

## Red Wilk Construction Tuff Hedeman Bull Bash



The Red Wilk Construction Tuff Hedeman Bull Bash kicks off the 2023 South Dakota State Fair grandstand lineup with two nights of high energy fun on Wednesday, August 30, and Thursday, August 31!

Hedeman, known for lining up elite riders to face off with world-class bucking bulls brings his annual professional, fast-paced, bull riding competition back to the South Dakota State Fair, featuring pro bull riders and bullfighters matched to animals of superior strength and fiery spirit.

The bull riding action begins with Tuff Hedeman "Bounty Bull" night on Wednesday with \$10,000 up for grabs, and continues Thursday night in a tournament style event and "Shoot Out" round where the bulk of the prize money, championship title, and custom prizes are earned.

The Red Wilk Construction American Hero Award will be held during both nights of bull riding. Typically, eight Veterans are honored each night, and since 2013, more than 100 Veterans from all over South Dakota have been honored.

## Salute to Veterans

oin us as we salute our Veterans at the SD State Fair! This year's keynote speakers are MG (Ret) Tim Reisch and Elsie Van Beek.

The program will be held at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, Aug. 31, on the North-Western Energy Freedom Stage.

Major General (Retired) Timothy A. Reisch was appointed by Governor Dennis Daugaard as South Dakota's 21st Adjutant General on April 2, 2011, and Governor Kristi Noem reappointed him when she took office in January of 2019.

As the Adjutant General, Reisch served as the Commanding General for both the South Dakota Air and Army National Guard and guided the preparation of 4,300 Air and Army National Guard Citizen-Soldiers and Airmen and over 1,000 full-time federal and state employees to respond in times of state or national emergency. Reisch logged over 40 years in the military before retiring in June of 2019.

On the civilian side, Reisch was elected the Sheriff of Miner County South Dakota at age 24 in 1982 and was re-elected in the four subsequent elections. In 2000, he accepted an appointment as the Deputy Cabinet Secretary of the SD Department of Corrections by Governor Bill Janklow. When Mike Rounds was elected Governor, he appointed Reisch as

the Cabinet Secretary of Corrections, a position he held for over 8 years. He returned to that position in 2021 at the request of Governor Noem serving for five additional months.

Reisch was appointed as the Miner County Veterans Service Officer in August of 2020 and continues to serve in that role on a part-time basis. In 2022 he was elected to the SD House of Representatives in District 8 which includes portions of Brookings and Miner Counties as well as all of Kingsbury and Lake Counties. He serves as the Chair of the House Military and Veterans Affairs Committee.

General Reisch has a Bachelor of Science degree in Public Administration from Upper Iowa University, a Master of Science degree in Administrative Studies from the University of South Dakota and a Masters in Strategic Studies from the US Army War College. In 2010 Reisch was one of 40 emerging state leaders from across the nation selected for the prestigious Toll Fellowship Program sponsored by the Council of State Governments. He is married to the former Anne Roby of Carthage, and they have five children and six grandchildren. Reisch enjoys the pastimes of hunting and camping.

Elsie Honors follows a young lady with big dreams. Since August 2017, our Patriotic Princess, Elsie Van Beek, has had the privilege of meeting over 1,300 of our Veterans to say Thank You. She gives each a special personalized dog tag to commemorate their specific flight when they return to Sioux Falls. She wanted to pay it even further and sponsored a flight at the "Medal of Honor Flight" level of \$50,000.

She started this goal, at the age of 13, after her older brother, the CEO of Midwest Honor Flight, said she could go on a flight if she sponsored it. In June 2021, Elsie Honors was created. Primarily, she raised her funds through baking and selling cupcakes. In February 2023, she reached her first goal of \$50,000 to get naming rights of the flight. Then, she increased her goal to \$85,000 to not only get naming rights of the flight but to sponsor all 83 Veterans that went on her sponsored flight. She reached this milestone the

day before her flight took off.

Her flight took off from Sioux Falls on May 31, 2023 known as the Elsie Honors Mission 15. Elsie had the opportunity to go on this flight and not only see where the money she raised went, she also was able to spend the entire day meeting all the Veterans that benefited from her flight. Veterans had the opportunity to see Arlington National Cemetery to witness the Changing of the Guards along with time at each of the memorials: WWII, Korea, Vietnam, Lincoln, Navy, Air Force, and Iwo Jima.

Soon after the flight, Elsie realized how important this day is for our Veterans and has decided to tie in her Eagle Scout project with supporting more Veterans traveling on future flights, possibly another sponsored flight. ## Dakotaland Museum welcomes you to the S.D. State Fair

ew this year at the Dakotaland Museum...admission will be free during the South Dakota State Fair. "Although we are not part of the State Fair, most people visiting our Fair City don't know that," explained Executive Director Louise Van Poll. "Visitors to the Fair are understandably confused when told there is an admission fee for the museum."

The Museum Board of Directors decided to open the museum to the public during the Fair and simply ask for a \$2 donation for adults. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Patrons will get an opportunity to make their donations at whichever exhibit they want to support and see improved.

"We will have four donation boxes at various locations around the museum," said Van Poll. "This will be a fun way to raise funds to upgrade our exhibits, based on what our visitors want to see improved or expanded."

The Dakotaland Museum has decided to purchase reading rails to create a better experience for all visitors. Reading rails stand waist high in front of a display and hold a descriptive panel offering the history, details, and significance of the items on display.

"We added a few last year in the redesigned Log Cabin Gallery," Van Poll said. "Those panels offer information about household chores and agriculture during the homestead era."

This year, museum staff expanded the phonograph area with the addition of an 1898 Edison Phonograph and will be adding a reading rail. Although there are no funds now for the actual mount, the museum was able to print the narrative panel of the history of

the phonograph to have on display this year.

"We have made quite a few changes at the museum lately," Van Poll said. "We encourage everyone to take the time to come visit and see what we've been doing."

There is a new area dedicated to the skill of typesetting for a printing press, including some fun facts and trivia. It is from printing we get the saying, 'Mind your Ps and Qs' and the terms upper and lower case. There is an entire set of letters, ink pads and paper for visitors to create their own headlines.

Other favorite displays include the 1921 Model T Speedster racecar; a scale model of Memorial Ballpark along with a unique Bottle Cap Collection depicting the 1965 Minnesota Twins team that won the American League Pennant; and of course, the two-headed calf. There is a Hubert H. Humphrey display of



## Sherwin Linton celebrates 50th year at fair

outh Dakota native Sherwin Linton, will be celebrating his 50th year performing at the South Dakota State Fair.

As one of the longest touring musicians in the upper Midwest, Linton is a living legend and his talent, wit, determination and generosity have made him a favorite of thousands of fans.

Linton made his first South Dakota State Fair appearance in the grandstand in 1973 following the release of his hit record, "Cotton King."

Subsequent appearances have been on the "Freedom Stage" in 1974, and in 1975 the city of Huron awarded Linton the key to the city. Sherwin's 1997 Freedom Stage performance was filmed live.

For the past 25 years Sherwin Linton, his wife Pam and their band "The Cotton Kings" have hosted the



entertainment offerings on the "Centennial Stage" where they feature other South Dakota entertainers as guests and opening acts.

Linton launched his career in the music business in the mid 1950s as a disc jockey and live performer of Rockabilly music on radio station KWAT in Watertown.

Now in his eighth decade of recording, Linton has released a new CD set reminiscing in music and stories the songs he recalls his parents singing while driving down South Dakota gravel roads in the 1940s. This new 43-song acoustic CD set is titled "Sunday Drives With Mom and Dad," and takes the listener on a musical journey of songs from the 19th and early 20th centuries.

Today, Sherwin Linton still tours with his wife Pam and their band "The Cotton Kings."

You will find the Linton's again on the Centennial Stage on "Cotton King Avenue" (named for Linton's hit record) during the 2023 South Dakota State Fair.


Their one-hour performances will include traditional country music and rock & roll classics laced with stories of Sherwin's tour experiences with the artists that made the hits.



## S.D. Farmers Union Day at State Fair is Saturday, Sept. 2

undreds of farm and ranch families plan to attend the **▲**2023 South Dakota State Fair. And the state's largest agricultural organization and the premiere sponsor of the State Fair has a full day of events to educate and entertain. Farmers Union Day at the State Fair is Saturday, Sept. 2. All activities will be held on or near the Freedom Stage.

"The State Fair is the largest agricultural fair in the state. It is where South Dakota's agriculture families showcase their best livestock, crops and showmanship talents. It's also where they come for information on relevant issues," said Karla Hofhenke, Executive Director of South Dakota Farmers Union.

During the Farmers Union Day, South Dakota Farmers Union (SDFU) hosts a Farmer Share Lunch, Farm Safety Ouiz Bowl and a Landowner Rights Forum.

"Landowner rights have been part of our organization's policy since the beginning because for farmers and

ranchers, our land is much more than our livelihood — it is our legacy," explained Doug Sombke, President of SDFU.

SDFU policy is established by its members. "Our policy is developed at the local level based on what is important to our members. This is the definition of 'grassroots,'" Sombke

Landowner rights have received quite a bit of attention in recent months after the private corporation, Summit Carbon Solutions, began threatening to use eminent domain in order to install its pipeline on private land in South Dakota.

"Threatening to use eminent domain instead of working with landowners is not respecting landowner rights," said Oren Lesmeister, a Parade rancher, small business owner and District 28-A Legislator.

Lesmeister and Sombke are among the South Dakotans discussing the issue during the public forum hosted by SDFU during Farmers Union Day at the State Fair.

"I expect this to be a lively discussion with plenty of crowd participation," Lesmeister said.

Tarmers Union feeds 1,000 fairgoers for the price farmers and ranchers are paid.

Providing food for others is a focus of South Dakota's No. 1 industry of agriculture. And the Farmers Share Lunch helps consumers understand just how much family farmers and ranchers earn for the work they do. It's a complete meal served by South Dakota Farmers Union and sold for a suggested donation of .42 cents.

"This nearly free lunch brings to light how much the middleman makes," Lesmeister explained. "The price people pay for a steak at the meat counter is far from the price I receive. Thankfully beef prices are up this year, but my family only receives \$2.64 for the \$9.99 steak sold at the grocery store. And this goes for all commodities we raise here in South Dakota."

ducating consumers as well as  $oldsymbol{\mathbb{L}}$  farm and ranch families is a large focus of South Dakota Farmers Union. The Farm Safety Quiz Bowl championships gives South Dakota teens an opportunity to sharpen and showcase their farm safety knowledge.

"I have seen many farm and ranch families go through loss or injury due to accidents. It's devastating. This quiz bowl is one of several ways our organization works to promote safety through education," Sombke explained. "And because fairgoers of all ages watch the competition, the Quiz Bowl educates more than youth."

Teams who qualified during the South Dakota State FFA Convention are Gettysburg, Selby Area, Platte-Geddes and Wolsev-Wessington.


