Colts get \$10,000 grant

Creston School recipient of America's Farmers funding

CRESTON —Creston School officials held a ceremony in their gymnasium Friday morning to celebrate a \$10,000 grant the district received from the America's Farmers Grow Rural Education Program, sponsored by the Bayer Fund.

In order to receive the grant, local farmers must nominate the school district they would like to see receive the funds. The district then fills out an application for the grant and turns it into Bayer. The program then decides which school districts will receive funds and how much.

Creston School leaders have applied for this grant multiple times in the past, but never received more than a few hundred dollars.

"We have filled this out for a number of years and

have received a few dollars here and a few dollars there. This year we got an email saying that we received \$10,000, and we thought we didn't read that right,

so we read it over a couple of times," joked Curt Rheingan, superintendent of the district.

Rheingan said the school district is planning

on using the funds to expand its STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) program. Some of the items they plan to use the funds on are purchas-

ing new equipment that is grade level specific, such as programmable mice that students enter the distance and direction they travel through a track they created.

Creston School District had been nominated by two local families. This grant helps give the school the means to expand their quality education program titled "Tinkering and Thinking Mobile Stem Parts."

"This means that we are able to enhance and get more hands-on activities, so we can continue to provide our students with great education," explained Rheingan. "I just think it is great and thank the Bayer Foundation, I don't think they know how much it is going to impact our kids, the teachers, the students, the farmers who nominated us. Just a big thank you to everyone who was involved."

A shining light

ROCHELLE — The City of Rochelle dedicated its first new street light to honor a local resident and his family as part of the new Shining Light Program.

City officials, local resident Archie Millotte and his family members all gathered in the rain around the street light in front of Kennay Farms Distillery Wednesday afternoon for the first dedication of the program.

Any individual or group interested in dedicating a plaque can do so by going to city hall and purchasing one for \$1,000. The designated recipients' names will be engraved on a metal

plaque and attached to the light pole for everyone to see.

Street lights can be dedicated to either a person, a family, an organization or a business.

"If people want to do it in memory of someone, with their family name or a local organization, they could do that," said Jenny Thompson, director of marketing, public relations and tourism.

There are many different people and organizations helping spearhead the program, including the mayor, city manager, Rochelle Municipal Utilities staff and Kim Montgomery from the Rochelle Area Community Foundation.

While many there are many people

involved, the idea was created by mayor John Bearrows as a way to both honor local residents while also helping fund future projects.

"This is an opportunity for residents to do something in honor or in memory of someone or something that they care about," explained Bearrows. "The whole project, with the donation being made to the city helps fund some more of these LED lights and light poles."

Millotte said that it is an honor to have his name permanently displayed downtown.

"This is an honor; my family has a lot of history. My mother and father both owned businesses down here and so did my grandparents," added Millotte.

Village talks solar panels

CRESTON — During their monthly board meeting on Tuesday night, Creston Village Board trustees discussed creating a solar panel ordinance for the village.

There currently is not one in place and one resident has been looking into installing panels at his residence.

"What we are looking for is to get something in line like other communities such as Rochelle and Malta. We are trying to adopt an ordinance so we can control where people put them," said Wayne Williams, Creston village president.

The resident has been doing research and already has a permit, so the village is going to allow them to put the solar panels on top of his garage and some on the ground.

Ranking strategies, creating teams

ROCHELLE – The second to last Revved Up Rochelle meeting was held Tuesday night and the focus this week was ranking strategies by importance and creating teams to begin working to achieve these community goals.

When attendees arrived at the meeting instead of being assigned a specific table as usual, they chose from six tables to sit at, each labeled with one of the community goals. Residents were told to sit at a table with the specific goal they would like to work on for the next few weeks.

Leaders handed out seven secrets to coping with change in small towns, which was compiled by Milan Wall and Vickie Luther from the Heartland Center for Leadership Development.

Some of the items on the list included having a bias for action, only focusing on the aspects that are controllable such as keeping a good attitude.

“The research demonstrates that leadership is more important than location and community attitude is more important than community size,” said Gisele Hamm, program manager.

Mapping program leaders have seen firsthand just how important

ant attitude can be in creating a successful transformation.

Residents voted on which strategies for achieving each of the six goals were most important to the community, and each person was given a clicker that was connected to the leader's computer on the screen.

The strategies were projected on the screen and attendees ranked each of them from least

to most important. This was done for each of the goals to get a feel as to which strategies the community thought were most crucial to complete.

These strategies included building a youth center, developing events/entertainment that promote retail and dining businesses and creating a business and retention program.

One strategy that ranked low, but may be

one of the most crucial for the success of this program was to develop a volunteer recruitment and management program.

“None of this is going to happen unless we have a dedicated group of volunteers, so that 4.9 rating should be a 7.0. you can't count on the city employees to do all of this, we need a dedicated group of volunteers,” explained

Jeff Fiegenschuh, city manager.

Following the voting, action teams worked on completing their goals. Each person had the choice to sign up for as many or as few goals as they desire and the teams began brainstorming ways to achieve the goals, assign positions to team members and determine where and when they would be meeting to begin working.

During this time, groups were asked to come up with a quick “win” (something that could be achieved in a month or less) and a short-

term goal (something that could be achieved in a year or less). One quick win the retail and dining group came up with was creating a map of all of the unoccupied business spaces in town including 3-D images, so that future businesses could view the location online before making a personal visit.

For its short-term goal, the retail and dining group thought that it was important for businesses to extend their hours to be open during prime shopping times such as evenings and Sundays.

“We are starting to hear some of that feedback as people are coming from out of town, it is that Saturday afternoon and Sundays when they come in and say, nothing else is open, what do we do,” explained Doris Kennay, co-owner of Kennay Farms Distillery.

Representatives from organizations such as IDOT or the USDA will be attending the final Revved Up Rochelle meeting next week to help the teams plan for their goals. So, the leaders are asking the teams to have some ideas written down and so they have something ready to show the representatives next week.

“Please have some ideas flushed out, so we don't hear crickets when the resource people are here next week and they ask what are you working on, because we are here to help,” added Hamm.

The final meeting will be held next Tuesday in Hicks Hall from 6 to 9 p.m., located at 709 4th Avenue, Rochelle.

Staying the course

Finfrock not eyeing changes as chairman

OREGON — After spending a number of years as a vice chairman of the Ogle County Board, John Finfrock had learned a lot about how the county operates.

That will serve him well as Finfrock is now chairman of the Board after the sudden death of former Chairman Kim Gouker.

“There was some trepidation there because this wasn’t in the script,” Finfrock said of being elected chairman at the County Board’s Sept. 17 meeting.

Finfrock, who is retired from Kable News Co. and lives in Mount Morris, was first elected to the Board in 2010. He had served as vice chairman since 2012, when Gouker asked him to fill the role. He said he told Gouker he would do it, as long as it was understood that if asked his opinion, he would certainly give it.

“We didn’t always agree, but we always worked something out,” Finfrock said of Gouker.

Finfrock said Gouker’s death was “unbelievable.” He said that when Gouker did not show up for county meetings on consecutive days, they knew something was wrong. Gouker was found dead at his Byron home during a wellness check on Sept. 10.

Finfrock admitted that he will have big shoes to fill following Gouker as chairman. But he said he is confident.

“Basically, the board’s

in good shape,” he said. “The county’s in good shape. We’ve got probably the best group of board members that I’ve been around since I came on the board.”

Another plus is that the county has a strong group of department heads, and that they all work well together.

“We all debate, and we all have our own ideas,” Finfrock said. “But when there’s a vote, the vote is it and you move on from there.”

He said that he plans to stay “on the course that is charted.” He said there may be some little differences in leadership, “but the objective is still the same.”

First, the focus is on getting the new Judicial Annex completed, which was a priority for Gouker.

He said the county is also facing issue like solar power and the question of how to handle legal cannabis.

But he main focus for now is keeping the county moving forward.

“I’d like to see the cohesiveness of the board itself stay where it is, because we’ve got a lot of cohesion there and a lot of people are engaged,” Finfrock said. “I’m not going to try to change much. Everything’s working well right now.”

As he settles into his new role, Finfrock said fellow Board members and county department heads have approached him to ask how they can help.

“And that is a boost you can’t believe,” he said. “But that’s the kind of people they are.”

County accepting applications for vacant board seat


OREGON — Ogle County is accepting applications to fill the board seat left open with the death of Kim Gouker on Sept. 10.

Museum demonstrates new research Rochelle station

ROCHELLE — The Flagg Township Museum has established a new research station at the museum, "Research Rochelle," that was officially dedicated on Sunday, Sept. 22 at a reception and demonstration.

Thanks to the donation of the collection of bound newspapers from John Shank at the Rochelle News-Leader, many dedicated hours by volunteer Tom McDermott, and funding from the Rochelle Area Community Foundation the museum was able to establish this new computer station.

Museum historian McDermott, who has been responsible for the extensive digitization of information scanned



from the bound volumes of newspapers and the museum's collection of historic photos and archival information led the demonstration for those who attended the event. The museum is pleased to be able to offer this dedicated space to anyone who

would like to research through the museum's digital collection or do genealogical research using Ancestry.com, newspapers.com or fold3.com, the avenue for searching historic military records, along with links to other sources. While no collection is ever complete, updates are constantly being made and more information added.

Thanks to library directory Sarah Flanagan the bound newspaper volumes are now at home at the Flagg-Rochelle Public Library in their newly established storage space made especially for the many volumes. While the oldest volumes are too fragile to allow reading, many can be accessed and perused under supervision by the library staff. An open house will be held at the library on Sunday, Oct. 13 from 1 to 3 p.m.

The Flagg Township Museum is a non-profit museum dedicated to stimulating interest in Flagg Township history through education, research, collection and preservation of historic information.

During the meeting, it was announced the village had come to an agreement with Petry Farms on a rental contract for farm land owned by the community. The agreement is for two years, with a third-year option at \$300 an acre. It is also included in the contract that Petry Farms facilitates getting bids on some tile work that needs to be completed on the land. Petry Farms and the village will then split the tiling work costs evenly.

Bill questioned

Another topic of discussion during the meeting was over a monthly bill from Rochelle Municipal Utilities that was much higher than typical invoices.

The bill is usually between \$5,000-\$6,000, but this month the bill was for \$34,000. The village thinks this could have something to do with the number of old sewers that causes groundwater to

leak into the system during time with large amounts of rain.

"We have had a lot of problems with our sewer. A lot of the manholes are leaking by the pipe and we are getting groundwater into the sewer system," explained Williams.

They have already had a lot of those manholes rerouted to stop that, but it continues to be a problem whenever the city experiences heavy rainfall. In an effort to help fix this problem and avoid high bills like this in the future, the city is having the grouting people to come back and identify at least 10 to 12 more manholes that need regrouting.

The city's agreement with NICOR Gas was also renewed for another 10 to 15 years before being renewed again. This was the first time in 25 years that the agreement was renewed.

It was determined during the meeting that trick or treating hours on Halloween for the village of Creston will be from 5 to 8 p.m.

NEXT Tuesday marks the 148th anniversary of one of the worst fires in our nation's history. More than 1,500 dead, many burned beyond identification, houses destroyed, entire communities

swallowed up in what has been described as a fire tornado. But in history, timing is everything.

The Great Peshtigo Fire does not have the same name recognition as the Great Chicago Fire. They both started Oct. 8, 1871. Coincidentally, it was the same day as the Port Huron fire and fires in Holland and Manistee, Michigan.

A hot, dry summer, wooden buildings, and a flash point triggered the fires on the same day.

Mrs. O'Leary's cow usually gets blamed for the Chicago blaze, but more likely it was a carelessly discarded cigarette or cigar, possibly by a neighborhood drunk trying to sleep it off.

Railroad crews or logging crews are often blamed for the Peshtigo and Michigan fires. Some have hypothesized that a comet was breaking up, and fiery pieces landed throughout the Midwest, causing the fires. I like that theory, despite all the drawbacks that go with it.

Fire Prevention Week in Illinois includes the Oct. 8 date as the start of the Chicago Fire. It is a good time to check your smoke detectors and

replace the batteries. We often think we are safe from these major fires, but then a Paradise, California, blaze reminds us that we can't control nature or fire. But we can prevent it in many cases.



NATIONAL Domestic Violence AWARENESS MONTH

What is domestic abuse?

DOMESTIC abuse is a pattern of abusive controlling behaviors that often escalate from threats and verbal abuse to violence. While physical

injury may be the most obvious danger, the emotional and psychological consequences of domestic abuse are also severe.

Abusive partners and family members victim-

ize others to gain control over them. Most research shows that the longer one stays in an abusive relationship the more frequent and violent the abuse can become.

Forms of Abuse

Physical abuse —

Physical abuse is a powerful way in which an abusive person gets and keeps their partner under control and it instills an environment of constant fear. While physical abuse is the form of abuse that is most commonly known, it may or may not be a part of an abusive relationship. If physical abuse is present early in the relationship, it commonly gets worse over time. If there is no physical abuse in the relationship, it may begin to occur when the victim is pregnant or when the victim is considering leaving the relationship.

Physical violence may include: hitting, punching, kicking, slapping, strangling, smothering, using or threatening to use weapons, shoving, interrupting your sleep, throwing things, destroying property, hurting or

killing pets, and denying medical treatment.

Sexual Abuse—Some form of sexual abuse is common in abusive relationships but it is often the least discussed. It can be subtle or overt. The impact on the victim is commonly feelings of shame and humiliation.

Sexual abuse may include: physically forcing sex, making you feel fearful about saying no to sex, forcing sex with other partners, forcing you to participate in demeaning or degrading sexual acts, violence or name

calling during sex, and denying contraception or protection from sexually transmitted diseases.

Emotional Abuse — Emotional abuse occurs in some form in all abusive relationships. It is a very effective tactic used by abusive partners to obtain power and control and it can cause extreme damage to the victim's self-esteem. Commonly, emotional abuse makes the victim feel like they are responsible for the abuse and to feel crazy, worthless and hopeless. It is so damaging that many survivors of

domestic violence report that they would have rather "be hit" than endure the ongoing psychic damage of emotional abuse.

Emotional abuse can include: constant put downs or criticisms, name calling, "crazy making", acting superior, minimizing the abuse or blaming you for their behavior, threatening and making you feel fearful, isolating you from family and friends, excessive jealousy, accusing you of having affairs, and watching where you go and who you talk to.

Financial Abuse —

This form of abuse is one of the least commonly known but one of the most powerful tactic of entrapping a victims in the relationship. It is so powerful that many victims of abuse describe it as the main reason that they stayed in an abusive relationship or went back to one.

Some forms of financial abuse include: giving you an allowance, not letting you have your own money, hiding family assets, running up debt, interfering with your job, and ruining your credit.

There is HOPE

HOPE of Ogle County's mission is to advocate on behalf of domestic violence victims and their children in a welcoming environment. Our caring professionals provide safety planning, support, shelter, and referrals while empowering survivors to build a safe and peaceful future.

In 1982, after the Illinois Domestic Violence Act was passed, a minister and a police officer who identified the need to protect families from domestic violence inaugurated HOPE through volunteer efforts.

In 1984, the organization increased the scope of client centered services substantially to ultimately include a 24 hour crisis intervention facility and domestic abuse shelter, 24 hour direct response hotline, counseling to victims and their children, advocacy and referrals, support group counseling, transportation, public education, professional training, prevention education in the schools, Latina advocacy and transitional housing.

In 2010, through the efforts of dedicated board members, HOPE opened Hope Chest, Twice Loved Boutique. This beautiful thrift store has helped HOPE of Ogle County maintain the level of funding it needs to best serve domestic violence victims and their children.

24 Hour Crisis Line, Safety Planning and Referrals

Those experiencing domestic abuse can contact HOPE of Ogle

County 7 days a week/24 hours a day. This service is available in most languages. Domestic violence advocates are there to listen, offer support and provide information on ways to increase personal safety. Advocates provide information about victim's rights and about local services that may also be of help.

Emergency Shelter

HOPE provides temporary emergency shelter for adults and their minor children who are experiencing domestic abuse. Safety, shelter, support and goal related services are provided to help individuals make their own choices about the next steps to take. Transitional housing is also available by application to families who access our emergency shelter. In addition, a local provider offers temporary shelter to family pets whose owners are staying at the HOPE shelter. They are a boarding and grooming facility that generously assist those who need a safe place for their pets.

Individual Counseling

Adult and child counseling services are provided by appointment. Women and men who are experiencing or have experienced domestic abuse are welcome to contact HOPE to set an appointment with one of our supportive counselors. Teens involved in abusive relationships can also be provided individual support and counseling. Children of adult clients are offered child centered counseling to help them with the effects of witnessing or experi-

encing abuse. Family counseling for the non-abusive caregiver and child is also available. Appointments are available in Rochelle, Oregon and Polo.

Support Groups

Weekly support groups are available for adults and their children.

Public Education

HOPE staff provide public education to local schools, colleges, service organizations, and businesses. Topics covered are: the warning signs of abusive relationships, dating violence, domestic violence, how the community can help, Safe Dates curriculum and HOPE of Ogle County services.

Court Advocacy

Court advocates are available to assist those experiencing domestic violence, in obtaining court Orders of Protection in Ogle County. Court advocates provide support and guidance to assist victims through the court process and can provide referrals for legal assistance.

Latina Advocacy

HOPE services are offered in Spanish and the HOPE Latina Advocate can meet with Spanish speaking clients to talk about their rights, resources, options, and provide support.

Hubs hang tough

Five players score as Rochelle takes must-win game over Sandwich 42-28

SANDWICH — Friday was a must-win scenario for the Rochelle football team, and the Hubs responded by putting together their best offensive performance of the season against the Sandwich Indians in conference play.
Five offensive players scored touchdowns including senior Gavin Ansteth, who led the rushing attack with 105 yards and two scores as the Hubs defeated Sandwich 42-28 to reach 2-4 on the season and keep their postseason dreams alive. Junior Ben Harvey compiled a team-high 112 rushing yards, and Rochelle finished with 399 total yards in the victory.
“We knew what the stakes were,” senior Austin Greifenkamp said. “We needed to beat Sandwich... We worked hard all week and we got the job done. We have a lot of guys who can play multiple

positions and we were able to stick together and get our work done.”
Senior linebacker Nick Albers stopped Sandwich running back James Coleman short on a fourth-and-3 rushing attempt to give Rochelle the football toward the end of the first quarter. The Hubs turned the possession into points with a 73-yard scoring drive culminating in a 5-yard rushing touchdown by Greifenkamp.
A tipped pass from Sandwich quarterback Jack Theurer led to an interception by Ansteth on the ensuing Indians drive. Harvey sprung a 29-yard rush off the left side on the first play after the turnover before running the following play 3 yards into the end zone. Trailing 14-0, Coleman brought Sandwich back with a 73-yard rushing touchdown on an end-around play.
The Indians struggled to contain the Rochelle offense throughout the first half, and their woes

continued after the Hubs pieced together a 14-play, 80-yard touchdown drive in the second quarter. Ansteth found the end zone on a 4-yard rush to make it a 21-7 game, and the score remained the same entering halftime.
Sandwich attempted to swing momentum with an onside kick attempt to open the third quarter, but Rochelle junior Ethan Albers was all over the football on the recovery. The failed attempt resulted in a 10-play, 60-yard scoring drive from the Hubs, with Ansteth running for a 1-yard touchdown to put Rochelle ahead 28-7.

ROCHELLE, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
JULY 1, 2019 TO JUNE 30, 2020**

The following constitutes the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the FLAGG-ROCHELLE PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, Ogle County, Rochelle, Illinois for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020, presented to the Board of Trustees of the District and proposed to be adopted by said Board of Library Trustees after a public hearing:

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Budget Law, 50 ILCS 330/1, et seq, as amended requires all Illinois Municipal Corporations as broadly defined therein, to adopt a combined Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, specifying the objects and purposes of expenditures; and the Illinois Public Library District Act 75 ILCS 16/1-10 and 75 ILCS 16/30-85, provides procedures for the passage of a Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and a Tax Levy Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above and other appropriate statutes, a Budget and Appropriation Ordinance has been prepared in tentative form at the designation of this Board, and has been made available for the public inspection at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereon, and a public hearing on said Budget and Appropriation Ordinance has been held prior to final action hereon, and notice of said hearing was published on August 7, 2019, being more than thirty (30) days prior to said hearing, in a newspaper published within the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Library Trustees of the FLAGG-ROCHELLE PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, Rochelle Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The following budget containing a statement of cash on hand at the beginning of the fiscal year, an estimate of all cash receipts of said Library District to be received during such fiscal year from all sources, the estimated expenditures contemplated for such fiscal year and a statement of the estimated cash on hand at the end of such fiscal year, be and the same is hereby adopted as the Budget for said Library District for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020, and the same sums are hereby appropriated as necessary to defray the said expenses and liabilities of this Public Library District, for the objects and purposes and in the estimated amounts as indicated, for said fiscal year:

SECTION 4: That each appropriated fund total shall be divided among the several objects and purposes specified, and in the particular amounts stated for each fund respectively in Section 1, constituting the total appropriations in the amount of Seven Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Seven and 55/100 (\$751,707.55) Dollars for the fiscal year July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020.

SECTION 5: That Section 2 shall be and is a summary of the annual Appropriation Ordinance of this Library District, passed by the Board of Trustees as required by law and shall be in full force and effect from and after this date.

SECTION 6: That a certified copy of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk within thirty (30) days after adoption.



HUB SPOTLIGHT

Hub senior Louis building on offseason running title

AS an eighth-grader, cross country standout Tucker Louis noticed someone riding a bicycle alongside him while he was competing in the annual Rochelle Middle School Color Run.

That person was former Rochelle Township High School head cross country coach John Dobbs, who told Louis after he won the Color Run that he needed to sign up for the high school program. Four years later, Louis has become one of the RTHS cross country team's fastest runners, and the senior Hub wants to finish his final season with a few more accolades.

"I feel like this season has gone really well," Louis said. "I think I've improved a lot. My freshman year, I was really slow and I didn't have much consistency. I've been able to decrease my time and get faster over the years... I want to break the 17-minute mark because that could get me close to making the state meet. I also want our team to make it past sectionals, and I think we can do that because we have a really good team this year."

Louis and the Hubs recently turned in their best team performance of the season, earning the fourth-place trophy at Genoa-Kingston's Matt Walter Invitational. A four-year cross country and track athlete at RTHS, Louis is part of a core group of runners who were often raced up on varsity as underclassmen. Louis was a sophomore when the Rochelle boys placed second in the Freeport Invitational, an achievement he said was one of his favorites since joining the team.

"I think that really pushed us," Louis said. "I was running 20 and 21-minute races my freshman year but my teammates and I were able to decrease our times by about 2-to-3 minutes because we were always running with faster people. Those races really pushed us forward."

Louis broke the 18-minute mark for the first time at last season's Matt Walter Invitational. The senior, who said he wants to study computer programming after high school, has formed a strong bond with his teammates. That bond was shown over the summer, when Louis and his teammates trained by running from Rochelle to Creston and even Malta.

"Santi [Cordoba] has helped me improve the most," Louis said. "We've stuck together since we were freshmen and we've kept almost the same times... Our coaches have always pushed miles over the summer, but I hadn't really done that until this year. I wanted to excel this year, so I set a goal to run 300 miles and I beat that. Santi, Aiden [Seldal] and I ran

to Creston over the first week of summer, and we continued running further east to see how far we could get."

Louis was one of two Rochelle cross country runners recognized with the program's first-ever Summer Running Champion award. Named co-champion alongside senior Britney Baez, Louis ran more miles than any other boy on the team in preparation for his senior season. The cross country season will help Louis stay in shape for track, where he competes in the 800-meter run, the 1600-meter run and the 3200-meter relay for his former cross country coach Dobbs.

"I want to push myself in the 800," Louis said. "My goal last season was to break the 5-minute mark in the mile... I really want to break the 2-minute mark in the 800 or run around that time. Coach Dobbs and coach [Mark] Zilis always worked together to create workouts, and coach Zilis has continued that this year."
