

Owner Karen Reilly, husband Jim, and teens Will and Megan have grown this Internet-based retail business into a colorful, vintage one-of-a-kind adventure. Many innovative ideas came out of the recent Pandemic times; this one is fuzzy and fun! Karen taught herself how to create felted creatures and artwork and the business took on a life of its own. It started so organically, as Karen shares, "I purchased a needle-felting kit and was immediately hooked. Because of the pandemic, I had more time to focus on a new hobby. I started out making gifts for family and friends and people asked to purchase more. That is how it began, and it all happened very quickly!"

Karen works with dyed wool to create unique, hand-crafted felted items, such as hippie figures, animal figures, oil diffusers, and felt paintings. One of the first things she created was a hippy gnome that resembles a local legend, Duke Devlin. Duke has been a Woodstock Icon here in Bethel for years and is a family friend.

"I didn't have anything specific in mind when I created it, but one look and I knew who it resembled. I showed it to Duke and asked if I could name a line of figures after him. He was very supportive." Every figure in the "Duke" line has a unique name derived from Sullivan County. They are named after local streets, towns, lakes, and rivers and each "Duke" figure comes tagged with its name.

Karen and Jim homeschool their children and a great deal of responsibility is given to the whole team. Megan is a fantastic artist and helps with color schemes and design. Will helps with product ideas

and to choose names and tag items. Jim steps in when items need to be glued, hung, or sawed. Everyone is very involved.

"It has been so fun to create the business name, logo, learn how to build a website, photograph the products, figure out the inventory system, management, and all the other little pieces that are required to run a small business", said Karen. "Farmhouse Traders quickly became a family affair and is a great experience creating the entrepreneurial business. Friends and family have been so supportive."

Bethel History

Town of Bethel, N.Y., one of fifteen towns in the center of Sullivan County, measures over 93 square miles, includes 4.6 miles of water, and 147 miles of road. Ninety miles northwest of NYC and southeast of Binghamton, it is located on the water-shed between the Mongaup and Delaware Rivers. Local government is lead by a Supervisor with a four person Town Board. The recent census recorded a population of 4362.

The first inhabitants in the territory were the Leni-Lenape Indians. 1795 records state that the Pintler brothers were the first settlers. Bethel separated from the Town of Lumberland, incorporating in 1809 with Briscoe, Bushville, Fraser, North White Lake, and Stephensville as the earliest settlements. The current land map consists of Bethel, White Lake, Kauneonga Lake, Smallwood, and parts of Mongaup Valley and Swan Lake.

Hunting, tanning and fishing were the original industries and naturally, due to the rich land suited to farming, agriculture followed. Bethel is still considered an Agricultural commu-

nity today.

It was not until the mid-nineteenth century that the tourist industry developed. Inns and summer camps lead the way in the 'Golden Age' for area hotels. second home development, and the hospitality industry. The Concord, Grossinger's, Kutsher's and a variety of "Borscht Belt" hotels dotted the area map. Holidav Mountain Ski Area, the 'Mighty M' Racetrack, and SC International Airport became operational by the '60s. The Woodstock Festival. Bethel's claim to fame, put the town on the map in 1969. The number of resorts diminished in the following years, however second homes and seasonal visitors kept the Catskills alive.

To our delight, Bethel Woods Center for the Arts and Museum opened its doors in Bethel in 2006. The exclusive Monticello

Bethel is idyllic. We offer open space, fresh air, various bodies of water and a welcome to a relaxed, country life.








