Judge keeps bond at \$10 million

Meyer faces life in prison if found guilty in fatal fire case

OREGON – The Byron man accused of killing his ex-wife and 3-year-old son in 2016 will remain in jail on a \$10 million bond, Judge John Roe ruled at a hearing Oct. 16.

Duane Meyer was charged on Oct. 9 with four counts of first degree homicide, two counts of aggravated arson and one count

of concealment of a homicidal death for allegedly setting the fire in Byron that killed Maggie Meyer and Amos Meyer

Duane Meyer, who was led into court in an orange jumpsuit with chains at his waist and ankles, has pled not guilty to the charges.

Meyer's attorney, Christopher Derango, of Rockford, who made the motion for the bond reduction, argued that Meyer was not a flight risk. He said Meyer was a lifelong Ogle County resident who had family ties

to the area.

He also said that during the three years since the fatal fire, Meyer has not left town or broken any laws.

"Not so much as a parking ticket," Derango said.

He said that if released, Meyer could continue to be a "productive member" of society during the trial.

More needed to gather Census

ROCHELLE – The United States Census is being counted next year and Ogle County is still in need of people to work as Census employees to prevent missing out of valuable funding from the state.

There are many reasons why it is important to get an accurate census count, but the most important reason is for funding from both the federal and state level that is determined by the area's population. According to the United States Census Bureau, the Census accounts for the distribution of more than \$675 billion in federal grants and support to states, counties and communities.

During the last census count in 2010, it is estimated that 84 percent of Ogle County participated. At first glance, that number appears to be a good participation percentage; however, when those numbers are broken down, the county is missing out on a large amount of valuable funding.

Annual Vein Drain blood drive Tuesday

Event will take place in new location

ROCHELLE – The Rock River Valley Blood Center and 102.3 The Coyote will host the 10th Annual Vein Drain Blood Drive on Tuesday, Oct. 22 from noon to 6 p.m. at Central Bank Illinois, 340 May Mart Drive, Rochelle.

Donors can make appointments online at rrvbc.org or by calling 815-965-8751. Walk-ins will also be welcome.

Over the previous years the blood drive was held at the Rochelle Police Station, but this year has been moved to the bank due to the construction taking place at city hall.



“We are excited to partner with 102.3 The Coyote again for this life-saving event,” said Lisa Entrikin, Interim CEO at the Rock River Valley Blood Center. “We provide more than 1,000 units of blood each week to 10 regional hospitals and we rely on partnerships like this to meet the needs of local patients. The first 102 donors will receive a T-shirt, sandwich and a cookie as a thank-you from our partners 102.3 The Coyote, Central Bank Illinois, Jimmy John’s and Sunshine Bakery.”

Donating blood is simple, and one unit can save up to three lives. After registering, a donor care specialist will take donor vitals (temperature, blood pressure, pulse and hemoglobin), complete an eligibility questionnaire, and then complete the actual donation process. The donation itself only lasts approximately 10 minutes.

Refreshments are available following donations.

“This blood drive is something we look forward to helping with each year, said Kris Wexell, program director at 102.3 The Coyote. “The whole community comes together to make the Vein Drain a huge success each fall, and The Coyote is grateful to be a part of it.”

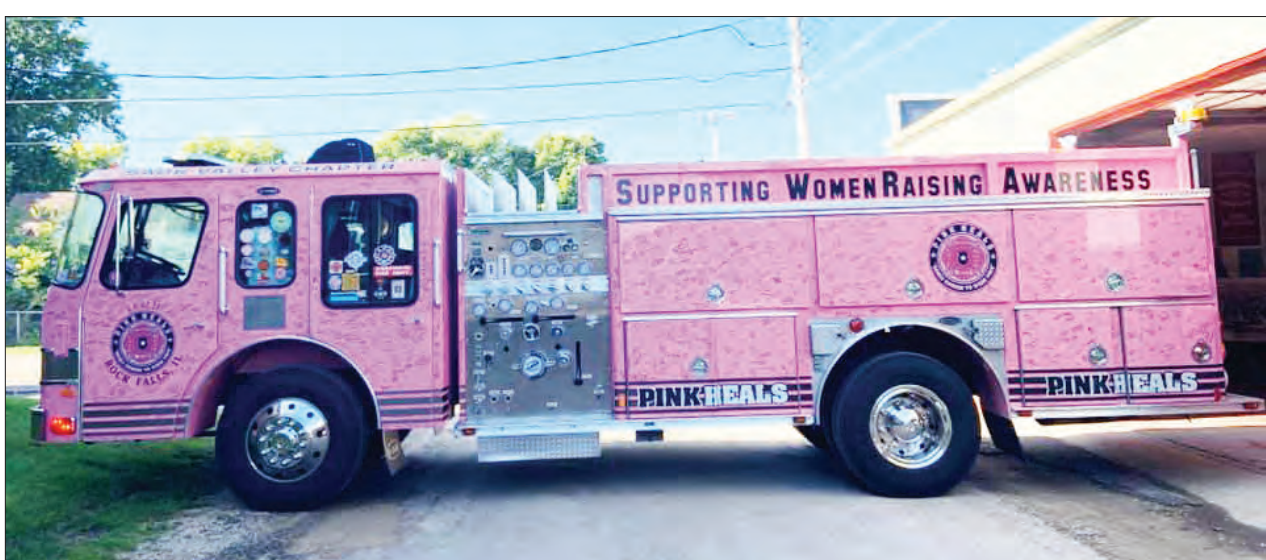
First-time donors are asked to bring a photo ID. Individuals can donate a single unit (whole blood donation, the most common type) every 56 days.

"In the 2010 census it is estimated that there were roughly 8,560 people that went uncoun-
ted for in Ogle County and it is estimated that each uncoun-
ted person cor-
responds to a minimum of \$1,535. So, for Ogle County for one year that would actu-
ate to over \$13 million," assistant to the Rochelle City Manager Sue Messer said.

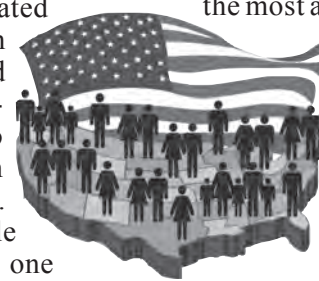
Accurate Census totals mainly effect the city's general fund bud-

get, which is used toward the city's police and fire departments.

Ogle County is currently asking for people to apply to be Census employees to help get the most accurate count possible this coming year.

Ogle County currently has 93 employees which is only 48.4 percent needed to be at peak operation level.

Anyone working as a census employee will earn \$15.50 per hour and can apply online by going to 2020census.gov/jobs.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

There are several ways to finance a funeral, including cash payment at the time of funeral, payment by proceeds of insurance or payment by settlement of the decedent's estate.

Some survivors pay the full amount of the funeral at the time of arrangements are made. The majority of people, however, will agree to a contract which specifies a schedule of payments. Demmer hosts RALI CARES Trailer Stop at Sandwich High School

SANDWICH—Parents from Sandwich had an opportunity recently to attend an event that provided insight into how today’s teens and young adults hide drug use.

Through a partnership with the Rx Abuse Leadership Initiative of Illinois (RALI-IL), Code 3 Association, and the Pharmaceutical Research & Manufacturers of America (PhRMA), State Representative Tom Demmer (R-Dixon) hosted a stop of the RALI CARES educational trailer at Sandwich High School on Oct. 9.

“Communities across Illinois have been impacted by the opioid crisis,” said Demmer. “In 2017 alone, over 70,000 individuals lost their lives from

drug overdoses, and the overwhelming majority of those deaths involved opioid abuse.”

The RALICARES exhibit is a traveling trailer staged as a teen bedroom and bathroom. Adults who visit the trailer can participate in a hands-on guided tour, where seemingly harmless items are pointed out as red flags for drug use or abuse. Warning signs and potential areas of concern are discussed, and experts answer parents’ questions as they move through the exhibit.

“Visitors walked away with a greater understanding of how young people hide or disguise their drug use,” Demmer said. “By educating parents

in what to look for, misuse or abuse of drugs can be identified early and lives can be saved.”

Demmer encourages all people who have been prescribed opioid medication to follow dosage directions closely, to store the medication out of reach of children, and to safely dispose of unused medications rather than leaving them in a medicine cabinet.

October 26 is National Prescription Drug Take Back Day. Anyone with unused medication is urged to drop off the medications at local police departments.

County gives open burn reminder

OREGON — With shorter days and cooler temperatures, autumn is now here in Ogle County.

The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department routinely fields calls and responds to complaints dealing with the open burning of waste at this time of year.

In Illinois, the Environmental Protection Act has addressed this issue since the 1970s. By law in Illinois, only certain types of waste may be openly burned, and even then, only under certain conditions. No matter where you reside in Illinois, the only materials that can be openly burned are landscape waste generated from that property, certain agricultural materials (animal bedding, straw), and domicile waste, which includes cardboard and junk mail, which is generated on that property.

If you live within city limits of a town or village, there may be more restrictions on open burning as well. If you are burning some of the above materials, be sure that you are doing it responsibly. Always monitor the fire, only burn dry materials to avoid a smoky, smoldering fire, and only burn on days when smoke will not create nuisance conditions for your neighbors or create

visibility hazards on roadways.

It is illegal to burn furniture, mattresses, tires, Styrofoam, plastic items such as chairs, coolers, or other containers, garbage, batteries and electronics, cabinets, carpet, vinyl siding, roofing shingles, fiberglass, or any type of construction or demolition debris, which includes lumber, OSB, paneling, and decking. Modern materials are mostly synthetic and petroleum based. Most wood debris is either treated, painted, or can contain adhesives. Burning these types of materials releases toxins and carcinogens to the atmosphere and the ash, which is toxic, contaminates the ground where the burn pile is located. It is in violation of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and Ogle County ordinances to burn the above materials. In addition, structures, recreational vehicles, or mobile homes cannot be burned as a method of disposal under any conditions.

If you have further questions regarding proper open burning or would like some alternatives to open burning such as waste-reduction, composting, recycling, or reuse, or would like information regarding open burning permits, please call the OCSWMD at 815-732-4020 or visit oglecounty.org.

Boes appointed to fill County Board seat

ROCHELLE — At its Oct. 15 meeting, the Ogle County Board filled the vacancy left by the death of Kim Gouker.

Larry Boes, of Byron, was selected to replace Gouker, the former County Board chairman who was found dead at his Byron home during a wellness check on Sept. 10. Boes will fill out the remainder of Gouker's term, which ends on Nov. 30, 2020. He will represent District No. 6.

Judicial Center Annex being built in Oregon. Most of the costs are for construction management services being provided by Gilbane. The new jail is expected to be completed in late 2020.

Also, the Board voted to approve an ordinance establishing a county cannabis retailers tax. It covers the tax rate for future businesses selling marijuana in the county, other than medical marijuana. For businesses in unincorporated area of Ogle County, the rate will be 3.75 percent.

But State's Attorney Eric Morrow told Roe that Meyer was a danger to the community and a flight risk. Morrow said that Meyer was charged with killing his ex-wife and son, two people close to him, and that when arrested, he was in possession of a loaded firearm in his vehicle.

"I would submit that nobody in this community is safe," if Meyer is released, Morrow said.

He also said that if convicted of the charges, Meyer faces a sentence of natural life in prison. Morrow said, "that alone" is enough to keep the bond in place.

Ultimately Roe agreed, citing the charges, loaded gun and the prospect of a life sentence – along with other evidence – as reasons to leave the bond at \$10 million.

"I am going to deny the bond reduction by the defense," Roe said.

Roe set the next pre-trial hearing for Nov. 18 at 10 a.m.

But with the Hubs winning by nearly six touchdowns early in the fourth quarter, head coach Kyle Kissack inserted Jandak at fullback, and the 265-pound senior took his first career varsity carry up the middle for a 2-point conversion that sealed Rochelle’s 42-0 win over Plano. The Hubs improved to 3-5 overall with the victory.

“Coach asked me if I wanted to play fullback and of course I said yes,” Jandak said. “I kept telling myself not to fumble the ball. I owed it all to my guys up front. They did

everything they could to let me score those points... It’s a good way to wrap up our last home game at RTHS. I love this town and there’s a great football atmosphere here.”

The Reapers entered Friday’s game having scored only 15 points over their previous four contests. Plano didn’t find much offensive rhythm against Rochelle, punting on its first two possessions in the opening quarter and allowing the Hubs to take an early lead. Senior Gavin Ansteth gave Rochelle a 6-0 advantage with a 3-yard touchdown run, and senior Austin Greifenkamp added a 1-yard rushing score later in the quarter.

Plano turned the ball over on downs early in the second quarter, leading to Rochelle’s third scoring drive capped off by a 4-yard rushing touchdown from Ansteth, who led the Hubs with 176 rushing yards in the win. Greifenkamp ran in the 2-point

conversion to give Rochelle a 20-0 lead, which stood at halftime. Plano’s best chance to score came late in the second quarter, but senior safety Ethan Etes intercepted Reaper quarterback Tony Licea to cancel out the Plano offensive threat.

Lady Hubs defeat Morris to snap losing streak

Green records double-double as Rochelle wins 20-25, 25-21, 25-15

ROCHELLE—Clare Green and her Lady Hub teammates were motivated to avenge their three-set loss against Morris earlier this season. The Rochelle volleyball team had its chance on Thursday, and while they may have started slowly, the Lady Hubs capitalized on their opportunity with a dominant performance near the end of the match.

Trailing the Redskins 14-11 in the third set, Rochelle rallied for five consecutive points to force a Morris timeout and take a slim lead, which soon exploded after the Lady Hubs ignited a 9-1 run resulting in a thrilling three-set victory for the purple and white. Rochelle defeated the Redskins 20-25, 25-21, 25-15 to snap a three-match losing streak and improve to 18-15 overall. Green recorded a double-double for the Lady Hubs, totaling 23 assists and 10 digs in the win.

“We all really wanted this win and we were really positive throughout the match,” Green said. “We had 1-or-2 girls going for

every ball no matter what. We really wanted this win and we wanted to get after them and not make it close. We found our motivation and our will to win. We continued to fight throughout the match.”

Despite the Redskins serving five balls into the net during the first set, Morris managed to pull ahead early and take advantage of some misplays by the Lady Hubs. The Rochelle front stepped up in the second set, with junior Afi Gati blocking back-to-back shots by the Redskins to help the Lady Hubs lead 14-9. Both teams exchanged short runs soon after, with Morris coming as close as 22-20 before Rochelle evened the match with a brief 3-1 spurt.

“Our blocks were working against us in the first set,” head coach Molly Sly said. “The girls were able to adjust and our blocks started working for us. We had multiple blocks in both the second and third sets, and we didn’t have that in the first set. I think that was the difference.”

Rochelle leaned on its veteran players toward the end of the match, and the Lady Hubs delivered by

scoring 14-of-15 points down the stretch. Many of those points resulted from Green assists and outside kills from seniors Katie Van Hise and Maggie Duval, who combined for 20 in the victory. Rochelle will wrap up the regular season with conference matches against Ottawa and Plano next week before tipping off the IHSA Class 3A Regional at RTHS.

“The way we finished the third set is what it’s going to take in order to extend our season,” Sly said. “When the going gets tough, we need to grit our teeth and go harder. We told each other at the end of the match that we need to go out there and take it.”

Rochelle exacts revenge against Marmion

Orozco, Milan shine as Hubs defeat Cadets 4-0

AURORA—Wednesday provided an opportunity for an emotional rematch for members of the Rochelle boys soccer team. The Hubs didn't balk at the chance to defeat the school that ended their perfect season and eliminated them in the IHSA Sectional Championship this past year.

Junior Brayan Orozco led Rochelle with two

goals and freshman keeper Jarett Milan shined with 13 saves as the Hubs took down Marmion Academy 4-0 on Wednesday to wrap up the regular season. The victory was significant for returning players like senior Max Torres, who was a starting forward when the Cadets topped Rochelle 2-1 in the sectional finals last season.

The Hubs improved to 13-7 overall with the win, and Rochelle will kick off the IHSA Class 2A Re-

gional Semifinals at Wheaton Academy on Tuesday, when the sixth-seeded Hubs will play the fourth-seeded Kaneland Knights, who beat Rochelle twice during the season.

"We knew they were still going to have a strong team since they only lost two seniors coming into this season," Torres said. "Our minds were set on getting a good victory before going into regionals... We didn't play our best both times against

Kaneland. We made some defensive mistakes, but as a team, we played much better the second time. As long as we can capitalize on the chances we have, I think we'll be able to win."

Rochelle took the early lead against Marmion after Torres assisted Orozco for a goal in the opening minute and Orozco found junior Zane Walters for another score in the 18th minute. The Hubs lengthened their advantage over the Cadets when Walters

connected with Torres for Rochelle's third goal in the 22nd minute.

The Hubs led 3-0 at halftime before icing the victory with an Orozco goal assisted by junior Josh Hurtado in the 51st minute. While Rochelle won the match, Marmion Academy actually outshot the purple and white 17-16 and outpaced them 13-10 in shots on goal and 4-2 in corner kicks. The Cadets were caught offside four times, though, while the

Hubs were flagged only once.

Wednesday's game was played on grass, whereas the regional tournament at Wheaton Academy will be conducted on turf, where the dimensions of the field will be wider than usual.

"The ball will roll much faster and it's going to be a much wider field," Torres said. "If there's a lot of wind, that will definitely affect the ball's movement. But I know we can play fine on turf."

Rochelle received the football to start the third quarter, and the Hubs continued dominating the line of scrimmage, compiling a nine-play, 86-yard scoring drive culminating in an 18-yard rushing touchdown from Greifenkamp, who recorded 110 rushing yards in the victory. Sophomore Eric Briseno's 17-yard off-tackle run early in the fourth quarter set up a 17-yard rushing touchdown by Ansteth, with Greifenkamp converting the 2-point play.

As the game approached its conclusion, action picked up in the fourth quarter when senior linebacker Nick Albers intercepted a deep pass from Licea and returned the football 39 yards to the Plano 5-yard line. Thinking he was head-

ing out of the game, Kissack told Albers to line up at wingback, and showing shades of his older brother Matt Albers, a former Hub running back, Nick went left and scored his first career varsity touchdown on a 5-yard rush.

"I couldn't have asked for a better opportunity," Albers said. "I was a little tired after that interception but I'm glad coach Kissack gave me the shot to score my first touchdown. With what we've been through all season... I think we deserved this win."

Senior Keegan Davis-Carter totaled a team-high 10 tackles on defense, while sophomore Cam Ajazi added nine tackles including five for a loss. Albers, Jandak and junior Mike Schlenbecker each had one sack.

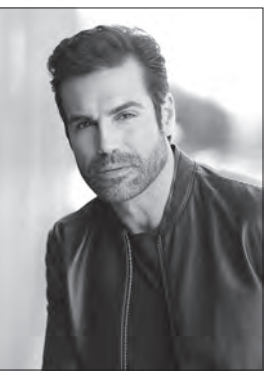

Also, it seems many contestants travel to the different cities even when they're not competing. I would think that could get fairly expensive if they're paying for it themselves. -- S.S.

A: NBC's "American Ninja Warrior" is an obstacle course competition held in various cities, culminating in the finalists competing in Las Vegas for a \$1 million prize. However, only one person takes home that loot. Everyone else gets squat, although as you mentioned, competitors can win up to \$10,000 if they're able to scale the Mega Wall.

According to [Looper.com](#), the ninjas you see succeeding season after season "are finding new ways to make a living based on their athleticism. ... This includes doing commercials and making appearances at gyms and other events."

A self-proclaimed five-time competitor posted anonymously on Reddit that the athletes pay for all their travel expenses unless they're competing in the national finals. In that case, NBC does cover the cost of the flight, hotel and meals. As for those ninjas who travel to other cities to cheer on their competition, I would imagine that's on their own dime as well. However, due to the popularity of "ANW," many of these competitors likely make money off sponsorships and promotions through Instagram, and some have even opened

their own gyms.

Young emerging as core tennis group grows

MELISA Young was preparing to enter her freshman year at Rochelle Township High School when she found out the Lady Hub tennis team was looking for new players.

Young happened to be neighbors with Rochelle head coach Lizzie Cartwright, who convinced her to take up tennis before the start of the 2018 season. Young grew up playing softball and she had no experience playing tennis, but after overcoming her initial worries, she said she's had fun learning to play a new sport.

"Coach Cartwright came over one day and told me she was going to take me to tennis," Young said. "I was nervous about playing tennis, but once I started playing I realized it was a lot of fun. I've become better friends with the girls on the team and it's a more laid-back sport."

The Lady Hubs lost several senior players the previous season, meaning the varsity team needed new players including Young to step up and play beyond their experience levels. Young started her freshman season at No. 2 doubles, and while Young wasn't expecting to play varsity matches right away, she said the experience helped prepare her for this season.

"I was definitely excited about it but I was also nervous because I didn't know how good the other girls were going to be since they were older than me," Young said. "I thought my first year went well. My serves have improved a lot and I've been getting to the ball quicker."

The Lady Hubs have been slowly building their varsity roster after finishing 1-13

in dual matches this past season and 2-13 overall this fall. Their success has come in doubles play, where the Lady Hubs swept both Rockford Lutheran and Belvidere to help Rochelle start the 2019 season with a 2-0 record. Young has moved up to No. 1 doubles as a sophomore this fall, and she's been an integral part of the team's doubles success, winning five matches as a No. 1 player.

"I feel like we've played pretty well and we've definitely improved from last year," Young said. "We're serving the ball better and our serves are a lot harder now. Our hits are more consistent and they're staying in more often... The girls I've played this year are better than they were last year and there's been more competition."

Young was one of three freshmen who played varsity tennis last season, and she was the only freshman to start the season on varsity. She's one of four sophomores who earned varsity experience this season (Jordin Dickey, Emma Hicks and Margaux DaCosta), and as the Lady Hubs continue building their young core, Young appears primed to spearhead the charge as she progresses into her junior and senior seasons.

"I like to challenge myself and see how well I can perform against other girls," Young said. "It will be fun to see how we grow up and it will be fun to see how the freshmen improve their skills from this season. It was exciting to start the season 2-0... We've definitely played well and I think we can play better. We have to work hard at practice and possibly take some lessons over the summer to improve our skills."
