Agencies unite in search for bodies

Two missing since boat flipped near Oregon dam on Wednesday

OREGON – The body of one of the two men who went missing in the Rock River when their boat capsized near the dam in Oregon on Nov. 20 was located Thursday, but officials were unable to recover it.

Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle said the body was located about a mile south of the dam in Oregon Thursday night. They tried to use a remotely operated vehicle and divers to recover the body, but the high flow of the current made recovery impossible, he said.

“The water was too fast, they couldn’t get to the bot-

tom,” VanVickle said.

They also dragged the river in that spot but were not successful. On Friday morning, they started using

sonar again on the river in search of the bodies.

The fishing boat was initially found at about 11:30 a.m. on Nov. 20 upside

down on the west side of the river near the dam.

VanVickle said a truck and trailer were found at Castle Rock which were

used to haul the boat. He said officials have been in contact with the families, but no names were released by Friday morning.

The initial search included boats from the Oregon Fire Department and Dixon Fire Department.

VanVickle said it is early in the investigation, so there is no clear answer as to how the boat capsized. But he said it might have gotten too close the dam and flipped over.

He also praised the response to the incident, noting that five counties were involved in the search the first day, and four the second.

“It’s just been a great team effort,” VanVickle said.



Honoring veterans

Holiday wreaths available for purchase

ROCHELLE – The Daughters of the American Revolution and St. Patrick’s cemetery are asking for members of the community to help participate in the national Wreaths Across America Program that aims to honor this country’s veterans.

Wreaths Across America is a national program that places purchased, sponsored wreaths by community members, family members, or anyone who wants to support a good cause on the graves of veterans in an effort to remember the country’s fallen veterans, honor those who serve and teach children the value of freedom.

“Wreaths Across America has been around for a long time and the goal is to put a wreath on every veteran’s grave in the whole United States,” explained Lydia Roberts, vice reagent of the Rochelle chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

Wreaths Across America has even expanded to some American cemeteries overseas.

Ceremony

The Daughters of the American Revolution will be hosting a ceremony at St. Patrick’s Cemetery in Rochelle before the

wreaths are placed on the graves of the veterans. The ceremony will be held at 2 p.m. on Sunday, Dec. 15 and will include a wreath representing each of the different branches of service, a wreath for each of the veterans being represented, and placing the wreaths on individual veterans graves.

“When we place the wreath on their grave, their name will also be said out loud so that they are remembered,” said Roberts.

Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows will also be speaking at the ceremony.

There are 140 known veterans buried in St. Patrick’s cemetery and the program has approximately 60 sponsored wreaths so far. Wreaths are available to sponsor for \$15 each. Sponsorships can be done online at Wreathsacrossamerica.org/IL0136P by Dec. 2, through mail by sending the form (found online) to PO Box 249 Columbia Falls, ME 04623 by Tuesday, Nov. 26.

Anyone can purchase a wreath to sponsor for any veteran, whether they are deceased, living, or active duty. Wreaths can also be purchased for sponsorship even if no veteran is known at all.

“If they have the patriotic desire to honor our veterans, they can do so and we would really appreciate if they dedicated a wreath,” added Roberts.

The Rochelle Daughters of the American Revolution are also encouraging anyone who would like to honor local veterans to attend the ceremony.



Groups donate AED device to Focus House

ROCHELLE – Local non-profit organizations Sudden Cardiac-death Awareness Research Foundation, otherwise known as S.C.A.R.F., and the Rochelle Rotary’s From the Heart Fundraiser have helped the Rochelle Focus house be prepared for any type of cardiac emergency with the recent donation of an Automated External Defibrillator.

Focus House in Rochelle, which provides a safe, nurturing and structured environment for youth in the community before having them successfully return home to their families, opened a second house called the Miller House back in August. The original location, located on Illinois Route 251, already had the equipment necessary in case of a cardiac emergency on the premises.

Since the opening of the second home, Focus House officials have been searching for another device to be placed in the Miller House. Rotary and S.C.A.R.F. answered the call.

“They donated the unit back in October and provided us with a little refresher training on how to use the device,” said Focus

House director Brenda Mason. “If any kind of cardiac event were to come up, we would be prepared.”

Previous to having this device on the premise, if an emergency were to happen instructors would have to conduct traditional CPR, compressions and call 911 until emergency help arrived.

Both organizations involved in providing the AED machine do a plethora within their local communities. From the Heart has raised more than \$46,000 for eight local non-profit organizations. And the mission of S.C.A.R.F. is to educate the community about the signs and prevention of sudden cardiac death and to provide tools necessary to do so, such as providing the life-saving machines.

Photos, other items given to defense in fatal fire case

Next pre-trial hearing for Duane Meyer will be Jan. 8

OREGON – The lawyer representing the Byron man accused of killing his wife and son in 2016 told a judge on Nov. 18 that he is reviewing documents and other items the defense has received from prosecutors in the case.

During a pre-trial hearing, Christopher Derango said the defense is still waiting for some items from prosecutors in the case against Duane Meyer. Meyer is accused of setting the 2016 fire in Byron that killed his ex-wife, Maggie Meyer, and 3-year-old son, Amos.

Ogle County State's Attorney Eric Morrow said his office has so far turned over roughly 35,000 pages of discovery to the defense in the case.

The items include police reports from multiple agencies, expert reports, laboratory notes, cell phone forensics and autopsy reports.

Morrow said most of the items are in a digital format.

Also included were videos of interviews and crime scene photos, he said.

Meyer was charged on Oct. 9 with four counts of first degree homicide, two counts of aggravated arson and one count of concealment of a homicidal death. He is currently being held in the Ogle County Jail on a \$10 million bond.

Judge John Roed denied a request by the defense Oct. 16 to lower Meyer's bond amount.

Roe set the next pre-trial hearing for Jan. 8, 2020 at 1:30 p.m.

Giving back to the community

Local restaurant donates proceeds from event to We Care Rochelle

ROCHELLE—Local non-profit organization We Care Rochelle partnered with Alfano's Pizzeria and Italian Restaurant in Rochelle to host its first ever "Pack the Place" fundraiser on Nov. 12 to earn money for four local organizations.

"We Care Rochelle is an organization built on the idea that in order to move forward, we have to give back. Our main goal is to strengthen four of Rochelle's community pillars by making a donation on behalf of our clients to these groups with every business transaction conducted," according to the website.

The group's first big event of the year was the Downtown Block Party held in June. The Pack the Place event was a follow-up event to the block party that will hopefully become an annual event in the community.

"When we first started planning for the block party and began reaching out to businesses seeing if anyone would be willing to participate or donate, Pete Alfano had the great idea to do a follow-up event called Pack the Place," explained Ryan Greifenkamp, co-founder of We Care Rochelle.

We Care Rochelle intends to host to main fundraisers each year, which are the block party and the pack the place event.

Proceeds from those who dined-in at Alfano's for the Pack the Place fundraiser, were donated to four different beneficiaries of We Care Rochelle. Those organizations include the Rochelle Police Department, the

Rochelle Fire Department, the Hub City Senior Center and the Rochelle Rescue Mission.

The check in the amount of \$500 will be equally split between the organizations.

"This check will actually get cut evenly four ways and dispersed within the next 24 hours," explained Greifenkamp.

The beneficiaries for We Care Rochelle will change next year, but the pillars of the community that the new ones serve will be the same. For example, instead of having the Hub City Senior Center, a different senior center or living facility could be chosen.

The day the event was held, the area experienced record breaking cold temperatures, so as a way to help with the turnout, the event was opened up for carry-out and delivery instead of dine-in only. While they received many calls from

people saying that they would have loved to make it out but couldn't because of the cold weather, We Care Rochelle and Alfano's Pizza would like to thank the community for their participation.

"We just want the community to know that we are very thankful for their participation and we want them to know that we are going to continue to support and pour back into the community and different entities within it," said Greifenkamp.

High school board proposes levy

ROCHELLE – During their monthly meeting Monday night, the Rochelle Township High School Board of Trustees approved a motion to pass the monthly minutes.

A motion to pay the bills and approve the treasurer's report was also passed during the meeting.

Another topic during the monthly meeting was the topic of employment for extracurricular activities.

"We hired two new assistant speech coaches and one new assistant wrestling coach," said Kevin Dale, Rochelle township high school business manager.

Nephertiti Valle and

MacKenzie Lara were hired as the new assistant speech coaches and Chris Hager was hired as the assistant wrestling coach.

Levy

Board members also proposed a levy for the 2019 taxes. They reviewed and discussed the reported gross Equalized Assessed Valuation increase of about 10.7 percent from last year because of the quadrennial. But school board officials expect this to drop when people begin noticing a big jump in their taxes and begin to appeal.

"Every year that we get this, the assessors give us a gross EAV of what they assess it at, and every year we have seen it drop," added Dale.

No decisions or action was taken on the proposed levy, but the board plans to adopt the levy at next month's board meeting on Dec. 16, given that their levy does not exceed 5 percent.

There is no need for a Truth in Taxation hearing.

The final thing that was brought up during their meeting was a quarterly update to the board policies provided by the Illinois Association of School Boards. Trustees will have one month to review the summary and ask any questions they may have, then at the December board meeting the policies will be adopted.

Trustees then when into executive session, but there were no decisions that came from it.

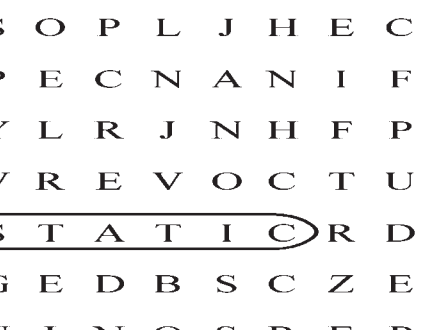

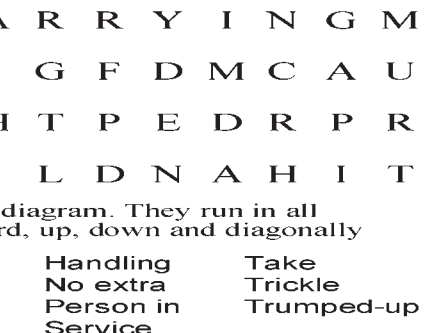

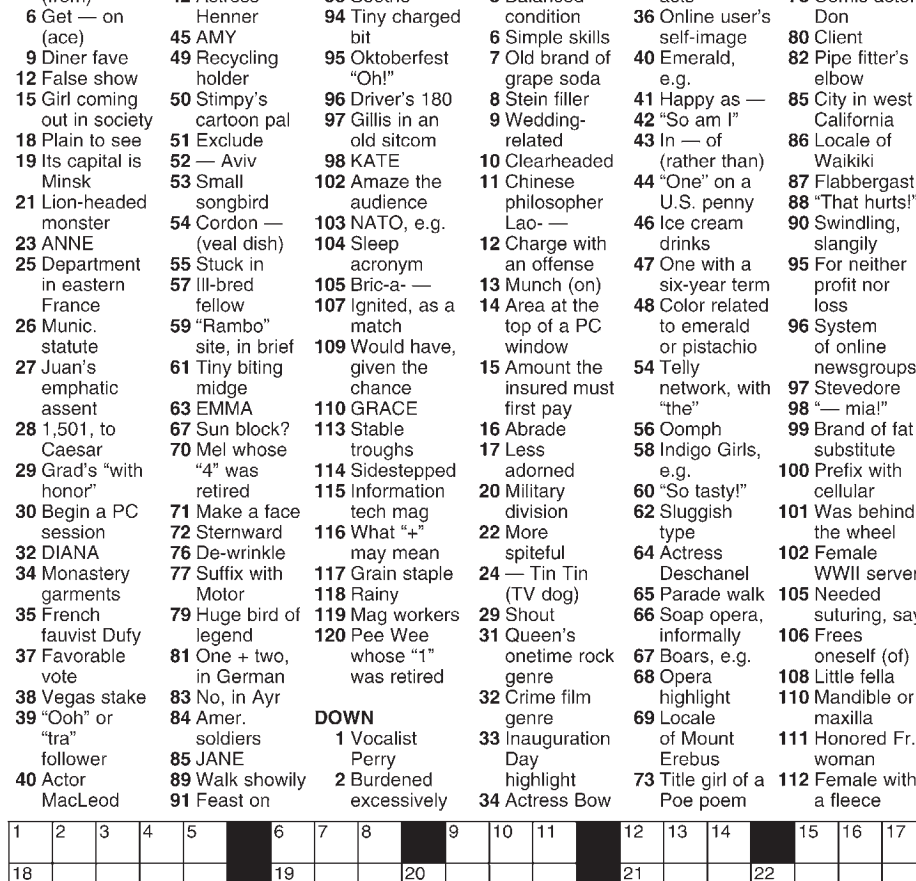

Varsity team takes 10th in 2019 Rockford Christian Lion Open

OTTAWA — The Rochelle boys bowling team had a tough trip to the Illinois Valley this week, dropping road matches against Interstate 8 Conference rivals LaSalle-Peru and Ottawa to fall to 0-4 on the season.

The Hubs faced Ottawa at Dettore's Town Lanes on Thursday, falling by a

Holland recorded a team-high 542 series for

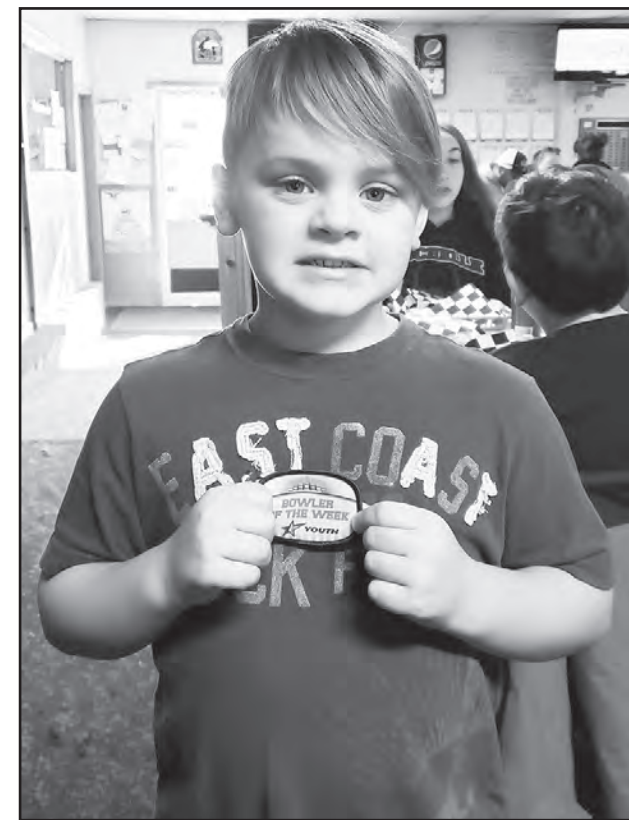
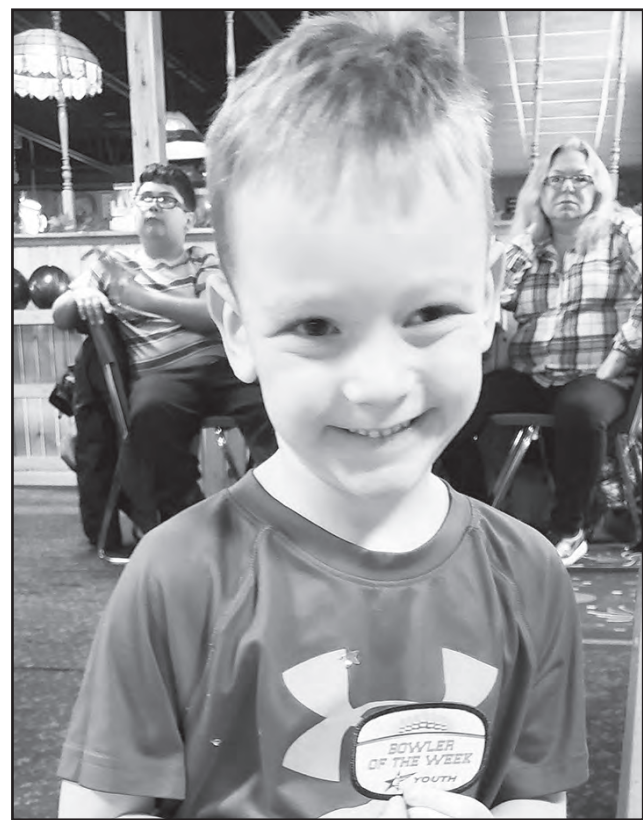
