Better technology helps detect breast cancer early

ctober is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, which promotes the importance of screenings, breast health education and advances in treatment.

Awareness of breast cancer is so important because one in eight women in the U.S. will develop breast cancer in her lifetime, making it the most common cancer for women in the nation.

According to the World Health Organization, breast health education and screening can save up to 37 lives every day in the U.S. If breast cancer is detected early, more treatment options are available and there's a better chance for survival. A vital tool in detecting breast cancer early is 3D mammography, which is the latest technology in breast imaging.

Garnet Health Medical Center – Catskills' Harris Campus now offers 3D mammography, also known as 3D tomosynthesis. The entire purchase of the 3D tomosynthesis equipment was made possible through funding raised at the 2021 Garnet Health Founda-

"Our family, friends and community have been a tremendous source of support throughout our battle with breast cancer. Our community loved us through it and now it is time to pay it forward. We understand that even with health insurance, the hidden cost of transportation related expenses can be a source of anxiety to many. It is our hope that Ride 2 Survive - Sullivan County will ease the burden of expenses related to transportation."

As of September, 2021, Ride 2 Survive has raised over \$265,000 to assist more than 1,200 with the financial costs of transportation associated with their treatment.

"We have the easy work - we just give the money out. But it's the community, the schools and everyone else who makes this possible," Ellison said.
