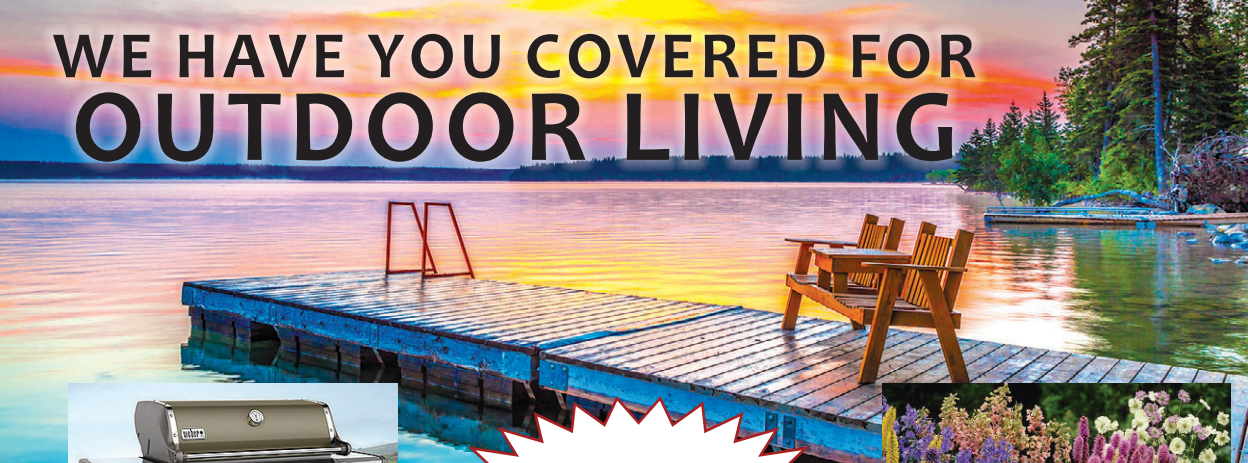

Un'Brae'keable

Tarry Brae Golf Course
remains a beautiful
pillar of years past

Situated on Pleasant Valley Road in Fallsburg, the Tarry Brae Golf Course remains a landmark of a different era.

Originally designed by William F. Mitchell and built in the 1960s, Tarry Brae became a golf destination during the Borscht Belt era, alongside Stevensville Country Club, Kutshers Country Club, the Concord Monster/International Challenger, The Pines and Grossingers. Now, just Tarry Brae remains.

The 6965-yard course features breathtaking views, including Tarry Brae's signature sixth

hole. Driving downhill and aiming for the green located next to Echo Lake.

Rock walls throughout the course have been there since the property was a farm. The rustic feel combines with the newer structures to create a mix of the past and present.

Tarry Brae is currently in the process of updating their clubhouse, increasing their dining space to fit 200 people.

Aside from good food, great golf and even better views, Tarry Brae is also home to Geoff Walsh, PGA.

Walsh's lifetime love of golf began at Tarry Brae, back when he was just 16 years old.

"This was, and still is, my dream job," Walsh explained as he rode around the course.

The course is owned and operated by the Town of Fallsburg, and is one of the premier golf courses in the area.

Just over two miles away from Tarry Brae, Lochmor is another course owned and op-

erated by the Town of Fallsburg. Geoff's son Taylor Walsh is the Head Golf Professional at Lochmor, and a membership offers privileges at both courses.

Tarry Brae gained in popularity during the Borscht Belt era, as many of the large resorts would send guests to golf the hilly par-72 course.

The course has stayed popular over the years through the continued effort to keep it such a great golf experience.

"Both of the courses in Fallsburg are spectacular," Walsh said. "Superintendent Pat McNamara does a great job."

Whether you're new to the game, or a seasoned veteran, Tarry Brae's inviting course offers some of the most difficult par 3's in the Catskills. However, it also offers plenty of birdie opportunities, alongside the beautiful views, making the challenge worth it for anyone that makes their way over to South Fallsburg.

Work that is getting done on the park to get it ready for opening includes a handful of renovations to current and new attractions. The plan, according to Jessica LaTourette, who is part of the new ownership group that took over this year, is to open by Memorial Day.

The park also has their Carousel Dairy Bar & Cafe open all year round from 6 a.m. till 10 p.m., which features an all new breakfast, lunch, and dinner menu. They offer dine in and take out options as well as daily specials.

One of the new attractions being added is batting cages for the baseball and softball enthusiasts out there, which LaTourette said a lot of people had been asking

They are also currently landscaping for a brand new Mud Pond Archery 3D course. The course includes several 3D decoys of different types of wildlife for park goers to shoot at.

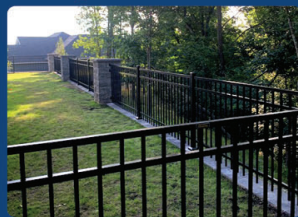
The family-oriented attraction offers many other outdoor activities that have been included in their park for many years. Carousel has two

A long-distant migrant
sings for spring and
babies on the nest

Its name comes from mewing, but it's not a cute kitty with whiskers or four paws.

Rather it's our warm weather visitor, the slim, plain-looking Gray Catbird – a robin-sized bird with amazing vocal abilities that range from glorious melodious songs to raspy mews that sound, in fact, like cats.

“Male Gray Catbirds sing a long, halting series of short notes collected into ‘phrases,’ which combine to make a song,” reports the Cornell Lab of Ornithology in upstate New York. “One whole song can last many minutes. Sounds include whistles, squeaks, gurgles, whines, and nasal tones. The notes often are imitations of other birds as well as of frogs and mechanical sounds.”

Females sing infrequently, and when they do, their songs are sung more quietly. Both male and female are slender, long-tailed dark gray birds with a blackish cap on the head and a dark, chestnut-colored inconspicuous spot under the tail.

The Gray Catbird has a very distinctive sound, with amazing vocal abilities that range from glorious melodious songs to raspy mews.

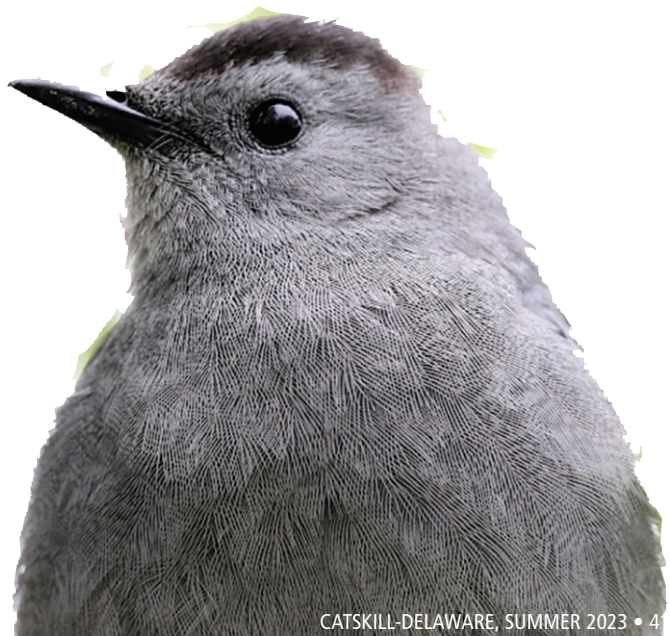
How they call it

For its fancy singing, the Gray Catbird possesses a “syrinx” – a voice box at the point where the bird’s windpipe divides into two bronchi. It is unusual in that both sides can operate independently, the bird warbling away, using two voices at the same time.

The song of a catbird consists of a series of rapid, short sounds. There may be up to 100 different syllables in a particular song. Most characteristic is a very quick cat-like “mew,” slowing towards the end or a “tcheek-tcheek” sound. Soft melodious warbling can be interspersed with mewing, squeaks and imitations of sounds they have heard.

Of course, catbirds are here mainly to raise families. They arrived in April from their wintering homes in the southern states, the Florida Gulf Coast, the Caribbean, or even Mexico or Cen-

tral America.

Year after year, catbirds tend to return to the same place for nesting. Here, they prefer to hide their low-lying nests in dense bushes, thickets and tangled vines. Both male and female carry straw, twigs, weed stems and rootlets, but the female constructs the nest – a small, bulky open cup for the eggs.

The mother can lay up to a half-dozen

turquoise-blue eggs but three or four are more typical. She incubates the eggs for 12 to 13 days while the male moves about the area, singing for hours. Both feed the blind and downy nestlings as they change and grow. The young leave the nest about 10 or 11 days after hatching.

Should a nest be disturbed during the all-important time when fledglings are

being raised, other catbird neighbors will join in the parents' raucous outcry of calls and mews.

Parents aggressively protect the nest against predators by spreading their wings and tail and calling loudly. They will physically attack predators with their beaks as witness one true tale in Pennsylvania when a two-foot-long blacksnake started making its way towards a catbird nest. One of the parents swooped down, seized the end of the snail's tail and jerked it. The snake plunged to the ground and managed to slither away.

Spring and Winter feasting

Catbirds are omnivores, eating ants, beetles, moths, caterpillars, earthworms,

spiders, crickets, and grasshoppers. But they also feast particularly on strawberries, blackberries, cherries, elderberries and grapes.

Often heard before they are seen, these birds tend towards secretiveness, darting into thickets when someone arrives on the scene. But they are also inquisitive and will respond to a person imitating the catbird's call. Or to someone sitting quietly in a nearby lawn chair. Tin plates of water or small pieces of soaked raisins, orange slices or a dab of jelly can sweeten the deal.

their summer home in a week, others longer. They live similarly as they do here: in shrubby habitats and near berry-producing plants with insects nearby.

The average life span of a catbird ranges from four to 10 years, barring predators from the air like blue jays, crows and hawks, or on land, squirrels, raccoons, domestic cats, foxes and even chipmunks.

But every catbird is an important predator in itself, helping to control the deadly gypsy moth population that can ruin oak trees, willows, birch trees, apple and crabapple trees.

And the bird has even captured a role in phraseology that's been in play since the nineteenth century, apparently derived from the catbird's secluded perch as he makes his calls. It's "You're sitting in the catbird seat," if you have the upper hand.

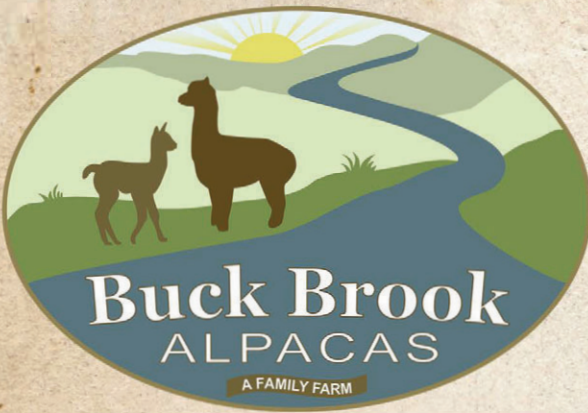

player base from 4.8 million players to 8.9 million in 2022.

Throughout the County, new pickleball groups are forming, and inviting locals out to try their hand. Some places, like Roscoe's branch of Sullivan 180, offer both beginner and intermediate nights for residents of the hamlet.

The Delaware Youth Center and Duggan Community Center are two other locations where interested players can give it a try.

Pickleball is versatile in that it can be played indoors or outdoors, with easy-to-build travel nets. The ball used when playing is akin to a wiffleball, similarly sized and hollow with holes.

The sport began back in the summer of 1965, when Joel Pritchard, Bill Bell and Barney McCallum began creating rules for the budding sport that began on an old badminton court on the Pritchard property on Bainbridge Island, WA.

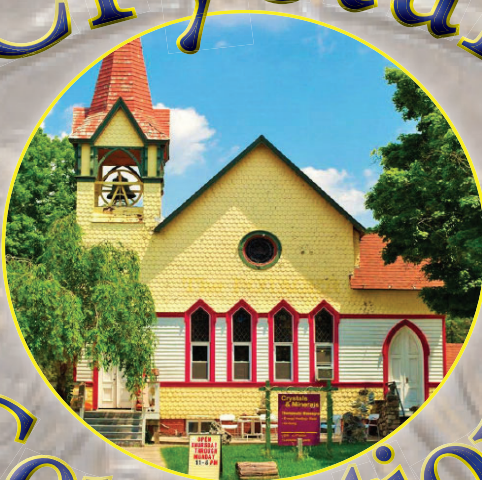
