# Details released for upcoming election

County clerk encourages vote-by-mail option for residents concerned about Coronavirus

**OGLE COUNTY** — Laura J. Cook, Ogle County Clerk and Recorder, announces the COVID-19 pandemic is a continuing concern as the 2020 General Election approaches.

Cook encourages voters to consider Vote by Mail as a safe, secure and convenient option to cast a ballot.

"The Illinois General Assembly this year passed an election bill that provides many safeguards against the spread of Coronavirus in the voting process for the Nov. 3 General Election," Cook said. "Chief among them are provisions to increase Voting by Mail throughout the state."

As of Aug. 1, 2020, all registered voters in Ogle County will receive a "Vote by Mail" application from the County Clerk's Office in the mail. The application will contain information on how to obtain a "Vote by Mail" ballot.

"Voting by Mail in the safety of your home is a great option for those concerned with the COVID-19 pandemic. When you choose to Vote by Mail you are reducing the risk of exposure. Voting by Mail has been an option in the State of Illinois for voters,

overseas citizens and military personnel for years and is secure," Cook said.

Ballots will be mailed to applicants beginning Sept. 24 which is also the first day of Early Voting. The deadline for applying for a Vote by Mail ballot is Oct. 29. Ballots must be postmarked no later than Election Day, Nov. 3, to be accepted, and properly postmarked ballots will be accepted through Nov. 17.

## City of Rochelle road work



Reconstruction of North Sixth Street from the Fourth Avenue intersection to the Fifth Avenue intersection along with the alleys east of North Sixth Street between Lincoln Avenue and Fifth Avenue, and the Municipal Parking Lot #4 south of the Flagg Township Museum began in early June. The project involves upgrades to the water main system, removal and replacement of curb and gutter, pavement and base course, sidewalks, storm sewer, streetlights, and other related improvements. The project will require periodic partial and full closures to vehicle and pedestrian traffic within the project area. Private drives will be closed for much of the project and alternate access and parking will be required in other locations adjacent to businesses fronting these streets.



Dement Road will be closed to traffic from First Avenue through Aug. 14 for bridge approach and pavement repairs on the south side of the road. Traffic will use Caron Road as a detour route.

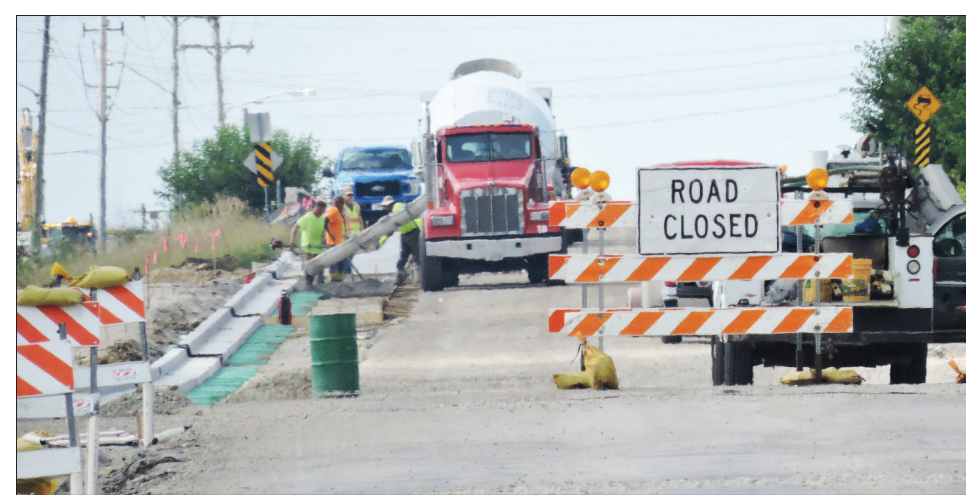

South Main Street construction is underway and South Main Street will be closed from Steam Plant to Steward Road until Oct. 23. There will be no access from Willis Avenue, Lake Lida Lane or Southview Drive. This project is the beginning of a year's-long process to overhaul South Main Street to include resurfacing, curb, gutter, street lights and a multi-use path. Phase I is now underway and Phase II is slated to begin in 2021 from Steam Plant Road to Veteran's Parkway, completing the multi-use path from Steward Road to Veteran's Parkway. This majority of this nearly \$3 million project is being funded by the State of Illinois.

## VOTE: Mail in ballots will be available for voters

There are security procedures in place that upon the return of the "Vote by Mail" application, the signature will be verified by the Election Staff of the County Clerk's Office. If the signature matches, the ballot will be mailed. But if there is a discrepancy, it will be taken care of immediately before the ballot is mailed to the voter. Once the ballot has been

returned to the Election Authority, there will be three Election Judges who will verify the signature on the "Ballot Certification Envelope" to the signature on the application. A ballot may be rejected for an invalid signature only by unanimous decision of the judges.

The ballot may be rejected based on a signature or lack of signature or because the ballot envelope was delivered opened. If

this shall happen, the voter will be notified within two days or within one day if the rejection occurs after Election Day. The new law contains provisions for the voter to address these problems.

Ogle County is also in need of Election Judges. For those interested in being a part of the election process, contact the Ogle County Clerk's Office at 815-732-1110 for more information.

Roberts explained that the concrete foundation for the statue is complete and will receive the veneer finish soon. "The statue is expected to be completed by the end of August and an unveil-

ing will hopefully be held for the community," Roberts said.

The statue was created by local artist Fran Volz and funding for the project was collected through pledges from the community.

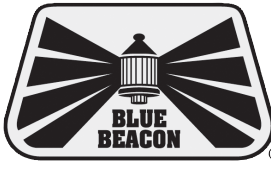

## Strength for the race, every day of your life

One way to keep going when difficult times come is to get your mind off yourself and your concerns and help someone else. The truth is we are happier and more content when we're helping others than when we're focusing on ourselves.

Refuse to get stuck in an attitude of self-pity, selfishness or self-centeredness. We all have problems, but our problems don't have to have us! Our victory will come as we remain deter-

mined to just keep moving, doing what God puts in our heart to do.

Rest. One major part of running your race is learning to rest. Now, that may sound like an oxymoron, but here's what I mean. Resting isn't about doing nothing; it's about being in a place of peace and complete trust in God. From a position of rest, we can do whatever we need to do because our faith is not in ourselves but in the One who gives us the strength and ability to do it.

God did the work of creation in six days, and on the seventh day, He rested from His work. Jesus died for our sins and then sat down at the right hand of God...a place of rest from His work.

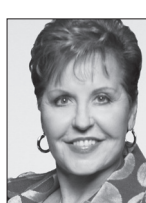
In the Old Testament, maintaining a covenant relationship with God was all about work. The high priest went into the Holy Place to offer a sacrifice for the sins of the people. There was no place to sit in the Holy Place because he was there to work. But when Jesus came, His sacrifice paid it all and He sat down because His

Learning to rest may be one of the most important things we ever do. A lot of times, people get stressed-out about their circumstances, but really it's not the circumstances that cause their stress; it's the way they handle them.

Resting in God is like a vacation for your soul. In rest, you are not concerned with what others think of you or how everything is going to work out as you fulfill God's will for your life because your faith is in Christ. You can be steadfast in the midst of trials because you know that God is in control and He will see you through anything you face. When you work from a place of rest, you do what you need to do in peace, having complete faith in God's grace to accomplish the task before you.

Run. Everyone has a race to run, a goal to accomplish, a life to live, and we all have to start somewhere. My encouragement to you is to start from a place of rest. Learn how to trust the Holy Spirit's leading. He will guide you and help you when it's time to sit...to stand...to walk...and to run your race to win.

## After decades of mismanagement Illinois headed for crash and burn

AS I walked a country road near my rural town this past week, a local slowed his pickup alongside me. “We’re moving to Florida, Jim.” He paused, then: “Illinois is not well managed, you know.” Three weeks ago, a hugely successful commodities trader friend, who lives in splendor on a big swath of Lake Michigan in Lake Forest, called: “Jim, we’re moving to Florida. It’s the taxes and the weather. And I can work from there.”

Illinois’ population has grown only slightly since 1970 – from 11.1 million then to 12.67 million today. The U.S. population, meanwhile, has increased from 205.1 million to 328.2 million during that same time.

People move for many reasons. Weather is obviously part of it, though Minnesota has harsher winters and higher taxes, yet has been gaining population. Minnesota is better managed than Illinois, and citizens there apparently sense it.

Our state has been ineptly managed for a long time. The last good manager was probably Gov. Jim Edgar (1991-98). He was known as “Gov. No,” because people who went into his office to ask for money were told No.

Since then, debt, unfunded pension obligations and deficit spending have piled up to the point our state has the worst credit rating in the nation. In efforts to find money for pensions

and Medicaid health insurance for the low income, Illinois has over the past two decades cut employees, ignored critical information technology needs and shorted both social services and higher education.

Managing a big, boisterous state is tough, really tough, even without a pandemic. First, the governor doesn’t alone run the state, as recent Gov. Bruce Rauner learned the hard way. The gov shares power with not only the Legislature but also the state high court and public employee unions.

Democratic House Speaker Mike Madigan, in the Legislature for half a century, can kill literally any bill — any bill — he wishes, with but a wave of his hand. A fetter on management.

The Illinois Supreme Court, dominated by Chicago Democrats since 1964, has rejected term limits, pension reform and popular efforts for nonpartisan redistricting — decisions all neatly in line with Madigan’s wishes. More fetters.

By the way, without reform of its ballooning pension obligations, the state will likely never stabilize its budget situation. Mike Madigan is not an evil guy. He is a product of the Boss Daley political machine, which worked tirelessly to benefit and protect its own, meaning government workers and unions. After all, they are generally Democrats.

That’s fine, but over the years, with the arrogance of dominance, they have gone way too far.

For example, the

public employee unions have negotiated such sweetheart contracts — often bargaining with sympathetic governors — that union rules basically manage state agencies day to day.

An illustration: Agency directors are basically unable to recruit top talent from the outside. Union rules say employees — last time I looked 95 percent of all state employees belonged to unions — have first crack at all jobs, even if they aren’t qualified. More fetters.

Gov. JB Pritzker is a

decent guy, trying to do a good job, I’m sure, and he didn’t create the present mess. However, born with a gold spoon in his mouth, he appears to take the “spend to solve” approach to government management.

Pritzker has put \$56 million of apparently limitless billions into his campaign to enact an amendment in November that would tax the rich at higher rates.

Our fiscal plight is so grave, however, that it cannot be fixed solely by hoisting ever more taxes onto the backs of a few rich

people. Our fiscal hole is so deep that, in the short run certainly, more taxes on all of us will be required, something neither side of the political divide will admit.

“Jim, if we don’t pass the governor’s tax proposal, Illinois will crash and burn,” said a Dem friend of mine.

I responded: “Illinois has been ‘crashing and burning’ for years now — in slow motion.”

An abrupt crash-and-burn scenario might just startle governor, lawmakers, and the state high

court into dramatic actions, which could unshackle some of the fetters on management of our state. If not, our elected officials will simply kick the can down the road, as ever, and population flight will continue.

After all, Illinois is not well managed, as my Florida-bound friend observed.

## Electronic recycling now has COVID-19 guidelines

**OREGON** – The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will be accepting residential electronics from Ogle County residents for recycling on Friday, July 31, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the County Annex Building at 909 Pines Road in Oregon.

This event is for electronic items from Ogle County residents only, please limit seven large items per monthly recycling event.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and for the protection of workers and residents, the following guidelines have been put in place by the OCSWMD for the acceptance of residential electronic items:

All residents attending the event must stay in their vehicles at all times with the windows closed.

Residents are to show their acceptable Ogle County I.D. to county staff through vehicle window (drivers' license, voter registration card, or recent utility bill accepted).

Electronic items must be loaded into trunk, truck bed, trailer, or rear of a van or SUV, and easily accessible to county staff to remove. Limit of seven bulky accepted items per vehicle; and box or tub loaded with smaller items is considered one bulky item.

Residents are advised to bring in

only accepted items for recycling, please check the list below or visit the county website for a full list of accepted items.

Items must be removed from original packaging prior to arrival at the recycling event.

Microwave ovens are \$5 per unit. If you have a microwave oven to recycle please tape an envelope with payment to the outside of the device prior to arrival at the event. Cash or check, payable to Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department, accepted. Exact payment only, no change will be available for larger denominations.

If a resident or their family member(s) are feeling ill it is advised that they stay at home and recycle their electronics at another future recycling event.

If electronic items have been in a residence with a positive COVID-19 individual, it is advised to not bring these items in for recycling until a future recycling event.

### Acceptable items

Accepted items include all televisions, computers, computer monitors, computer hardware and cables, printers, FAX machines, copiers, scanners, video gaming items, VCR/ DVD players, cable and satellite boxes, cell phones,

tablets, laptops, radios, stereo equipment (no wooden speakers), digital clocks, holiday light strands, extension cords, phone systems, calculators, shredders (no plastic tubs), rechargeable batteries, CFL bulbs, and printer ink cartridges. Microwave ovens accepted for \$5 per unit, limit seven (7) bulky items per vehicle.

Items NOT accepted include smoke detectors, coffee makers, toasters, bread makers, vacuum cleaners, fans, heaters, air conditioners or dehumidifiers, lamps, power tools, alkaline batteries, LED bulbs, exercise equipment, medical equipment of any kind, toys or drones, business or institutional electronic items, and any packaging from electronic items such as boxes, plastic wrapping, and Styrofoam.

The OCSWMD reminds residents that recycling events may be cancelled or abruptly ended due to weather conditions, warehouse volumes, staffing issues, events related to the COVID-19 global pandemic, or for other uncontrollable events or situations.

## Store opens after COVID closure

SuperValu will ask its shoppers to wear a mask to enter the building

**OREGON** — The Ogle County Health Department last week announced the re-opening of SuperValu in Oregon.

The health department has worked closely with staff and leadership to get the store operational again. All staff and their households went through testing.

Staff were released to return to work once their entire household tested negative for COVID.

Any positive cases and their households are working with Ogle County Health Department case investigators to isolate.

The county health inspector did a re-opening inspection after sanitizing and cleaning took place at the store.

The store will be asking patrons to mask up before they come into the store. Please be respectful

of this and understand that everyone continuing to mask is still crucial in preventing community spread of COVID.

While there is minimal risk to the public of the SuperValu outbreak, any time you go into public places there is a risk of transmission. The health department is reminding everyone to continue to mask up, social distance and wash hands frequently.

The store was closed on July 8 after an outbreak of COVID-19 was detected.

The Health Department reminds people that the pandemic is not over and suggests the following precautions:

**Wear a facemask:** Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth to help prevent the spread of the virus to others, especially

those with underlying health condition.

**Watch your distance:** Keep at least 6 feet apart from others.

**Wash your hands:** Wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds frequently to prevent spread.

**Limit your time:** When possible, limit your time with others not in your household to less than 15 minutes. The more time you spend around others, the greater your risk of exposure.

**Go outside:** When getting together, outdoors is safer than inside to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

**Leave when needed:** Leave if guidelines are not being followed, there are others around not masking or social distancing, or there are too many people around.

## 4-H fair going virtual

Judges will start reviewing the projects on July 23

**OREGON** — COVID-19 cannot stop our 4-H members from showing at fair.

Even with the cancellation of the Ogle County Fair, our 4-H members are still working hard to finish their projects for the Ogle County 4-H Virtual Fair. Three hundred fifty-nine 4-H members from 14 clubs have the opportunity to exhibit general projects and livestock on Fair Entry, the 4-H virtual fair platform.

Currently, members are finalizing projects just as they would in a normal year. Members will then look at the virtual show requirements. This will tell them what photos or videos are required to upload to Fair Entry. General Project exhibits will include a project report and 3-4 pho-

tos or a slideshow to show off their work. Livestock exhibitors will upload an approximately 60 second video of their animal. By July 16, members will upload all projects and the Ogle County 4-H Staff will prepare for judging.

Starting July 23, judges will log into Fair Entry and review all projects. Then, for general project exhibits, they will select ribbon ratings, awards, and state fair delegates and alternates. Judges are able to leave feedback for the members as well. In early August, members will receive their results and feedback from the judges.

At the 4-H Fair, competition exists at two levels. First, 4-H'ers compete against themselves for exhibit ratings. Judges assign a blue, red, or white

rating for every animal and non-animal exhibit.

Entries that meet class guidelines and represent high quality work receive a blue rating. If the exhibit does not meet class guidelines, or is of low quality, it will receive a white rating. Red ribbons are assigned for exhibits falling somewhere in between.

Once judges assign ratings, all of the blue award winners compete against one another for the chance to become class champions or overall division winners. Each year, judges select a number of blue rated non-animal exhibits to represent Ogle County 4-H at the Illinois State Fair. The Illinois State Fair will also be hosting a virtual Fair for 4-H members showing general projects in 2020.

# Pineda pushing forward

Rising senior grappler becoming more confident on the mat

ROCHELLE lightweight Ivan Pineda faced many challenges early in his wrestling career with the Hubs. The 106-pounder immediately became a varsity starter as a first-year competitor, and without a consistent wrestling partner in the mat room, experience was tough to gain.

Those obstacles didn't hold Pineda back from pushing as hard as he could, however, and his contributions resulted not only in an IHSA 2A Individual Sectional qualification, but a trip to the IHSA 2A State Dual Championships, where the Hubs brought home a fourth-place trophy. Pineda has stuck with the wrestling program, and as the rising senior returns for his fourth varsity season, Pineda said he's gained significant confidence in his abilities.

"I'd like to make it to sectionals and possibly further," Pineda said. "It will take a lot of hard work from the day we start practice and I'll need to give 110 percent effort... I love how wrestling is a team sport, but once I step on the mat, it's all on

me. Our wrestling team isn't like any other team. We're basically a band of brothers and it's an amazing feeling."

A former RTHS Fresh-Soph Most Dedicated Award winner, Pineda set a new season-best in victories this past year, finishing with 17 wins at the 106-pound weight class. Pineda frequently wrestled

against 113-pounder Weldon Nay during practice, and Pineda said that having a consistent practice partner for the first time in his career helped him see more improvements.

"I felt that I did pretty well last season," Pineda said. "It was the best season I've had so far and I think having a consistent partner in Weldon really

helped me. I hope we can continue to practice together next season. I felt that I was much stronger in the neutral position and I was more aggressive on offense. I'd like to continue getting better from the bottom position."

Both Pineda and Nay are among several returning wrestlers from a varsity team that went 18-4 in

dual matches and finished third in both the Interstate 8 Conference Championships and the IHSA 2A Sycamore Regional. With Pineda, Nay and incoming freshman Tommy Tourdot primed to anchor Rochelle's lighter weight classes, expectations will be high this coming winter.

"We set a goal to have a positive record before

this past season and we did really well on that front," Pineda said. "I think we can make it to the dual team sectional and possible the state meet next season. As a team, I thought our offense was solid and nobody was really scared to take shots. I think we can get better off the bottom and score more escapes."

# Bowling centers challenge state over restrictions

ISBPA lawsuit aims to increase current capacity limits

ROCHELLE — When Illinois entered Phase 4 of Gov. J.B. Pritzker's Restore Illinois economic reopening strategy, many businesses around the state including gyms, retail stores and restaurants were allowed to reopen at 50 percent capacity.

Bowling centers like Rochelle's T-Byrd Lanes haven't received that same guidance, however, and a lawsuit filed Tuesday by the Illinois State Bowling Proprietors Association will seek to amend the current limitations.

The ISBPA published a press release Tuesday stating that successive orders issued by the governor have caused "tremendous emotional and financial hardship" over the last several months.

Under the current Phase 4 guidelines, bowling centers are allowed to reopen with only 50 people in the building.

For owners such as T-Byrd Lanes operator Dan Wyka, ongoing restrictions have presented the bowling center with many challenges financially.

"We've had to extend our loans and we've had to not make loan payments on our mortgages for a couple of months," Wyka said. "Bowling comes first, and with the pandemic ongoing, there are still people who don't want to come out. We're doing our best to clean everything, but the financial impact on us has been huge... We're hurting right now, and if we can't start our leagues up in August when we normally start them, we're going to be in big trouble."

## BOWL: T-Byrds adjusting to restrictions

ISBPA executive director R. William Duff stated in the Tuesday press release that bowling centers around the state have instituted a broad range of safety and sanitation measures as well as strict guidelines such as leaving one empty lane between each group of bowlers and daily temperature and wellness checks.

At T-Byrd Lanes, Wyka said he and his staff have stepped up to ensure the bowling center is safe for both bowlers and employees.

"We have one table per pair of lanes and we leave all the bowling balls down on the lane," Wyka said. "We sanitize them with bleach before we put the balls back for the next customers. We spray all the bowling shoes and everything gets left by the lanes before we take care of the cleaning. We've placed plastic over the keypads so the next group isn't touching a keypad that the previous group touched."

We've shut down our arcade games and vending machines because we're trying to keep people from touching something that somebody else touched."

If bowling centers like T-Byrd Lanes are confined to 50 or fewer people, Wyka said the limitation will have a significant impact on running leagues, which Wyka said are a major source of revenue for the business.

While adjustments could be made to adult leagues, questions about youth leagues and high school meets would still remain.

"We have three leagues that are right around the 50-person mark, which would mean that we could bring the bowlers in, but we wouldn't have anybody in the bar or the restaurant," Wyka said. "We have 70 bowlers during our Thursday league, so we would have to figure out what to do with about

20 of those bowlers... We could have 70 percent of our leagues, but we'd have to think about our youth leagues and high school leagues because our parents like to come and watch the kids... If we have to cut leagues down to 50 people, it's going to hurt the business."

An increase to 50 percent capacity would allow Wyka to host 100 people at T-Byrd Lanes, which would allow he and his staff to conduct all of their regular leagues. Since the bowling center reopened, Wyka said all bowlers have been asked to wear masks while inside, and additional sanitizing stations have been added to ensure bowlers are keeping their hands clean.

"We're in good shape if we can get to 100 people," Wyka said. "I could have all of our bowlers as well as our employees and some customers in our restaurant at separate

tables. We've posted on our doors that people wear masks... We'd ask our league bowlers to stay with their teams at their tables, which are already separated. We're adding more hand sanitizing stations and we're getting to the point where we'll have a sanitizing station behind every pair of lanes."

The ISBPA lawsuit filed in Lee County will ask the court to issue a restraining order prohibiting the state from enforcing the governor's order and request the latest executive order be deemed invalid. In the press release, Duff said the ISBPA has invested around \$40,000 to provide bowling centers around the state with proper protective equipment. Moreover, Duff stated that bowling is an activity that can be performed safely while wearing a mask.

"I agree with the lawsuit," Wyka said. "I believe 50 percent is fair."
