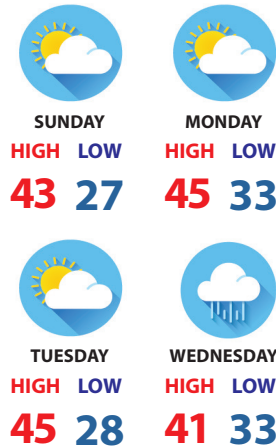

Schools closed

Governor's directive done to slow virus spread

ROCHELLE — Rochelle schools superintendent Jason Harper confirmed that all Rochelle schools will be closed starting Monday, March 17 through Monday, March 30.

Following President Trump's declaration of a national emergency regarding the spread of the coronavirus on Friday and Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker's subsequent announcement that all schools in Illinois were to close from March 17 to March 30, Harper released a statement that all Rochelle schools would not be in session for the remainder of the month.

The plan as of Friday afternoon calls for students to return to school on Tuesday, March 31.

Rochelle school staff members have been preparing over the past few days for this impending announcement which Harper sent to parents and guardians through the schools' email and text alert system. The following information was included:

"All students in grades Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12 will be coming home with packets of school work for five days of Alternative Learning at home.

Alternative learning

Starting Monday, students are expected to complete each day of work.

These Alternative Learning assignments

will be due when school re-opens.

Your students' attendance will be determined on the days of completed assignments they turn in.

All expected tasks can be completed with paper/pencil. There is no expectation of Internet usage.

If your student was not at school on Friday, March 13, please e-mail your building principal for arrangements.

We will communicate any changes or updates to this plan using our all-call/text system, social media, district websites and local media outlets.

College classes, senior center activities, local gatherings cancelled

ROCHELLE — As cases of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) increase across the country and state, many organizations are implementing strict guidelines to limit its spread, protect those at high risk and prevent healthcare facilities from being overwhelmed.

With universities and schools in the nation temporarily closing, many institutions and organizations across the state have begun doing the same. Northern Illinois University, Illinois State University, University of Illinois and Kishwaukee College, Rochelle

schools and the Hub City Senior Center have announced changes to their normal operations.

Northern Illinois University President Lisa Freeman announced Wednesday that the college is extending its spring break until March 22. Following spring break, the university will offer modified courses from March 23 to April 4.

While students will not be meeting for classes, residence and dining halls will remain open for students who wish to stay on campus. The campus itself will remain open and all staff will continue working its usual schedules as well.

Ogle County Election Day Tuesday

ROCHELLE — While the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) has been disrupting many public events, polling locations throughout the country are beginning to feel the effects as election day approaches.

Election day in the United States is set for next Tuesday, March 17 and with many people coming into close contact, polling places have started making changes to the current procedure. Recently, local polling locations open for early voting haven't seen a

decrease in individuals coming out to vote, but volunteer election judges have started to cancel.

Election judges are all volunteer based and help individuals with their applications and ballots from 5 a.m. until the polling is finished at 7 p.m. When sign up began, there was no shortage of election judges but with the recent developments of COVID-19 many have begun to cancel out of fear of catching the virus or currently not feeling well.

Gas prices take a dip

ROCHELLE — Recently, the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) has been impacting everything from universities to professional sports leagues and now it has begun affecting gas prices across the country.

Driven by the Coronavirus pandemic and a crude oil price war between Saudi Arabia and Russia, gasoline prices throughout the United States are dropping fast. According to AAA, Gas prices have hit a new low for the year, at \$2.30 a gallon on Friday.

This comes as a sur-

prise because gas prices are usually climbing this time of year, as people begin to travel more. Prices still vary throughout the country by location, but the national average could reach \$2 soon if the current trend continues.

"Should trends continue the way they are, there is a possibility we could see the national average hit \$2 in the coming weeks," said Jeanette Casselano, AAA spokesperson, in an interview with NPR.

Drivers throughout the country and locally have been enjoying the savings and filling up their vehicles. Prices locally, range from the lowest of



\$1.84 at Clark gas station on Route 251 and the highest of \$2.21 at the Shell station on the south side of town. One resident filling up at the local road ranger could not believe the price.

"\$2.04, that is the lowest it has been in a long

time," said Arlyn Van Dyke, local resident. "I honestly can't remember the last time I have seen it that low."

While drivers throughout the country have been rejoicing at the surprisingly low prices, organi-

zations such as AAA and U.S. producers of oil are worried it could be a sign of something negative. Cheap oil coming in from Russia and Saudi Arabia may save American Drivers money, but is costing American producers significantly more.

While the low gas prices may cause struggles down the line for many of the oil producers in the United States, right now, drivers are enjoying the low prices and a change of pace in the news.

"With everything else that has been going on around the world lately, this is a good sight to see," said Van Dyke.

During this period, NIU will identify ways it they can offer academic support services and continue to provide childcare and health services. In an email sent to the NIU community, president Freeman says she understands the magnitude of this situation and how it affects everyone.

"This type of developing situation will no doubt leave you with more questions than answers," said Freeman. "We are in constant communication with Gov. Pritzker's office, state agencies and public health authorities and are working around the clock to work out details and provide communication and instructions as soon as possible. I deeply appreciate the care and resilience they are demonstrating throughout this process and I especially appreciate your patience."

University of Illinois has also suspended face-to-face classes and is urging its residents to continue taking classes online from their permanent residences beginning March 23. Illinois State university has extended spring break until March 23 and is moving to online classes until at least April 12 as well.

On Thursday, Kishwaukee College officials released an alternative instructional delivery plan as well, stressing that the college is not closing, only attempting to reduce the density of people on campus. The plan, outlined on the college's website, reads:

"Next week the college will add an additional week of Spring Break for our students, from March 16 through March 21 with campus operation hours from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Faculty and staff will continue to report to work with faculty having time to develop their alternative instructional delivery plans. The week

of March 23 through March 27 will be spring break as scheduled. The alternative instructional delivery method will begin on March 30 and will continue through April 9. At that point, we will reassess the situation. We will be canceling all group functions on campus, per the recommendation of the DeKalb County Health Department to suspend activities for groups of 25 people or more.

We plan to keep the Early Learning Center open as long as it is feasible/safe.

The college's response seeks to strike a balance between preparedness and caution on this important matter. Our most important responsibility is to provide continuity of instruction. We are preparing to move instruction online where possible, with limited on campus labs, studio and shop based face to face classes. Our goal is to decrease the overall concentration of students on campus without disrupting the work of teaching and learning."

Kishwaukee College will update their instructional plan accordingly. Visit www.kish.edu/covid19 for the most up to date information.

Senior center

Locally, under the decision of the Illinois Department on Aging, the Hub City Senior Center has cancelled all group and social activities including congregational meals beginning Monday, March 16 until further notice. The center has also cancelled all of its transportation and caseworker services.

Meals on Wheels will continue to operate under normal operations for the time being. The senior center is aware of the struggles this will put on many of the senior citizens in the community. The decision was made due to the increased risk the virus poses to the

elderly.

"The safety and well-being of our seniors is our utmost importance and we know the hardships this will create for many of them," said Connie Dougherty, executive director of the Hub City Senior Center. "It makes me really sad to do this and we hope that it does not last long. But, we ask the seniors to please use caution and follow the health safety procedures from the CDC."

The senior center also urges all seniors to call anytime for updates and to keep up to date with the news for any developments with the virus.

State of the Community Dinner

The League of Women Voters and Rochelle Chamber of Commerce State of the Community Dinner scheduled for Thursday, March 19 has been cancelled.

According to LWV co-president Eileen Liezert the LWV decided to cancel the event with hopes of rescheduling the event at a later date.

"The board will meet the first Tuesday in April and will talk about hopefully rescheduling the dinner for a later date," Liezert said.

The State of the Community Dinner has been held annually for past several years.

The Vince Carney Community Theater currently does not have a date set to reschedule the event since the health departments did not put a length on their recommendations.

Additionally, all Rochelle schools are cancelling all public events in accordance with guidance provided by the Ogle County Health Department and the Illinois Department of Public Health. This includes field trips, competitions, concerts, ceremonies, and other similar events. All school clubs and practices are cancelled while school is closed. We will communicate these cancellations via social media and through group advisors/coaches.

We encourage all community members to follow guidance provided by the Ogle County Health Department, Ogle County Regional Office of Education, IPDH, and the CDC. All decisions are being made with the safety and well-being of our students in mind, and we are being as responsive as we can with the most reliable information we are receiving.

The Fitness Center will be closed until further notice with the exception of Cardiac Rehab and Pulmonary Rehab.

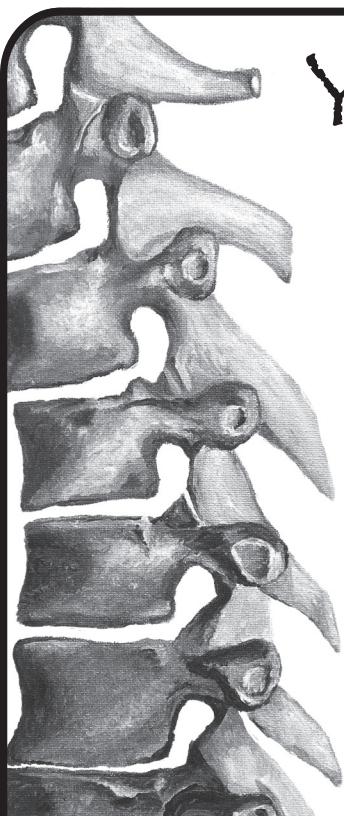
Visitor restrictions are temporary and subject to change as necessary.

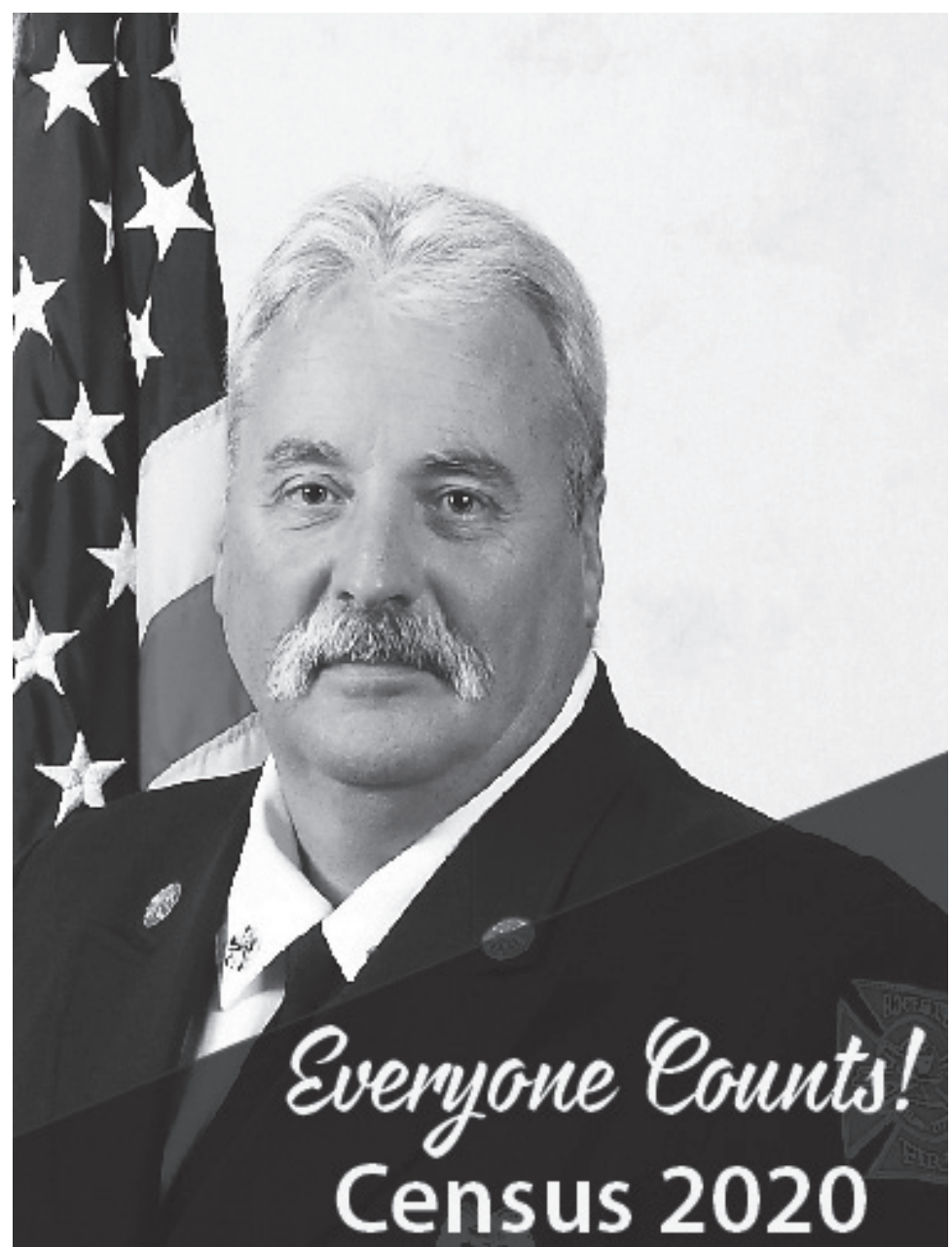

“We have had a lot of people start to cancel because they just don’t want to be around other people right now,” said Ogle County Clerk Laura Cook. “Some of them are also feeling under the weather, it is going to be a stretch this election.”

To ensure the senior citizens in the area still get to vote, Cook has gone around to each of the nursing homes and dropped off ballots that she will go around and collect later.

Come election day, anyone who is currently registered to vote, with valid voter’s registration, is required to go to their specific polling location to vote. For individuals who are not currently registered to vote, they have to come to the Ogle County Court House between 6 a.m. and 7 p.m. to register and vote.

Hillcrest officials OK on-site fuel tank, seal coat project

Per new business, village water bills will increase by around 3 percent, with new bills scheduled to be sent out later this month. The annual increase stems from a village ordinance. The next village meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 8 at 7 p.m.

John Deere Historic Site open for season

GRAND DETOUR — The John Deere Historic Site opened its gates to the public for its 56th season on Monday, March 2 at 1 p.m.

Located in Grand Detour, the site is the original Illinois homestead of John Deere and where he built his first self-scouring steel plow. This year, guests will be treated to an updated archeologic exhibit with new hands-on features that explore a blacksmith anvil and a replica of John Deere’s first plow. They will also learn more about the story behind the birthplace of the company.

Also new this year, the John Deere Historic Site will host a special family event on Saturday, October 10, 2020. Forge Into Fall Fun is the site’s signature event, celebrating the age-old trade of blacksmithing and the bounty of the fall harvest season. Guests will see dozens of blacksmiths and other artisans crafting one-of-a-kind pioneer-era items while kids can decorate pumpkins, bob for apples, pet farm animals, and take horse-and-wagon rides.

“We are very excited to open our doors to the public and show off our new exhibit, enhancing the experience

guests have when they visit,” said Kristen Veto, manager of the John Deere Pavilion. “Coming to the John Deere Historic Site is like taking a step back in time. From watching a blacksmith demonstration to seeing how John Deere and his family lived, there is so much to explore and learn about an important part of history.”

John Deere Historic Site Exhibits

Blacksmith Shop: A highlight of any visit to the site includes seeing a recreation of John Deere’s original blacksmith shop. Entering the exhibit is like walking into a time warp to early pioneer days as guests see the shop as it would have looked over a century ago. Throughout the day, resident blacksmiths demonstrate what it takes to be a skilled ironworker.

accommodated live-in apprentices in their six-room home. See the rooms as the Deere family would have known them, furnished with period household items that show how pioneers cooked, cleaned, bathed, and spent their few leisure hours.

Archeological Site: In 1963, an archeology team uncovered the exact location where John Deere forged his first self-scouring steel plow. While visitors look over the preserved site and see firsthand the excavated artifacts, a video tells the story of how John Deere built a thriving manufacturing business. New features uncover Deere’s story according to neighbors at the time and provide a hands-on element.

Gift Shop: This one-of-a-kind gift shop sells hand-forged items made in the blacksmith shop. A selection of John Deere licensed items and other Historic Site merchandise is available.

The John Deere Historic Site is open March through December. Gates are open Monday 1 to 5 p.m. and Tuesday through Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Admission is free.

EMBALMING PROCESS

The embalming process essentially involves replacing the blood and other bodily fluids with a preservative such as formaldehyde. Embalming is required by law only under certain circumstances, but families that intend to have a public viewing of the body usually choose to have it done, embalming preservative powers give them more leeway in scheduling a funeral. Embalmers are adept at restoring natural features that have been injured or to people who die after a long illness. They have a range of techniques to deal with various difficulties. They can replace missing hair, rebuild fractured features, or disguise the effects of

the drastic weight loss from a long, wasting illness. Before it is placed in the casket, the body is dressed and prepared for viewing. Hair is shampooed and set, and men get a shave. Families are sometimes encouraged to bring in a recent photograph of the deceased to help guide them.

Hospital, health department, city extend information about virus and precautions

Dear Editor,

All of us at Rochelle Community Hospital are working alongside the Ogle County Health Department and the City of Rochelle to monitor rapidly changing conditions about the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). Our highest priority is the health and well-being of our patients, staff and residents of the communities we serve. Like every organization today, we are seeking federal, state and regional guidance in determining the appropriate adjustments to make as the COVID-19 situation evolves.

It is important to note that there are no confirmed cases in Ogle County as of March 11, 2020.

We continue to stress that residents limit the possible spread of the disease with these precautions:

- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use a hand sanitizer with 60 percent alcohol if soap and water are not available.
- Cover your sneeze and cough.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Stay home if you are sick.
- Social distancing – maintain a distance of

three feet from other people; avoid shaking hands and hugging.

- Avoid close contact with sick people.
- Avoid travel if your destination is in an area with widespread outbreak.

Stay current on accurate information from reputable sources, such as the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Ogle County Health Department. All these sources are sharing updates and information on their websites and social media pages. Go to www.cdc.gov for the most current information about the virus including precautions and frequently asked questions.

If you are sick, we certainly want you to seek medical attention. We ask that you call ahead to the emergency department, provider office or Convenient Care if you are in one of the three high risk categories:

Have a fever and signs of a respiratory illness (cough, shortness of breath) and have travelled to a country or region that has an increased incidence of community spread COVID-19 within 14 days of symptom onset.

Have a fever and signs of a respiratory illness (cough, shortness of breath) and have

had close contact with a laboratory confirmed case of COVID-19 within 14 days of symptom onset.

Have a fever with severe acute lower respiratory illness (pneumonia, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome) requiring hospitalization and without an alternative explanatory diagnosis (i.e. Influenza) AND no source of exposure has been identified.

Rochelle Community Hospital, in conjunction with the CDC, the Ogle County Health Department and the Illinois Department of Public Health, does not recommend wearing a mask if you are not sick. If you are experiencing severe respiratory symptoms, call 911.

Since there is no specific treatment for this virus, we need the public's help. We can't do it alone.

Lutheran Social Services of Illinois keeping busy in the region

OGLE COUNTY — With its prevention programs, Lutheran Social Services of Illinois has been very busy offering services that benefit local youth in Ogle, Whiteside, Lee and Carroll counties.

Danielle Horst and Jackie Smith are two of the team members in Youth WORKS and Project LEAD who are dedicated to prevention activities in Ogle County. Both workers been extremely busy with teaching evidence based curriculum, leading a youth committee, and advocating for local schools to participate in the Illinois

Youth Survey.

In addition, the Prevention staff are planning for several requests to host the "Hidden in Plain Sight" exhibit, which is a setup of a mock teenager's bedroom. Participation in this exhibit increases awareness about the warnings signs of youth substance use, possession of drug paraphernalia, and concealment of illicit drugs and alcohol.

Recently, the "Hidden in Plain sight" exhibit was updated to include some of the most recent warning signs of not only youth substance use, but

also other high risk behaviors, including self-harm, bullying, suicidal ideation, and dating violence. Hidden in Plain Sight is presented in a small group setting with each adult attendee having the opportunity to walk through the room while a Prevention Specialist guides them through the mock bedroom and provides education about the contents.

Attendees also have the opportunity to ask questions and inspect the items in the exhibit. A question and answer period follows the end of the presentation and open the door for

any concerns adults within the communities might have.

Hidden in Plain Sight is an interactive adult's only exhibit which is periodically offered in the Ogle County communities.

LSSI's prevention programs are funded in part by the Illinois Department of Human Services, the local 708 Board of Ogle County, and local United Way Agencies.

Station undergoes maintenance

Byron reactor serviced; upgrades continue

BYRON — Operators removed Byron Generating Station's Unit 1 nuclear reactor from service last week for a scheduled refueling and maintenance outage.

While the unit is offline, technicians will replace one-third of the reactor's fuel and complete maintenance tasks that cannot be performed while the reactor is online.

The unit just completed its third consecutive uninterrupted 18-month cycle, in which it powered more than 1 million homes and businesses with carbon-free electricity every day. That clean power production is the equivalent emissions avoidance of removing 2 million vehicles from local roadways.

"Completing three 18-month cycles on Unit 1 without interruption is a testament to nuclear power's reliability and to the precise maintenance and operation by the nuclear workforce," said Site Vice President Mark Kanavos. "We rely on the skills and talents of many local union workers to support reliable, carbon-free energy generation for the Rock River community."

More than 1,200 supplemental workers will join 800 Exelon Generating employees in preparing the facility for another reliable run.



"The jobs provided by refueling outages are reliable and good-paying, attracting expert labor from far and wide," said Terry McGoldrick, president of IBEW Local 15. "It's a win-win for the local community and the workforce, who both benefit from their work and stay in the Rock River area."

For several weeks preceding and following the outage, the influx of workers provides a significant boost to the local economy.

"The refueling outages at Byron Station are a boon to our local economy," said Liz Vos, executive director of the Oregon Area Chamber of Commerce.

"Our area businesses will see the added foot traffic, which can make a big difference to the bottom lines of many merchants."

In addition to regular refueling and maintenance, the station will continue its commitment to major equipment upgrades. During the outage technical experts will replace two large transformers, which are used to take the electricity produced in the Unit 1 generator and distribute it within the plant to operate pumps and other equipment. Continually upgrading or replacing major components at the plant helps ensure the facility will run uninterrupted between outage projects, providing continuous carbon-free electricity to Northern Illinois and beyond.

With both units at full power, the Byron Generating Station produces almost 2,500 megawatts, enough electricity to power more than 2 million average American homes.

Electronic recycling is March 27

OREGON — The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will be conducting the monthly residential electronics recycling event on Friday, March 27.

The event is for Ogle County residents only and runs from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 909 Pines Road in Oregon. Please bring a valid form of ID verifying Ogle County residency.

Items accepted include all residential televisions, computers, computer monitors, peripheral computer hardware, laptops, tablets, cell phones, UPS systems, printers, copiers, FAX machines, routers, video gaming equipment, DVD/VCR players, satellite and cable boxes, remotes, stereo equipment, shredders, boom boxes, radios, digital clocks, phone systems, calculators, adding machines, holiday light

strands, extension cords, rechargeable batteries, CFL bulbs, and printer ink cartridges. Microwave ovens are accepted for a charge of \$5 per unit.

There is a limit of 7 bulk items per vehicle. A crate or box filled with accepted materials counts as one bulk item. Items not accepted at these events include smoke detectors, heaters, fans, dehumidifiers, light fixtures, LED bulbs, alkaline batteries, personal hygiene equipment, power and yard tools, coffee pots, toasters, bread machines, slow cookers, and other kitchen appliances. Also not accepted are shredder tubs, wood encased speakers, and packaging from your electronics. Please remove electronics from boxes, Styrofoam, and plastic wrap.

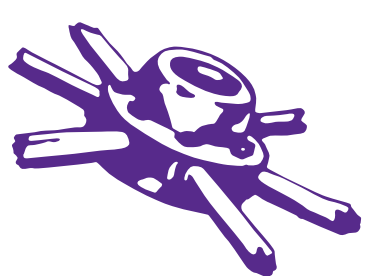
this year.

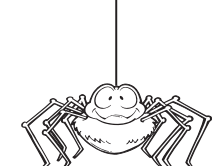

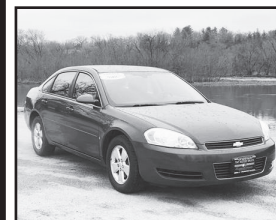

2020 spring sports cancelled

Steps taken to prevent spread of COVID-19

DEKALB — In concert with the Mid-American Conference and Northern Illinois University administration, effective immediately, NIU Athletics will cancel all spring sports and non-traditional season competition in 2020, NIU Associate Vice President and Director of Athletics Sean T. Frazier announced Thursday.

The decision was made by the MAC in consultation with the MAC Council of Presidents and Council of Directors of Athletics and followed the NCAA's announcement that it was cancelling all NCAA Championships for the remainder of the year.

The league also announced the cancellation of the MAC Women's Gymnastics Championship on Saturday, March 21 in Kalamazoo, Michigan and all MAC spring sports championships. All formal and organized

practice activities, including spring football, and all in person recruiting activities — both on and off campus — for all sports are suspended until further notice. The only permissible recruiting will be written and electronic communication (letters, emails, text messages, phone calls).

The decision to cancel spring sports competition affects seven NIU programs (baseball, softball, outdoor track and field, men's tennis, women's tennis, men's golf and women's golf), as well as the men's and women's soccer and volleyball teams which hold off-season competitions.

"We are in full support of these steps taken by the MAC," Frazier said. "At this point, the safety and health of our student-athletes, fans and community takes precedence over everything. We know that these unprecedented measures



were necessary based on prioritizing the safety and security of all the participants and fans involved. We're heartbroken for all of our student-athletes, especially our seniors, that their seasons had to end in this way."

NIU teams currently on the road for spring break will return as soon as possible.

In addition, the IESA State Wrestling Championships scheduled for the NIU Convocation Center this weekend have been cancelled. All other events, including the IHSA 3A/4A Supersectionals will be managed based on recommendations of local and state health agencies as well as university policies.

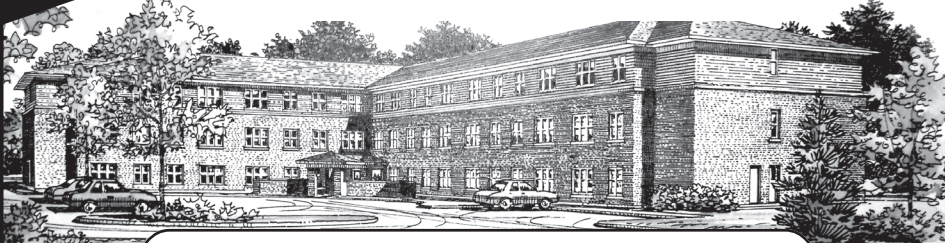

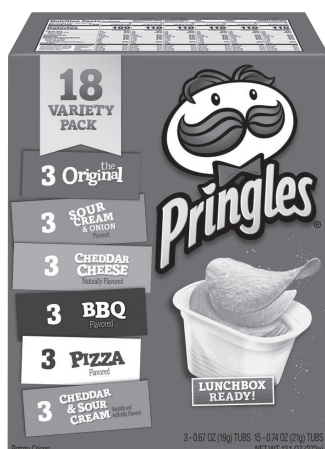
