Locals share perspective on Floyd death

ROCHELLE – As protests and riots continue across the country in the wake of George Floyd's death, individuals and groups from across the nation are sharing their reactions to video footage of that specific incident and the greater issues at hand of racism, profiling and unequal treatment of African-Americans.

In the video, Floyd, who was African-American, can be seen being pinned to the ground for nearly nine minutes by Derek Chauvin, a white Minneapolis police officer.

Chauvin had his knee on Floyd's neck the entire time and Floyd can be heard begging the officer to let up because he could not breathe.

Despite pleas from Floyd and bystanders, Chauvin did nothing to lessen the pressure or weight on Floyd's neck, which ultimately contributed to Floyd's death. Since then, Chauvin has been charged with second-degree murder and three other Minneapolis police officers who were also on the scene are being charged as well.

In the light of this tragedy, many people across the country are protesting and speak-

ing out about the actions in the video and against the history of racism in the nation. Unfortunately, in many cases, the protests have also opened the door for violence and looting which takes away from the intended message and complicates the issues.

In Rochelle, a peaceful protest was held recently without any incidents, but some local individuals have expressed their perspectives on the video and also the bigger picture of what took place and what America as a whole should be doing in response.

Curbside checkout

Flagg-Rochelle library to begin pick-up service June 15

ROCHELLE – The Flagg-Rochelle Public Library will begin offering curbside pick-up service to current library card holders in the coming weeks.

The pick-up service will begin Monday, June 15 but patrons can begin placing holds on items they want to check out as early as Wednesday, June 10. Patrons can place their orders via phone at 815-562-3431, by emailing rochellereaders@gmail.com or online through the Prairie Cat Library Catalog at www.prairiecat.info and choosing the Flagg-Rochelle Public Library.

Patrons will need their library card number when placing items on hold to check out and all items checked out will be completely fine free. Library staff will email patrons when their items are ready for pick-up and patrons will call the library to follow instruction when they arrive.

"Please tell us that you have arrived, what parking stall number you chose and your library card number," library director Sarah Flanagan wrote in a press release. "Staff will check out the materials and bring them out in a bag while wearing a face mask for protection."

The library will be offering pick-up service Monday and Wednesday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Friday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. As another safety precaution, all returns must be done through the book drop to limit staff contact.

After being returned, library staff will also quarantine all material for one week before sanitizing it to be checked out again. The library would also like to inform its patrons if their library card expired in either March, April or May, it has automatically been renewed through July 1.

While the library is not offering any additional services at this time, it is still offering Axis 360, Tumble Books and Free Wi-Fi that can be accessed without a password in the parking lot or any of the benches surrounding the building. While the pick-up service may take some time to get used to, the library is very happy to be serving the community once again.

"We are so excited to see our library patrons," Flanagan wrote. "Please bear with us as we navigate through these challenging times, behind every great library is a great community."

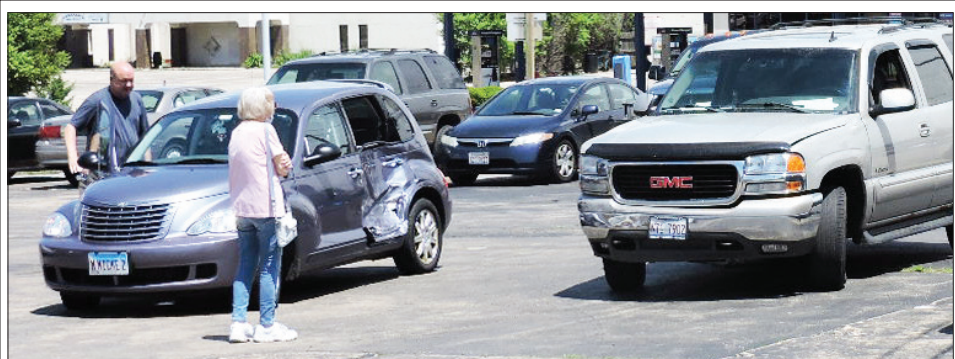

PERSPECTIVE: National issue prompts discussion from local residents

"The video made me cry, it is very hard to watch and both makes me infuriated and scared," said Jodie Hart, a Rochelle resident who is a white mother of two African-American children. "When somebody is begging for help and begging for their life and nobody stops, it makes me very angry that we are not listening to black voices."

With the advent of cell phone video and social media, more alarming incidents similar to Floyd's case have come to the forefront of late. For that reason, many people in the African-American community, including Jodie's 19-year-old son, James, were upset, but not surprised by the actions in the video. "We have been fighting this for years," James said. "It is very sad that I have to say that this didn't surprise me, but there are just so many videos out there and nothing has changed. George Floyd was just the tipping point of the bigger issue."

It is not only members of the African-American community who are voicing their opinions and protesting, but individuals of all backgrounds and even police officers are standing together to push for change with how authorities interact with African-American citizens. Local retired Illinois State Trooper Mike Broome, who spent over three decades in law enforcement, couldn't help but have a problem with how Chauvin conducted himself in the video.

"I have been through three police academies and I do not remember ever being trained to put a knee on somebody's neck to restrain them," Broome said. "If you have to cuff somebody, you put your knee on their shoulder to cuff them, but once they are restrained you get them up and put them in the vehicle. I was taught to restrain them, get them in the vehicle and get them out of there, I do not understand why Floyd was on the ground for nearly nine minutes."

From what Broome was taught and what he saw in the video, the way Chauvin conducted himself

was nowhere near normal procedure. However, while cases of racism and police brutality in law enforcement is a current hot button issue, Broome would like people to know that the actions of a few bad officers shouldn't paint all officers in the same image.

"It is a very small percentage of police officers who overstep their bounds," said Broome. "From my experience with the people I worked with, they are very dedicated to the job, and they are here to serve and make their communities better. If someone gets into law enforcement for any other reason than to serve the community, they are in it for the wrong reasons."

Many officers even continue serving their community in various ways after they retire. Broome and other officers in the area continue working with those looking for help by volunteering as a chaplain at the Winnebago County Jail.

The Rockford Reachout Jail Ministry is an organization based inside the Winnebago County Jail. The ministry works with the incarcerated to help bring them to Christ as a way to better themselves as a person.

"I tell them that me or somebody like me might have brought them or a family member in here, but that doesn't mean that we want you in here," Broome said. "It just means that you did something to be brought here. We are all in this together and not a single person is perfect."

While many people sympathize with the vast majority of very good officers who get put into a bad light after these situations, protesters are concerned that too much has happened in this nation and major changes are needed. The Harts believe the entire system needs an overhaul if anything is going to improve.

James added that he is concerned out in the world that an interaction with law enforcement could turn bad just because he is African-American.

"We need new training, we need officers to hold

other officers accountable," Jodie said. "Our officers need to start calling each other out and when there is a pattern of bad behavior, either retrain or let them go."

Locally, to ensure all officers and deputies are properly trained in how to safely restrain a suspect, the entire Ogle County Sheriff's Department and Rochelle Police Department complete a multiple day "Use of Force" training course each year. Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle also teaches his deputies to treat everybody with the same respect and encourages anybody who has an issue or concern that he is here to listen.

"I would want my family members spoken to and treated a certain way, so I expect our deputies to keep that in mind when dealing with the general public," VanVickle said. "Treat those people just like you would treat your family member, because they are somebody's family member. And I would encourage anybody who has suggestions or concerns to reach out to me at the Sheriff's office, I will be more than happy to sit down and talk and I will always return a phone call."

According to the Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby, all of his officers also strive to treat each situation the same.

"While there is no such thing as a 'routine' traffic stop, our officers handle our vehicle and pedestrian stops in a similar manner each time," Higby said. "Members of the Rochelle Police Department enforce laws and ordinances based on the circumstances at hand, without bias."

The Harts are hoping a better dialogue will come and she just wants white America to listen to the feelings African-Americans are trying to express.

"People who have never experienced what African-Americans face in this country need to start educating themselves and stop getting offended," Jodie said. "They also need to stop asking black voices to provide that education because it is not up to them, it is up to us to be better and take action, rather than just talking or posting about it."

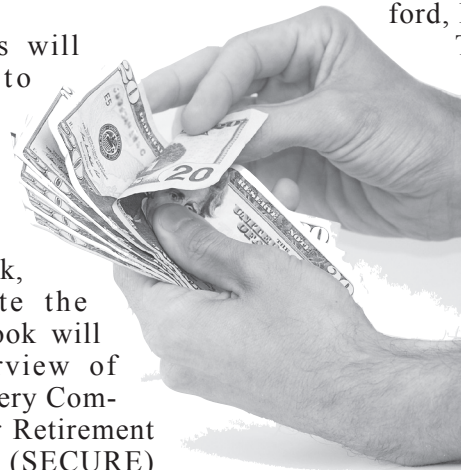
Mook founded Carl Mook Financial Group in 1988. The company

Wild Ones video series continues

ROCKFORD — The June Wild Ones program will be "How to Collect and Store Seeds of Native Plants." The online video educational program will be held Thursday, June 18 at 7 p.m.

While many of us have extra time now, maybe you have thought about growing your own wildflowers. The first step is to collect the seeds. June is the time to start collecting seeds from early blooming wildflowers, sedges and grasses. Mike Groves, natural resource manager

for the Forest Preserves of Winnebago County, will present a video primer on how to ethically collect and store seeds of native wildflowers, grasses, sedges, trees, and shrubs for use in natural landscaping projects.

Born and raised in the Winnebago area, Groves graduated in 1994 from the University of Wisconsin at Stevens Point with a major in wildlife management and biology. He started working with the Forest Preserve District in the summer of 1990 in

preserve maintenance and also worked a summer at Klehm Arboretum. He was hired full time in 1994, and eventually was transferred to the Natural Resource Department.

He currently oversees natural resource work in all 43 preserves and on all 10,500 acres. His job duties include seed collection, seed cleaning, greenhouse propagation, invasive species control, tree planting, wildlife monitoring, restoring natural areas, tree removals, and managing

prescribed burns. He also oversees all resource staff and equipment.

Man arrested for driving under the influence

On May 29 at 6:33 p.m., Ogle County Sheriff's deputies conducted a traffic stop in the 3000 block of S. Lowell Park Road for a traffic violation. After an investigation, Joseph Geesey, 55, of Mt. Morris, was arrested for driving while under the influence of alcohol. Geesey was transported to the Rochelle Police Department and was released on a \$3,000 I-Bond.

Ronald Korth

ROCHELLE—Ronald F. Korth, 73, passed away peacefully Wednesday, June 3, 2020 with his family by his side at his home. Ron was born on Aug. 30, 1946 to Arnold J. and Marie V. (Wichman) Korth in DeKalb. He proudly served with the United States Army from 1967 to 1969. On June 24, 1972, he married Mary McCaslin in rural Rochelle.



Ron enlisted in the U.S. Army after graduating from Shabbona High School. He served as an aircraft commander in Vietnam with the 173rd Airborne, piloting a Huey helicopter. He saw a lot of action, including the battle of Dak To, Hill 875, and the Tet Offensive. His favorite missions were with the long-range reconnaissance patrol. After his tour, he was a flight instructor at Fort Rucker, Alabama.

After leaving the Army, his friend, Chuck Hendrickson, helped him get a job as a crop duster. He then went on to graduate from the University of Illinois in 1980 with a Bachelors in Agricultural Education. He taught high school agriculture for a year, then went back to his first love, crop dusting. He

was a crop duster for 50 years and was a mentor to many aspiring young pilots along the way. Among his many lifetime accomplishments, Ron worked hard to obtain his Airframe & Powerplant Mechanic and Inspection Authorization certificates. Over the years, Ron totaled more than 90,000 hours in helicopters. He also found time to teach welding part-time at Kishwaukee College for 20 years.

In the off-season, when Ron wasn't flying, he enjoyed being with his family, working on projects with "the boys at the hangar" and finishing the day off with a beer and some popcorn. He was a proud member of the American Legion and the Experimental Aircraft Association.

Ron, a lifelong Catholic, is best remembered as a humble, hardworking man whose quiet strength provided comfort to all. He was a loving father, husband, grandfather, brother, and friend. Kind and patient, he was an unwavering rock to those who were lucky enough to know him.

In addition to his parents, Ron is preceded in death by his sister and brother-in-law, Val Jean and Thomas Emerling; brother-in-law, Burl Rainwater; and granddaughter,

Overcome fear that keeps you from your destiny

GOD has a wonderful plan for each of our lives. Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV) says, "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." When we put our faith in Jesus as our Savior, we put ourselves in a position to walk out our God-given destiny.

Sadly, many believers in Christ aren't living out their destiny because of fear. The fear of man is a common problem that causes us to worry about things like, "What will they think of me? What are they going to say about me? What will they do if I don't do what they want? What if they reject me? What if they don't like me?"

Everyone struggles with insecurity and the fear of rejection to some degree. And there's nothing wrong with wanting people to like you. But when we are so focused on being people pleasers that our fear of being rejected, judged or criticized controls our choices, we're being controlled by the fear of man.

If we're going to get free of fear and really pursue everything God has for our lives, we

have to make a decision that we won't let fear be the ruling factor—we will not live with fear. Instead, we can learn how to live courageously by the grace and strength we have in Christ.

It's important to understand what it means to live courageously. It doesn't mean we will never feel fearful, because the truth is, we will never completely get rid of the feeling of fear. But it does mean that when we feel afraid, we can do whatever we need to do through Christ who gives us strength. (See Philippians 4:13.) We can follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and do what God puts in our hearts to do, rather than settle for an okay or average life. And God wants to do amazing things in our lives that will likely pull us out of our comfort zones and require us to walk by faith to do them.

Now, I'm not talking about making foolish choices or doing things that are dangerous because you don't want fear of those things to hold you back. Being free from fear means we can be bold and take risks instead of just doing what seems "safe" but keeps us from becoming everything God

has created us to be.

I remember when I had to make some bold, scary choices so I could move forward in God's plan for my ministry. I had friends who didn't think I had the right personality to be a Bible teacher. There were people in my church who didn't think women should teach the Word. And there were family members who didn't understand the call of God on my life and they rejected me because of it.

It was a very hard time, but I'm so glad God gave me the courage I needed to do it afraid. Now it's scary to think about where I would be if I hadn't trusted God and followed His plans for me because of fear that I'd lose my friends and not be well thought of by others.

The only way you can conquer fear is to confront it—to keep going forward with God while the enemy of fear is trying to drive you backward. Remember that "the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline" (2 Timothy 1:7 NIV).

When you're struggling to do what you

know God wants you to do, go to the Word for encouragement. Here are a few powerful scriptures (NIV) you can use to conquer fear:

Isaiah 41:10 says, "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Psalm 118:6 says, "The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?"

Psalm 27:1 declares, "The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?"

Romans 8:31-32 says, "...If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?"

The Word of God has power to set you free from fear. Take time to study these verses and pray for God to help you live courageously in His will for your life. You'll discover there's nothing more exciting than overcoming fear and finding freedom to fulfill your destiny.

RTHS Boys Basketball

Growing his game

Senior guard Hickey helps Hubs turn around early-season struggles

THE Rochelle boys basketball team pieced together one of its strongest second-half season stretches in recent history this past winter, finishing 20-12 overall behind a 16-3 run over its last 19 games. Senior guard Ben Hickey played an integral role in helping the Hubs turn their early-season struggles around.

Hickey, who spent four years with the RTHS basketball program, was primarily a reserve during the 2018-19 season before becoming a key role player during his senior campaign. His defense, rebounding and occasional scoring provided Rochelle with much-needed depth this past winter, and his improvements garnered positive feedback from head coach Tim Thompson.

“Ben had a very solid senior season,” Thompson said. “He was a pleasure to coach and he always had a smile on his face. I wish Ben the best of luck with his future endeavors. I know that Ben will be successful in anything he chooses to put his mind to.”

As Rochelle geared up for the postseason, Hickey was part of a largely six-player rotation that pulled together an enormous upset

against the Sterling Golden Warriors in the IHSA 3A Regional Semifinals at the Musgrove Fieldhouse. While the Hubs fell just short against another high seed in Geneseo, Hickey said the regional atmosphere is something he’ll always remember about

his career with the RTHS basketball program.

“I enjoyed all of our games,” Hickey said. “I feel that my communication improved the most throughout my time with the team. The playoffs during my senior season will be my favorite memories from playing

for the Hubs. Overall, the basketball program taught me how to be the best student-athlete I can be, both in the classroom and on the court.”

A multi-sport athlete, Hickey also competed with the cross country and track programs at RTHS. He

finished his track and field career with personal-best times of 12.86 seconds and 1:04.01 in the 100 and 400-meter dash, respectively. Hickey also competed in the high jump, posting a personal record clearance of 5 feet 8 inches in 2019.

An Interstate 8 Academ-

ic All-Conference honoree this season, Hickey first began playing basketball in seventh grade to compete alongside his friends. After high school, Hickey said he plans to attend Northern Illinois University to study engineering and technology.

FOR Rochelle Township High School senior Lilly Portzen, playing for the Lady Hub basketball program was about more than the action happening on the court.

Seebach makes most of senior volleyball season

SENIOR middle blocker Allison Seebach found a few unique ways to make the most of her final season with the Rochelle Township High School volleyball program.

Seebach was unfortunately sidelined with injuries twice throughout the 2019 campaign, with the second injury keeping her on the bench for the final portion of the regular season and postseason. However, Seebach managed to stay active with the team, using her time on the bench to build up her relationship with assistant coach Lindsay Suess and senior teammate Gabrielle Harding, who was also out of the Rochelle lineup with an injury.

"Even though I was injured, Gabby was also injured, so we would sit together and watch our practices and matches," Seebach said. "We would throw volleyballs all over to see who would notice, and during each match, we would sit and talk with coach Suess... What I enjoyed most about my time with Rochelle volleyball was how close we all were off the court. We all shared so many inside jokes and we could talk to each other about anything."

Although Seebach didn't see the floor much her senior season, she started at middle blocker when healthy, finishing 2019 with 16 kills, five blocks, five digs and Academic All-Conference honors from the Interstate 8. A four-year player for the Lady Hubs, Seebach peaked during her junior season, when she totaled 19 blocks for the varsity team and helped anchor a Rochelle squad that advanced to the IHSA 3A Regional Finals against eventual state champion Sterling.

"One of my favorite moments was when we played Sterling at the regional championship last season," Seebach said. "We all knew Sterling had an amazing team, but that didn't stop us from playing hard and making it a very close match... RTHS volleyball helped me improve all of my skills. My hitting and blocking improved dramatically from my freshman season to my senior season. Even though I hit and block a lot, I thought my passing improved as well."

Seebach, who also earned Academic All-Conference recognition in 2018, began playing volleyball at St. Paul Lutheran School in

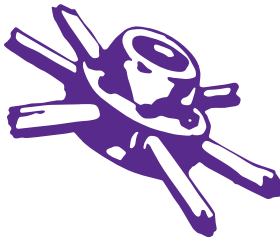

Illinois High School Association

IHSA schools awaiting Return to Play Guidelines

IDPH approval still pending

ROCHELLE—As the state works through Phase 3 of the Restore Illinois plan implemented by Gov. J.B. Pritzker, student-athletes and coaches are anxiously awaiting guidelines from the IHSA that will allow them to resume activities and safely return to action.

IHSA Executive Director Craig Anderson released a statement this past Friday that the association has been working with the IDPH to finalize Return to Play Guidelines to safely reunite coaches and student-athletes within the governor's Restore Illinois boundaries. The statement detailed that guidelines would be enacted on Monday, June 1, but after multiple daily postponements, the IHSA has not yet revealed its guidelines to state athletic directors.

"I recognize that IHSA schools, students, and coaches are anxious for the IHSA Return to Play Guidelines to be released," Anderson wrote in an additional statement Tuesday. "In many ways, they represent the first step in a return to normalcy as we continue to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. The IHSA Sports Medicine Advisory Committee was diligent in their development of these guidelines, and we have worked in good faith with the Illi-

nois Department of Public Health (IDPH) to make sure our plan optimizes safety for high school students in Illinois."

Multiple reporters stated earlier this week that the guidelines are awaiting approval from the IDPH. Kevin Schmit of the Daily Herald reported Wednesday

that the Illinois Athletic Directors Association (IADA) will not keep athletic directors on call until an announcement is made by the IHSA. Additionally, Schmit reported that a virtual meeting between the IHSA and state athletic directors will be held the day after guidelines are announced.
