Missing windmill found

ROCHELLE – A very special garden windmill that was stolen out a resident's front lawn weeks earlier, was recently discovered by a father and son spending quality time together.

The five-foot tall garden windmill was purchased at an auction by Joanne Rogde who has always had a fondness for windmills. She put the windmill in a flower patch in the front yard, underneath an American flag since her husband was a veteran.

Her husband was also a die-hard Chicago Cubs fan, so when his health declined and he got very sick she stripped it down and painted the windmill "Cubby blue," with the Cub's logo on one of the blades. Her husband would look out the window at the windmill to see if it were too windy to sit on his porch swing.

Her husband has since passed away and one day she looked out that same window and cried, when she saw the windmill had been stolen. She informed the Rochelle Police Department and on April 18, made a Facebook post asking for any information and has been searching for it since.

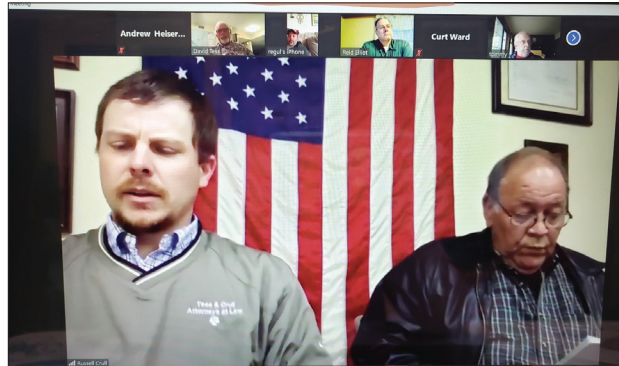

Safe Route to School project funding received

CRESTON – Due to the current stay-at-home order, the monthly Creston board meeting was conducted online via a Zoom meeting. All board members participated from their homes except for a select few, including Village President Wayne Williams, Village Attorney Russell Crull, and Village Clerk Deanne Haub, who all attended from city hall.

The first topics of discussion of the meeting were during the village engineers report. The

city is out for bids right now on automatic transfer switches for city well numbers two and three. The bids will be open to

hear at city hall on June 2 at 10 a.m. The second topic was the village's safe route to the school sidewalk project. Creston

has received \$156,000 in grant funds from Illinois Department of Transportation to move forward with the project and get a second bid.

Grant funding

During the streets and sidewalks committee report, Village Trustee Curt Ward informed the board of Rebuild Illinois funds the city will be receiving from IDOT in multiple installments. The funds are based on population and the village will be receiving a total of \$43,000 in six different installments. The first installment will come in

the next week or so and the amount will be paid in full within the next three years.

"Whatever check you are getting in a week or so, you will get five more of those," village engineer Kevin Bunge said. "It is supposed to be a check every six months, for three years, for a total of six equal payments."

During the meeting, board members also passed a motion to move forward with a seal coat project that will include all the streets on the south side of the railroad track as well as Main Street and Woodlawn Road.

Mobile wi-fi available to students

ROCHELLE – With students learning from home across the state, Rochelle Township High School administrators have thought of a way to help provide fast, reliable Internet access to as many students throughout the community as possible.

RTHS has partnered with Kajet, a mobile phone operator company that makes a product called SmartBus. This product uses Verizon LTE routers to outfit district vehicles into mobile WiFi hotspots. RTHS has five

of these vehicles that will be placed throughout the community in different locations, proving Internet access to students in their neighborhoods Monday through Friday from 8:30 to 11 a.m. and 1 to 4 p.m.

"There are a lot of other free Internet resources around town," said Will Wise, RTHS IT director. "But we wanted to make sure that we are able to serve those people who are stuck in their neighborhoods and not able to make it or travel to other locations."

Kishwaukee College offering online pharmacy technician training this summer

MALTA — Kishwaukee College's Community Education department is offering the Pharmacy Technician program completely online for the Summer 2020 semester.

Class will begin the week of May 26 and end the week of Aug. 27. Students registered for the program must attend the Orientation Session on May 19 at 7 p.m. via Zoom. Participants are required to have access to a computer and the internet to participate in the program. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act may provide funding to cover the cost of the class for participants who qualify.

The Pharmacy Technician program prepares participants to successfully start work and pass the national certification exam. Completion of this short-term training program provides an entrance into a career path that begins with a skilled, entry-level position with the opportunity for further career advancement. Participants must be at least 16 years of age to register for the program.

Pharmacy Technicians assist pharmacists with dispensing prescription medication. Depending on the position, the technician may also manage third-party billing, answer telephones, direct customers to items or to the pharmacist for medication consultation, receive written prescriptions, clean and sterilize dispensing bottles and instruments, answer questions regarding non-drug products and collect payments.

Farm bureau accepting applications for veterinary loan program

BLOOMINGTON — Illinois Farm Bureau® (IFB) is accepting applications for its Illinois Veterinary Education and Training (IVET) loan program. Loans are available to students attending any accredited college of veterinary medicine in the U.S. and who are focused on Illinois food animal medicine.

The Illinois Veterinary Education Training (IVET) Program helps offset the high cost of veterinary education. The program loans up to \$40,000 to as many as three veterinary students each year.

Loans are made over a period of two to three years. IVET awards recipients a \$1,500 stipend during their fourth year in school to help pay expenses associated with clinical rotations. Loans are repaid over five years, during which graduates must commit to working in a food animal practice that services Illinois livestock producers.

"Illinois Farm Bureau encourages veterinary students to pursue a career in caring for food animals. To succeed, farmers need the services of a food-animal veterinarian to help them care for their beef cattle, swine, sheep, and poultry," said Tasha Bunting, Associate Di-

The key to having a perfect heart

YOUR heart is the most important part of you. It's not only a physical organ that keeps your blood pumping, but when the Bible refers to the heart, it's talking about who you really are. Each person has an inner and an outer life.

There's the person we show to everybody around us and the part of us that only God can see, the part He really cares about.

The Bible tells us to have a perfect heart. Matthew 5:48 (NIV) says, "Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect." If you're a perfectionist, this is a scary verse, because it's a struggle to always try to be perfect. But this is not what it means to be perfect, according to Scripture.

The Amplified Bible translation of Matthew 5:48 says, "...Be perfect [growing into spiritual maturity both in mind and character, actively integrating godly values into your daily life], as your heavenly Father is perfect." A person with a perfect heart is someone who loves God and always

wants to grow.

2 Chronicles 16:9 (NIV) says, "For the eyes of the Lord range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him." This verse doesn't say that God can just work through those who are perfect but through those who are "fully committed to him."

Just as we don't have to make ourselves perfect before we come to Christ (which we couldn't do anyway), we don't need to behave perfectly in every area of our life before God will work in us and through us. When I first started teaching a home Bible study years ago, I wore short shorts and smoked while I taught the Word, sitting on my living room floor.

I had a lot of growing to do, but I really loved God and wanted to please Him. He met me right where I was and worked with me to get me where I needed to be. There's always room to grow in my walk with Christ, and I'm so thankful that God keeps working in me and through me on every level of my journey, every day of my life.

A person with a perfect heart is some-

one who loves God with all their heart, soul, mind and strength, and who is fully committed to Him. The question is: What areas of your life have you been holding back from God? Have you been giving Him your time, praying and studying the Word? Do you give of yourself to others, helping to meet their needs as you're able? Are you managing your finances the way God wants you to, living within your means, saving, spending and giving as He puts it on your heart to do so?

It's important to remember that whatever God asks us to do, it's always for our good. Initially, it may feel sacrificial, giving up things we like or want. But as we obey God, we find later on that there was so much more we didn't even know about, and what God wanted was much better for us in the long run.

More than anything else, the Bible says God wants us to love Him (Luke 10:27), and love sacrifices and obeys. The more we love Jesus, the easier it is to obey and trust Him. Because when you really love someone, you want to please them and make them happy.

What makes God happy is helping you do anything that will give you a better life.

In Mark 7:15, Jesus says, "Nothing outside a person can defile them by going into them. Rather, it is what comes out of a person that defiles them. This verse makes it clear that it's what comes out of a person's heart that really matters.

We all need to have a meeting with ourselves once in a while to examine what's really in our hearts. It's easy to smile and act like we're good on the outside, while on the inside, it's a different story. I remember times when I was in church, singing "I Surrender All" with my hands in the air, and thinking, "If Dave thinks I'm cooking something for him today, he's got another thing coming." It's possible to appear to be doing one thing while your heart is somewhere else.

My goal with this message is to help you make a committed decision to love God with all of your heart, and to fall in love with Him more and more every day. As you do, you'll discover how it's the key to having a heart that's more like His... a perfect heart.

First donation recipient announced

again vote via the Internet for its next donation recipient.

The organization especially wants to extend the invitation to women from each of the towns in Ogle County so that all areas are represented and all nonprofits in the county have the same chance of winning.

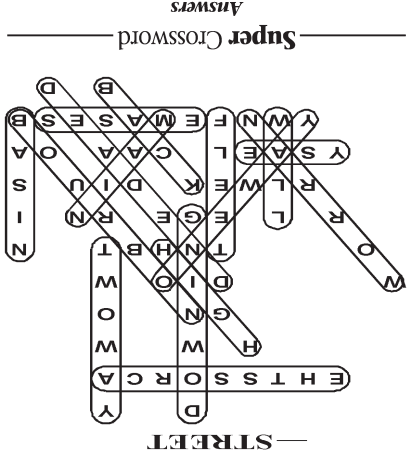
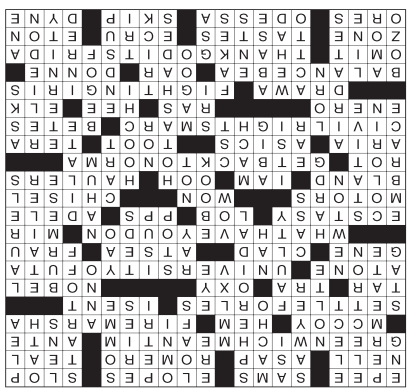

Employment security department processing claims 'in timely manner'

Ezike says honor mothers this weekend by staying home as state announces another 138 COVID-19 deaths

SPRINGFIELD — Gov. JB Pritzker said Thursday the Illinois Department of Employment Security is paying benefits to unemployed Illinoisans “in a timely manner” after a number of improvements were made to the oft-maligned process.

Three quarters of people filing claims received their first benefits within two weeks of applying, he added.

Personnel worked daily to “expand our systems and capacity” in order to address concerns from residents who could not access the online forms or reach a call center representative, the governor said.

“In many ways, they’ve been forced to build a new airplane while flying it,” he said.

Since March, the department has hired new employees and contracted retired ones, expanded the daily call center hours, updated its phone system and modernized its online portal. Its staff worked “thousands of overtime hours to process the avalanche of claims,” Pritzker said.

The governor announced the creation of a new call center staffed by 100 agents. Available Monday, it is designed to answer questions from residents filling out the online unemployment forms.

And for those using that web platform, he added, the system has been “improved measurably.” Web pages now load with less than one second of wait time.

The improvements come in time for independent contractors to file unemployment claims under a new federal program that makes those workers eligible for such claims. Pritzker said IDES will begin processing those forms Monday, but he urged eligible applicants not to wait.

The federal government mandates independent contractors or self-employed people apply for traditional unemployment benefits and be denied before they can apply for this new program.

Pritzker said those who apply for benefits by debit card, as opposed to direct deposit, could have the card mailed before entering a new pandemic unemployment assistance claim, even if their regular unemployment claim is denied. He said cards can often take two weeks to arrive, so applying early would speed up the process for when the pandemic unemployment assistance portal opens Monday.

The IDES website is “prepared to process more than 140,000 claims per hour,” the governor said, “and we will be using capacity at our new call center to support claimants starting Monday.”

Pritzker has faced criticism from Republican lawmakers about delays in the unemployment filing process, which he conceded was initially overwhelmed as more than 1 million

Illinoisans filed claims since March 1.

Republicans said in a videoconference meeting Wednesday that their offices frequently field calls from constituent reporting problems with their unemployment claims.

Delays in the department’s ability to process requests came after a decade of being “often overlooked,” understaffed and gutted by state government disinvestment, Pritzker said. He said IDES has 500 fewer employees than it did when the Great Recession hit in 2008-2009.

The systems, Pritzker said, were not constructed to meet the “historic” demand, which was far greater than the 180,000 claims filed in the first nine weeks of the Great Recession.

In all of 2019, IDES paid out about \$1.5 billion in benefits. In the first four months of 2020, it has paid \$2 billion.

“Beyond the thousands who’ve died and the tens of thousands who’ve been sick and the hundreds of thousands who’ve lost friends and loved ones to COVID-19, the financial toll to the people of Illinois has been breathtaking,” Pritzker said. “And it’s unprecedented.”

Health update

The Illinois Department of Public Health reported 2,641 new confirmed COVID-19 cases, and 138 residents died in 15 counties over the previous 24 hours. That brings the state’s total to 70,873 cases and 3,111 deaths in 97 counties.

There were 17,783 tests results reported in the last 24 hours, meaning the positivity rate for those tested in that span was about 15 percent. A total of 379,043 tests have been conducted thus far.

Dr. Ngozi Ezike, the department’s director, said residents helped stymie the growth in COVID-19 cases by social distancing, but the curve has “stayed flat.”

She said officials are watching what will happen as the weather gets warmer and restrictions are loosened.

“We’ll move quickly through the phases (of the Restore Illinois plan), but we have to be realistic,” Ezike said. “The more people are out, the more infections there will be. The more infections there will be, the more hospitalizations there will be. The more hospitalizations, some fraction of those will go on to have severe complications and potentially die.”

With Mother’s Day upcoming Sunday, Ezike said it is still important to observe social distancing.

“Please let’s honor our elderly mothers and our grandmothers this Mother’s Day by keeping them safe,” she said. “To do that, please stay at home. Please wear your face coverings. Please wash your hands frequently.”

In the Northeast region of Illinois, she added, the infection rate is slightly higher than 20 percent. In the other three regions outlined in the governor’s plan to reopen the state’s economy, that rate is “well under” 20 percent.

Pritzker said he thinks a viable COVID-19 treatment may be available before a vaccine, a development that would help the state’s regions begin to reopen.

“An effective treatment, I think, is potentially on the horizon and that will change everything,” he said. “(The Rebuild Illinois) plan can evolve. I’ve said we’re going to change the playbook — we need to because things will change as we go forward.”

Other notes

1. Pritzker said national sports leagues moving to restore their seasons is good for residents’ “psyche,” but his primary concern is ensuring their safety.

There is no state in the U.S. that can safely have thousands of people gathering in stadiums, Illinois included, the governor said. In speaking with sports officials, he said he learned many plan to resume games without fans physically present.

2. When asked whether the Nov. 3 general election will continue as planned, the governor said the General Assembly needs to pass a law allowing for mail-in ballots. He confirmed there will be in-person voting and how the state implements that with IDPH’s guidance “will be important.”

3. Pritzker said child care should not be a concern for parents because even under the stay-at-home order, 2,500 facilities were available. He added his administration convened a task force to ensure those services continue to exist.

4. Pritzker also announced his daily briefings will no longer occur on weekends.

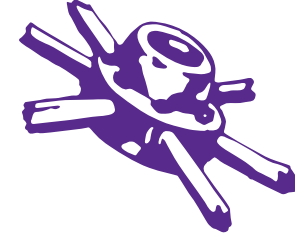

Scorching start highlights Wanner's senior season

Mark Wanner was on the road with his Washburn University teammates when the former Rochelle Township High School baseball standout heard the unfortunate news that his final collegiate season was canceled because of the coronavirus pandemic.

Wanner had been dominating opposing pitchers prior to the cancellation, which made the news much tougher for him to hear. The senior infielder appeared in 16 games with seven starts, leading the Ichabods with a .424 average while adding three extra-base hits and five RBIs. Wanner was ranked second in the Division II MIAA Conference in hitting before play stopped.

"I was devastated when I found out our season was canceled," Wanner said. "We were halfway to our weekend series and we had to turn around and come back to campus. I understand why our season was canceled but I was disappointed that I couldn't finish the season."

Wanner had been making significant strides from his junior campaign, where he finished with a .190 batting average and six RBIs. Despite missing time this past summer with a broken arm he suffered on a hit-by-pitch, Wanner said the mechanical adjustments he made to his swing over the offseason helped facilitate the improvements he saw in the box this season.

"The changes I made allowed me to have a great summer until I broke my arm," Wanner said. "I used most of the fall to rehab, but I played well in our fall games. I continued to work hard on my mechanical adjustments over the winter and they were paying off this spring."

Wanner, who helped guide Rochelle to an IHSA 3A Regional Championship in 2014, began his collegiate career at the NJCAA level, spending one season with Indian Hills Community College before transferring to McHenry County College, where he slashed .354/.453/.531 with 36 RBIs and was named an All-ISCC First Team member in 2018. He earned MIAA Academic Honor Roll recognition during his first season with Washburn University in 2019.

"My favorite thing about the Washburn team was playing the game I love at a high level with such a great group of teammates with similar goals of competing and winning," Wanner said. "I had a great experi-

ence with Washburn baseball. I made a lot of lifelong friends and we had a great fan base for the baseball team, which warranted an awesome atmosphere to play in. I was off to a great start to the season and I thought we had a great team chemistry."

Wanner, who majored in physical therapy, said he plans to enter a doctorate program and pursue a career in rehabilitation and athletic training. He said his most memorable experience with the Washburn baseball program was traveling to San Bernardino, California for a three-game series against California State in February. During the second game of the series, Washburn trailed 5-4 before Wanner hit a game-tying single in the top of the ninth inning.

"It was a cool experience flying over there with my teammates and touring the local beaches while playing a team from California," Wanner said.

"I think RTHS shaped them in a lot of ways," said mother Jeanie Jandak. "It's nice when we lay down core values as parents and we see those values reinforced at school. RTHS has really helped shape their character. I've seen them become more confident, especially in sports, and they learned to support other people. They learned good sportsmanship and they became more well-rounded individuals. RTHS has been like a family for us and we wanted to give back." "Jeanie and I are so proud of the boys for their academic and athletic accomplishments, and we know they couldn't have done that without the support of their coaches and teachers," father Bill Jandak added. "I thought the bell was a great idea and I think it can help student-athletes set new personal goals for themselves... The teachers here have been great in preparing the boys and the coaches have really pushed them. It's important that we give something back."

The idea for the bell, which features the Hub logo and the word "FINISH" displayed boldly on the front of its face, originated from William and Charlie, who recently completed their four-year high school careers under head coach Kyle Kissack. William, currently a freshman at North Central College, was a two-time All-Conference First Team offensive tackle at RTHS before helping the Cardinals take home the NCAA Division III National Championship this past season.

"We knew we wanted

to give back to the high school because of what RTHS has done for us," William said. "We liked the idea of the bell because our tradition after winning home games was always to ring the bell, so we thought bringing that into the weight room would motivate the student-athletes... We had a great brotherhood at RTHS and that family tradition was a major reason why I chose North Central College. I learned a lot of life lessons here."

Charlie, who will be continuing his academics and his football career at Washington University in St. Louis this fall, also earned All-Conference First Team recognition twice during his time at RTHS. William and Charlie helped guide the Rochelle football team to the IHSA 4A State

Quarterfinals in 2017, and later that school year, they were members of the Rochelle wrestling team that brought home a fourth-place trophy from the IHSA 2A Dual State Championship.

"It may seem small, but as football players at RTHS, the bell symbolizes a sense of completion," Charlie said. "It's everything to us, and we thought that if we could bring that symbol into the weight room and motivate the student-athletes to push themselves a little harder, it would mean a lot. The word 'finish' means pushing all the way through, whether it's in the classroom, in the weight room or on the football field. We learned that the closer the team is, the better chance the team has of winning, and that's what we really pushed for at RTHS."

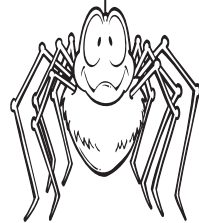

While there may be other Internet options throughout the community, this was done to help make it more accessible for people who may be bound to their homes.

Jason Harper, high school and elementary school district superintendent, presented the idea and Mr. Wise put the plan into motion.

"The schools are excited we were able to secure the hardware needed to provide free wireless Internet at various high need locations in our community," said Harper. "We hope by providing these Internet options, we can help close the connectivity gap created when schools closed for the year."

The school would also

like to thank Mike Tooley for doing all the physical installations. The district understands the struggles the schools closing put on many families and hopes this will help many of those families.

Acquiring the routers from Kajeet involved paying up front for a one-year contract, just like most phone service plans. So, the district plans to monitor all data usage during the duration of its contract, as this could be a viable option if school closures should extend passed this school year.

"We plan to review the data usage from these mobile hotspots and combine it with our stu-

dent engagement data," said Harper. "Based off these two pieces of information, combined with the advantage of using mobile vehicles to deliver the internet, we can modify our approach as time goes on to better serve our students."

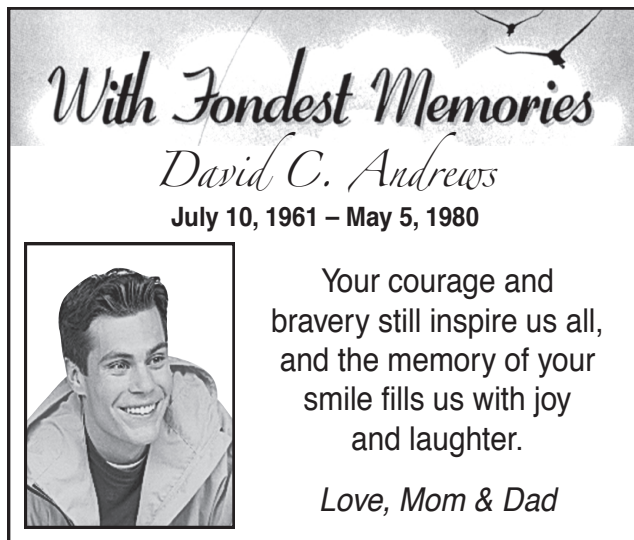

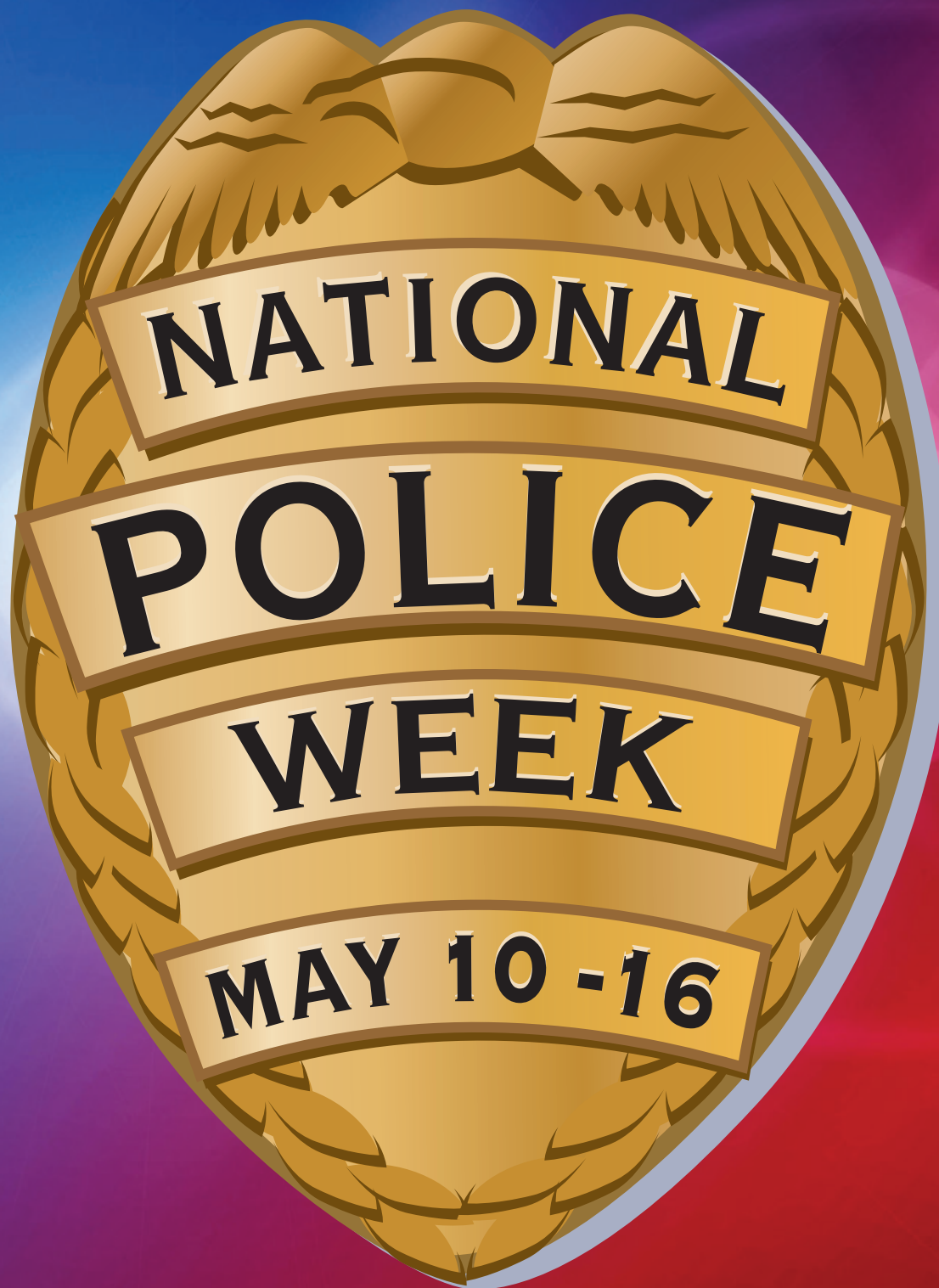

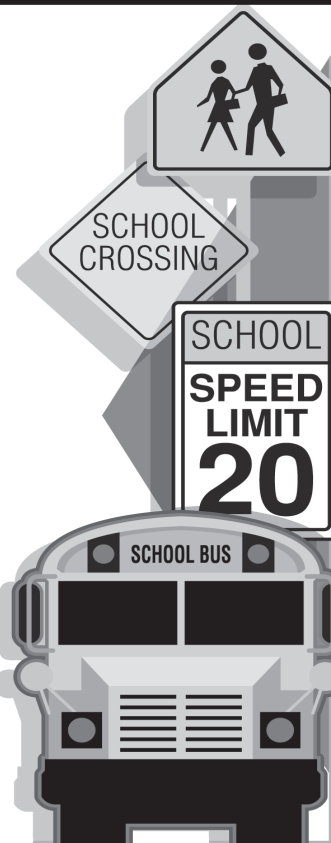

This is just a drill

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Township High School was host to an array of emergency personnel Saturday for an active shooting drill training session.

Area police and fire departments participated in the event that included more than 320 students and adults that took personnel more than 20 months to put together.

During the hours-long training session, police officers were faced with a shooter in the building who had detonated a pipe bomb.

According to Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby — during a mock media news conference — the 17-year-old student had barricaded himself inside a classroom in the “C” wing of the building along with approximately 20 students where he detonated the pipe bomb and began shooting a gun, critically injuring eight students before being taken into custody by police.

“Planning for this drill began in February of 2018 and in that time we’ve engaged the stakeholders and responders in numerous conversations, training and smaller scaled

walk throughs,” emergency management coordinator for the City of Rochelle and Rochelle Police Department Detective Terry Inman said. “This drill was another step in the process and we exposed the responders to concepts and tactics that they’ve either never experienced — such as responding to an active shooter in a school — or have recently begun to train with — such as rescue task force operations. I am very confident that we took away many lessons learned from this drill.”

Many agencies participated in one

fashion or another Saturday, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Illinois State Police District 1 and 15, ILEAS, MABAS, Rochelle Police, DeKalb Police, Rockford Police, Rock Valley College Police, Ogle County Sheriff’s Police and Emergency Management, Lee County Sheriff’s Police and Emergency Management, Oregon Police Department, Genoa Police Department, Rochelle Fire Department, Ogle-Lee Fire Protection District, Oregon Fire Department, Rockford Fire Department, Cherry Valley Fire Department, Dixon

Fire Department, City of Rochelle, Rochelle Street Department, Rochelle Water Department, City of Algonquin, Rochelle School District 212, Rochelle School District 231, Dixon public schools, Oregon public schools, Regional Board of Education, Focus House, Kishwaukee Education Consortium, Kishwaukee College, Western Illinois University, American Red Cross, Salvation Army, Sennisissippi Centers and AESI Counseling.

“Looking at initial observations and immediate reactions taken right after the drill, there were a lot

of favorable comments from participants regarding their experience with the scenarios and lessons they learned. As well, there were a number of constructive comments about things that could’ve gone different or better; and these are common with any training evolution,” Inman said. “We are in the process of assessing all of the participants’ feedback and will have specific action points in the weeks and months ahead with the completion of the After Action Report & Improvement Plan.”

Rochelle Township

High School District 212 and Rochelle Elementary District 231 Superintendent Jason Harper said that in the aftermath of the session, staff will be looking at security protocol, some of the pro-active things that are already being done and the reactive things that happened during the training and discussing with Rochelle Police and the other agencies that participated Saturday.

“We continue to do our training that we are required to do and I think we have done some things that are proactive in trying to be ahead of these types of situations but there’s a feeling we could always do more,” Harper said.

Inman believes Saturday’s drill was successful overall.

“Anytime you get individuals and entities together for a common goal such as improving the safety of our community and they all give 100 percent toward that end you can’t help but be successful,” he said.
