Following his passion

Works on shrimp species identification

ROCHELLE – One college sophomore from Rochelle is conducting research on clam shrimp shells in hopes to create a new way of identifying the different species.

Nikos Konstans, a graduate from Rochelle Township High School, has been conducting research using an electron scanning microscope, looking at the shells of different species of clam shrimp.

“A clam shrimp is a small shrimp-like creature that lives in a shell,” explained Konstans.

Konstans became interested in fossils and paleontology when he was 5 years old and went through a dinosaur phase. When he grew up, that love stuck with him and carried over into his studies of clam shrimp.

Board approves pay raises

CRESTON – During its monthly meeting on Tuesday, the Creston Village Board discussed its three-year contract with Petry Farms ending this fall and the possibility of renewing it.

The previous contract leased at \$300 per acre plus a bonus based on price and yield, paid after harvest. Petry Farms would like to renew the contract at \$300 per acre but drop the bonus if possible, for a total of \$43,380 for 144.6 acres that would last another three years. The land is part of the village farm

located on the Southwest side of Route 38, just west of town that is rented out to farmers to help with income. Sending this to a bid could end up costing the village more than helping it.

“If you throw it out for bids and somebody else comes in at \$250 and he bids \$275, we could have had them for \$300,” explained Wayne Williams, village president.

It was decided to hold this discussion over until next month’s meeting to talk about options.

Other items

Village attorney Russell Crull discussed the two solar panel ordi-

nances that he provided to the mayor, along with the government cannabis policy resolution. Both of these topics will be discussed at next month’s meeting.

During the meeting

village trustees also passed a motion to higher Casper Manheim as the building inspector at a cost of \$850 per month with him traveling to Creston twice per week for approximately two hours each time.

“Everybody I have talked to speaks very highly of him,” said Williams.

Pay

Along with the new building inspector, a motion to increase the stipends and salaries for certain board members for 2021 was also passed.

ROCHELLE – The City of Rochelle is gearing up for its 22nd annual Lincoln Highway Heritage Festival.

The festival will take place from Aug. 16-18 in the downtown area of Rochelle and will feature attractions for people of all ages. Some of the activities include live bands, carnival rides, a kid’s zone, a car show, a beer garden and a parade on Sunday with many local businesses and organizations participating.

“The parade is at 1 p.m. on Sunday and it is getting bigger every day, I get e-mails about participating and then I send them to our parade coordinator,” said Laura Thomas, marketing coordinator for the festival.

Unlimited ride wristbands for the whole weekend can be purchased before the event for \$50, \$60 at the event, or tickets can be purchased individually or by the sheet.

“This is a social time, a fun time, a lot of people who have left come home for their reunions. It is like a reminiscing and I think people enjoy the atmosphere of the whole thing, pulling the community together.”

Unlimited ride single day bands can also be purchased for Friday or Sunday for \$25 or \$30 for Saturday. Each ride costs between two and five tickets, so organizers recommend purchasing a wristband to save money. Wristbands can be purchased at one of the following locations: Ray’s New and Used Merchandise, Rochelle City Hall, RMU, Colonial Flowers or Quinn’s Jewelry.

Along with all of the other activities, new this year is an open mic that will be taking place on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., on the main stage. Time slots for open mic are 15 minutes each and are first-come

first-serve. People are just asked to bring their own music and equipment if they plan on performing. The 50/50 raffle tickets will be sold throughout the weekend as well, with the final drawing on Sunday at 6 p.m. Donations to the raffle will be accepted up until Friday.

Without all of the many sponsors, this event could not have happened.

“We appreciate all of the help, we wouldn’t be able to do this without our sponsors. Sponsors are a very, very big deal here,” explained Thomas.

Rochelle Elementary School District 231 stopped using Pearson's assessment program (AIMSweb) as a progress monitoring test in 2016. The district has not used AIMSweb for the past few school years.

"The district moved to Renaissance Learning's STAR testing platform in 2016 because STAR uses a dynamic testing model. This means the assessment changes based on the performance of the student during the assessment. Because of this testing model, we feel STAR results give parents and teachers more accurate and timely data to measure student growth," superintendent Jason Harper explained.

Pearson says there is no evidence that student or adult information has been misused as a result of the data breach and that they are working with law enforcement on the matter.

"If a parent/guardian has questions about personal information, contact Pearson at 866-883-3309 or e-mail aimswblrequest@pearson.com. Please note that Pearson is offering free credit monitoring services from Experian," Harper said. "I understand that this data breach is concerning for parents. I recommend that parents/guardians make contact with Pearson and take advantage of the credit reporting services being provided."

Until now there are generally two different ways of identifying clam shrimp, the biological way — which involves looking at the head, body, legs and tissues of the clam shrimp — or the paleontological or fossilized way — where all you have is the shell so all you can look at is the ornamentation patterns.

Many biologists don't believe the paleontological way is accurate but Konstans is hoping his finding will prove this wrong.

"A lot of biologists don't see the shell as viable for identifying a species, because up until recently it has been seen as a variable thing. What I am working on is proving that it is not variable, that it is specific



from species to species. So that the shell can be used to identify them," said Konstans.

Clam shrimp were first being discovered during the Cold War era when scientists from different cultures and countries did not interact with each other. This led to three or four different ways of identifying the same species of

clam shrimp. Since then it has become a little bit more unified by culture, but still varies greatly from field of science to field of science. One of the goals of Konstans's research is to integrate fossilized clam shrimp into the records and the same way dinosaurs are recorded.

"Before this research there were different schools of thought on clam shrimp shells, one guy back in the 1980s basically said we should ignore the fossilized clam shrimp entirely and put them all into one category," added Konstans. "Which was very wrong, because there wasn't just one species of clam shrimp." As of today, there are approximately 40 different known species of clam shrimp and for his research Konstans looked at 17 species. For his process, he would take the specimen and coat it in a special metal that would reflect the electrons from the microscope to help brighten and show detail in the photo. Pictures were then taken of the shell from different angles and distances to compare the ornamentation patterns.

Along with looking at the differences in shell patterns, the location of the shell was also a big factor in helping to identify these species. Konstans conducted his research with the help of his University Professor Dr. Thomas A. Hegna. His professor then asked him to accompany him on his trip to the city of Sha Tin in Hong Kong. There he attended the annual meeting of the Crustacean Society in May and set up a poster to present his research for a few hours on the first day.

Along with attending the conference, Dr. Hegna is also helping to get their research published in a magazine titled Zoological Studies to help continue Konstans's goal of becoming a paleontologist. "He has been a huge help

in me pursuing my goal of eventually becoming an actual paleontologist, which is what I want to do," said Konstans. "Having a published paper is huge in your undergrad years. It is very helpful not only by looking good on a resume, but for getting scholarships, getting accepted into grad school and ultimately getting my PhD."

Publishing his work means that it can also be used as a resource to reference for future projects.

While getting his work published would help Konstans advance his future in paleontology, he also hopes it can be used to open doors for future people identifying species of clam shrimp or adapted to be used on any species with a shell.

Konstans feels that through the examination of 17 different types of clam shrimp species, he has good grounds to prove that shells can be used for identification. But to ensure his data is accurate he plans to examine every type of known species.

"We only had access to 17 species but what we are

going to do is broaden our research. So we can make sure its 100 percent true we need to look at each species, which is going to take some time," explained Konstans.

This was all preliminary research for Konstans's next project which he will be starting in a couple weeks when the next semester of classes begins. The first part was more of taking pictures and observations and the next step is going to be acting on that. Looking at what is causing these patterns, why, how, environment factors and coming up with theories.

While Konstans has been working very hard on his research, he is very grateful for the opportunities he has received and has enjoyed every second of it.

"I am very thankful for my professor Dr. Hegna for giving me this excellent opportunity to have this amazing experience as a freshman. I actually have real experience in the field, an idea of what my future as a paleontologist is going to be like. And it has reinforced that I really enjoy it and love doing it," said Konstans.

The village meter reader will go from \$12 per hour to \$14 per hour; the clerk will go up to \$450 per month; the president pay will go to \$500 per month; and the trustees will be paid \$100 per month.

Pay increases for the clerk and president would go into effect in 2021 while the meter reader would go into effect during the next pay period.

A 50-year-old agreement with NICOR gas was also discussed during the meeting, the agreement would give NICOR the franchise

rights to all of the gas lines. The only difference between this agreement and the old one was a \$5,000 bond that could be used in the case of a gas leak that is not in the new agreement.

"I don't think \$5,000 would do a whole lot if there was a gas leak today, with today's funds," explained Crull.

Another issue that was resolved during the meeting was a walking path that cuts through a subdivision that children use to get to and from school. Where the sidewalk has an "S" curve has become overgrown and could be dangerous to a child if a coyote or animal ran out, or if

they weren't paying attention when biking. The board passed a motion to spend \$500 to clean that area up to keep the children safe and will contact Abe's Tree Service about doing so.

The final topic discussed during the meeting was the concern of people speeding down South Street and blowing the stop sign. Officials are concerned someone is going to get hit, and is looking into the option of installing either speed bumps or speed tables to help ensure drivers slow down and use the stop sign. It was an idea to put a speed detecting sign near the stop sign as well.

"Emergencies can occur any time of the day or night, including when children are in school," said Acting IEMA Director Alicia Tate-Nadeau. "The start of a new school year is the perfect time to make sure you know your school's plans for keeping students safe during an emergency and then talking to your child about those plans."

Here are some tips for parents to consider:

- Find out where children will be taken in the event of an evacuation

during school hours.

- Ensure your current emergency contact information is on file at your child's school.

- Pre-authorize a friend or relative to pick up your children in an emergency and make sure the school knows who that designated person is.

- Teach children with cell phones about 'Text First, Talk Later.' Short, simple text messages, such as "R U OK?" and "I'm OK," are more likely to get through than a phone call if phone service is unavailable immediately following an emergency. As phone congestion eases, you can follow up with a phone call to relay more information.

New this academic school year, state law requires schools to hold a minimum of three evacuations drills while students are present to better prepare students and person-

nel for emergencies. Specifically, within the first 90-days of the school year, schools must conduct at least one law enforcement evacuation drill. These drills must be conducted according to the school's emergency and crisis response plans, protocols, and procedures.

Students headed off to college also need to be prepared for emergencies. While doing back to school shopping, consider picking up the essential items for an emergency preparedness kit. Every home, dorm and apartment should have the supplies needed to endure a storm, power outage or disaster. You can find a list of emergency kit essentials online at www.ready.illinois.gov.

Many college campuses also offer email and text messages to alert students of potential dangers, such as severe weather and other threats. Encourage

your college student to sign-up for such alerts. Some colleges also provide alert messages for parents so they also are aware of potential dangers on campus. In addition, make sure your student knows the emergency plans for their dorm or apartment building.

In addition, a great resource for both parent and college students is the FEMA Weather app. This free app provides fast and reliable alerts from the National Weather Service (NWS). Best of all, the app can be tailored to offer alerts for up to five different locations. This convenience can provide peace of mind for parents who have kids that have moved away to college.

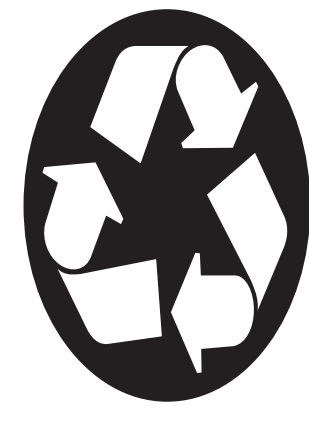

VOP: Celebrating a legacy of service

THIS summer I've been rummaging through the Village of Progress archives, preparing for our 50th anniversary. A few things surprised me. They might surprise you, too. It always starts with parents. Long before there was a Village of Progress there were a group of parents raising children with developmental disabilities. These parents believed that their children deserved a life of opportunity and respect. And so they formed the Blackhawk Association for the Mentally Retarded. That was in 1957. This parent's association learned what other communities were doing to aid persons with disabilities and advocated for their children's

education and for their future. After years of helping to establish and support special education classes these parents started to dream about life for their children after they graduated from school. And so began the Village of Progress. Wherever you see changes that help those with disabilities, you'll always find a group of parents who began with a dream. It takes leaders with passion. In the Spring of 1969 this Association asked Robert Glaser, then just a 26-year old instruc-

tor at the Dixon State School, to create a Day Training Center in Ogle County. By the fall of 1969, the Village of Progress officially opened its doors in Mount Morris. True to Bob's vision, the VOP offered a sheltered workshop and a day care for children not able to attend public schools. Not long after, Bob was introduced to John Herrmann, the Operating Manager of Caron Textile. John was a man with a passion for excellence in business that was a strong as Bob's passion for excellence in disability services. The two men quickly became strong friends and allies. As the VOP grew, John arranged for the operation to use part of its building for produc-

tion work. Six months later, John followed up on this unprecedented show of support by leading his company to donate two acres of their land to the VOP and advance a loan to help the VOP construct its facility. That's where the Village of Progress has been located ever since. Since then, the VOP has expanded from 6,000 square feet to its current size of more than 25,000 square feet. Bob believed in the power of industry and was never afraid to explore new opportunities for the workshop. John believed in the power of industry as a force for good in the community. In 1972, John traveled to Springfield to receive the Francis J. Gerty Award for excellence in community-

based mental health care. John remained actively committed to serving adults with disabilities until his death in 2000. It takes a village. No matter how strong the parent base or how passionate and capable the leadership, social good seldom happens without the support of the community. In this case, that support has come in many forms. A driving force in moving from a parents' group to a functioning day training center was passage of the Ogle County 708 referendum to provide funding for local mental health and disabilities services in 1968. The county, its residents, and its many townships, clubs, and churches, have been faithful supporters of the VOP ever since.

I imagine that the parents who helped create that first Blackhawk Association over 60 years ago could hardly imagine how far their dream has progressed, and how many families have been touched and served. So you see, we're not just celebrating 50 years of the Village of Progress, we are also celebrating 50 years of a county constantly demonstrating its kindness and compassion. Thank you. Without each of you we could not be who we are. Please join us on Wednesday, Aug. 28, from 1-2:30 p.m. as we celebrate together a wonderful legacy of service. 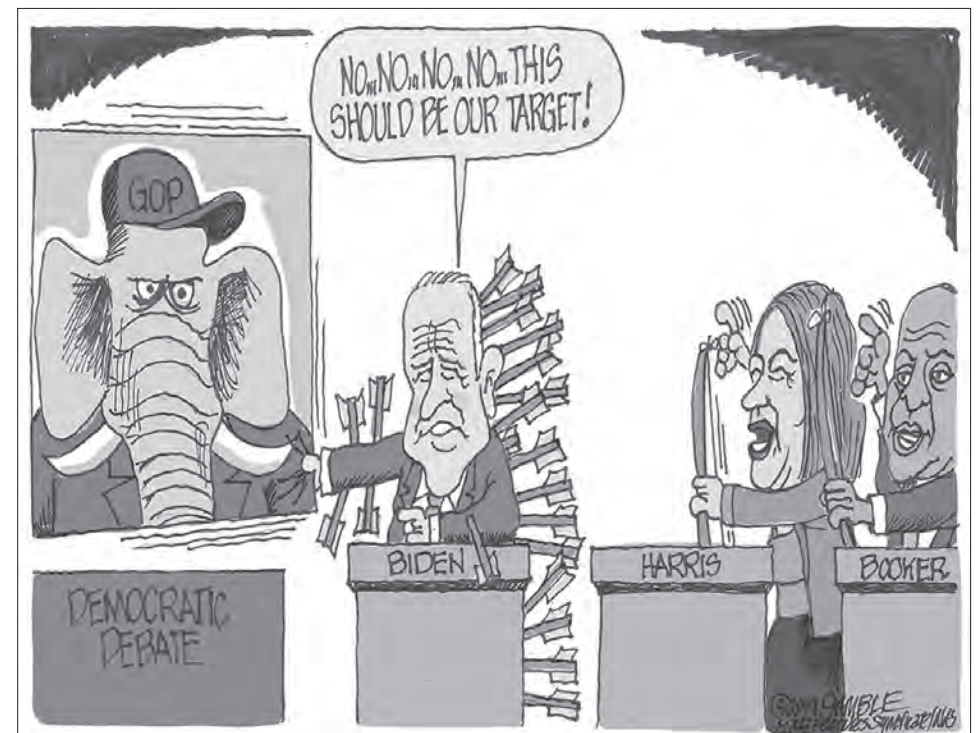

Making memories

Headon represents Team USA at World Para Athletics Junior Championships

ROCHELLE — U.S. Paralympic athlete and Rochelle Township High School graduate Aubrey Headon had one final stop to make before departing the United States to represent Team USA in the 2019 Para World Athletics Junior Championships in Nottwil, Switzerland, this past weekend.

That stop took place at MedCare in Rochelle on Saturday, July 27, when Headon united with family members, friends, veterans, policemen and firefighters before receiving a special escort away from the ‘Hub City.’ Headon and her family spent roughly one week in Switzerland, where she competed in three events including the shot put, the 100-meter dash and the 200-meter dash at the junior championships, which ran from Aug. 1 through Aug. 4.

“The send-off was great,” Headon said. “It was awesome to see how

much this city supports me. Overall, my time in Nottwil, Switzerland, was awesome. I made a new friend named India Oates from Great Britain who is the same classification as me. I think I performed well.”

Headon set a new personal record in the 100-meter dash, clocking in at 17.99 seconds to take ninth place in the mixed heat.

Headon finished eighth in the mixed heat of her 200-meter dash with a time of 39.50, and despite rainy conditions, Headon marked 4.73 meters in the shot put to place third in her group.

Team USA selected only 20 athletes to compete in the junior championships including Headon, who will now prepare to begin her academics at Carroll University, where she plans to study exercise science with an emphasis in physical therapy. Headon also said she hopes to compete for the Carroll University track and field team.

Headon will leave for school on Aug. 30.

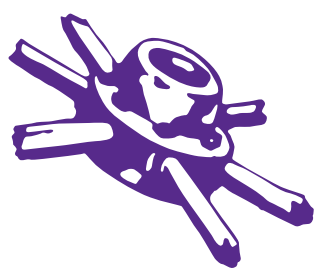

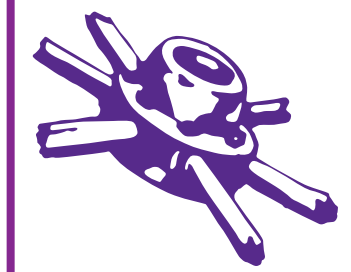

Lawhorn lands All-NACC honor in final season

STANDING 6 feet 3 inches and weighing 275 pounds, former Rochelle student-athlete William Lawhorn has been an anchor on the offensive line for the Rockford University football program over the last four seasons.

Lawhorn appeared in 30 games throughout his time with the Regents including all 10 games his senior season, when his play warranted First Team All-Conference recognition from the Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference. His favorite moments from his playing career were defeating Lakeland 37-20 and topping Concordia University Wisconsin 24-0 in 2018.

"We had one of our best seasons during my time there," Lawhorn said. "We ended up 3-7 my senior year but we competed in every game. We beat Lakeland who was the four-time reigning conference champion, and we beat Concordia Wisconsin who we had never beaten. Our record didn't show it, but we were in every game and almost all of them went down to the wire."

Rockford University recorded eight wins throughout Lawhorn's time with

the program. While he said that pursuing graduate school is definitely in the future, he said he's accepted an assistant coaching position with the MacMurray College football program. Lawhorn recently completed his bachelor's degree with the Regents.

"The biggest thing that Rockford football taught me was to not only trust the process, but to also fall in love with it," Lawhorn said. "I got addicted to results throughout my time in Rockford. Whether it was in the classroom, the weight room or the football field, I loved seeing results, and I still love seeing results."

Lawhorn earned First-Team All-NACC honors for the first time in 2018. The former Hub helped the Rockford University offense record one of its most productive seasons in the NACC, totaling 3,643 yards on offense (second-most since 2008) including 1,663 rushing yards (second-most) and 1,980 passing yards (third-most). Lawhorn said the relationships he built with players and coaches are what he will miss most about the sport.

"Going to a small school like Rockford, the team really turns into a family," he said. "I've really missed just hanging out with the guys."

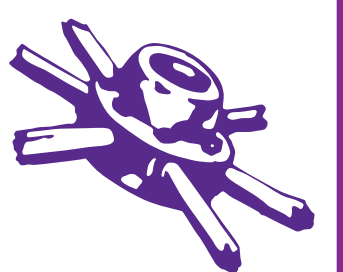

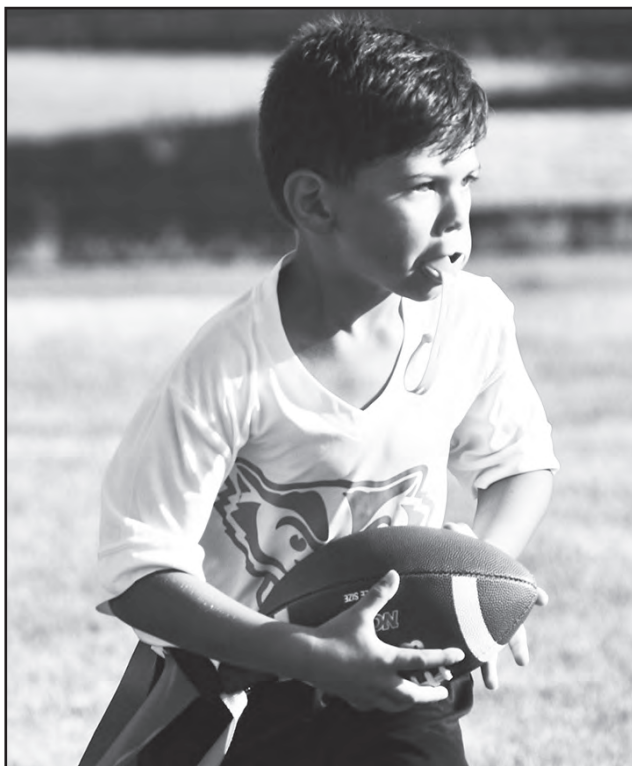
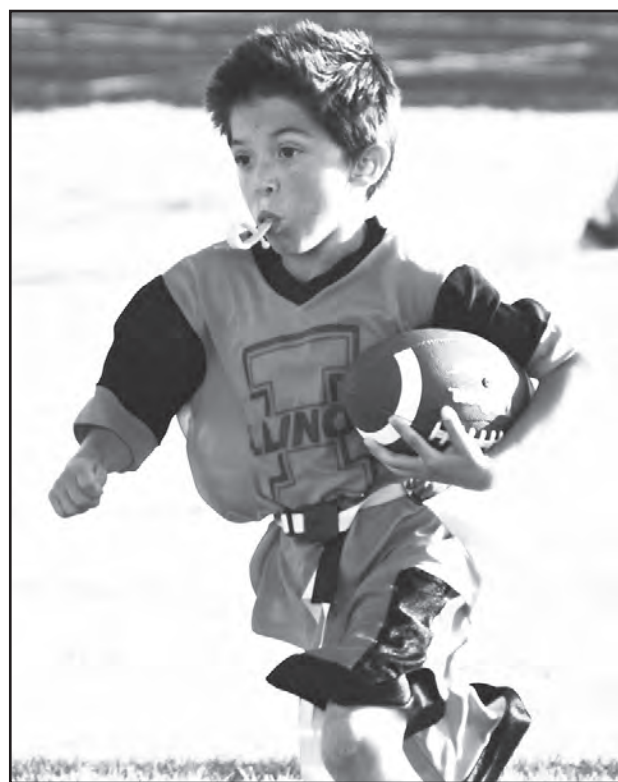
