Man charged in fatal fire back in court

OREGON – The volume of documents and other items being reviewed by the lawyer representing the Byron man accused of killing his wife and son in 2016 has again delayed the next pre-trial hearing.

Ogle County State’s Attorney Eric Morrow told Judge John Roe at a hearing on Jan. 8

that his office has provided defense attorney Christopher Derango with “thousands and thousands” of pages of discovery related to the case against Duane Meyer. Derango told the judge he needs more time to go through it all.

He also said that he has an expert looking at cellphone data related to the case and that he does not have a timeline as to when that expert will complete his examination.

Meyer is accused of setting the 2016 fire in

Byron that killed his ex-wife Maggie Meyer and 3-year-old son Amos Meyer.

Roe set the next pre-trial hearing for March 4 at 1 :30 p.m.

Meyer was charged on Oct. 9, 2019 with four counts of first degree homicide, two counts of aggravated arson and one count of concealment of a homicidal death. He is currently being held in the Ogle County Jail on a \$10 million bond.

Pole fire cause of south side power outage Thursday

ROCHELLE – Two small fires occurred across from the new Pilot gas station construction site late Thursday morning, causing a power outage to the city’s south side for approximately one hour.

The first fire occurred just before noon when a new telephone pole with a live power line caught fire across the street from the new gas station. The top of the pole where the power line connected and the bottom where the pole reached the ground were sparking and causing small flames.

Water talks continue

Hillcrest public hearing centers on five alternatives for water storage improvements

HILLCREST — Hillcrest villagers had another opportunity to address board trustees regarding possible water storage and infrastructural improvements when trustees hosted their second public hearing in two months on Wednesday.

The village received five alternatives for water storage improvements from Baxter & Woodman Engineering this past year, with alternatives including a new shallow well, a new deep well or a connection with Rochelle Municipal Utilities. An RMU connection would come on either a standby, wholesale or retail customer basis. The construction of a 200,000-gallon water tower to accompany any water storage improvement would cost the village an estimated \$2.2 million. Estimated costs

for the alternatives run from \$2.4 to \$3.2 million.

Infrastructural improvements to the village’s roadways, sewer and water systems would cost an estimated \$6.85 million for the first phase of construction on the south end of the village. Four villagers spoke at the meeting including Teresa Adams, who has lived in Hillcrest for roughly 40 years and has previously served as village clerk.

“We have to do something,” Adams said. “Because our previous boards failed to look down the road and plan properly, we’re paying for it today. My question now is how are we going to try and maintain our independence throughout this process? What’s the board’s main priority?”

Program helps businesses improve storefronts

ROCHELLE — As part of its façade improvement program, the City of Rochelle awarded a longtime local business with the funds needed to improve the front of its building.

Bill's Trading Post received a check in the amount of \$5,000 Thursday that was used to pay for the tuck-pointing to the brick on the front of the building. Tuck-pointing is the process of taking the cement out from under the bricks, cleaning it and replacing it with a new color to improve the look of the building.

The city says that this façade improvement program is a great way to let businesses know that they are here to help.

"When a business is planning a project to improve their building, this is a nice way for us to say that we want to help you do this," explained community development director Michelle Pease.

Last year the city had \$15,000 allocated to present to local businesses, but this year the budget has allocated \$30,000 to be spent city wide and not limited to the downtown area.

Bills Trading Post has been in business since 1943 and has been providing the community with a place to find quality new and used furniture, apparel and many other treasures. Owner Frank Smardo says he is very

pleased with how the work turned out and he has more improvements planned for the coming spring.

Board trustees first introduced the proposals to the public in December 2019, when roughly 10 villagers arrived and discussed the alternatives with trustees. Board President Jason Fore, who was absent from the December public hearing, addressed the public at length on Wednesday.

"It comes down to us getting feedback from the residents, and I've said I'll have as many public hearings as required," Fore said. "Without the information from Baxter & Woodman, we'd be guessing how much everything would cost... I'm fully aware of how many residents in this village are on fixed income. At the end of the day, it's going to be a financial decision that impacts all 440 properties in

this village, and we'll have to take fixed income and non-fixed income residents into account... My priority right now is ensuring that every household in this village has the right amount of water and the right quality of water."

Agenda

The public hearing preceded the monthly Hillcrest village board meeting at 7 p.m. Wednesday. Trustees voted unanimously to approve the installment of a new village notification and alert system, which will include a \$990 startup cost and \$560 annual renewal for the village. Fore also said that seal coat work on village roads will cost \$35,000 this year, with funds for the work coming from money generated through the motor fuel tax.

Rochelle firefighters suspect the strong winds may have been the cause of the fire.

"The wires have orange insulators on them that keep them from arcing and the orange insulators slid in the wind," explained Rochelle Fire Chief Dave Sawlsville. "When that happened, the pole was acting as a

ground for the current, which is what caused it to ignite."

This pole was recently erected to supply power to the future gas station.

Along with the Rochelle Fire Department, Rochelle Municipal Utilities was called since it was electrical related.

Once the first fire was put firefighters noticed that a second fire in a tube underneath the street had

begun to burn.

"The conduit that goes underneath the road has a wire that goes into it through a tube and the wire caught fire, so we went from the other side of the road and filled the tube with water to put that out," added Sawlsville.

Both the telephone pole across the street and the tube running the wire underneath the road will need to be replaced.

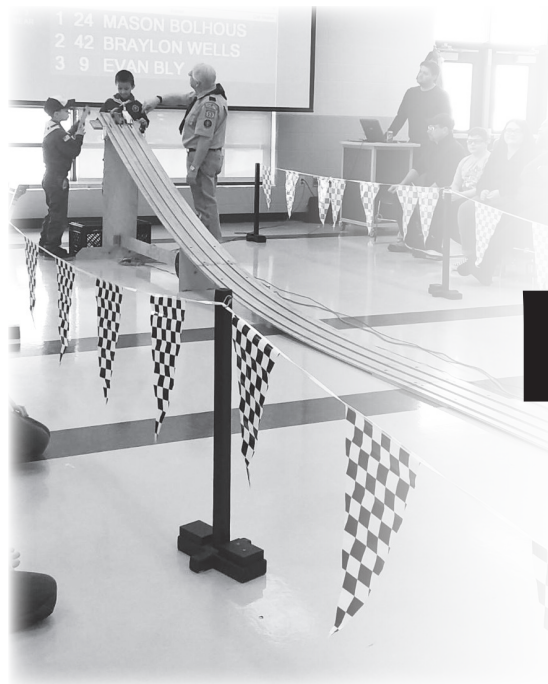

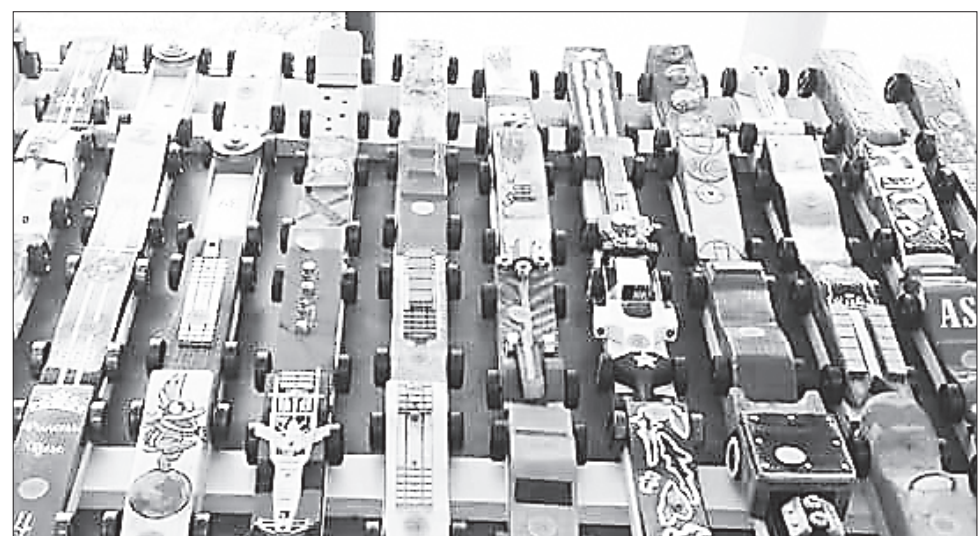
Annual Pinewood Derby set for Jan. 18 at Lincoln School

Each of the scouts are given a block of wood, four plastic wheels and four nails to hold the wheels. Other than that, the only restriction is that the car weighs five ounces or less.

Then a computer averages all of the heats based on speed and then a trophy is handed out for first, second, third and best designed car. House bill would add risks of sexting to sex ed curriculum

Students in grades 6-12 would learn about the legal and personal consequences of sharing sexual images and videos

SPRINGFIELD — Sex education in Illinois middle and high schools would be required to include a discussion on sexting if a bill introduced in the state House of Representatives becomes law.

House Bill 4007, introduced by Rep. Maurice West, D-Rockford, would require sex education curriculum in grades 6-12 to include material on the legal and social risks of sharing sexually explicit images, messages and videos.

“This is something that a lot of our students are dealing with and are partaking in without really understanding what the consequences could be,” West said.

Issues surrounding sexting that would be required in curriculum include long-term consequences, bullying and harassment, resisting peer pressure and using the Internet safely. Lessons would also have to highlight school and community officials who students can reach out to with a problem.

“There’s no telling what our children are doing on their phones,” West said, “so instead of trying to intrude into their privacy, let’s just make sure they’re educated on even the things that make us adults uncomfortable.”

The bill defines sexting as “sending, sharing, receiving, or forwarding a sexually explicit or sexually suggestive image, video, or text message by a digital or electronic device, including, but not limited to, a mobile or cellular telephone or a computer.”

Illinois would become only the second state to require teaching

about sexting in sex education, according to Jennifer Driver, vice president of policy at the nonprofit Sexuality Information and Education Council of the United States, which advocates for modern and comprehensive sex education.

New Jersey’s law, signed in 2018, requires schools to teach the “social, emotional, and legal consequences” of sexting.

The Los Angeles Unified School District, America’s second-largest, added the risks and consequences of sexting to its curriculum in 2015.

Driver says including sexting in sex education is a “smart response” to a growing practice.

“Young people generally think short term, in the immediate, and so providing the education before it becomes punitive ... is a very responsible way to address sexting,” she said.

A 2018 study of 110,000 teenagers published in the Journal of the American Medical Association found 15 percent had sent sexts and 27 percent had received them. Twelve percent also admitted to sending a sext of someone else without their consent.

Sexting between minors is illegal in 25 states including Illinois, according to a 2018 analysis by the Cyberbullying Research Center. Illinois law forbids minors from sharing sexual images and videos of themselves via any electronic method, such as texting, social media and smartphone apps. The penalty is usually community service or counseling.

Illinois is one of 24 states plus the District of Columbia that require sex education. School codes require

sex education lessons in Illinois to be age-appropriate, evidence-based and medically accurate. Parents have the option to take their children out of class if they object to the material.

“It is my hope that schools will be understanding of this because this is one thing that we really can’t control,” West said.

Ben Schwarm, deputy executive director of the Illinois Association of School Boards, predicts his organization will oppose the bill once it is assigned to a committee.

“We oppose all new curricular mandates. It has just really grown out of control,” he said.

Schwarm calls the bill unnecessary because school codes already mandate instruction on related topics like Internet safety and cyberbullying.

West, however, said he does not believe it would be an unnecessary mandate.

“We’re just simply saying we need to acknowledge the elephant that’s in the room,” he said.

West said sexting has already come up among a group of middle school boys he mentors.

“I’m telling them the ramifications to it and telling them how, though you may feel that this is pretty cool now, it can be detrimental later,” he said.

“But that’s just with six boys that I mentor. There’s a lot more out there that may not be getting that same kind of guidance.”

Driver said she agrees that sex education should meet young people where they are.

“I think very much how we’re trying to keep up with technology, we need to be keeping up with sex education at the same time so that one doesn’t happen without the other,” she said.

West introduced the bill in December and is reaching out to fellow lawmakers from both sides of the aisle for support as the General Assembly prepares for its 2020 session beginning Jan. 28.

Here's what I did and didn't learn from the recent debate

a month why should I first give it to the government so they can give it back to me, can't I just hang on to it and cut out the middle man?

Going down this slippery slope of "free" stuff for all, sounds good if you are to receive the "free" stuff, but what it does in the long run is destroy responsibility, accountability and productivity, and ultimately ambition and self-worth. After all, if you are going to "give" me \$12,000 a year I can be \$12,000 a year less productive!

Other things I learned: One trillion seconds is over 31 thousand years. One trillion pennies stacked on top of each other would make a tower 870,000 miles high.

Black Hawk statue work done

All scaffolding has been removed

OREGON – The scaffolding has finally been removed from the Black Hawk Statue near Oregon as a long restoration process comes to a close.

Crews began the process of removing the special scaffolding used on the project last week, and it was completely removed by Wednesday. The fencing around the statue was still in place.

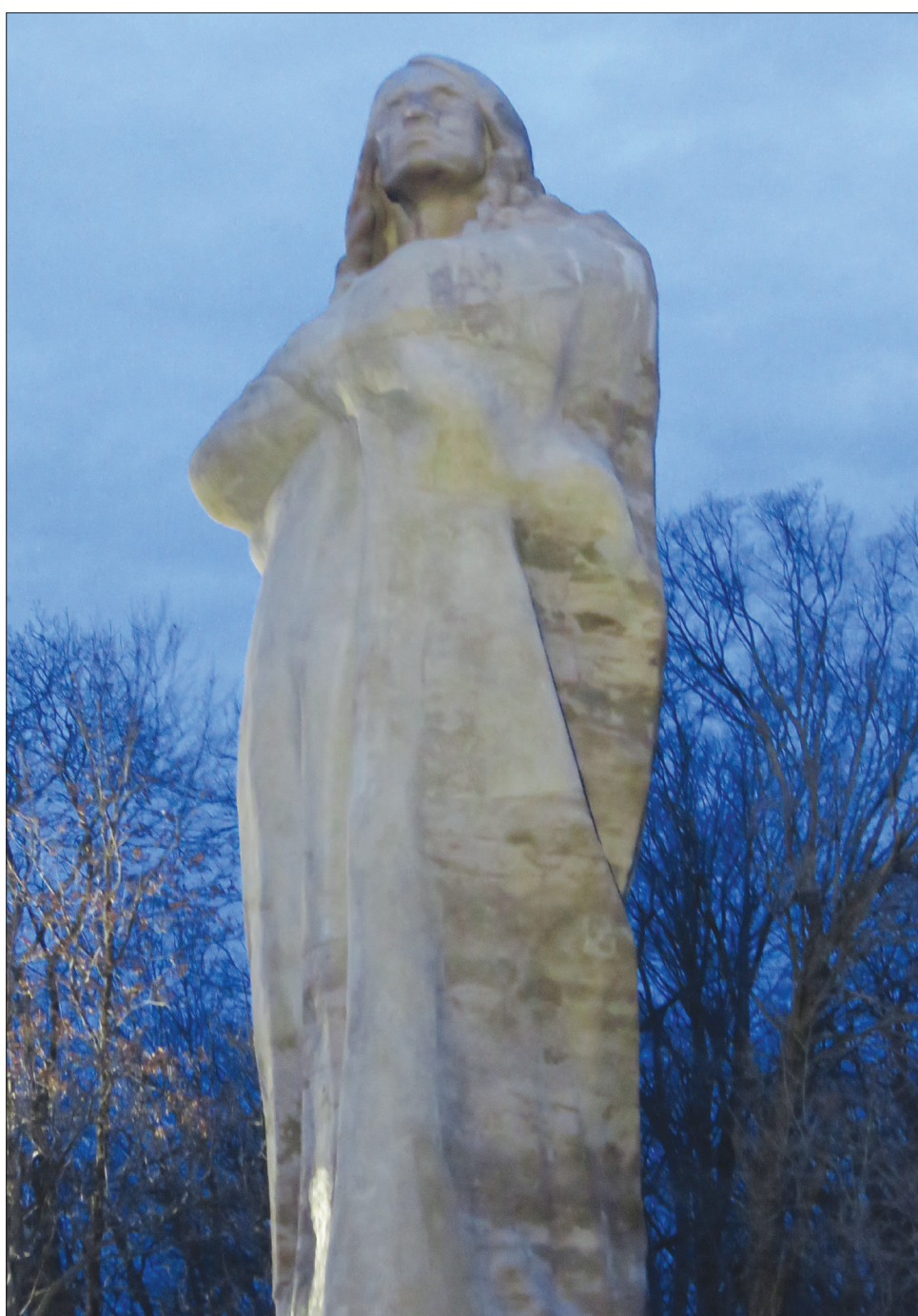
The statue has been under wraps for much of the past couple of years while funding was sought to restore it. Created by Lorado Taft and completed in 1911, the statue was in desperate need of repair.

“On behalf of Oregon Together, thanks to all of the people who donated to preserve our beloved statue,” said John Lindhorst, president of Oregon Together.

The work was originally scheduled to be completed in early November 2019, but was pushed back.

The Illinois Conservation Foundation is overseeing the work—and writing the checks from money donated locally as well as state matching funds. Locally, \$225,000 was raised, including \$100,000 donated last year by E.D. Etnyre & Co.

The original forms were used to pour new concrete for the arms of the statue, Lindhorst

said. Workers even brought red granite from the same northern Wisconsin quarry for the restoration that Taft used.

The next step will be the re-design of the grounds around the statue, which should happen this summer. That will

include all signage and parking. Lindhorst said the funds are already “locked in” for that work.

County releases voter information

OREGON – Ogle County Clerk, Laura J. Cook, announces that her office complies with the Federal Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act.

Disabled voters who find it difficult or nearly impossible to go to the polls on election day may now ask for a Vote by Mail ballot without having a signature from their physician. They must contact the office of the Ogle County Clerk and ask for an application. Voters can early vote in person at the county clerk’s office, or request a Vote by Mail ballot. The clerk’s office will send an application to be filled out and on return of that application, we will then send out the ballot.

Voters can download an application by visiting the Ogle County official website at www.oglecounty.org by going to the “I Want To” tab, select “Application for Vote by Mail.” This application must be filled out and mailed or hand delivered to the county clerk’s office, who will then mail the Vote by Mail ballot to the voter. After voting the Vote by Mail ballot it must be mailed or hand delivered back to the county clerk’s office so it can be counted on election day.

The Ogle County courthouse is accessible to disabled citizens for voter registration. The county clerk will send a deputy registrar to the residence of any person who wishes to register to vote and is unable to go to a registrar. For information on this service, please call the county clerk’s office at 815-732-1110.

The last day to register to vote or change your address is Feb. 18 (with the exception of grace period voter registration and transfer of registration beginning Feb. 19 and ending March 17 in the office of the Ogle County Clerk.)

Early Voting will be conducted at the Ogle County Clerk’s Office located at the Ogle County courthouse, 105 S. 5th St., Oregon, Feb. 6 through March 16 for all Ogle County precincts.

Early voting will be conducted at the Flagg Township Building located at 303 W. Illinois Route 38 in Rochelle March 11 through March 13 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and March 14 from 9 a.m. to noon, for Flagg and Dement precincts, only.

The first day to mail a Vote by Mail ballot is Feb. 6 with the last day for mailing a ballot from the county clerk’s office being March 12. Early voting in person at the county clerk’s office may be done through March 16 until 4:30 p.m.

If there are any voters in Ogle County who cannot get into the polling place, two Judges of Election can be sent within 50 feet of the polling place with the ballot. A request should be made prior to the election on a form provided by the county clerk’s office. If we can assist you in any way, within the law, please let us know.

The clerk’s office is open 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Hubs devour Sandwich

Rochelle outlasts Indians 39-30, extends streak to nine dual wins

ROCHELLE — The ebb and flow between the Rochelle and Sandwich wrestling teams culminated in the 113-pound bout between Weldon Nay and Indian grappler Dougie Taxis. With fans from both schools cheering loudly Thursday night, Nay and Taxis traded points throughout the first and second periods. An escape from Nay tied the match 3-3 before a takedown and back-to-back reversals pushed the Rochelle freshman ahead 7-5. But the building erupted in applause when Nay took and pinned Taxis down at the 3:41 mark to win the bout, a critical victory for the Hubs who narrowly escaped Sandwich with a 39-30 victory.

“That was great,” Nay said. “I felt like I shouldn’t have won that match but I tried my hardest and I was able to get through and beat him... Coach [Alphonso] Vruno told me before break that it’s about time I start winning my matches, and sure enough, I’ve won most of my matches since then. We support each other through the wins and it

motivates us to do better.”

Senior Keegan Davis-Carter opened the match for Rochelle, defeating 138-pounder Aidan Linden via 7-2 decision. After Sandwich standout Cael Schindlbeck pinned Wade Samp in the 145-pound bout, the Hubs (13-2 overall) evened the match when sophomore Ethan Tooley wrestled up and outlasted Nolan Reilly with a 7-5 decision in the 152-pound bout.

“It feels really good to win,” Tooley said. “Coach Vruno told me I was going to wrestle up and I went with the flow. I played defense for most of the match and I had one good move to get him on his back. I was really hyped. I think I’ve improved my defense a lot and I’m keeping my weight down to prevent my opponents from getting shots on me.”

Sandwich won both the 160-pound and the 170-pound bouts behind Eddie Brown’s fall over Zeke Horn and Jackson Murphy’s 9-2 decision against Bryan Garza. The Indians extended their lead when Alex Alfaro pinned Noah Messer in the 182-pound matchup.

Ben Harvey delivered in the 195-pound bout for Rochelle with a 7-1 decision over Sammy Dale.

With his team trailing 21-9, senior Gavin Ansteth stepped up with an enormous win in the 220-pound bout against Connor Holly. Ansteth led 2-0 after a first-

period takedown, but a reversal in the second period led to Rochelle’s first fall of the match. Zack Capes took a forfeit in the 285-pound matchup for the Hubs, tying the match 21-21.

A back-and-forth tilt between Rochelle’s Ivan Pineda and Anthony Sparti

highlighted the 106-pound bout. Pineda trailed 4-3 before earning an escape in the third period to even the match. With roughly 15 seconds remaining, Sparti scored a takedown to claim the bout by 6-4 decision.

The Indians forfeited the 120-pound bout for

Rochelle’s Josey Weber, leading to sophomore Caleb Nadig’s dominant fall over Evan Reilly in the 126-pound matchup that sealed the team victory. Sandwich closed the dual with Braulio Flores pinning Grant Thompson at 132 pounds.

Rochelle triple threat overwhelms Morris

Martin-Burdin-Brown trio leads Hubs over Redskins 83-71

ROCHELLE — The fast-paced tempo and the high-level energy inside the Rochelle Township High School gymnasium helped the Hubs ignite for their greatest scoring output of the season Tuesday evening, when the Morris Redskins arrived for an Interstate 8 Conference game.

Only days removed from an 80-point performance against Mendota, Rochelle’s triple threat (Landan Martin, Garrett Burdin and Austin Brown) caught fire midway through Tuesday’s game and propelled the Hubs over the Redskins 83-71. Martin finished with a game-high 34 points for Rochelle (6-9) and the backcourt trio scored all 27 of the team’s third-quarter points.

“We have a lot of shooters which leads a lot of teams to opening up the middle on defense,” Martin said. “I exploit that and I get a lot of my points around the bucket. We’re trusting

each other, we’re moving the ball around and we’re trusting that our shots are going down.”

Leading his team into the second quarter with a 17-16 advantage, Martin commanded the painted area and used his quickness to score several layups and soft floaters around the rim. While Morris had a noticeable size advantage down low, the Redskins weren’t swift enough to contain Martin, who poured in 28 points across the second and third quarters.

“My teammates were finding me and getting me the ball when I was open,” Martin said. “They allowed me to score that much, and the energy in the gym kept us going.”

Burdin (22 points) knocked down three triples in the first half including two in the first quarter, allowing the Hubs to maintain a slight 39-34 lead after two quarters. Morris made second-half adjustments to seal Martin off from the painted area, but the senior guard was in his bag Tuesday night,

stepping back and canning four 3-pointers in the third quarter to help the purple and white start the second half on a 27-8 run.

The stretch included both a triple and a layup through contact from Brown, who earned a loud applause from the students before sinking the freebie. Brown finished the game with 15 points.

“We’re shooting with confidence,” Brown said. “I take what the defense gives me. If the defense wants to pressure me and leave open shots for Garrett and Landan, or even Ryan [Simmons] and Ben [Hickey], I’ll hit whoever is open. If I’m open, I’m open. We’re playing the sport we love, and we had a lot of support from the fans tonight. The hype keeps us going.”

The Redskins made a slight surge in the fourth quarter, pulling together a 9-0 run to make it a 70-58 game with 5:36 remaining. Morris guard Jack Walker (21 points) did most of the damage, hitting multiple 3-pointers to keep the Red-

skins alive. But Rochelle’s dominant third quarter set Morris too far back, and the

Hubs exited the building on a two-game winning streak. Sophomore Ryan

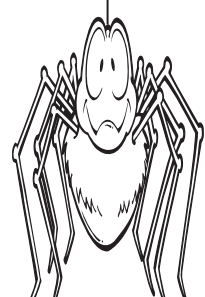
