Working as a team

ROCHELLE – Workers from Americold Logistics and children ages 7-12 at the Rochelle Child Care Center teamed up Tuesday afternoon to build benches, learn to work as a team and support the day care operation.

The Rochelle Child Care Center recently reached out to different corporations in the community seeking donations. Americold was contacted and came up with the idea of hosting a team building exercise rather than simply donating money.

“As Americold we look for opportunities to give back to our community. The theme today is building towards the future, and these are the youth that are going to be driving the next employees,” said Dan Lundquist, Americold general manager.

Once Americold was contacted, company leaders found out the facility was in need of benches, storage space and art



supplies and created an event to cater to those needs. The main goal of the event was to give back to the community, but it also focused on teaching the children valuable life lessons.

“We are going to talk to them about the four C’s we try and run our business by;

consistency, curiosity, confidence and celebrate,” added Jamie Proctor, general manager of Americold Belvidere. “We are going to talk about what those things mean to them to try and get them to think a little bit.”

At the event workers and children were split up into eight different teams consisting of one child and 4-6 Americold staff members. Each team was given a bench to build, a specific color, and one of the four C’s as their team motto. The C’s also had a specific rule the team must follow such as not being able to speak, no assembly instructions or team members being blindfolded. Once the bench was built, the team had to run to a table and create something related to their motto out of Legos.

According to child care staff, it was hard to tell if the kids were more excited about working together as a team or playing with Legos

New laws change stopping, parking areas near schools

ROCHELLE – People dropping off or picking up their children at the local elementary schools may have to rethink their plans for stopping, parking and waiting.

A new parking ordinance for neighborhood elementary schools was passed at Monday night’s Rochelle City Council meeting which aims to eliminate congestion and improve the flow of traffic in the general pick up and drop off areas outside Central, Tilton, May schools and Rochelle Middle School.

According to Rochelle city officials, the elementary schools were built during a different era and the neighborhood streets do not have the capacity to handle the amount of traffic seen today.

“These schools were built back when a lot of the population was either bused or walked to school, that is not the case these days. There is a lot of parental pick-ups and drop offs and the facilities that they have currently are not conducive to doing that,” explained Matt Wittenberg, Rochelle Police Department officer.

Currently, there is a loophole in the Illinois law that states, drivers can temporarily stop in a general no parking zone to pick-up or drop off passengers. With the current city and school budgets, there are not enough funds to build larger parking lots or widen streets, so creating enforceable city ordinances was the only option to improve safety and

flow of traffic.

“This kind of closes that loophole and allows some sort of law enforcement to be able to step in and say ‘hey, you can’t do that in these specific areas,’” added Wittenberg.

By creating specific areas to park while waiting for kids the flow of traffic is expected to improve going both ways through intersections.

Right now, if one driver is stopped picking up or dropping off, all vehicles behind wait as well.

Wittenberg said the changes in the ordinance to know are not financially motivated but are merely geared for the safety of the students.

Loan agreements approved for city vehicles

ROCHELLE — Rochelle firefighters will have a new fire truck in their fleet next year after Rochelle City Council members unanimously approved a revolving loan agreement last Monday night.

The truck will replace Engine 8 which was built and purchased in 1995.

According to Rochelle Fire Chief Dave Sawls-

ville, \$200,000 from the Ambulance Fund was budgeted in 2019 to cover the cost of the chassis of the truck with the remainder of the engine to be paid for upon its completion in 2020.

“Earlier this year the department applied for and was approved to receive a loan in the amount of \$350,000 from the Office of the State Fire Marshal through the Illinois Finance Authority for the purchase of this

engine,” Sawlsville told the council.

The term of the loan is up to 20 years with a fixed interest rate of 1.89 percent.

Dump trucks

On Feb. 2, 2019, city council members approved a resolution waiving bidding requirements and authorizing the purchase of two dump trucks from CIT Trucks, LLC in the amount of \$343,898.

Due to an average an-

nual increase of 3 to 5 percent from manufactures, it was proposed to purchase the trucks at the same time in an effort to eliminate this annual increase for the second vehicle.

It was also proposed that the purchase of these trucks be financed through a local bank for a term not to exceed four years and at an interest rate not to exceed 4.75 percent.

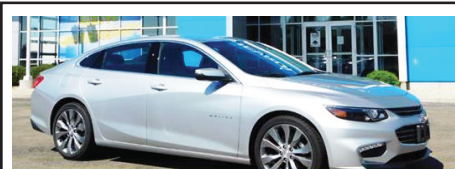
Olson named interim chamber director

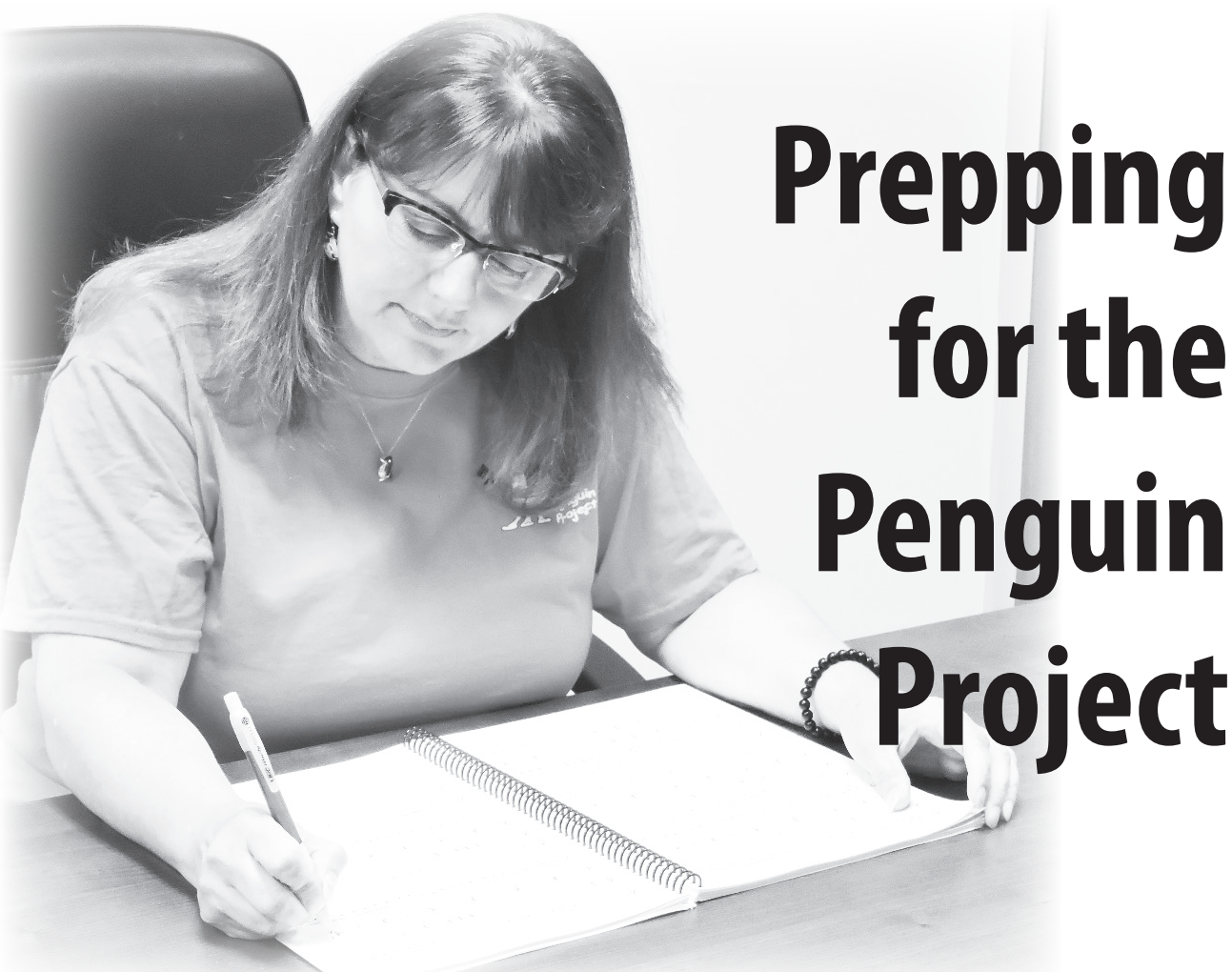

Prepping for the Penguin Project

Kids to perform Hairspray in September

PROGRAMS and activities offered for kids with disabilities have come a long way over the years through athletic programs, work programs and educational programs, but up until 2004 there was nothing within the arts.

The Penguin Project is a program that was created 15 years ago in Peoria by Dr. Andy Morgan and has since grown into a nationwide program with chapters throughout the United States. In this program, children with disabilities work with mentors (children of the same age without disabilities) to put on a modified version of a Broadway play.

The Penguin Project is offered by various community theaters throughout the country including DeKalb County's Children's Community Theater. Children ages 10 through 22 with disabilities work together to perform a full-length musical. Each year involves lots of planning and four months of rehearsal that could not be done without the generous help from Tracey Busby.

Busby works at Rochelle Community Hospital as the manager of outpatient services but volunteers her own time each year to direct the Penguin Project play. The project means a lot to her, as she has a daughter with a disability and an older son who does not have a disability. This program has allowed them to work together in the play as an artist and her mentor, ultimately benefiting each in their own ways.

"Not only does it serve to provide an artistic outlet, but there is a real social theme to it as well with a lot of partnership work. It also gives mentors an opportunity to learn about people with disabilities and mingle with people they would not normally do so," said Busby.

Planning for each program begins in January with the show announcement in March. Rehearsals for the play begin in May and continue throughout the summer until the showtime in September. During the four months of rehearsals the artist's and their mentors work on various things including vocals, choreography and remembering lines.

While the artists in the play steal the show, the mentors' job is just as important.

"The mentors do an amazing job because they have to be in the show and they have to remember all of their artist's lines. If their artist might forget something or stumble over something then they are there to whisper in their ear what the line is," added Busby. "So, they have a huge job, not only working with the other person, but they need to know everything as if they were the character."

The play put on by the children is no different than it would be on Broadway, except for a few slight changes to help suit the children's needs. No matter the role or the disability, Busby does everything in her power to help the child complete their role.

"I don't treat my cast any differently than if I directed any other show. Now given that, we do make modifications, like if someone doesn't speak they still have to do the lines in the script, but how can we help them to do that," said Busby. "We had an artist with cerebral palsy and he was wheelchair-bound and did not speak. But I gave him a role with lines, his dad recorded it, he practiced pushing the button, and

when he had to give his lines they were delivered."

While this project benefits the children involved, the mentors, and the family members of the artists in many ways, it is not until the curtain closes on their first performance that the children realize how much they have accomplished.

ther. This can help change the way that society looks at people with disabilities — to realize everyone is alike and to look at the many similarities rather than focusing on the few differences.

"I want people to know that you can never underestimate somebody because of a disability, my goal is always to have people look at my kids and forget that they have a disability," Busby said.

This year, the kids will be performing Hairspray at Sycamore High School from September 12-15. Thursday, Friday and Saturday the play will begin at 7 p.m., and 2 p.m. on Sunday.

There is no charge to participate in the Penguin Project, everything is funded by DeKalb foundations, generous donations and grants. Anyone who would like to make a donation, start a local chapter or learn more about this program can visit www.penguinproject.org.

Applicants encouraged for board of review

OREGON—Ogle County is seeking applicants for its Board of Review.

The board, which has three members, meets annually to hear disputes on property tax assessments, both residential and commercial.

The board is currently down one member, as a member who was appointed in May had to step down due to a conflict, said Ogle County Board Chairman Kim Gouker.

"They meet once a year, usually in the spring, to hear these appeals from taxpayers," said Gouker, who announced the opening at the July County Board meeting.

To apply, people can contact the office of the Ogle County Clerk at 815-732-1130 and ask for an application. Applications are due to the county by the first Friday of September.

Gouker said he is hoping that having some "good civic-minded folks" apply would allow for the board to pick a strong candidate for the position.

The county has a variety of boards and commissions that are filled with people who volunteer their time, and it is increasingly difficult to find people to fill those positions, he said. For the Board of Review, when the last appointment was made in May, only two people applied.

Shuttle offered for train stop Tuesday

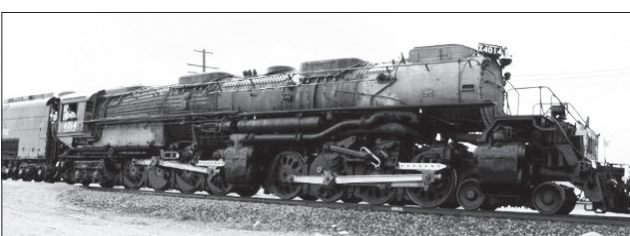

ROCHELLE – Union Pacific Railroad is celebrating the 150th anniversary of the completion of the transcontinental railroad with a cross-country tour for one of its original steam engines—the Big Boy No 4014—which will be traveling through Rochelle.

The model is one of 25 original Big Boy steam engines that were built exclusively for the Union Pacific Railroad. The steam engine will be making a transcontinental tour and plans to stop at the Rochelle Railroad Park on Tuesday, July 30 between 9:45 and 10:30 a.m.

The extreme flooding out west threatened to delay the arrival of the steam engine, but UP crews have kept everything on schedule at this point.

“Despite the flooding experienced by the crew in



Nebraska, the steam engine is still expected in Rochelle on July 30,” said Jenny Thompson, director of marketing, public relations and tourism, in a press release.

The old steam-powered engines are much larger than the newer diesel-powered locomotives used today.

According to the Union Pacific website the Big Boy Locomotives are 132 feet long, weigh 1.2 million pounds and have hinged frames to allow such a long engine to negotiate curves in the tracks. These engines are supported by 14 wheels arranged in a 4-8-8-4 pattern and carry a total of 56,000 pounds of coal used as the trains power supply.

Engine No. 4014 that will be stopping in Rochelle was originally delivered to Union Pacific in December of 1941 and was retired in December of 1961. The Union Pacific Website states that in the locomotives 20 years of service it traveled a total of 1,031,205 miles.

Free shuttle

Due to the number of expected visitors, the city of Rochelle encourages guests to make use of a free shuttle running from parking lots downtown Rochelle to the Railroad park.

“Rochelle rail fans will enjoy shuttle service from downtown Rochelle municipal parking lots

between the hours of 8 a.m., and noon at no cost. We encourage our guests to take advantage of the shuttle service and enjoy our Downtown shops and Distillery while in town,” explained Thompson in a press release.

The shuttle stops include the municipal lots at: North Main Street and Fifth Avenue, Fifth Avenue and North Sixth Street, and Fourth Avenue and North Sixth Street.

There will be local non-profit organizations including The Kitchen Table and Golden K serving both breakfast and lunch items throughout the event. Big Boy 4014 T-shirts will be for sale as well.

“This is not a revenue generator or anything like that, we will work with the parents to educate them before ticketing them,” said Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby. “The goal is to improve traffic flow and also the safety of the kids, we are not looking to ding a hundred parents the first day.

The ordinance will take some time to go into effect as the signs still have to be ordered and put up around the schools, and officers know as with any new changes there is going to be somewhat of a learning curve and they are here to help.

“When signs are actually out there, it isn’t going to be tickets the first day. It is going to be us out there knocking on people windows saying hey, this is not where you are supposed to park and we need to move you over to a different spot,” added Wittenberg. “That is the whole goal of the police department, it is not to nail people on the first offence but to get

people into a general flow to improve the safety of the kids.”

The new laws will officially go into effect once the signs are placed outside of the schools, but it is not definite if that will happen prior to the first day of school next month.

The no parking/no drop-off/no pick-up zones will be located on North Ninth Street and 10th Avenue/North 10th Street near Tilton School; North Ninth Street, North Eighth Street and some of West Fifth Avenue around Central School; West 10th Avenue, North Second Street and School Avenue near May School and Calvin Road and portions of School Avenue at Rochelle Middle School.

“I just want to thank officer Wittenberg for the research and work he has put into this,” stated Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh, after the changes were passed by council on Monday night. “He saw a situation and a need to improve safety and took action to solve it.”

Good for local businesses

COMMUNITY colleges provide many learning opportunities in the local communities focused on workforce training. Kishwaukee College continues to create innovative ways to support local business through relevant training, programming and services.

Last December, we launched Sycamore U, a partnership with the City of Sycamore aimed at developing leadership skills for their employees. During the 2018-2019 academic year, 62 Kishwaukee College students participated in the "earn while you learn" program as interns at local businesses such as 3-D Automotive, Alexander Lumber, Brad Manning Ford, Cresswood Shredding Machinery, DeKalb Implement, DeKalb Park District, DeKalb Motors,

Hormel Foods, HyVee Floral, Lowe's, Merlin Muffler, Nenni and Associates, R-Equipment, Rochelle Municipal Utilities, Rochelle Truck Center, Schnucks Floral, Superior Diesel and Walt Ltd.

Launching this fall is a Hospitality & Culinary program. The program developed out of conversations with local restaurants expressing a need to hire staff with the fundamental skills to work on a team in a kitchen environment. Our new Medical Assisting program has a similar story — it sprung out of a need expressed by local healthcare facilities to hire people skilled in both clinical and administrative responsibilities. Kishwaukee College will soon begin to educate and train people to fulfill this needed role in healthcare.

Kishwaukee College has been and will continue to be responsive to local needs. Serving on the DeKalb County Economic

Development Corporation Executive Committee and the Greater Rochelle Economic Development Corporation Board provides an opportunity for me to hear about workforce needs and how the college can work to support and grow local businesses.

Fifty-two percent of the college occupational graduates from 2018 work within the Kishwaukee College District and 96 percent of occupational graduates work within the State of Illinois. We prepare people in a wide range of occupations and many of them stay to contribute to the local economies.

"Babe" the pig could save the lives of human babies

Dear Editor,

More than 100,000 Americans are on waitlists for organ transplants. Many will die before the organ they need becomes available.

Those deaths may soon be avoidable. A team of researchers in Japan just announced that it had successfully grown mice kidneys inside rats using only a small collection of stem cells. Researchers noted, "This approach could be used to generate human stem-cell-derived organs in livestock."

In other words, scientists could eventually grow human organs in pigs and other mammals — and then transplant those organs to sick patients.

Some fringe activists want to shut such revolutionary research down — and ban scientists from conducting medical studies in animals. Doing so would effectively tell the hundreds of thousands of people awaiting organ transplants they haven't suffered long enough.

Thousands of Americans are alive today thanks to organ transplants. In 2017, surgeons in the United States performed more than 34,000 transplants — including more than 3,200 heart transplants and nearly 19,500 kidney transplants.

Without animal research, these operations wouldn't have been possible. Consider the history of the heart transplant. In the mid-20th century, researchers employed animals to investigate how to perform a transplant

and minimize the chances of organ rejection. In the 1950s, U.S. surgeon Norman Shumway began performing heart transplants in dogs. Building off his work, Professor Christiaan Barnard practiced transplants in animals for years, and ultimately completed the first human-to-human transplant in 1967.

Animal research continues to influence the field of transplant medicine today. Scientists at the University of Alabama at Birmingham, for example, recently analyzed how blood serum from a human baby interacted with cells from a genetically modified pig. The scientists found no adverse reaction. Based on this experiment, researchers believe babies in need of heart transplants might be able to rely on a pig heart until a human heart is available.

Animal research could also make organ transplants safer. It's difficult to determine when a body starts rejecting an organ. In many cases, a biopsy will be normal, and a patient will feel perfectly fine until organ damage is already severe. New research from the Georgia Institute of Technology and Emory University could change that. Using mice, scientists developed a method that makes urine fluorescent when the body starts rejecting an organ.

Despite the potential for such research to save and improve lives, critics continue to attack scientists

for using animals in research. People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals recently called on the federal government to investigate animal research at the University of Washington. Activists have also staged protests at other prominent research institutions, including the University of Delaware, the University of Missouri, and Colorado State University.

Activists claim animal research is cruel and unnecessary. They say there are other ways to conduct research that don't involve animals — such as using cell cultures or computer models.

But such restrictions would stifle medical progress. Cell cultures and computer models aren't sophisticated enough to replicate how a transplanted organ will interact with human and animal immune systems.

Further, scientists don't abuse animals. The opposite is true — they go to great lengths to ensure animals are treated humanely. The federal Animal Welfare Act also sets a host of regulations, guidelines, and inspection requirements on scientists who use animals in research.

Americans are dying because there aren't enough organs available for transplant. Animal research offers us a chance to save the lives of our fellow citizens.

Troop has been reborn, chartered by Rochelle Moose

Rochelle's Scout Troop 312 was formed in 1971 under the leadership of Scoutmaster Harold Mitchell and the Rochelle Presbyterian Church was the charter organization. When Norvin Moss became the fourth Scoutmaster of Troop 312, the charter organization became the Rochelle United Methodist Church.

Troop 312 at one time was one of the larger troops in the district and attended the National Jamborees in 1989, 1993 and 1997. Troop 312 maintained an A-frame building off of Sweeney Road and had priority over other units in its use for many years.

The last scout to achieve Eagle Scout status in Troop 312 was Logan McKinley in 2007 and after that the charter was allowed to expire in 2009. Steve Beck was the last Scoutmaster and the trailer, equipment and canoes were all donated to

other troops.

On Oct. 11, 2017, the Boy Scouts of America Board of Directors unanimously voted to invite girls into all scouting programs, and all-girl Cub Scout units were established in 2018.

On Feb. 1, 2019, Scout

Troop 312 was reborn as an all-girl unit in Rochelle under the leadership of Scoutmaster Beth Bemis, Assistant Scoutmaster Greg Ebens and Charter Liaison Mike Wilson. The idea to bring back Scout Troop 312 as an all-girl unit came

from the girls wanting to do the same things the Boy Scouts do.

"The Girl Scouts locally do not go camping, it is optional for the Girl Scouts but is mandated for the Boy Scouts and that is what the girls want to do," explained

Dave Schabacker, Rochelle Moose Lodge representative.

The charter organization is now the Rochelle Lodge No. 903 of the Loyal Order of Moose, and the troop is now called Scouts BSA Troop 312.

Bemis asked the Moose leaders to charter the group and the board was excited about the opportunity.

"We got approached and we thought that is part of what the Moose mission is, to help sponsor a Scout Troop," explained Schabacker.

Going forward Scouts BSA Troop 312 plans to help with the annual Lincoln Highway Heritage fest, the spook house at the Moose and continue helping with adopt a highway.

The event will be held on Saturday, Aug. 17 from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Pines Road Annex located at 909 Pines Road in Oregon. This event is for Ogle County residents only.

Illinois Recovery Group will be on hand with its vacuum truck to collect used motor oil and antifreeze. Used oil filters will also be accepted for recycling. Residents will be able to bring up to 200 gallons of used oil to the event. For quantities greater than 200 gallons call the OCSWMD for more information.

Small containers as well as oil drums may be brought to the event. Oil containers will be



returned for either reuse or proper disposal. No mixed automotive fluids, cooking oil, fuel, tires, or other household hazardous waste will be accepted.

Latex paint will also be collected for recycling through e-Paint. Residents may bring up to 20 containers of liquid latex paint in for recycling. Residents will be charged \$1 per gallon container, quart-sized containers are \$1 for one to two containers, \$2 for 3 to four containers, etc.,

and \$5 for five gallon containers of paint. The remainder of the cost to recycle the paint will be subsidized by the OCSWMD. Residents may bring more than 20 containers, but will pay the full price for additional containers over 20.

Dried up or hardened paint will not be accepted, only liquid latex paint. No oil-based paints, stains, varnishes, paint thinners, or other household hazardous waste will be accepted. Paint must be in original containers.

This event is for residential materials. No business or contractor materials will be accepted.

Byron plant keeps up with demand during heatwave

BYRON – While the sun beat down on Illinois recently, sending temperatures and energy demand soaring, Exelon Generation’s six Illinois nuclear plants operated at full power, producing enough carbon-free electricity to keep 11 million homes and businesses safe and cool.

That predictable, sustained energy production helped keep prices stable throughout the heatwave.

Carbon-free nuclear

energy not only provides the electricity needed for air conditioning during extreme heat, it does so without releasing the harmful carbon emissions like those from fossil fuel plants. All of Exelon Generation’s 22 reactors remained online during the recent heat wave that hit across the country.

Griffith ready to step up for OUAZ tennis program

NOAH Griffith finished his high school tennis career as a three-time IHSA state qualifier and one of the elite players in the Northern Illinois Big 12 Conference.

Griffith made his name in singles play, but after choosing to continue his academics and athletics at Ottawa University Arizona, the former Rochelle Township High School standout has been trying some new things.

Griffith recently completed his freshman year at OUAZ, where he primarily played exhibition matches in both singles and doubles. While his role wasn't as big as he would've liked, Griffith said he's looking to become a key contributor for the OUAZ team his sophomore year.

"I try and help my team as much as I can, whether that's in practice or supporting them during matches," Griffith said. "I always try to be positive and look for where I can improve. I'd like to keep improving and prove myself to be in the lineup next year due to our team losing four seniors. Anything can happen, and I'm blessed to be a part of a great team. I'm excited to see what happens over the next couple of years."

OUAZ went 14-8 during the 2019 season and 6-4 in conference play. The Spirit won two matches in the Golden State Athletic Conference Championship including an upset over nationally ranked Hope International (No. 17). OUAZ earned three victories and took second place in the NCCAA National Championships, topping No. 18 Campbellsville along the way.

“We had a big team with lots of talent,” Griffith said. “Our team is very diverse with people from all over the world. We had a very successful year. The atmosphere and style of play is very different from high school, and the competition is unbelievable. Brennan ties for second at Lincoln Highway tourney

DEER GROVE — Thomas Brennan entered the 97th Annual Lincoln Highway Tournament as the defending champion after besting Ryan Harrison in a playoff last year.

While Brennan fell a few strokes short of repeating this year, the Rochelle golfer still shot his way near the top of the tournament leaderboard.

Shady Oaks player Cole Ruckman scored 211 over 54 holes to win the championship this year. Brennan fired 215 to tie for second

place, and although he was disappointed in his performance, he said he was still proud to record his second runner-up finish over the last four years. Brennan also won two titles over that span.

“The course was in good shape, but the greens were slow, which made putting fairly difficult,” Brennan said. “I had not played the course since I was in high school about 10 years ago, but I remembered playing well there so I had some confidence going into the tournament.”

Brennan fell behind early in the event, carding 78 after

his first 18 holes to sit 10 strokes behind the leaders. He caught fire during his second 18-hole run, however, dropping seven strokes over the first 11 holes and shooting a 6-under-par 66.

Brennan cut the lead down to as few as two strokes, but his tough first round proved too difficult to overcome.

Brennan represented Fairways Golf Course, which took fifth place out of 12 teams with a plus-54 score.

“We did alright as a team,” Brennan said. “We are always looking to win, but most of us started off
