Running to change lives

A local team will be running in the Chicago Marathon this year as part of a life-changing mission. Jennifer Knetsch from Steward and her team from Heartland Community Church in Rockford will be participating in the Chicago Marathon this year as part of Team World Vision, a fundraising program of World Vision International. This program focuses on providing lower income families across the world with access to clean water.

“They are the largest non-governmental supplier of clean water and every \$50 earned brings clean water to one person forever, not just a year or a month, but forever,” explained Knetsch.

While Team World Vision will have thousands of runners in the marathon, the goal of Knetsch and her team is to earn \$300,000.

Many of these families walk five miles or more multiple times a day in order to get water that will most likely get them sick. Knetsch said it was a video that a representative from World Vision presented to her church that made her feel the need to join.

“We had a representative from Team World Vision come to church and show a video of his personal visit to a location in Africa where they were doing some work, and it was just disgusting,” Knetsch explained. “He was taking a video of the child he sponsored at the watering hole and there is literally an animal going to the bathroom in it in the background.”

in their efforts to supply clean water to the world. But if people would like to get involved on a more personal level there is an option to sponsor children directly.

“For \$39 a month you can sponsor children directly and that will help with immunization, clothing and things like that — more than just the water,” explained Knetsch.

While the main goal of Team World Vision is to supply clean water to people, their goal for the Chicago Marathon is also to get non-runners to come out and participate in the marathon. The program offers an 18-week marathon training plan that involves running four days a week, strength and core training one day a week and cross training one day a week.

While many people may not enjoy running in a marathon, people do it to support the cause behind it.

“Being in a marathon was never something on my bucket list but the experience of doing it last year was incredible. Just knowing that I was doing something that was going to potentially help save lives was a pretty rewarding feeling,” Knetsch said.

While the deadline to participate in the Chicago Marathon as part of Team World Vision was July 31 they are always accepting donations through their website at Teamvision.org or through Knetsch’s personal fundraising page at <https://www.teamworldvision.org/index.cfm?fuseaction=donate.participant&ParticipantID=156702>.

Knetsch also typically documents all of the runs she completes on her social media at Jennifer Lynne on Facebook and Knetschkisses on Instagram.

Adams new planning, zoning administrator for Ogle county

OREGON – After a closed session at a special board meeting Tuesday night, the Ogle County Board appointed Harry Adams Jr. as the county’s new planning and zoning administrator.

“I think he’s going to bring a unique perspective for us,” Ogle County Board Chairman Kim Gouker said of Adams, who is replacing outgoing administrator Michael Reibel.

The Planning and Zoning Department is responsible for regulating construction activities in the unincorporated area of the county.

Gouker said Reibel is leaving the position to become the pastor of a Lutheran church in Lanark.

During the closed session, the county also considered candidates for supervisor of assessments, which is being filled in

the interim by Carol Magnuson. Gouker said although the county received, “a lot of candidates” for the position, the board still did not select one.

He said by state the law, once appointed the person get a four-year term, so the county wants to make sure it has the right person in the job.

Gouker said there were three applicants for the planning and zoning position, but that all three were strong candidates. He said Adams, whose grandfather once served on the County Board, has been involved in construction and has interacted with area zoning offices.

Adams, who is self-employed, will start with the county by Aug. 19 at the latest. Reibel will be in the position until the end of the month.

Adams will be paid \$62,500. With five members absent from the meeting, he was approved by a vote of 16-3.

Lawmakers call hearing in higher education financial aid controversy

Action follows report of wealthy parents gaming system to draw down student financial aid

SPRINGFIELD — A pair of Illinois House committees have scheduled a joint hearing next week to explore recent news reports about wealthy parents exploiting a legal loophole in order to draw down more student financial aid for their children.

The story was first reported online Monday, July 29, by ProPublica Illinois, which said it identified nearly four dozen cases of parents in suburban Lake County, north of Chicago, who had assigned guardianship of their teenage children to a friend or relative, thus allowing their children to declare themselves financially independent of their families so they could qualify for federal, state and college financial aid.

Of particular concern to Illinois lawmakers is the state-funded Monetary Award Program, or MAP grants, which are awarded on the basis of financial need.

the brunt of the pain, it is outrageous to learn that some wealthy families have decided to game the system at the expense of those who truly need help affording an education," Chicago Democratic Rep. LaShawn K. Ford, who chairs the House Higher Education Budget Committee, said in a news release announcing the hearings.

The ProPublica Illinois story reported that nearly all of the guardianship cases it identified were handled by two Chicago-area law firms.

The story also identified a Lincolnshire-based college consulting company, Destination College, which works closely with one of the lawyers involved. It said the company offers

"strategies to lower tuition expenses," including one plan that involves a "College Financial Plan, Using Income and Asset Shifting Strategies to Increase Your Financial and Merit Aid and Lower Out of Pocket Tuition Expenses."

"It pains me to see that individuals have decided to be dishonest in applying for college financial aid," said Rep. Carol Ammons, D-Urbana, who chairs the House Higher Education Committee. "As the cost of college skyrockets, we must take appropriate steps to ensure our finite resources are only going to those who truly need it, not those elites who have rigged the system again and again to their own advantage."

In addition to the legis-

lative inquiry, Democratic Gov. J.B. Pritzker has said he is directing his staff to investigate to determine how widespread the problem is in Illinois.

"We want it to go to the students who are most in need, not to people who are defrauding the system," Pritzker told reporters during a news conference in Chicago on Monday, soon after the story was published. "So we need to look into it to make sure that we are identifying people who are doing this, calling it out, and making sure we are preventing it from happening in the future."

The legislative hearing is scheduled for 10 a.m. Thursday, Aug. 8, at the Bilandic state office building in Chicago.

Illinois Department of Public Health warns of hospitalizations potentially tied to vaping

SPRINGFIELD — The Illinois Department of Public Health is working with local health departments to investigate the hospitalization of three young people who experienced severe breathing problems after

vaping.

Friday, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services reported 11 confirmed and seven suspected cases of severe pulmonary disease among adolescents, some of whom had to

be intubated, who reported vaping. These identified individuals experienced respiratory symptoms including cough, shortness of breath, and fatigue. Symptoms worsened over a period of days or weeks

before admission to the hospital.

"Vaping among teens has increased dramatically over the last several years," said IDPH Director Dr. Ngozi Ezike. "While the short- and long-term effects of vaping are still being researched, these recent hospitalizations heighten the need for parents talk with their teens about vaping and for both to understand the consequences and potential dangers of vaping."

According to the Amer-

ican Association of Poison Control Centers, as of July 31, 2019, poison control centers have managed 2,439 exposure cases about e-cigarette devices and liquid nicotine in 2019.

The names and types of vaping products, as well as where they were obtained, are still being investigated. The three reported individuals in Illinois reside in the northeastern part of the state. In order to protect the identity of the affected individuals, additional information is not available. IDPH will

continue to work with local health departments, as well as the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, to identify the cause of these severe illnesses.

People who experience any type of chest pain or difficulty breathing after vaping in the weeks or months prior to these symptoms should seek immediate medical attention. Health care providers caring for patients with unexpected serious respiratory illness should ask about a history of recent vaping.

A show of gratitude

ROCHELLE – The Veterans War Memorial located at Lawnridge Cemetery will soon be getting a new addition.

Veterans War Memorial Association members have plans to erect a new life-size statue of a soldier kneeling down with his rifle and helmet in hand on top of a pedestal. The statue itself will weigh an estimated 500-750 pounds and will be made out of bronze, making it the only bronze piece of art in the community.

The statue is designed to represent and honor anyone who has served or is serving in this country's armed forces.

"It is paying tribute to the decedents, the fallen and the people that are still serving," said Chuck Roberts, local American Legion commander.

Creating the statue will take about four to five months and includes many different steps in the process. First a small concept model or Maquette is made to show what the final piece will look like. Once approved, creation of the actual statue begins. The soldier will be sculpted in clay using a real person posing dressed in the clothes and holding his helmet and M4 Carbine

rifle. When finished, the clay statue will be converted to bronze which is done by an art metal foundry. There are two such foundries in the area, one in Mt. Morris and one in Oregon. In the end, the soldier will be hollow with quarter inch thick walls all around.

"When the hot metal cools down it does that at different rates depending on how thick it is. So, if you have an arm

that is only two or three inches thick and body that is 10 inches, then you are going to get lots of warpage and crazy stuff with the metal," explained Fran Volz, sculptor of the statue. "But if the whole thing is hollow and the wall is a quarter of an inch thick all around, then you don't get cracks or anything like that."

Volz said the statue will need to be waxed about once a year to help

with upkeep. The statue will be placed where the artillery gun is located now at the memorial site, and the gun will be moved over slightly in the grass. The estimated cost to complete the statue is \$54,300 and the legion has already pledged \$43,200 with another \$20,000 in the bank. They expect roughly 90 percent of their pledges to come in, but are asking for other donations to ensure enough

funds are collected. "If anyone would like to donate they can either get a form from the VFW or the City of Rochelle website, fill it out and send it in to the address on the form. We only accept checks no credit or debit cards," explained Roberts.

Along with being able to donate to the memorial, people also have the option to purchase bricks that are laid on the ground to have a loved

one's name engraved into the brick and memorialized. There are roughly 850 bricks to choose from and those forms are also available on the city website or at the VFW. The oldest veteran honored is John Coffeen who served in the Revolutionary War.

While there are many different pieces at the memorial to honor our veterans, many legion members will tell you they are most interested in the stories that go along with them.

"One of the most interesting stories is about a local teen who was drafted into WWII right after he graduated. He survived D-Day and went on to the Battle of the Bulge, and then he was listed as missing in action until two boys from Bastogne were digging around in the Ardennes Forest and found some human remains and his dog tags," added Colwill. "Through DNA comparison with one of his remaining brothers it was confirmed that it was Stanley Larsen. The Belgian government sent the two boys who found his remains to escort Larsen's remains back to Rochelle where we had a funeral and he was buried in the cemetery."

The goal is to have the statue completed and ready for the 2020 Memorial Day ceremony.

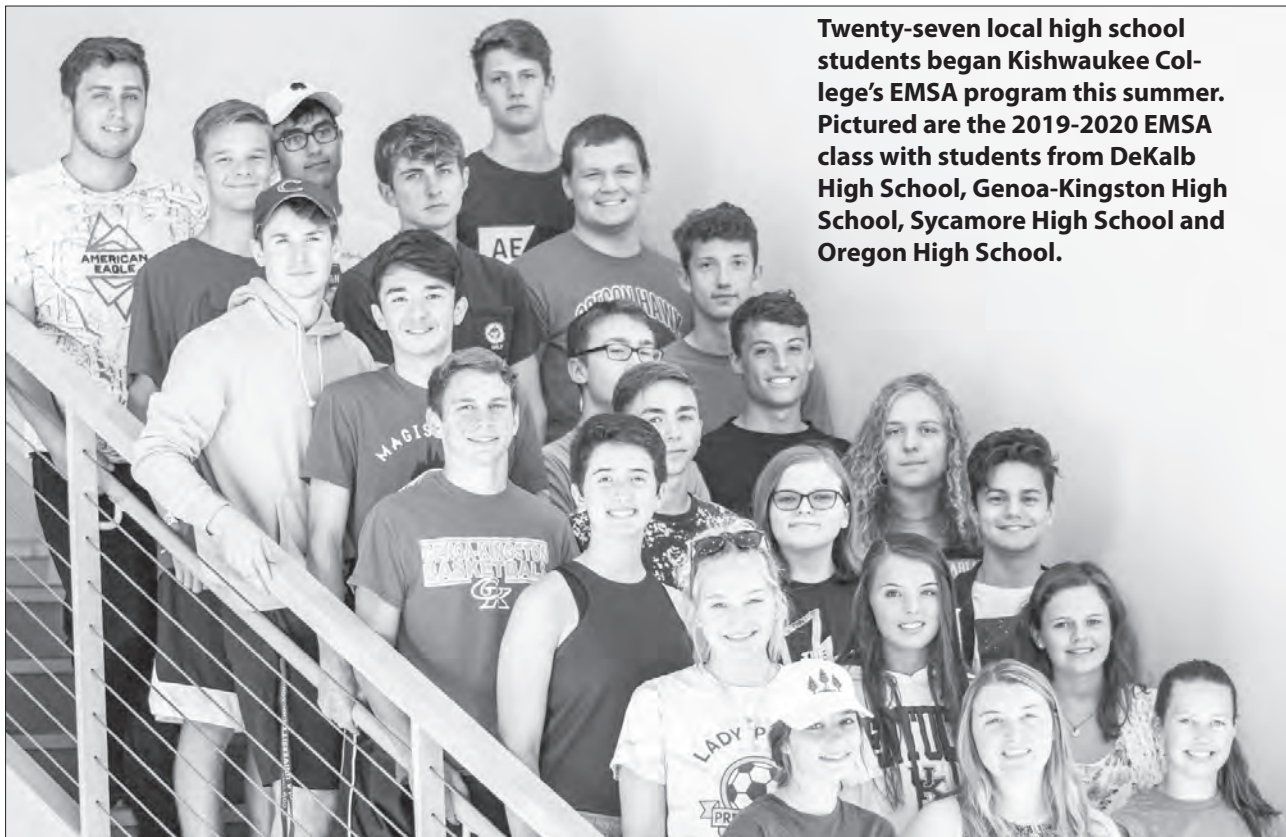
Drivers urged to note traffic shift at I-88, Route 47 interchange

SUGAR GROVE — Beginning this week, a new traffic configuration will be put in place for northbound Illinois Route 47 traffic traveling to the westbound Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) as construction advances to complete a new full-access interchange in Sugar Grove.

Electronic message signs and construction signage will be put in place in advance to alert drivers to the new traffic pattern.

During the week of Aug. 5, all traffic on Illinois Route 47 is scheduled to shift to the northbound side of the road, with a single lane open in both directions. Once the traffic shift is complete, northbound Illinois Route 47 traveling to westbound I-88 will be directed to a new ramp on the right, improving safety by eliminating the need for a left turn in front of oncoming southbound Illinois Route 47 traffic.

The existing ramp carrying traffic to westbound I-88 will remain open for use by southbound Illinois Route 47 traffic only.

Local high school students began EMSA program at Kishwaukee College this summer

MALTA — Kishwaukee College's Engineering, Math & Science Academy welcomed 27 local high school students into the program this summer, making it the largest class since 2016. The 2019-2020 EMSA class consists of students from DeKalb High School, Genoa-Kingston High School, Sycamore High School and Oregon High School.

The unique program offers high school students an early start on their college careers by taking college-level courses during junior or senior year. Students can earn up to 23 credit hours through the EMSA program, generally transferrable to 4-year public universities. EMSA students have transferred to some of the top engineering schools in the country, including the University of Illinois, Purdue, Georgia Tech and Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.

"EMSA is a great opportunity for highly motivated students that are

looking to get a head start on college," says EMSA advisor and assistant professor of physics & engineering Alan Edgecombe. "Kish College offers small class sizes and a great learning environment at an affordable cost."

Students have the option to follow one of two tracks during their year in the EMSA program. "When we began EMSA over 10 years ago, the program was geared towards students entering the engineering and physics fields," says dean of instruction Kyra Rider. "We soon saw a demand for a track that emphasized science-based professions such as pre-med, pre-veterinary and physical therapy, so we responded with the development of the pre-professional track."

The 27 high school students completed Calculus I this summer and will progress on their chosen track in the fall. The 6 pre-professional track students will take Biology and Chemistry whereas the other 21 students will enter the engineering track and take

Calculus II and Physics.

"Parent feedback has been very positive. We are happy to provide this opportunity for high school students to receive dual credit that satisfies their high school requirement and earns them college credit," Edgecombe adds.

EMSA is open to any high school student who has completed pre-Calculus and Chemistry with a "B" grade or better, whether entering their junior or senior year of high school. Application materials must be received by the college no later than Jan. 31 of the year in which the student plans to begin.

Students interested in participating in EMSA are encouraged to discuss it with their high school guidance counselor and attend the informational meeting at Kishwaukee College on Nov. 13.

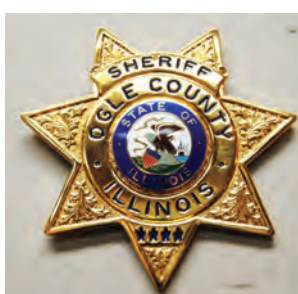

The response from the community has been very good in previous years. Last year a couple hundred community members were in attendance and the police department is expecting another good turnout this year.

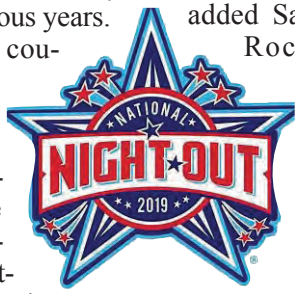
"The community has

Hitting the gridiron

Junior Hubs approaching opening games against Byron

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Junior Tackle teams are less than two weeks away from kicking off the 2019 season against Byron on Saturday, Aug. 10. Roughly 130 players between fifth and eighth grade are set to take the field this year, and the teams are looking forward to getting the new season underway.

While the eighth-graders have the smallest roster (23 players) among the four Rochelle Junior Tackle teams, that doesn't mean there's any heart to be spared. Led by head coach Ben Manning, who returns after stepping down from the lead position in 2018, the Junior Hubs are aiming to build on their 4-4 record as seventh-graders last season.

Flag football program preparing for kickoff

Games begin Tuesday evening at Helms Field

ROCHELLE—While the middle-schoolers are preparing for the upcoming Rochelle Junior Tackle season at Helms Park, the youth sports organization's flag football players have kicked off practice at Rochelle Middle School, with the season scheduled to start on Tuesday, Aug. 6. More than 175 players are signed up to compete in flag football this season, with each team rostering 8-to-9 players. The increased participation numbers are a positive sign for new program coordinators Dan Escatel, Chris Smith and Johnny Gonzales, who are excited to get the 2019 season underway.

"We've wanted to find different ways to give back to the Rochelle community," Gonzales said. "We really enjoy watching these kids grow and learn the game of football. We get kids as young as 4 years old, and we're always trying to help the kids get better every day. We want to build excitement so the kids continue on with the

tackle football program and, eventually, the high school football program."

The flag football program's eight-week regular season begins this coming week, with games running from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at Helms Field on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. There are three divisions including the Arena League (preschoolers and kindergartners), the Jungle League (first and second-graders) and the NFL League (third and fourth-graders).

Both the Arena and Jungle League teams will end their respective seasons after eight weeks, while the NFL League teams will have a postseason tournament culminating in a championship game at Helms Field in early October. "We wanted to add college football teams to the Jungle League and we think those will be fun for the kids," Gonzales said.

Flag football teams will continue practicing at Rochelle Middle School as construction prepares

to begin on the new park district community center at Helms South. Despite practices being moved from Helms Park, Gonzales said the combination of more playing space at RMS, smaller flag rosters and more volunteer coaches has made prepa-

ration for the 2019 season smooth.

"We're really excited about our numbers this year," Gonzales said. "Pushing the start of practices back one week allowed more parents to get their kids signed up for flag football, and we took some

kids past our registration deadline because we didn't want to say no to kids who wanted to play the sport... We have more teams with smaller numbers since we have more volunteers, and that gives all the kids more opportunities to play a lot of minutes."

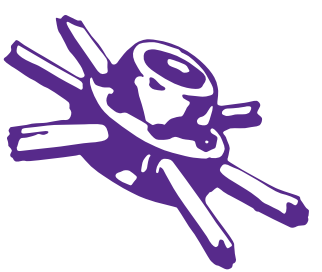

Thiravong qualifies out of local Drive, Chip & Putt Championship event

THE Drive, Chip & Putt Championship allows young golfers to test their skills against players from across the United States. Ailani Thiravong has competed in the Drive, Chip & Putt Championship circuit every summer since 2016, and the 10-year-old from Rochelle breezed through the local qualifying round for the fourth consecutive year.

Thiravong placed second in the local qualifier at Aldeen Golf Club on July 25, scoring 100 points across the three categories and tying for first place with 19 points in the driving category. Thiravong advanced to the subregional qualifier at Countryside Golf Club on July 30, finishing third in her age group with 84 points to earn alternate status for the regional qualifier.

"It was an amazing experience," Thiravong said. "I was looking forward to seeing and playing at a new golf course. My goal is always to make it to the Masters Tournament, and I know it takes a lot of practice, hard work and believing in myself to achieve that goal."

Ailani is the younger sister of Megan Thiravong, who currently plays for the

Rochelle Township High School varsity golf program. She said her short game has been critical to playing well in tournaments this summer, and she's aiming to improve her driving as she continues getting older and gaining more experience.

"I cannot hit the ball very far compared to my 11 and 12-year-old competitors so my short game definitely makes up for my long game," Thiravong said. "My mom ages me up to compete against older players, and I'm working hard to improve my long game."

This summer has been a busy one for Thiravong, who plays in Rockford's PGA Junior League and has won several tournaments including a top finish at Ledges on July 22. But her favorite experience from this summer was attending the 43rd Annual Rockford Pro-Am, where she had the chance to interview PGA professionals such as Troy Merritt and Kevin Streelman. Thiravong was also named to the Junior League All-Star Team for a fourth consecutive summer.

"The highlight of my summer golf season was having the opportunity to interview all of the professional players at the Rockford Pro-Am," Thiravong said. "I had the most awesome experience."

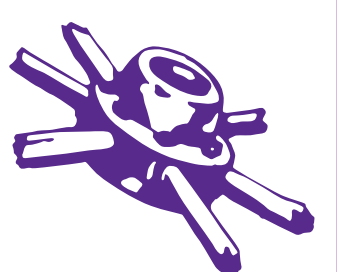
