City zoning re-write update given by consultant

ROCHELLE – Rochelle city officials and Teska & Associates held a public zoning code update meeting on Thursday.

The meeting was held on March 5, from 3-4:30 p.m., at Salt 251. As part of a year-long process, the City of Rochelle has been working with its consultant, Teska & Associates, to update city zoning codes. The process is being done to better serve residents, businesses and to encourage economic development in a thoughtful manner throughout the community.

Many of the codes that are in now

in affect are outdated, confusing and not user friendly for the city staff or residents. The codes were last updated in 1996, and a lot has changed since then.

“When they were last updated in 1996 there were no cell phones, cell towers or Ubers,” said Pete Iosue, Teska senior associate. “We need to make them more current and bring them up to date.”

Any resident who owns property within the City of Rochelle will be affected by the new codes. They deal with many different topics including fences, recreational vehicle parking, accessory structures such as sheds, commercial vehicles, commercial downtown building guidelines and

signage.

The city staff is really excited for the process of updating the codes, since it will make future interactions between staff and residents much more user friendly. Some of the changes being made include categorizing businesses and adding more charts and diagrams.

Making sure the city codes are current and up to date is very important to the city and its population. Having old and out of date codes can affect individual’s decisions of whether to move to town or not.

“A bad code can really prevent people from coming to town, but a good code won’t keep anyone away,” said Iosue.

Hoping to make a difference

ROCHELLE – Fourth and fifth-graders at Tilton Elementary School are making a difference today, in hopes of protecting the planet for future generations.

This is the first year that Tilton Elementary School has created an environmental club for fourth and fifth-

grade students. The main goal of the club is to inform and educate not just the students, but the community as well, that everything they do has an impact on the health of the planet.

“The idea for the club started when the topic of using a different material than Styrofoam for lunch trays was brought up,” said Jenni Seibert, teacher at Tilton.

“Mrs. Tooley then presented a PowerPoint on the environment to the students to gain interest. After seeing the PowerPoint, students began signing up for the club.”

Since the club’s creation this year, members have been working hard on completing multiple projects that benefit the planet. The first project was a coin drive for animals affected by Australia-

lian bush fires.

The goal of the club was to raise \$250 and it has more than doubled that goal, raising over \$500 that will be donated to help the animals. Other ideas the group has include adopting a highway and selling reusable grocery bags to raise money to plant trees around the school.

Next murder trial date set

OREGON – More time is needed to analyze cellphone data in the case of the Byron man accused of killing his wife and son in 2016, his lawyer said during a pre-trial hearing on March 4.

Christopher Derango, lawyer for Duane Meyer, said the cellphone expert working for the defense had finished a primary analysis, but now wants the raw data, provided by the FBI, to examine.

Derango asked for a 45-day continuance, and Judge John Roe provided it, setting the next pre-trial hearing for Monday, April 20 at 1:30 p.m.

Meyer is accused of setting the 2016 fire in Byron that killed his ex-wife Maggie Meyer and 3-year-old son Amos Meyer.

He was charged on Oct. 9, 2019 with four counts of first-degree homicide, two counts of aggravated arson and one count of concealment of a homicidal death. He is currently being held in the Ogle County Jail on a \$10 million bond.

Separately, State’s Attorney Eric Morrow said that his office has provided all of the police reports and other evidence generated by the investigation into the fatal fire. He said that includes, “over 30,000 pages of documents along with many digitals files containing evidence collected during the investigation.”

“If the defendant intends to use this expert at trial they will need to provide our office with the expert’s report through the discovery process,” Morrow said.

As for the strength of the case, Morrow was clear.

“We believed that we had strong enough case to proceed with charges against the defendant and the Ogle County Grand Jury agreed and returned a true bill of indictment,” he said.

Learn family history

Museum hosting genealogy workshops

ROCHELLE – Two local organizations are helping individuals learn more about their family history.

Laurie Carline Perry, from the Rochelle chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, will be hosting three upcoming genealogy workshops at the Flagg Township Museum. The DAR is hosting the workshops to help people learn more about their family tree, while also shedding light on the many things the DAR does.

“The workshops are here to help people get started doing any kind of genealogy work, as well as helping people build

upon any research they have already done,” said Jan Devore, director of the Flagg Township Museum. “It gives a perspective that goes beyond what people think of when they hear the DAR, which is strictly making a connection to the revolutionary war.”

The workshops are free to attend and set for Sunday, March 15, April 19 and May 17, all from 1-3:30 p.m. The museum hopes that hosting the meetings in its building will also bring attention to the free research station it has set up for the public.

The research station was provided by the Rochelle Area Community Foundation through a grant last year. The station can be used for many different tasks from looking

through old documents that have been digitized, to determining when one’s relatives immigrated from overseas.

With the many different genealogy tests available and the invention of the Internet, people have recently become more interested in family history. No matter the amount of previous research done, the workshops will benefit everyone who attends.

“The workshops are very well done and people will get a lot out of it,” said Devore. “If you even think you are interested in this, it is an excellent starting place. It is not just for starters though, if you have experience doing this, there will still be something new that you will learn.”

Van Stedum and his wife Katie moved to the Oregon area in 2005 from the suburbs where he had driven a garbage truck since 1978.

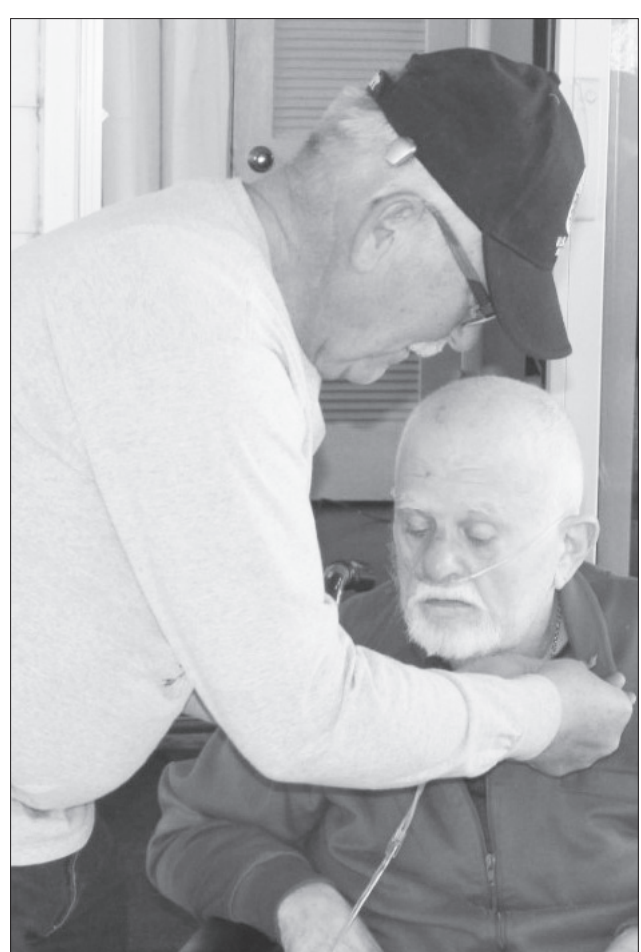
“Business was always picking up,” Van Stedum jokes.

EMBALMING PROCESS

The embalming process essentially involves replacing the blood and other bodily fluids with a preservative such as formaldehyde. Embalming is required by law only under certain circumstances, but families that intend to have a public viewing of the body usually choose to have it done, embalming preservative powers give them more leeway in scheduling a funeral. Embalmers are adept at restoring natural features that have been injured or to people who die after a long illness. They have a range of techniques to deal with various difficulties. They can replace missing hair, rebuild fractured features, or disguise the effects of

the drastic weight loss from a long, wasting illness. Before it is placed in the casket, the body is dressed and prepared for viewing. Hair is shampooed and set, and men get a shave. Families are sometimes encouraged to bring in a recent photograph of the deceased to help guide them.





Rep. Demmer introduces, co-sponsors legislation to lower the cost of health care and prescription drugs

SPRINGFIELD — State Representative Tom Demmer (R-Dixon) is introducing and co-sponsoring two pieces of legislation aimed towards lowering the cost of health care and prescription drugs.

“The rising cost of health care and prescription drugs is one of the biggest issues facing the people of Illinois,” said Rep. Demmer. “I believe we can enact some fairly common-sense solutions that increase transparency and encourage competition to lower the cost of care and prescription drugs. HB 4822 and HB 5510 do just that. I look forward to supporting these two pieces of legislation, and I urge my colleagues from both sides of the aisle

to support them as well.”

Preserving access to affordable drugs

House Bill 4822 (HB 4822), introduced by Rep. Demmer, would create the Preserving Access to Affordable Drugs Act. If enacted, HB 4822 would outlaw the anticompetitive practice of brand name prescription drug companies from entering into agreements with generic drug companies that delay the entry of generic drugs into the marketplace.

Essentially, brand name manufacturers are paying generic manufacturers to not sell generic drugs once

a brand name patent ends, which artificially inflates the price of prescription drugs. This legislation would speed up the entry of generic drugs in to the market and would lower drug prices by increasing competition between generic and brand name drug companies.

Prior Authorization Reform Act

House Bill 5510 (HB 5510), introduced by Rep. Greg Harris of Chicago and co-sponsored by Rep. Demmer, would create the Prior Authorization Reform Act. Before a hospital clinician can prescribe a medication or perform

a surgery covered under an insurance policy, they must receive approval from the insurance company, which is a process known as prior authorization. In some cases, this process leads to the delay of medical care and increases compliance costs for hospitals and medical facilities. HB 5510 would increase transparency to the prior authorization process and would establish timelines for insurance companies to respond to clinicians’ authorization requests, which would speed up the delivery and lower the cost of care.

HB 4822 has yet to be assigned to a substantive committee and HB 5510 is awaiting a hearing in the House Human Services Committee.

Regional heartbreak

Postseason ends as Hubs fall to Geneseo 61-54 in championship game

STERLING — The Hubs did everything they could to slow down Geneseo standout Isaiah Rivera during the IHSA 3A Sterling Regional Championship on Friday. A third-quarter surge was all the Maple Leaf senior and Colorado State commit needed to start his engine, however, and his spark was the deciding factor in Rochelle’s 61-54 loss to Geneseo.

Rivera netted only two field goals in the first half, with three of his eight first-half points coming on free-throw attempts. Trailing 35-33 at halftime, the Hubs looked to take the lead, but cold shooting to open the third quarter led to multiple rebounds and full-court drives to the rim for the 6-foot-5-inch forward Rivera, who scored 10 of his 22 points in that quarter.

“We knew we could only contain him for so long,” head coach Tim Thompson said. “We said that our defense had to be

predicated on our offense, and that if we could play fast and make baskets, they can’t get the ball out to him and we can set our defense. In that third quarter, when we started missing shots, they got him the ball, and that’s where he’s unstoppable.”

Rather than Rivera starting strong for Geneseo, it was Maple Leaf freshman Bristol Lewis who stepped up early, scoring six points in the first quarter to help his team carry an 18-15 lead into the second quarter. Rochelle hung tough throughout the first half, with senior Austin Brown sinking three of his team-high eight 3-pointers in the second quarter to keep it a one-possession game. Brown led all Hubs with a season-high 28 points on Friday.

“We knew Lewis was going to be an issue,” Thompson said. “We saw him shoot the ball well in the 3-point contest and he shot the ball well when we watched him on film.”

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle softball program finished the 2019 season winning three of its final four games including an IHSA 3A Regional matchup against Dixon. The Lady Hubs will be looking to build on their six-win season when they take the field this spring. Rochelle held its first practice of the 2020 campaign on Monday, with the team scheduled to open the season with a non-conference home game against Belvidere North on Wednesday, March 25. The Lady Hubs graduated a handful of starters from last year’s team including catcher Maddi O’Rorke and infielders Emilee Dueringer, Macy Luxton and Becca Bunger.

“We’re excited for the season to start and we have some returning players who we’re really excited about,” head coach Lindsay Suess said. “We have some new talent coming in as well and we’re looking to build on what we did

last year.”

Sophomore outfielder Jordin Dickey and senior utility player Hannah Luxton headline Rochelle’s returning players this season. Dickey compiled a .318 batting average, earning All-Conference First Team honors from the Northern Illinois Big 12. Luxton led the Lady Hubs with a .348 average and an on-base percentage over .400.

“We want to compete in the conference and I think that joining the new conference will give us a new look at some of our opponents,” Suess said. “We want to be more competitive in our games, and it would be nice to win a few more games in the postseason.”

Rochelle will also return two starting pitchers from last season including junior Bella Lodico, who struck out well over 100 batters in 2019. Senior twins Ally and Abby Reish, both Kishwaukee College commits, are also expected to play larger roles. The 2020 season will be Rochelle’s first as

a member of the Interstate 8 Conference.

“Returning both Bella and Ally as our top two

pitchers is really exciting,” Suess said. “Hannah will be our utility player this year, and Jordin returning

"We concentrated so much on keeping the lane packed for Rivera that he's naturally going to kick the ball out. We closed out and challenged shots well... The kids executed our plan the very best they could."

Rivera's scoring streak in the third quarter put Geneseo ahead by as many as 15 points before Rochelle slowly battled its way back in the game. A 3-pointer from Brown closed the third quarter out, with the Maple Leafs leading 52-40. Brown continued to fire in the fourth quarter, adding three more triples and helping Rochelle bring Geneseo within five points, 59-54, with roughly one minute to play in regulation.

"I can't say enough about Austin Brown," Thompson said. "He wears his heart on his sleeve, and I had no doubt that Austin was going to play well tonight. The bigger the game, the better Austin's going to play. He's just that kind of kid, and I was really proud to see him play so well tonight. He fought through a groin injury and he was awesome."

Geneseo missed the front end of two 1-and-1 free-throw opportunities in the last minute, and the Maple Leafs gave Rochelle a third chance when Kyle Traphagen drew the front of the iron. But Traphagen outrebounded four Hubs for the ball before sending it out to Lewis, who made two free throws with about 10 seconds to play. Senior Landan Martin finished with 10 points for the Hubs, with Garrett Burdin and Seth Gould combining for 13 points.

"It's always so hard because when we play athletics, there's always a finality to it," Thompson

said. "It's hard to see the kids crushed, but our message was totally positive after the game. I've been a part of the Rochelle basketball program for 21 years, and we had a season where we started 19-0, but the second half of this season is about as good of basketball as I've seen at Rochelle, especially considering where the boys came from being 4-9 to start the season."

Rochelle finished the 2019-20 season with a 20-12 overall record and

a 9-5 record in the Interstate 8 Conference. The Hubs won 16 of their last 19 games.

Shootout

Rochelle fielded four competitors in the Regional 3-Point Shootout, with Austin Brown and Garrett Burdin each qualifying for the sectional tournament next weekend. Brown led the Hubs in the regional contest, taking second with 11 triples made while Burdin tied for third with 10 made.

RTHS Baseball

Unknowns loom as Hubs gear up for new season

Senior trio headlines varsity players returning this spring

ROCHELLE — The Hubs will be counting on leadership and production from their three returning senior players when Rochelle's baseball team opens the 2020 season with a road game against Genoa-Kingston on March 17.

Seniors Gavin Ansteth, Ethan Etes and Austin Greifenkamp will carry the big sticks in the Rochelle batting order this season, and all three players will be asked to step up behind the plate and in the field. The Hubs, now members of the Interstate 8 Conference, are looking to remain competitive after finishing 16-9 this past season.

"It's always interesting to see who we have and how much the kids have improved," head coach Jarrod Reynolds said. "It's essential that our seniors are good leaders and set a good example for the rest of the group. If our seniors are doing what they need to do, that sets the tone for our program over the next few years. We need them to have some important at-bats for us and fill some important positions around the field."

Ansteth returns as Rochelle's top hitter after batting .378 with three homers and 23 RBIs during the 2019 season. Pitching will be an area the Hubs need to develop, however, as the team lost six senior hurlers this past year including top-3 starters Johnny Beck, Brandon Johnson and Cody Johnson. Juniors Evan Meyers and Mark Hopkins earned limited varsity reps last season.

"Everybody will have to pitch for us," Reynolds said. "We have a lot of games at the start of the season and we'll need to depend on everybody. There are some unknowns right now, but I think that's exciting because we're going to see who can step up and fill those roles."

Juniors Kyler Lara and Sam Hacaga are two more players to keep an eye on when the Hubs take the field this season. As the spring unfolds, Reynolds said he's optimistic that the unknowns currently looming over the team will shake themselves out.

"We only have two returning starters," Reynolds said. "Our spots are open to the kids who play well and practice well. The spots are there for the taking."

Huskies work out for NFL scouts at Pro Day

Chicago Bears among 12 teams in attendance Wednesday

DEKALB — A total of 14 former Northern Illinois University football players, as well as several other local products, worked out under the watchful eyes of professional scouts representing 12 National Football League teams as NIU held its annual Pro Day Wednesday.

Players began the day with weigh-ins and measurements, including height, hand size and wing span, before starting the “testing” portion of the day with the bench press and vertical leap in the Northwestern Medicine Sports Performance Center. NIU offensive lineman Jordan Steckler led the way with 26 reps of 225 pound in the bench press with tailback Marcus Jones close behind at 24 reps.

Jones’ vertical jump of 34 inches was also in good company in the group, behind only Marshé Terry’s 36.5-inch leap among the former Huskies, and just ahead of Spencer Tears’ 33.5.

The action moved inside the Chessick Practice Center, where three Huskies

surpassed the 10-foot mark in the broad jump with Terry’s 10-3 leap leading the way, followed by Tears at 10-2 and Mykelti Williams’ 10-1. In the 40-yard dash, Jones posted a time of 4.53 for the fastest time of the day by a 2019 Huskie. Dwayne Milton, who played for NIU in 2016 and ’17 before transferring to St. Francis where he became an NAIA All-American, ran a 4.54 in his second attempt.

Terry (4.61), Tears (4.63) and Williams (4.69) posted the next fastest 40 times. Timing continued with players asked to run the three-cone and shuttle runs.

The day concluded with scouts putting players through positional drills split into the offensive and defensive line, defensive backs and then receivers, running backs and quarterback.

NFL teams represented included the Green Bay Packers, Los Angeles Chargers, Chicago Bears, Houston Texans, Jacksonville Jaguars, New York Jets, Denver Broncos, Arizona Cardinals, Tampa Bay Buccaneers, San Francisco

49ers, Carolina Panthers and Detroit Lions.

NIU coaches and players were interested observers of the activities.

“Obviously Pro Day is for these young men and their futures,” said NIU head coach Thomas Hammock. “Hopefully they will keep training, keep themselves in football condition and be ready for whatever opportunity presents itself in the future. I’ve been a part of a lot of Pro Days so it’s nice for me to be on this side of and kind of sit back and watch.”

Hammock and his 2020 NIU Huskies open spring practices Thursday and Friday with a pair of closed acclimatization sessions. The team will then take a break for spring break before resuming practices the week of March 16. A complete spring schedule and preview will be available Thursday on NIUHuskies.com.

Missouri

Missouri will become the second Southeastern Conference football team to visit Huskie Stadium as

Northern Illinois University and the University of Missouri on Friday announced a three-game series between the schools that will begin in 2028.

NIU will play the Tigers in Columbia on Sept. 30, 2028 and on Sept. 4, 2032, and NIU will play host to Missouri on Sept. 29, 2029.

The 2028 game will mark the first meeting between the teams.

The Huskies’ lone victory over an SEC team came in 2003 when NIU defeated No. 21 Alabama, 19-16, in Tuscaloosa. All-time, NIU is 1-11 in 12 road games versus six different SEC opponents, including a 24-18 loss at Vanderbilt in 2019. The Commodores will become the first SEC team to play in DeKalb on Sept. 17, 2022.

In addition to the Missouri games, NIU has finalized a home-and-home series versus New Mexico State in 2024 and 2027. The Huskies will play in Las Cruces on Sept. 14, 2024 and will host the Aggies on Sept. 11, 2027.

NIU’s 2020 non-conference schedule begins with



the season opener versus Rhode Island at Huskie Stadium, followed by a road game at Maryland on Sept. 12. After opening Mid-American Conference play at Eastern Michigan on Sept. 19, the Huskies will take on Iowa in Iowa City on Sept. 26. On October 24, the Huskies will play BYU in the 2020 Huskie Chi-Town Showdown at SeatGeek Stadium in Bridgeview, Illinois. Single game tickets for that contest are now available. Click here.

Hubs open regional with upset over Sterling

Gould, Simmons shine as Rochelle defeats Golden Warriors 75-59

STERLING — Ryan Simmons picked his spots early, and the 6-foot-4 sophomore found enough space to shred the Golden Warriors from the perimeter when No. 5 seed Rochelle battled No. 3 seed Sterling in the IHSA 3A Regional Semifinals on Wednesday.

Simmons hadn't scored over 12 points in a game all season, but that quickly changed after he drilled six field goals in the first half including three 3-pointers. Using corner and elbow shots to his advantage, Simmons helped the Hubs upset the Golden Warriors 75-59 and reach the championship game against No. 2 seed Geneseo. Wednesday also marked the first victory over Sterling for Rochelle (20-11, 9-5 Interstate 8) since 2015.

"Once they start falling, they keep falling," Simmons said. "When the team keeps feeding me the ball, it all works out for everybody. Those corner and elbow shots have been my main spots in practice recently, and I shoot from those spots all of the time. It was very important for us to get out to a good start. We knew we had to play fast and we had to play hard."

Sterling entered the night with home-court advantage, but behind 10 first-quarter points from Simmons, Rochelle

seized control over Musgrove Fieldhouse early. The Hubs outscored the Golden Warriors 25-11 in the first quarter, with six players making baskets along the way.

"It feels amazing," senior Seth Gould said. "We came here and told ourselves that we're not losing this game... I caught the ball down low, and the

basket was open most of the time I turned around, so I thought I might as well put the ball in there."

Gould found himself matched up against Sterling forward Trevon Jordan, who held a 3-inch, 70-pound size advantage, but the Rochelle senior utilized superior footwork and balance to score 20 of his team-leading and

Sterling guard Cooper Willman gave the Golden Warriors a brief spark to open the fourth quarter, making two 3-pointers and scoring eight straight

points within the first 90 seconds. Sterling became more aggressive on the boards, and although Rochelle didn't knock down a single 3-pointer in the second half, the Hubs were too far ahead to be caught. Senior Landan Martin helped close the win out with eight of his 16 points on four layups in the fourth quarter.
