Rec center payments made

Park commissioners OK maximum \$3.75 million at special meeting

ROCHELLE — The Flag-Rochelle Community Park District Board of Commissioners approved the second phase of its guaranteed maximum price with Ringland-Johnson Construction for the community center under construction on the south side of Helms Park.

After approving the first phase of the GMP for about \$9.5 million nearly 90 days ago, the board solidified the second phase for \$3.75 million during special session at Rochelle City Hall on Wednesday night. The second phase of the GMP includes monies not bid out during the first phase including interior finishes and items for later in the project.

Board President Tim Hayden said the overall GMP has fallen once again, now to \$13.25 million. Hayden also said that excavation work at the construction site is nearly 90 percent complete.

“We have an overall number now that is lower than it was originally projected to be, and also lower than where it was as recently as a few weeks ago,” Hayden said. “We’re to the point now where, subject to any changes on our end, we know exactly where the cost is going to be... We’re confident that we can build this facility within our \$14 million budget.”

The GMP with Ringland-Johnson doesn’t include fixtures, furniture and equipment for the community center such as fitness and recreational

equipment, flooring, security systems and more. Executive Director Jackee Ohlinger said the cost for the FF&E will be about \$750,000, which would bring the overall cost for the project up to the park board’s \$14 million budget.

Two subjects to be determined will be the cost for installing turf at the community center and the type of flooring the park district will use for the turf. Ohlinger said two main flooring options are concrete or crushed stone, with a concrete foundation costing around \$240,000. Ohlinger also said both fill and no-fill turf are being considered for the facility.

“We should have the fitness center bids wrapped up at the end of the month so we can then focus on the turf,” Ohlinger said.



On schedule

Crews begin erecting steel beams of new facility

ROCHELLE – The new recreation center being built behind Walgreens in Rochelle is beginning to take shape.

Construction on the property began in late August with a groundbreaking ceremony. Since then crews from Ringland-Johnson Construction have been hard at work getting the foundation completed and structure set before the winter months bring

snow.

Crews are nearly complete with the foundation and have begun erecting the steel beams that serve as the frame of the building.

“We are approximately 75 percent complete with the foundation and now we are erecting the steel beams for the field house, which will be going on the entire month of November,” explained project manager Megan Simon. “Then in early December the pre-cast concrete panels will be coming in that will make up the exterior

of the building.

After erecting the field house located on the east side of the building, crews will begin erecting the pool and community center on the west side of the building during the months of January into the beginning of February.

Despite having to work through tough weather conditions this year, crews are on schedule for their estimated completion date of Aug. 28, 2020.

Once completed, Liberty Village of Rochelle will offer an age in place campus, unique to the Rochelle community. The campus will consist of beautifully designed neighborhoods, which will provide an individualized care approach defined by the needs of the resident.

"We plan to turn it over to the Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District by the end of August 2020. Crews will work through rain, sleet or snow, the only time crews won't be working through the winter is if the temperatures reach dangerously low levels," said Simon.

Bearing no delays this the winter, crews fully expect to complete the construction before their completion date.

Once completed the rec center will feature many amenities including two parking lots, one on each side of the building; a field house with six basketball

courts, four volleyball courts, a turf area with two soccer fields and a walking track around the soccer fields that will be divided by a screen so it doesn't interfere with any games going on.

There will also be two pools, one that is a lap pool and another one that is a warm water pool that can be used for physical therapy or classes such as water aerobics.

"I think this is just going to be a great facility for Rochelle, they need these kinds of facilities because people have to travel far for these accommodations. I just think it is a really great opportunity for the community and we are happy to be a part of it," added Simon.

A story of survival

I love a good story. Recently I read an amazing story about a plane shot down during WW II. The surviving crew members were stranded on an island before two of them made a makeshift raft and sailed off to find help. The two eventually reached another island, found friendly forces, and in the end, the remaining five crew members were rescued. Sounds like a movie, right?

It's the story of Hector McDaniel, a 1938 graduate of Rochelle Township High School. He enlisted in the Navy in 1939 and eventually became copilot on a B-24 bomber, dubbed the Liberator, and saw heavy action in the area of the Philippines. On one of these missions, the plane encountered heavy enemy fire. They completed their mission, but the plane was so damaged it crashed on a remote island. The Rochelle News-Leader story tells that he was missing in action — fearful words for family and friends half a world away. Shortly after they crashed, a Japanese bomber also crashed on the island. Although its crew died, the plane contained supplies of rice and fish. Added to the coconuts on the island, the Navy crew was able to survive for two months. McDaniel and another crew member set

off in a makeshift raft, eventually reaching a friendly island. McDaniel received a variety of medals, including the Purple Heart, Gold Star, Navy Cross, and a Distinguished Flying Medal. His story sounds like a must see movie. Where did I get that information? From the Flagg-Rochelle Township Museum. I am on the board of the museum, so maybe I am a little biased. Tom McDermott is also on the board, and he has scanned thousands of articles and pictures that appeared in Rochelle newspapers through the years, including Hector McDaniel's story. Anyone can access these stories at the museum. There is a research station, and if you are curious about an event or person, you can use the computer at the station to find out more information. The museum is open from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday through Sunday. There is an admission charge, but Thursday is always a free day. After I read some newspaper accounts of Hector, I Googled his name. His is a fascinating story. And a good one to share as we honor veterans on Monday. Thank you for your service. My love of records is getting a new life

I love records. They are a magical disk to me. They made me a dreamer, a music lover and a musician. I spent hours, days and weeks in my childhood bedroom listening to records and staring at their covers. Those magical covers. And what was in the grooves of those vinyl delights was also magical. KISS, Rush, UFO, Thin Lizzy, Judas Priest, the Ramones. Those might not be names that mean much to you, but they meant a lot to me during my teen years. I had a pretty decent collection of vinyl when I was younger. I bought plenty of records with money I made as a busboy or delivering pizzas. Yes, I also bought 8-track tapes and, later, cassettes, but I always loved albums. Not all of it was the harder rock mentioned above. I was a huge Elton John fan, and also had some pop music, plenty of progressive stuff and even some jazz

fusion. I could sit in my bedroom, put on an album and stare at an album cover for hours. I read the names of the producers, where it was recorded, who the engineer was. I read the lyrics and scanned the "thank you" section many bands put in the liner notes for cool shout outs to other bands. My mother thought I was crazy. She was probably right about that, but not because of my love of records and music. I had those albums for decades, and I continued to add to the collections for a long time. I was not a completist who had to have everything, but I did collect everything from certain bands simply because I loved the music. But eventually I stopped listening to vinyl. First CDs and then digital took over and my records simply became boxes of memories that I

carted around from state to state. I didn't even own a record player for years. I gave many of my old classic albums to a friend in Minnesota when we moved from there to California in the mid-2000s. I knew they were going to a good home. And before we moved from California to Illinois five years later, I gave the rest of the collection that was not water or heat damaged to another friend. For the first time since I was a toddler, I was record free. But a few years ago, I started record shopping again. Surprise, surprise — records became cool again. Yes, they sound better than CDs and much better than any digital file you can download. Also, they have a certain cool factor. My wife bought me a turntable, and I enjoy listening to records

The album is a thing of beauty, and all the extras brought being a teen in my bedroom hearing this music for the first time rushing back to me. Of course, my mom would probably think I was crazy for spending that much on a 42-year-old album. And I might be crazy — but not for buying that album. 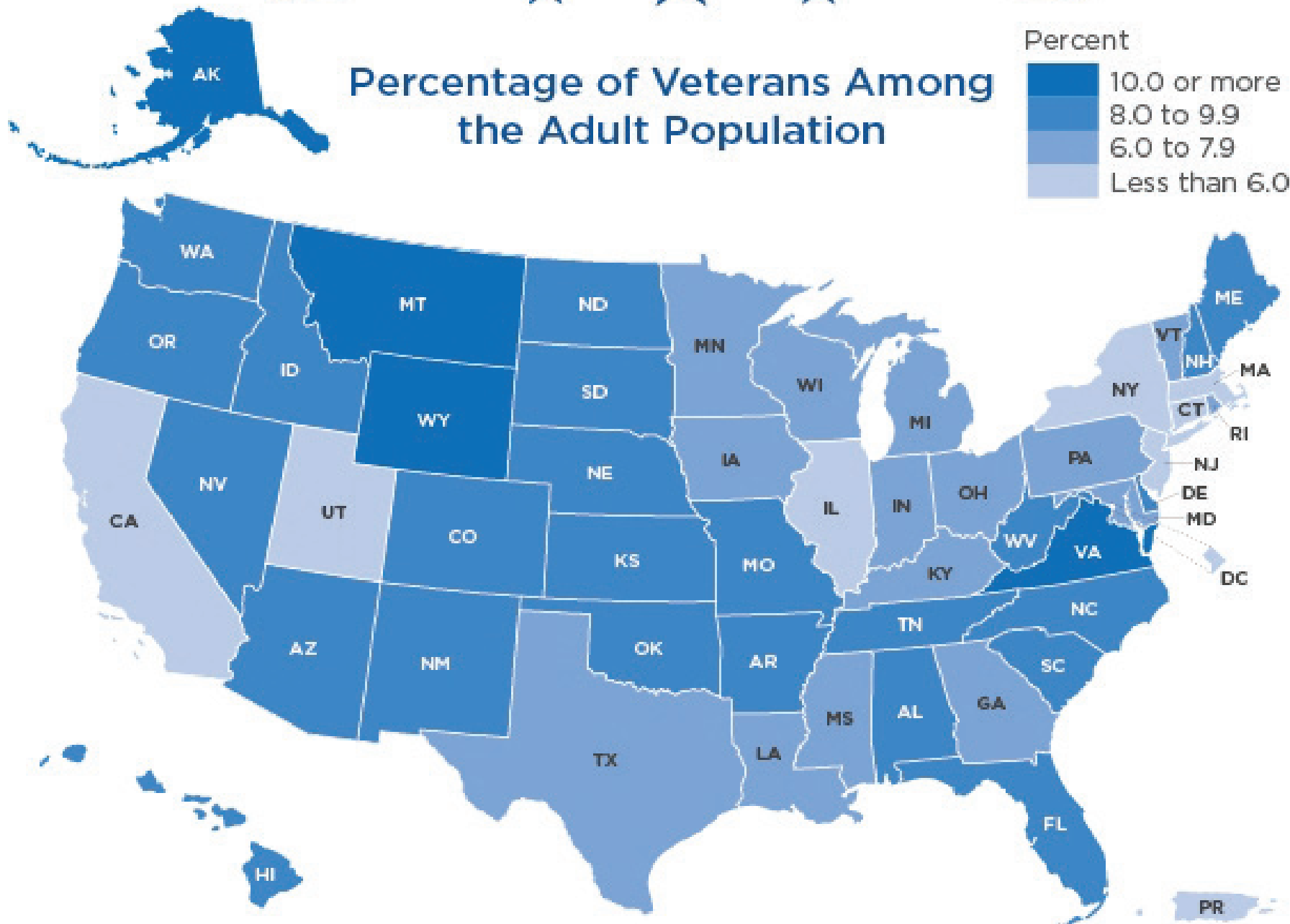

Ahtziri improved her PR by a couple of minutes and Morgan’s improved so much from her freshman year... I’m really looking forward to what the girls team will be able to do in the future.”

The Rochelle boys were the more experienced group this fall, placing second in the Byron Invitational, third in the Oregon 7 Person Invitational and fourth in both the Rochelle Invitational and Genoa-Kingston’s Matt Walter Invitational. 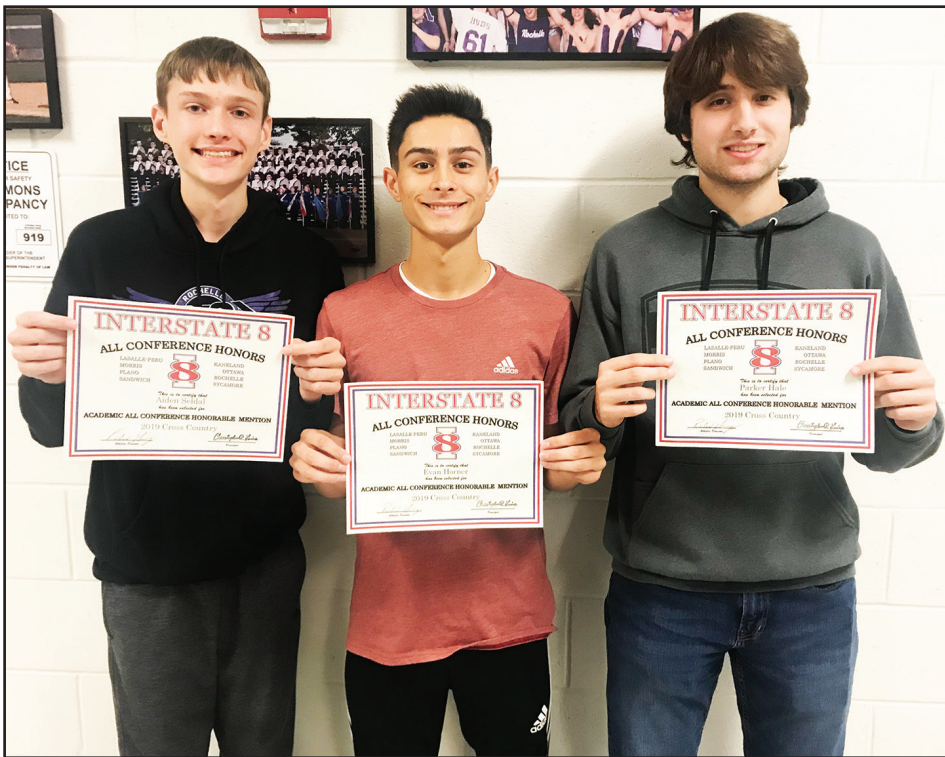

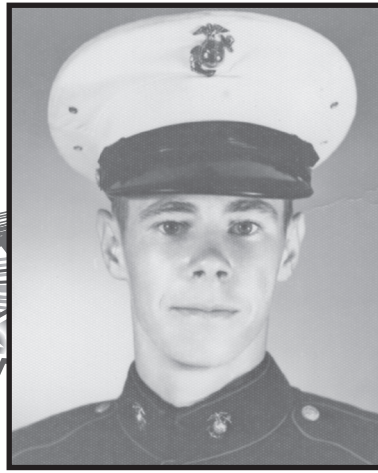

THE ACTION

The Action commenced
on May 20, 2014, when
Plaintiffs Floyd Schultz,
Stanley Blunier, and Brad
Riskedal filed the Com-
plaint which asserted
allegations and claims
on behalf of the Class.
The Complaint alleged
that the Defendants
named in the caption
on the first page of this
Notice breached duties
to the Class in connec-
tion with the merger in
the first quarter of 2012
that required the Class
to relinquish their units
in Illinois River Energy
Holdings, LLC ("IREH")
for \$1.10 per unit.

In 2012, the IREH ma-
jority unitholder (GTL)
decided to pursue a
merger of IREH into a

Rochelle soccer players sticking together

THE Kishwaukee College men's soccer program was dormant for many years, but the arrival of four Rochelle Township High School players has helped bring new life to the team after the Kougars struggled to find success during the 2018 season.

Former Hub standouts Jessee Infante, Ruben Herrera, Josue Almaraz and Juan Montemayor wanted to stick together after leading Rochelle to its first-ever IHSA 2A Sectional Championship appearance in 2018. The foursome signed with Kishwaukee College earlier this year, and the boys made an immediate impact with the Kougars, helping the program finish 10-7-1 this season. Kishwaukee started the 2019 campaign with eight wins over the team's first 10 games.

Infante emerged as one of the NJCAA's top scorers during the stretch, ranking as high as second in the nation in goals. The RTHS single-season scoring champion ended his freshman campaign with a team-high 19 goals and seven assists. Infante scored a season-best four goals in the team's 7-0 win over Richard J. Daley College on Sept. 14.

"What I enjoyed most about playing with my Rochelle teammates was that we had a brotherhood that was nearly unbreakable," Infante said. "We know each other's backgrounds and we all have the hunger to win... I feel like I improved by becoming

more physical and scoring goals in big moments for my team."

Almaraz started 16 games on defense for the Kougars, while Herrera started in 14 games. The two center backs combined to help Kishwaukee hold opponents to only 1.96 goals per game this season. Almaraz added one goal and one assist to aid the Kishwaukee offense. Montemayor started in 10 games for the Kougars, totaling two assists in the midfield.

"My first season with Kishwaukee went better than expected," Almaraz said. "I enjoyed playing against other colleges because the competition was much higher than it was in high school. I feel like I improved my overall defensive skills and my decision-making with the ball... What I enjoyed most about playing with my Rochelle teammates was the chemistry we already have."

"Josue and I always had that bond on the back line," Herrera added. "I have improved on becoming more of a leader and always trying to get everybody pressuring the ball. I want to improve my conditioning. I felt comfortable in the back since I had someone on the line that I knew really well."

"It was exciting to be with a whole new team because we had new coaches and players to work with," Montemayor said. "It was a whole different experience when it came to our training, our games and the competition we faced... I really liked playing with my Rochelle teammates. We pushed each other through training sessions and games, and they're like my brothers so it was nice to experience soccer at this level with them."
