Rowe "Returning the Favor"

TV personality Mike Rowe's visit to Rochelle's Kitchen Table to air July 22

ROCHELLE — When many people hear the name Mike Rowe they might first think of the celebrity's hit television show *Dirty Jobs*, where he travels across the country and demonstrates the most disgusting jobs people do for a living.

But Rowe might now be better known to Rochelle area residents for his generous donation to Rochelle's very own The Kitchen Table, operated by Carolyn and Grant Brown and other volunteer board members.

Rowe produces a new internet series titled "Returning the Favor," in which he searches for stories of organizations and people who put others in the community before themselves.

ganization The Kitchen Table was selected a few months ago to be featured on an upcoming episode in the fourth

season of the series which will air on July 22 through Facebook Watch.

"The Kitchen Table re-

cently received both the attention and a \$50,000 donation from celebrity Mike Rowe as a part of his new internet stream-

ing series," said Mark Schwendau, kitchen table board member, in a press release.

Lois Piller a board member of The Kitchen Table nominated the organization and the Browns to be featured on the show without anyone else's knowledge. In early March, a crew was sent from the show to interview diners and board members without anyone knowing why they were doing so. Following the interviews, the next step was to send Rowe and his crew to officially film the episode and lend a hand.

"On March 21, Rowe brought his film crew to shoot a new episode of his show, he interviewed the Browns and even pitched in by helping work at The Kitchen Table," added Schwendau.

Big Boy train to stop in Rochelle

ROCHELLE — Rail fans both locally and across the country are excited as the Union Pacific celebrates the 150th anniversary of the completion of the transcontinental railroad with a cross-country tour for one of its original steam engines.

Big Boy No. 4014 is one of 25 original Big Boy steam engines that were built exclusively for the Union Pacific Railroad. The steam engine will be making a transcontinental tour and plans to stop at the Rochelle Railroad Park on Tuesday July 30, between 9:45 and 10:30 a.m.

These old steam-powered engines are much larger than the newer diesel-powered locomotives used today, and according to the Union Pacific website the Big Boy locomotives are 132 feet long, weigh 1.2 million pounds and have hinged frames to allow such a long engine to negotiate curves in the tracks.





These engines are supported by 14 wheels arranged in a 4-8-8-4 pattern and carry a total of 56,000 pounds of coal used as the trains power supply.

Engine No. 4014 that will be stopping in Rochelle was originally delivered to Union Pacific in December of 1941 and was retired in December of 1961. The Union Pacific website states that in the

locomotives 20 years of service it traveled a total of 1,031,205 miles.

Since 2013 the Big boy engine No. 4014 was on display at the RailGiants Museum in Pomona, California and then was relocated to Cheyenne, Wyoming, for a multi-year restoration process.

Since the completion of the restoration process, Big Boy No. 4014 is the world's only operating Big Boy locomotive.

"The Big Boy's return to the rails is the product of more than two years of meticulous restoration work by the Union Pacific Steam Team," said Jenny Thompson, City of Rochelle director of marketing and tourism.

Creston officials talk residential solar panels

CRESTON – During their monthly meeting on Tuesday, Village of Creston Trustees discussed creating and ordinance that residence would have to abide by if wanting to install solar panels on their homes.

The board heard a presentation from Reid Elliot, a local resident

who plans to install solar panels on the roof of his garage and one on the ground. The village does not currently have an ordinance for installing solar panels, but plans to look into surrounding county towns that already have solar ordinances.

Village board president Wayne Williams said he believes the board supports the project, but

guidelines need to be put in place.

"Everybody has to abide by the rules and if you don't have any rules it is a free for all, and I don't want that," said Williams.

The board also approved the 2020 fiscal year appropriation Tuesday night. The total is less than previous years due to several projects being completed and no

longer in the budget.

"We are still in the black and we plan on keeping it that way," Williams added.

The sanitary sewer contract with Rochelle Municipal Utilities was also approved on Tuesday. The contract covers maintenance RMU provides to Creston's lift station and has been in place for many years. It was last updated in 2011.

Other business

The board is searching for a new building inspector after the previous one from Rochelle resigned.

The board also voted to pay for a water main leak that occurred at a residence just after hydrant flushing had been completed. The trustees approved payment for the leak after determining that it could have been caused by the work being

done on the hydrant.

"It was discussed that it could have been a problem with slamming the hydrant shut when doing a flow test," explained Williams.

Village staff is also continuing with the grouting of leaking manholes that was discussed at last month's meeting. Seven have been completed so far based on need.

While the help from Rowe and being featured on the show will likely bring awareness to the organization, it is the \$50,000 donation that will help the café serve the most people possible.

“Rowe’s \$50,000 donation will be used toward an expansion project to build a new dining hall at the community café, located at 7034 Klondike Road,” explained Schwendau.

The Browns, who reside in Ashton, envisioned a restaurant such as The Kitchen Table years before they eventually purchased the property in 2013 and opened for business in 2016. The café serves about 10 meals a month where diners are asked to pay what they can afford. Those who are unable to pay are offered the opportunity to volunteer their time in exchange for their meal.

The café remains operational thanks to individuals who dine and then pay it forward along with donations

Rockford man arrested for possession

IL Route 251 resurfacing expected to begin Tuesday

ROCHELLE — The Illinois Department of Transportation announced Wednesday that weather permitting, construction work on IL Route 251 from Lakeview Drive to Veterans Parkway in Rochelle will begin on Tuesday, July 9.

Martin & Co. Excavating will be starting the \$390,000 project to patch and resurface the roadway.

Daily lane closures with flaggers will be utilized. Drivers should be prepared to stop for flaggers who will be directing traffic through the work areas. The project is expected to be completed within six weeks.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and



signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert

As per our founder Carolyn Brown's vision, the Kitchen Table, Incorporated, is 100 percent volunteer operated. Nobody gets a dime from being involved with the Kitchen Table.

It is not a "soup kitchen." I cannot recall us ever serving soup... though we have had chili now and again when the weather was right for it.

We are not out to compete with local restaurants. We only serve about 10 meals per month and we can only seat 36 at a time as of now.

It is not a dining establishment just for the poor. Rich and poor alike come to dine together in community and those who have much pay a little extra for those who have less and nobody needs to know or care who-is-who... just as God intended us to live.

I would like to conclude by saying if you have yet to dine at the Kitchen Table, you are missing out on a pretty amazing current trend and Carolyn Brown is an outstanding cook to boot.

Also, if you have a longing to volunteer and serve others, the Kitchen Table offers outstanding experiences to serve others in a food service setting. It is a great opportunity for church, civic and youth groups.

Juniors sharpen skills at youth summer camp

Future Lady Hubs practice basics

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Township High School volleyball players and coaches were front and center this past week, when they had the chance to work with grade-schoolers and middle-schoolers during the program's annual youth summer camp June 24-27.

The four-day camp took place at the RTHS main gymnasium from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m.

"It's really fun seeing the fifth and sixth-graders we've had over the last few years grow into their seventh and eighth-grade years," head coach Molly Sly said. "It's fun seeing their skills at the eighth-grade level improve as they become ninth-graders at the high school level. It's

amazing how the girls can improve in four years and they get so much better."

The camp helps beginning and experienced volleyball players learn fundamental skills including blocking, serving, setting, hitting, digging and passing.

Advanced campers spent more time learning offensive and defensive strategies as they prepare for middle school and, eventually, high school volleyball.

"We want to introduce volleyball to the younger girls so they can learn rotations and how the game is played," Sly said. "Whether it's overhand passing or underhand passing... It's fun seeing how some girls, who may not have had many skills prior to the camp, walk away understanding

the game and wanting to play the game more often. The older girls work on serving zones and not just getting the ball over the net."

The camp includes daily scrimmages where players can practice the skills they learn during live matches against their peers. Each camper receives a T-shirt at the conclusion of camp.

For Sly, who will be entering her second season as RTHS head coach, introducing volleyball at the youth level is paramount for creating more depth at the high school level.

"Especially for the fifth-graders, it's really important to come to the camp so they can decide whether or not they want to commit to volleyball," Sly said. "It's a great four days to get a taste of how volleyball is played."



Family rivalry kicking off for Redington brothers

FORMER Rochelle offensive line-man Danny Redington will have a rare opportunity to see a familiar face on the opposite side of the football field when he suits up for his junior season with the Wisconsin-Platteville Pioneers this coming fall.

An NIB-12 All-Conference First Team tackle with the Hubs, Redington has spent his last two years with the Pioneers. As he gears up for his first season as an upperclassman, Redington will likely have Saturday, Oct. 26 marked on his calendar. That's when Platteville travels to face Wisconsin-Eau Claire, where his younger brother, Ben, will soon begin his college football career.

"Facing Ben's team will carry a bit of extra excitement, and it will be a great moment for our family," Redington said. "He has played this sport as long as I have and at the same levels I have. He knows how much work it takes. The one thing I told him is to not let the college level be intimidating, because it's still just football. There's nothing for him to worry about."

A mountainous man standing 6 feet 8 inches tall and weighing 332 pounds, Danny Redington played tackle over his first season with the Pioneers before tran-

sitioning to the interior of the offensive line his sophomore year. While the change was different for Redington, he said switching positions has helped create a new mindset moving forward.

"I felt my sophomore season went well as far as the strides I made as an athlete," Redington said. "I feel as though I improved mentally more than anything else. Switching to an interior line position has brought with it a new mindset, one that I feel much more comfortable with. Though I'll still keep the playbooks fresh in my mind, my focus now is to continue getting better physically."

The Pioneers will kick off the 2019 season with a home game against East Texas Baptist on Saturday, Sept. 7. Redington and his teammates will be seeking to build off their 4-6 record during the 2018 season, which included topping East Texas Baptist 59-44 on the road. Redington said the 28-hour round-trip experience was the best of his collegiate career.

"The best part about college football is undoubtedly getting to know my teammates," Redington said. "Calling the bond with my teammates a brotherhood is no exaggeration. My absolute favorite experience so far was the bus ride to Texas for our first game last season. It was long, but going home with a win and sharing the experience was all worth it."
