## Sold

Former Nippon Sharyo facility sells

ROCHELLE—A57-acre property previously used by Nippon Sharyo, a Japanese railcar maker, has been purchased; however, the buyer and what the two buildings will be used for has not yet been identified.

“All we know is what is in the public record regarding the purchase of buildings that were once home to the Nippon Sharyo manufacturing facilities,” City of Rochelle Economic Development Director Jason Anderson said. “We are waiting to meet with the company representatives and it will be up to them to make an announcement on the name of the company and what the use of the facilities will be.”

According to public record, the facility is listed under the name of a limited liability company, 1600 Ritchie Court. That LLC was filed on Nov. 7 in the state of Delaware under The Trust Corporation of Wilmington, Delaware, in New Castle County, Delaware.

The two building, 800,000 square foot facility was previously owned by the railcar manufacturer and was opened in 2012. The company announced its closure in 2018; prior to closing, there were several rounds of layoffs at the facility.

“I think it closed on the 12th of December,” Anderson said. “I am not sure when we will meet. The broker is the “go-between” and he says they will contact us when they are ready to talk.”

## New year will bring a higher minimum wage, legalization of marijuana

### Hundreds of state laws take effect in January

SPRINGFIELD — The state’s minimum wage will increase by \$1 hourly, recreational marijuana will go on sale to those over 21 years of age, and some state taxes and licensing fees will increase when the calendar hits January.

The changes are among hundreds resulting from laws passed during a busy legislative session which adjourned in early June.

Minimum Wage: The minimum wage will increase by \$1 to \$9.25 hourly on Jan. 1, the first such increase since 2010. The wage will increase to \$10 hourly in July before increasing \$1 each January until it hits \$15 by 2025.

Marijuana Legalization: With the legalization of adult-use marijuana in the state, Illinois residents will be allowed to possess 30 grams of cannabis flower, 500 milligrams of a marijuana-infused product and 5 grams of cannabis concentrate. Non-residents can

## Garage damaged in Christmas night fire

HILLCREST — A garage and a vehicle were damaged on Christmas night after garbage next to the home in Hillcrest reportedly caught fire and spread to the siding of the garage.

According to Rochelle Fire Chief Dave Sawlsville a call came into the department at approximately 8:06 p.m. of a fire at 217 Windover Park Drive.

“Originally, the call was a car fire, but actually it seems something put into the garbage started on fire and then it climbed up the outside of the garage,” Sawlsville said. “The owner was home and was alerted when he heard some popping noises.”

Sawlsville said the fire damage was pretty much contained to the garage,

although there was some smoke damage throughout the home.

“The fire wanted to get into the attic and spread through the vent, but we were able to cut a hole in

the roof and vent it upward instead of toward the rest of the home,” he explained.

No major injuries were reported, but the home owner was being evaluated for smoke inhalation.

possess half those amounts.

Consumption of marijuana will still be banned in public places, however, unless a licensed marijuana facility or certain lounges obtain local government clearance for allowing use at their facilities.

Marijuana legalization will also provide for the expungement of low-level cannabis convictions and criminal records in the state, the first of which were filed in Chicago this month.

New Taxes, Fees for Capital Plan: Some new taxes and fees which will help fund a multi-year \$45 billion capital infrastructure plan will also take effect starting in January.

Registration fees for passenger vehicles will increase to \$151 from \$101, while electric vehicle registration fees will increase to \$251 annually from \$34 every other year.

The licensing fee for a trailer weighing less than 3,000 pounds will increase to \$118 from \$18, with every weight class above that also seeing a \$100 increase.

A new tax on parking garages will also take effect next month, with a 6 percent rate applied to hourly and daily garages and a 9 percent rate applied to monthly.

The state will also begin taxing the value of traded-in vehicles starting after \$10,000 of value, down from \$20,000.

**Other new laws**

The maximum fine for a hitting a construction worker with a vehicle will increase to \$25,000 from \$10,000.

Those violating “Scott’s Law” by failing to reduce speed or change lanes when an emergency vehicle is stopped on the side of the road will see increased fines in the new year as well. The minimum fine for a first offense will increase to \$250 from \$100, while the minimum for a second offense will be \$750.

## Ogle County again offers holiday light recycling

**OREGON** — It's that time of year again when we start to decorate for the holiday season.

When you come across holiday light strands that refuse to work, have those light strands recycled instead of landfilling them.

The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department is partnering with local fire departments and villages to again offer several convenient drop-off boxes so those frustrating, non-functional holiday light



strands can be recycled.

Boxes are available at the following fire departments: Rochelle, Byron, Stillman Valley and Mount Morris.

They will be located

at the village halls in Polo, Forreston, Davis Junction and Creston. Light strands are also accepted at the Ogle County courthouse and at the OCSWMD office at 909 Pines Road in Oregon. Boxes will remain at these locations until Jan. 24, 2020.

Accepted light strands include Italian mini-lights, traditional lights, LED lights, and other holiday light strands. Extension cords are also accepted. Material not accepted include rope lights, wreaths, garland, metal stakes or silhouettes, live greens, plastic decorations, timers, and light packaging or boxes. Please place light strands into the boxes and do not place shopping or garbage bags into the boxes, doing so hinders the recycling process for this material.

Lights and cords will be shipped to Dynamic Lifecycle Innovations in Onalaska, Wisconsin to be recycled.

In 2018-19, more than 1,500 pounds of material was collected and recycled through this program.

So, as we prepare to untangle, test, and put out those holiday lights this season, remember you can help the environment and recycle all those strands of lights which have brightened our homes in the past but now refuse to light up anymore.

#### NEED FOR WILL

Many people who have relatively simple lives don't feel that they need to go to lawyers to have their wills drawn up. They own some property jointly with their spouses and feel that is enough.

The truth is that if you die intestate (without a will), your estate will be divided according to the current laws of your state. In one state, for example, if a person dies intestate and leaves behind a spouse and children, the law decrees that the spouse shall get one-third of the estate, with the rest divided among the children. If the deceased has no children, but does leave a spouse as well as a surviving parent, the spouse gets one-half of the estate, with the rest



going to the parent.

In other words, if you are married and die without a will, your spouse will not automatically inherit your entire estate. So forget any preconceived notions of what will happen to your property. Make a will so that you can be sure that it goes as you wish.

## Pritzker administration secures \$40.2 million federal preschool development grant

### New federal funds follow creation of Early Childhood Education Commission and Record Investments

**SPRINGFIELD** — In line with Governor J.B. Pritzker's vision of making Illinois the best state in the nation for families raising young children, the Pritzker administration announced it has secured \$40.2 million in federal funding over the next three years to improve early childhood programs across Illinois.

"From our aggressive efforts to secure federal funding to our historic investments in early childhood programs and facilities, Illinois will become the best state in the nation for families raising young children," said Governor JB Pritzker. "We have so much more to accomplish for Illinois families and their children, and this administration will continue investing in the care and education our kids need to succeed."

From 2020 through 2022, the state will receive \$13.4 million per year from the Preschool Development Birth through Five (PDG B-5) Renewal Grant, administered by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

The competitive federal program supports states' efforts to build early childhood program infrastructure and expand high-quality preschool programs in targeted communities that would serve as models for expanding preschool to all 4-year-olds from low- and moderate-income families. The award comes with a 30 percent cost-sharing commitment with non-federal funds and can be used to strengthen coordination within the mixed-delivery system, improve program quality or expand services.

Last week, Gov. Pritzker announced that the administration is increasing reimbursement rates by 5 percent for child care providers statewide and by a total of 20 percent for providers in Group 2 counties, primarily in rural areas. An additional \$3 million is being dedicated for workforce training, and a new 29-member commission of experts has been tasked with taking a fresh look at the state's entire ECEC system.

In the 2019 legislative session, the Governor and General Assembly also made the largest investment ever into early childhood programs and facilities in state history. The Early Childhood Education Block Grant was increased by \$50 million, and the Rebuild Illinois capital plan dedicated \$100 million to early childhood facilities across the state.

## Master Naturalist training announced

**OREGON** – University of Illinois Extension invites adults of all ages to join them for the 2020 Illinois Master Naturalist training.

The classes will be held in Ogle County on Monday evenings from 5 to 9 p.m., starting March 16 and ending May 18. The training features instructors from local natural resource agencies and organizations as well as state Extension experts. The training will highlight our rich natural heritage by hosting classes in different locations in the area such as Nachusa Grasslands and Kickapoo Mud Creek Nature Conservancy.

As a Master Naturalist, you will learn about ecosystems and interrelationships of plants and animals that make up our natural world. You will also learn how to assist with land management and to share your knowledge with others in your

community. The goal is to encourage participants to seek out lifelong learning opportunities to further their development as a naturalist.

Master Naturalist participants agree to serve 60 hours of volunteer service within the first two years of their initial classroom experience. Volunteers can then continue their certification with 30 volunteer hours and 10 continuing education hours annually. Volunteer opportunities in your county are extremely flexible and tailored to fit your personal interests, abilities, and time restraints.

\* The Blackhawk Statue will be uncovered just in time for it to be covered again in order to fix the problems caused by it spending so much time being covered.

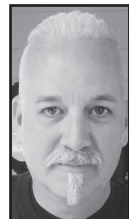
\* Bernie Sanders will drop out of the presidential race after

# Holiday hoopsters

Lady Hubs battle Woodstock, Quincy to open KSB Dixon Classic

"Bella's letting the game come to her," Rowan said. "When she's aggressive, good things will happen for her. She worked on her shot a lot over the summer, and we're hoping that she can start knocking down some of these outside shots so she can get in the mix more often."

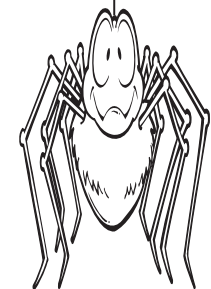

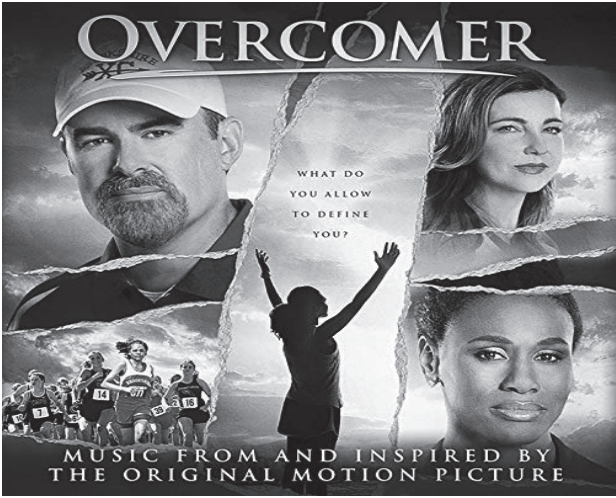
