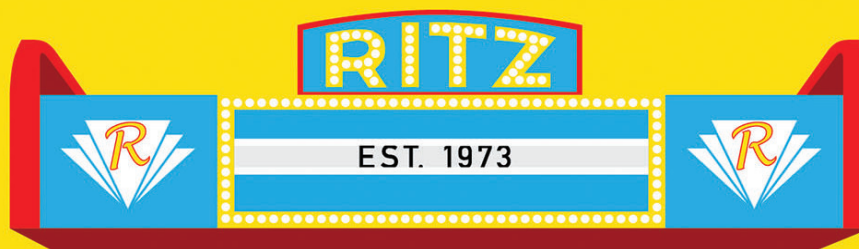

The 159th Wayne County Fair Returns!

Down in the valleys of Northern Pennsylvania, near the Delaware River, the Wayne County Fair returns after over two years. Everyone is invited to come out August

6 through the 14th to enjoy rides, live music, animal shows, monster trucks, and fun for all ages.

The Wayne County Fair is bringing back the \$10 pay-one-price wristband, allowing fair guests to attend a majority of the grandstand entertain-

ment, enjoy rides, and park all for one low price. This wristband does not include food, drinks, or specific grandstand events like the Monster Truck show.

"We are really proud of the pay one price option," said Vice President of the Fair Jeff



Firmstone. "We are so happy to give people the biggest bang for their buck."

Fan favorite returning shows include Rosaire's Racing Pigs, tractor and truck pulls, children's concerts, an educational dinosaur puppet show and more. Larry the Chainsaw Carver and Ryan Gothrup, a glassblower, will also be on the grounds. Their unsold pieces will be auctioned off on the small stage during the

final day of the fair.

The pay-one-price also allows attendees access to parking as well as to the midway, with over 20 big-time rides, a kiddie land section, and games to win prizes. And good news for seniors, those 62 and older are offered half off wristband prices on Friday, August 6 and Wednesday, August 11.

"On Wednesday there will be a spectacular fireworks show," said

Firmstone. "Because we're in the valley and it's so flat you'll have a view from anywhere in the fairgrounds. It's loud and it's fun."

The nine-day fair will be packed-full with new entertainment and activities as well. The Marvelous Mutts, a twice daily show featuring performances and tricks from all sorts of rescue dogs. Oakley the Tree Man, a 17-foot-tree person uses puppets, comedy and photosynthesis to

tell his story. He will also make his debut at the fairgrounds Tuesday through Saturday.

Tom Petty and Journey cover bands will be performing on Saturday, August 7 at the fair's grandstand. Long time Wayne County favorite Big Tiny Young will perform old favorites in his one man band during the first weekend of the fair. Other free

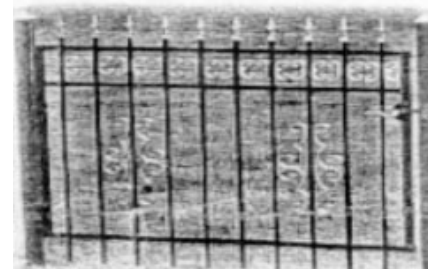
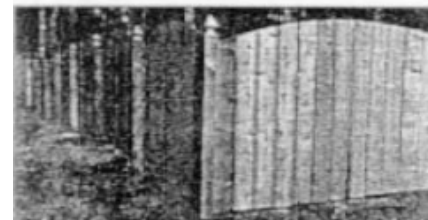
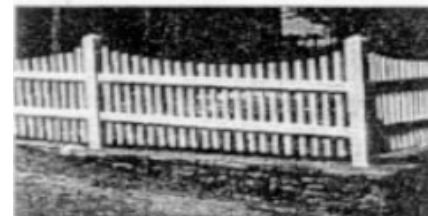

Baking Up Deliciousness

Delicious treats made by amateur bakers are taking part in a baking competition on Thursday, August 5.

Sponsored by the Pennsylvania State Association of County Fairs, there will be four separate competitions. There will be a chocolate cake, an angel food cake and an apple pie competition. There will also be a junior baking competition where those between the ages of eight to 18 are eligible to submit their recipes for cookies, brownies, and bars.

The competitions will be judged on a series of categories, including flavor, appearance, and decoration. Creativity is emphasized across each of these contests with majority awarding a percentage of points to those who let their imagination shine through.

For each of these contests, bakers were asked to be amateurs, use at least two ingredients that are PA Preferred, and most importantly, be homemade. The winners of each of these competitions will be given the opportunity to compete with their entry at the PA Farm Blue Ribbon Show and win \$500.

After nearly two years following the rules of the road, monster trucks, daredevils, and demolition drivers will invade the Wayne County Fairgrounds on Friday August 13 at 7 p.m.

Monster Jam Young Guns and World Freestyle champion Mike Vaters Jr. and his monster truck "Overkill Evolution" will headline the event. In 2014 and 2015, they became the first driver-truck duo to consecutively win Young Guns and World Finals Championships.

In addition to Overkill Evolution, four of the best monster trucks in the industry will be showcased during the event. The fair is bringing in the daredevils Higher Education, Black Stallion, Iron Warrior and Wicked Sickness to the Honesdale grandstand, guaranteeing an action packed evening.

The fun starts earlier in the week as well, with a demolition derby planned for Friday, August 6 and an Automobile Thrill Show performed by the Black Cat Hell driv-



ers on Thursday, August 12. Both of these events will occur at the grandstand at 7 p.m.

Amateur participants are welcome to join the action this year in quad racing and children ages 4 to 9 can sign up for the Power Wheels Demolition Derby.

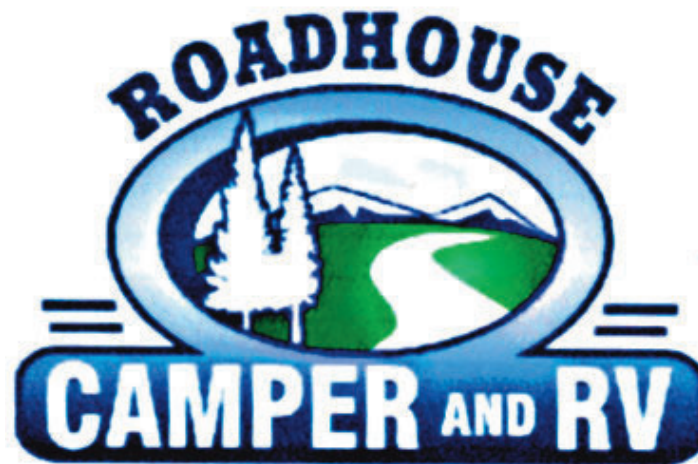

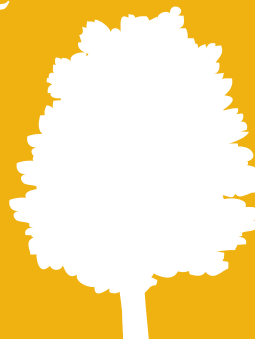

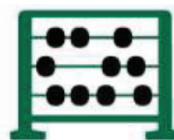

Back at the Barnyard



With a rich agricultural history, Wayne County honors its 159-year-old roots during the fair with plenty of animal attractions and educational exhibits.

Horse and pony pulls occur multiple times throughout the fair. These horses will be hitched to a 12,000-pound weighted sled and drag it for more than 27 feet. The ponies are also impressive, pulling well above their own body weights. Farm tractors, semi-trucks, and pedal pulls will also happen in the grandstand.

Livestock competitions are also held daily in the arena. Local animals raised by local kids in 4H will be on display. Children ages 5-18 may show the rabbits, chickens, goats, and sheep they raised, competing in a competition that will

last the same length as the fair.

These adorable barnyard animals like horses, cows, pigs, lambs, and birds will be showcased at the north end of the midway throughout the fair. The last day of the fair will see the 4H livestock sale occur.

Try to catch the Trivia Tractor Show that roams around the midway grounds during the entirety of the festival. The mobile game show asks contestants of all age's questions in a fast-paced, high-energy game. The Wheels of Agriculture will be present as well at the south end of the midway. This trivia game focuses primarily on agriculture-based questions spanning from animals, to local farming practices, to food groups, and beyond.

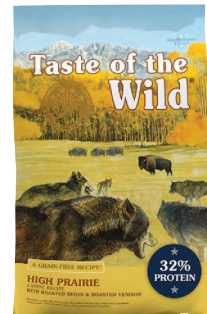

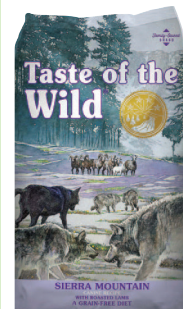

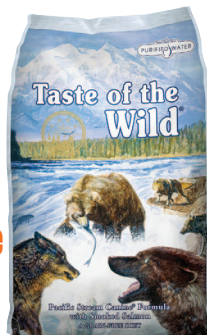
