## Rabies vaccine required for all cats

Local veterinarian office hosting open house to discuss new law

ROCHELLE – The Rochelle Veterinary Hospital will be holding an informational open house event to discuss the new state law requiring all cats that interact with humans to be vaccinated against rabies. Anyone looking to learn more about vaccines, rabies or the new state law is urged to attend the open house meeting.

The meeting will be held at the Rochelle Veterinary Hospital on Thursday, Jan. 30, from 6 to 7 p.m. to discuss what rabies is and some of the risks it presents to animals and humans, why all rabies vaccines aren't created equal and why the state has made this change to the law.

There will also be dinner provided as well as speakers Dr. Warren and

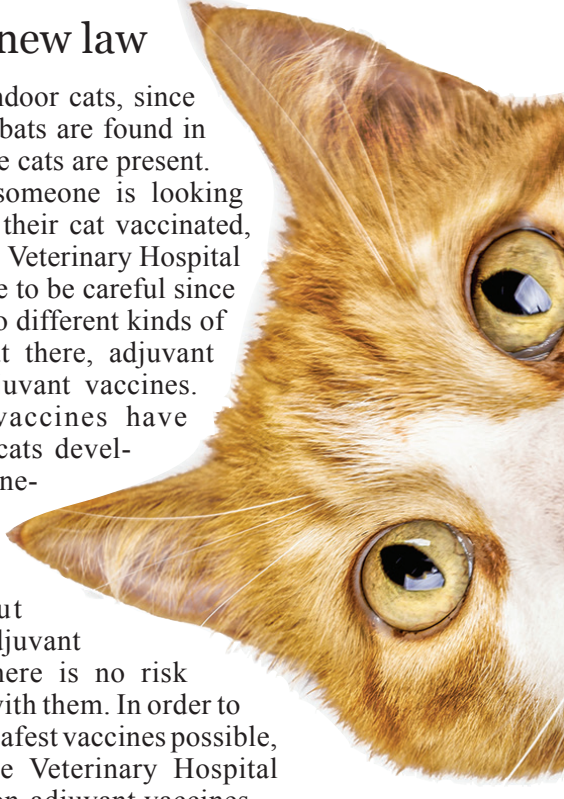
Tracey from Boehringer Ingelheim to answer any questions or concerns attendees might have. The event is free to attend, but the veterinary hospital kindly asks that people RSVP by Jan. 28. They can do so by phone at 815-562-5207 or through email at rochellevet@mail.com.

"We are excited to educate the community a little bit on the vaccines and give them a better understanding of why there is a change and why the state is requiring it now," explained Dr. Marquardt, doctor at Rochelle Veterinary Hospital.

According to the Illinois State Veterinary Medical Association, there are about 250 to 300 cases each year, and each case is 100 percent fatal to the pet. The animals most likely to spread the disease are bats, skunks, raccoons, foxes and coyotes. While these are all outdoor animals, rabies

can affect indoor cats, since many rabid bats are found in homes where cats are present.

Even if someone is looking into getting their cat vaccinated, the Rochelle Veterinary Hospital wants people to be careful since there are two different kinds of vaccines out there, adjuvant and non-adjuvant vaccines. Adjuvant vaccines have the risk of cats developing vaccine-induced sarcomas, a type of cancer. But with non-adjuvant vaccines, there is no risk associated with them. In order to provide the safest vaccines possible, the Rochelle Veterinary Hospital only uses non-adjuvant vaccines.

## Worldwide organization now has local chapter

ROCHELLE – Thanks to the efforts of three local women, a worldwide organization with chapters throughout the United States and Europe has recently created a local chapter in Ogle County.

100 Women Who Care is an organization with 650 county chapters spread across the United States and Europe. 100 Women Who Care gathers to raise money and make an impact on nonprofit organizations located within the same county as the chapter. The goal of each of the chapters is to donate \$10,000 to a local charity in one hour, four times a year by following a formula from the organization.

"Fundraising takes a lot of hours of leg work on the part of the volunteers and with system, only four meetings a

year, if we can get 100 women members who are willing to donate \$100 we can raise \$10,000 in one hour," explained Deanna Forrest, one of the three founders.

Group members will meet four different times a year for one hour each time, where they will each donate \$100 and choose the organization that will receive the \$10,000 donation. At the meetings, each member brings a check for \$100. Then members nominated organizations to be put into a hat to draw from. Three organizations are drawn at random at the meeting.

Nominating members of each of the chosen organizations make a 5-minute presentation about the organization or charity for the entire group to vote on which cause to support. Once an organization is chosen by the group they receive the funds immediately.

## Facade program open to all businesses

ROCHELLE – The City of Rochelle, in its continuing effort to support the revival and development of local business, has expanded its Façade Improvement Program to all business owners and operators within the community.

The city will provide a 50 percent matching grant, with a maximum amount of \$5,000 to business or building owners who complete eligible improvements to the facades of their buildings. Improvements must be constructed within six months of application approval.

Eligibilities

The city will match dollar-for-dollar an owner's investment in eligible improvements to the appearance of their building's storefront façade. The building or business owner who has funded most of the improvements must apply for and be approved in order to receive the 50 percent matching grant.

All commercially operated buildings within the community are eligible for the Façade Improvement Program. Only one grant will be awarded per building within a five-year period. Only improvements to facades that directly front a public right-of-way are eligible for funding.

## Battle of the Bulge: The Ardennes Counter Offensive

THIS January is the 75th anniversary of the Battle of the Bulge. In December 1944, the Germans were retreating on all fronts. The front line was along the border between Germany and the countries of Belgium, France and Luxembourg. Hitler wanted to stop this advance with a desperate thrust toward the port of Antwerp in Belgium to divide the Allies and cut off their supply route.

The plan was a huge gamble in that the Germans had only enough fuel to travel about one half of the way toward Antwerp. They assumed that they would capture Allied fuel supplies along the way, which would allow the tanks and other vehicles to make it to Antwerp.

The Germans massed a large force in the Ardennes Forest in eastern Belgium with the intention of attacking a weak area in the Allied lines, drive toward the port of Antwerp and capture it. This area opposite the German force was lightly defended by American units. Allies were preoccupied with attack plans and crossing the German border.

Intelligence did not detect the significance of the build-up because of the radio silence practiced by the Germans, the camouflage of the forest from air observation, and the lack of reconnaissance units patrolling the Ardennes Forest.

American units in this area were newly trained, were without combat experience or were resting after extensive deployment. Allied commanders did not believe that the German army could attack through such a dense forest. Nevertheless they did.

The battle started on Dec. 16, 1944 and lasted until Jan. 25, 1945. The German code name was "Operation Watch on the Rhine." The Germans started with a 90-minute artillery barrage to soften up Allied positions. It was thought by the Allies that this was a localized counter-attack to reverse recent advances by the Allies over the Siegfried line, the German defensive line near the German border. The weather was bad; a heavy snow storm had moved in. This was a mixed blessing for the Germans. The storm severely limited Allied air attacks, but also made it difficult for German vehicles to advance.

On Dec. 16, 1944 the Germans attacked toward the town of Bastogne and St. Vith in Belgium, primarily in the American sector. The Allies thought this was a small counter-attack, however as the attack progressed with many elite German divisions and the latest model of heavy tanks, it became obvious to the Allied command that this was a significant counter offensive. The Germans made a huge bulge in the front lines as they attacked, resulting the battle being called the "Battle of the Bulge." Despite the lack of a defensive plan, American units, no matter how well armed or trained, stepped up and began to resist the onslaught. The Germans pushed on to the town of Bastogne and an area called Elsenborn Ridge. Bastogne was a central crossroads town on the way to Antwerp. The Germans had to capture this town in order to reach their objective. As American resistance increased, the German attack became behind schedule, slowed and was eventually stopped at Bastogne and other towns.

Despite being surrounded, the 101st Airborne Division under General McAuliffe was ordered to defend Bastogne, while the 82nd held off SS Panzer Divisions at Elsenborn Ridge.

Meanwhile, General Patton's 3rd Army disengaged from a winter battle to the south and turned north to relieve Bastogne. Patten knew that when there was

a bulge in the line, it was easy to go behind the bulge, and trap the enemy in a pocket. The 4th Armored Division of Patton's 3rd Army relieved Bastogne on Dec. 26, 1944. The German offensive began to fail as a result of fuel shortage, supply interruption, stiff American resistance and improving weather allowing Allied aircraft, which had air superiority, to attack German positions.

By mid-January, many German vehicles had been abandoned from lack of fuel, but the German army made a successful fighting withdrawal, reducing the bulge to the configuration of mid-December 1944.

### Local involvement

Some Rochelle veterans were involved in the Battle of the Bulge.

Gerald Wine, member of the 334 Infantry Regiment of the 84th Infantry Division in an anti-tank company which engaged a large German armored column at the Ardennes Forest in December 1944, was wounded and survived the battle.

Ralph Walker was in the 106th Infantry Division at the battle.

Edward Heron was killed in action during the battle.

Stanley Larson was killed in action during the battle.

Walter Dailey of the 9th Army was captured during the battle and survived the war.

Charles M. Eyster, member of the 103rd Combat Engineers, survived the battle.

Gerald Jacobs was reported missing during the battle, but ended up as a prisoner of war and survived.

Oville Gentry was in the 79th Division during the battle and survived the war.

### Overall

To review, the battle started on Dec. 16, 1944 and ended on Jan. 25, 1945. The American losses were 19,000 killed, 47,000 wounded and 26,000 missing. The U.S. lost over 700 tanks. The German losses were 12,000 killed, 38,000 wounded and 30,000 missing.

The Germans lost over 500 irreplaceable tanks and 5000 soft skinned and armored vehicles.


By the end of January, the lines between the Allies and the Germans were roughly that of December 1944. The battle delayed the Allied advances into Germany by several weeks. The German forces were so depleted that this was the last major offensive by the enemy during World War II.

At the end of it all, Winston Churchill declared that the Battle of the Bulge was an American victory.

The "Battle of the Bulge" was the bloodiest for U.S. forces in WWII.

# County sets electronic recycling dates for 2020

**OREGON** – The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will offer residential electronics recycling throughout 2020 on select dates for Ogle County residents.

These drop-offs are held at the County Annex Building at 909 Pines Road in Oregon, which is just west of the Illinois Route 2 and Pines Road intersection.

These events are for Ogle County residential electronics and an ID is requested upon check-in at the event. Items accepted include all televisions, computers, monitors, computer hardware and cables, printers, FAX machines, desktop copiers, phone systems, cell phones, tablets, laptops, VCR/ DVD units, cable/ satellite boxes, video gaming equipment, radios, digital clocks, stereo equipment (no wooden speakers are accepted), holiday lights, extension cords, fish finders, calculators, rechargeable batteries, CFL bulbs, CD/DVD's, and printer cartridges. Microwave ovens are accepted for a \$5 fee. There is a limit of seven large items per vehicle, and boxes and crates filled with smaller items are considered a large item.

Unaccepted items include smoke detectors, vacuum cleaners, heaters, fans, dehumidifiers, sump pumps, motors, tools, toys,

lights, lamps, flashlights, appliances, coffee makers, toasters, bread makers, fryers, exercise equipment, and personal hygiene items. Please remove electronics from boxes and other packaging prior to attending the event. No business/ institutional electronics accepted at these events. Contact the OCSWMD for business electronic recycling options.

### Dates

The dates for the res-

idential electronics recycling program for 2020 are listed below:

Friday events will be held Jan. 31, Feb. 28, March 27, April 24, May 29, June 26, July 31, Aug. 28, Sept. 25, Oct. 30 and Nov. 20. There will be no December collection. These events run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Saturday events will be held on May 16 and Oct. 17 and will run from 8 a.m. to noon.

The OCSWMD may cancel or alter the hours of

any collection event based upon weather conditions, staffing, or warehouse space. The OCSWMD will make every effort to publicize cancellations of collection events through social media.

Any building with a zoning or building code violation is not eligible for the program. Any commercial building owner, or business owner with building owner authorization, may apply for the grant.

Façade improvements beginning construction before March 1 will not be eligible. Examples of eligible projects include: brick cleaning, exterior doors, streetscape elements, tuck pointing, windows and window frames, landscaping, painting, shutters and awnings, stairs, porches,

railings, wall façade repair and treatment, exterior lighting, roofs visible from the street, original architectural feature repair or replacement, signage repair or replacement, or improvements for ADA compliance.

Harvell was selected among the 12 High Performers of the Month in 2019. He has been employed at the hospital for two years as a skilled maintenance technician.

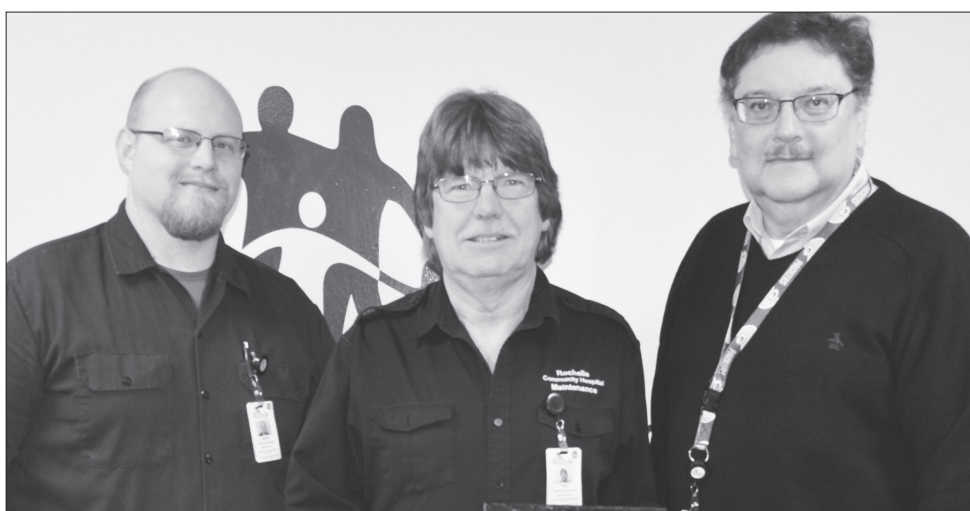
### Nominations

I started playing an instrument (trumpet) in the fifth grade, and moved to baritone by seventh grade. I did some time in the high school marching band before making the guitar my main instrument.

I wrote music and played in bands in high school, like many teens do. No, those songs weren't that great, but being creative was a muscle I loved to flex, and still do. In fact, it is a muscle I have to flex to survive, it seems.

I played while I was in the military. I played during college. I snuck in song writing and recording sessions while covering high school

football games at night and county board meetings during the day as a new reporter.

Being creative was an outlet I had to have in my life. The stress of being a new father and

working long hours and buying my first home were all washed away when I plugged in and played – or simply strummed my acoustic guitar.

I have hours and hours of tapes filled with songs I have written and recorded. Some are very good. Some are not so good. But all of them were a great emotional release when I needed it. And at times, these creative sessions have truly saved my sanity.

I still write and play music multiple times a week. My wife and I preform as an acoustic duo doing songs we wrote. We also play in an all-original rock band

in the region. Yes, I am still playing loud rock music and I plan to do so as long as I can. No, it is not a young man's game. It is not a game. It is the heartbeat of my life, and the life of many others.

If you have a son or daughter or grandson or granddaughter and they want to play an instrument, please encourage them to do so. Put up with the drumming, or the piano playing or the awful early stages of them learning the guitar. It might lead nowhere, but it might also be the beginning of a lifelong passion that gives them limitless joy.

In today's crazy world, we need to find our joy. We need to find an outlet from the crazy. We need art in our lives, I believe. For me it is music. And without it, I would not be who I am.



# Senior Night rolls on

### Hubs recognize three players before season finale against Streator

**ROCHELLE** — The Hubs came close to sending their three senior bowlers off with a victory when Rochelle hosted Streator for its Senior Night match at T-Byrd Lanes on Thursday. 923-887 win over Rochelle in the first game. Sophomore Devansh Patel rolled 179 for the Hubs, while John Henson added 165. Grabowski’s 194 and Ashton King’s 190 propelled the Bulldogs to

a 992-935 victory in the second game despite Henson’s 181 for Rochelle.

Rochelle’s second-pair trio of Dobberstein, Patel and Henson led the Hubs over Streator by a score of 995-977 in the final

# Hubs extend streak with Winnebago-Belvidere sweep

### Nay seals Rochelle’s 11th straight dual win on match-clinching pinfall

**BELVIDERE** — Behind 13 points with only three bouts remaining, the Rochelle wrestling team needed to win out in order to have any chance of defeating Belvidere on Tuesday.

285-pounder Zack Capes was first to step up for the Hubs, recovering from an early takedown to pin Bryan West and bring Rochelle within seven points. Belvidere forfeit the 106-pound match to Rochelle’s Ivan Pineda, setting 113-pound freshman Weldon Nay up against Alejandro Banuelos for the final bout of the dual with the Hubs trailing by one point.

In an absolute thriller that featured a combined six takedowns, five escapes and three near-falls, Nay and Banuelos remained tied 13-13 with less than 15 seconds remaining in the bout. A missed shot nearly cost Nay the match, but with one final effort, the freshman turned Banuelos over, taking the lead before pinning him

with five seconds left in the third period. The victory pushed Rochelle over Belvidere 38-33 and extended the team’s dual win streak to 11 matches.

“It was a real team effort tonight,” head coach Alphonso Bruno said. “It’s really Weldon’s first full year wrestling and he’s really improved every week... We coached him through the match and we did whatever we could to help him be successful, and he followed the plan. It was all heart at the end of the match, and even though he took a bad shot, he found a way to finish on top.”

The Hubs never led before Nay’s victory in the 113-pound bout. Rochelle fell behind 12-0 after conceding a forfeit in the 120-pound bout and losing the 126-pound bout when Antonio Alvarado won by fall over Caleb Nadig. Grant Thompson got the Hubs started in the 132-pound bout, reversing Izaac Palmer and pinning him in the second period. 138-pounder Keegan Davis-Carter followed Thompson’s win with a 17-7 major

decision against Caden Lendman, totaling a team-high eight takedowns in the match.

“We’re in Keegan’s ear all the time about wrestling all six minutes,” Bruno said. “I think that’s the biggest jump he’s made from last season. I think he can take down any kid in the state, and I watched him make four takedowns in the third period of one of his tournament matches on Saturday. He’s done an excellent job for us this season.”

Belvidere scored a fall victory in the 145-pound bout, leading to an extremely close 152-pound match between Rochelle’s Zeke Horn and Alexander Piloni. Horn trailed 9-6 in the third period, but a takedown and a stalling penalty against Piloni evened the match before Piloni ultimately escaped Horn’s grasp with seconds to spare. Bryan Garza put Rochelle back on track, defeating Jake Bell by 11-2 major decision in the 170-pound bout after Bell beat Garza on Saturday.

## Lodico's hoops passion carries into coaching

**T**IM Thompson's coaching career with Rochelle has spanned over two decades. Thompson has coached hundreds of prep players during his tenure, but not many of them have shared the same passion for high school hoops as former Hub shooting guard Riley Lodico.

Lodico grew up playing basketball in Rochelle, spending four seasons with the high school program and three seasons on Thompson's varsity team. Lodico's basketball fever never waned after graduating RTHS in 2018, and when Thompson offered him an opportunity to join the coaching staff, Lodico didn't hesitate to take the chance.

"I helped coach the freshman baseball team this past season, and coach Thompson and I had some conversations back then about coaching basketball," Lodico said. "I told him that I'd love the opportunity to spread my joy for the game to these kids... The experience has been better than I expected it to be because I didn't know what to expect. I'm trying to learn more about the game, and I love working with the kids in practice and developing their skills."

Lodico currently works as the sophomore assistant alongside head coach Josh Johnson, but he also sits on the bench with Thompson and his staff during varsity games. Rochelle's sophomore players frequently practice with the varsity players, allowing Lodico to spend time with both teams and learn from multiple coaches. A recent graduate who played up on varsity as a sophomore, Lodico said he's aiming to bring a new energy to the Hubs this season.

"The kids are very eager to learn more about the game," Lodico said. "I was a senior when a couple of the varsity players were sophomores, so I want to support them

and give coach Thompson and the players as much information as I can to help them out. I feel like I have a good connection with the kids because they know where I'm coming from as someone who's been coached by all of these men in the past. I relate to them really well."

Johnson and Lodico's sophomore team has been very successful this winter, defeating Oregon on Thursday and improving to 12-4 overall after finishing fifth in the Plano Christmas Classic this past month. Rochelle currently rosters three sophomores on the varsity team including Ryan Simmons, Adam Kemp and Zach Sanford, and all three are in the team's rotation. Lodico said his relationship with the coaching staff has greatly evolved since his playing days.

"Our team had a lot of success when I was in high school and I understand what it takes to be in this program," Lodico said. "We expect a lot out of the kids offensively and defensively, and we know how their skills should translate from practices to games... The coaches and I have connected a lot more and we build off of each other's ideas. We discuss different teams and scouting reports, and having more minds in the room has been really great."

Lodico, who's currently studying at Kishwaukee College and planning to further pursue physical education at Northern Illinois University, played for the Hubs when Rochelle went 20-8 and reached the IHSA Regional Finals during the 2016-17 campaign. He'll be looking to help lead the program back there this season, and Thompson will be happy to have him along for the ride.

"I've had the blessing of coaching a lot of great kids and Riley is one of the best," Thompson said. "He loves high school sports... He's been such a breath of fresh air to have on our staff."

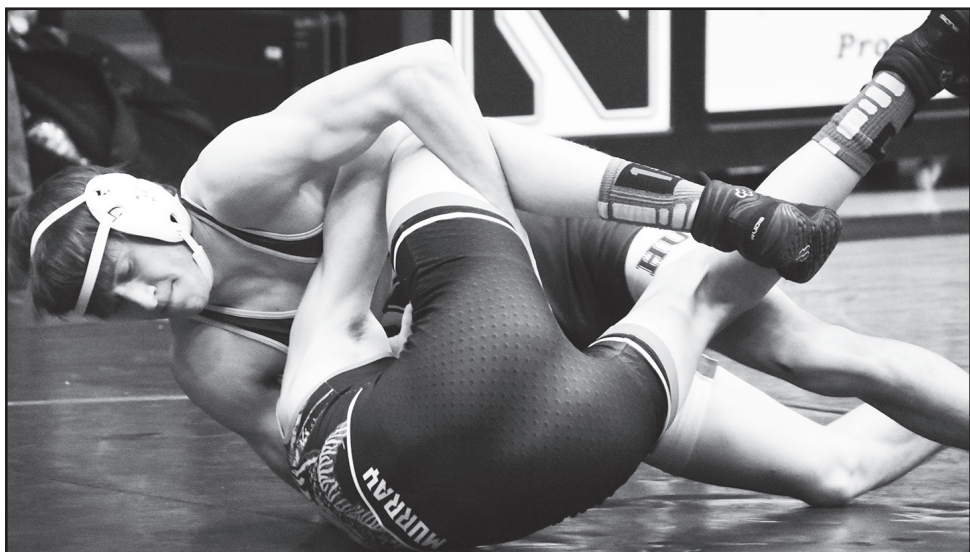
### Winnebago

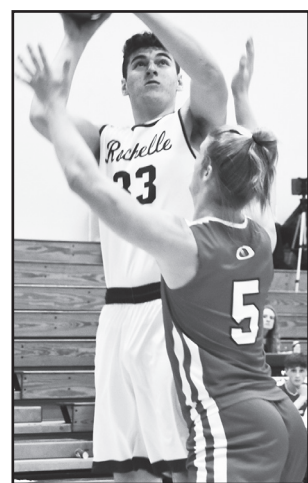
## Hubs outlast Woolsey, Oregon for home victory

### Rochelle runs win streak to four

**ROCHELLE** — Oregon standout Trey Woolsey can score the basketball, but the Rochelle defense did enough to limit his chances when the Hubs faced the Hawks on Thursday. Rochelle quieted Woolsey in the first half, holding him to 12 points and forcing him into more perimeter shots than close-range layups. Despite getting loose in the third quarter, Woolsey and his game-high 27 points would not fold the Hubs, who absorbed a 15-8 run in the quarter and held off the Hawks for a 65-55 win. Rochelle (8-9) has won four straight games. "I was proud of our guys," head coach Tim Thompson said. "He was going to score in the upper 20s no matter what we did because he was going to get enough shots. I thought he struggled from the perimeter early... I knew if we could get our defense set, we could at least try on him. When he got going in transition, it was because of our missed shots." The Hubs started the game with a 9-1 run that

featured baskets from four different players including a 3-pointer from sophomore Ryan Simmons. Senior guards Seth Gould and Landan Martin combined for 12 points in the first quarter, helping Rochelle build a 17-11 lead. The Hubs increased their distance in the second quarter behind two triples and a layup from junior guard Garrett Burdin, who scored all 10 of his points in the first half. With his team leading 31-23 entering the third quarter, senior guard Austin Brown attacked the basket on three straight plays, scoring seven points including an old-fashioned 3-point play that gave Rochelle its largest advantage of the game at 38-25. "Austin's scoring was a huge lift for us," Thompson said. "He was going north-south and attacking the front foot of the defender. We knew he could get to the basket and we knew they weren't providing much help-side defense for him. He was big in that third quarter." Oregon took a timeout to stop the game, and when action resumed, Woolsey kicked into high gear, scoring 11 quick points on

four layups and a triple to run his total up to 23 for the night. 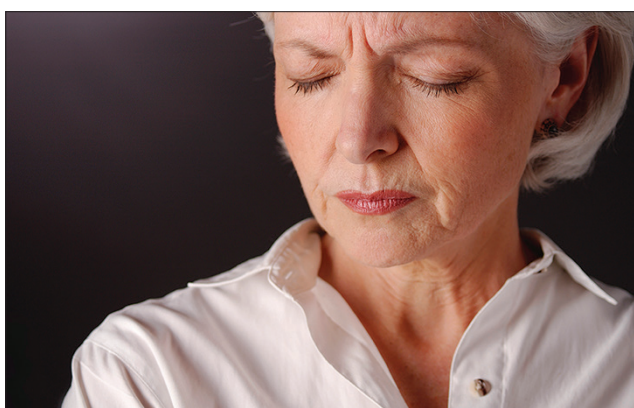
## Stop eye strain before it starts

IT'S that time of the year when many areas of the country are under the cold cloak of winter. Unforgiving temperatures can translate into an increase in hours spent indoors, whether at work or at home, and more time relying on devices to pass the hours. Spending more time watching television, playing video games, texting friends, or browsing the internet can lead to a condition known as "computer vision eye strain." Eye strain also may be caused through intense eye use, such as while driving long distances or engaging

in activities that require close attention, such as crafting or reading. The American Optometric Association says digital eye strain can result in various forms of discomfort, which increase with the amount of screen use. The most common symptoms include:

- headaches;
- blurred vision;
- dry, watery or burning eyes;
- increased sensitivity to light; and
- neck and shoulder pain.

The AOA says viewing a computer or digital



screen often makes the eyes have to work harder. The AOA notes this is different from reading a printed page. The letters are not as precise or sharply defined, and areas of contrast can be

muted. Also, the presence of glare and reflections on the screen may make viewing difficult. Furthermore, the Mayo Clinic says people tend to blink less while using digital devices, and view them at

less than ideal distances or angles. Alleviating eye strain from digital sources involves making changes in daily habits or the environment. Taking regular eye breaks, and looking at objects from different distances can help them focus. These tips may help as well.

- Adjust the lighting to reduce glare on screens or your task.
- Limit screen time as much as possible and engage in other activities.
- Consider the use of artificial tears products to lubricate dry eyes.
- Choose the right

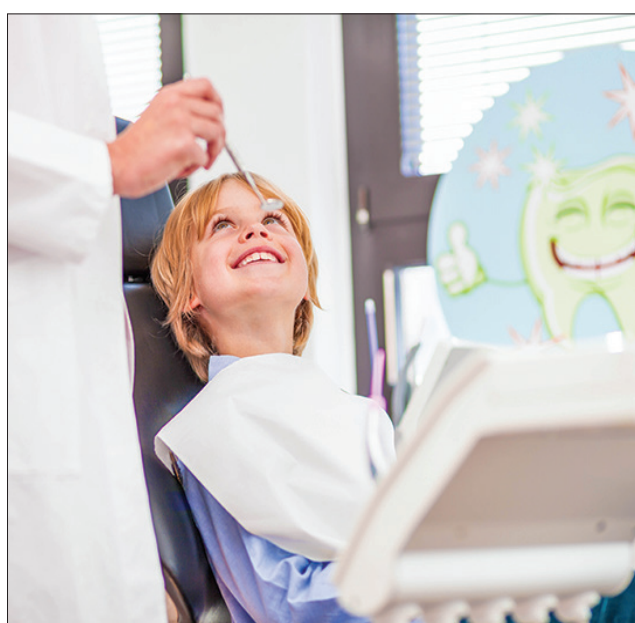
eyewear, and work with an eye professional to find products that can assist you. Specialized glasses or contact lenses are designed for computer work. Investigate tintings and coatings that also may help.

- Blink often to refresh the eyes.
- Talk to a doctor if eye strain persists or changes in severity.

When the weather gets cold, people may rely on digital devices for recreation more than they otherwise would. Avoiding eye strain in such situations can help people avoid discomfort.

## Make the dentist a fun experience for kids

VISITS to the dentist for periodic cleanings and checkups are an important component of oral hygiene. Dentists also may be the first people to identify potential issues that can affect health elsewhere in the body. Many people are unaware that children should visit the dentist early in their lives. The American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry recommends that a child should visit the dentist by age one or within six months of the eruption of his or her first tooth. However, many parents wait until much later — age two or three — to take kids to the dentist, offers Delta Dental Plans. Hesitance



to visit the dentist may stem from personal fears or perceived reactions by children. Primary teeth may eventually fall out, but they shouldn't be ignored. They save space

for permanent teeth and serve other functions. Therefore, parents should begin to acclimate children to the dentist at a young age to make the experience fun and even enjoyable.

**Lead by example**  
Children who witness their parents putting off going to the dentist or being apprehensive about visiting the dentist may develop their own fears. Always paint the dentist in a positive light and keep appointments.

**Focus on the good aspects**  
Talk up all the benefits of going to the dentist, such as having a squeaky clean and fresh mouth. Many hygienists will hand out small toys after a successful visit, or at the least a great new toothbrush and other

fun products to try.

**Get a tour of the office**  
Ask the staff if your child can get a special tour of the office with explanations of all the tools and equipment. Understanding what to expect the next time around in a no-pressure situation can make the process much easier for everyone involved. The dentist may be able to also give a test ride on the exam chair, moving it up and down, as well as showing off the water fountain and oral irrigator.

**Avoid giving false hope**  
Do not tell a child

that "everything will be OK" at the dentist's office. If a child needs treatment that may be uncomfortable, he or she may not trust you the next time a dental visit is scheduled, according to Joel H. Berg, D.D.S., M.S., Director of the Department of Dentistry at Seattle Children's Hospital. Avoid words like "shots," "pain," "hurt," or even "cavities." Dentists, particularly pediatric dentists, may have their own vocabulary that can assuage fears and seem less alarming to kids. Over time, dental visits can become an easy routine with children, setting them up for a lifetime of healthy mouths and teeth.

## Risk factors that can compromise mental wellness

At the dawn of a new year, much is made about the popularity of resolutions focusing on improving physical fitness. While it's important to be physically fit, a new year also marks a great time to examine one's mental wellness.

The World Health Organization defines mental wellness as "a state of well-being in which the individual realizes his or her own abilities, can cope with the normal stresses of life, can work productively and fruitfully, and is able to make a contribution to his or her society." Men and women who are mentally unwell may find it difficult if not impossible to achieve their other goals, including those pertaining to their physical fitness. No one is immune to mental health problems, which the American Mental Wellness Association notes are never the result of

a single risk factor. Many people whose mental wellness has been compromised are dealing with a variety of risk factors. The AMWA breaks down those risk factors into four categories: biophysical, psychological, social, and spiritual. Learning these risk factors can help people learn more about themselves and might

even compel them to seek help before their mental wellness is compromised.

### Biophysical

Family history of mental health problems  
Complications during pregnancy or birth  
Personal history of traumatic brain injury  
Chronic medical conditions, such as

cancer or diabetes. Hypothyroidism or other brain-related illnesses, such as Alzheimer's or Parkinson's disease, also can compromise mental wellness

Use of alcohol or drugs  
Poor nutrition  
Lack of sleep

### Psychological

Stressful life situations, such as financial

problems or breaking the law

Traumatic life experiences, such as rape or serving in the armed forces

Low self-esteem, perceived incompetence and/or a negative view of life

Poor academic achievement

### Social

Being abused or neglected as a child

Being in an abusive relationship or friendship

Having few friends or few healthy relationships

Recent loss, either by death, divorce or other means

Bullying; both victims of bullying and perpetrators can be at risk for mental health problems

Growing up, or currently living, in poverty

Poor social skills, poor communication skills

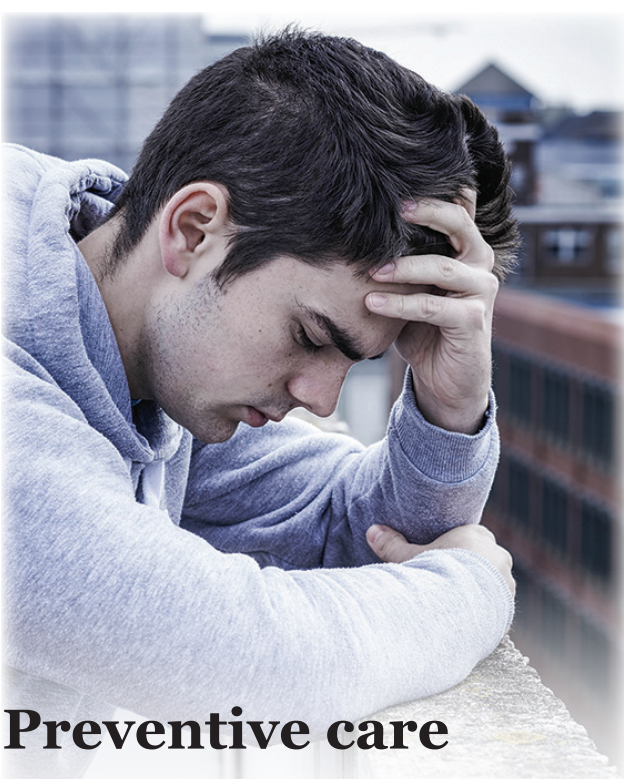

## Preventive care involves safeguarding mental health as well

Preventive care is often looked at through the needs people need to do to protect their physical well-being. For example, a healthy diet and routine exercise, while beneficial to mental health, are often viewed as lifestyle choices that can make people feel better physically. But taking steps to protect one's mental health also is vital to a long, productive life.

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services notes that positive mental health and mental wellness can have a profoundly positive impact on a person's life. Positive mental health can help people realize their full potential, cope with the stresses of life and make meaningful contributions to their communities.

### What can I do to protect my mental health?

Learning to recognize the early warning signs of mental health problems can help prevent such problems from escalating and compel people to seek help. The DHHS advises anyone feeling these signs or recognizing these signs in others to seek help for themselves or their loved ones:

- Eating or sleeping too much or too little
  - Pulling away from people and usual activities
  - Having low or no energy
  - Feeling numb or as if nothing matters
  - Unexplained aches and pains
  - Feeling helpless or hopeless
  - Smoking, drinking, or using drugs more than usual
  - Feeling unusually confused, forgetful, on edge, angry, upset, worried, or scared
  - Yelling or fighting with family and friends
  - Severe mood swings that cause problems in relationships
  - Persistent thoughts and memories you can't get out of your head
  - Hearing voices or believing things that are not true
  - Thinking of harming yourself or others
  - An inability to perform daily tasks, such as taking care of your children or getting to work or school
- Taking steps to protect one's mental wellness is a vital component of preventive care. More information about mental health is available at [www.mental-health.gov](http://www.mental-health.gov).

### Beating the winter blues

FEWER daylight hours can adversely affect mood and productivity. Seasonal affective disorder, often referred to as "SAD" or "the winter blues," has been recognized and included in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual for Mental Disorders. Clinicians say that, as days become short and dark, a predictable set of symptoms of SAD may emerge. Individuals with SAD may experience a host of symptoms, including difficulty waking in the morning; diminished energy levels; a tendency to eat more; an inability to concentrate; and depression.

A combination of self-care strategies as well as professional medical treatment may help those with winter blues or more severe SAD. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services says that these strategies can help people coping with SAD.

- Get out of the house into sunlight or brightly lit spaces early in the day when the sun is out.
- Increase time spent outdoors. Take a break midday and enjoy lunch outside or take a walk, even if it's chilly.
- Try to spend time with other people and chat with friends and relatives.
- Avoid overloading on carbohydrates like cookies and candies.
- Talk to a doctor about using light therapy, which is the first line of SAD treatment, according to the University of Maryland School of Medicine.
- Consider cognitive behavioral therapy or talk therapy with a licensed mental health provider. He or she also can make recommendations about the use of medication to alleviate symptoms if other treatments do not provide results.
