


Bridger Amiotte

Isabelle Camino attended Buffalo High School. She chose EWC for of its rodeo program and because 'I enjoyed the school.' Isabelle is majoring general ag.





Greisyn Chaney





Events: Team roping



Events: Tie-down roping and team roping


