

MONTICELLO – Division games always bring an extra dimension of competition and high stakes with them, and Friday's contest between Monticello and Port Jervis was no different. Despite their downhill attack and fast pace early, the Panthers would ultimately fail to close out the win, dropping the home game 47-40.

The Panthers held the lead for the first 85 percent of the game, despite being outrebounded by the Raiders. Thanks in part to a strong first quarter leading to a 13-4 lead, with senior guard Joseph Russo netting five points in the quarter.
