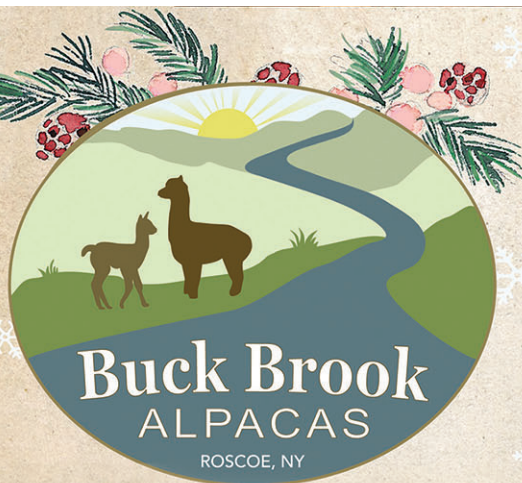

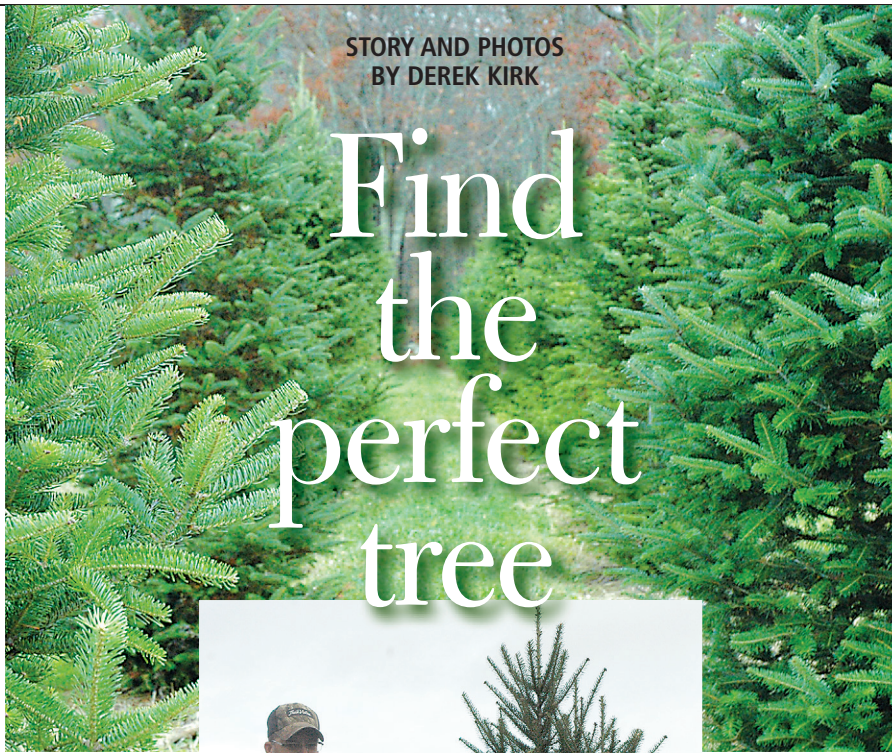

Started in 2012, Giving Tuesday was established to "unleash the power of radical generosity," which its creators define as "the concept that the suffering of others should be as intolerable to us as our own suffering."

This year, November 29 serves as the official date of this annual day of generosity. In 2021, an estimated \$2.7 million was raised, which was a nine percent increase from 2020. With this being their 10th anniversary, there's no doubt the originators would welcome an even higher total in 2022.

Many local organizations have become involved in the global generosity movement. For example, Nicole Feller Lee, Communications and Creative Consultant at the Community Foundation of Orange and Sullivan (CFOS), told the **Democrat** that its nearly 400 component funds count on the generosity of donors on Giving Tuesday and throughout the holiday season.

inspired by the stories of everyday people doing good in our communities and give local," she said. "We provide one-stop online giving on our website at cfosny.org. Our funds support a wide range of causes from education to healthcare, animals to the environment. Whatever is near and dear to your heart this Giving Tuesday, you can provide support with a donation through the Community Foundation!"

Gary Siegel is one of the organization's board members and fund representatives. He will be leading his own campaign for the Siegel Trust Enriching Arts and Music (STEAM) Fund. STEAM supports musicians, artists and venues through Mission One Gig At A Time (MOGAAT), providing Arts In Education programs with hot topics such

as social emotional learning, health, mindfulness, nutrition, peace, love and equality for children, teens and adults and awarding scholarships for graduating seniors.

Speaking as a CFOS board member, Siegel said he is a fan of "no-brainer" fundraisers, and Giving Tuesday is one of them.

Furthermore, he said that research shows 30 percent of all yearly giving is done in December, and three percent is done in the final three days of the year. He believes Giving Tuesday is the perfect kickoff for this period of generosity.

"It seems to me like there is enough to go around for everybody to be involved in a Giving Tuesday campaign," said Siegel.

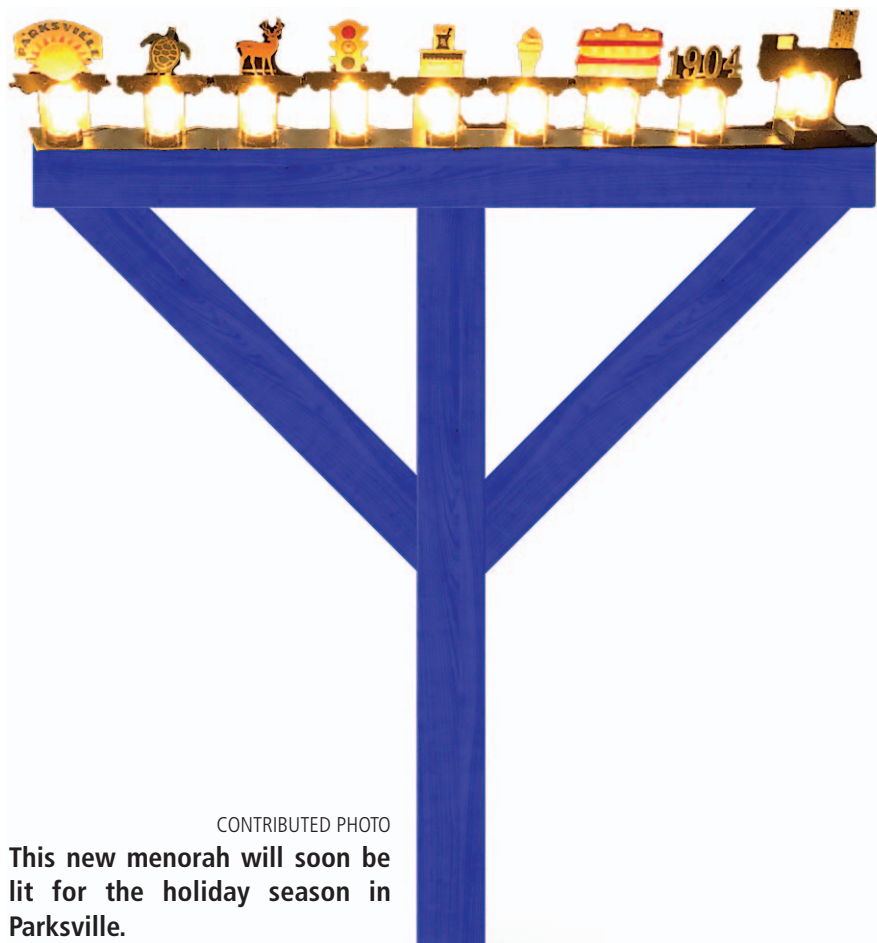
Parksville to light menorah on Dec. 17

On Saturday, December 17, the first annual Sunset Stroll, Music and Menorah event will take place in Parksville, which will light the new menorah that was funded by Sullivan Renaissance's Neighborhood Beautification Grant.

The seed for the project was planted in November and December of 2021, after Dr. Hope Blecher and Mr. Ray Croney, Parksville residents, attended Holiday in Hurleyville and then the lighting of the Liberty menorah sponsored by Chabad at Shop Rite. While chatting with Harriet and Gerry Dorfman, the idea germinated and conversations followed.

There were conversations, emails, and in-person meetings with exchanges that included Liberty Supervisor Frank DeMayo, Nick Rusin, 10th Floor Production crew Colin Sass, and grew to Van Morrow. With the rendering evolving, the grant conversations began with Shannon Cilento of Sullivan Renaissance. The menorah project was shared during multiple Parksville Priority Committee meetings lead by Frank and Nick.

Once the grant was awarded, the rendering became the physical 9-foot blue menorah. The symbols were painted by Hope with the assistance of Sarah Weber and Sarah Litwin. The design for the nine symbols evolved from com-

munity feedback gathered at the Trout Parade, a **Sullivan County Democrat** article and a WJFF radio interview, as well as other local conversations. The discussions and design of the menorah as a public work of art and a sharing of culture was also facilitated with input from Rabbi Fred Pomerantz, of Congregation Agudas Achim of Sullivan County.

The symbols were selected to reflect the past, present and future of the hamlet of Parksville. The engine has a smokestack that represents Hillig's Castle. There is a nod to the hotels, the pharmacy on Main Street, natural elements, the Leni Lenape, and the blinking light and ice cream shop on Old Route 17. The train concludes with a sunrise, the future of Parksville. The train motif was chosen because the menorah will stand on township property by the Parksville Rail Trail.

For the dedication ceremony on Saturday, December 17,

people can gather at Trailhead A, Fox Mountain Road. At 3:30 p.m. the participants will stroll along the rail trail to their destination, Trailhead B, by Cabernet Franks and the site of the menorah. At 4:30 p.m., there will be a celebration that will include a few speeches, songs and music by local people, including Sarah Weber and Tobi Innerfield. Participants are welcome to sing along, bring their dreidels and join in the community camaraderie. Afterwards, Cabernet Frank will feature latkes on their menu.

This menorah and the celebration ceremony were made possible through the support of The Town of Liberty, Sullivan Renaissance, Sullivan 180, Sullivan County Chamber of Commerce, Cabernet Franks and the volunteers of the community. It's truly a concept come to life and showcases what is special about Parksville, a hamlet of Liberty in the heart of the Sullivan County Catskills.

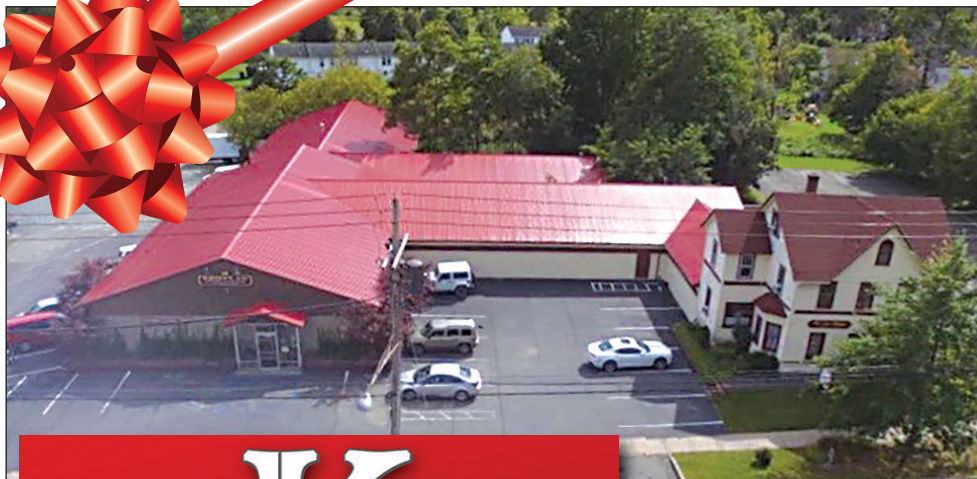
