TICK-BORNE ILLNESS PREVENTION TIPS



After returning indoors, check for ticks, change clothes, and shower as soon as possible.

Do tick checks on your clothes and skin while hiking.

Use an insect repellent with at least 20% DEET, picaridin, or IR3535.

Avoid tick infested places such as brush, tall grass, and wood piles.

Hike in the center of trails.

Check your pets for ticks regularly.

Whenever possible, wear long sleeves and long pants.

Don't let a tick make you sick!

Treat clothes and equipment with Permethrin.

Lake Superior passes are on sale

Lake Superior State Park in Bethel will open for boat rentals and picnicking on Saturday, May 28, and continue to operate every weekend through the end of June, when it will commence daily operations through Labor Day.

Season Passes

Sullivan County residents and property owners can also visit Lake Superior State Park, 342 Dr. Duggan Road, in Bethel during operating hours to get a season pass.

Each pass is \$15 per person, which provides free entry into the park for the season.

First-time applicants need to bring proof of local residency or property ownership. Holders of 2021 season passes do not have to provide
