he Neversink Agricultural Society's annual competitions will return as another highlight of this year's fair.

An array of categories offered to farmers and amateurs who enter the competitions. Animal competitions include beef and dairy cows, sheep, horses, goats, rabbits and pleasure horses. Those who win the show will be eligible for premium cash prizes. The Youth Fair will be held in connection with the Little World's Fair, beginning on Thursday, August 12.

There will be an agricultural section of competition including

flowers, house plants, landscaping, and fruits and vegetables. Fine arts and hobbies will also have competitions for judging during the course of the fair. Crafts, photography, jams and jellies, baked goods, and sewing will be on display during the entire fair, although they will be judged the Thursday prior.

There are no entry fees for the still exhibits. A new dove – part of the Sullivan Catskills dove trail – will be unveiled on Friday, August 13. Check the fair's website www.grahamsvillefair.com for a full list of rules and regulations as well as entry instructions.
