Delaware County Fair has something for everyone

The Delaware County Fair returns to Walton from August 15-20, 2022. The board of directors for the Delaware County Fair include Jason Craig, Ed Rossley, Bob Moody, Norm Kilpatrick, Cecil Davis, Ray Baker, Dan Hodges, Kevin O'Brien, Bill Banks, Jon Seely, and Niles Wilson.

This board is all volunteer, and they are local residents who understand the agricultural industry.

According to delawarecountyfair.org, the fair brings in over 80,000 people annually over a six-day period to enjoy the many events and vendors it has to offer. The fair features tractor and farm equipment displays and demonstrations such as the all-day Garden Tractor Pull, the Antique Tractor Pull, and Super Farm Tractors and Diesel Trucks.

Delaware County Fair also showcases livestock contests including horse, sheep, goat, cow, rabbit, and pig shows along with allowing guests to see and interact with thousands of animals.

There will also be entertainment all day and every day of the fair. In the entertainment court will be several bands and musicians playing like The Barnyard Saints Band and Randy Hulse Band of One. Other shows and events will also take place such as karaoke contests for kids and adults, a cutest

baby contest, demolition derby, a kid's power wheel derby, a talent contest, an illusionist, a show from the Catskill Dance Expo, the Hero's Parade, and Cowboy Circus.

In addition, there will be amusement park rides at the Midway, food vendors, events in the Youth 4-H barn like milk moustache photo opportunity, baby chicks hatching, and teen council quilt tickets for sale. Programs teaching how to save energy, stretch food budgets, and save money in general will be featured several times a day in the Home Economics Building. There are more events listed on the full 2022 fair schedule.

Some events start as early as 8 a.m. and some go on until as late as 11 p.m. Fair goers should check the full schedule for times of specific events. Daily Passes, Grandstand Tickets, and Season Tickets are available for purchase. Entry tickets are only available at the gate, but Grandstand Tickets are also available online and at Hodges Welding/Machine at 53 Liberty St., Walton, from Monday to Friday 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Midway (Amusement Park Rides) tickets can be purchased online in advance at tinyurl.com/596dfv9n.
