Campbell receives top honors

RTHS physics teacher named Illinois High School Physics Teacher of the Year

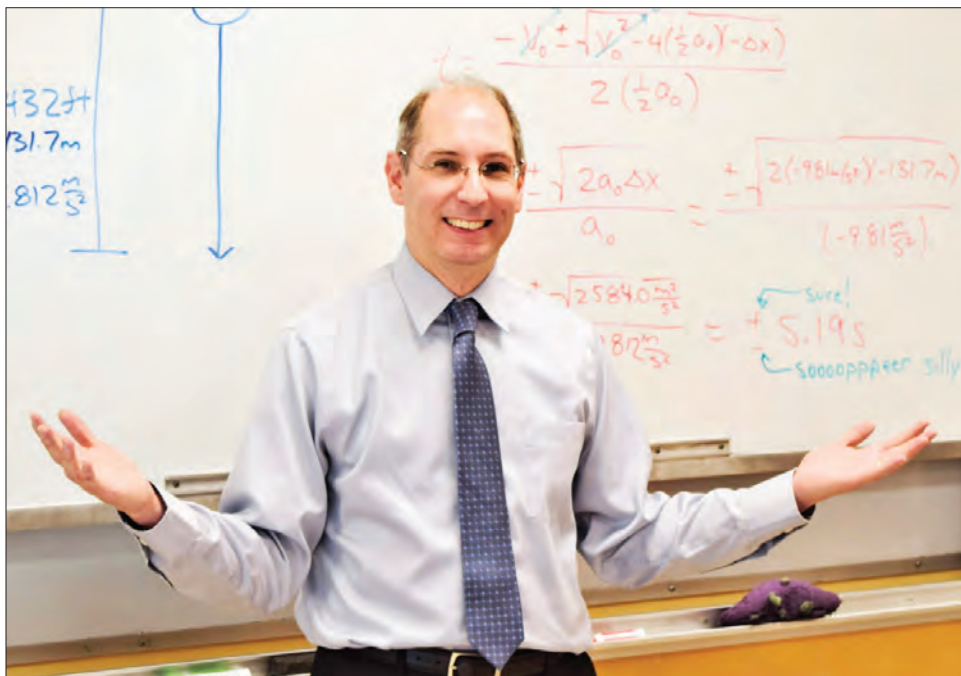

ROCHELLE — That Rochelle Township High School physics teacher Scott Campbell has been named Illinois Physics Teacher of the Year comes as no surprise to his students.

Campbell has been teaching Honors Chemistry, Advanced Placement Chemistry, Physics, and Advanced Placement Physics at RTHS since the fall of 2014.

Campbell, born in Appalachia near Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, was awarded an academic scholarship to Boston University, earning a degree in Aerospace Engineering.

Campbell said he was a high school science and math nerd who would have enjoyed a career in education, but listened to

the people in his life who said teaching was a dead-end career, "So, I buried the idea of teaching and followed the money."

Campbell arrived in

Illinois (his wife is a native) after college, working for Service-master and immediately began working toward an MBA from Benedictine

University. Three years later, he entered the world of banking. He rose to senior vice president but realized he didn't want to run a bank, so he left, join-

ing Volkswagen Bank (a startup) for two years as he weighed his future.

With his Volkswagen office in Utah, Campbell enrolled at Western Governors University there to become certified to teach physics and general high school science. He also earned a Master's degree in Chemistry Education.

Campbell became a student teacher in DeKalb before taking a position at Harlem High School teaching Chemistry, Physics and a science program for at-risk students. He had finally returned to the career field to which he had initially been drawn.

"This is what I'm supposed to be doing," he said.

Campbell learned of the opening at RTHS and applied in 2014.

Arrest made in fatal Byron fire

Ex-husband being held on \$10 million bond

OREGON — Duane Meyer was been arrested Wednesday and charged with the deaths of his ex-wife, Margaret "Maggie" Meyer, and his 3-year-old son, Amos, who died in a Byron house fire on Oct. 19, 2016.

Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle announced at a press conference Wednesday that Duane Meyer, 37, was indicted by an Ogle County Grand Jury on Oct. 8 on four counts of first degree homicide, two counts of aggravated arson and one count of concealment of a homicidal death.

He was arrested at approximately 6 a.m. Wednesday morning without incident, according to the Ogle County Sheriff's Department. During his

arrest, Meyer was in possession of a loaded firearm and was additionally charged with unlawful use of a weapon.

Ogle County State's Attorney Eric Morrow presented the case to the Grand Jury.

"After a thorough pre-

sentation, the Grand Jury did return an indictment," Morrow said during the press conference.

Meyer is now being held in the Ogle County Jail on a \$10 million bond.

"I would note, if the defendant is convicted of the [charges]...murder cases, this would be a natural life sentence," Morrow added.

Meyer was the person who called in the fire at about 6:40 a.m. on Oct. 19, 2016, telling officials he was there to pick up Amos. The Illinois State Fire Marshal official on the scene determined the fire was arson at that time.

At the time of the fire, Byron Fire Department officials said there was no fire visible from outside the home, at 2020 Silverthorn Ave. A small

fire was found in the living room of the home, where Maggie Meyers, 31, was also found.

The Ogle County Sheriff's Office began investigating the fire immediately, along with Byron Police, Illinois Police Zone 2 investigators, the Ogle County Coroner's Office, Illinois State Police Crime Scene, the Illinois Fire Marshal as well as technical assistance from the Illinois Attorney General's Office and the FBI.

The investigation produced more than 35,000 pages of documents and other evidence and was 'active and ongoing' until the last few weeks.

Meyer would be required to post \$1 million cash bond to be released.

Hillcrest website to get upgrade

HILLCREST — The Village of Hillcrest Board of Trustees voted Wednesday to allocate \$4,600 in budget funding to have a new village website built for residents and others to access. The village

plans to partner with the municipal web design company Municode for the new site.

"This is something I've been researching for a few months," Village Clerk Dawn Bearrows said. "Our site is pretty basic and it's broken. It doesn't really do what we need it to do. It's outdated, simple

and plain... There isn't any technical support behind the website, so when it gets to a point where I can't do anything with it, it's broken."

Bearrows introduced the idea to the village board Wednesday evening during the new business portion of open session. Bearrows initiated the discussion by

detailing the lack of functionality behind the current website, <http://www.hillcrestil.us>. Bearrows also noted the current site doesn't comply with ADA standards due to a lack of embedded visual and audio support.

Center closed next week

ROCHELLE – Due to the current sidewalk construction in downtown Rochelle, the Hub City Senior Center will be closed from Oct. 14 to Oct. 20.

For approximately the last two months the city has been replacing sidewalks and gutters and installing new streetlights throughout the downtown area. During the entire process, they have been considerate of working with surrounding businesses, including the senior center, to avoid closures.

“City engineer Sam Tesreau has been very accommodating and easy to work with, they have been very careful about timing the days they work around the days we have events,” said Connie Dougherty, executive director of the senior center.

Work on the sidewalk surrounding the senior center is about to begin next Monday, giving center officials no choice but to close during the construction. Once the work is completed, the new sidewalk will make it easier for people to come and go.

“Not only will it be more aesthetically pleasing, but the entrance will also be more handicap accessible with new crosswalks and ramps,” explained Dougherty.

As long as there are no unexpected delays or bad weather, the city plans to have the construction near the senior center finished within one week so the center can re-open Oct. 21.

If any changes in the re-opening date occur, the senior center will put the information on their answering machine as well as announce it through WRHL and the Rochelle News-Leader.

Making plans to achieve goals

ROCHELLE – The final Revved Up Rochelle meeting took place Tuesday night, and representatives from many different organizations in the state were there to help get things off the ground.

The main focus of the fifth and final Revved Up session was for representatives from the organizations to meet with each of the groups to begin helping them determine a plan to achieve their goals. The first half of the meeting was dedicated for each of the representatives to give a short presentation about their organization, their experience, and how they can help the community accomplish its goals.

Before the various presentations, mayor John Bearrows stood up in front of the room to give a thank you to everyone who took the time to attend each of the meetings.

“I just want to say on behalf of the city, we want to personally thank each and every one of you who have taken the time to attend each of the meetings. I know five nights, three hours a night is quite a commitment,” said Bearrows.

There were presentations from organizations such as the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Peace Corps programs and even local organization Rochelle Area Community Foundation.

One presentation in specific addressed the drop-in population in the region from 2010 to 2017 and what the community needs to provide for people to get them to move to Rochelle.

“You have to be able to provide the good quality of life resources to people who are coming to your town. So, parks, recreation, food and dining, everything that you would

associate with quality of life,” explained Daniel Payette, executive director of Blackhawk Hills Regional Council.

Payette also touched on the fact that Rochelle already has valuable transportation resources and benefits from two interstate highways and two major railroads intersecting in town.

Following the presentations, the groups then continued to plan out their goals, while the representatives walked around to each group answering questions and offering their input on how to achieve the goals.

Now that the Revved Up meetings are complete, it is up to each group to set up its own meeting time to begin working on the plans that they came up with.

A community-wide town hall meeting will be held in the near future to share the cities ideas and projects with the community to encourage more people to join in.

A national champion

THE City of Rochelle is home to many namesakes, but it is now also home to the best mandolin player in the nation. Local resident Wes Carr has been playing the mandolin since he was 13 years old. Recently, the 29-year-old competed in and won the Walnut Valley National Mandolin Championship that is held in Winfield, Kansas, each year. There is a 40-person limit for the contest, and each person plays two tunes for the preliminary round that judges then choose the top five to move on to the championship. Once in the championship each contestant gets to play two more tunes for the judges who then vote on the winner of the entire competition. Carr has competed in the contest before, but decided to try a different approach this year. “I ended up taking some more chances by

performing one bluegrass, two jazz pieces and a classical tune. It would have been safer to stick to bluegrass, but it paid off in the end,” said Carr. This was his first time winning the competition in the multiple years he has competed. At the competitions, there are events for eight different instruments such as the banjo and guitar, all of which are in the bluegrass genre. The top three players from all eight of the categories divide \$116,566 of trophies, instruments and cash. While Carr was confident in his abilities, he admitted he was a bit taken back when he found out he won the competition. “I signed up for mandolin because it was the day before the guitar, so I had put more thought into the guitar and was kind of using the mandolin as a warm up for the next day,” added Carr. “When I found out that I had won it was kind of surreal.”

“I actually approached it pretty casually,” he said. He was initially lured in by the thought that Rochelle would cut his commute from DeKalb, but Campbell said he came away from the interview very impressed by both then Superintendent Jamie Craven and principal Jason Harper, as well as the discipline and the facilities. When Scott first interviewed for the job, it was clear that he was highly qualified for the physics and chemistry positions. His background was unique,” science department chair David Oldenburg said. “Scott came to Rochelle with a lot of enthusiasm, willingness to put in long days, different perspectives, and new ideas. He earned the respect of his peers early in his time here. Scott has shown himself to strive for excellence as a teacher. He holds high standards for his students. With the high expectations, he also gives his students ample access to his assistance by spending many early mornings and after school hours to help them. Scott is always willing to assist his peers and has a positive impact on the teachers who work with him.” District 212 Superintendent Jason Harper has observed Campbell in the classroom. “As a National Board Certified Teacher, he utilizes best teaching practices on a daily basis. More importantly, Mr. Campbell is able to connect with students of all levels and backgrounds to help improve student achievement beyond what students thought was possible,” Harper said. “I think it is important to put into perspective what exactly the AP Physics course was for Mr. Campbell in my senior year when AP Physics was introduced at RTHS. It was an experiment of sorts that only happened because of Mr. Campbell’s extensive knowledge, background, and credentials,” 2017 RTHS grad Ben Chiavini said. “The AP Physics course did not and would not have existed without him. That meant that Mr. Campbell had to create the entire course from scratch, on his own, and format the class to meet the AP guidelines and trajectory that it needed to follow. This, however, was nothing new for him; he had already done the same thing for his Chemistry and AP Chemistry courses.” Chiavini, who is currently a chemistry major at the University of Illinois, said the course he took with Campbell at RTHS prepared him for his college-level work.

“AP Physics was also an unusual challenge because the Physics we were learning was calculus-based, and we were learning the very basics of calculus in our class with Mr. (Tim) Hill right alongside this class. To help us, Mr. Campbell taught the minimal amount of calculus we needed to know for the topics we covered in class,” Chiavini said. “The class itself gave me a greater understanding of derivatives (a calculus concept), taught me how to pick apart a problem and make it manageable and understandable, and made me more used to what college would be like.” “Those last two points are the most important. The ability to pick apart a large and complex problem and make it manageable is not only useful and necessary for college, but for life...if all taken at once, someone would go crazy and feel overwhelmed, but like a physics problem if all these issues are made smaller and more easily understandable, then they can be managed. This is what Mr. Campbell taught me in AP Physics. Almost every problem we did had many parts to it, many forces to calculate and weigh against each other, many energy and trajectory calculations. Even simply moving a box across a surface would fill up a page with work and calculations, and if taken all at once, it would be impossible, but Mr. Campbell taught us to split up the problem and identify its key parts,” Chiavini added. “AP Physics (and Mr. Campbell) prepared me for college. AP Physics was extremely difficult for the entire class, with most test averages being near the failing to low C range. For many of us, this was one of the first times that a class actually beat us down, and it taught us a great truth, especially for college: you cannot coast by in college without actually studying hard and working at a topic. We learned this by failing and because we failed we learned from our mistakes. For college students that didn’t have the luxury of having a hard teacher in high school, they are hit hard with crushing test grades. Mr. Campbell challenged me academically like I had never been challenged before.” “Mr. Campbell is the best physics teacher I’ve had, and I have had six different

physics professors at my school already (moving quickly through the curriculum). There was something about the way that he explained things that kept people paying attention, and in a physics class not filled with physics majors, that is exceptionally rare,” Matthew Malaker, a 2017 RTHS grad said. “Even in my physics classes now, there are plenty of people who aren’t as enraptured in the content as future non-STEM majors were in (Campbell’s) physics class. Mr. Campbell didn’t do demonstrations particularly often, but each one served an exact purpose that perfectly conveyed the idea he was trying to express, and this goes for both physics and chemistry.” Malaker is currently double majoring in physics and astrophysics at the Illinois Institute of Technology. “Another thing I remember Mr. Campbell for was that his classes — particularly AP physics, less so for chemistry — weren’t always the class on the label. By that, I mean that he planned to have several days when we discussed things other than physics, namely college experience, the future, etc. Those classes in particular were some of the most informative and view-forming classes I have ever been in,” Malaker said. “I remember listening to a podcast once. I believe it was “Startalk” with Neil DeGrasse Tyson, and he mentioned he had many physics teachers, but he had very few exceptional ones. He referenced one of his high school teachers, raving about how they were able to get students passionate about the content that they were learning and how that type of teacher was the best possible teacher in virtually every objective sense. I firmly believe that Mr. Campbell is that type of teacher.” If I didn’t care about his class, I wouldn’t have stayed for several hours every day for several weeks to refine my titration skills in honors chemistry. If I didn’t care about his class, I wouldn’t have wanted to be a TA for a semester in AP Chemistry. If I didn’t care about his class, I wouldn’t have spent six hours every day perfecting my end-of-the-year AP Chemistry experiment,” Malaker added. “Most importantly, if I didn’t care about what he was teaching, there is a significant chance that I would not be a physics major right now. I might

have found my way here some other way, but after taking Mr. Campbell’s class, I didn’t really have much of a choice in what I wanted to pursue. Every other option paled in comparison... I can guarantee that almost every student you ask will have great things to say about Mr. Campbell. To me, he was more of a mentor than a teacher.” Many of Campbell’s students feel he not only stimulates a college environment but also makes the classes engaging and rewarding. “Mr. Campbell excels at preparing students for their futures through coursework that simulates a college environment while also providing a tremendous student-teacher relationship that secondary education thrives on. Mr. Campbell cares about his students’ academic success and their extracurricular accomplishments,” 2018 RTHS grad and current biomedical engineering pre-med student Alex Harvey said. “He can often be observed discussing subject matter other than coursework. His class is engaging, helped by his outstanding personality and good humor, but also rewarding. Students learn much more than physics from Mr. Campbell.” Physics. Hensley will pursue a university degree in industrial engineering. He said, “Mr. Campbell is very good. He explains things in a way that makes it easier to understand and in addition, he offers advice when asked,” current RTHS senior Cole Hensley said. Hensley has had Campbell for honors chemistry, AP chemistry and now AP physics and plans to pursue a university degree in industrial engineering. “[And] he’s always here early and always makes time [for those that need extra help],” he added. So while he never worked in aeronautical engineering, Campbell shelved neither his education nor experience. He is a member of the DeKalb County Board serving on both the finance and health and human services committees and is a member of the DeKalb School District 428 Finance Committee. Campbell also says he’s honored to serve as the President of the Rochelle Township High School teacher’s association. He is currently a full-time doctoral student in education, and while he may consider moving into education administration, Campbell said he would be perfectly happy to retire as a teacher. Campbell will attend the fall meeting of the Illinois Society American Association of Physics Teachers Nov. 8 through 9 at Joliet Junior College to accept his award.

“Municode is a company we already work with to put our municipal ordinances online,” Bearrows said. “The company would build a website that takes and integrates the Municode ordinances we have into a website that [village trustees] could add to... The company would do agendas, minutes, schedules and calendars that would all integrate together... Getting the minutes onto our site is currently a chore because our site is broken.”

Bearrows said the \$4,600 in funding would allow Municode to build the new website and make it operational for the public. Additionally, Bearrows said the village will need to pay a \$1,500 fee each year for continued hosting and support from Municode. Several vil-

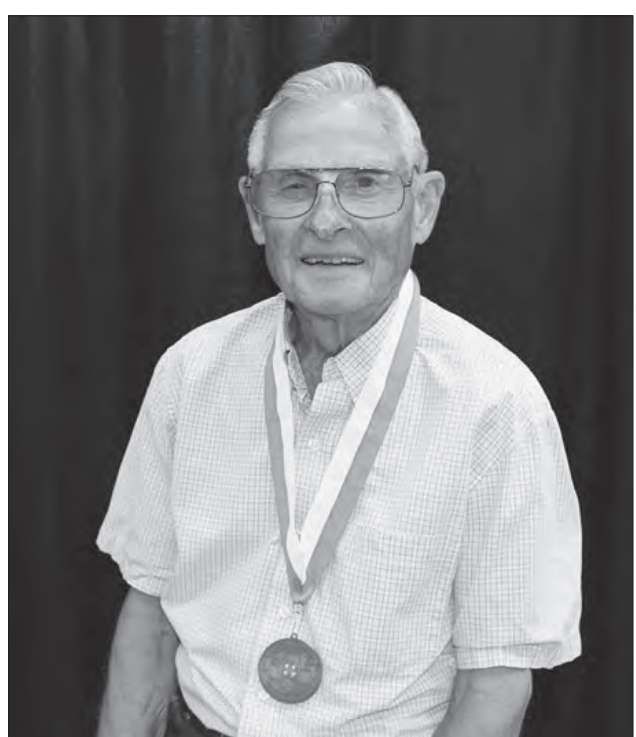

SHARING DURING A WAKE

When you have a “visitation” or “wake”, or what some refer to as “calling hours”, you permit family and friends to express their feelings about the deceased. This sharing experience can be important to you in your grief. When you are with others, you may find comfort and enlightenment. You can usually see the relaxation of the bereaved by the end of the wake.

You and others should be able to express your own emotions. At the same time, it is helpful for you to hear what the life of the deceased has meant to others, some of whom you may not even know. The visitation in the presence of the viewable body provides a proper setting and climate for these expressions.

There are some people who suggest other approaches or even elimination of this custom. In fact, some alternatives are totally lacking in those elements which experience and research have shown to be helpful to normal recovery from the loss a death creates.

Sewer lining work cause of smoke, odor inside business

ROCHELLE —Aldi was forced to evacuate the building and remain closed for multiple hours because of a fire scare on Wednesday afternoon. Reports of smoke coming from both the men's and women's restroom in Aldi forced the fire department to be called and the building to be evacuated. Along with the smoke, there was a strong chemical smell that was permeating throughout the building and carrying out to the parking lot.

After an investigation, it was determined that the cause of the smoke and the smell was the sewer lining work being done in the area by city crews.

kind of a lining in the sewer line then they use steam to harden the material. The problem is if all of the sewer traps don't have water in them, it allows those fumes to come up into your building and that is what happened in both of the bathrooms at Aldi," Rochelle fire chief David Sawlsville explained.

To help alleviate the smell, Aldi was forced to remain closed to customers and use fans to pull the air

from inside the store to the outside for several hours.

There were no injuries or any damage to the property as a result of the incident.

"We monitored the air and nothing was showing up as being dangerous, flammable or explosive. I talked to the local people and they explained to me that they are not dangerous, just obnoxious," added Sawlsville.

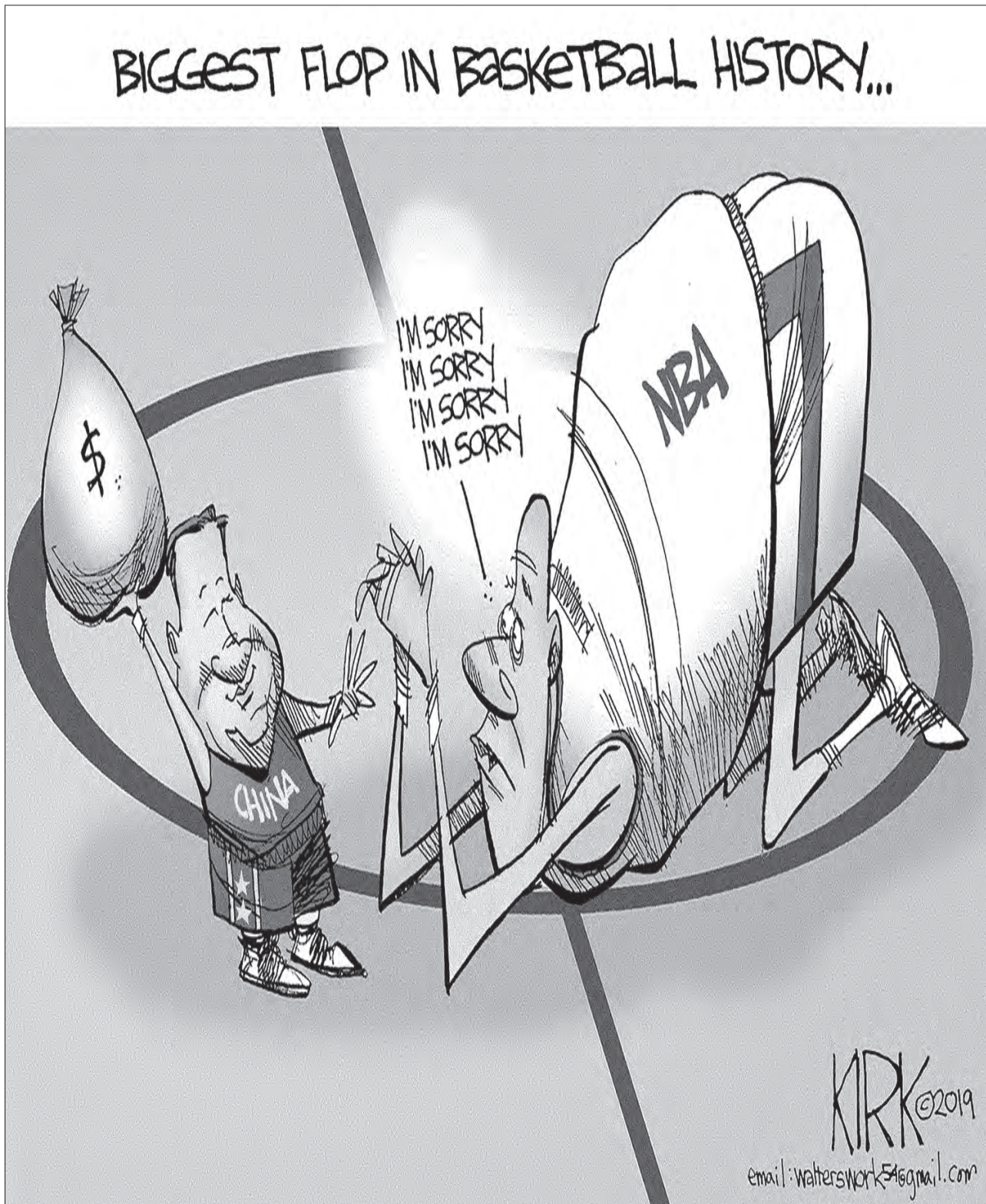

Lady Hubs fall to Kaneland

RTHS celebrates Volley for the Cure

ROCHELLE—After falling in a very competitive match against Sycamore on Tuesday, head coach Molly Sly was anxious to see how the Lady Hubs would bounce back when the Rochelle volleyball team hosted another tough conference opponent, Kaneland, on Thursday.

Wearing their pink uniforms in celebration of Volley for the Cure, the Lady Hubs kept with Kaneland for most of the opening set before the Knights pulled away with a strong start in the closing set to defeat Rochelle 25-19, 25-16 and drop the Lady Hubs to 17-14 overall. Senior Katie Van Hise led the team with eight kills, while junior Clare Green had 10 assists.

Junior Ellie Kinn recorded 11 digs on defense, with sophomore Zoey Tabor adding seven digs. Green also finished with seven digs including a brilliant save near the end of the second set.

“Clare made a fantastic save for us,” Sly said. “She comes out ready to play every single game and I love her spark and her fire. She wants to win and I love her desire to go out and get it every single game.”

Rochelle tipped off the match with the first two points before Kaneland strung seven straight points together to lead 7-2. The Lady Hubs fired back with a 7-2 run of their

own to even the set 9-9 and both teams split the next 10 points to remain deadlocked halfway into the set. But the Knights rallied off three consecutive points to go ahead 17-14 and force a Rochelle timeout.

The 3-point burst was part of an 8-2 Kaneland run that put the Knights ahead 22-16 before both squads split the final six points of the set. Another slow start hurt the Lady Hubs in the second set, as defensive errors allowed the Knights to start up 10-3 and eventually pull ahead 19-8. Rochelle fought back briefly, stringing a 7-3 run together to keep Kaneland slightly on its heels before the Knights closed the match by winning three points in a row.

“We can’t wait until the other team has point No. 24 before we start running balls down,” Sly said. “We need to read the ball... We had a lot of touches at the net and I thought we read where they were going to hit the ball pretty well. I’m looking for us to finish the season with a couple of wins and to finish on a win before entering the regional.”

Rochelle received the No. 4 seed in the IHSA Class 3A Regional at RTHS beginning the week of Oct. 28. The Lady Hubs will continue conference play against LaSalle-Peru and Morris next week before finishing the regular season with matches against Ottawa and Plano the following week.

Soph harrier Johnson up next for Lady Hubs

THE Rochelle girls cross country team has seen its leadership torch passed down a few times over the last three years. From former Lady Hub standout and perennial medalist Katherine Bakken to current senior Britney Baez, there has always been a runner ready to take the next step and lead the cross country program.

It's looking like Lady Hub sophomore Sara Johnson will be handling the torch pretty soon. The younger sister of former Rochelle student-athlete and state track qualifier Levi Johnson, Sara has pieced together an excellent second season with the Lady Hubs, earning awards in five consecutive meets dating back to the Eddington Invitational at Kaneland on Sept. 21.

"Katherine and Britney have taught me to keep pushing myself and continue getting better," Johnson said. "They taught me how we can work as a team and that's really important for us. It's an individual sport but we're still part of a team and we need to work together. It's cool that I'll get to be the next person to lead our team."

Johnson's most recent achievement was finishing fifth out of nearly 100 runners in the 3-mile junior varsity race at the Freeport Invitational on Oct. 5. She recorded her top time this season during the First to the Finish Invitational in Peoria (22:03.4) and she made her personal record with Rochelle during the 2018 season, when she ran a time of 21:47.2 in the IHSA Class 2A Belvidere North Regional at Spencer Park.

"The season has gone pretty well and we've been developing over the course of the season," Johnson said. "Our team has improved a lot... Britney and I have decreased our times and our practices have improved too. We've increased our distances. I've done better this year and I'm faster now than where I was at this point last season."

Johnson entered Rochelle Township High School with no cross country experience, but she said former head coach John Dobbs motivated her to participate with the program. Johnson, who also competes in the 800-meter run and the 300-meter hurdles with the track and field team, was also inspired by her older brother Levi, who ran cross country his senior season.

"I like running and I enjoy the team aspect of the sport," Johnson said. "Levi has been my biggest role model and he's taught me not to stop and to continue getting better

at what I'm working for. He taught me to always give 110 percent."

Johnson has raced in both varsity and open competitions throughout her sophomore season. She took ninth place out of almost 70 runners in the annual Rochelle Invitational, where racers have the opportunity to run through Skare Park and get a little dirty while doing so. The event, also known as the Mud Run, has become an early favorite for Johnson, who admitted she went through the creek during the meet last season.

"We have so much fun at practices and we've made great memories," Johnson said. "Running the course at Skare Park is really fun and going into the creek last season was a really cool experience."
