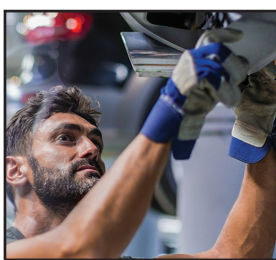

## More virus cases in county

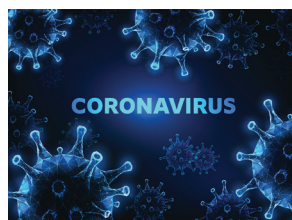
Officials have identified four positive cases of COVID-19; ages range from 10 to 50s

**OGLE COUNTY**—On Friday, Ogle County Health Department officials identified two more positive cases of novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) bringing the total to four positive cases in Ogle County.

The individuals identified Friday are an adult in their 30s and a child under 10 years of age. On Thursday an adult in their 20s was identified as the county's third positive case.

Further details about the individuals will not be released to protect the privacy of the individuals and their families. Both the individual and their close contacts are being monitored by the Ogle County Health Department.

"The increase in cases reinforces the importance of actions the public can take to protect themselves and prevent the spread in the community. The



healthcare partners in Ogle County are working closely with IDPH, the CDC, and regional partners to monitor, respond, and help limit the spread of the disease," emergency preparedness and health coordinator

Cherie Rucker said in a press release Friday. "Unless it is an emergency, we advise individuals who think they may have COVID-19, or have had close contact with someone diagnosed or under evaluation for possible exposure, to stay home and call their healthcare provider for further direction."

Rucker reminded that close contact means having been within 6 feet of

that person for an extended time or being exposed to their cough or sneeze. Do not go to the emergency room, a walk-in clinic, health department, or to your doctor's office. Call ahead and follow your healthcare provider's instructions. Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, cough (or other cold or flu-like symptoms), difficulty breathing and/or shortness of breath.

## Still in need of a loving home

**ROCHELLE**—While the coronavirus situation and the stay-at-home order are affecting many people's work and daily lives, they are also having an effect on animals looking for a home.

Local animal shelter Tails Humane Society, located in DeKalb, had been experiencing record high adoption rates for 2019 and early 2020. But, once the coronavirus pandemic began and the stay-at-home orders were issued, those rates began to decline quickly.

"Unfortunately, we have seen quite a drastic

decrease in adoption rates in the last few weeks," said Michelle Groeper, executive director at Tails. "We were doing record adoption rates in 2019 and early in 2020. Then, everything came to screeching halt when the shelter-in-place order was given."

When the order was given, the shelter was closed and all the animals were put into foster homes. Since then, some of the animals have been brought back to the shelter, and the shelter currently has 10 animals that are up for adoption by appointment.

org. The shelter believes that one of the main rea-

sons for the large decrease in adoptions is being unable to come into the shelter and have a large number of animals to choose from.

"Before the stay-at-home order was ordered we had specific adoption hours with 60-plus animals for people to come in and choose from," said Groeper. "Now, all adoptions are done by scheduling an appointment and we have far fewer animals."

Adoption appointments can be made by email at [info@tailshumanesociety.org](mailto:info@tailshumanesociety.org) or by calling 815-758-2457 Ext. 153 and leaving a message. The shelter would like everyone to know that it is practicing all CDC recommendations

during adoption appointments.

While the effects from this situation may take some time to pass, even once the stay-at-home order has expired, Tails is really thankful for all of the support it has received from the community and is hopeful that adoption rates will return to what they once were.

"We are unsure, but we are very hopeful that as soon as the animals are back in the shelter, the people will come back too," said Groeper. We're so impressed by how the community has supported us and how our team has pulled together through these really trying times."

## Providing HOPE

APRIL is Child Abuse Prevention Month and Sexual Assault Awareness Month. Social service agencies that provide victim/survivors services in Ogle County are providing service information to our local communities

and the services we are providing for survivors of abuse during this challenging time.

Domestic abuse is about power and control, and abuse may be more than pushing, grabbing, restraining, strangulation or biting. Some non-physical abusive tactics include intimidation, emotional abuse, economic abuse, isolation, coercion and threats.

Five million children are exposed to some form of family violence over their entire childhood (0-17 years). Children who experience abuse are at higher risk to develop behavioral or emotional difficulties such as withdrawal, aggression, depression, and anxiety. Exposure to domestic violence may significantly alter a child's DNA and age them prematurely by 7-10 years.

During these challenging times, the health and personal safety of our clients and staff remain a priority, therefore, our goal is to continue to provide as many client services as possible with necessary restrictions, however some of our services will be put on hold or modified

due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

We will be asking incoming persons who contact HOPE three important COVID-19 response questions prior to providing any services in-person at our Rochelle, Oregon and Polo offices. This is to better ensure the welfare of clients, staff and the community.

Emergency shelter is available although space availability is more restricted due to recommendations of sharing close quarters. HOPE is currently working with state funders to increase shelter availability.

## State Police release enforcement figures

**STERLING** – Illinois State Police District 1 Commander, Captain Matthew Hodgdon, has announced District 1 enforcement figures and activity for February Illinois State Police District 1. Troopers issued 446 citations, 496 written warnings, and made 10 criminal arrests during the month of February. Speeding accounted for 257 citations, 34 citations were issued for occupant restraint violations and 20


citations were issued for distracted driving violations. Troopers investigated 21 traffic crashes, assisted 118 motorists, and conducted 133 commercial vehicle inspections, 16 of which were placed out-of-service for safety reasons. There were seven arrests for driving under the influence. District 1, which encompasses Carroll, Lee, Ogle, and Whiteside counties, had 1 traffic crash fatality in February.

Seems to me, the greatest industrial power in the world could be doing a better job at producing materials for our people.

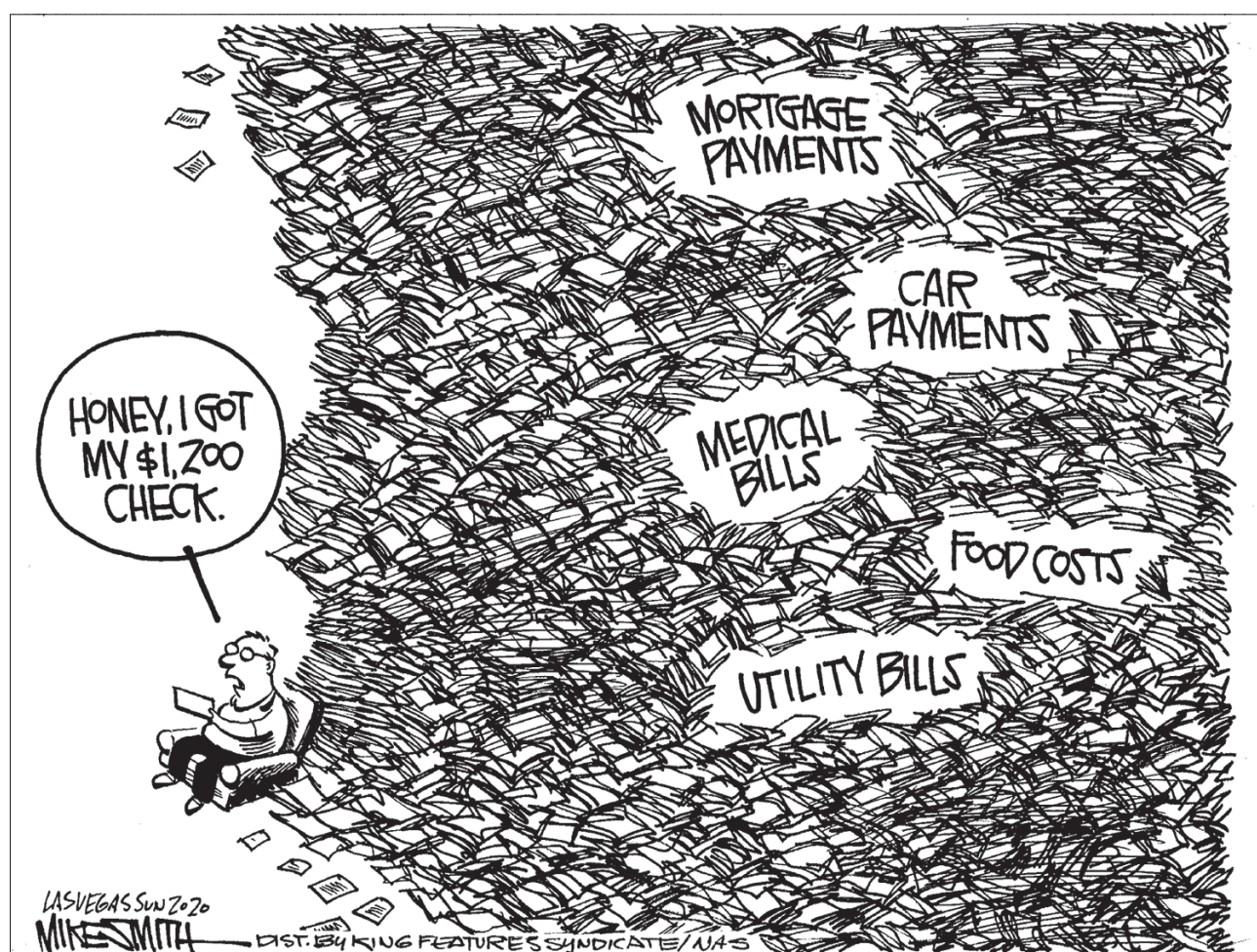

**A**UTISM spectrum disorder has the potential to touch just about anyone. The World Health Organization estimates that one in 160 children across the globe has ASD, while some well-controlled studies have reported that figures are substantially higher than that.

ASD affects all ethnic and socioeconomic groups, meaning just about any family can be affected.

In 2018, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention released its biennial update of autism's estimated prevalence among the nation's children. The update was based on analysis of medical records, and where available, educational records of

eight-year-old children from 11 monitoring sites across the United States. In a two-year period, the new estimate indicated a 15 percent increase in ASD prevalence.

Understandably, anyone who has been affected by ASD wants to learn more about what individuals can do to advocate for high quality services for those with ASD. The autism information group Autism Speaks says more work is needed to understand the increased prevalence and the complex medical needs that often accompany ASD. There are many different and effective ways to become more involved in the autism community.

# Coronavirus Stimulus Guide

How the \$2 trillion CARES Act will assist local residents, businesses



## The CARES Act

- \$250 billion to make unemployment insurance available to more categories of workers and to extend the duration of benefits to 39 weeks from the 26 weeks typical in most states. It would also provide an extra \$600 a week for four months.

- \$301 billion in direct payments to households.

- \$349 billion in loans to small businesses, with the amount spent on payroll, rent or utilities converting into grants that don't have to be repaid.

- \$500 billion for loans, loan guarantees or other aid to businesses, states and municipalities—including the possibility that the government will take direct equity stakes in distressed companies. Of the total, \$29 billion is set aside for cargo and passenger airlines, and \$17 billion is for businesses deemed critical to national security, such as Boeing. The remaining \$454 billion would go to backstop losses in lending facilities established or expanded by the Federal Reserve.

- \$32 billion in grants to cover wages at passenger air carriers, cargo air carriers and contractors.

- \$150 billion in direct aid to states, distributed according to population size. A municipality could apply to receive aid directly, reducing the amount available to the rest of the state.

- \$221 billion in a variety of tax benefits for businesses, including allowing businesses to defer payroll taxes, which finance Medicare and Social Security, for the rest of the year. It would also temporarily allow businesses to claim deductions using today's losses against past profits to claim quick refunds for cash infusions.

- \$340 billion in supplemental spending, which includes \$117 billion for hospitals and veterans' care. It also includes \$25 billion mostly for public transit to make up for revenue lost because of dwindling ridership.

## Households and Workers

### Individual checks

The CARES Act provides for direct payments of \$1,200 to adults and \$500 per child to American households, structured as tax refunds to allow the Internal Revenue Service to distribute the funds quickly.

There is no provision for future direct payments in the event the economic disruption lasts into the later spring. The direct grants are phased out for upper income brackets, starting with \$75,000 of

individual income.

The grants aren't available at all, for example, for individuals without children making more than \$99,000 and married couples without children making more than \$198,000.

### Unemployed workers

The CARES Act would extend the duration of jobless benefits to 39 weeks from 26 available in most states, and includes a \$600-a-week increase for the first four months, with the bonus payment avail-

able through July 31.

These benefits would be extended to contract workers, freelancers and other nontraditional workers, who lack benefits in some states. The aim is to replace lost wages as completely as possible.

### Freelancers

The CARES Act expands some benefits and grants to independent contractors, such as Uber drivers and freelance film editors, that normally go only to employees or small businesses. For example, it extends unemployment benefits to self-employed

workers, including independent contractors, freelancers and other nontraditional workers who are unemployed, partially unemployed or unable to work because of COVID-19.

It includes a \$600-a-week increase on top of current levels of unemployment benefits for four months. Independent contractors also can apply for the \$10 billion set aside for emergency EIDL—economic injury disaster loan—funds, which are normally available only to a narrower category of small businesses.

## Personal Financing and Taxes

### Bankruptcy

According to the CARES Act, the law ensures that people who file for bankruptcy don't have to use stimulus checks to repay past debt, and it extends the time that bankrupt people have to repay a portion of their debt as a condition to getting a fresh start. The current repayment time limit is five years; the bill extends the repayment time frame to seven years.

bearance of up to 360 days to borrowers who say they have been harmed by the coronavirus outbreak. Servicers are prohibited from initiating foreclosure and processing foreclosure-related evictions for 60 days beginning March 18. Owners of multifamily properties can request a forbearance of up to 90 days, during which tenants cannot be evicted for nonpayment of rent or other fees.

### Retirement

According to the CARES Act, the law temporarily loosens the rules on hardship distributions from retirement accounts, giving people affected by the crisis access to up to \$100,000 of their retirement savings without a 10 percent penalty. The law doubles the amount 401(k) participants can take in loans from an account for the next six months to the lower of \$100,000 or 100 percent of the account balance. (IRAs don't permit loans.)

For retirees, the law suspends for 2020 the mandatory distributions the government requires most



to take from tax-deferred 401(k)s and individual retirement accounts starting at either age 70½ or age 72.

### Student loans

Per the CARES Act, the law would allow most Americans with federal student loans to suspend their monthly payments through Sept. 30, 2020, without any interest accruing. It would also enable employers to make tax-exempt contribu-

tions toward their workers' student-loan payments.

### Taxes

Under the CARES Act, people who don't itemize their deductions would be able to claim up to \$300 for charitable contributions. Businesses get the ability to apply losses from 2018, 2019 or 2020 to past years' profits and claim refunds. Restaurants and retailers would benefit from the

fixing of a mistake in the 2017 tax law that curbed their depreciation deductions on renovations.

Employers would be able to defer paying their share of 2020 payroll taxes. They could then make half of those payments in 2021 and the other half in 2022. In addition, the bill creates a new tax credit for retaining employees that's aimed at companies that are too large to benefit from the

small-business assistance elsewhere in the bill.

Those employers would be able to get a tax credit equal to 50 percent of payroll. That is limited to \$10,000 per employee per quarter, and for employers with more than 100 employees, it is available only to those companies and nonprofits that had their businesses limited or closed by government actions.

# Businesses and Industries

## Airlines

Under the CARES Act, for passenger airlines, the bill includes \$25 billion in direct funding for worker salaries and benefits, as well as up to \$25 billion in loans and loan guarantees. The bill hews to what airlines had been asking for. Carriers had lobbied aggressively for direct grants rather than just loans, warning that without an immediate infusion of cash, they would have to make sharp job cuts.

The bill also includes \$3 billion in assistance to keep paying contract workers that provide airline catering, baggage loading, ticketing and check-in, and other services at airports. Cargo airlines will be eligible to receive \$4 billion in loans and guarantees, and \$4 billion in payroll assistance.

In exchange for the payroll grants, carriers must agree not to furlough, lay off or cut pay for employees until Sept. 30. Assistance also hinges on companies agreeing not to buy back shares or pay dividends, and to limits on executive compensation.

The package also allows the Transportation Department to direct airlines to maintain specific flights based on their schedules on March 1, before carriers had instituted the deepest cuts to their flying. This would include services to rural communities and to support delivery of health-care-related cargo.

## Banks

The CARES Act delays implementation of a new accounting rule that would have required banks to sock away reserves for any estimated loan losses all at once, instead of spreading them out over the life of the loan. The Act gives the office of the comptroller of the currency the authority to allow banks to make loans that would typically trip up size restrictions. Smaller community banks with less than \$10 billion in assets get more lending flexibility through a higher maximum leverage ratio and more wiggle room if they exceed it. Banks will also get more leeway on how they account for troubled consumer loans,



allowing them to work with struggling borrowers who have fallen behind on their payments.

## Energy

The CARES Act contains no major provisions to specifically aid the U.S. energy industry. Beleaguered U.S. oil producers had sought a range of remedies, including preferential tax treatment, direct subsidies and a \$3 billion purchase of oil by the federal government for the Strategic Petroleum Reserve. The renewable energy industry had sought extensions to tax provisions that would have helped wind-and-solar developers secure valuable tax credits even if there were construction delays.

## Farmers

The CARES Act directs more than \$48 billion to agriculture and nutrition programs, helping cushion the blow for producers reeling from the latest in a string of hits to the U.S. farm economy, as prices sank for corn, soybeans, wheat and cattle. The law designates \$14 billion to replenish the Commodity Credit Corp., a Depression-era program designed to stabilize farm

incomes, and \$9.5 billion to support producers of specialty crops, livestock and dairy, as well as those who supply farmers markets, restaurants and schools.

## Health industry

The CARES Act adds \$27 billion to an emergency fund that could give a boost to dozens of projects by pharmaceutical companies and academic groups developing drugs and vaccines against coronavirus. The emergency fund received a smaller amount of funding under a coronavirus response act signed earlier in March. There is no COVID-19 vaccine, but dozens are in development. The package allows the government to take steps to ensure that products developed with the emergency funding will be "affordable in the commercial market," but that these steps shouldn't delay development of the products.

The bill also includes provisions to increase reporting of potential shortages from drug manufacturers and companies that make active pharmaceutical ingredients, which are the building

blocks of prescription drugs. Many of these raw materials are produced overseas and drawn more attention during the virus outbreak. Companies that make respirators and other medical devices would be required to report to the federal government potential supply chain interruptions.

## Hotels

The hotel industry last week asked the White House for a \$150 billion financial-aid package, targeted specifically for hospitality companies. What it got instead from the CARES Act is a patchwork of loans, grants and tax help, much of it through the \$350 billion in loans and grants for small businesses. The majority of U.S. hoteliers qualify as businesses with fewer than 500 employees, making less than \$35 million in annual revenue.

The lodging industry even scored a victory in getting language in the Senate bill that defined each individual hotel as its own business. Hotel owners with several properties had been concerned that they would not qualify as a small business because taken together, all their properties would have

pushed them over the current Small Business Administration's definition.

The federal boost in unemployment insurance will help the many hotel employees who have been furloughed across the U.S. Larger hotel companies can apply for loans through the Treasury Department's economic stabilization fund. But few in the lodging industry expect travel to bounce back by late spring, or even soon after.

## Postal Service

Under the CARES Act, the financially strained U.S. Postal Service is getting a \$10 billion Treasury loan to help the mail carrier during the pandemic. That should be welcome news for Amazon.com Inc., United Parcel Service Inc. and, to a lesser extent, FedEx Corp., which rely on postal workers for last-mile delivery in certain places.

The Postal Service is only allowed by law to raise its net debt by \$3 billion a year, so the bill loosens that restriction. But it does come with some strings attached. Mainly, the Postal Service can only use the financing for operating expenses and not to pay down outstanding debt. The bill also requires

the Postal Service to prioritize medical shipments and allows temporary delivery points to protect workers and recipients of mail.

## Private equity

According to the CARES Act, private-equity firms will likely find it a challenge to get access to stimulus funds. Based on available details of the stimulus package, private-equity-owned businesses wouldn't be explicitly barred from receiving assistance. But government lending requirements could prevent them from unlocking the aid, say lawyers, lobbyists and regulatory experts.

## Railroads

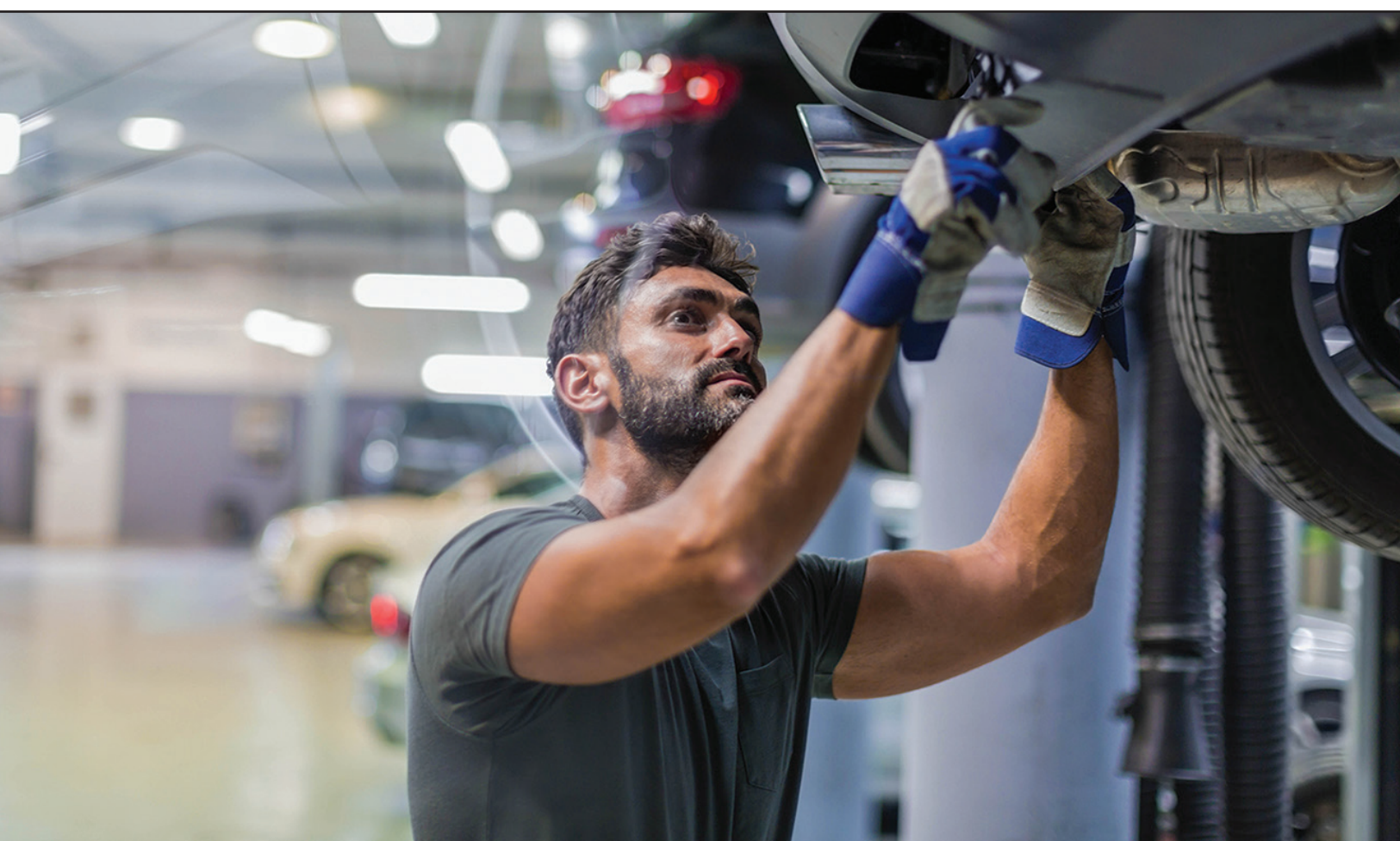
Per the CARES Act, national passenger railroad Amtrak secured about \$1 billion to cover revenue losses related to the coronavirus. The railroad industry won enhanced unemployment benefits that account for its workers not being covered under traditional state-run unemployment programs. Railroad workers instead receive unemployment benefits under a program administered by the Railroad Retirement Board.

The bill removes a seven-day waiting period to collect unemployment and provides \$50 million to cover the benefits tied to that waiver. It also provides \$425 million to double biweekly unemployment payments to \$1,200 through July.

## Small

## businesses

The CARES Act would allow businesses and nonprofits with up to 500 workers in a single location to apply through qualifying banks for loans backed by the Small Business Administration. The loans would convert into grants that don't have to be repaid for amounts spent on items such as payroll, rent or utilities, with the grants reduced when workers are laid off. The loans would be capped at \$10 million and cover wages up to \$100,000 a year.

## Local leaders remain hopeful for 2020 season

Activities suspended through May 11

**ROCHELLE** — The coronavirus pandemic has brought athletics around the world to a standstill, as professional, collegiate and high school organizations implement measures to contain the spread and enforce social distancing guidelines.

The crisis has also affected youth organizations like Rochelle Little League, which has suspended all activities until May 11 in cooperation with recommendations published by the international Little League Baseball & Softball entity this past month. While the 2020 season has been put on hold, local board members including vice president Roman Villalobos are hopeful that Little League players will be able to return to action when the suspension ends next month.

“We’re waiting on additional information from the international board of directors on player eligibility and tournament participation,” Villalobos said. “We’re waiting to see if the suspension will be extended any longer, and we’re also waiting on more information about the best way to resume operations once we receive clarification on when we can start practicing.”

Sign-ups are still open for Rochelle Little League, and Villalobos said that numbers have been steadily increasing since sign-ups were extended this past

month. If the 2020 season were to be canceled, Villalobos said those who signed their athletes up to play would receive either a refund or a credit toward next season. Parents and guardians who haven’t signed their athletes up can register them online at <https://www.rochellelittleleague.com>.

“It’s bigger than sports,” Villalobos said. “The No. 1 concern right now is the health and safety of our kids. We have hundreds of kids who want to get out and throw the ball around, but we have to wait this thing out and hopefully get through this soon so we can get back out there.”

Because the tryout and evaluation process was interrupted by the suspension, Villalobos said that all registered athletes will be subject to a blind draft. However, due to both the suspension and Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker’s shelter-

in-place order, a draft date has not been scheduled. The 2020 season had been scheduled to open April 20, with Opening Day coming May 2.

“We were a few days away from doing our last tryout and we were going to have the draft later that day,” Villalobos said. “If we ever get to the draft, it’s going to be a blind draft so we can get the kids playing as soon as possible. We’ve never been in this kind of situation, but the best we can do is play the season by ear and get as much done as we can for the kids.”

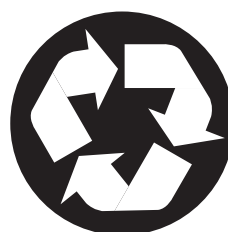

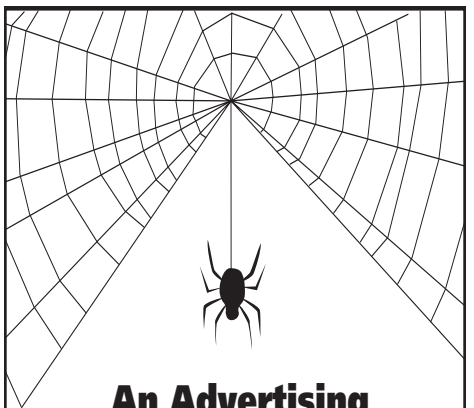

# HOME BUYING OR SELLING



## Exterior renovations that can improve home value

## When will the impact of coronavirus hit state budgets like Illinois'?

Some effects could come soon, but policymakers face significant long-term uncertainty

**SPRINGFIELD** — State officials nationwide fear that a substantial decline in tax collections as a result of the coronavirus pandemic will throw their budgets into turmoil. But they will have to wait for the first hard data on how big the decline might be.

When the economy struggles, state tax revenue usually suffers too. States' two largest sources of tax revenue are the personal income tax and the sales tax. If employers lay off workers or reduce their hours, workers earn less income and pay less in income taxes. If consumers scale back purchases, sales tax revenue drops. These declines are likely to play out over the course of months because there's always a lag between changes in a state economy and changes in revenue.

As a result, policymakers are facing considerable uncertainty as they seek to maintain balanced budgets in the current fiscal year—and develop budgets for the next one. With these challenges in mind, Congress is providing financial relief to states, most substantially through a \$150 billion fund for states and localities that was part of the stimulus bill signed by President Donald Trump on March 27. However, some governors have warned that the aid won't be enough to prevent dire budget challenges.

Some of the first signs of trouble are likely to emerge in income tax withholding payments. Although taxpayers file their income taxes once a year, employ-

ers withhold a portion of each paycheck based on estimates of what the total bill will be, so withholding payments represent a large share of state income tax revenue. If workers' paychecks shrink, the withholding payments will shrink too, and states will see the effects in a matter of weeks.

An economic slowdown will affect sales tax collections nearly as quickly. Although consumers pay sales tax when they make a purchase, businesses don't remit those dollars to states immediately. Instead, they are typically required to make monthly payments that are due toward the end of the month after the one in which the purchases are made. As a result, consumer spending declines that began in March will begin to affect state revenue in late April.

### Accounting for fiscal year calendars

Most states begin their fiscal year July 1. With key

revenue sources at risk of decline starting in April, their current year budgets could fall out of balance in the final few months of the fiscal year.

Adding to that risk, many states have announced extensions of their income tax filing deadlines past the end of their fiscal year, complementing the federal government's decision to push its deadline from April 15 to July 15. Mirroring the federal extension will provide relief for state tax filers and reduce the potential for a confusing and complex filing process. But it also means that a portion of the taxes these states expected to collect this fiscal year will be delayed until next fiscal year instead, compounding the strains on current budgets. Although states receive income tax revenue throughout the year via withholdings, April is the month when they typically collect the most revenue.

Closing midyear budget gaps always poses challenges for states, and many of the strategies that they typically use—such as leaving vacant

positions unfilled—provide less in savings if the problem occurs in the final months of the year.

Although the potential for a severe and rapidly developing economic downturn means that significant gaps could develop quickly, two factors may provide some help. Most states were enjoying reasonably strong revenue growth before the start of the coronavirus pandemic, creating some cushion to keep this year's budgets balanced. Plus, states now have more money in reserve than at any time in at least two decades, thanks to effort by policymakers to strengthen rainy day funds after the Great Recession. Because states, unlike the federal government, cannot engage in routine deficit spending, reserves play a crucial role in helping them balance their budgets in times of fiscal stress.

An economic slowdown caused by coronavirus also poses significant risks to states' budgets for the 2021 fiscal year, which begins July 1 in most states. Depending on the severity and length of a downturn, sales tax collections and income tax withholdings could continue to be depressed in fiscal 2021.

Other revenue sources may see effects that develop slowly, with the bulk appearing in that next fiscal year. For instance, stock market losses could take a big bite out of capital gains tax revenue. Although taxpayers with large capital gains often must make payments quarterly based on estimates of how much they will ultimately owe, experts predict that the largest decline in payments will not begin until

fiscal 2021.

The economic upheaval comes at an awkward time for states' upcoming budgets. Generally, states determine how much money they can appropriate for the year based on revenue forecasts that are completed in January or February. This year, however, those forecasts may be far too optimistic, given that they predate the onset of the pandemic in the United States.

A handful of states have already finalized their fiscal 2021 budgets, while others were deep into drafting them before most legislatures started modifying or suspending operations in recent weeks to slow the spread of the virus and protect lawmakers.

If the damage to the economy is as substantial as economists expect, states could face significant fiscal challenges and may have no choice but to revise their revenue forecasts and adjust their fiscal 2021 budgets accordingly. In New York, which is the only state that starts its fiscal year April 1, the state comptroller recently estimated that the state would collect at least \$4 billion less than forecasters expected just weeks earlier. But the comptroller also acknowledged that those estimates came with a huge amount of uncertainty.

In Illinois, a commission that advises the General Assembly on revenue and economic issues is warning that a slowdown of business activity caused by the COVID-19 outbreak is likely to bring about a recession that could cause a 20 percent drop in state revenues, spread out over a number of fiscal years.

The Commission on

Government Finance and Accountability, or CoGFA, gave that warning as part of its three-year budget forecast, which it is required to make annually. Those forecasts include an analysis of potential threats and opportunities to the state budget.

"While the certainty of the country, and world plunging into recession seems to grow each day, attempting to value the impact of COVID-19 on state revenues is virtually impossible," the report stated in the section dealing with economic threats. "With that caveat, it seems reasonable to offer a scenario with more devastating impacts on revenues in the near-term than even the 'Great Recession.' As a result, should revenues experience a peak-trough decline of 20 percent, a revenue reduction of over \$8 billion would be experienced, although likely spread over multiple fiscal years."

That uncertainty is common across the country. Not only do states not yet have data on the revenue impact of the slowdown, but they also are only just beginning to receive early data quantifying the economic disruptions that will ultimately reduce tax collections. With that in mind, leaders will need to be flexible in the coming months and be prepared to respond to fast-changing conditions to balance their budgets once the picture becomes clearer.
