A rare site

Caravan of Corvettes to make stop in Rochelle Tuesday

ROCHELLE – Classic car fans and Corvette enthusiasts may want to clear their morning plans Tuesday. Rochelle Petro officials are expecting approximately 200 Corvettes to make a stop at their station to fill up their gas tanks, take a little break and get some food.

In honor of the 25th anniversary of the National Corvette Museum, the sixth national Corvette Caravan will be taking place all across the country, ultimately finishing at the museum in Bowling Green, Kentucky. The caravan takes place every five years to align with the museum's milestone anniversaries.



Starting from various cities throughout America, it has been dubbed the world's largest moving automotive event and participants plan for it years in advance.

"We are fortunate to have loyal Corvette enthusiasts who serve as volunteer captains for this massive event. Group organizers spend

years coordinating their trek across the country and planning fun stops along the way," stated Katie Ellison, director of marketing and communications.

The National Corvette Museum is one of the top five automotive museums in the country, and is expecting over 8,000 Corvettes to convene for the festivities.

The North Central region of the Corvette Caravan, which will be stopping at the Rochelle Petro station, consists of 20 percent of all Corvettes traveling to the museum and will be led by Ed and Barb Saari of Towanda, Illinois. The couple are long time Corvette fans and owners of a Velocity Yellow C6.

In order to accommodate the 200 vehicles that will be arriving at the station, Petro management plans to have the cars parked nose to bumper and split between the RV lot on the north side of the main building and the south edge of the car lot along Illinois Route 38.

Breaking ground

Work begins on rec center project

ROCHELLE — A groundbreaking ceremony for the Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District recreation center at Helms South has been set for Wednesday, Aug. 28 at 4 p.m. The \$14 million recreation center is scheduled to be completed by Labor Day 2020.

Park district executive director Jackee Ohlinger said that 12-foot fencing around the entire property should be installed by Friday, Aug. 30. Ohlinger also said the park district has

requested the north end of the parking lot remain open through the end of September to accommodate Rochelle Junior Tackle football games. The parking lot will close Oct. 1.

"A lot of the construction on the parking lot will be done this year and not having access to the full property may cause the construction company to delay some aspects of the project," Ohlinger said. "We should have our final permit for the second phase of construction by the end of this month and we're looking to have our last phase permitted by Sept. 6."

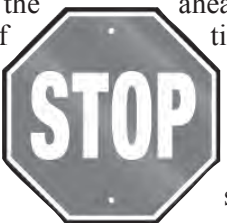

Flagg, Chana road intersection getting four-way stop

ROCHELLE — According to Ogle County Highway Engineer Jeremy Ciesiel, the intersection of Flagg Road and Chana Road will be converted to a four-way stop on Monday, Aug. 26.



The intersection has been a two-way stop for more than 50 years; however, over the decades traffic patterns and roadside conditions have changed resulting in the need to add stop signs on

Chana Road.

New flashing beacons and signs will be placed ahead of the intersection to alert drivers of the new stop condition. In addition, changeable message signs will temporarily be placed along Chana Road notifying drivers of the new stop condition.

Drivers are urged to take note of the new signage and travel accordingly in the area.

Man who survived suicide jump from Golden Gate Bridge to speak locally

DIXON — In the moment after he jumped from the Golden Gate Bridge his first thought was regret. Kevin Hines attempted to take his own life on Sept. 25, 2000. He miraculously survived that jump and today travels all around the world sharing his story of hope, healing, and recovery. He describes himself as a storyteller at heart. He is also a bestselling author, a global public speaker, and an award winning documentary filmmaker.

Kevin Hines will speak on Tuesday Sept. 17 at 6 p.m. at Sauk Valley Community College's Mathis Theatre.

"This is a free event open to the public," said Stacie Kemp, Sinnissippi Centers' chief clinical officer. "Kevin's appearance is supported by grant funds from an Illinois State Targeted Response (STR) Grant. We are happy and privileged to be able to bring Kevin to speak to individuals in our area about this important topic. Kevin will inform us, inspire us, and most of all, motivate us to take care of our own mental wellness, and care for others around us."

Hines tells people how lucky he was to survive the 220-foot free fall from the bridge, although he was injured, shattering three vertebrae. Since the bridge opened in 1937, more than 1,700 people have jumped to their deaths from

its structure and only 25 are known to have survived.

Hines said that his thoughts that day were that someone might come up to him on the bridge and ask if he was okay or if they could help, and then he thought he would tell them his struggles and be safe. He says it's not logical, but that's the nature of suicidal thinking; it's not logical or rational. However, he also had an overwhelming compulsion to take his own life, and that compulsion won and he jumped.

Hines suffers from bipolar disorder and stays well through therapy, medication, exercise, and other activities. He wrote about his attempt and his recovery in a book, Cracked, Not Broken: Surviving and Thriving After a Suicide Attempt.

He still struggles daily with his disease and symptoms of paranoia and suicidal thoughts, but he hopes that by telling his story, he can inspire others to seek help and begin their recovery. He encourages individuals to reach out for help if they are struggling and reinforces the importance of hope and healing. He also promotes the suicide prevention hotline that is always available at 800-273-TALK.

Off to a proper start

ROCHELLE — The school year has begun and two local organizations have helped nearly 200 kids obtain the proper school supplies they need to be successful.

The Community Action Network with funding from a \$3,850 grant provided by the Rochelle Area Community Foundation were able to host the 6th Annual CAN Backpack Program.

The program purchases new backpacks from a company that fills them with supplies that are specific to certain grade levels. The backpacks are then given out to the children in need, ranging from kindergarten to eighth grade.

Last year the program was able to supply 175 children with backpacks and supplies and this year that number has grown to just under 200.

“We ordered 200 and I believe that I have two left in my office,” said

school supplies such as pens, pencils, notebooks and rulers, most of the essentials that

are included in the supply lists that the local schools hand out each year. Without the help

from this event, many of the families would not be able to afford the supplies their children need for school.

The program really aims to give children from lower income families the same tools as everyone else in order to succeed.

“This backpack program is probably one of my favorite things to do, because you just get to help that kid start off just like everyone else,” explained Pease.

Along with the backpack program, CAN hosts many other events throughout the year to help community members in need such as the coat drive in the winter

and the annual shopping trip around the holidays.

For the shopping trip, CAN asks people to donate any amount they can afford and then those funds are used to purchase gift cards to then take children on shopping trips to Walmart.

“When we get close to that December shopping trip we have a mailing list that we send out to people and ask if they are able to give any amount. Last year the kids were able to get a gift card that was for \$65 or \$70,” explained Pease, who added that community donations are the key to providing more for each child.

Military Vehicle Preservation Association convoy rumbles through Rochelle

ROCHELLE — On Thursday, the Military Vehicle Preservation Association 2019 convoy passed through Rochelle on the way to San Francisco, California, following the original Lincoln Highway.

This was in commemoration of 100th anniversary of the first ever transcontinental military convoy that crossed the country in 1919.

In 1919, the U.S. Army decided to plan and execute a motor convoy of various military vehicles across the country, on the newly-formed Lincoln Highway. In general, the route began at the White House, in Washington, D.C., and ended at Lincoln Park, in San Francisco, California — some 3,250 miles and 62 days later. This would be the first motor transport convoy — ever — to cross the U.S.

The convoy had the following objectives:

- Put military vehicles through as grueling a trial as could be devised.
- Study how the varying road conditions affected vehicles from each branch of the service.
- A transcontinental recruiting drive for the Army.
- Demonstrate the need for good roads.
- To say “thanks” to the American people for their support during WWI.

Lydia and Chuck Roberts joined the convoy in Rochelle with their WWII, Dodge M6 Gun Motor Carriage, and traveled with the group to Dixon where the convoy stopped for lunch.

“It was wonderful meeting all the vintage military vehicle drivers from several states including Texas, Pennsylvania, Nebraska and Ohio, as well as Illinois,” Chuck Roberts said.

After lunch, the convoy took off to Iowa for the next overnight stop.

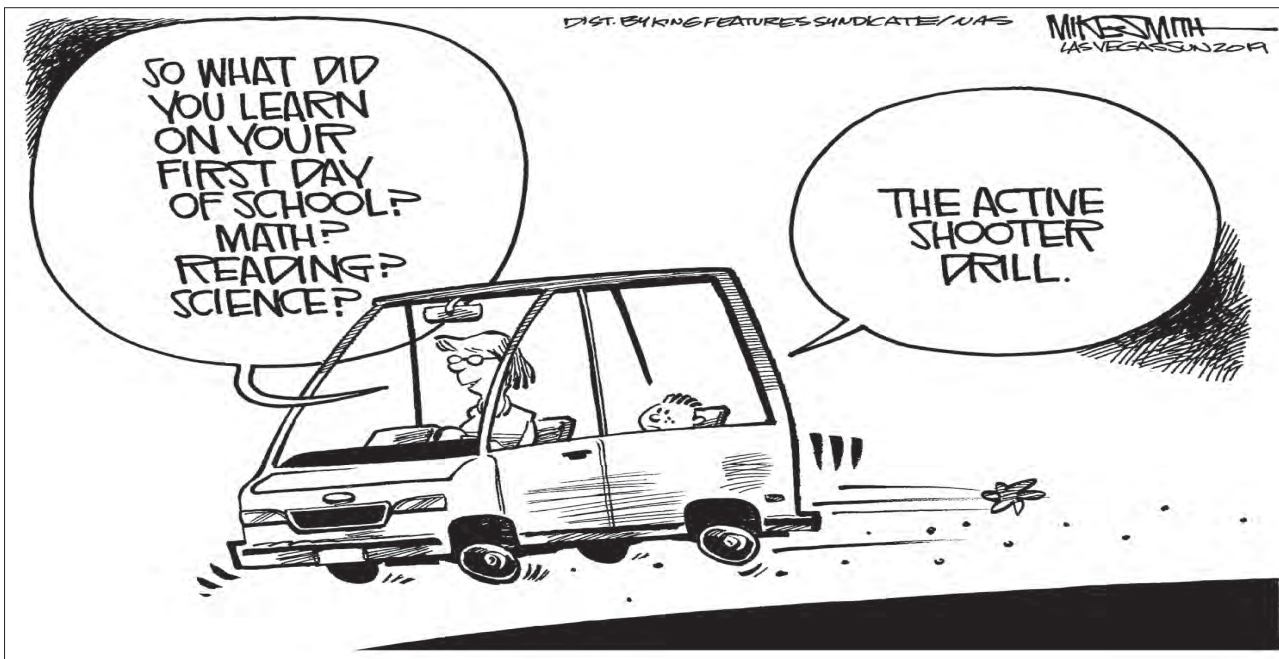
Add to my list of worries: jumping worms or crazy worms. They are not like our friendly earthworms. The jumping worms are much bigger and they eat dead plant material.

Respiratory illness cases troubling, not surprising

Dear Editor,
The Illinois Department of Public Health has issued a recent alert about several cases of "severe respiratory illness among individuals who have a recent history of vaping."
The patients in question were young – between 15 and 27 – and most required hospitalization, with symptoms including "progressive respiratory compromise," fever, chest pain and nausea. All reported vaping in the weeks to months prior to their illness.
These cases of severe respiratory illness are troubling, but not

surprising. Who would have thought it might not be safe to regularly vaporize and inhale a mix of chemicals that might include propylene glycol, nicotine, glycerin, and any number of other additives, for no good reason?
Of course, some will say, "Vaping is still less harmful than smoking!"
Smoking is the leading preventable cause of death in the United States. Allow me to suggest, then, that "less harmful than smoking" is a poor standard for healthy behaviors.
Smoking is bad for you, and if you smoke, you should quit. Anecdotaly,

some smokers seem to have found it easier to quit by switching to e-cigarettes, then quitting altogether. But anyone who thinks vaping is harmless is fooling themselves.
I lost both my parents to lung cancer. This is personal for me. Anyone who is addicted to nicotine – in any form – should make quitting their top priority. You will be healthier, wealthier, and almost certainly happier as a result.

If smoking was ever cool, it is not now

I see an older man many mornings on my trip to work. He is usually coming out of a store, very slowly. He does not appear to be very steady on his feet.
But as soon as he can, he grabs a cigarette and lights up. That, ladies and gentlemen, is addiction.
And I certainly understand it. I smoked myself for a few years. I then quit for nearly 15 years, and then started again and quit a few times before it stuck for good.

deadly. According to the World Health Organization, tobacco kills up to half of its users, and kills more than 8 million people each year. More than 7 million of those deaths are the result of direct tobacco use, while around 1.2 million are the result of non-smokers being exposed to second-hand smoke.
So, smoking is certainly not cool. It is trying to kill you.
Don't get me wrong, I loved smoking. Smoking after a good meal was great and I will probably always miss that. Smoking while having a beer? Also excellent. Smoking was a very social thing to do.
But the coughing? Not cool. The wheezing walking up steps? Not healthy. The stink of smelling like cigarettes? Not attractive at all.

Thankfully, fewer people are smoking these days. I am sure much of that has to do with the fact that people now clearly understand the dire health risks of smoking. Also, adding taxes to cigarettes to drive up the price has the effect of making people quit.
Yay taxes!
Illinois recently increased the age to buy tobacco products to 21, and I say that is a good thing. Of course, people who are younger than that who want to smoke will find a way. And we see more and more young people vaping these days, even though the science on vaping is not looking good – for vaping, that is.
When I was a teen, there was still some something cool about smoking. It had the rebel image. And everyone smoked back then. My parents would have dinner parties and the smoke would be so thick we almost had to crawl on the floor to make our

way through the house.
But that was long, long ago. Now, almost none of the people I know smoke regularly.
Look, people who choose to smoke are not bad people. I understand that. But society is clearly saying, "please, don't smoke." You can't smoke in bars or restaurants anymore, or on planes, or on trains, or in a car with your kid. Some states have very strict smoking laws even outside in public.
It is about the public health, which I fully support.
The good news is there are more things available now to help you quit than ever. Gum, medications, support groups – they can all help.
It might be too late for that older man I see nearly every day, but it isn't too late for everyone. Maybe even you.

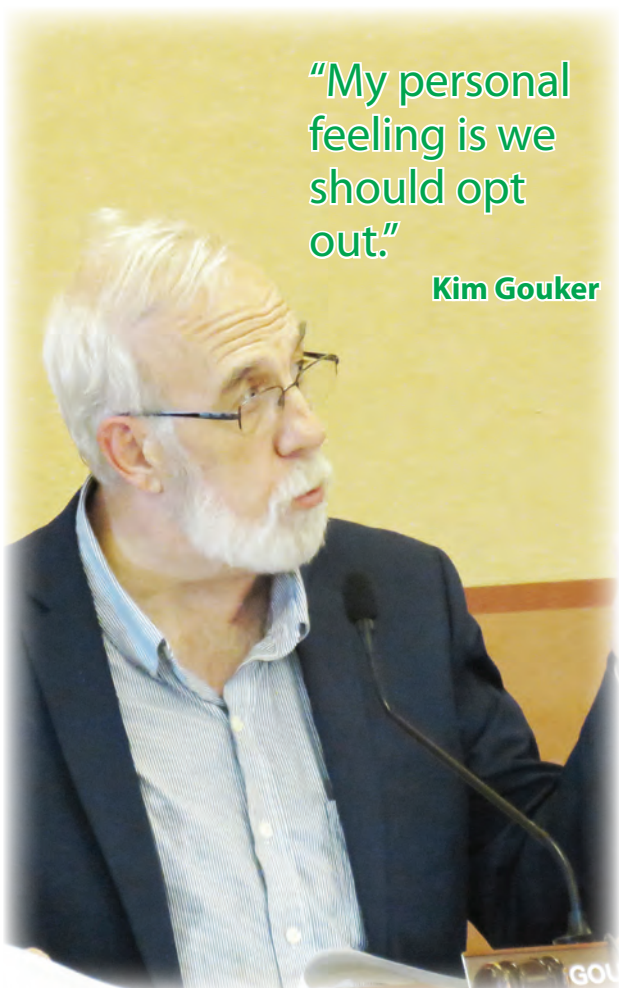

Moratorium extended

Solar developments put on hold for second time

OREGON – The Ogle County Board on Tuesday extended the moratorium on new solar developments in the county until the end of the year.

The board agreed to extend the moratorium for the second time because the state has not set another date for a lottery to select new solar developments. The extension will also give Harry Adams, Jr., the county's new Planning and Zoning administrator, time to "become acclimated" to the solar issue, said Board Chairman Kim Gouker.

The county initially set the moratorium at a public forum in August 2018. It was extended earlier this year so the county could form a taskforce to study the issue.

The board also received an update on the new jail currently being built behind the Judicial Center on Sixth Street. The plumbing and electrical work have started, and the load bearing walls are up. The construction is on track for the late 2020 opening of the 42,000-square

foot, 154-bed adult facility. The county broke ground of the project on April 10.

Marijuana use

The board also had a discussion about recreational marijuana use in Illinois, which goes into effect on Jan. 1. Gouker said he just wanted to gauge how board members felt about it and how the county should come down on the issue.

"My personal feeling is we should opt out," he said, meaning there would be no growth or sales of cannabis in unincorporated parts of the county.

Municipalities will make their own rules regarding recreational marijuana sales.

But Board member Kim Whalen of Rochelle said if the county opts out, people will just bypass it to find a place that sells pot.

Board member Don Griffin said there is a lot of gray area with the state, and said the county should take some time to look at the issue before moving forward.

Gouker said he would have more information to the board on the cannabis as early as next month.

River Sweep seeks volunteers

OREGON – The 10th Annual Oregon Area Rock River Sweep will be held on Saturday, Sept. 7 from 8 a.m. to noon.

Check in will begin at 7:30 a.m. at Kiwanis Park, behind Conover Square, at the intersection of North Second Street and Franklin Street.

Rock River missed its clean up last year due to persistent high water, so it's time to put a little extra work this year.

Volunteers

Volunteers are needed on foot or in boats to clean up a nine-mile section of the Rock River, from north of the boat landing on Illinois Route 2 to the Castle Rock State Park boat landing, for this annual effort to protect and preserve this local resource. Boaters, paddlers, river land owners, scout groups, service organizations and individuals are needed to help pick up trash as well

as sort the recyclable items from the trash. Students can earn community service hours by helping out.

For the third year, White Pelican Canoe & Kayak Rental Inc., will be providing a limited number of canoes for use for the sweep and will also provide free shuttle service from Castle Rock boat landing back to Kiwanis Park for those with their own canoes or kayaks.

Two years ago, approximately 50 people participated in the effort. With the flooding of the Rock River last year and this spring, the Rock River is expected to have a lot of waste which may have floated downstream and settled along the banks. This needs to be removed.

All participants are asked to check in at Kiwanis Park, where they will be assigned to a section of the river on which to focus. Those with motorized boats then

proceed to the boat landings to cover the assigned section. Those on foot will walk or drive to areas accessible from shore. Several drop-off sites for trash will be located along the cleanup route, where crews from the Oregon Park District, and the Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will pick it up and take it back to Kiwanis Park for sorting and recycling. Refreshments will be available afterward.

Gloves, safety vests, trash bags, bug spray, snacks and water will be available, as well as a limited number of T-shirts for sale. Participants are encouraged to wear long sleeves, long pants, and old shoes, and to bring a reusable water bottle to the event to reduce waste.

The Rock River Sweep is an effort by many groups up and down the Rock River, from Horicon Wisconsin to where it meets the

Mississippi River in Rock Island, to clean up sections of the river in a coordinated effort. It is sponsored by RockRiverSweep.org, a grass roots, non-for-profit organization dedicated to preserving the health and ecosystem of the Rock River and its tributaries. Other supporters include the Rock River Trail Initiative and the Rock River Times.

Locally, the Oregon Area Rock River Sweep is also sponsored by the Ogle County Solid Waste Management, the Ogle County Sheriff's Office, the Oregon Park District, White Pelican Canoe & Kayak Rental, Oregon Together, and American Rivers National River Cleanup.

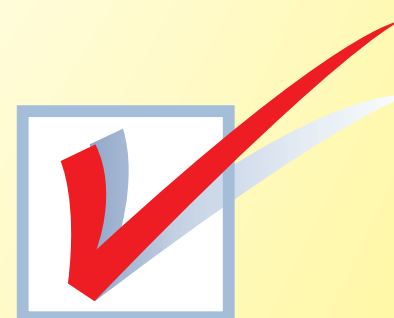

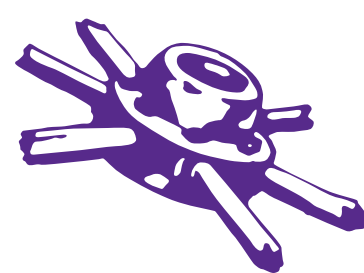

HUB SPOTLIGHT

Kirk shooting for breakout golf season with Hubs

REESE Kirk entered his sophomore year thinking he would compete for the top junior varsity spot on the Rochelle Township High School golf team. When the 2018 season started, Kirk was shocked to learn he would be the No. 3 varsity player behind only Sean Flanagan and IHSA State Championship qualifier Megan Thiravong.

Kirk spent his entire freshman season with the junior varsity team, shooting 9-hole scores that ranged from the upper-50s to the mid-60s. With several older players waiting their turn to earn varsity spots, Kirk was primed to spend another season on junior varsity. But the Hubs lost 11 players over the offseason including nine upperclassmen, and Kirk was tasked with stepping up and filling a significant role with the varsity team.

"I wasn't sure what happened to everybody else," Kirk said. "I was terrified when I played my first varsity match. I thought my opponents were going to crush me since it was my first match, but I shot 53 and they shot 49, so I knew I could stay with whoever I played against... I tried to be ready and I did my best to stay in the moment throughout the season."

Kirk, Flanagan and Thiravong were primarily Rochelle's only varsity players during the 2018 season, which made winning matches difficult. But the lack of team scoring didn't prevent Kirk from making improvements to his game, and while roster numbers are once again minimal this fall, Kirk and his returning teammates still have plenty to play for.

"Coach [Glen] Mehrings never told us our team scores and that was good for us because we wouldn't focus on where we were as a team," Kirk said. "Our focus was on being team players and not counting up our scores too early because anything could happen. Coach Mehrings helped us learn how to avoid jumping ahead and how to just keep playing and make shots."

Kirk and the Hubs teed off the 2019 season this week with their Interstate Eight Conference debut against Ottawa and a nonconference triangular meet with Dixon and Freeport. Kirk has moved up to the No. 2 varsity spot on the Rochelle roster, and after spending hours on the course this summer, recording 9-hole scores as low as 41, Kirk now has the physical build and the confidence to have a breakout season for the Hubs.

"I've really cut my scores down to where

I think I had a bad day if I shot 50," Kirk said. "I want to be in the 40s this season... I know I'll be ready and I know how to play a lot of the courses on our schedule. I want to be a leader for the younger guys and I want to encourage them when they make good shots."

Kirk has quickly surged up the Rochelle depth chart despite having almost no experience before high school. He said he chose to make the transition from football after Mehrings called his aunt and invited him to practice during the summer before his freshman season.

"I didn't know what I was doing on the course," Kirk said. "I had all drivers in my bag and I didn't even have a putter, but I started practicing with coach Mehrings more often and I started playing more over the summer. When school started, everything started clicking for me, and the game started feeling natural to me."
