

Now it's a step to keep opening safe, finding 'normal' and looking to the future.



Bethel History

Town of Bethel, N.Y., one of fifteen towns of Sullivan County, measures 93.5 square miles, includes 4.6 miles of water, 147 miles of road and is located on the watershed between the Mongaup and Delaware Rivers. The Supervisor leads local government with a four person Town Board. The most recent recorded population was 4255.

The first inhabitants in the territory were the Leni-Lenape Indians. 1795 records state that the Pintler brothers were the first settlers. Bethel separated from the Town of Lumberland. It incorporated in 1809 and the earliest settlements were Fraser, Briscoe, North White Lake, Bushville and Stephensville. The current land map consists of Bethel, White Lake, Kauneonga Lake, Smallwood, and parts of Mongaup Valley and Swan Lake.

Hunting, tanning, and fishing were the original industries and naturally, due to the rich land so suited to farming, agriculture followed. Bethel is still considered an Agriculture community today.

It was not until the mid-nineteenth century that the tourist industry developed. Inns and summer camps lead the way in the 'Golden Age' for area hotels, second home development, and the hospitality industry. Grossinger's, Kutsher's, the Concord and a variety of hotels dotted the area map. The 'Mighty M' Racetrack opened in 1958 and SC International Airport was built in the '60s. The Woodstock Festival, our claim to fame, put Bethel on the map in 1969. The number of

resorts diminished in the next few decades, yet our second homes and seasonal visitors kept the Catskill area alive.

To our delight, Bethel Woods Center for the Arts and Museum opened it's doors in Bethel in 2006. The exclusive Monticello Motor Club, Resort World Catskills Casino and The Kartrite Resort and Indoor Water Park made Sullivan County their home in the last decade.

In 2019, Woodstock's 50th anniversary year, the county-wide Dove Trail was promoted, while Bethel extended the trend with The Heritage Trail, depicting Woodstock highlights. Antique, Artisan Crafts, Maple Syrup, Craft Beer and Spirit Trails have popped up throughout New York State, especially in our area. We are also home to segments of the popular walking and hiking Trailkeeper and Rail-to-Trails.

All of this enticed the influx of new home owners in 2020 and as the population increases so does progress.

The Town of Bethel offers electric car stations and is continuing with technology improvements, solar energy arrays and serious environmental development. Our growing Parks and Rec boast of the Forest Reserve at Smallwood, the Dog Park, Park Facilities expansion and providing lake and waterway monitoring.

Today, our town promotes business, growth in the second home and tourist industry and a strong green, sustainable lifestyle.

Bethel is idyllic. We offer open space, access to various bodies of water, fresh air and will always welcome visitors to a relaxed, country life.




