## Fox sightings alarm pet owners

**Rochelle resident John Shank captured this photo of what the Illinois Department of Natural Resources has identified as a red fox. Shank encountered the wild animal while walking his dog near St. Paul Lutheran Church on 10th Avenue early Thursday morning. The animal came running out of the 14th Street intersection to chase down a baby rabbit on the St. Paul grounds just 25 feet from Shank and the small dog, and then quickly ran off with the prey across the street before disappearing behind a neighbor's yard.**

**ROCHELLE**—Recent fox sightings in town have many owners of small pets thinking twice about letting their house animals outside unattended.

In the last few weeks, multiple residents have commented on social media about a fox roaming around their neighborhoods, and on occasion reported attack attempts on rabbits and cats near homes. Two recent sightings in Rochelle were reported near Central School on Ninth Street and at St. Paul Church and School on 10th Avenue near 14th Street.

"I was on the phone with my mom and all of a sudden she started screaming and said the fox was right up by her porch,"

local resident Bree Celine said. "It was looking right at her cat and lunged for it. Luckily she screamed to scare the fox away and got the cat inside before it was too late."

Celine said she called local authorities and county animal control about the incident and was directed to the Illinois Department

of Natural Resources. After speaking with an IDNR official, she was told private trappers would need to be hired to capture the fox.

"I just really hope that something can be done about this," Celine said. "Because I don't want anything to happen to anybody's pets."

While many people

might wonder why foxes chose to come into town and how to get rid of them, local resident Emily Page believes that it is to protect their young from predators.

"I grew up on a farm and have seen this before," Page said. "If they (foxes) are out in the wild, there is no protection from coyotes that hunt for their babies. So, the foxes go where they are protected and surrounded by people where coyotes will not go. Then, once the kits are old enough, they go back out where they are supposed to be."

According to the IDNR, foxes are very important to the ecosystem by helping control the population of rabbits and rodents, but they can sometimes become a nuisance in communities.

The best way to prevent a fox from attacking pets is to limit the opportunities of it happening.

**Preventing wildlife attacks on pets**

Having a pet attacked or killed by wildlife is a traumatic experience. However, there are easy steps you can take to prevent attacks and keep your pet(s) safe.

Watch out for your pets. Keep pets inside when possible. When a pet does go outside, make sure it is on a leash or in a fenced-in yard with access to shelter. Small dogs, cats, rabbits and other domestic pets should never be left alone outside at night.

## Community foundation awards relief funds

**ROCHELLE**—Selected to distribute \$100,000 from the Illinois COVID-19 Response Fund (ilcovidresponsefund.org), The Rochelle Area Community Foundation is pleased to announce grant awards to nonprofit organizations across Ogle County assisting those affected by the social and economic implications of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Intended to quickly respond to basic needs such as emergency food and supplies, housing and emergency shelter, health and mental health care services, short term rent, mortgage and utility assistance with a focus on vulnerable populations, the Rochelle Area Community Foundation approved \$100,000 in grants to 13 local organizations.

Rochelle Christian Food Pantry was awarded \$15,000 toward a walk-in refrigerator and freezer to increase their capacity to serve the community.

Lifescape Community Services was awarded \$10,000 to meet the increased need for meals on wheels in Ogle County.

Easter Seals was awarded \$2,000 to respond to emergency needs of Ogle County residents served by Easter Seals of Metropolitan Chicago.

Sinnissippi Centers was awarded \$5,000 to support the needs of individuals with serious mental illness residing at Fairview Apartments.

Village of Progress was awarded \$8,000 to assist with care packages for their clients while services are interrupted.

Rochelle Rescue Mission was awarded \$3,000 to assist with essential needs of vulnerable populations within Ogle County.

"We are very thank-

ful to get the money we received," said Conrad Olson, Rochelle Rescue Mission on site coordinator. "It is going to go to motel stays and COVID necessities such as masks, sanitizer, cleaning supplies and to the Ogle County utility needs to help anybody in the county who has been affected by COVID."

Farmworker and Landscaper Advocacy Project (FLAP) was awarded \$7,500 to provide direct assistance to Latino and immigrant populations affected by the pandemic throughout Ogle County.

Kitchen Table was awarded \$10,000 for emergency food and supplies to provide take and bake meals.

"It is awesome to be chosen to receive these funds, it is such a huge

relief," The Kitchen Table founder Carolyn Brown said. "We have been serving over 100 meals every night we do it and the funds will be used to purchase more ingredients, pans and lids."

Northern Illinois Food Bank was awarded \$3,600 to provide mobile food pantries in underserved areas of Ogle County.

Hub City Senior Center in partnership with Rochelle Rescue Mission and Rochelle United Methodist Church were awarded \$10,000 to assist with utility bills.

HOPE of Ogle County was awarded \$6,000 to provide basic needs such as food, supply and rent assistance for those affected by domestic violence.

## Library hosting virtual events

Summer reading program and annual pet show happening online

**ROCHELLE** – To keep everybody safe during the current COVID-19 pandemic, the Flag-Rochelle Public Library announced it will be holding some of its annual events and programs virtually.

The library recently announced it will be conducting its annual Pet Show and summer reading program completely virtually this year. The library has partnered with a program that allows individuals to sign up and keep track of their reading both online and on their own.

The summer reading program is open to people of all ages and is broken up into different age groups accordingly. To register themselves, their child or both, individuals



can visit [www.flaggrochelle.readsquared.com](http://www.flaggrochelle.readsquared.com), answer a few registration questions and they will be assigned to the proper age group.

The different age groups are: Infants to age

5 (not attending kindergarten), age 5 (attending kindergarten) to 12, ages 13-17 and ages 18-19+. While individuals keep track of their reading online, the library will also be monitoring the progress and will announce surprises throughout the program.

“We will be keeping an eye on things and throughout the summer we have some specials things planned to reward them for their reading,” said Connie Avery, youth services librarian and assistant library director. “If they participate this week, maybe they will get a book bag or something like that.”

The library is currently

accepting applicants for the program and readers will have until mid-August to finish books. While the program will be conducted much different than it has in the past, the library is hoping the new online system will increase flexibility and allow for more readers to participate.

“Many of the kids are so busy all of the time, so it is hard to get them to come into the library for the program,” Avery said. “So, with it being different and them keeping track on their own, we are hoping that it will spark the interest of more readers.”

While the library cannot allow pets and people in person, it still wants to showcase pets within the community. With the reduction in new positive COVID cases and a partial reopening of businesses, RCH is easing, not eliminating, visitor restrictions. We know that when patients have a loved one with them they have less anxiety and often have better outcomes. Therefore, one dedicated visitor per patient will be allowed on the Medical/Surgical floor, Emergency Department and outpa-

tient clinics.

The visitor accompanying the patient must be the same person every visit for inpatient visits and Emergency visits. Visitors must meet screening/masking requirements and remain masked for the duration of the visit anywhere in the facility, including the patient's room.

Be assured RCH continues to review what additional areas can reopen based on meeting public health thresholds and State requirements. The health and safety of patients and staff are always top priority.

## Hospital offering sports physicals

High school, middle school, Rochelle Junior Tackle athletes or any

student athlete is welcome.

The cost is \$35 to be paid by cash or check only; no insurance will be accepted that night. All proceeds will be donated back to the schools/organizations represented.

Students and parents are asked to use entrance “G” at the South end of the hospital in the Health & Wellness Center. Masks are required and there will be a temperature check at the door.

Parents should be advised that this physical does not meet the requirements for incoming sixth graders or freshman physicals.

## FOX: Tips given to pet owners

Reduce food sources. Property owners should limit the availability of unintentional food sources such as spilled bird seed, pet food, ripe fruit or trash. When these resources are available, they attract mice and other small mammals. That in turn attracts predators such as coyotes and foxes to the neighborhood.

Use a leash when going for a walk. Like any parent, wildlife will aggressively defend their young. If a coyote or fox starts

following you and your dog while you are walking, you may have accidentally gotten too close to a den. Keep your dog close to you, wave your arms, throw rocks (to scare the animal away, not to injure it) and shout until the animal stops following or goes away. Find another route to walk for a few weeks.

Talk with your neighbors. Let others know if you've seen coyotes or foxes in the neighborhood. A coyote or fox moving through a neighborhood is not usually cause for concern. A coyote or fox that

approaches people may indicate a situation that could later escalate. These animals should be driven away from homes and yards so they don't become comfortable in these areas. Yelling, arm waving, banging pots or pans or spraying water from a hose are all ways to let the animals know they aren't welcome in that area.

Carry an umbrella. Sometimes hawks, red-winged blackbirds or other birds will “dive bomb” people or pets. Using an umbrella will keep the bird a safe distance away from you and your pet.

## Health department reporting cases of Cyclosporiasis

**OGLE COUNTY** — According to a health advisory posted by the Ogle County Health Department Friday afternoon, Ogle County is seeing cases of Cyclosporiasis.

A recent recall of bag lettuce from Hy-vee or Aldi due to Cyclospora is contributing to the cases of Cyclosporiasis.

Anyone experiencing symptoms is urged to consult with their physician.

sician.

Cyclospora cayentanensis is a parasite composed of one cell, too small to be seen without a microscope. This parasite causes an intestinal infection called cyclosporiasis.

Cyclospora is spread by people ingesting something—such as food or water—that was contaminated with feces (stool). Cyclospora

needs time (typically, at least 1–2 weeks) after being passed in a bowel movement to become infectious for another person. Therefore, it is unlikely that Cyclospora is passed directly from one person to another.

### Symptoms

Cyclospora infects the small intestine (bowel) and usually causes watery diarrhea, with

frequent, sometimes explosive, bowel movements. Other common symptoms include loss of appetite, weight loss, stomach cramps/pain, bloating, increased gas, nausea, and fatigue. Vomiting, body aches, headache, fever, and other flu-like symptoms may be noted. Some people who are infected with Cyclospora do not have any symptoms.

## Understanding faith and how it works

I like to define faith as the hand that reaches out and receives what God has for us. By faith we believe what God says in His Word is true, that it's for us, and that we will receive everything He wants to give us. We believe we have His promises before we get them or experience them.

Everyone has faith, but not everyone puts their faith in God. For example, when a person sits in a chair, they have faith that the chair will hold them. People drive to work because they have faith in the traffic laws that make it possible to travel on the roads.

But first and foremost, we need to put our faith in God and the truth of the Bible.

Romans 1:17 says, "For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed, both springing from faith and leading to faith [disclosed in a way that awakens more faith]. As it is written... 'The just and upright shall live by faith.'"

This verse reveals that we're saved by faith and we

are created to live by faith. In order to live by faith, we have to release it, and there are three ways we do that: praying, saying and doing.

Prayer is the greatest privilege we have! It's amazing that we can personally communicate with Almighty God, the Creator of the Universe. That means we can talk to Him and He hears us, and He wants to talk to us.

One of the main ways we hear God's voice is through His Word, which is why it's critically important for us to study the Bible. When we diligently study the Word, we get revelation of who God is, how He loves us, and what His will is for our lives. We learn how to pray for the things He wants to give us...the kind of life Jesus died for us to have.

James 4 says that people live in strife, quarreling and fighting, because they try to get what they want and they're jealous of what others have, but they can't make it happen for themselves. Verses 2-3 say, "You covet but cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight. You do not have because you do not ask God. When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures" (NIV).

Have you been trying to get something or make something happen and you're frustrated because you can't achieve it? Maybe you're struggling because you're striving to do it in your own strength or you're going after things that aren't right for you or in God's plan for your life.

We need to pray and ask God for what we want, but

we need to ask for the blessings He wants to give us. I often pray like this: "God, I'm going to ask You for everything I want, but if I ask for something that's not right for me, please don't give it to me. I really only want what YOU want for me, because You know what's best for me."

There are some situations where we may not know for sure what God's will is, and that's when we need to trust that if we don't get what we think we want, it's because He has something better for us. But there are many things we can ask for with assurance and confident expectation that God will give them because He promises them to us in His Word. Here are a few...

You don't have to be lonely because God is always with you (Psalm 73:23; Hebrews 13:50).

You can have peace in every situation (John 14:27; Philippians 4:6-7).

You can have God's wisdom for every decision (James 1:5).

You have the strength, in Christ, to do whatever you need to do (Philippians 4:13).

God loves you and He has an amazing plan for your life (John 3:16; 1 John 4:9-10; Jeremiah 29:11).

God has so much more for you than what you have experienced so far in your life. Make it your number one priority to spend time with Him every day in prayer and Bible study, and begin boldly asking Him to give you every good thing He's planned for you.

Put your faith in God in every area of your life and everything you do, and you'll discover how living by faith really is an amazing adventure.

my hometown paper and then served as city editor at a daily newspaper in Nebraska, a great newspaper with a publisher so horrible I have tried to block that time from my memory.

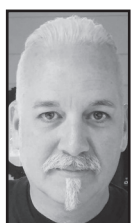

## Questions to ask when your doctor prescribes a new medicine

**T**HOUGH few people may want to take medicine each day, prescription drugs prolong lives and help people manage conditions that might otherwise make it difficult to live life to the fullest.

A 2017 survey from Consumer Reports found that 55 percent of people living in the United States take a prescription medicine. The survey also found that those who take prescription drugs use an average of four such medications. That figure might alarm some people, especially aging men and women whose bodies might be more susceptible to conditions that are often treated with medication.

There's no denying that prescription drugs can save lives. But men and women have a right to explore their options when doctors prescribe them medications, and asking the right questions when doctors suggest medication can help men and women decide if prescription medicine is their best option.

To help men and women make the best decisions regarding their healthcare, the National Institute on Aging advises people to ask their physicians these questions when being prescribed a new medicine.

- What is the name of the medicine, and why am I taking it?
- Which medical condition does this medicine treat?
- How many times a day should I take the medicine, and at what times should I take it?
- If the prescription instructions say the medicine must be taken "four

times a day," does that mean four times in 24 hours or four times during the daytime?

- How much medicine should I take?
- Should I take the medicine on its own or with food? Should I avoid certain foods and beverages when taking this medicine?
- How long will it take this medicine to work?
- Will this medicine cause problems if I am taking other medicines?
- Can I safely operate a motor vehicle while taking this medication?
- What does "as needed" mean?
- When should I stop taking the medicine?
- What should I do if I forget to take my medicine, ?
- Can I expect any side effects? What should I do if I have a problem?
- Will I need a refill, and how do I arrange that?

When discussing medications with a physician, it's imperative that men and women be forthcoming about any other medicines they might be taking under the guidance of other doctors. In addition, men and women should tell their physicians about any over-the-counter medicines or vitamins and supplements they are taking. Sharing such information can prevent potentially serious complications from arising.

Medicine saves lives every day. Smart patients can help medicine do its job by learning about their medications and discussing them openly and honestly with their physicians.

## Healthy eating options for seniors

**“**LET food be thy medicine” is a quote attributed to Hippocrates, the ancient scholar considered to be the father of modern medicine. The saying relates to the notion that what people put in their bodies can heal and/or prevent certain conditions.

For seniors with medicine cabinets full of over-the-counter and prescription medications, the idea of relying predominantly on food to promote optimal health may be tempting, and various foods can be particularly useful to the 50-and-over demographic.

According to the World Health Organization, poor diet is a major contributor to many of the diseases that affect older people. Poor diet has been connected to the development of diabetes, and degenerative diseases such as osteoporosis also may be linked to the foods ones eat. The National Council for Aging Care says micronutrient deficiency is often a problem among the aging due to factors like lack of variety in diet and reduced food intake. Eating a variety of foods can provide all of the nutrients people need to stay healthy as they get older. Certain foods may be particularly helpful.

- **Brain-friendly foods:** Foods such as avocado, leafy vegetables, sunflower seeds, blueberries, and salmon are good sources of vitamin E, antioxidants, omega-3 fatty acids, and other nutrients that may help ward off dementias like



Alzheimer's disease, advises Sonas Home Health Care.

- **Anti-inflammatory foods:** Foods rich in omega-3 fatty acids may help prevent inflammation that can cause cancer and rheumatoid arthritis. Aging.com says foods that are high in omega-3 fatty acids, like salmon, should be consumed at least twice per week.
- **Fruits and vegetables:** Fresh, canned or frozen produce tend to be high in micronutrients, including a variety of important vitamins that are essential for all components of health. The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics advises eating dark green vegetables, such as leafy greens or broccoli, and orange vegetables, such as carrots and sweet potatoes.
- **Energy-boosters:** Choose whole grains that can provide sustained energy by way of healthy carbohydrates over processed grains.
- **Bone-friendly foods:** Calcium-rich foods, such as milk, yogurt and cheese, can prevent calcium from

being leached from the bones, which contributes to conditions like osteoporosis.

- **Digestive system-friendly foods:** The digestive system slows down as the body ages, as the walls of the gastrointestinal tract thicken and digestive contractions that push waste along may slow down and become fewer. Foods rich in fiber can promote proper digestion by moving food through the digestive tract more easily. High-fiber foods also may help naturally reduce blood cholesterol levels.
- **High-iron foods:** Without enough iron in the body, a person may feel tired and lethargic from a reduced production of hemoglobin, which carries oxygen in the blood from the lungs to the rest of the body. A lack of oxygen in body tissues from anemia can be serious, says the National Council for Aging Care. Tofu, spinach, lentils, pumpkin seeds, and fortified breads and cereals are high in iron.

Smart food choices can help seniors live long and healthy lives.

## Who is most vulnerable to osteoporosis?

**O**STEOPOROSIS is a disease in which the density and quality of bones are reduced. According to the International Osteoporosis Foundation, age and gender are two of the fixed risk factors for osteoporosis. Fixed risks factors are things that cannot be changed, and the IOF notes the importance of being aware of these factors.

Awareness of the fixed risk factors for

osteoporosis allows people to take steps to reduce bone mineral loss in an effort to prevent osteoporosis. Bone loss is gradual and painless, and people may experience no symptoms suggesting they are developing osteoporosis, even though the National Osteoporosis Foundation notes that as many as one in two women and up to one in four men over age 50 will break a bone due to osteoporosis. In addition

to age and gender, the NOF notes that certain diseases and conditions can increase the likelihood that people with develop osteoporosis.

Autoimmune disorders like rheumatoid arthritis, lupus and multiple sclerosis and certain types of cancer, include breast cancer and prostate cancer, also can elevate a person's risk for osteoporosis. People who have neurological or nervous system disorders, such as Parkinson's disease and spinal cord injuries, also may be more vulnerable to osteoporosis than those without such conditions.

Men and women age 50 and older should discuss their medical histories and their risk factors for osteoporosis with their physicians.

## West Nile season is here, but no reported cases yet

**OREGON** — According to the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), West Nile Virus (WNV) is spread to humans through mosquitos that have been infected by a bird carrying the virus.

In 2019, IDPH reported 28 cases of West Nile in humans in Illinois, which resulted in one death. Most people that are infected have very few symptoms or experience a mild fever and headache. Those most at risk for adverse symptoms are individuals such as the elderly or those with weakened immune systems. There have been no reported cases yet in 2020.

### Symptoms

Symptoms of WNV include:

Fever  
Headache  
Body aches  
Skin rash  
Swollen lymph nodes



The Ogle County Health Department will be surveying nine sites in the county for infected mosquitos. Additionally, OCHD will be collecting dead birds in order to test for West Nile Virus. The following types of birds will be collected for testing:

Top Priority: Crows and blue jays

Second Priority: House

finches, house sparrows, and robins

Other Eligible birds: Blackbirds, bluebirds, catbirds, cardinals, chickadees, cowbirds, creepers, goldfinches, grackles, finches, flycatchers, larks, mockingbirds, nuthatches, orioles, purple martins, sparrows, starlings, swallows, tanagers, thrashers, cedar waxwings, and wrens

Excluded Birds: waterfowl, gulls, vultures, chickens or eagles cannot be tested.

These birds will be found most likely in midsummer to early fall. Birds that will be collected should have been dead for less than 48 hours and show no sign of decomposition such as strong odor, no presence of maggots and no bloating.

If a dead bird is found, please contact the Ogle County Health Department at 815-562-6976 as soon as possible.

Thiravong shoots 69 to open Girls Midwest Golf College Showcase

Since beginning her freshman season at Rochelle Township High School, rising senior Megan Thiravong has been shooting to achieve a single-round score of 69. That dream became a reality when Thiravong battled over 100 prep golfers during the 5th Annual Girls Midwest Golf College Showcase at Winding Ridge Golf Club this past weekend.

Thiravong outpaced the entire field over the qualifying round, carding 69 on the number before scoring 76 during the final round to place second overall in the 124-player tournament. While the tournament's nonaggregate scoring prevented her from winning the title, Thiravong was the only player to shoot under par for any round at the par-72 course in Indiana.

"Shooting under par is a very rewarding feeling," Thiravong said. "I greatly appreciate all of the support gifted to me from the community. I would like to emphasize the encouragement from my parents for always providing ample

tools to achieve success on and off the course, my coaches [Glen] Mehrings and [David] Cartwright for always cheering me on, the RTHS athletic department and the beautiful city of Rochelle for working together towards making this community a fabulous place to live and raise the next generation like myself."

Thiravong said her approach shots and her level-headed demeanor spearheaded her charge on the course, which featured numerous hazards including hills, prairie grass and water. While her practice routine has been largely unaffected, Thiravong said the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic erased the majority of her summer events and competitions, leading her to use the range simulator in her family's garage to continue sharpening her skills as the fall season nears.

"I appreciate all of the work that golf courses have put into establishing social distancing guidelines while allowing players to retain the joy of playing golf," Thiravong said. "I expect to continue

golfing well into the regular season with my favorite RTHS team members, and I think that we all will improve together as a unit. All of the boys have much potential that they have yet to showcase. I am positive we will have a great season this year."

A three-time IHSA State Championship qualifier, Thiravong will return to the Hubs this fall looking to make even more history as the school's first-ever four-time state qualifier. Thiravong will also be seeking to defend her Interstate 8 Conference Championship, and she'll be Rochelle's top returning varsity player from a group that hauled in six victories in 2019.

"My approach shots and short game need to be the focus of my practice for upcoming tournaments in order to improve my overall average," Thiravong said. "I have changed the angle of attack with my irons in order to enhance the height of the ball while increasing the amount of spin generated upon contact with the green. In addition, I narrowed my putting stance while straightening my swing plane."

Nambo, who has played soccer since he was 5, said he plans to study business at Kishwaukee College before transferring to a four-year university to finish his academics.

"I really enjoyed the bus rides home after wins," Nambo said. "I think I improved my communication the most and I became more of a vocal leader throughout my career. My teammates and I played together for a long time."

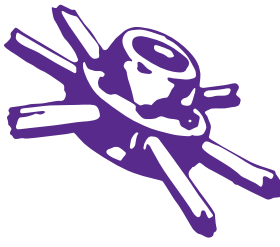

## Hub senior Etes shines as two-sport athlete

2019 was a very kind year for Rochelle Township High School senior Ethan Etes. Not only did Etes grow into a versatile starter for the Hub baseball team in the spring, but he also stood out as the starting quarterback and free safety for the Hub football team in the fall.

While the COVID-19 pandemic erased the 2020 baseball season, Rochelle finished 16-9 during its 2019 campaign as a member of the Northern Illinois Big 12 Conference, with Etes alternating at the second base and catcher positions. Etes, who averaged .324 with three homers and 18 RBIs in 2019, was an integral cog in an offense that scored nearly eight runs per game.

"My favorite moments from this past season were all of the home runs we hit," Etes said. "Our bus rides home after wins were always really fun as well. Playing

baseball at RTHS taught me a lot about behavior off the field and understanding how one player's actions affect the team."

Etes totaled 271 yards and one touchdown on offense while securing the secondary with a team-high three interceptions. Etes said he plans to apply for a career with an operator's union after high school.

Beating Ottawa in double overtime this past season was one of my favorite memories with the team. Playing football at RTHS also taught me about how one person's behavior can affect a whole team."

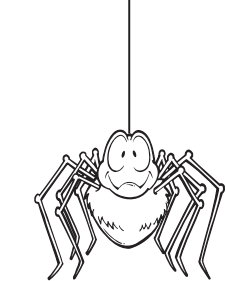

# FOURTH OF JULY



## The history of America's Independence Day

FEW summertime holidays elicit as much excitement as the Fourth of July, also known as Independence Day in the United States. Each year, family, friends and revelers anticipate the arrival of the holiday so they can host barbecues, enjoy the sun, listen to their favorite summertime tunes, and commemorate the freedoms afforded by the monumental events that led to the holiday's establishment.

Independence Day became a federal holiday in 1941, but July 4th has stood as the birth of American independence for much longer. July 4th marks a pivotal moment in the American Revolution. According to PBS, the colonies were forced to pay taxes to England's King George III despite having no representation in the British Parliament. "Taxation without representation" became a battle cry and was one of several grievances colonists had with Great Britain.

Conflict between the colonies had been going on for at least a year before the colonies convened a Continental Congress in Philadelphia in June of 1776, says Military.com. On July 2, 1776, the Continental Congress voted in favor of independence from England. Two days later, on July 4, 1776, delegates from the 13 colonies adopted the Declaration of Independence.

The Declaration of Independence is an historic document drafted by Thomas Jefferson. Jefferson was considered the strongest and most eloquent writer of the declaration writing committee charged with putting the colonies' sentiments into words. Richard Henry Lee of Virginia was one of the first people to present a resolution for American independence, and his commentary was the impetus for the formal Declaration of Independence. A total of 86 changes were made to Jefferson's original draft until the final version was adopted. The signing of the document helped to solidify independence, and eventually lead to the formation of the United States of America.

A total of 56 delegates signed the document. Although John Hancock's signature is the largest, it did not hold more weight than the other signatures. Rather, rumor has it, Hancock signed it so large so that the "fat, old King could read it without his spectacles." However, the National Archives says it was also customary that, since Hancock was the president of the Continental Congress, he be the first person to sign the document centered below the text.

The Pennsylvania Evening Post was the first newspaper to print the Declaration of Independence on July 6, 1776. The first public readings of the Declaration were held in Philadelphia's Independence Square on July 8, 1776.

## Tips for hosting a fun 4th of July party

THE Fourth of July is a day to celebrate in the United States. Much about July makes the fourth day of the month the ideal time to celebrate. School is out, the weather is warm and the generally relaxed attitude of summer has typically set in by the first week of July.

People tasked with hosting Fourth of July festivities may not feel the same pressure when hosting such gatherings that they would when hosting more formal affairs. The relaxed nature of summer often pervades Fourth of July festivities, but hosts can still take a crash course in summer hosting to ensure everyone has a good time.

- Don't try to break the mold. Some hosts may be tempted to think outside the box in regard to the foods and beverages they'll serve at their Fourth of July parties. While hosts can still experiment and serve new foods and creative cocktails at their parties, many guests will be anticipating some Fourth of July staples, such as grilled hot dogs and hamburgers and cold beer and lemonade.
