## Plant to reopen

Rochelle Foods workers to return to work Monday following 14-day closure for COVID-19 outbreak

**ROCHELLE**— Following a 14-day closure, Rochelle Foods, LLC announced that it will reopen as scheduled Monday, May 4.

The facility, which makes grocery, food-service and specially-formulated cancer nutrition products, completed COVID-19 testing of its team members last week with the vast majority of them testing negative. Of those who tested positive, numerous people had no noticeable symptoms.

During the pause in operations, additional enhanced safety procedures were implemented

including deep cleaning of high-touch areas, re-configuration of common areas and workstations, revised shift scheduling, new guidelines on carpooling and more extensive social distancing measures. Rochelle Foods will be moving forward with a reopening plan that exceeds CDC and OSHA guidelines, outlining procedures for continued team member safety and raising the bar on best practices in the food industry.

## Help for HOPE

Current stay-at-home order means closure of thrift store; no extra funding for domestic violence shelter

**ROCHELLE** – With the stay-at-home order forcing many businesses to close, a local nonprofit thrift store is desperately in need of donations to ensure being able to reopen and continue helping fund its partner nonprofit.

The Hope Chest "Twice Loved Boutique" is an upscale thrift store located in downtown Rochelle that has been serving the community and helping local domestic violence victims for 10 years. The Hope Chest donates all its proceeds to HOPE of Ogle County and is asking the community for help during these

tough times.

HOPE of Ogle County, the local domestic violence organization, and the Hope Chest work together to help victims in the community. At the thrift store, people donate new or used items, which the store cleans, prices and resells.

"We are self-sufficient and don't utilize any funds from grants within the system," said Jodie Hart, manager at the Hope Chest. "So, once our overhead is paid for such as, utilities, payroll and garbage, whatever is left, which is usually a big portion, all goes back to HOPE for their services to help clients."

## Beware of scammers

**ROCHELLE** – With all the stress, fear and uncertainty spreading in the world today, many phone scammers are attempting to take advantage of unsuspecting individuals during these troubling times.

Since the COVID-19 pandemic started and the stay-at-home order went into effect, both residents and authorities have seen an increase in reports of scam phone calls. Nonprofit organization the Better Business Bureau, Rockford office, uses a scam tracker technology to locate these phone calls.

The technology used is linked to a national network of 100 different offices in the United States, Canada and Mexico, which track and identify the different types of calls. The technology is so accurate it can track calls down to the zip code in a certain state. The BBB has seen a drastic increase in scam calls since the beginning of the pandemic.

"Since the advent of the pandemic, we have seen a ten-fold increase in the number of types of scams that are out there," said Dennis Horton, BBB director of the Rockford regional office. "The most prevalent types deal with the stimulus checks people are waiting to receive as well as filling out the 2020 Census. When you look at the pandemic, the census and stimulus check all happening at once, it almost creates the perfect storm for scammers."

The information gathered is sent to local and state law enforcement agencies including the Illinois Attorney General's Office, The Federal Trade Commission and local police departments. Recent phone scams in Rochelle have reported somebody pretending to be calling from Consumer Collections at the U.S. Diagnostics Lab.

Rochelle resident Barb Manning received a suspicious phone call earlier this week from a woman posing

as an official collection caller who claimed Manning owed for blood work dating back to April 2018. The caller told Manning she owed \$385.54 and a \$75 late fee could be waived if they came to an agreement on the phone.

Manning was smart and told the scammer that she would not pay anything until she researched it further. The scammer on the phone agreed and left 618-881-1117, as a number to reach her back.

Manning then looked deeper into the call and the suspicious bill and found out the entire thing was a scam.

"I called my insurance company and they called U.S. Diagnostics Lab, which is an official organization," Manning said. "The lab said they had nothing on record for me at all and my insurance had absolutely no claim filed; we know it was a scam."

Since receiving the phone call, Manning has contacted the Rochelle Police Department, and after multiple attempts to call back the number, it has not answered. Scam phone calls are something that occurs all the time, especially when there are big headlines in the news scammers can use to bait their victims.

### Do research

While these calls can be a real threat to anybody with a phone number, people can stay safe by being cautious and doing some research. The No. 1 way to stay safe is to never give out any personal or banking information over the phone, even if the person uses a real person or organization's name.

"Don't volunteer any personal information such as bank card information or social security number," said Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby. "Even if somebody calls and says they are from a local doctor's office, make sure to check into that. Anybody can look up a doctor's office online and say they are calling from that office."

## HOPE: Some relief coming in form of COVID-19 grant money

The thrift store also helps individuals going through the HOPE system come to the store. The store will provide them with anything they need, whether its clothes, furniture or pots and pans so they can remain in a safe environment. But with the current stay-at-home order, no new income is being brought in and expenses still need to be paid. This also means HOPE of Ogle County is not receiving any funds from the Hope Chest to help fund their services.

While the Hope Chest is unable to apply for grants, HOPE of Ogle County recently received some funds from a COVID-19 grant provided by the Rochelle Area Community Foundation. The grant funds will be used to help pay for necessary expenses to keep the organization open, but funds are still needed to help to continue providing direct services to clients.

"We applied for a COVID grant that they were giving out to non-profits and we received confirmation last week that we will be receiving funds," said Ruth Carter, HOPE director. "It will help replace a portion of the loss of revenue that we normally bring in through Hope Chest, and we are so thankful."

April is usually the organization's busiest month, bringing in approximately \$13,000, and the grant is replacing \$6,000 of that. But with the stay-at-home order now extended through May 30, HOPE will continue to see losses.

Through the current situation, HOPE of Ogle County continues to offer individual counseling for adults and

teens, mostly through telephone. Some crisis situations warrant seeing clients in person and when doing so, all necessary protective and social distancing precautions are taken.

Unfortunately, individual and group services for children have been postponed, except for crisis services in shelter. Emergency shelter and emergency orders of protection are also still being offered for those who need it. For anybody in need of help, the first thing they should do is call HOPE's 24/7 hotline.

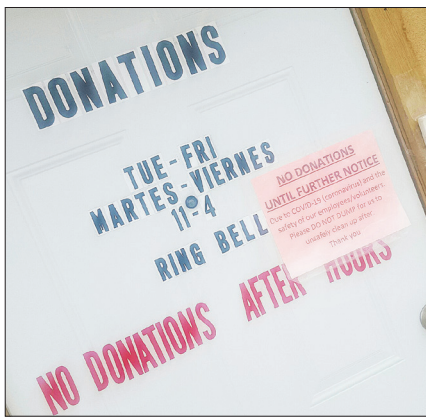
"Our main line is 815-562-8890 and people can call anytime, we are always open," said Carter. "Hotline information is also listed on our website at [www.hopedv.org](http://www.hopedv.org) and Facebook page."

During these tough times, monetary donations of any amount are greatly appreciated and go along way. Without the community's help, there is no certainty that these organizations will be able to continue serving the community in the future.

"We have a lot of people that come in and shop here on a day-to-day basis," said Hart. "So, I want to be able to continue to be open for the community."

Most Beloved Church in the northwest Illinois village of Lena has sued to block the part of Gov. JB Pritzker's stay-at-home order that bans public worship services in Illinois churches. The church is planning on holding services Sunday.

## Lena church challenges ban on worship services

Questions constitutionality of governor's action; executive order now allows for small church gatherings

**SPRINGFIELD** — A church in northern Illinois has filed a federal lawsuit seeking to block part of Gov. JB Pritzker's stay-at-home executive order, and especially its restrictions on public worship services.

The suit was filed by the Thomas More Society, a conservative legal advocacy group, on behalf of Pastor Steve Cassell of Most Beloved Church in Lena, in Stephenson County. The complaint argues that the order violates several provisions of both the state and federal constitutions.

"The spiritual well-being of the people of Illinois is just as important as their temporal well-being during these dark times," Peter Breen, vice president and senior counsel at the

Thomas More Society, said in a news release. "Keeping liquor stores open but indefinitely shutting down churches and religious ministries violates our constitution and our most basic liberties. If liquor stores are 'essential,' so are churches."

The church has said it plans on holding services Sunday, despite the order, although details of how that service will take place were still being worked out Friday.

The latest stay-at-home order that went into effect Friday has been amended to allow for small church services — limiting gatherings to 10 or fewer people and requiring social distancing.

The lawsuit cites an April 21 memo from David J. Robinson, chief deputy director of the Illinois Appellate Prosecutor's Office, to Director Patrick Delino, in which he argues that any local prosecutors who try to enforce the order, especially as it applies to worship services, would likely lose in court.

"It appears that the stay-at-home recommendations and social distancing are great recommendations," Robinson stated in the memo. "Those things should be practiced; but criminal enforcement of the EO is a different question. My research leaves me less than confident that a reviewing court will hold that the Governor has the authority to close businesses, bar attendance at church services and assemblies in excess of ten citizens (particularly if they are assembling to redress grievances)."

Pritzker issued the first stay-at-home order on March 9 directing people to stay home as much as possible except for conducting essential business. That order also closed what were deemed nonessential businesses.

That order was originally set to expire April 7, but on April 1 he issued a second order extending it through the end of that month, and last week he announced he would extend the order further, with some modifications, through May 30.

Pritzker has said that he will leave it up to local law enforcement and local prosecutors to enforce the order at their discretion. But the Robinson memo notes that the Illinois Emergency Management Act, which is the basis of the executive orders, specifically states that the law may not be used to affect the responsibilities of police forces or firefighting forces, and therefore the orders may go beyond the governor's statutory authority.

The church lawsuit argues that the order infringes on rights guaranteed by both the Illinois and U.S. Constitutions — specifically the free exercise of religion, freedom of speech, freedom of assemble and the guaranty of due process of law.

Those are all considered "fundamental rights" under the law, which means any attempt to restrict them will be judged under a "strict scrutiny" standard. Under that standard, the government must show that its actions are based on a compelling state interest, that the action is narrowly tailored to achieve that interest and that the action is the least restrictive means of accomplishing the stated interest.

The lawsuit concedes that the state has a compelling interest in preventing the spread of COVID-19, but it argues that the executive orders are not narrowly tailored, nor are they the least restrictive means of achieving the state's objective.

Asked about the lawsuit Thursday during his daily COVID-19 media briefing, Pritzker said most faith leaders in Illinois have found creative ways to hold services by video or telephone conferences, and that the lawsuit was "a bit of an outlier."

"But everybody has the right to sue and, you know, we've seen in multiple states now, people have filed lawsuits on various things having to do with the stay at home order, but we're going to keep doing what we need to do to keep people safe," Pritzker said.

Many juniors and seniors already had their outfit planned out and paid for, so this is one way for them to still get to show it off. Students already have plans to post pictures and videos online using the school hashtag.

"I know that a few girls on the committee as well as other girls have been putting together a video to showcases our prom dresses using TikTok," said Coglianese. "We have been a proud member of Ogle County and Rochelle for decades and we know that this current COVID-19 pandemic has been a very difficult situation for our team members, their families, our friends and neighbors, our community and our nation," Rochelle Foods plant manager Bill Rice said. "We want to thank the community for the outpouring of support as we navigate this pandemic's impact and those who helped us execute our pilot testing program. Everyone who has reached out to us and our team members understands this pandemic is occurring everywhere and we are not alone in our efforts to protect our team members and this community."

Rice continued by saying safety of team members is first and foremost.

"We have put the safety of our team members first throughout this pandemic and will continue to do so. As a leading employer in the area, and one with our core priority on the health and safety of our employees, we are certainly eager to get back to doing what we love and that's making great food," he said.

### Initiative

Rochelle Foods also knows that the community has been hit hard by layoffs and furloughs, and that food insecurity is at an all-time high in the community. Therefore, the company and its team members will donate 10,000 meals to Feeding America and the local food bank. This is in addition to more than \$10,000 already donated to support the community hunger programs during the COVID-19 crisis. The company has been working closely with external health experts, including those at Mayo Clinic, as well as following and exceeding all CDC guidelines since the very early days of COVID-19 in the United States.

"As these national health experts have told us, we understand that with more testing, we will see more positives," Rice added. "We are focused on the health and safety of our team members and these test results will help us ensure people understand their current status. In some cases, it is possible that there are individuals who have COVID-19 and are asymptomatic and others who may not have realized they had symptoms."

During this global pandemic, Rochelle Foods, along with other essential manufacturers in the food industry, was designated as an essential business and stayed open because it was asked to step up and ensure Americans had food available during this unprecedented crisis. Many manufacturing facilities from many different industries are facing similar challenges given the community spread of COVID-19, including in the state of Illinois where cases are among the most significant.

## Your authority over the enemy

I went to church for years and never heard about the devil. It's not fun talking about him, and I don't ever want to put too much focus on him. But the truth is, we have an enemy. First Peter 5:8 (NIV) says, "...Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour."

If we're going to defeat our enemy, it's important for us to believe in the power and authority we have in Christ. That's the only way we can have the great life God wants us to have.

There are so many Christians who seem to be going through their daily life just hoping they can make it through the day. They go from one problem or crisis to the next, and they lack a confident, bold faith in God that can keep them stable, full of His peace and joy in the difficult circumstances of life.

John 10:10 tells us Jesus gave His life so we can "have life, and have it to the full." When we accept Christ as our Savior, we receive the assurance of eternal life, but we also become joint heirs with Christ (Romans 8:17) and are entitled to have everything He is and everything He has: grace, peace, righteousness, joy and power and authority over the enemy.

Matthew 10:1 says, "Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness." This authority has been given to every believer. It's important to understand that the devil has power, but we have power and authority in Christ.

Our enemy only has the authority that we give him, and many times we give him the ability to attack us through ignorance.

The devil hates anyone who is trying to do any good in the world, and his influence can be seen in the evil things people do. For example, when I'm tempted to be selfish and complain, it's not God work-

ing in my life. James 1:13, 17 says, "... God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone. Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights...."

We need to learn how to be proactive and resist the devil immediately when temptation comes. First Peter 5:9 says to "withstand him; be firm in faith [against his onset—rooted, established, strong, immovable, and determined]..." (AMPC). Notice this verse says to resist him at his onset.

Don't wait to see how bad things will get or how much you can get away with before you get in trouble. Be firm in your faith at all times, and resist the enemy immediately when he comes against you. God has a plan for your life, and walking in the authority you have in Christ is an important part of experiencing His will for you.

The Word of God is an offensive weapon in our warfare against the enemy. It has the power to renew our mind, heal our brokenness and change our lives. The Word contains God's wisdom and the direction we need for every problem we face. Everything we need is found in the Word; it's God's love letter to us, our

instruction book for life and reveals all of God's promises to us as His children.

The power and authority in God's Word equips you to go after the devil—he hates the Word and must bow down to it. But we must approach the Word with the attitude, "With God's help, I'm going to do what it says." That's the key to operating in the authority we have in Christ.

I want to encourage you to make it a priority to spend time with God and study the Word. Go for quality, not quantity; meditate on Scripture so you really get it deep down in your heart. Make a predetermined decision to apply what you learn to your life. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to help you, and He will show you how to obey the Word in your daily life. ## Officials urge re-opening of economies on regional case basis

**A**CROSS Illinois, private citizens, healthcare professionals, business owners, and government officials are offering thoughts and input on how to address both the public health emergency and the economic crisis we're currently facing. Many, including me, have advocated for a regional approach to managing the situation. I'd like to offer some plans and suggestions for how a regional approach could actually work. I think it's important that we talk about some of the key points and details, instead of simply offering generic or overly broad ideas.

I don't think it's reasonable to expect the Illinois Department of Public Health to create and implement 102 different plans to cover each county in Illinois. Instead, we should look to the health experts and officials who are already working within those individual counties. Together with county health departments, local hospitals and clinics, first responders, municipal officials, and other key stakeholders, we should empower the creation of regional plans for dealing with COVID-19.

I propose allowing an individual county or group of counties to create, publicize, and implement their own "Regional Plan" for COVID-19 response. Each county already has a public health department, with experts who are working every day to protect public health and safety. A county or group of counties would be required to consider and detail their response plan for specific criteria, including:

- Average daily testing counts, and plan to ensure ongoing testing levels
- Confirmed case count and trend
- Local availability of hospital beds, ICU beds, ventilators
- Local number of first responders, nurses, physicians, and healthcare personnel
- Surge plan, including mass testing and rapid response ability for suspected clusters
- Supply levels for testing swabs, personal protective equipment (PPE), and sanitizing products
- Number of community organizations and businesses who are participating in best practices to limit physical contact, ensure so-

cial distancing, and make accommodations to promote employee and customer safety

Methods to communicate status and information to the public in a clear and timely way

A Regional Plan must include current COVID-19 data, as well as indicate specific benchmarks for how an improvement could allow for relaxed restrictions, while an increase of COVID-19 cases would require tighter restrictions.

A Regional Plan would give details on different phases of restrictions, with specific examples of what activity is allowed or prohibited during each phase.

A Regional Plan would require approval of relevant County Boards, County Health Departments, and hospitals, and submission to IDPH and to the public.

A successful Regional Plan would incorporate models, criteria, and phase recommendations from reports published by the federal and state government, the Centers for Disease Control, the National Governors Association, and other similar third-party validators.

Governor Pritzker's Executive Orders would apply to counties or regions who have not formulated and approved their own response plans, but those areas who have taken the appropriate steps to create plans and win local stakeholder approval would be permitted to operate under their local plan guidelines.

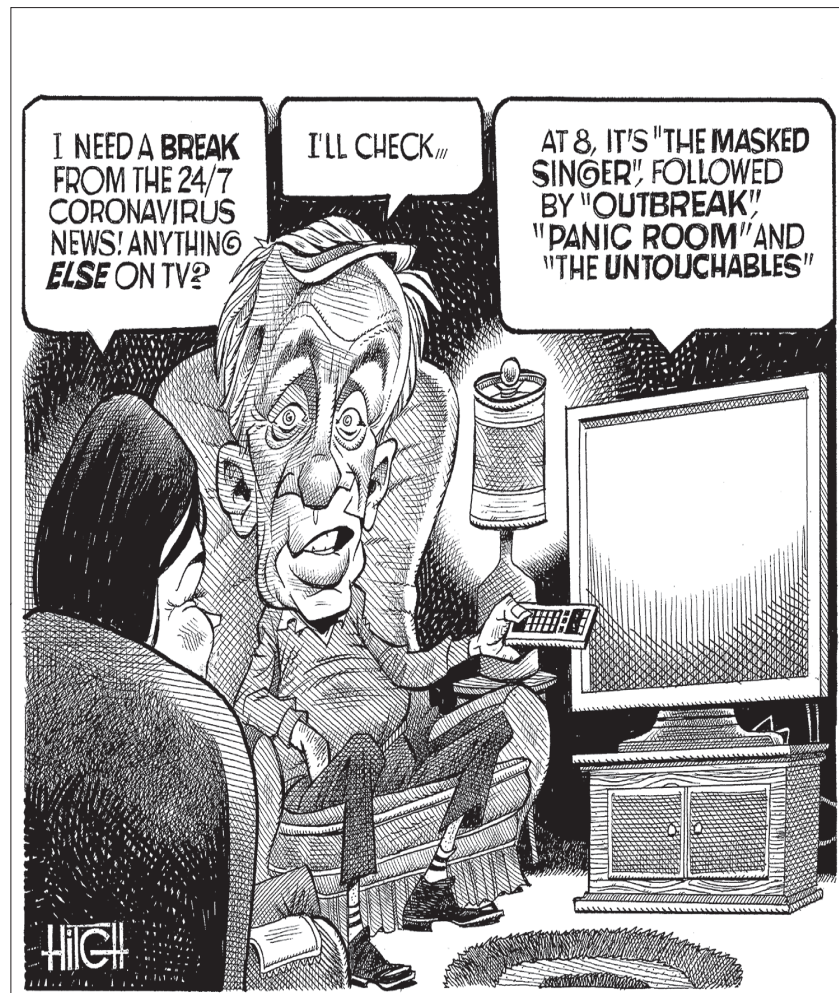
Because of the specific criteria which must be addressed, a county could not simply decree that no restrictions apply. Instead, we set a universal threshold and then empower local officials to survey their area and make appropriate guidelines based on their circumstances and capacities. Some areas may see additional restrictions, and some may see fewer restrictions.

Already, local officials are having discussions like these. I believe it is appropriate and responsible to empower those with "boots on the ground" in each county to choose to create and implement their own plans. This approach will promote public health and safety while allowing for a more responsive and tailored approach to meet the unique needs of each region.

## Wellness checks are safe during COVID-19

**SPRINGFIELD**—Older Illinoisans are among those most at risk for health complications related to COVID-19.

The state's posture to increase safety, both of our residents and our first responders, has visually changed the landscape of our state. The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), along with partners from Illinois Department on Aging (IDoA), Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal (OSFM), Illinois State Police (ISP) and the Illinois Sheriffs' Association want to remind residents of the following safety measure put in place in light of COVID-19.

Police, fire and EMS personnel conducting requested wellness checks on seniors, the disabled or any other resident will be dressed in proper personal protective equipment that has been deemed appropriate by their local jurisdiction. This change in appearance is a safety precaution. The personal protective equipment is designed to protect the resident and our first responders. It's also important to keep in mind

that all first responders should be able to present proper identification.

"Seniors should not feel anxious about answering the door as proper precautions are being taken by first responders to ensure the safety of residents and themselves. If someone still feels unsafe opening the door, they can communicate through a glass door or window to let the responders know they are well. Rest assured, the person may be unrecognizable under all the protective gear, but is still the same dedicated individual in uniform that is always in their community protecting citizens," said State Fire Marshal Matt Perez.

"I understand that it could be unnerving to open your door to someone wearing a mask, goggles and gloves. Right now, Illinois State Police wear these to protect not only ourselves, but the public from the spread of COVID-19, especially to vulnerable populations like seniors and the disabled. If we come to your home to check on your welfare and you are nervous about an-

swering the door, call your local police department's non-emergency number, wave out the window or shout through the door. Just let us know you are okay. Our uniforms may look different right now, but we are still the Illinois State Police," said Director Brendan F. Kelly.

"Members of the community should rest assured that your first responders are still there to keep you safe. In fact, we may be asked to come to check and make sure that you are ok," said Jim Kaitshuk, Executive Director of the Illinois Sheriffs' Association. "However, if you aren't immediately comfortable answering the door, you should contact your non-emergency number for police to confirm."

IDoA wants to let older Illinoisans and people with disabilities know that it is common for people to feel distressed during a crisis. Asking for and accepting help from professionals - who are following all of the proper precautions and guidelines to keep everyone safe - is a sign of strength. Many of these



individuals live in the community and depend on services and supports provided in their homes or in the community to maintain their health and independence.

Although IDoA has temporarily suspended group services at adult day centers and senior centers, we have increased our one-on-one in-home services. The agency's goal has been to prevent the spread of COVID-19 among older adults, while also increasing the ability to closely monitor their well-being. The agency has

implemented guidance and tools from IDPH so that both in-home workers and the older adults they care for are safe when they do their work. The agencies in IDoA network use this as part of any protocol where face-to-face contact with an older and more vulnerable adult occurs.

"The stress on everybody is growing every day, and we want you to know you are not alone. Plan for what you can, and focus on things you can control," said Paula Basta, Director of IDoA. "I encourage everyone to be mindful of

our older family members, friends, or neighbors, and check in to see how they are doing. Find a creative way to communicate with them during this time and monitor their health."

## White urges residents to renew vehicle registration online

**ILLINOIS** — Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White is urging the public to renew their vehicle registration online at [www.cyberdriveillinois.com](http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com) instead of waiting for Driver Services facilities to reopen. Since mid-March, more than 400,000 people have renewed their stickers online, an increase of approximately 50 percent from last year.

"Don't wait, renew online," said White. "By renewing your vehicle registration sticker now, you won't have to visit a Driver Services facility once they reopen. This will save you time and will also help alleviate the rush of face-to-face transactions at facilities once they are reopened."

To renew vehicle registrations online, residents

need their registration ID and PIN, which are located on their renewal notice and registration card - which most people store in their vehicle's glove compartment.

If you live in Chicago or Metro East areas, federal law requires the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) to test vehicles for emissions prior to renewing your vehicle registration with the Secretary of State's office. This requirement impacts approximately 20 percent of those with expiring vehicle registrations. If your vehicle is due for an emissions test, the IEPA is requiring the test be completed before you may renew your vehicle registration online. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, IEPA testing centers are

currently closed; however, White extended vehicle registration expiration dates for at least 90 days after Driver Services facilities reopen.

Additional 90-day extensions include driver's licenses, ID cards and other transactions and document filings.

In addition to renewing vehicle registrations online, other essential services available at [www.cyberdriveillinois.com](http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com) include: renew a driver's license through Safe Driver Renewal, obtain a duplicate driver's license or ID card, obtain a driving record abstract or change your address.

White also reminded the public that the federal government extended the REAL ID deadline by one year. The deadline is now Oct. 1, 2021.

## Girl Scouts move to online cookie sales

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS** — Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) recently announced a new resource to serve girls and consumers during this time of crisis and isolation.

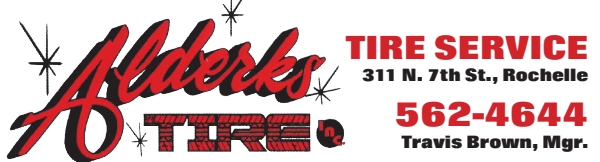

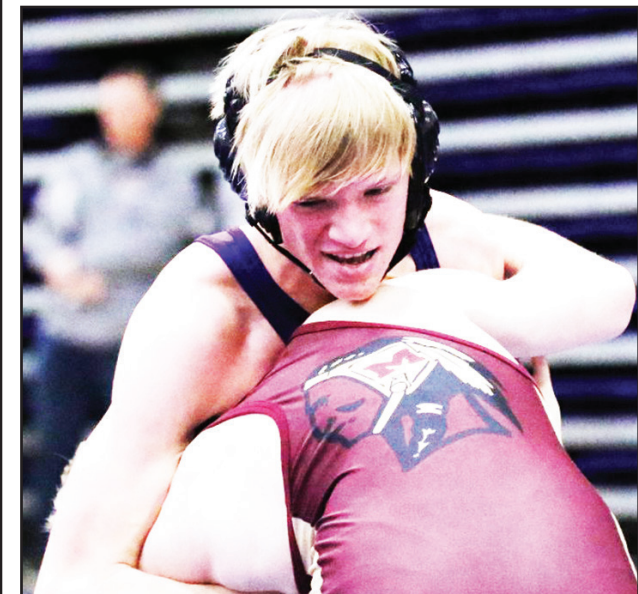

## Hurst bringing cheer passion into coaching

Mychaela Hurst's passion for cheerleading has taken on many forms since she took up the sport in fifth grade. After four years with the Rochelle Township High School cheerleading program, Hurst has returned to her alma mater, this time as head coach of the junior varsity team.

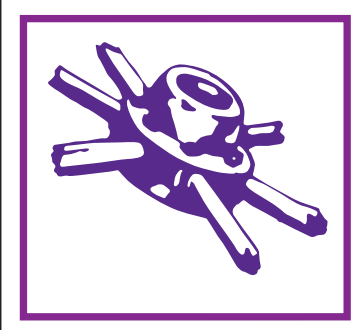

Water Quality  
RMU has developed a contingency plan to ensure that, through emergency preparedness, any risks to the water supply will be minimized.

Water Resources  
The sources of drinking water (both tap water and bottled water) include rivers, lakes, streams, ponds, reservoirs, springs, and wells. As water travels over the surface of the land or through the ground, it dissolves naturally-occurring minerals and, in some cases, radioactive material, and can pick up substances resulting from the presence of animals or from human activity.

Drinking water, including bottle water, may reasonably be expected to contain at least small amounts of some contaminants. The presence of contaminants does not necessarily indicate that water poses a health risk. More information about contaminants and potential health effects can be obtained by calling the USEPA's Safe Drinking Water Hotline at 1-800-426-4791.

Contaminants that may be present in source water include:  
Microbial contaminants, such as viruses and bacteria, which may come from sewage treatment plants, septic systems, agricultural livestock operations, and wildlife.

Inorganic contaminants, such as salts and metals, which can be naturally occurring or result from urban storm water runoff, industrial or domestic wastewater discharges, oil and gas production, mining, or farming.

Pesticides and herbicides, which may come from a variety of sources such as agriculture, urban storm water runoff and residential uses.

Organic chemical contaminants, including synthetic and volatile organic chemicals, which are by-products of industrial processes and petroleum production, and may also come from gas stations, urban storm water runoff, and septic systems.

Radioactive contaminants, which can be naturally occurring or be the result of oil and gas production and mining activities.

In order to ensure that tap water is safe to drink, USEPA prescribes regulations which limit the amount of certain contaminants in water provided by public water systems. FDA regulations establish limits for contaminants in bottled water which must provide the same protection for public health.

Some people may be more vulnerable to contaminants in drinking water than the general public. Immuno-compromised persons such as persons with cancer undergoing chemotherapy, persons who have undergone organ transplants, people with HIV/AIDS or other immune system disorders, some elderly and infants can be particularly at risk from infections. These people should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers. USEPA/CDC guidelines on appropriate means to lessen the risk of infection by Cryptosporidium and other microbial contaminants are available from the USEPA's Safe Drinking Water Hotline 1-800-426-4791.

If present, elevated levels of lead can cause serious health problems, especially for pregnant women and young children. Lead in drinking water is primarily from materials and components associated with service lines and home plumbing. Rochelle is responsible for providing high quality drinking water, but cannot control the variety of materials used in plumbing components. When your water has been sitting for several hours you can minimize the potential for lead exposure by flushing your tap for 30 seconds to 2 minutes

before using water for drinking or cooking. If you are concerned about lead in your water, you may wish to have your water tested. Our Water Supply  
We want our valued customers to be informed about their water quality. If you would like to learn more, please feel welcome to attend any of the Utility Advisory Board meetings held at 3:00 p.m. on the third Wednesday of January, March, May, July, September and November at the Technology Center, 910 Technology Parkway. The source water assessment for our supply has been completed by the Illinois EPA. If you would like a copy of this information, please stop by RMU or call our Water Operator at 815-562-4155. To view a summary version of the completed Source Water assessments, including: Importance of Source Water; Susceptibility to Contamination Determination; and documentation/recommendation of Source Water Protection Efforts, you may access the Illinois EPA website at <http://www.epa.state.il.us/cgi-bin/wp/swap-fact-sheets.p1>.

To determine Rochelle's susceptibility to groundwater contamination, information obtained during a Well Site Survey, which was performed by the Illinois Rural Water Association on July 15, 1999, was reviewed. Based on this information, several potential sources of contamination were identified within proximity of this water supply's wells. The Illinois EPA does not consider the City's source water susceptible to contamination. This determination is based on a number of criteria including: monitoring conducted at the wells; monitoring conducted at the entry point to the distribution system; and the available hydrogeologic data on the wells. In anticipation of the U.S. EPA's proposed Ground Water Rule, the Illinois EPA has determined that the water supply is not vulnerable to viral contamination. This determination is based upon the completed evaluation of the following criteria during the Vulnerability Waiver Process: the community's wells are properly constructed with sound integrity and proper site conditions; a hydrogeologic barrier exists that should prevent pathogen movement; all potential routes and sanitary defects have been mitigated such that the source water is adequately protected; monitoring data did not indicate a history of disease outbreak; and a sanitary survey of the water supply did not indicate a viral contamination threat. Because the community's wells are constructed in a confined aquifer, which should minimize the movement of pathogens into the wells, well hydraulics were not considered to be a significant factor in the vulnerability determination. Hence, well hydraulics were not evaluated for this groundwater supply.
