## County board talks downsizing

**OREGON** – A member of the Ogle County Board has suggested the body reduce its size from the current 24 members down to 16.

At the regular board meeting on Jan. 21, Bruce McKinney, who represents Rochelle on the board, said the county currently has eight districts with three people elected from each district to the board. During a presentation, he suggested lowering the number.

“What I would like to see is us go from eight districts to 16,” he said, adding that only one person would be elected to the board from each district.

He said the goal would be to eliminate multiple board members who serve the same area.

“This isn’t anything unusual,” he said of the

change.

For example, Winnebago County has 20 board members, with one person elected from 20 districts. The number of board members in area counties varies, from nine in Carroll County to 24 in DeKalb County.

“I think it would be better representation on the County Board for Ogle County,” McKinney said.

Board member Kimberly Whalen asked what would happen to committee assignments if the number of board members was reduced. She said that might put more pressure on board members to fill out committees.

McKinney said that some may have to add another committee to their workload, but the county could also look at combining some committees.

## Middle school gets a G.O.A.L.

**ROCHELLE** – Multiple Chicago Blackhawks youth hockey coaches paid a visit to the seventh-graders at Rochelle Middle School Thursday for a special donation and hockey clinic.

The Chicago Blackhawks G.O.A.L. (Get Out And Learn) program travels to schools and community centers throughout the Chicagoland area to introduce hockey at the grassroots level to kids who may not otherwise have the opportunity.

In order for the program to come to Rochelle Middle School, Jason Deutsch, a math teacher, former hockey player and Chicago Blackhawks fan, applied for the grant program online.

Once the school was chosen, some of the teachers were able to attend a training at the United Center this past October where they participated in different activities and

then got to see the Blackhawks morning skate.

Along with teachers attending the training and youth coaches coming to the school for the clinic, the Blackhawks also made a generous donation of floor hockey sticks, 30 balls, 30 pennies of different colors, and two new goals," explained Deutsch.

"The school is very thankful for their donation of 30 floor hockey sticks, 30 balls, 30 pennies of different colors, and two new goals," explained Deutsch. "This donation is also one that will be reoccurring each year."

In the past, the school would offer an intramural floor hockey program for the students but had to stop doing so when the equipment began to wear out and they didn't have the resources to purchase more.

During Thursday's clinic, there were five Chicago Blackhawks youth coaches that lead the children in different skill building exercises ranging from learning the correct

way to hold the stick to dribbling back and forth across the gym working on keeping their eyes and head up looking ahead. Finally, after a several drills, the coaches and students played a scrimmage game against each other, rotating players in and out every five minutes or so.

"We are very appreciative of the organization

and the NHL players association for coming out and continuing to do this for us," expressed Deutsch.

With the donation, Rochelle Middle School is not only hoping to bring back their intramural

hockey team, but also to extend the offer to the sixth and eighth-grade classes as well.

## Illinois RISE Act may provide most students access to financial aid

**MALTA** — The Retention of Illinois Student & Equality (RISE) Act was signed into law on June 21, 2019 and allows access to state financial aid (i.e. MAP) to students who were previously ineligible. These students include:

- Undocumented students who are Illinois residents.
- Transgender students who do not complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) due to the requirement to report their gender "at birth."

The RISE Act also removed the 75-hour maximum MAP grant eligibility for students in good academic standing who had not reached junior standing. These students may be eligible to receive MAP Grant for the Spring 2020 semester.

Effective Jan. 6, 2020, students who are unable to complete the FAFSA can complete the Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid (formally known as the RISE Act Application) to determine MAP Grant eligibility for the 2020-2021 academic year.

The application consists of pre-screening questions to confirm if an individual should complete the FAFSA or Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid.

Individuals the application indicates should complete the FAFSA will be advised to consult their high school counselor, a financial aid professional, or an ISACorps member for assistance completing the FAFSA.

Individuals who should complete the Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid will have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) calculated which will be used by their college.

MAP awards will be calculated for eligible students and sent to the college.

Colleges will notify students of their MAP Grant eligibility.

Please note, similar to the FAFSA, individuals must complete the Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid each academic year to apply for MAP Grant.

CJ was involved in the Byron Boy Scout Troop until he was 14, when him and his father discovered the Rochelle Boy Scout Troop 553 and made the switch. CJ continued up the ranks of scouts in Rochelle on his journey to achieving Eagle Scout.

To do this, CJ had to first complete each of the Cub Scout levels of Tiger, Wolf, Bear and Webelos, all of which included completing many different skills and merit badges that aim to build certain skills such as leadership.

While completing all of the ranks was a lot of hard work, CJ said that it was also very fun, especially going on different camping trips.

"It has been a journey, definitely a lot of work as you go up the ranks, but it is a lot of fun too," explained CJ. "We do a lot of fun stuff like camping in the Mississippi Palisades, learning knots and survival skills and many leadership building activities."

One of CJ's favorite things that the scouts do is going on all of the camping trips at different locations throughout the country.

Once completing each

of the Cub Scout levels, CJ then moved on to the next step in his journey, Boy Scouts. During his time in Boy Scouts, CJ

once again had multiple levels each with different requirements to complete. Boy Scouts is broken into seven different levels: Scout, Tenderfoot, Second-class, First-class, Star, Life and Eagle.

On top of the seven levels, scouts working toward achieving Eagle Scout must also hold a certain position for six months as well as complete an Eagle Scout project that aims to better their community.

"The big requirement for Eagle Scout is your Eagle Project, there is a lot of paperwork and a lot of approval it needs to go through, but it basically just needs to benefit the community," said CJ.

Examples of positions a scout could hold are senior patrol leader and assistant senior patrol leader.

For many scouts, they decide fairly early

on whether or not they want to go all the way to Eagle Scout, but that was not the case for CJ. For the last few years he

thought that it would be pretty nice to accomplish it but never took it seriously. Approximately six months ago, he decided last minute that this was something that he really wanted to do.

"I had always thought that, oh yea, that would be nice, but it was about six months ago that I realized I really had to get this done if this was something that I wanted to do," explained CJ.

After making the decision to go forward with becoming an Eagle Scout, he started looking for ideas for his project.

As he was searching for ideas, one presented itself to him. A Shar Pei dog rescue that is located in Plano, near Yorkville, previously needed new dog beds for its kennel, so the company reached out to CJ and presented the idea to him. He thought it was a great project and started getting to work making new dog beds for the rescue.

With help from his local church and many of the members, he was able to make and present 32 new dog beds to the rescue.

"Faith Lutheran

Church had a lot of people who wanted to help as well as some stuffing and fabric they were willing to donate," added CJ. "So, we put them all together and then had a volunteer help sew them together for us."

All of the old beds were very worn out and in need of replacement.

After finishing his eagle project, CJ had completed everything necessary to earn the rank of Eagle Scout. His official recognition in front of a board of reviews was held on Tuesday, Jan. 7, but the official celebration is being planned for the near future.

Being an Eagle Scout means to go above and beyond to take the extra step.

"It definitely relieving, I was under a lot of pressure to get that done," said CJ. "I would absolutely do it all again, but I would probably not procrastinate so much."

CJ's father is also very proud to see his son follow in his footsteps and surpass his accomplishment.

"I am very proud, I only made it to Life so he made it the extra step that I couldn't," expressed Christopher.

There are only a few other scouts from Rochelle Troop 553 that have achieved the rank of Eagle Scout.

CJ is already looking ahead to sign on as an assistant scout master so he can remain active with scouts for a while yet.

Board member Dan Janes said changing the voting districts could be difficult, as there are state guidelines to follow, including population. He said changing districts could adversely affect multiple "population center," like Byron.

McKinney said that the county might then look at having two people elected from the current eight districts. That would still reduce the number of board members by eight.

Board member Thomas Smith suggested the board wait until it gets fresh census numbers, and then form a committee to look at the right number to downsize the board to.

The board took no action on the matter.

**MIRACLE OF TRANSPLANT ORGANS**

We hear a lot about the miracles of modern transplantation of human organs. But those "miracles" could become commonplace. Many transplant operations are now routine and make more sense economically than other forms of treatment. For instance, many specialists believe that at least half of the people who begin kidney dialysis each year could have successful transplants instead.

However, there is a shortage of organs so that nearly half of the potential candidates do not receive transplants. Each year more than two million people die in the United States, but fewer than fifty thousand of them become organ or tissue donors. In some cases, next-

of-kin turn down requests of hospital personnel. Often, however, families are never asked about donation. Yet families rarely deny requests when the deceased has indicated a willingness to donate organs through a universal donor card, a check-off on a driver's license or, discussion with the family.

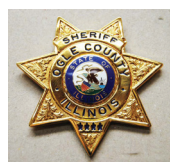

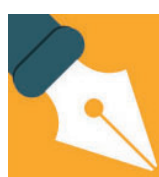

Instead of carving into a fresh carcass, I would order something from DoorDash.

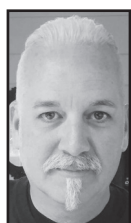
There will also be the very manly activities of grilling steaks, mowing the yard,

## Ogle County tentative multiplier announced

**SPRINGFIELD**—Ogle County has been issued a tentative property assessment equalization factor of 1.0000, according to David Harris, Director of the Illinois Department of Revenue.

The property assessment equalization factor, often called the "multiplier," is the method used to achieve uniform property assessments among counties, as required by law. This equalization is particularly important because some of the state's 6,600 local taxing districts overlap into two or more counties (e.g. school districts, junior college districts, fire protection districts). If there were no equalization among counties, substantial inequities among taxpayers with comparable properties would result.

State law requires property in Illinois to be assessed at one-third (1/3)

of its market value. Farm property is assessed differently, with farm homesites and dwellings subject to regular assessing and equalization procedures, but with farmland and farm buildings assessed according to standards based on productivity.

The equalization factor is determined annually for each county by comparing the sales price of individual properties sold over the past three years to the assessed value placed on those properties by the county supervisor of assessments/county assessor.

If this three-year average level of assessment is one-third of market value, the equalization factor will be one (1). If the average level of assessment is greater than one-third of market value, the equalization factor will be less than one (1). And if the average level of assessment is less than

one-third of market value, the equalization factor will be greater than one (1).

Assessments in Ogle County are at 32.99 percent of market value, based on sales of properties in 2016, 2017 and 2018.

The equalization factor currently being assigned is for 2019 taxes, payable in 2020.

Last year's equalization factor for the county was 1.0000.

The tentative factor is subject to change (1) if the County Board of Review takes actions which significantly affect the county assessments or (2) if local officials or others can present data showing that the Department of Revenue's estimates of the average level of assessments in the county should be adjusted. A public hearing on the tentative multiplier will be held between 20 and 30 days

after the tentative factor is published in a newspaper of general circulation within the county.

A change in the equalization factor does not mean total property tax bills will increase or decrease. Tax bills are determined by local tax-

ing bodies when they request money each year to provide services to local citizens. If the amount requested by local taxing districts is not greater than the amount received in the previous year, then total property taxes will not increase

even if assessments may have increased.

The assessed value of an individual property determines what portion of the tax burden a specific taxpayer will assume. That individual's portion of tax responsibility is not changed by the multiplier.

# Hubs reset, beat L-P

Rochelle rises up conference ladder with 70-58 win over Cavaliers

**ROCHELLE** — Nine unanswered points quickly faded away for the Hubs when Rochelle tried for its seventh straight victory this season with a home matchup against LaSalle-Peru on Tuesday. The Cavaliers fell down 9-0 to open the game before firing back with 12 consecutive points of their own and forcing Rochelle to spend an early timeout. The Hubs responded with better effort throughout the game, and behind 45 combined points from guards Landan Martin and Garrett Burdin, the Hubs defeated the Cavaliers 70-58 and improved to 11-9 overall. “I didn’t think our minds were in the right place,” head coach Tim Thompson said. “We started on a 9-0 run and I think the kids thought it was going to be an easy game. They started making mental mistakes and the other team was able to come back. We weren’t being disciplined, and we can’t take any team for granted, especially one that was trying for its first conference win.” Martin lit the fire for

Rochelle in the first half, taking LaSalle-Peru defenders off the dribble and using his mid-range game to sink free-throw-line jumpers and score in the paint. The senior guard recorded 19 of his team-high 24 points over the first two quarters, leading the Hubs to a 35-22 halftime advantage over the Cavaliers. “Landan has a nice mid-range game and he’s confident when he’s around the block,” Thompson said. “I think he knew that they didn’t have a big enough player to match up with him, and he was able to finish when he caught the ball down there. He does a lot of double-clutching and he holds players off with his body. He’s just really good around the basket.” Burdin took the torch in the third quarter, draining three triples while reserve guard Mike Schlenbecker stepped up with five points including a 3-pointer of his own. The Hubs opened the second half on a 16-8 run, and they ended the third quarter with five 3-balls made and a 57-37 lead over LaSalle-Peru. Burdin finished the game with 21 points and five 3-pointers. “I was really proud of

Mike,” Thompson said. “He’s a kid who’s been working really hard all year and being a good teammate. He works hard in practice, and we thought that we could give

him some run in a game where we had some kids who were sick. He played well tonight.” LaSalle-Peru didn’t leave the building quietly, though, and despite

trailing by as many as 25 points in the fourth quarter, the Cavaliers surged back and eventually made it a 10-point game with roughly one minute remaining. The early hole

was too steep to climb, however, and the Hubs ended the game with 10 players scoring at least two points.

# Hubs split Sterling-Marengo triangular meet

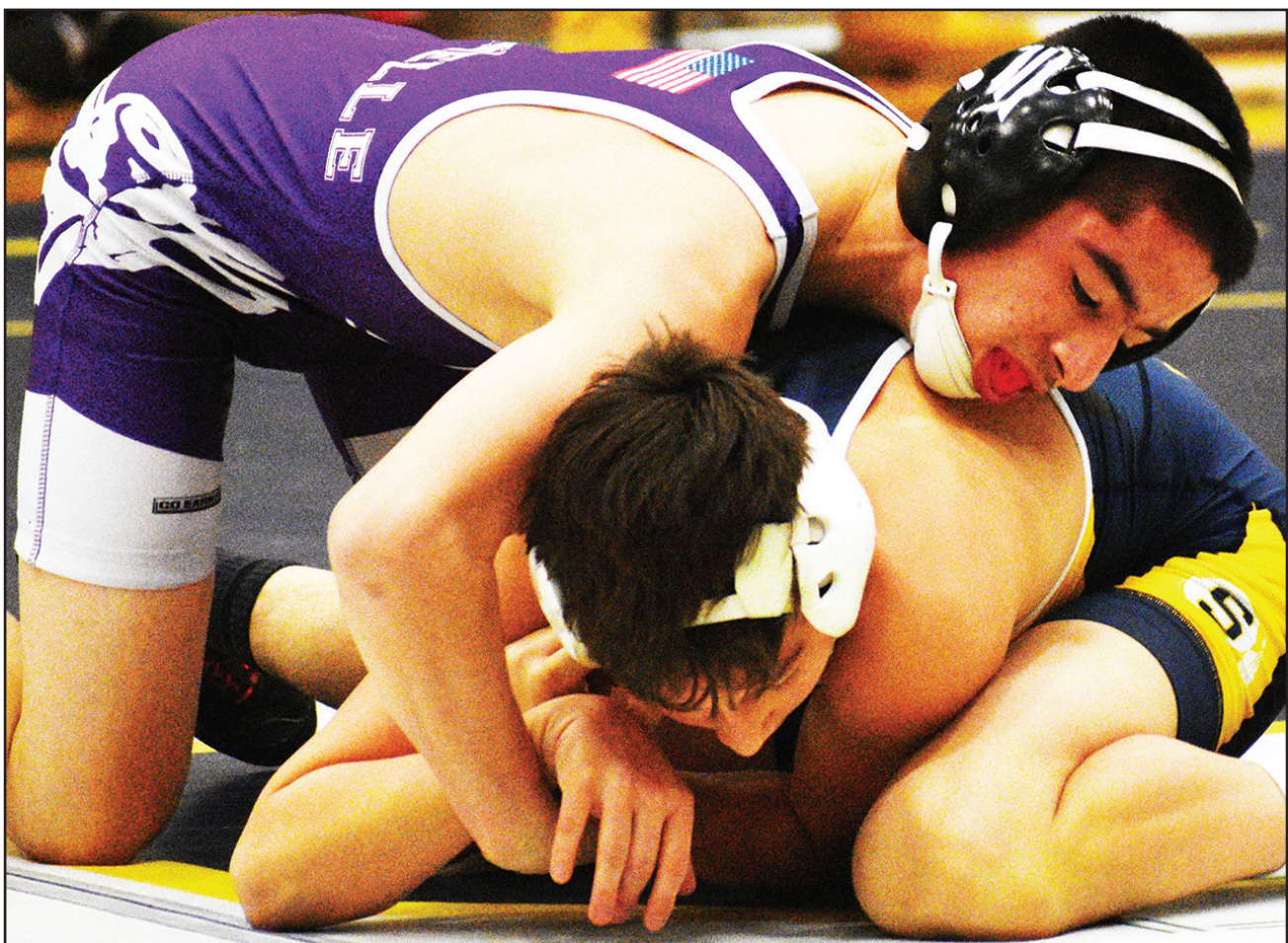
Rochelle grapplers hang on for Tuesday victory at Freeport

**STERLING** — The Rochelle wrestling program split its three-team meet with the Marengo Indians and Sterling Golden Warriors on the road Wednesday at the Musgrove Fieldhouse. Rochelle opened the meet with a 45-36 victory over Marengo. The Hubs scored the first 12 points of the match, with Reese Kirk receiving a forfeit in the 152-pound bout and senior Zeke Horn needing only 46 seconds to win by fall over Dylan Stolz in the 160-pound bout. Juniors Ben Harvey and Noah Messer recorded second-period pins over Eddie Solis and Jack Heinberg in the 182 and 195-pound matchups to give Rochelle a 24-6 lead over the first five bouts. “Noah’s at a weight where we have some pretty successful wrestlers, but

we’re trying to find spots in the lineup for him,” head coach Alphonso Vruno said. “He showed up tonight and wrestled hard. He’s doing all of the right things, and he got us some huge team points tonight.” Senior Gavin Ansteth went up a class and edged out Michael Macias 6-4 in the 220-pound bout, scoring a late takedown in the third period to seal the win. Senior Zack Capes followed Horn’s 47-second pin with a 48-second pin against Mason Feldt in the 285-pound bout. Marengo held a temporary lead after winning the 106-pound bout by fall and earning forfeits across four weights including 113, 120, 126 and 132 and going ahead 36-33. Needing two wins to close the dual, 138-pounder Grant Thompson and 145-pounder Ethan Tooley delivered for the Hubs, recording first-period pins.

Rochelle faced the Golden Warriors in the final dual of the evening, falling 43-24 and moving to 17-4 on the season with the Interstate 8 Conference Championship this weekend. The match featured several thrilling bouts including the 170-pound matchup, where Nick Simister slipped past senior Bryan Garza 3-1 with a takedown in overtime.

Noah Messer and Ben Harvey answered with back-to-back pins at 182 and 195 to give Rochelle a 12-3 advantage. Sterling's Jason Farnham and Cade Lyons claimed the 220 and 285-pound bouts, with Farnham topping Gavin Ansteth 7-0 and Lyons pinning Zack Capes in the second period. Junior Ivan Pineda scored a key win to keep Rochelle in the dual, holding off Sterling's Karson Strohmayer 1-0 in the 106-pound bout on a second-period escape.

"Ivan's always been decent on his feet, but he's really stepped up this year," Bruno said. "He stays in a good position and he's defending shots well. He's getting to his snap-downs and his shots more often. He rode that kid for a long time by staying in a good position. I'm really proud of how he wrestled in that match."

Sterling received forfeits at 113 and 120 while Rochelle's Wesley Brown took a forfeit in the 126-pound bout to set up an intense match between Drew Kested and sophomore Caleb Nadig. Wrestling up a class, Nadig managed to secure a 3-1 lead entering the third period, but Kested rallied with two takedowns across the third period and overtime for a 5-3 sudden victory.

Brayden Porter and Mauricio Garcia won the 138 and 145-pound bouts to put the Golden Warriors ahead 37-21 and seal the dual. Zeke Horn fought for a 3-2 win against Julian Rodriguez in the 152-pound bout before Sterling's Kolten Smith pinned Diego Escobar at 160.

"Zeke has unquestionable loyalty," head coach Alphonso Bruno said. "He cut down to 152 for us earlier in the season, but we had a string of matches where Diego [Escobar] was hurt and it was better for the team to wrestling him up at 160... He hasn't complained one time, and it was nice to see him wrestle well tonight."

### Freeport

The Rochelle wrestling team edged out Freeport on the road Tuesday, winning 39-36. The Pretzels took the lead when 138-pounder Tarrone Jackson pinned senior Wade Samp to start

## BOYS: Hub winning streak snapped against Kaneland

A short-handed Rochelle boys basketball team did everything it could to battle back against Kaneland when the Hubs faced the Knights on the road Friday evening.

With illnesses keeping players out of the lineup, Rochelle stuck to a six-man rotation throughout the game. While Kaneland surged ahead in the second quarter, the Hubs fought to bring the Knights within five points midway through the fourth quarter. But Kaneland's size and athleticism was too much, as the Knights held on to win 72-65 and drop Rochelle to 11-10.

"We're not a very good box-out team and I think we need to be better at that," head coach Tim Thompson said. "We don't match up with them size-wise... I thought Zach [Sanford] battled well down there, but physical teams like

Kaneland give us problems. We really have to be perfect offensively if we're unable to get out of defensive possessions."

Kaneland's Jamari Meeks bounced back from a poor shooting performance in Rochelle's first game against the Knights this season, sinking three first-half triples including two in the first quarter. Seth Gould and Garrett Burdin spearheaded the charge early for the Hubs, scoring nine of the team's first 19 points as Rochelle led 19-16 entering the second quarter.

The Knights opened the second quarter on an 8-0 run, pushing the ball in transition as much as possible and using their size and length to finish around the rim. Kaneland's fast-paced play too some wind out of the Rochelle sails, as the Hubs fell behind 33-24 despite burning two timeouts in the quarter. Kaneland center Ethan Feiza and forward Bryce

Ebert punished Rochelle on the boards, giving the Knights numerous second and third-chance points.

"We had a lot of guys who were sick and just getting their legs back," Thompson said. "We didn't want to put them out there when they haven't done much running recently. We had a shorter rotation which meant we had to play a little differently than we normally do. They took advantage of our 2-3 zone, but the effort was there from our kids."

The Knights took a 38-30 lead into the second half, where Rochelle managed to keep the deficit within single digits entering the fourth quarter. While the Hubs weren't able to create space on the perimeter, seniors Austin Brown and Landan Martin found ways to score inside against bigger and longer defenders. Martin finished with 19 points in the game, while Brown added 18. The two

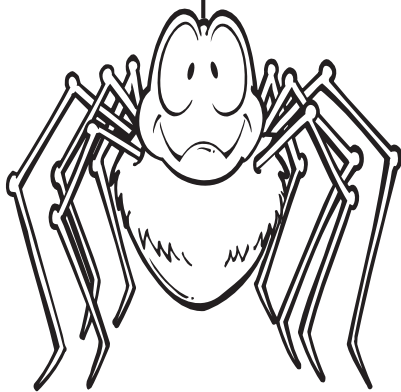

### Perimeter shots foil Lady Hubs against Kaneland

3-pointers nonexistent for Rochelle in 60-35 loss to Knights

**ROCHELLE**—Kaneland guard Kelsey Modaff scored as many first-half points as the Lady Hubs when the Knights and Rochelle met for their Interstate 8 Conference showdown Thursday.

Modaff drilled three triples in the first quarter, leading Kaneland with 16 points in the first half and 23 for the game as the Knights cruised over Rochelle 60-35 and dropped the Lady Hubs to 3-20 overall. Modaff ended the game with a team-high five 3-pointers.

"She's able to shoot the ball from as much as 25 feet away from the basket," head coach Tony Rowan said. "With how athletic she is, when she can hit shots from that far out, it creates a lot of disturbances for our defense. Even when we tried pressuring her, she was able to cut through the back door for layups. She's a very good player and she's going to make shots."

Kaneland thrived on the deep ball during Thursday's game, as Modaff and the Knights knocked down seven 3-pointers in the first half while the Lady Hubs

failed to convert a single 3-point shot during the game. Kaneland held Rochelle to only 13 points in the first matchup between the two teams this season,

and the Knights were stout on defense once again, leading the Lady Hubs 19-8 after the first quarter and 33-16 at halftime.

"When teams are able

to make some 3-pointers against us, it's mainly because we have slow rotations on defense," Rowan said. "We were watching the ball as opposed to

reacting to the ball and that's not how we want to play. When we give good teams open shots, good shooters will be surprised when they miss, and their shooters were on tonight."

The Lady Hubs found some success in transition during the third quarter, using long inbound passes to get behind the Kaneland defense and score easy layups under the basket. But without an ability to sink 3-pointers, the early hole was difficult to climb, and the Knights managed to stretch their lead to 49-24 before playing the entire fourth quarter with Modaff on the bench. Junior guard Sam House led Rochelle with 10 points on five made field goals in the loss.

"Sam was aggressive with her shot and she was aggressive off the dribble," Rowan said. "She was jumping for rebounds on defense and getting into passing lanes. She's really come a long way this season and we're only hoping she's going to get better."

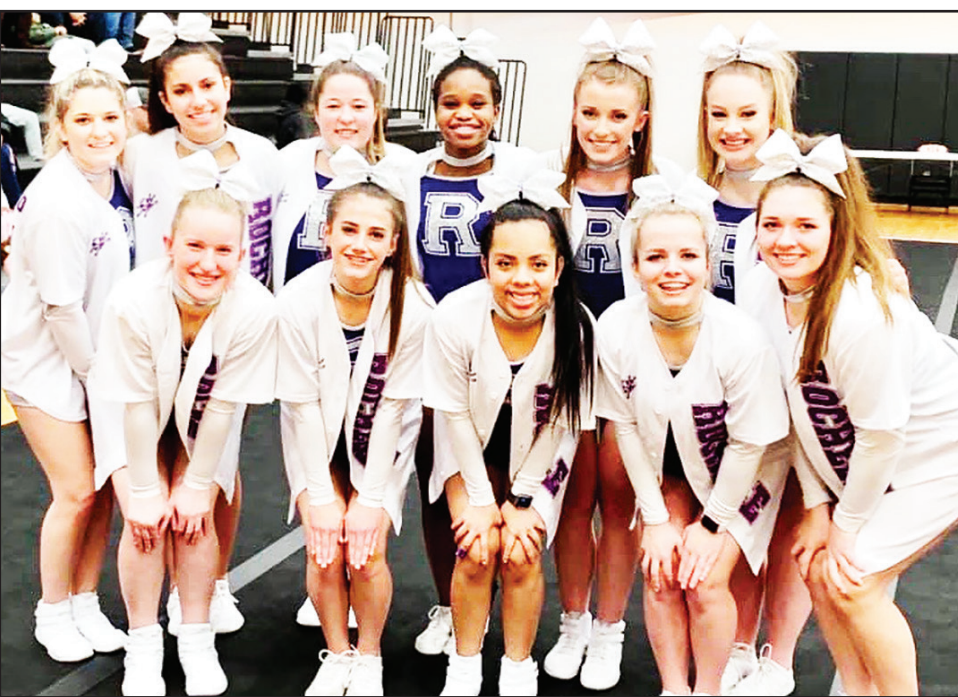

top bowler for Lisle with a 378 series.

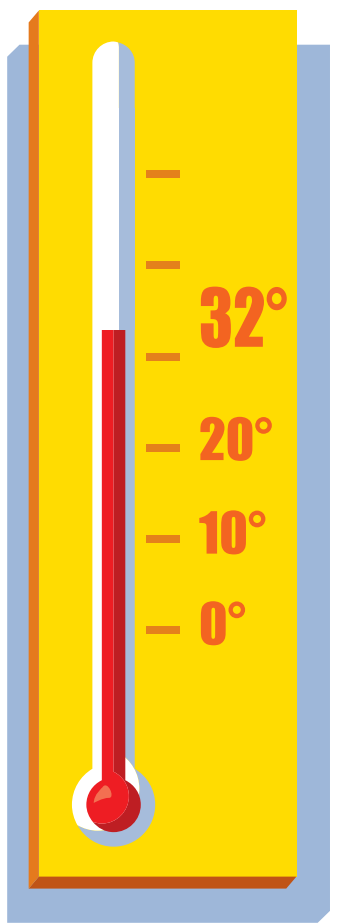
### Sterling
