Firefighters, like all of our first responders, must undergo hours of training to acquire various skills and knowledge. Oftentimes this training is done outside of work hours, perhaps on nights and weekends, which can be a challenge to complete while juggling career and family obligations.

But they do it.

Describing what firefighters do isn't as simple as saying they selflessly run into burning buildings to save lives.

Several firefighters today are on technical rescue teams, helping to stabilize structures while people are extricated, as we recently saw in a response to a motor vehicle accident in Grahamsville.

They're also on FAST teams working to assist their peers when

they're in distress. And then there are dive teams, who've responded to calls for water rescues, among other responsibilities.

Speaking of water rescues, while it seems like most of the summer was quiet on that front, there have been a number of calls in the last couple of weeks.

While there are too many heroic efforts to recognize individually, we do want to

We are blessed to have you in our community and for all you do.









# Ninety-five years of service


r or 95 years, the White Lake Fire Company has been a pillar in the community. From rescuing lives on the water or running into burning buildings, or providing life-saving CPR, they've seen it all.

While the company started in 1927, it was not officially incorporated until February 1933, and the original firehouse was an old chapel. In 1962, that

chapel was lifted from its foundation to make way for a two-bay garage that could house the White Lake Fire Company's three fire trucks at the time.

Fast-forward to 1974, and the White Lake Fire Company purchased the beachfront property it currently calls home at State Route 17B.

When they sold White Lake Fire Company's property, it helped pay for the new firehouse built in 1992, along with money raised during fundraisers like Bingo.

The White Lake Fire Company has seen Sullivan County go through its ebbs and flows from the rise of the Borscht Belt Hotels to the recent resurgence of the casinos and hotels.

In 1969, when nearly 400,000 made their way to Yasgur's Farm, 17B was their primary connection.

In the past, Thomas Hendrickson, the White Lake Fire

Company Fire Chief at that time, told the Democrat that during the festival of peace, love, and music, they had to set up a water tank at the festival in order to help hydrate the festival goers.

The fire company has transformed its life-saving fleet of vehicles from a 1928 Ford Model AA—which they still own—to now
