



If approved, this project would likely proceed with CFA 2022 announcements in December 2022. Responses to this request will be accepted until 2:00 P.M., June 13, 2022 at the Office of the Vilage Clerk, Village Hall, 167 North Main Street, Liberty, New York 12754. Mark on the outside of the envelope, "Response to Engineering Services Request for Qualifications – Rail Trail Culvert and Sanitary Sewer Main Replacement Project". Respondents are required to submit one (1) original and six (6) copies of their proposal.

The Village proposes to replace the sanitary sewer main and laid stone culvert at the Village Rail Trail to prevent a major sewer spill that would occur if the rail trail culvert failed. Activity includes installation of a new culvert, next to the existing culvert. The new culvert would be large enough to allow most debris to pass through, preventing clogging, and would be sized to

convey the stream flow under storm event conditions. The project budget is \$997,970 including construction, engineering and administrative costs.

The Village is seeking engineering services to include design, preparation of bid specifications, and assistance with bidding, construction administration, inspection services and as-built drawings. Copies of the preliminary engineering report, cost estimate and project area maps are available at the Office of the Village Clerk, Village Hall, 167 North Main Street, Liberty, New York, 12754 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.
