The Fair returns to Delaware County



he Delaware County Farm returns for its 134th year to the fairgrounds in Walton with rides, animals and plenty of entertainment from August 16-21.


Each day of the fair, visitors can see an assortment of entertainment. An illusionist with tricks and illusions, an interactive children's show called Cowboy Circus and Buffalo Barfield, a traditional American folk band, will all perform daily in the entertainment tent.

On Monday, a garden tractor pull will be held along with a musical performance by the Jason Wicks band. Children's Day is Tuesday, and will have a sundae making station and a kid's

power wheel derby. Adult and child karaoke competition will be held later in the evening along with a Hero's Parade, honoring the military, fire, and police who protect the community.

Wednesday features an out of field tractor pull as well as an altered farm tractor and diesel truck event. The country music duo Rick and Lori French are the musical guests of the evening.

Thursday sees a similar antique tractor pull early that morning. The Brad Collins Band and 2015 runner up on the Voice, Emily Ann Roberts will perform that night.

Friday will hold both a pony pull in the morning and a demolition derby in the evening. The Barnyard Saints perform that night. The last day, Saturday, sees NYTPA super-stock competitions and a stock-car pick up pull. Saturday evening will also hold the karaoke finals as well as a performance by BJ and Greg, a local duo that performs all the hits you know and love.

Dreamland Amusement presents rides and games on the midway during the entirety of the fair. The vendors also lined along the midway will also be in attendance, with nearly half of them representing local businesses from around the county.

Of course, 4H will also be a large part of this year's fair. Each day multiple competitions will be held for animals such as dairy and beef cows, rabbit, chicken and goats. The competitions will be held in the exhibition tent and the animals will be released at 8 p.m. on Saturday.
