“We know this is where the income goes to buy cars, pickups, drainage tile, family room additions, and so on,” Martin said. “It’s those bumper years in income that finance the extras on the farm.”

He said for all of Barnett Township, it represented potential lost net farm income of about \$1.8

million a year.

“Over 30 years of this proposed project, that’s \$54 million of economic impact,” he said.

Martin said ground application of chemicals for wide areas of crops was not a realistic option. He said the application window was not large enough to cover an area in

a timely manner.

Because of the risks he feels are associated with a wind energy project, as an appraiser, Martin said he would appraise a farm property lower in the area of a wind farm.

He said there existed little data on farms in wind project areas because, “farms just don’t turn over

that often.”

“So, to accurately appraise a property would lead one to include more of the risk and income components in their analysis,” he said. “Which, in this case, would lead to a lower valuation when compared to similar properties without any of these encumbrances.”

The council also approved some expenditures.

Commissioners approved appropriation of infrastructure funds of \$361,332 for improvement to Center Street, \$3,695 for Illini Drive street lights from Ameren Illinois,

\$9,990 to Donahoe & Associates, Inc. for engineering services to relocate the water main at Marco NPK, Inc., and the purchase of two Dell desktop computers for the police department not to exceed \$3,000.

The council also approved

intergovernmental agreement with the DeWitt County Housing Authority giving the police department authority to enforce parking code on private property. Police Chief Ben Lowers described the agreement as similar to

an agreement the city has with the school district.

Lowers said the agreement was intended to give officers the authority to enforce no parking in a fire lane area but also to deal with any other parking issues the housing authority has.

No monkey business, please

Welcome to my little corner of culinary delights. Some time ago, a dear friend asked me about bananas. She recalled something I had said about them but forgot it. I will now repeat it in written form. I thank you Kathy for bringing this up.

A point of trivia, a banana is not a fruit any more than a tomato is a vegetable. A banana is considered an herb and a tomato is a fruit. It does not really matter.

There are enzymes on the skin that causes the banana to ripen quickly. They are harvested from the tree and shipped green. As they continue ripening on the grocery store shelf, it does not take long for them to become overripe. For such things as puddings, you do not want them too ripe. For baking purposes; such things as

bread, pies, cookies and muffins, you want them overripe.

If you store bananas in a closed container along with fruit, the enzymes from the banana skins will speed up the ripening process of that fruit. This is a good reason to not store bananas in the refrigerator. A grocery store tries to order just the right amount to prevent having overripe bananas. As a result, I cannot depend on getting overripe bananas as needed. I therefore purchase bananas well in advance thus assuring availability when needed for baking. Now for the best way to store them.

Before working with

the bananas, rinse them. You do not know what all has crawled over them. The next thing to do is to thoroughly wash your hands with soap and hot water. Next, remove the banana pulp. Place this pulp into a stainless-steel bowl. Thoroughly mash with a handheld potato masher. Place a plastic film (plastic wrap) down over the surface. Then seal the bowl air tight. Store the mashed bananas in the refrigerator until needed. Since the banana skins are absent, the pulp remains good for over a month and other items in the refrigerator will not be affected by enzymes.

The top part of the mashed bananas might blacken. This hurts nothing. All it did was to oxidize. If you really want to try something wonderful, keep the mashed bananas in the

refrigerator long enough for them to ferment. The fermentation lends an unusual but wonderful flavor to the end product.

There is a wide use for bananas in cooking, baking and garnishing. Have you ever made a banana shake or smoothie? I enjoy making ice cream. Banana ice cream you get from the grocery store, if you can find it, is probably made with banana flavorings. Have you ever had a banana ice cream made from real bananas? If not, you are missing out on something wonderful. It is well worth the trouble. Discover how to use them as a dessert item, in cookies, puddings, etc. Try making a banana cracker. Be adventurous. Be daring; but don’t monkeying around.

Some don't grasp what rural life is really about

At a recent DeWitt County public hearing, county board candidate Megan Myers publicly stated that she believed that the private property rights of farmers in DeWitt County should be restricted based on the obstruction of view shed to surrounding residential neighbors.

For years now, this has been a key legislative and regulatory fight of the Farm Bureau and its members. The key issue, people moving to rural settings for the express intent of living the "rural life" on small acreage plots designated and zoned for agricultural purposes. What these new residents sometimes fail to understand is that their view is of our business and our livelihood. They come for beautiful vistas overlooking wind swept corn fields but could not tell you the price of corn or beans, cannot grasp the struggle we had with yields due to weather last year, or understand how the development of ground for explicit residential use impacts the economic sustainability of central Illinois farming operations.

These regulatory fights are not new or uncommon to the Illinois farmer. The Modern Farmer recently had an article on how 31 million acres of farmland has been lost due to the development of residential property in the last two decades. With that has come suburbanite neighbors who commonly protest smells, noise, and changes to the landscape always citing the same reason, "I moved out to the country and built my dream home, for the nice quite country life."

Our neighbors in McLean County had to pass zoning ordinances requiring a minimum of 40 acre lots in which the purchaser had to prove their homestead was explicitly being used for farming operations. The Illinois Farm Bureau for the past several years has fought to keep statewide permitting of hog operations with the Illinois Department of Agriculture. This regulatory process was put in place to protect pork producers from their residential neighbors. Neighbors who moved out to the country and did not view hog operations as a part of the rural aesthetic they had always dreamed of.

It is for these reasons that farmers in DeWitt County should consider voting for Dave Newberg and Jay Wickenhauser for District C. These candidates have a proven track record of protecting the private property of farmers in DeWitt County.

In addition, while other new county board members refused to even attend any finance committee meetings concerning the budget, Newberg and Wickenhauser worked tirelessly to pass a budget that protected residents from tax-increases. DeWitt County needs thoughtful and steady leadership not children playing political games, speaking of sending messages to Springfield, with aspirations of running for higher office in the back of their minds.





South's hand was not good enough to bid her Diamonds at the two-level, so she responded 1♣ and soon found herself declaring a 4♣ contract.

You can see all four hands, it's time to place your bets. Do you want to declare or defend?

Declarer can count a trick in each side-suit, so one route to success would be to cross-ruff the hand, scoring those trumps separately. But not so fast! West cleverly finds the opening lead of a trump, and Declarer can be sure that the defense will lead another trump next time they get in. The second trump lead holds Declarer to only six trump tricks (♠A, ♠K, plus two ruffs in each hand) to go with the three side-suit tricks.

So 4♣ is down one? Not necessarily, it may be possible to set up a long Heart for the 10th trick, and the best way to do that is to lose a Heart at Trick Two. The defense returns another trump, and now Dummy's ♥A is cashed, then a Heart ruffed. Declarer's ♠Q is taken by West, who cannot lead another trump. He does best to exit with a Club, but Declarer wins that in Dummy, ruffs another Heart, cashes the ♠A, ruffs a Diamond, draws East's last trump, and scores Dummy's long Heart. Making 10 tricks!

West could have made Declarer's life more difficult by letting Declarer's ♠Q hold the trick! This surprising play leaves Dummy an entry short of being able to enjoy the long Heart. So, down one after all? No, of course not, if West finds that fine play then Declarer counters by overtaking with the Queen with the King! That provides the extra Dummy entry, and 4♣ does indeed make. Was that how you bet?




