. The design is then removed from the excess vinyl and lastly the design is attached to the mask using a heat press. Co-owners Heidi Bratko and Dana Theiss thought the masks would be a fun way for people to express themselves, especially kids when school returns in the fall.

"We just started making masks when the school districts announced they would be requiring them when school is back in session," Theiss said. "Currently, there is a high demand for masks and the fact that we can customize them makes them a little more fun. We thought maybe this will help kids want to wear their masks."

Many of the designs were created by Bratko,

It's tragic to think that Jesus paid the price for our sins, that He suffered to make that sacrifice, and yet there are Christians who are struggling just to get by and make it through each day.

The key to having abundant life in Christ is living by God's grace through faith. Because grace is His power working in us that enables us to do whatever we need to do in life.

When we try to do everything in our own strength and leave God out of the equation, we just get worn-out and frustrated by our mistakes and failures. But when we lean on God, we actually enter into His rest and can enjoy our lives, no matter what our circumstances may be.

Hebrews 4:9-11 (AMP) says, “So there remains a [full and complete] Sabbath

rest for the people of God. For the one who has once entered His rest has also rested from [the weariness and pain of] his human labors.... Let us therefore make every effort to enter that rest [of God, to know and experience it for ourselves]....”

Now the rest of God is not a rest from work—it's a rest in work. It's partnering with God to do what He is calling you to do by His grace and leaving the part you can't do in His hands, trusting Him to do it. Hebrews 4:3 says it this way: “For we who believe [that is, we who personally trust and confidently rely on God] enter that rest....”

When I'm trying to believe, I haven't entered God's rest. But when I do believe, I have complete rest in Him. Living by faith is not a life of struggle—it's rest. And you can enter into God's rest in every area of your life.

I've discovered that the stress in my life is caused by the way I approach my circumstances and the attitude I have toward

them. It was a turning point for me when I realized that the world will probably never change, but I can learn how to change the way I go about handling situations that are challenging.

One key to this is knowing that as believers in Christ, we are partners with God—we have a part and He has a part in everything He calls us to do. When we don't do the part we can do and we try to do His part, that's when we live stressed-out with worry, fear, anxiety, frustration, no peace and no joy.

The reason this happens sometimes is because we think God needs our help. We meditate on the problem—rolling it over and over in our mind, worrying, trying to figure out how things should work out. It's like we're telling God, “I kind of think You need my help, and I'm not sure You can take care of this situation, Lord.”

We need to realize that worrying is useless! It's like sitting in a rocking chair, rocking all day, wearing yourself out and getting nowhere. Trusting God means we

give up worrying, reasoning, and anxiety and we enter into His rest with simple child-like faith—we live by grace through faith!

Ephesians 2:8-9 is a great scripture that says we're saved by grace through faith. And we walk out our relationship with God and His plans for our lives the same way we receive salvation: by grace through faith.

This is possible because Jesus made the perfect sacrifice for us when He gave His life, taking our guilt and condemnation and paying for our sins. Through a personal relationship with Jesus, we access God's grace so we can do what He's calling us to do.

It's so amazing to know that God is always with us, giving us His grace for everything we need to do in life. Trust God's unconditional love for you today. Do what you can do and give Him everything else. And when you find yourself getting frustrated or feeling overwhelmed, like you just can't do it anymore, remember to stop, get your focus back on Him and enter into His rest once again.

There are lots of changes going on downtown, with streets being rebuilt and parking lots redone. Please be alert when driving.

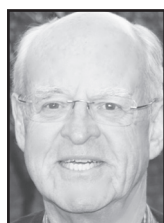

This is Mike Madigan's last hurrah

AS one who scribbles largely about things Illinois, I feel almost obligated to observe on the bombshell (certainly for the small fraternity that follows Illinois politics) news that utility ComEd has agreed to pay a \$200 million fine for bribery of Illinois officials. The announcement by the U.S. attorney's office in Chicago identifies Illinois House Speaker Mike Madigan as the ultimate object of the bribery.

Some background: Madigan has been speaker of the House for most of the past four decades. During that time, he has accrued almost dictatorial powers. He can block any legislation — any bill whatever — with the wave of his pinkie finger. By the way, during those four decades, Illinois has built up so much debt, obligations and unpaid bills that we have the worst credit rating of any state in the nation, and another tax increase is on the ballot this fall.

A utility regulated by the state of Illinois, ComEd supplies electricity to 70 percent of our state's households. It simply has to have Mike Madigan's blessing to increase electric rates and buck up its bottom line.

Bruce Rauner failed as governor (2015-2018), yet he was spectacularly successful in using his millions in TV ads to paint Mike Madigan across the state as the Wanted Poster caricature of the evil, corrupt Chicago political boss. I have seen reputable polls that say Illinois voters who know nothing about politics do indeed know and dislike Mike Madigan, and that most of them would vote against a candidate associated with him.

Affiliation with Mike Madigan

was already costly. Candidates associated with Madigan must spend more than would otherwise be needed, the cash generally provided by Madigan, in order to counter attacks about their Madigan connections. This past week, these costs just shot up.

As a result of the federal prosecutor's bribery revelations, 15 members of Madigan's House Democratic caucus publicly asked Madigan to step down as speaker, “if the allegations are true.” Except for pinning the tail on the donkey — Madigan — how can the allegations not be true? ComEd has stipulated that they are true!

Why in the world would ComEd ever put itself at risk of bribery charges if the company weren't pressured to do so by Mike Madigan?

And think of the excruciating dilemma for all Democratic candidates in Illinois. Can they afford to accept campaign contributions from Madigan, who controls almost all the party's campaign cash hoard of \$22 million? If they do, they will be pilloried by GOPers. But what do they do without it? Will billionaire Gov. J. B. Pritzker replace the money. After all, he has also called for Madigan to step down.

My insider friends say that Madigan will, yet again, be able to weather this storm; that Dems will back him, and the feds may not be able to prove that Madigan personally benefited from the millions spent by ComEd to earn his blessing for their legislation. I disagree about the speaker weathering the storm.

The optics of the ComEd bribery and Madigan shake-down scheme are breathtaking, at least an order of magnitude more brazen than your typical corruption. ComEd continued to pay the best man at Madigan's wedding (lobbyist Mike McClain) hundreds

of thousands annually, even after the company declared he was no longer lobbying for them.

Madigan even demanded — talk about brassy — that ComEd place one of his political friends on their board of directors. And they did! Think of the chill that must send down the spines of CEOs who might want to set up shop in Illinois.

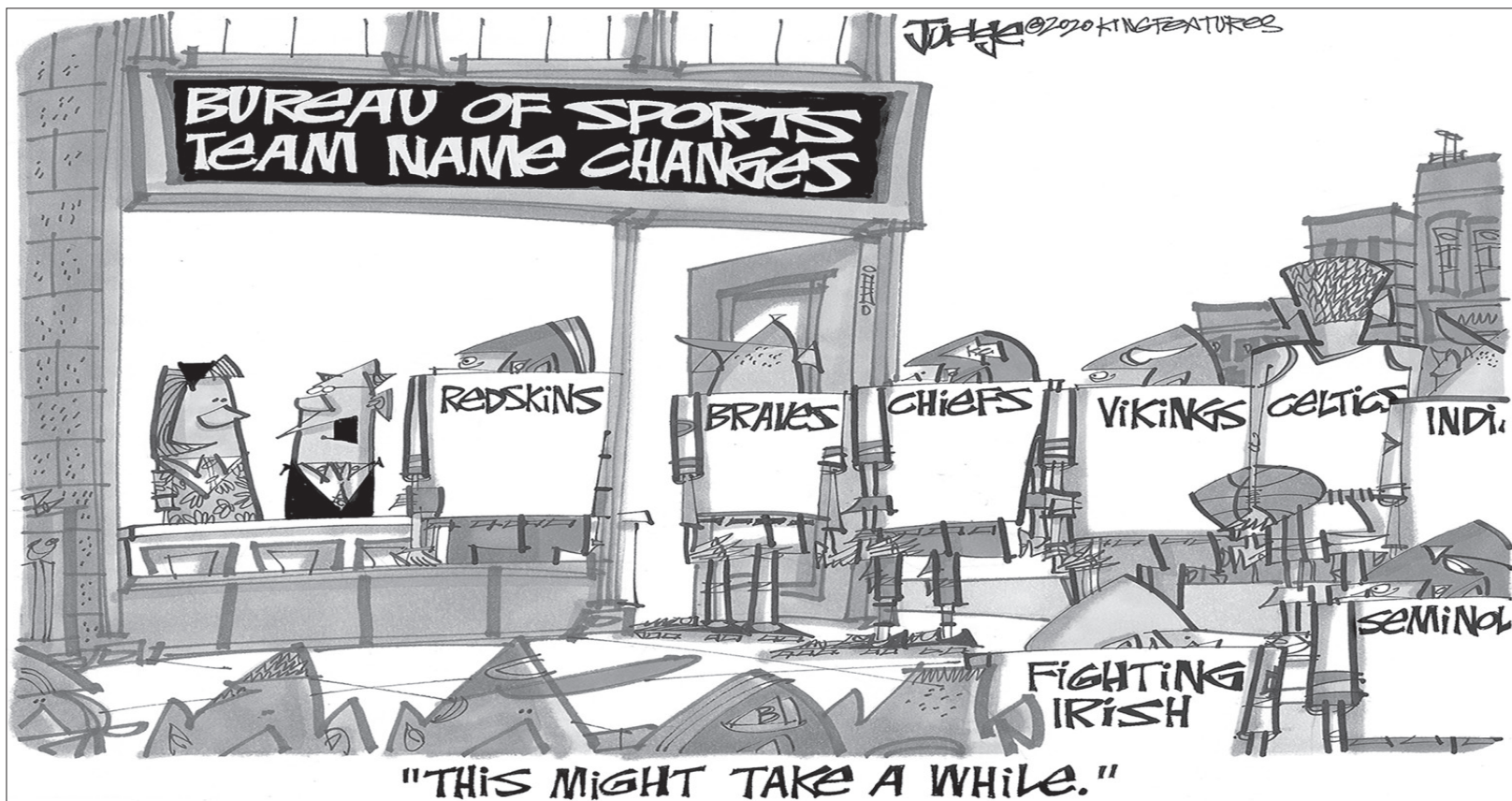
Any legal actions against Madigan are in the future, yet I predict the court of public opinion will indict, try and send Madigan packing in the coming year. Even Dems, certainly the younger ones, want to put the speaker, who is also chair of the state party, behind them after half a century and move on.

Republican leaders don't want Madigan to go away anytime soon. They want him — and Dem candidates connected with him — to twist in the wind. If voters can't connect the dots between ComEd bribery money and Madigan power, GOP candidates will do so for them.

Assuming Madigan is elected to a 26th term(!) in November, he would seek the support of his caucus to be elected speaker yet again. Without those 15 lawmakers who asked Madigan to step down — and more likely to follow suit — he would not receive a majority vote of the House. Think how awkward it would be for House members to backtrack in the caucus on their demand that he step down.

I predict Madigan will resign in December, rather than be denied the speakership. This will give Gov. JB Pritzker an open field to take over leadership of the Illinois Democratic Party.

Since COVID-19 and the quarantine begun, the city has been looking for ways to continue forward in adding to the downtown area. With the many guidelines set by the CDC and health officials, the city thought this was a smart and safe way to keep its momentum.

“This whole COVID

thing has put us on hold and we didn’t know what the future was going to look like,” Pease said. “So, we are just trying to do small, cheap and economical things that will keep our downtown progressing forward.”

The logos were freshly painted during last week and since then, the city has received compliments from residents who have said that they look very nice. The City of Rochelle is already working on its next project to add to the downtown area in the future.

“We wrote a grant for another mural through the Rochelle Area Community Foundation and they have put those funds on hold for us,” Pease said. “We want to do some more artwork and murals downtown to continue adding more fun and brightness to the area.”

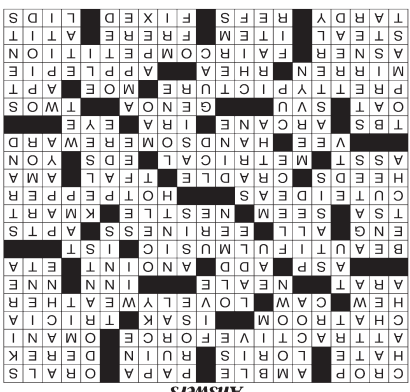

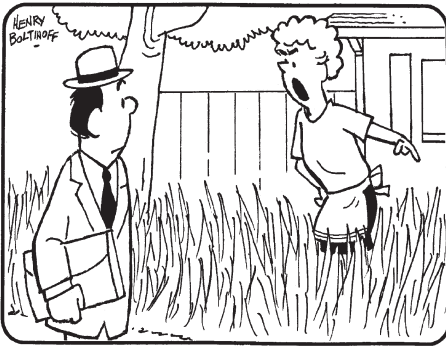

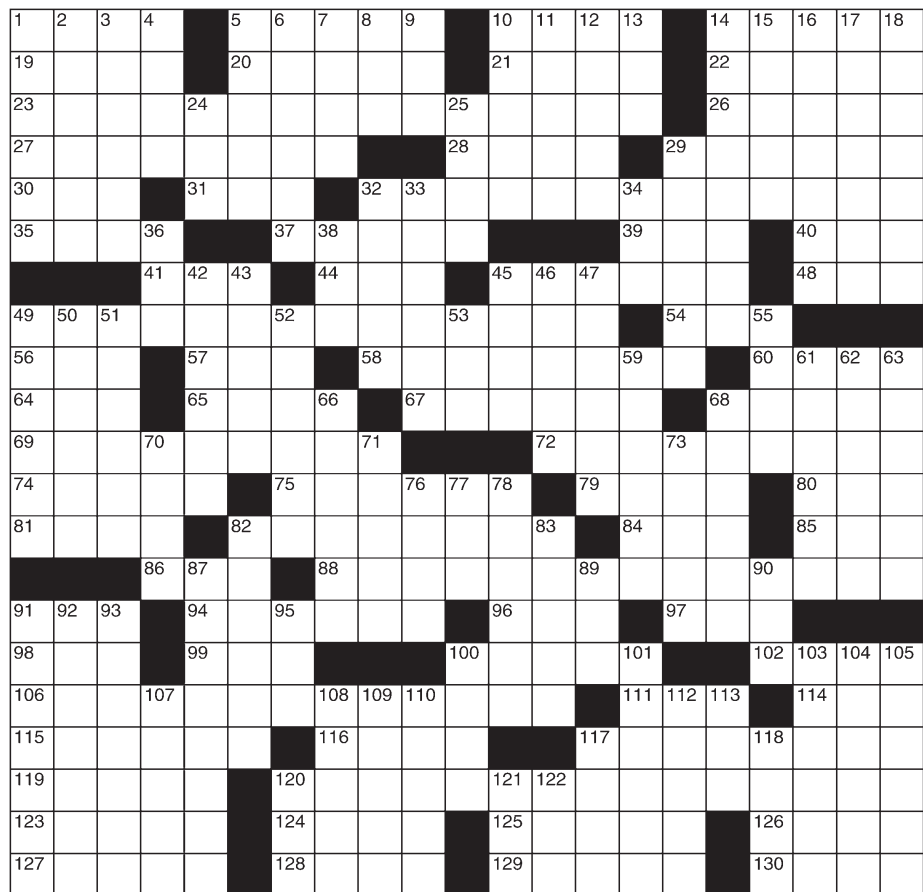

Electronic recycling event will be July 31

OREGON – The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will be accepting residential electronics from Ogle County residents for recycling on Friday, July 31, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the County Annex Building at 909 Pines Road in Oregon.

This event is for electronic items from Ogle County residents only. Limit seven large items per monthly recycling event.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and for the protection of workers and residents, the following guidelines have been put in place by the OCSWMD for the acceptance of residential electronic items:

All residents attending the event must stay in their vehicles at all times with the windows closed.

Residents are to show acceptable Ogle County I.D. to county staff through vehicle window (drivers' license, voter registration card, or recent utility bill accepted).

Electronic items must be loaded into trunk, truck bed, trailer, or rear of a van or SUV, and easily accessible to county staff to remove.

Limit of seven bulky accepted items per vehicle; and box or tub loaded with

smaller items is considered one bulky item.

Residents are advised to bring in only accepted items for recycling, please check the list below or visit the county website for a full list of accepted items.

Items must be removed from original packaging prior to arrival at the recycling event.

Microwave ovens are \$5 per unit. If you have a microwave oven to recycle please tape an envelope with payment to the outside of the device prior to arrival at the event. Cash or check, payable to Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department, accepted. Exact payment only, no change will be available for larger denominations.

If a resident or their family member(s) are feeling ill it is advised that they stay at home and recycle their electronics at another future recycling event.

If electronic items have been in a residence with a positive COVID-19 individual, it is advised to not bring these items in for recycling until a future recycling event.

Accepted items include all televisions, computers, computer monitors, computer hardware and cables,

printers, FAX machines, copiers, scanners, video gaming items, VCR/ DVD players, cable and satellite boxes, cell phones, tablets, laptops, radios, stereo equipment (no wooden speakers), digital clocks, holiday light strands, extension cords, phone systems, calculators, shredders (no plastic tubs), rechargeable batteries, CFL bulbs, and printer ink cartridges. Microwave ovens accepted for \$5 per unit, limit seven (7) bulky items per vehicle.

Items NOT accepted include smoke detectors, coffee makers, toasters, bread makers, vacuum cleaners, fans, heaters, air conditioners or dehumidifiers, lamps, power tools, alkaline batteries, LED bulbs, exercise equipment, medical equipment of any kind, toys or drones, business or institutional electronic items, and any packaging from electronic items such as boxes, plastic wrapping, and Styrofoam.

Recycling events may be cancelled or abruptly ended due to weather conditions, warehouse volumes, staffing issues, events related to the COVID-19 global pandemic, or for other uncontrollable events or situations.

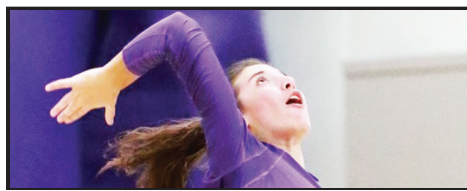

Leading in the trenches

Schlenbecker headlines returning senior linemen for Hubs

RISING senior Michael Schlenbecker wasn't thrilled with his performance on the gridiron this past season, but the third-year varsity lineman has one goal on his mind for this fall, and that's to be one of the best players on the field each time he and his Rochelle teammates suit up for game action.

A three-sport athlete at RTHS, Schlenbecker became the starting right tackle for the Hubs early in his sophomore season, and he returned this past fall as a two-way starter in the trenches. Schlenbecker played in all nine games during the 2019 season, finishing with 1.5 sacks on defense, and he'll be a key playmaker on both sides of the football when the 2020 campaign kicks off.

"I felt like I underperformed during my junior season due to my body transformation," Schlenbecker said. "I felt like I

showed great leadership last season and I did a good job of motivating our team. I'm looking to become a better leader this year and improve my skills on both sides of the line... My goals are to make the All-Conference team and help our team win games. To be successful, I'm going to not only focus on myself, but push others as well."

Schlenbecker will be one of three starters returning on both the offensive line and the defensive line this fall. The Hubs carried only eight seniors on the varsity roster in 2019, but the 2020 roster will feature far more experience, something Schlenbecker said will be a strength of the Rochelle team when the Hubs kick off their season against the Pekin Dragons next month.

"I felt like we underperformed as a team last year because we had a low number of seniors," Schlenbecker said. "But we had a lot of talent on that team, and we have

Recreation center nearing substantial completion

Despite COVID-19, \$14 million project remains on schedule

ROCHELLE — Construction crews remain hard at work on the \$14 million Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District recreation center at the south end of the Helms Athletic Complex.

Ringland-Johnson Construction Superintendent Tim Daley said

earlier this week that the project remains on track for substantial completion by the end of next month. Basketball hoops, windows, scoreboards and a walking track curtain have recently been installed inside the fieldhouse, while the artificial turf is scheduled to be placed in early September.

"All the gym equipment should be installed before

the end of next week," Daley said. "Flooring is scheduled for Oct. 3 and the park district will be putting the turf down in the second week of September. We're down to trims and ceiling work inside the community center as well as fixtures and other finishes. I expect the community center to be wrapped up in 2-to-3 weeks. Flooring and equipment inside

the fitness facility will be put in after substantial completion."

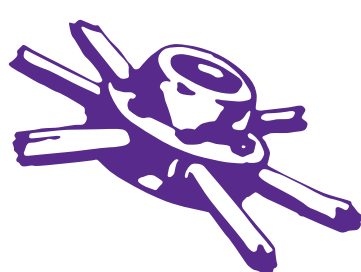
Drywall, insulation, plumbing and electrical work on the north end of the building has largely been completed, and workers have begun painting and installing cabinets and other office equipment throughout the facility. Outside the facility, Daley said the next ma-

jor phase of construction will involve clearing and paving the parking lots on the north and south ends.

"We're right where we need to be as far as our schedule goes," Daley said. "We're getting ready to start pulling up all of the exterior asphalt to pour new concrete and asphalt. We have about six weeks to go before we hit our substantial completion

date at the end of August. We'll start the parking lots after we install the storm drain, and pulling up the blacktop will take about 3-to-4 days. We'll then layout the curbs, gutters and sidewalks before we prep for the new asphalt... We're thinking we'll need about four weeks for that whole process."

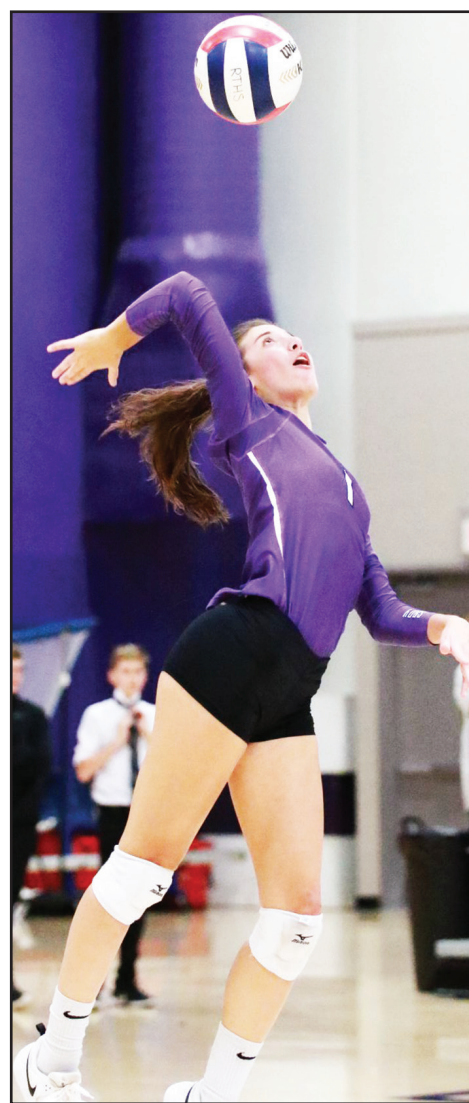

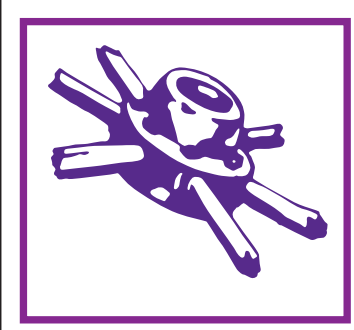

Daley said workers have been fast-tracking progress inside the aquatics facility, where both the lap pool and the recreational pool have been dug out and concrete bases and walls have been poured. Daley said crews are currently tiling and pouring concrete for the pool decks, while the pool finishes will be completed in late August. Sealing, trim and paint work inside the bathrooms will also be a priority for the aquatics facility as workers continue into next month.
