



# Fall line-up lookout: What to expect for Bethel Woods' autumn season

lthough the sounds of summer are nearing their final notes as Bethel Woods Center for the Arts prepares to host its final few shows of the 2022 summer pavilion concert season, the excitement of autumn-themed adventures

perseveres into the Fall season with returning events including Peace, Love, and Pumpkins, Harvest Festival, and Event Gallery concerts.

Returning for its second year, Peace, Love, and Pumpkins brings with its reappearance spooky special offers and themed nights throughout the event, and will run from October 14 to 30. The event is open nightly from 6:30 p.m. to 10 p.m., with the last entry at 9 p.m.

The event includes a family friendly walk through the Bethel Woods garden venue decorated with Halloween ornamentation, which includes thousands of unique hand-carved jack-o-lanterns and glowing pumpkin art.

Brave the pumpkin-lit path with weekly night specials, such as Friday Night Frights on October 21 and 28, Back-to-Ghoul Student Tuesdays, and Wear-Wolf Wednesdays. Other special events include a Sensory-Friendly Experience on October 24, the Night Markets at Peace, Love, and Pumpkins running from October 28-30, and Boos and Booze on October

Tickets are currently \$18 for adults, \$8 for youth (3-17), and children 2 & under are free entry. Early bird ticket pricing ends on Sep-

tember 5, so don't wait around like a scarecrow and purchase yours today! This is a rain or shine event.

## Escape Room and Venue/Backstage Guided Tour

Looking to challenge your Woodstock wisdom and to see more of the venue at Bethel Woods? Then look no further than the new Behind the Scenes guided tours and Escape Room.

This tour gives guests an exclusive backstage Pavilion access and grounds tour via golf cart, and includes an Escape Room experience in the Museum at Bethel Woods Special Exhibit: & Art Fair.

This event is limited to up to seven guests and is not available on concert days. Tickets for adults are \$25, \$15 for students, and free for children 12 and under.

Act now as this is an extremely limited time event, running on Wednesdays throughout September only from 3:30 p.m. to 5:45 p.m.!

## The Big Sip

Lovers of wine and spirits are invited back to 'the Garden' to participate in the second-ever Big Sip, a weekend celebration that highlights and features wineries from around the Hudson Valley, Finger Lakes, Long Island, and more

The event runs two days, October 8 and 9, with general gates opening at 1pm and closing at 5pm. VIP tickets get noon entry.

A general ticket includes entry into the festival plus unlimited sampling, a commemorative tasting glass, live music on the Festival Stage, and access to the food court and shops from local craft, artisan, and specialty food vendors. General Admission tickets are \$50 on Saturday, and \$45 on Sunday.

On Saturday, taking the stage is performer Mike DelGuidice & Big Shot, and on Sunday, Bethel Woods welcomes the musical group Ripe.

VIP tickets give guests a little extra peace, love, and wine, with early entry to the venue, access to a private lounge sponsored by Makers Mark, a non-public dining experience with exclusive wines and spirits, and complimentary admission to the Museum at Bethel Woods. VIP tickets are \$90 on Saturday, and \$85 on Sunday.

To help ensure the safety of guests after enjoying the variety of craft and artisan wines and spirits, Designated Driver tickets are also available at a lower price.

The holiday season will soon be here once again, and Bethel Woods has just the event to bring the family to for winter-themed festivities, various local markets, and a jolly car ride through the even bigger and brighter Holiday light show at Peace, Love, and Lights powered by Healey Brothers.

The light show will run from November 25-27, December 1-4, and then 8-11. On December 15, the event will be open nightly until January 1, 2023.

When open, it will run from 5 pm to 10 pm, with last entry being at 9 pm. It is one ticket per car load.

If you would wish to walk through the illuminated winter wonderland, Monday nights are dedicated to the Sullivan 180 Walk-thru, where no drive-thru will occur.

With that said, a few of these vendors recently chatted with the **Democrat** for a brief interview about their business' involvement with the Harvest Festival, and thoughts on the annual event.



#### **Do Good Spirits**

Roscoe-based Do Good Spirits will be back at Harvest Fest for another season, and have participated in the event for about six years.

They'll have a variety of their spirits available each week from vodka, gin and the very popular Beaverkill Bourbon Cream.

They will have another treat for attendees come Labor Day weekend. Using strawberries from Mountain Sweet Berry Farm in Roscoe, they'll be debuting strawberry liqueurs.

Do Good Spirits Owner Brian Facquet said

the new liqueurs will be called "Fruit of the Labor," and is a tribute to farmers.

"We're always honored to be at Bethel Woods," said Facquet. "It's such a great part of the Sullivan County community."

He added that like any farmers' market, he enjoys engaging with people willing to try local, New York products.

"It's beautiful," Facquet said of the event, "the diversity of vendors ... all-around it's a really positive thing."

#### Lori Rae Jewelry

Lori Rae Jewelry offers original pieces (like the bracelet pictured top right) that will add to any outfit. Stop by her booth and ask about her "Peace, Love and Pearls" collection, which fits the theme of Bethel Woods and the iconic 1969 Woodstock Music Festival.

Lori Rae Silvers has participated in the Harvest Festival for over a decade.

"The vibe is incredible," she said. "The music ... the variety of goods. Bethel Woods brings in a lot of people and they do a great job with the





festival. It's so well run. It's the most beautiful, lovely day out ... a giant craft and farmers' market."

#### **Muthig Farm**


Muthig Farm, located in Parksville, has been a staple of the Sullivan County market community since the late 1950s.

They'll be back at Harvest Festival with their New York State Pure Maple Products, which includes their dark syrup, medium syrup, cream, candies, jelly, granulated sugar and more.

Attendees can stop by and try the different variety of syrups offered by Muthig Farm, which has been around for five generations. They'll also get the opportunity to learn a little bit about them, as well as the process.

Meeting the great variety of people is what Dennis Muthig, who owns the farm with his mother Dorothy, enjoys the most.

"You get three-to-five thousand people [each weekend], of all ages from all over," said Muthig. "There are so many artisans and it's just a wonderful day."




