



# Pets and Holidays

ver the river and down thruway and up the challenging Catskill foothills our relatives will come for this holiday's celebration. Here are some of the things we will do so that our pets can enjoy the visit too.

- We grownups keep the energetic kids busy with crafts and games and a leisurely stroll outdoors after the dinner mess has been cleared.
- Small children are encouraged to pet only those pets who like attention, and we keep an eye out when they do.
- Regular mealtimes are kept, as close as possible, so that no pet goes hungry and tries to eat something it shouldn't.
- No potpourri or fragrance burners in the house, these can be poisonous or irritating to pets. Sometimes pets will try to eat unusual things, so keep them out of reach and securely enclosed.
- To freshen the air before guests arrive, sprinkle some baking soda on area rugs and let it stand briefly, then vacuum thoroughly. In years past, I have rented a carpet cleaner but no one seems to appreciate the aftermath of fans blowing to dry the carpet—most notably the fourlegged residents.
- We never offer people food to our pets, so no table begging. Fat scraps are just bad, and bones are put away before they tempt anyone. Small bones can lead to choking. Larger bones, such as pork chops or beef bones, can have sharp edges. If you do offer bones, keep an eye on your pet while they're gnawing on them. Take away what's left over when they're finished.
- No shellfish, oyster or clam
  - No raw eggs or raw fish
- Plastic bags are off-limits. If chewed and swallowed, they can cause intestinal problems. Pets can also get hurt if a bag completely covers their head and they can't shake it loose. They may run into walls or fall down stairs or, worst case scenario: suffocate.
- Potato chip bags or other snack bags go in the garbage, which is



Decorate with the safety of your pets in mind: have a tinsel-free tree, with unbreakable ornaments, no low-hanging light strings, and no other goodies that they might chew on. Keep the number for your local 24/7 emergency veterinary hospital handy. If you suspect your pet has eaten something poisonous, call the **ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center at** (888) 426-4435.

always out of reach. Pets can get their heads stuck inside these types of bags too, and there's a risk of suffocation.

- Small boxes, like empty tissue boxes, are flattened for recycling.
- Pet toys are always available to de-stress from the "interlopers," and a bedroom door is always open for our pets to escape the traffic of a full house of guests.
- We also watch the outside door as guests come and go to be sure no pet retreats outdoors because of stress from having extra company.

We're always glad when we can have family with us for the holidays. We don't have them close often, and it's wonderful to share time with them when we do. We'll remember those who have passed on, and we'll miss those who can't join us this year because they no longer travel long distances.

I'm thankful for the time we've had with all family and friends, and I hope you readers will enjoy similar time with your loved ones.

They haven't said as much, but I'm fairly certain our pets would prefer if all holidays were always celebrated with guests joining via Zoom session.







# A portal to the past

Gardner & Co. General Store open full-time

or Cindy Herbert, owning and running a store had always been something she wanted to do. With Gardner & Co. General Store, that dream became a reality. What began as a holiday pop-up in the hamlet of Hortonville, has now become a year-round operation that highlights artisans from around the county and beyond.

Cindy grew up in Jeffersonville before moving to Hortonville in 1998. She knew when she bought the property that she wanted to do something with the building on the property that was built in 1850.

"I've been building towards a theme of sustainable products but

keeping a rustic, almost antique feel to it."

Ând so far, that theme seems to be working. Customers that stop in comment on the old-timey feel of it all, from the products for sale to the display shelves and layout that Cindy came up with.

When asked

about some of her favorite parts about running the store and being able to sell local products Cindy said, "Meeting everyone and learning about them and their stories has been such a great experience. From the artists to the customers that come through the door, everyone has their own unique story."

One of the biggest hits within the walls of the store has been local ice cream from Myers Century Farm.

"During the summer we had tables and chairs where some of the Christmas displays are, giving customers a place to sit and enjoy

their ice cream.' Opening an old-fashioned soda fountain is another of Cindy's todo's for the store, adding to the

vintage feel and keeping with the

theme of the past brought to the present.

While she explained that the store is slightly off the beaten path, there is still plenty of traffic to the store from the road that connects Callicoon to North Branch and be-

For now the store is open from Thursday to Sunday each week, and the hours vary. On Thursday, they are open from 11 a.m. until 4 p.m. On Friday and Saturday they are open 11 a.m. to 6 p.m., and on Sunday they are open from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.




